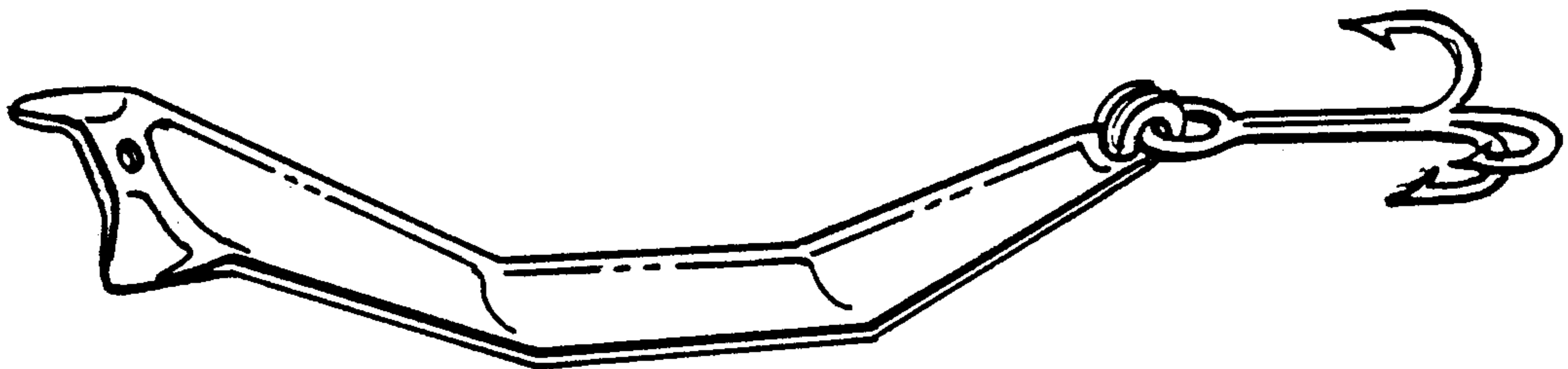

The ornamental design for a fishing spoon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing spoon illustrating my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a view as seen from one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 5 is a view as seen from the right end of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 6 is a view as seen from the left end of FIG. 2.



