The ornamental design for an electronic music generator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electronic music generator showing my new design;

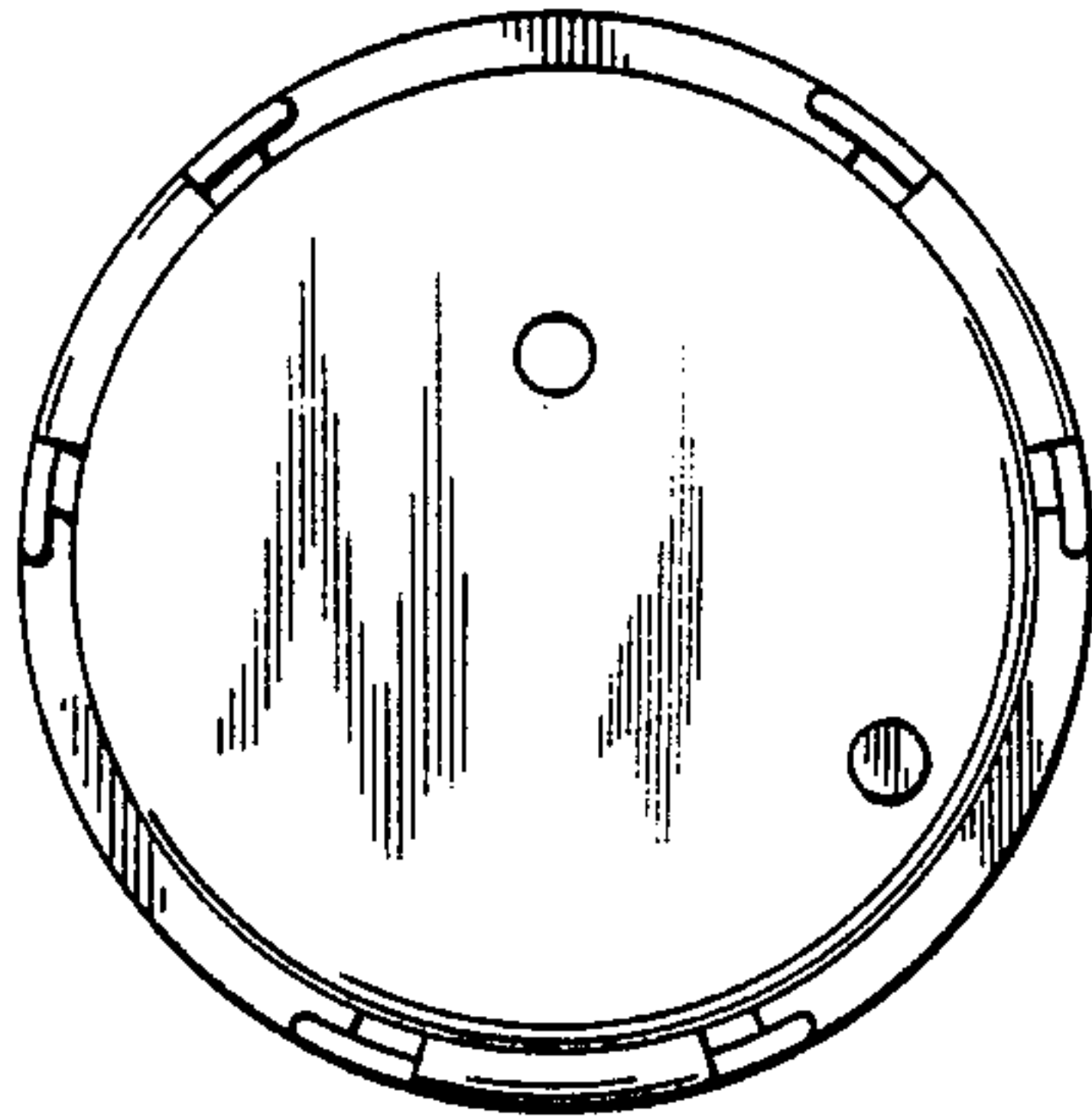


FIG. 2 FIG. 3

 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a top, front and left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is an exploded front elevational view thereof, shown with the front and rear components disassembled; and
 FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof, shown as applied to the bottom of a mug.
 The broken line showing of the mug in FIG. 9 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

