DESCRIPTION

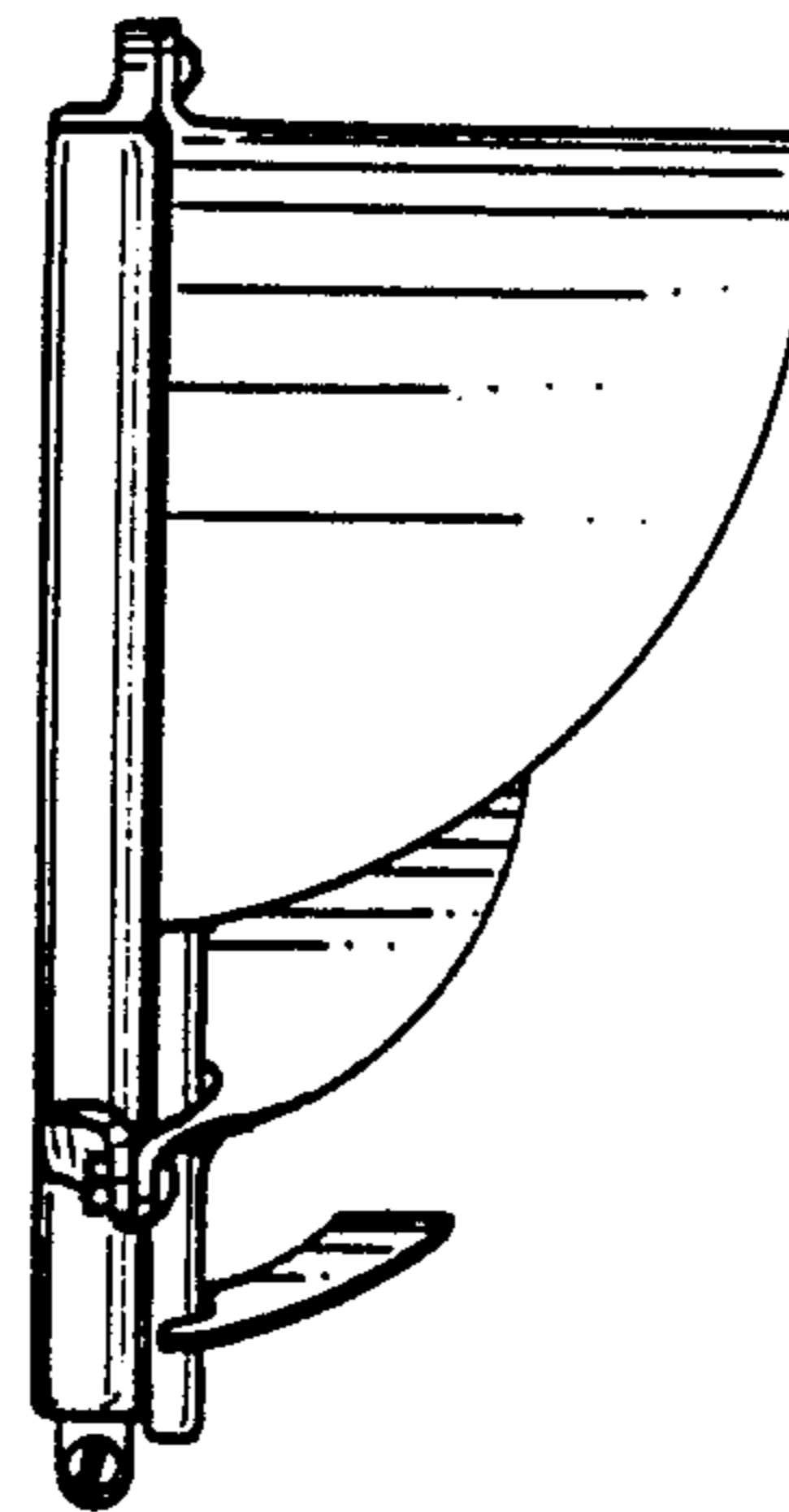
