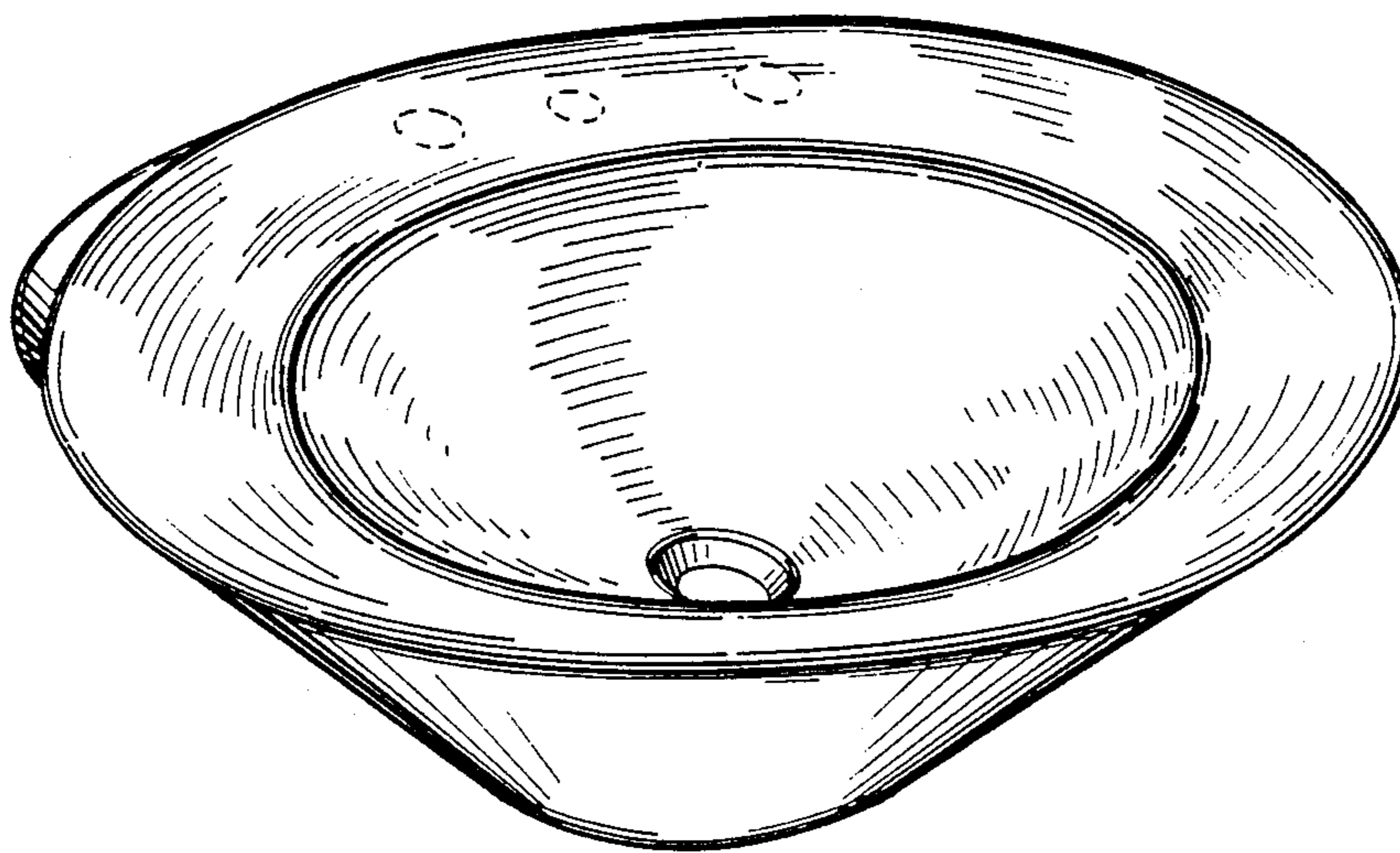

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lavatory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a lavatory showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the mirror image of the right side;
 FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of a modified form of the lavatory shown in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of FIG. 9, the rear being the same as the front shown.
 The broken line representations of fitting holes in FIGS. 1, 3, 8 and 9 are for purposes of illustration only.