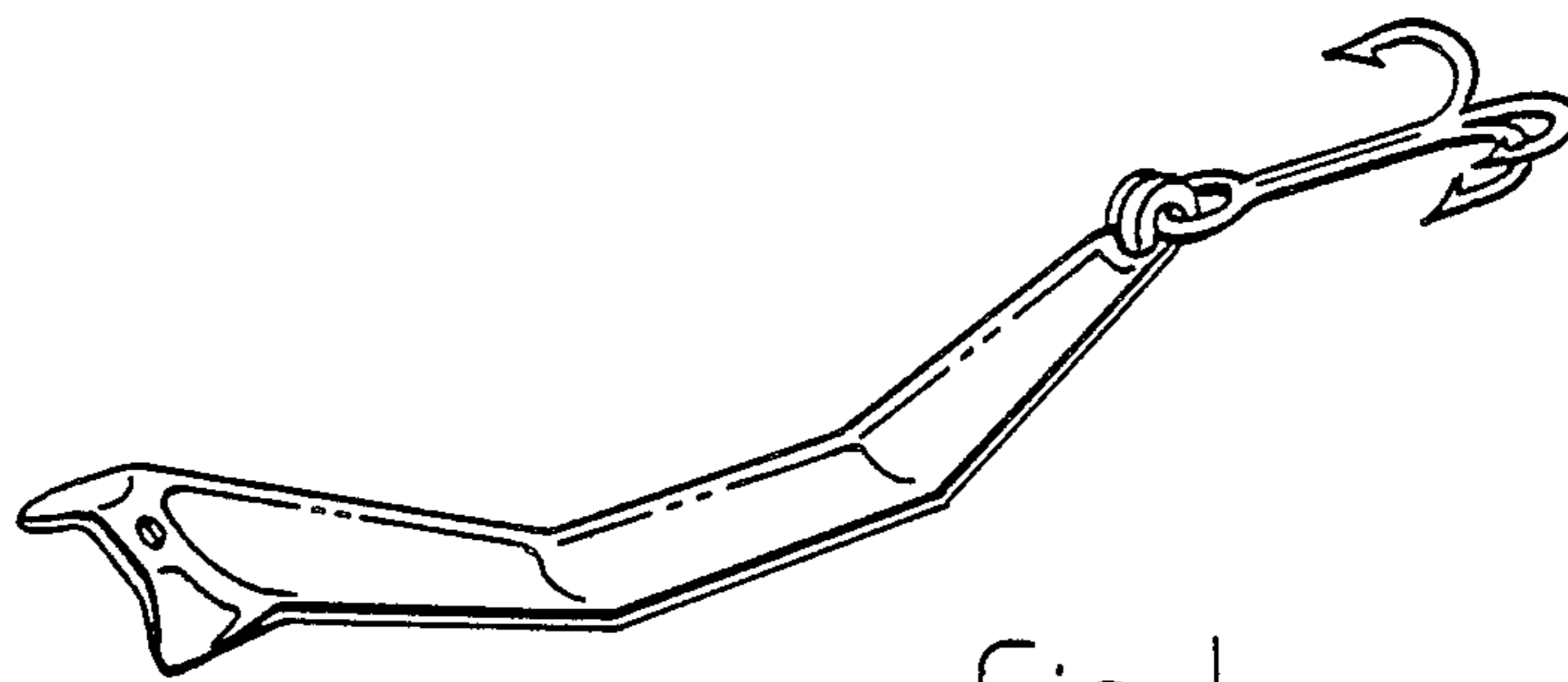

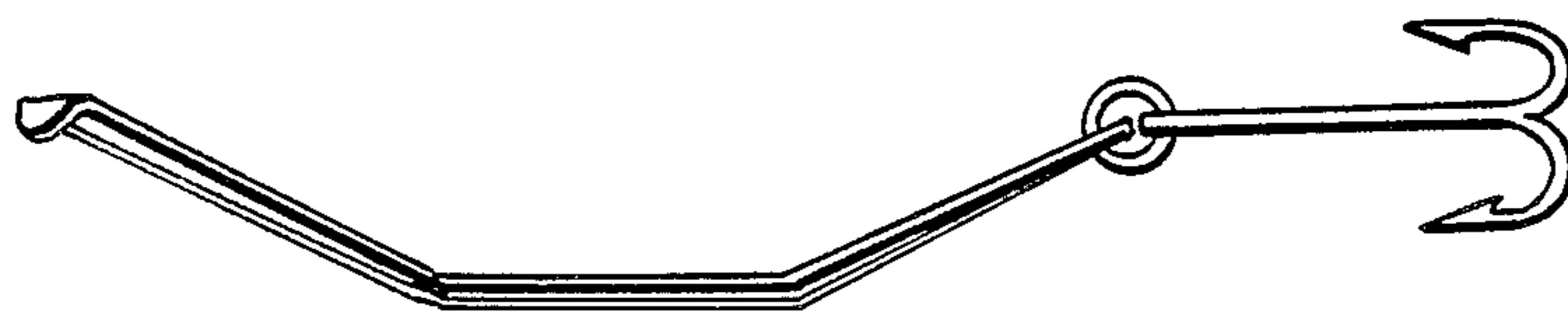

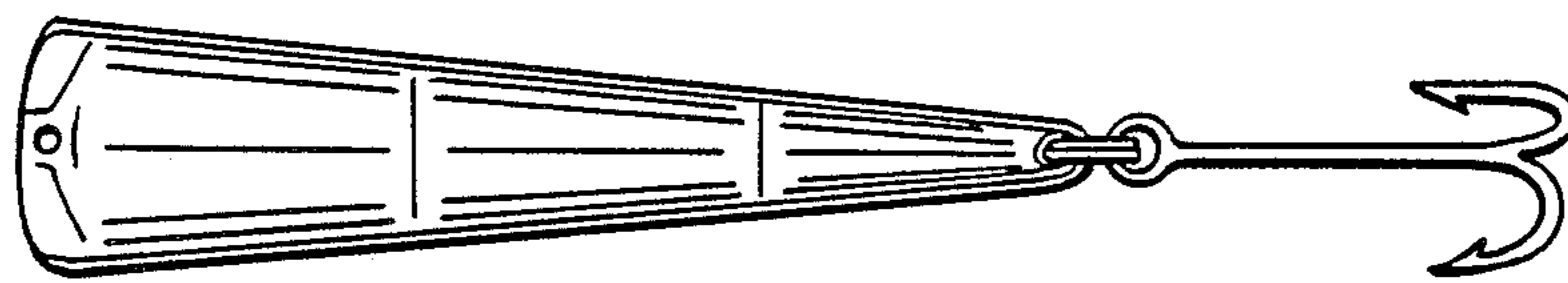

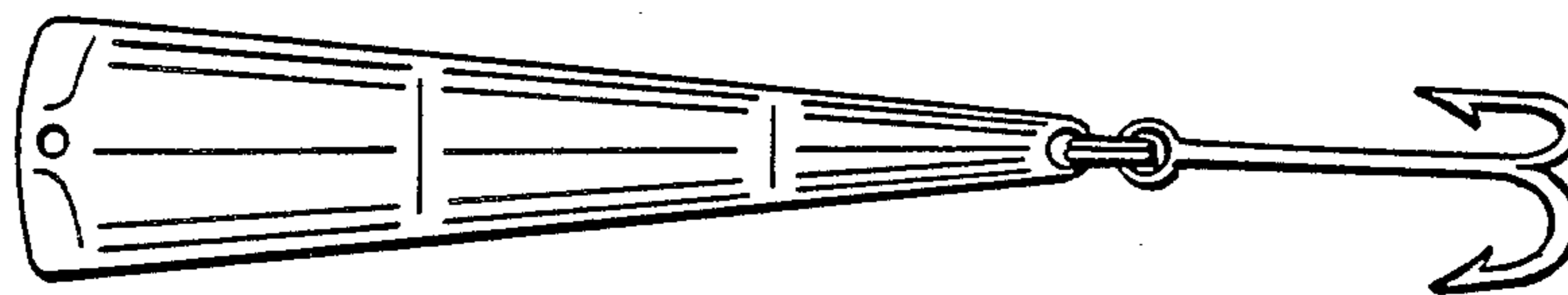
