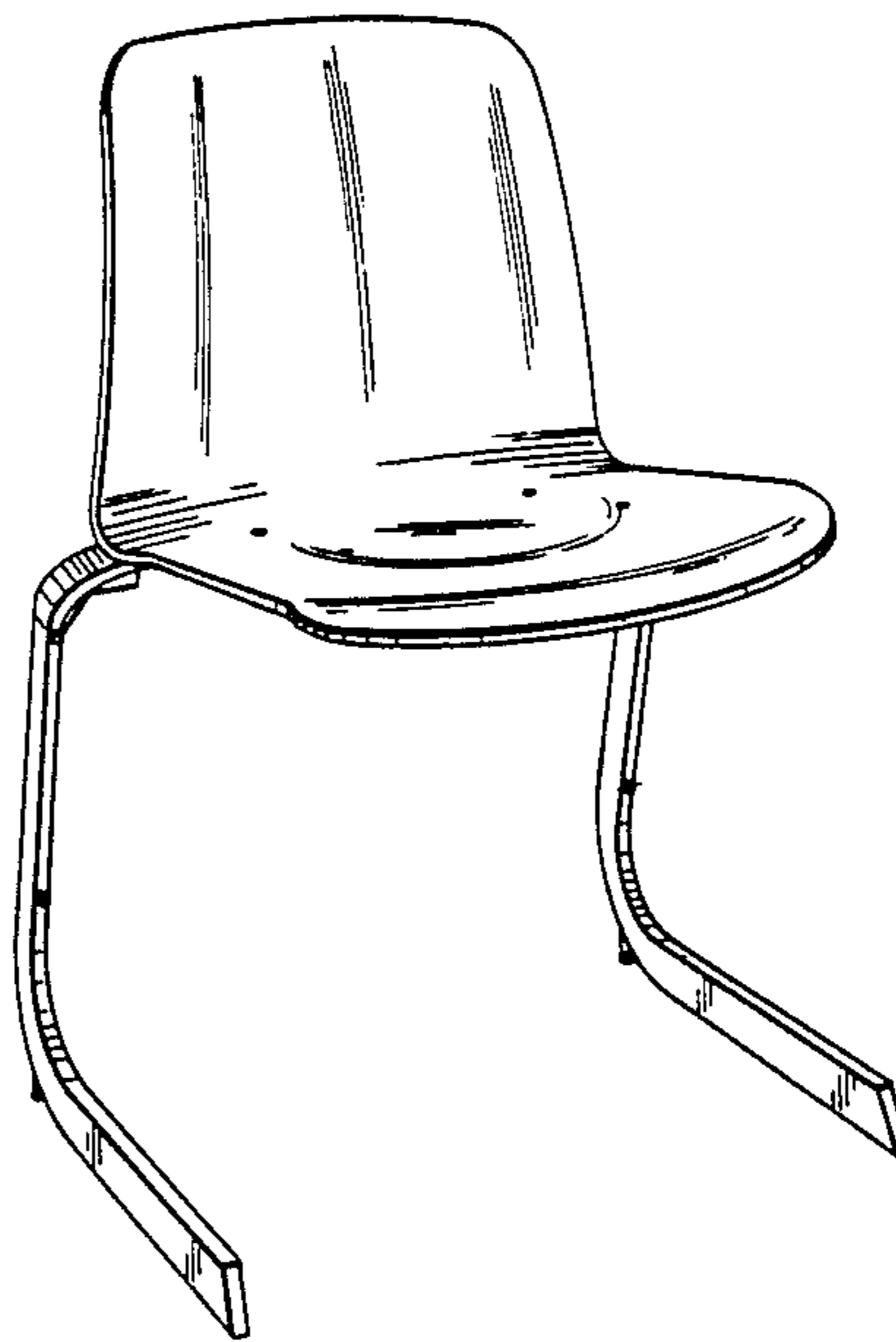

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my design on an enlarged scale;