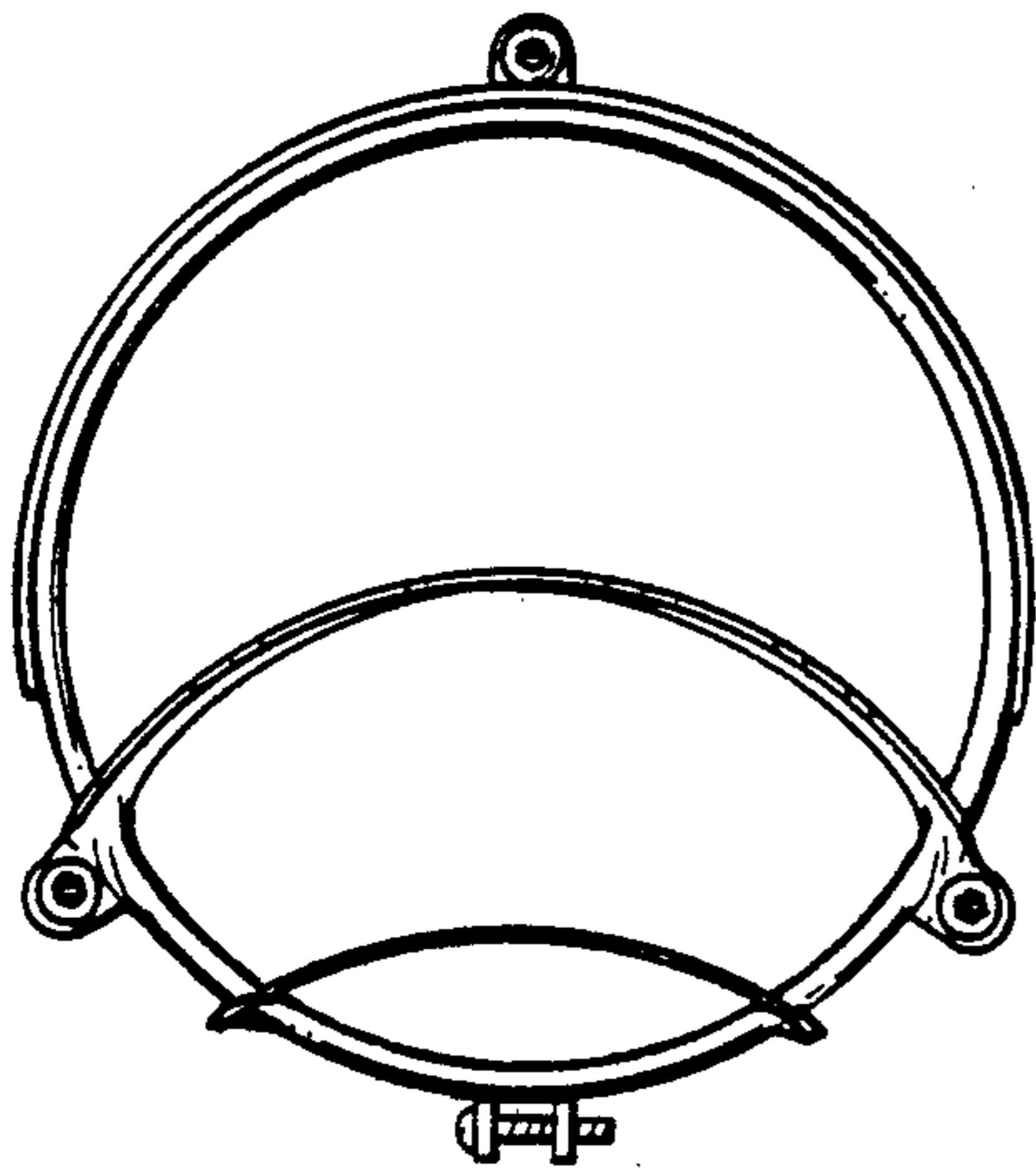
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