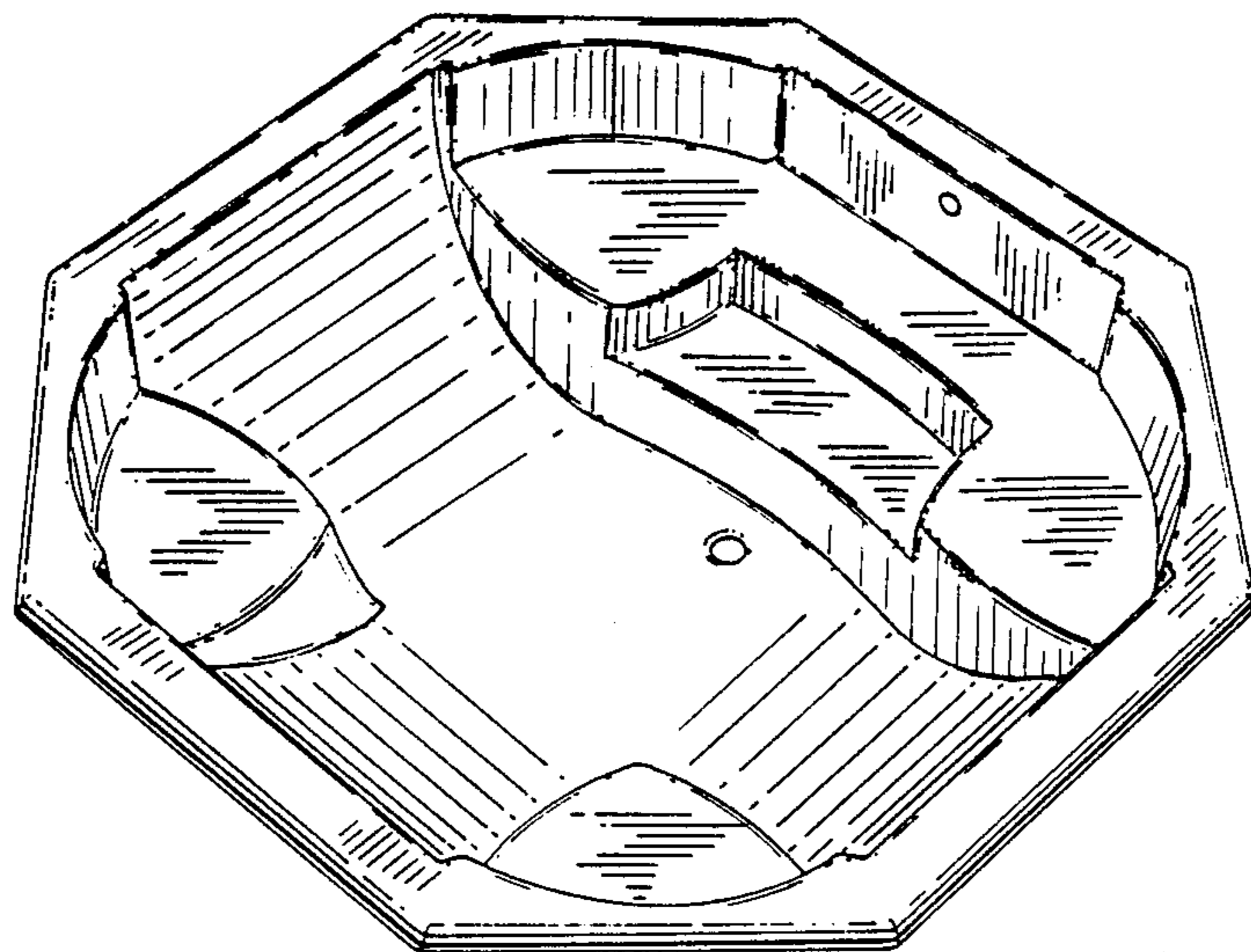

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bathtub showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line III—III of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken on line IV—IV of FIG. 2.



