[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an extension lever attachment for a motor vehicle door handle, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an extension lever attachment for a motor vehicle door handle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is an opposite side elevational view; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