a headlight louver showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



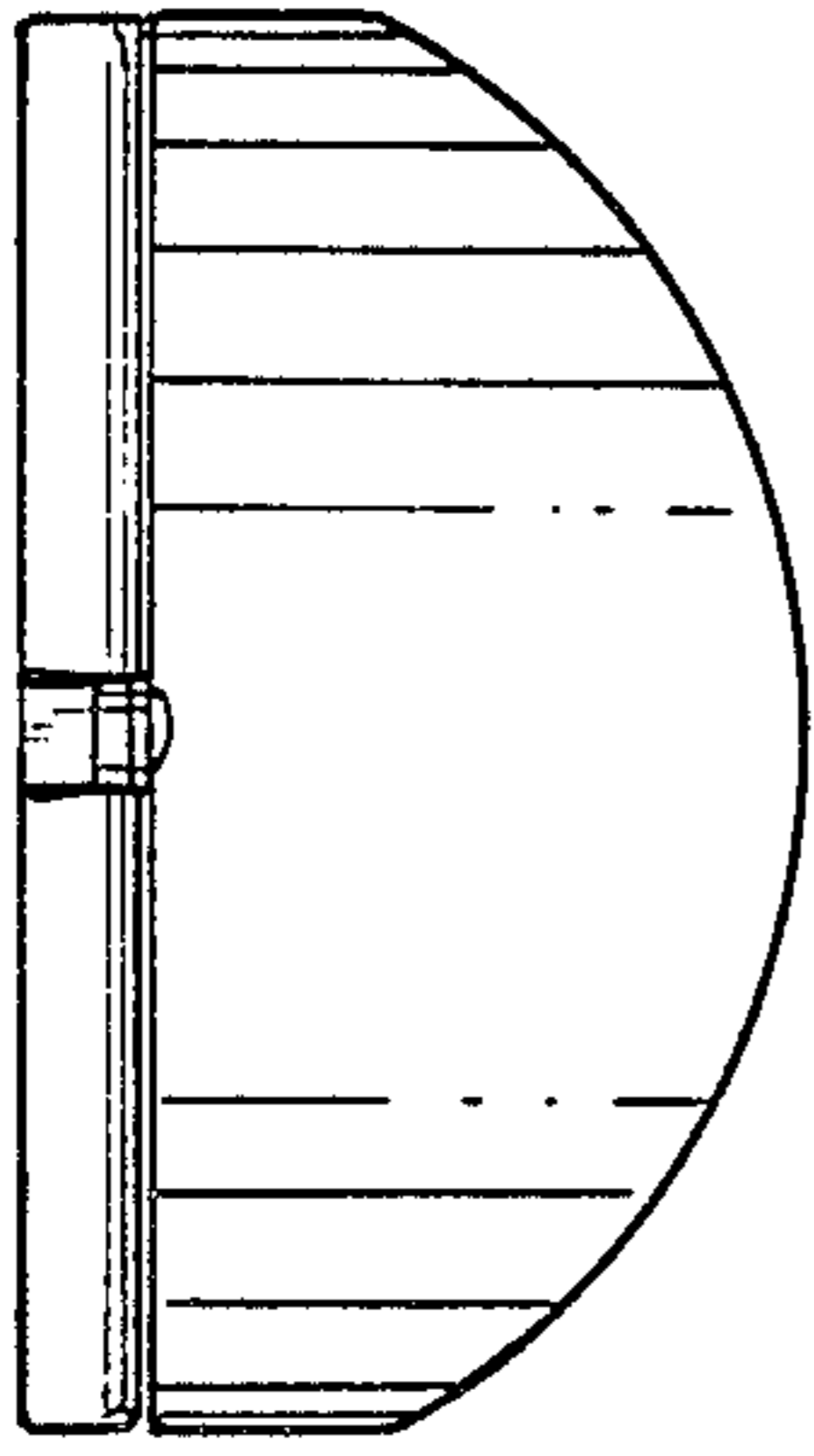