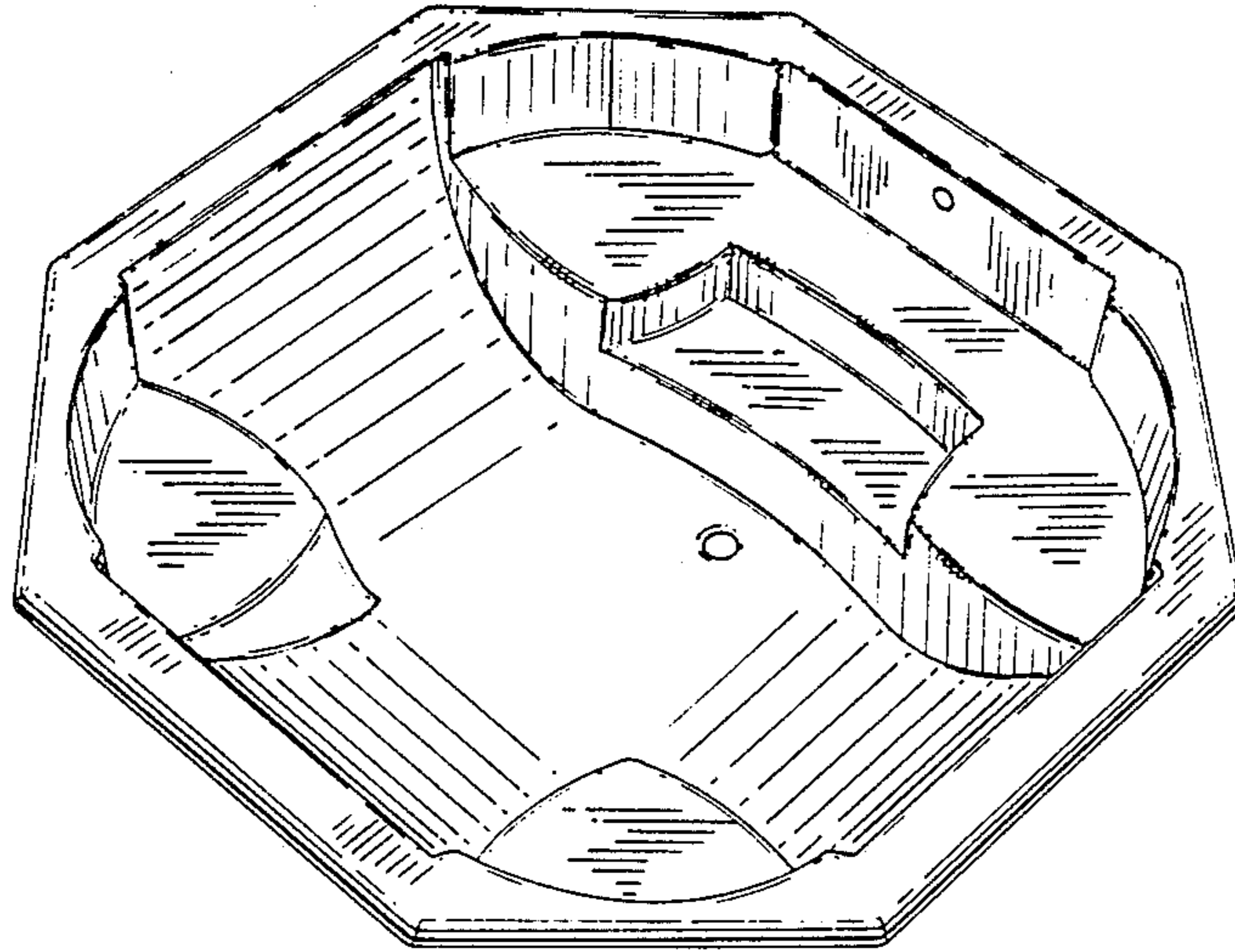