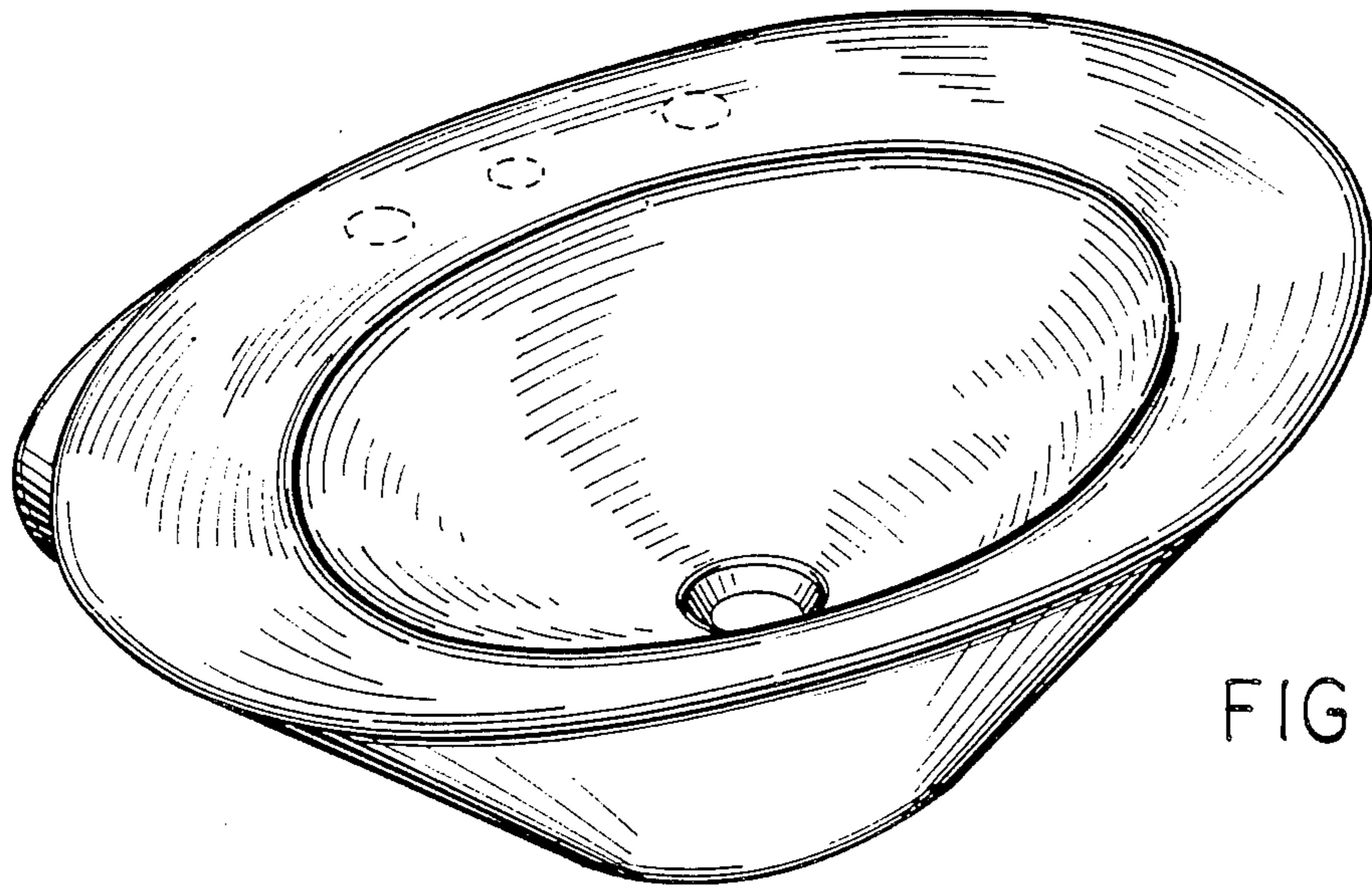