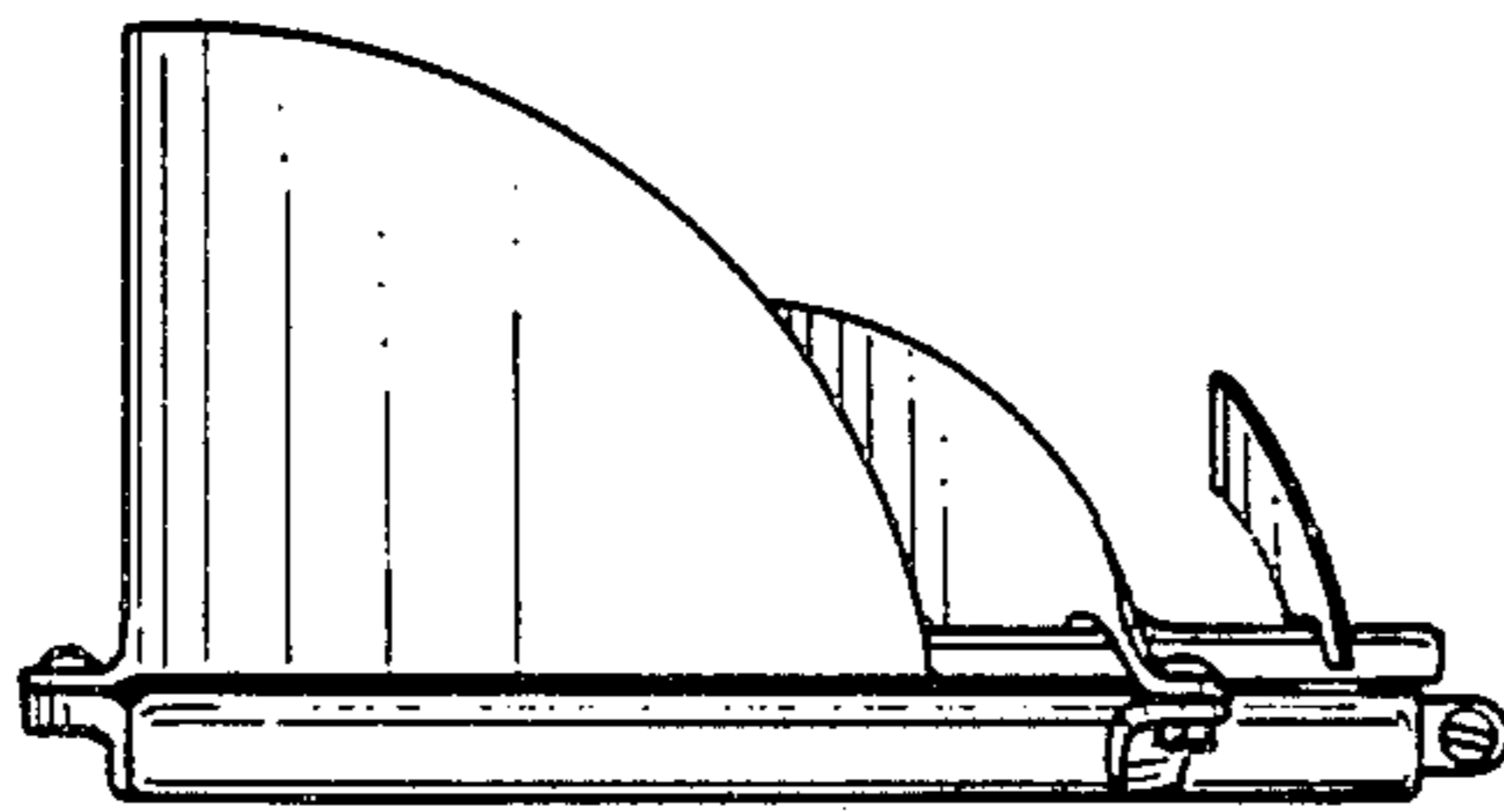