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



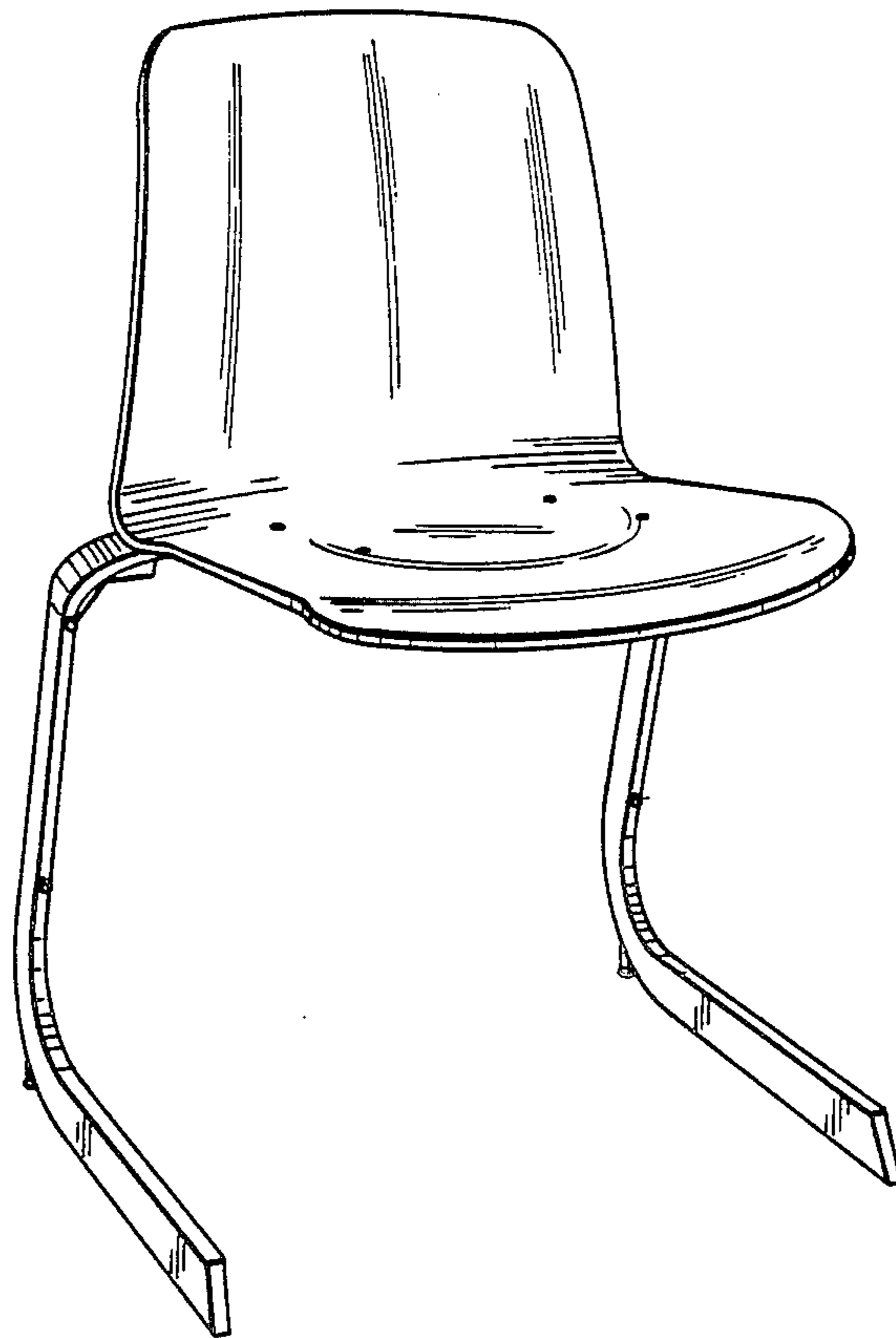