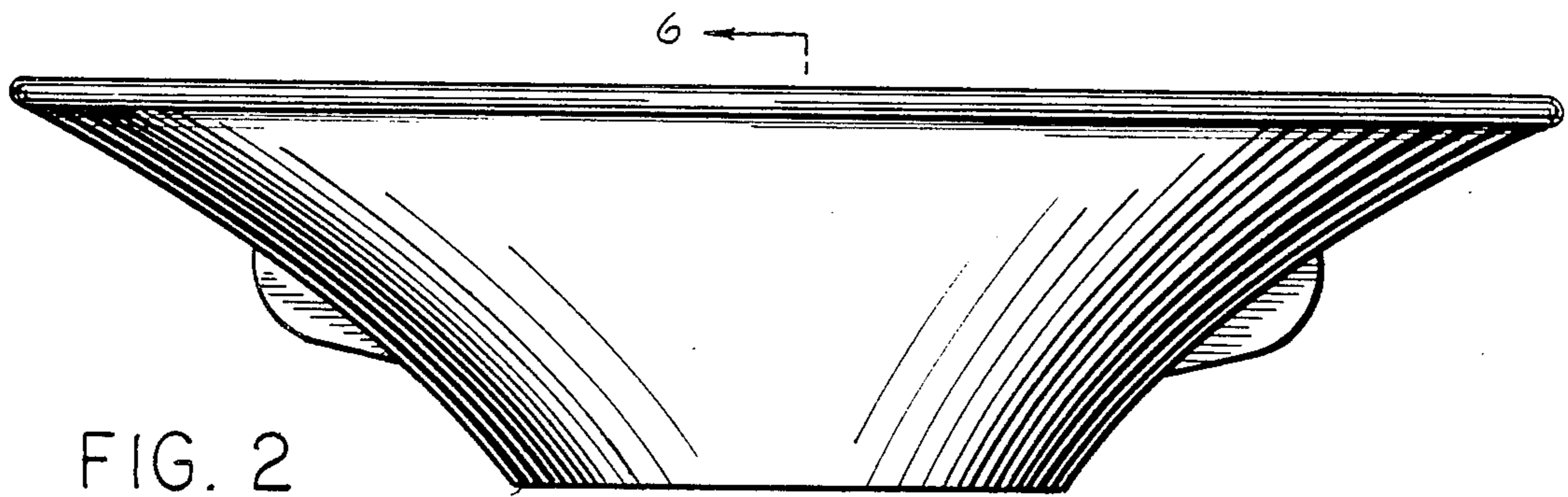

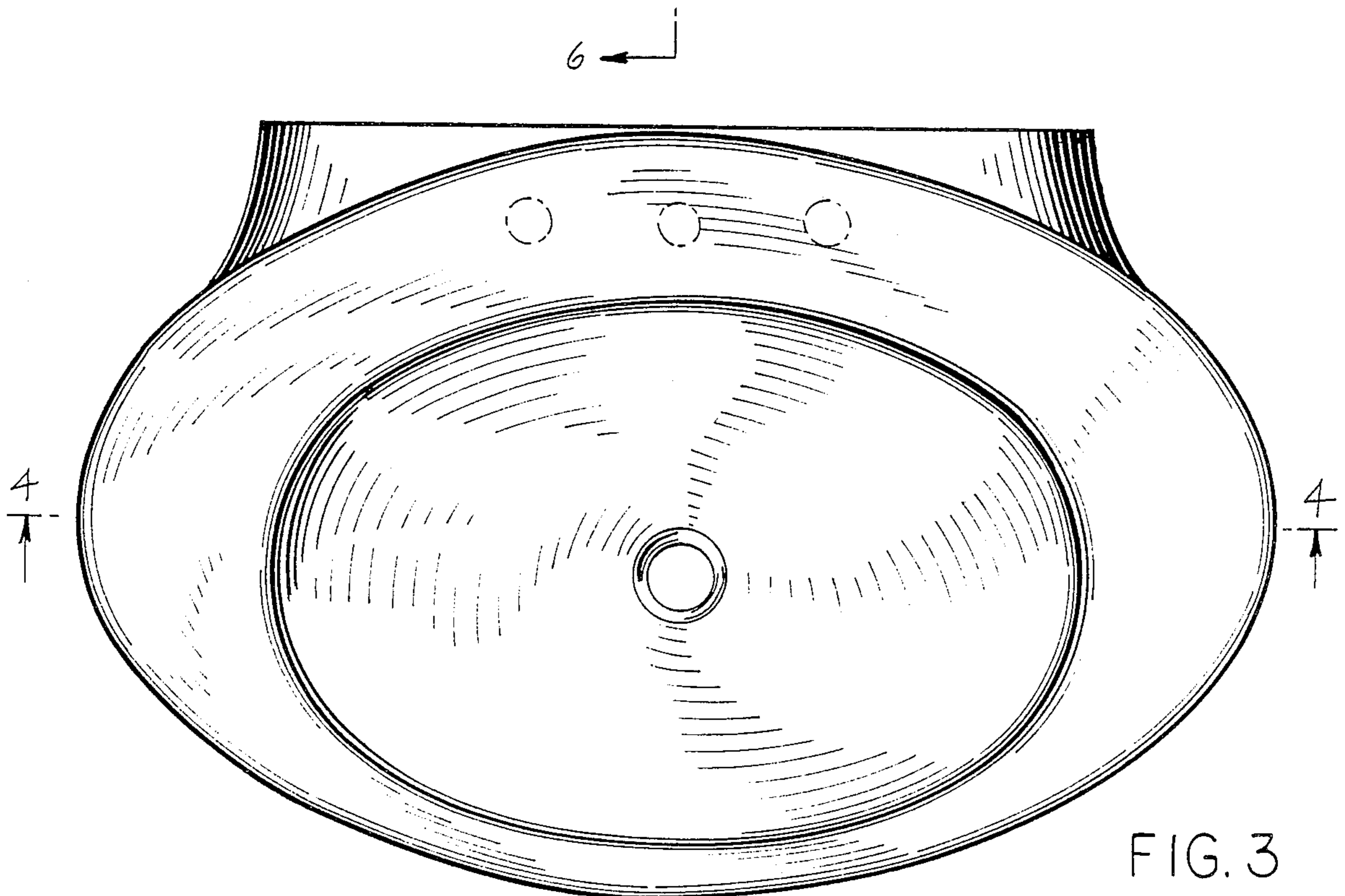