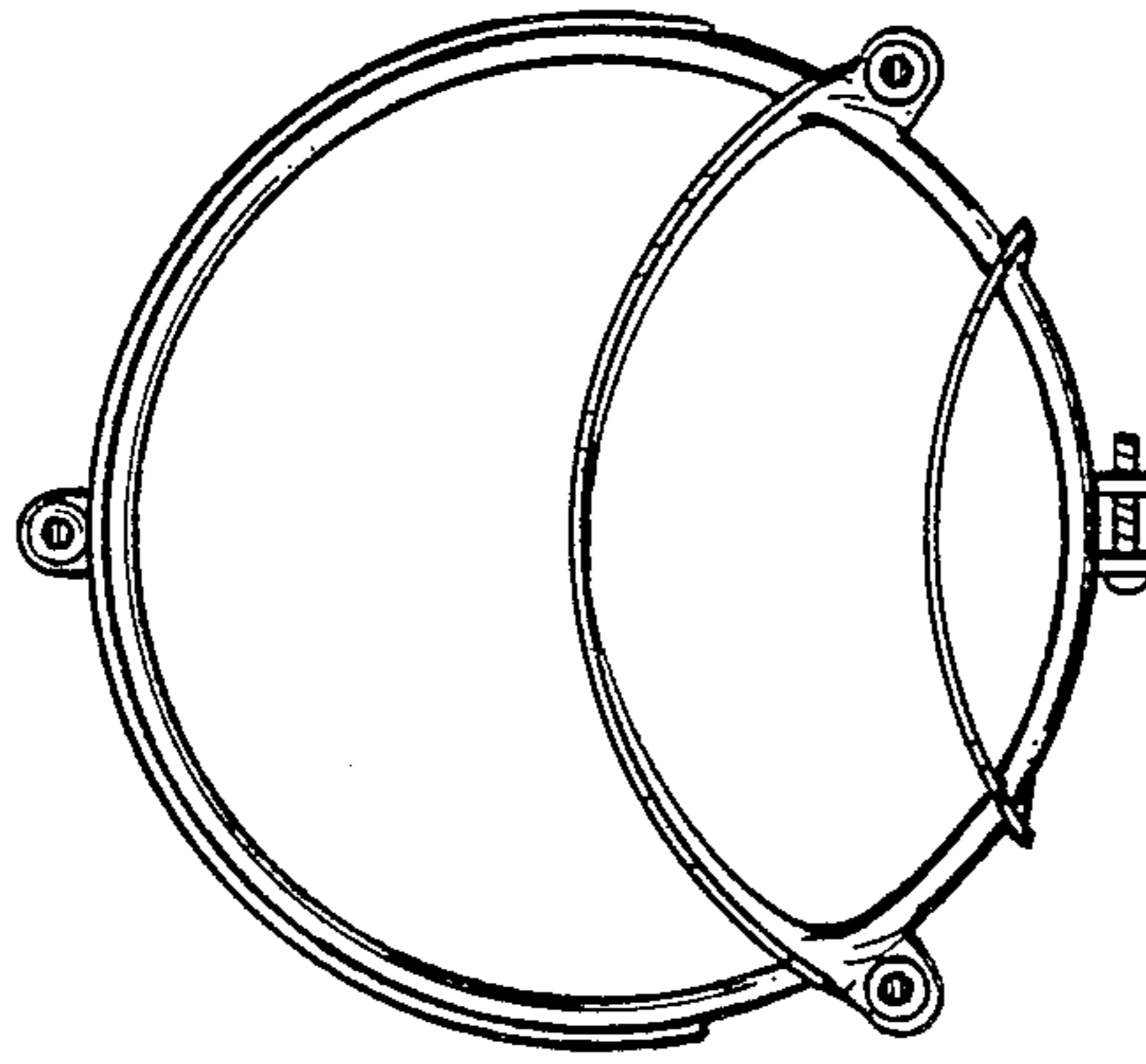

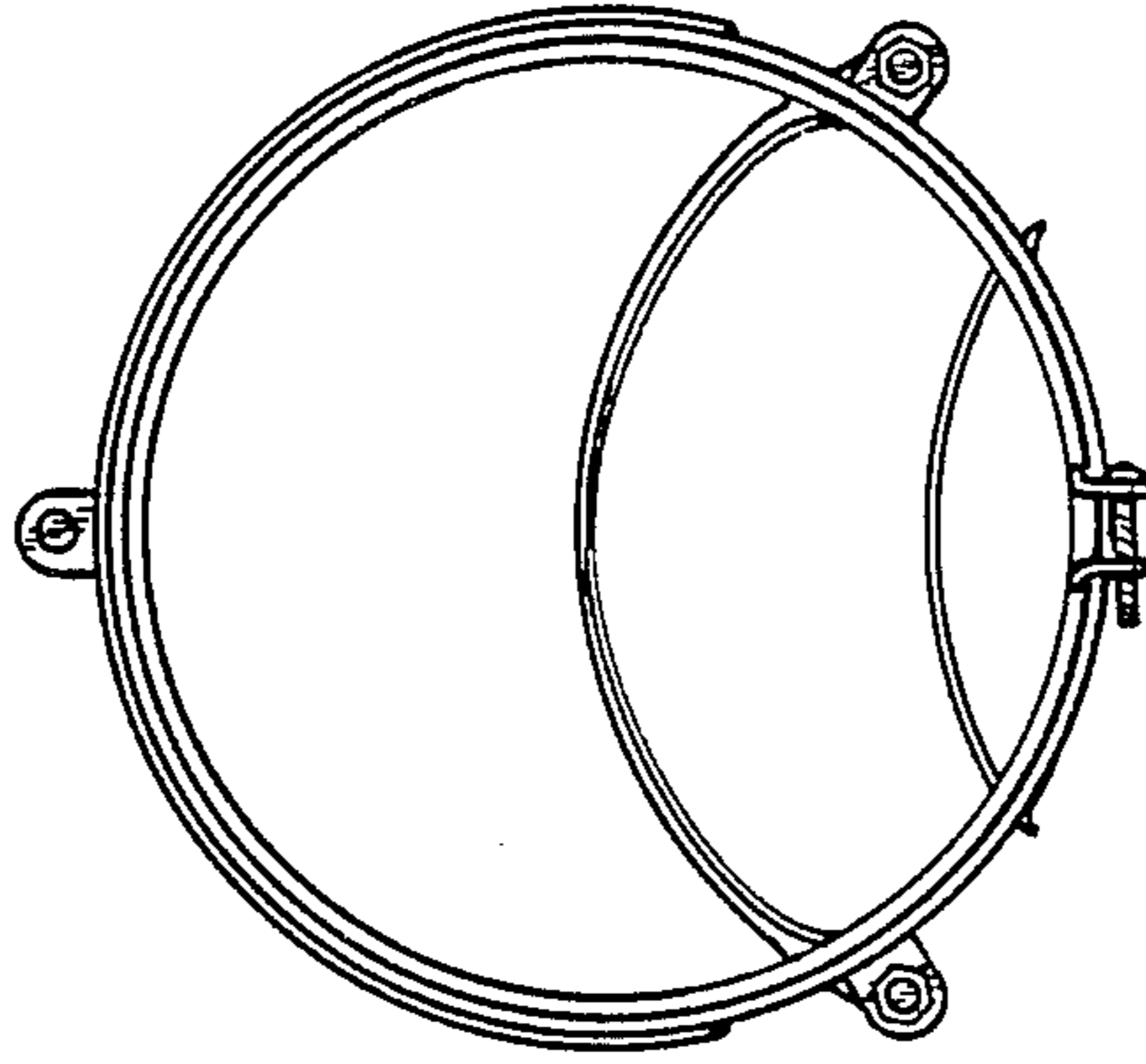

