FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

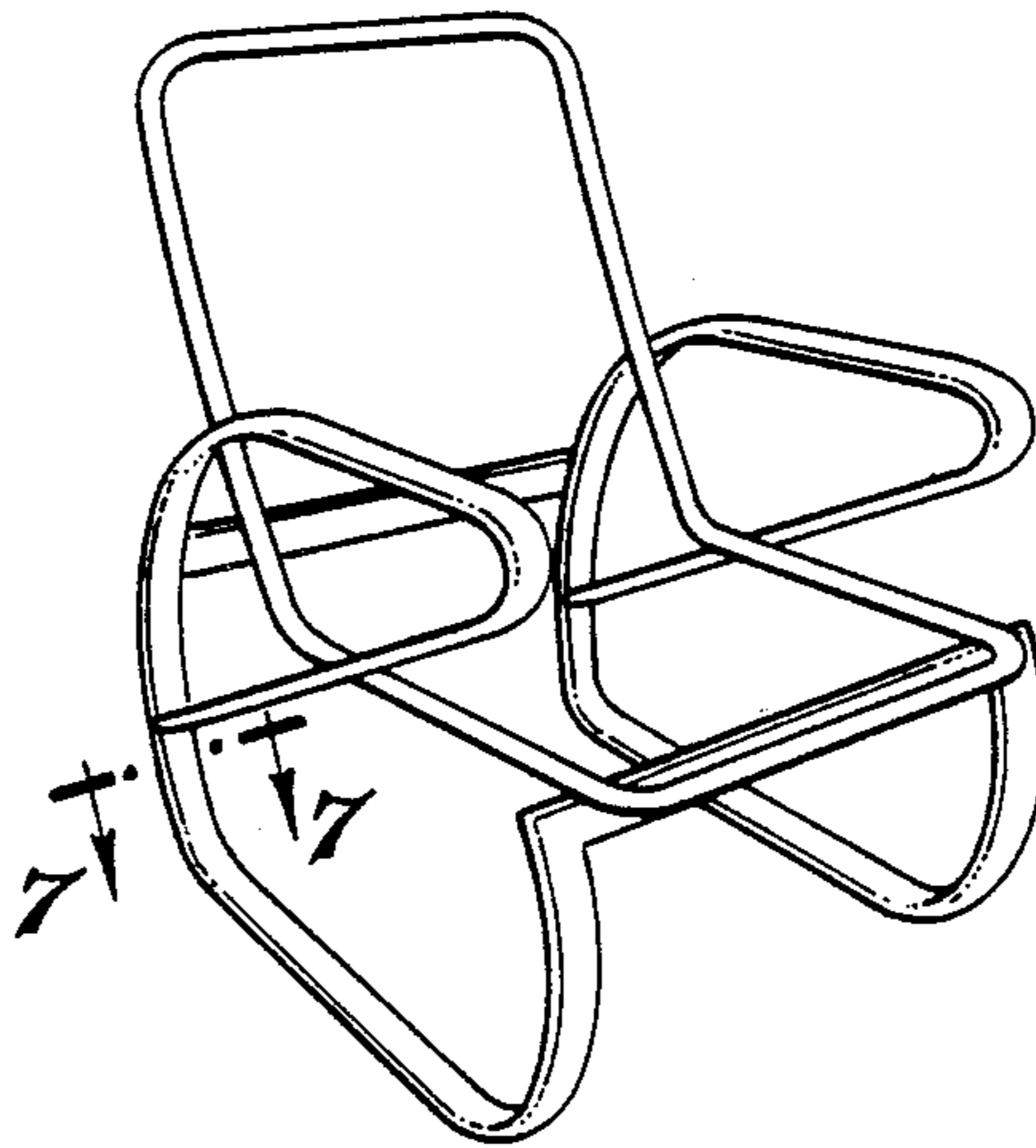
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view thereof taken along the plane 7-7 of FIG. 1 and looking in the direction of the arrows.