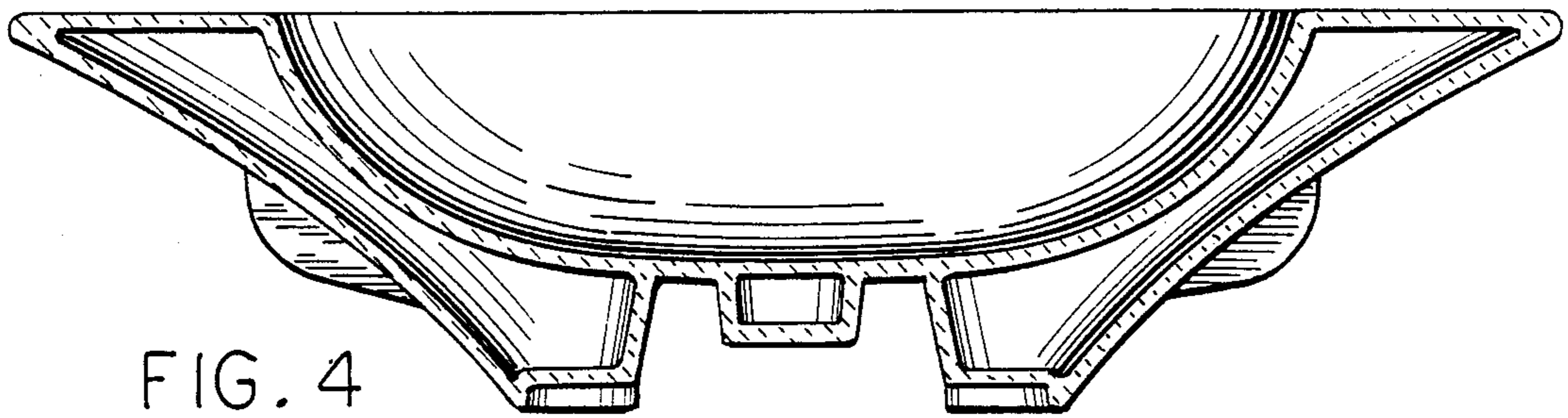