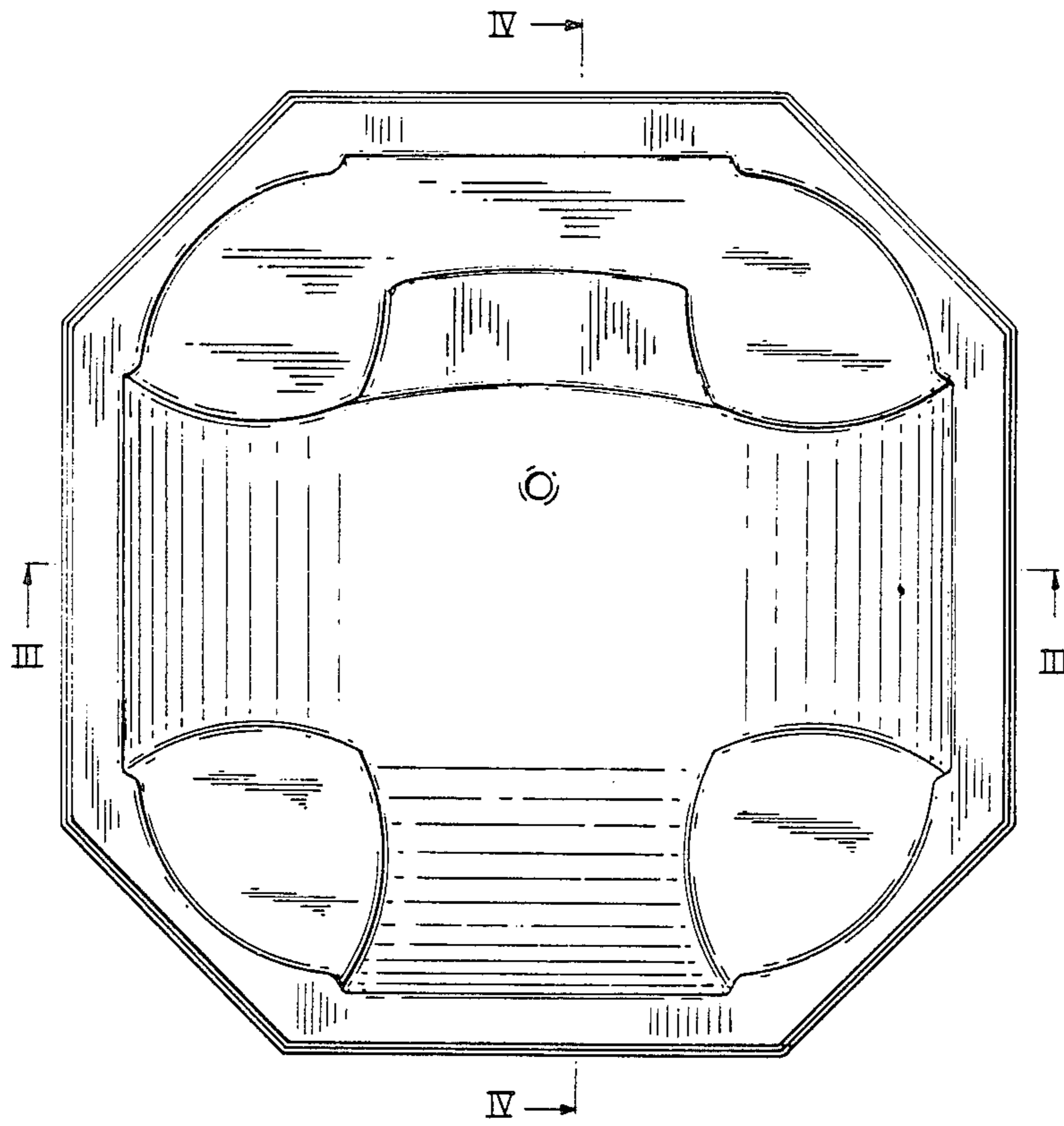

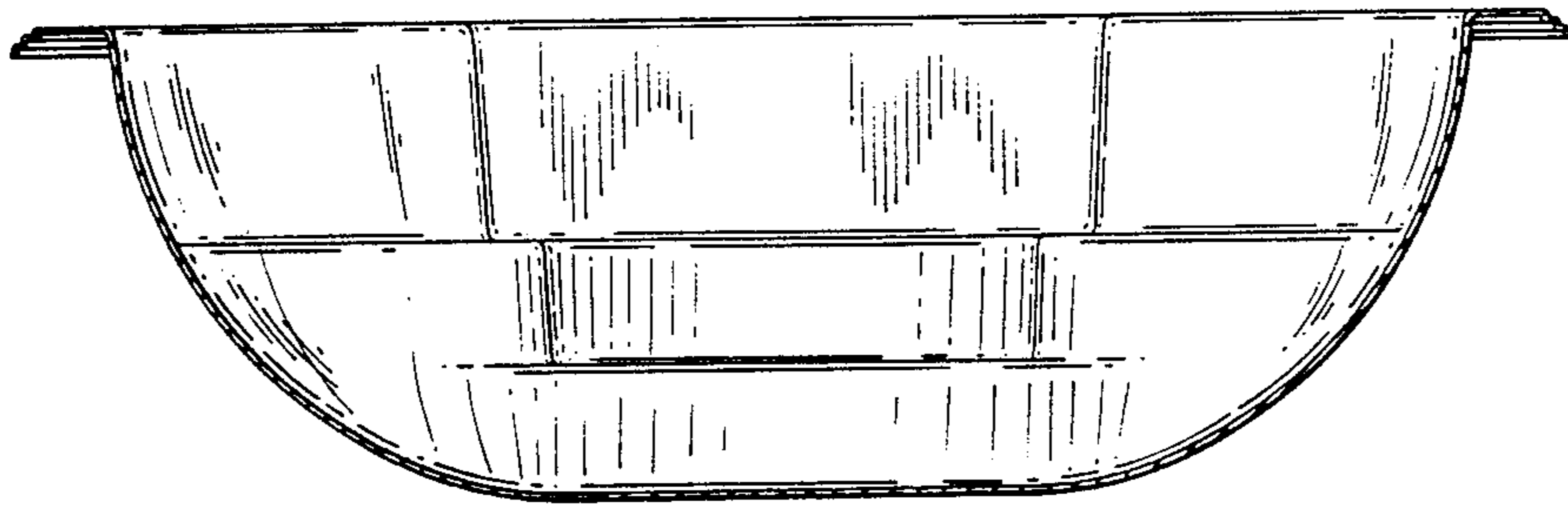