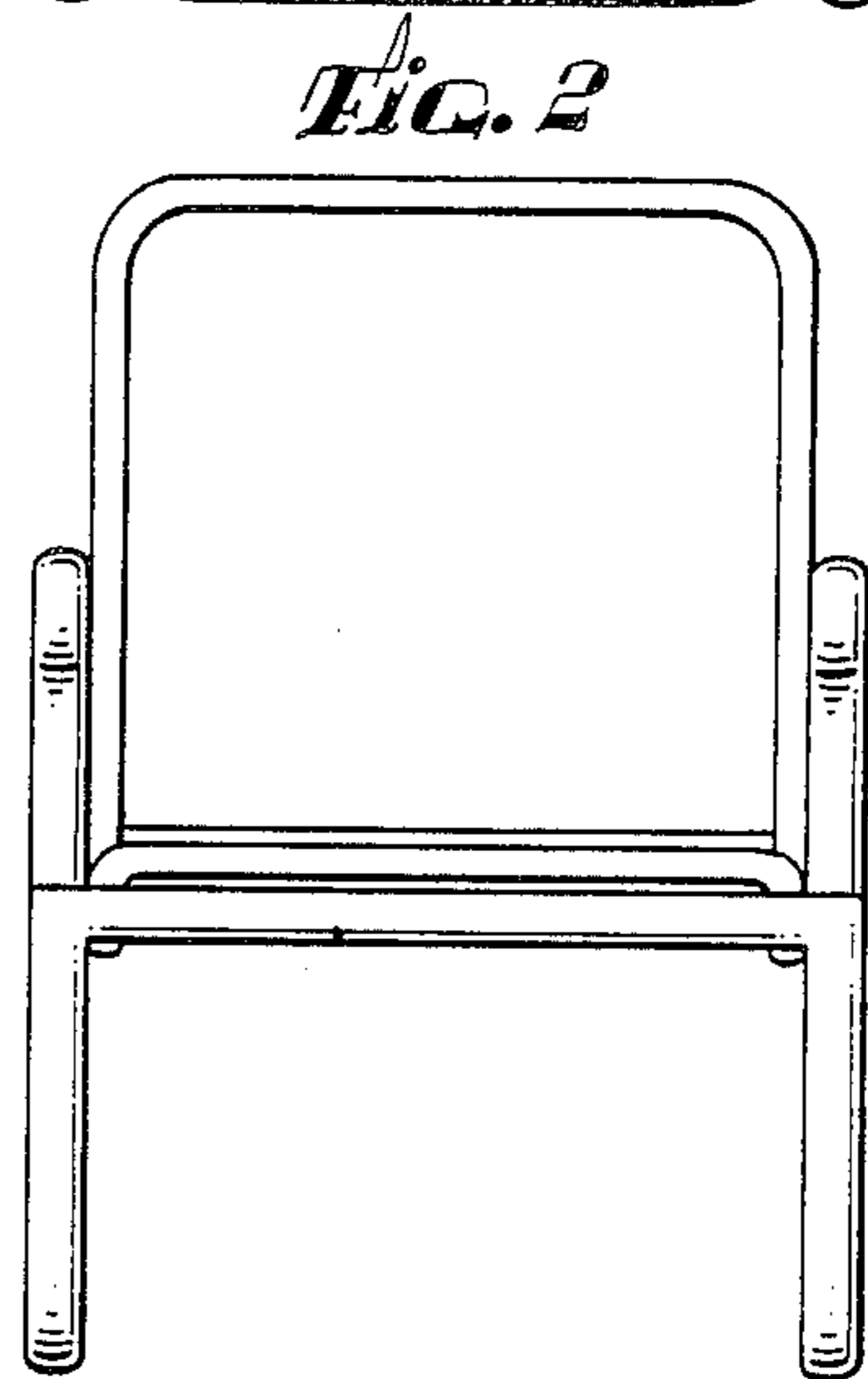