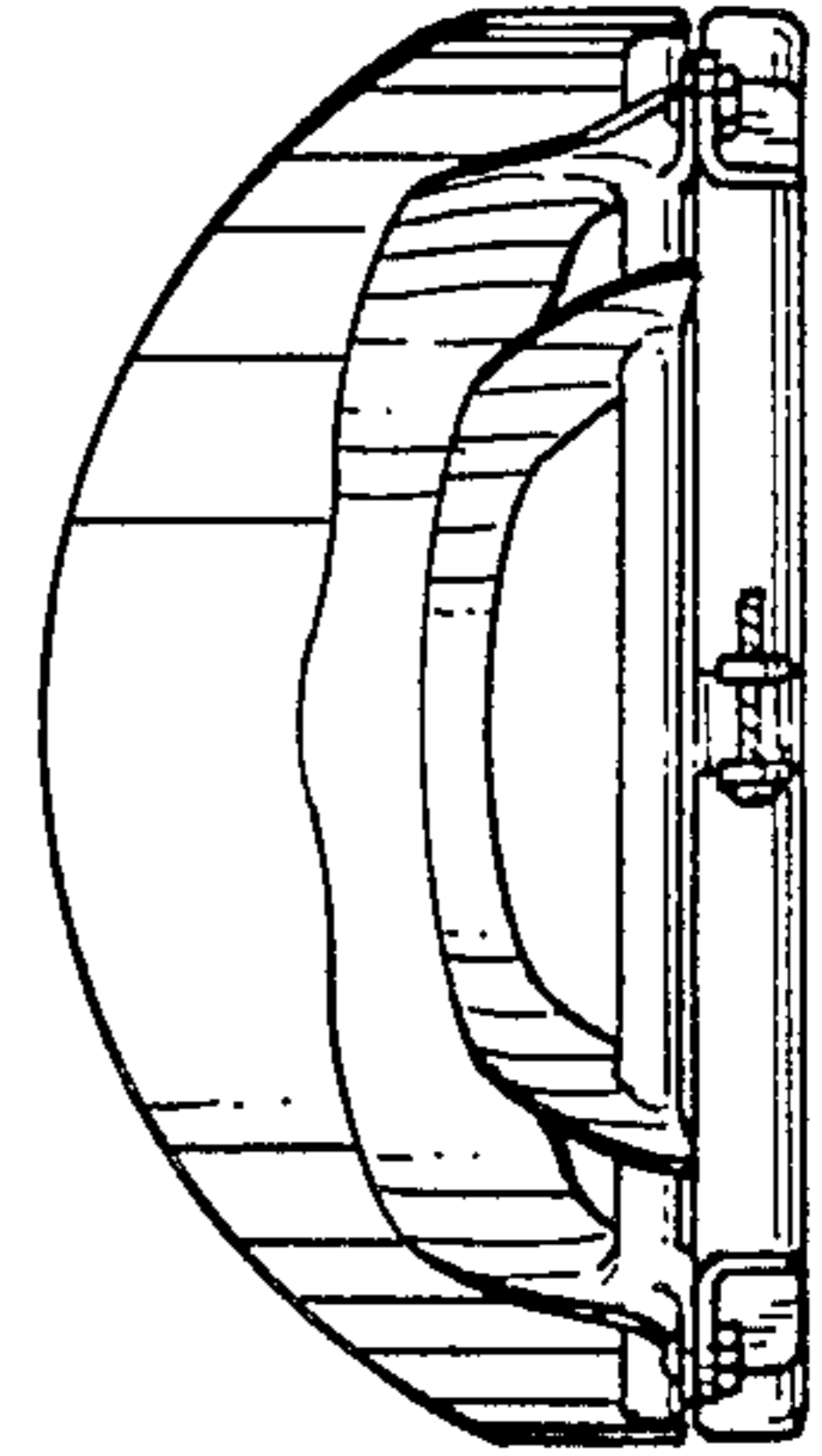