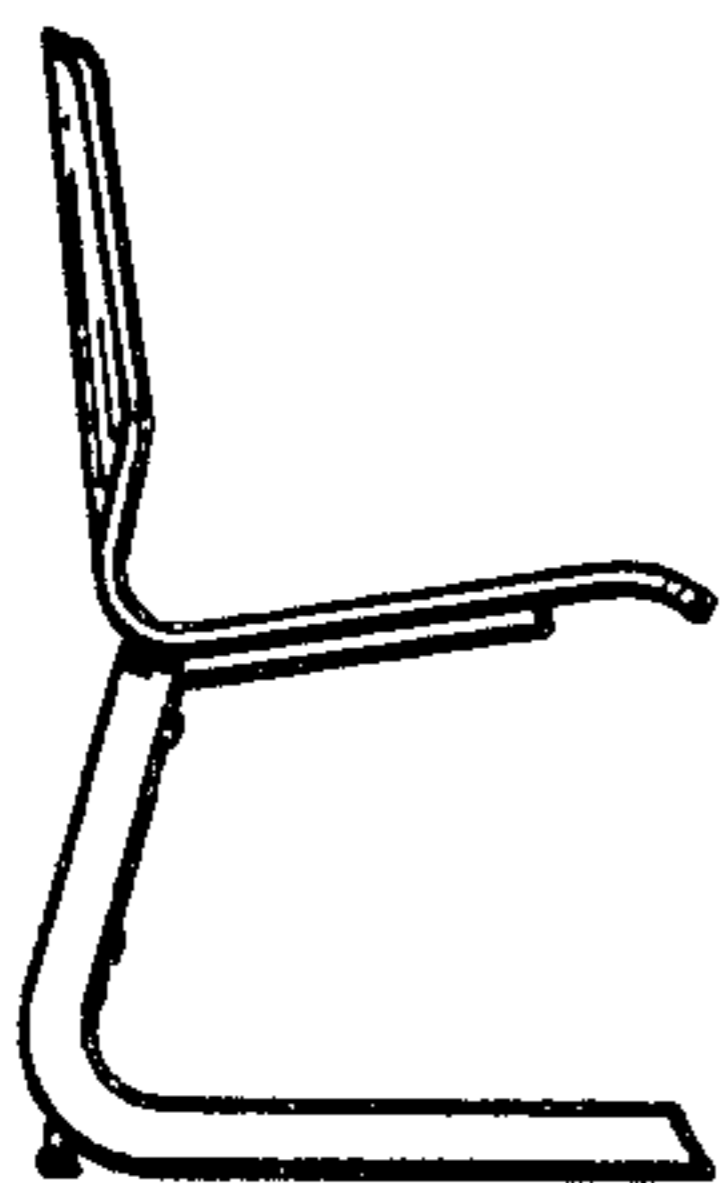

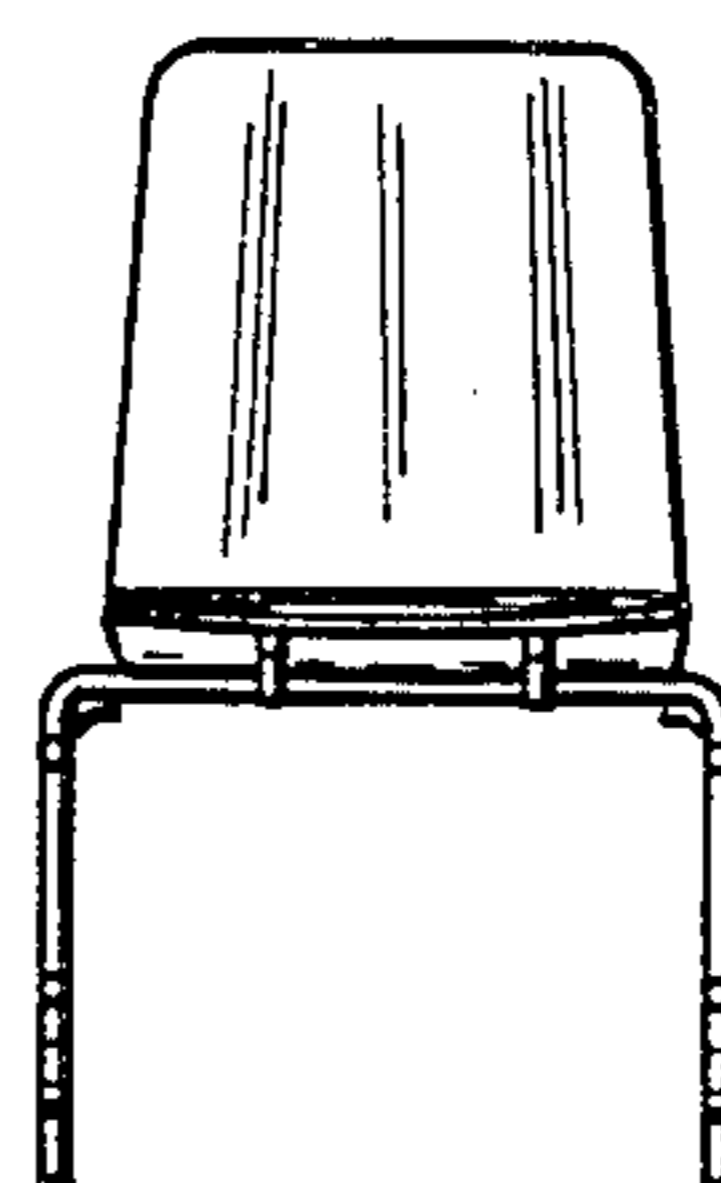