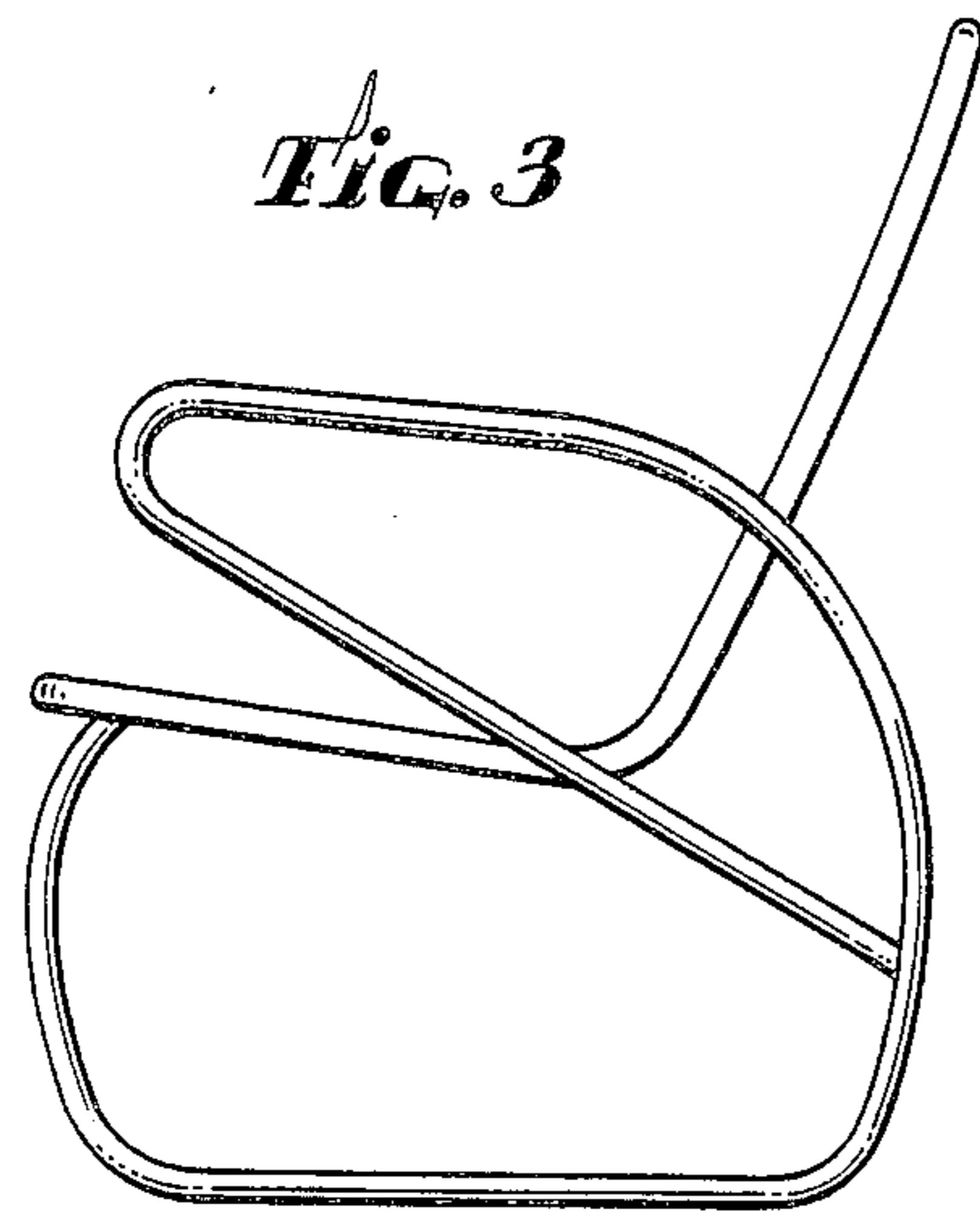