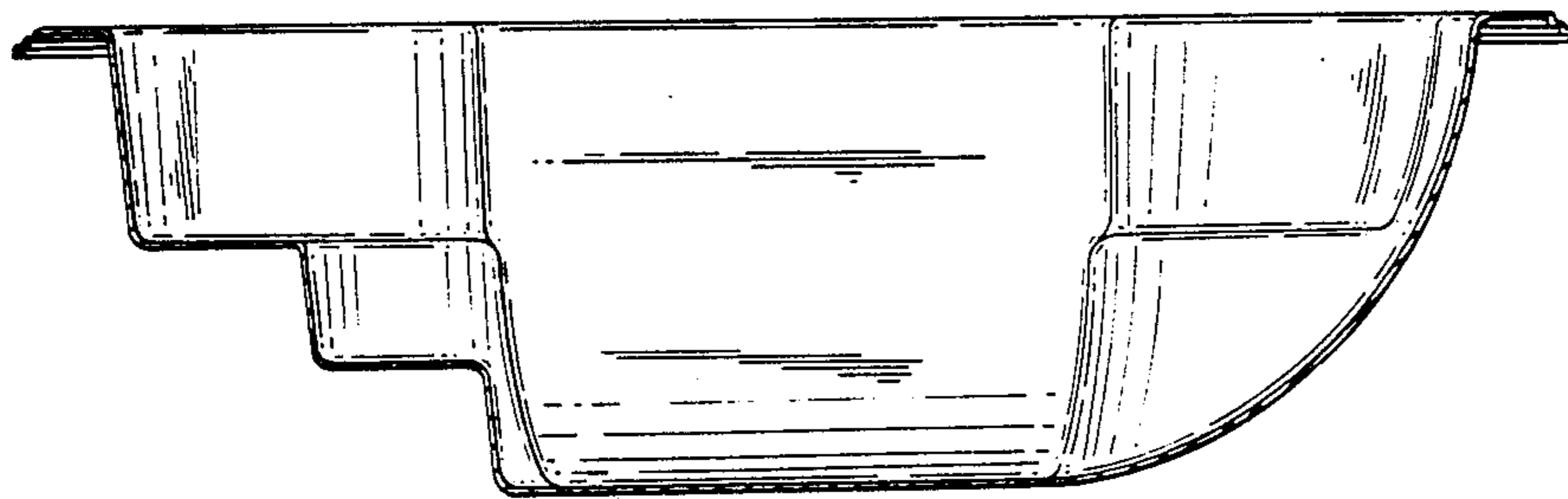