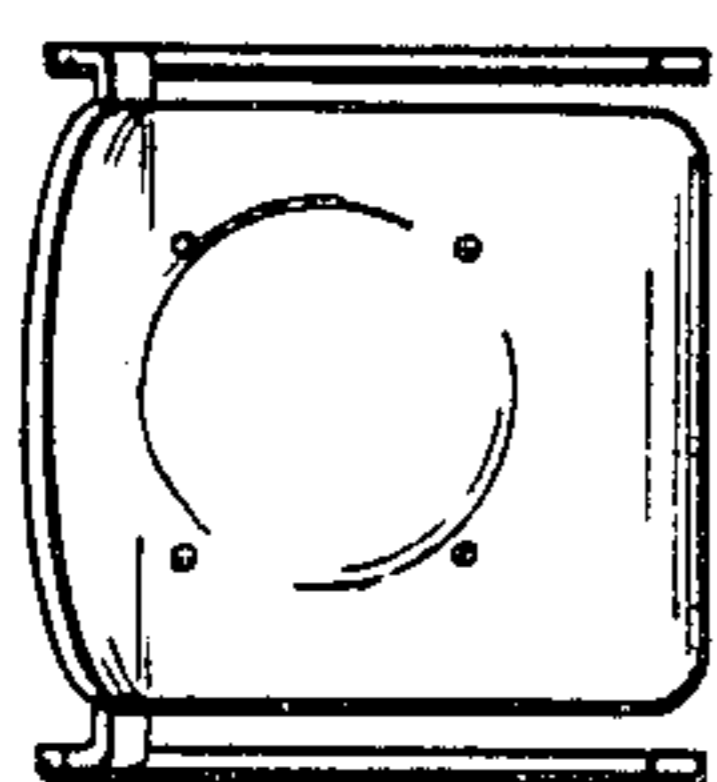

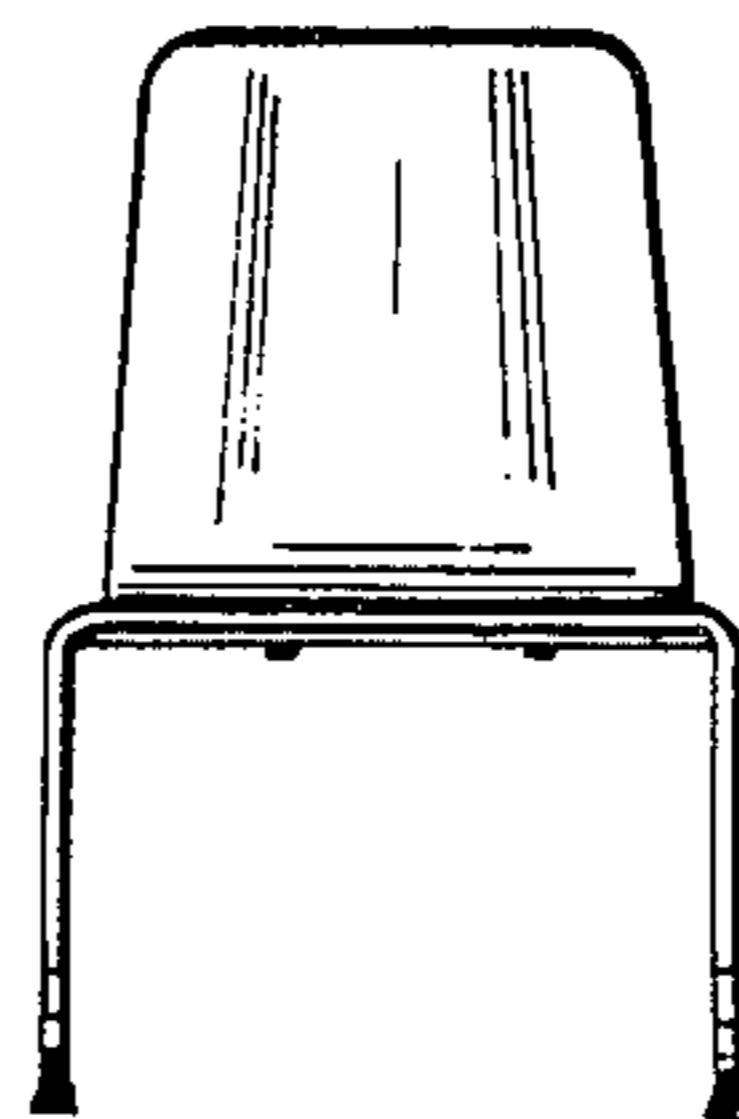