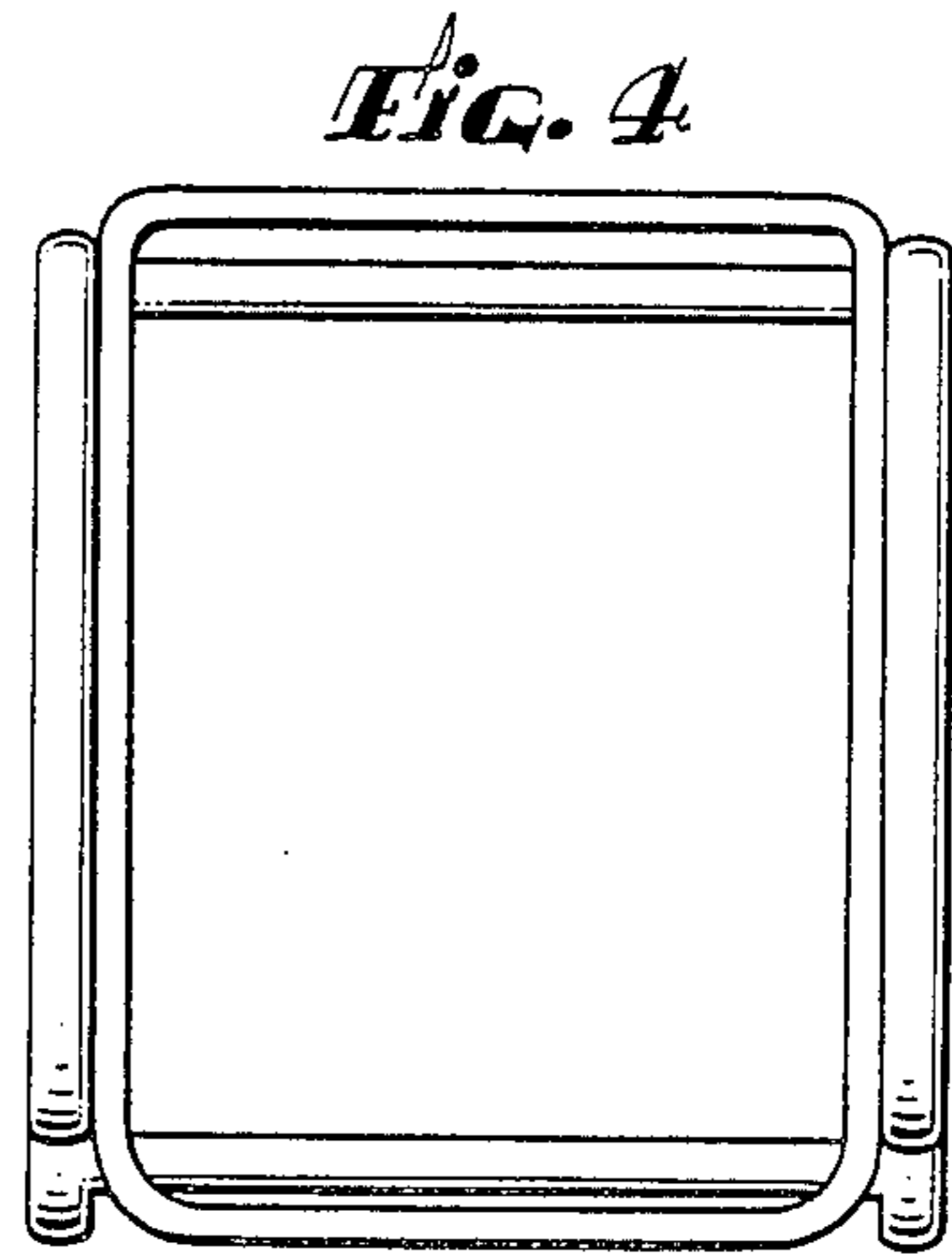
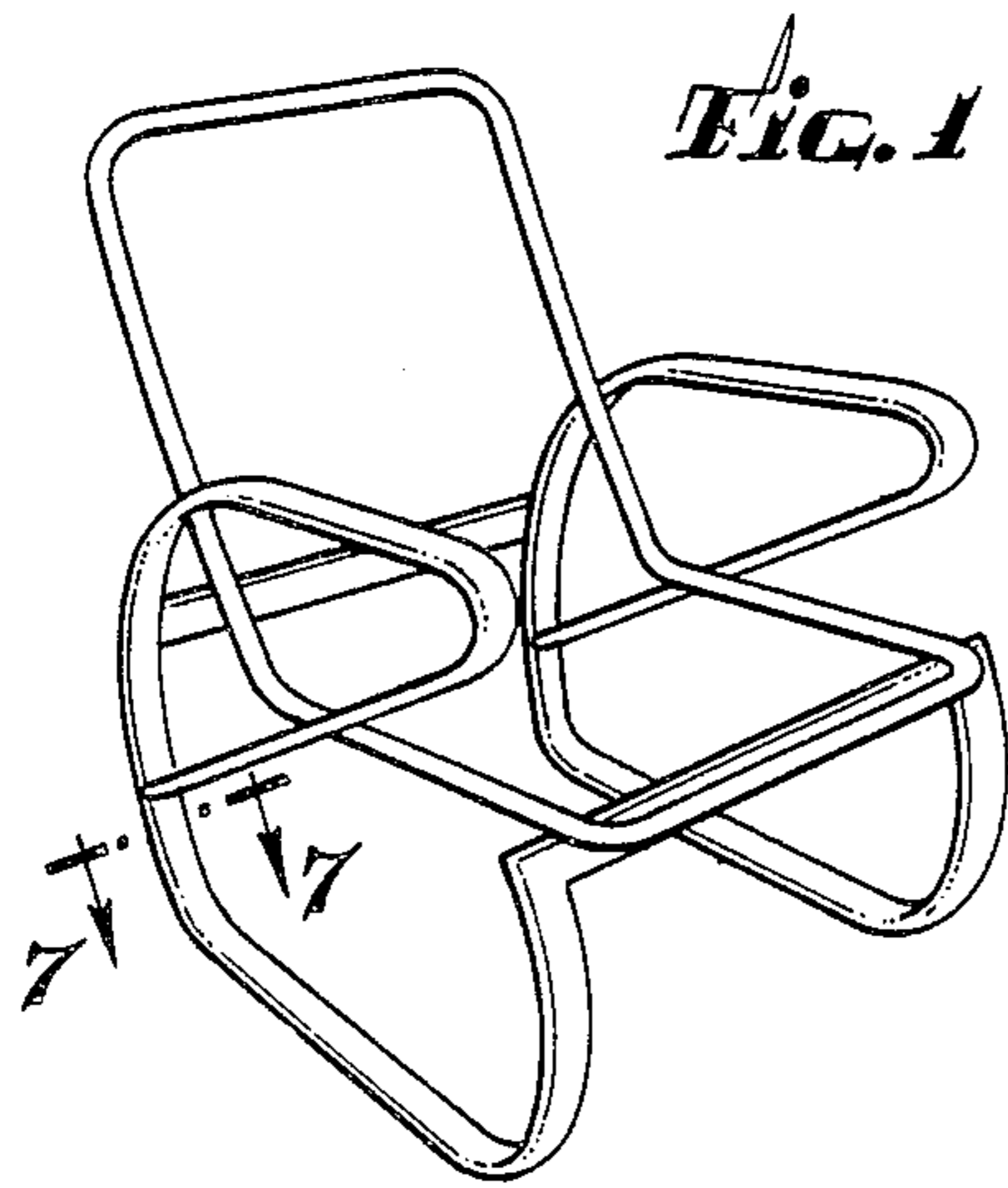