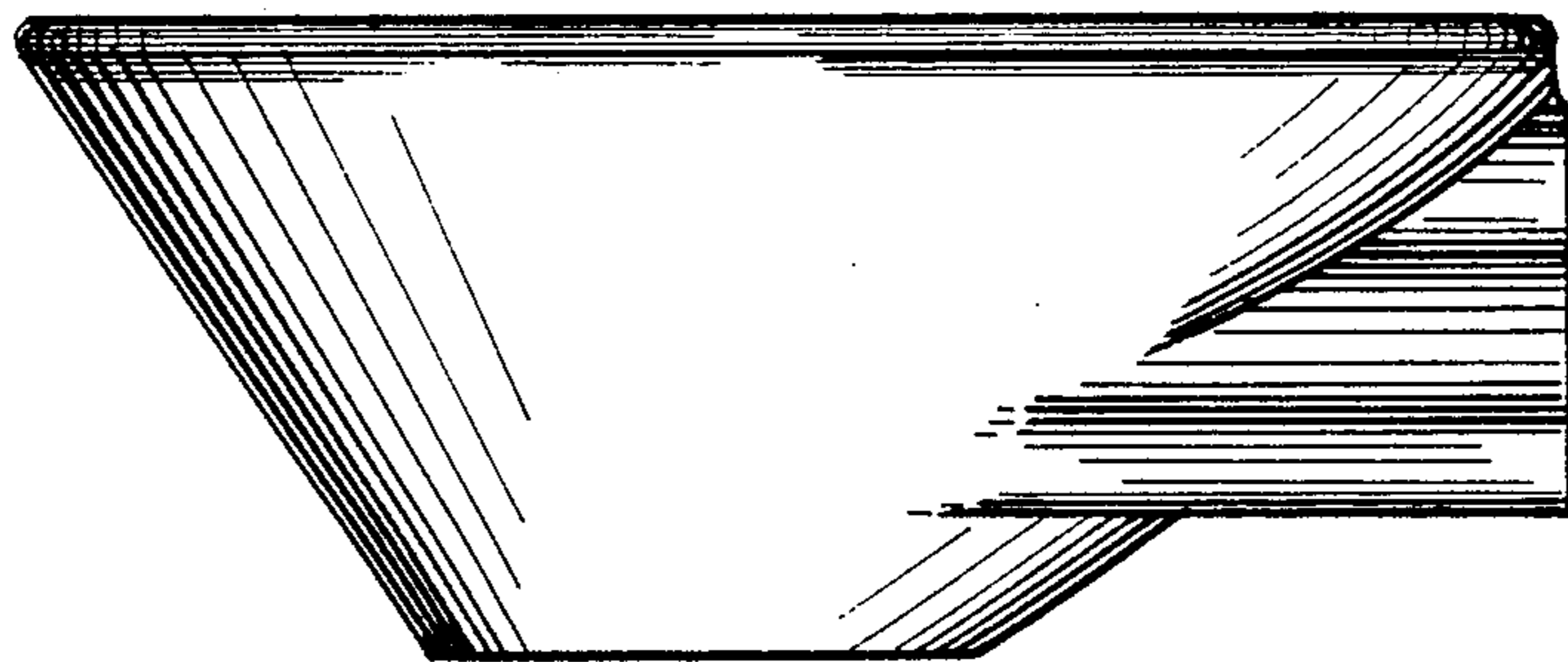

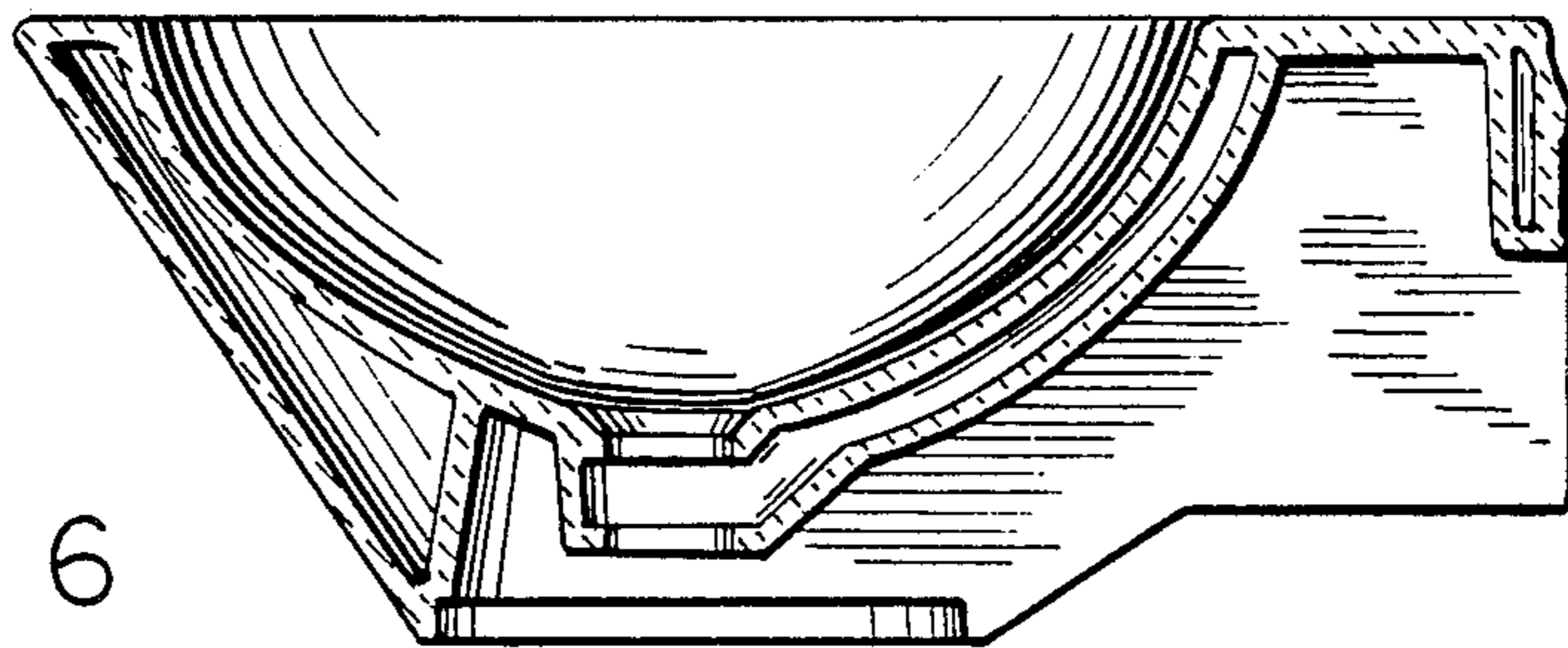