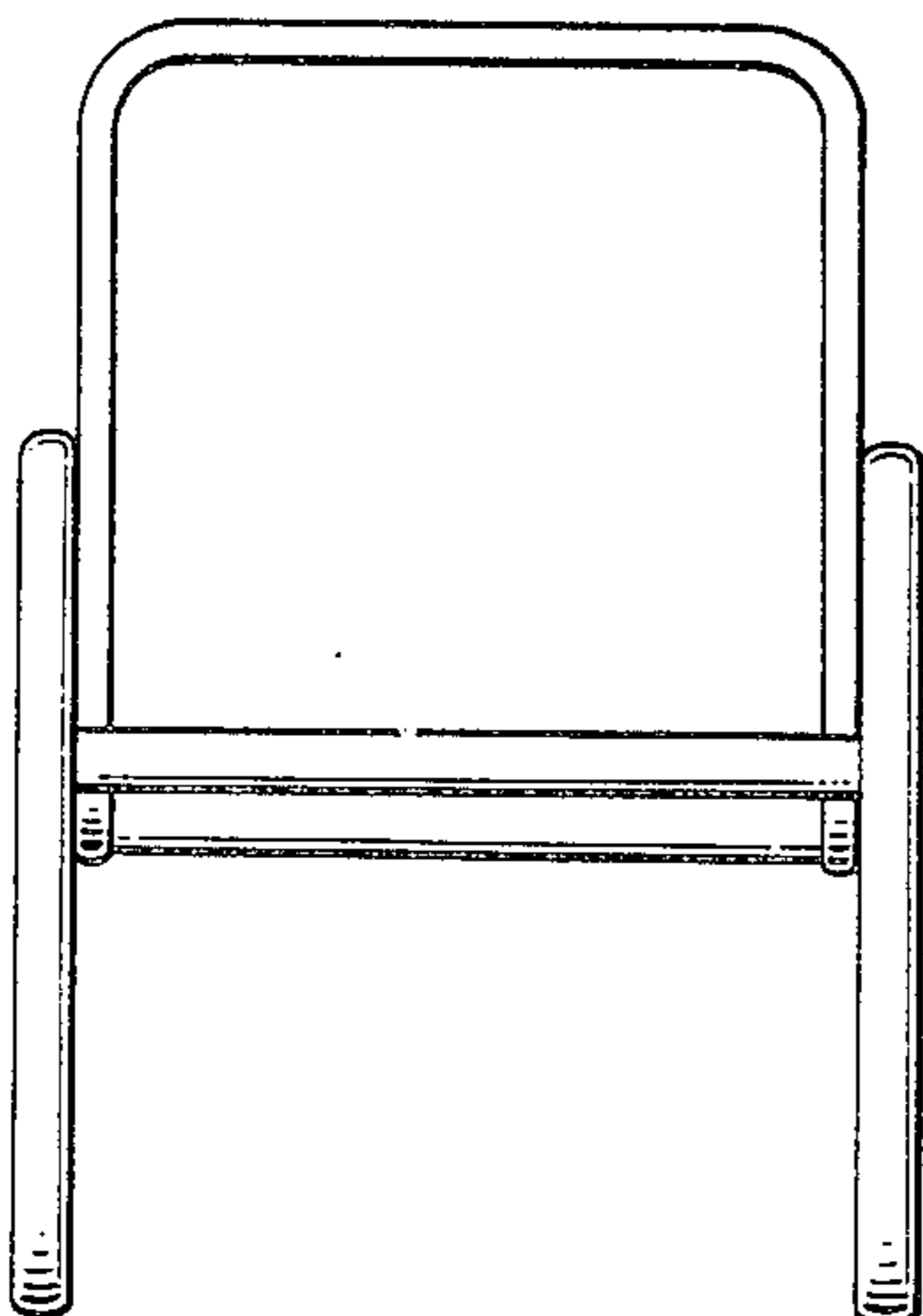

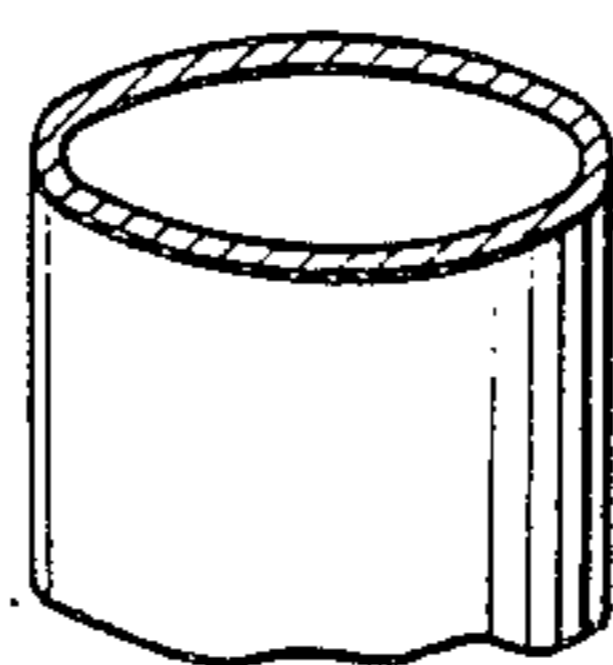