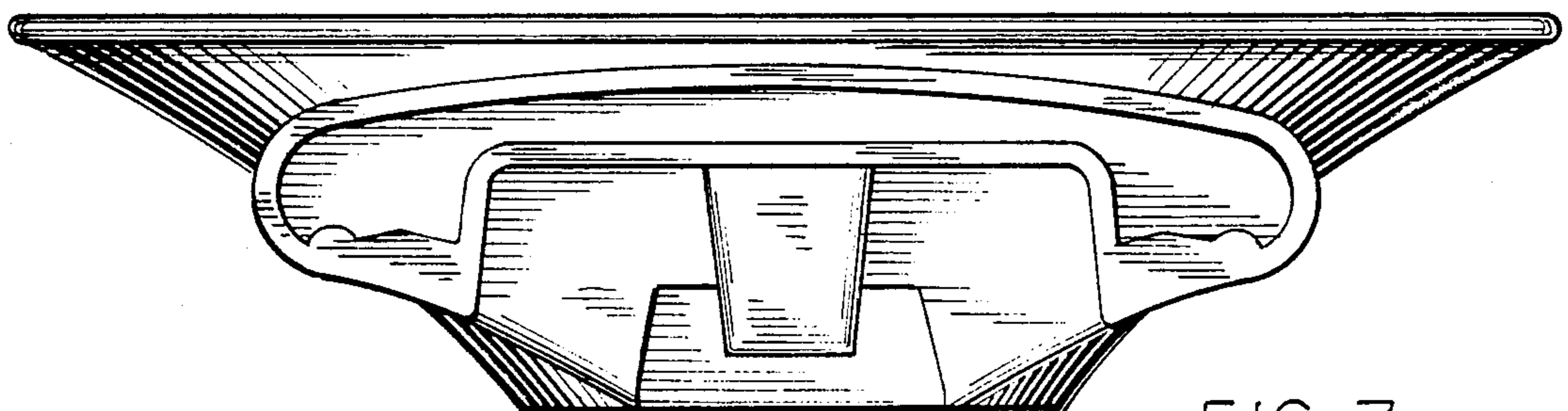