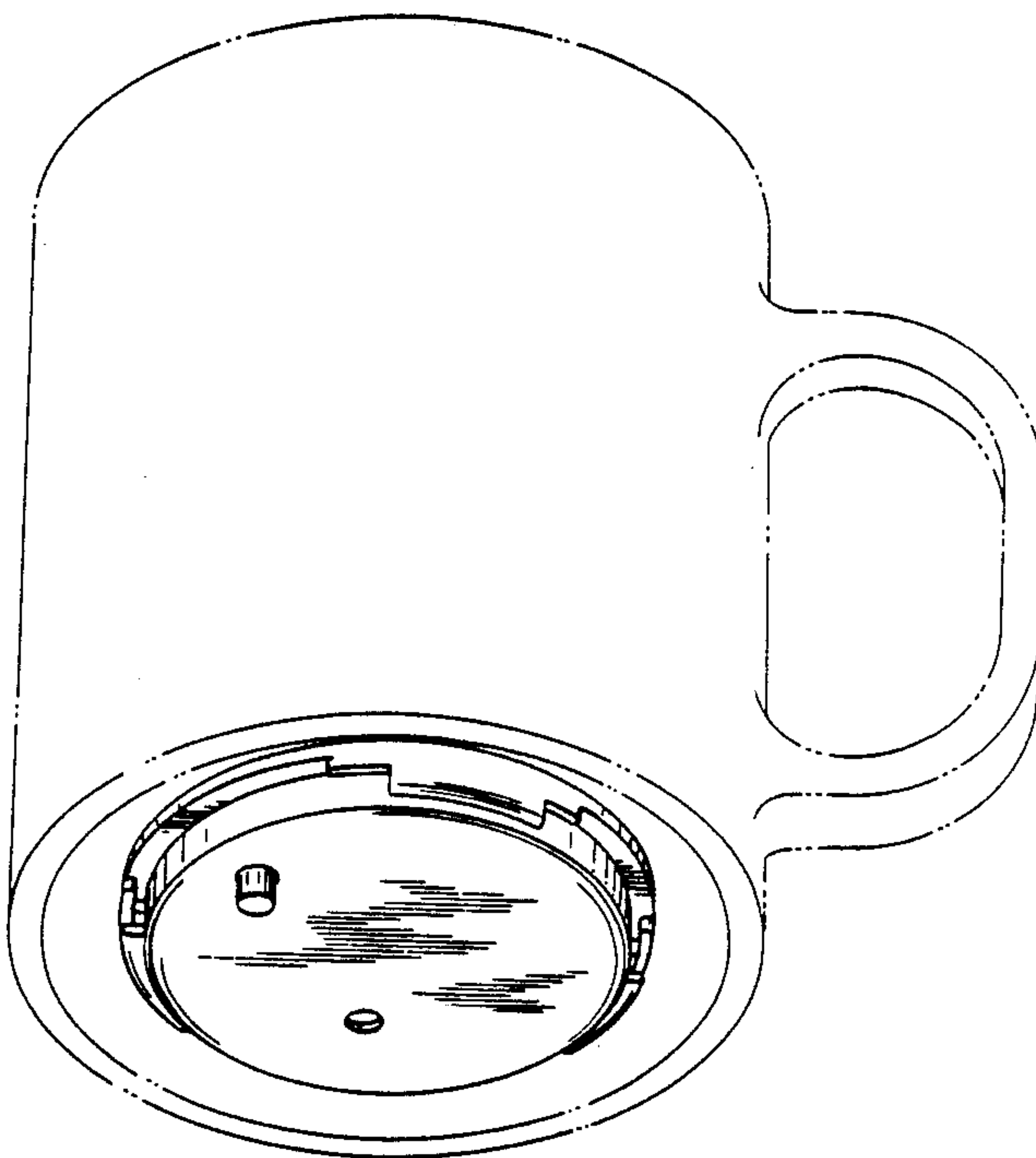

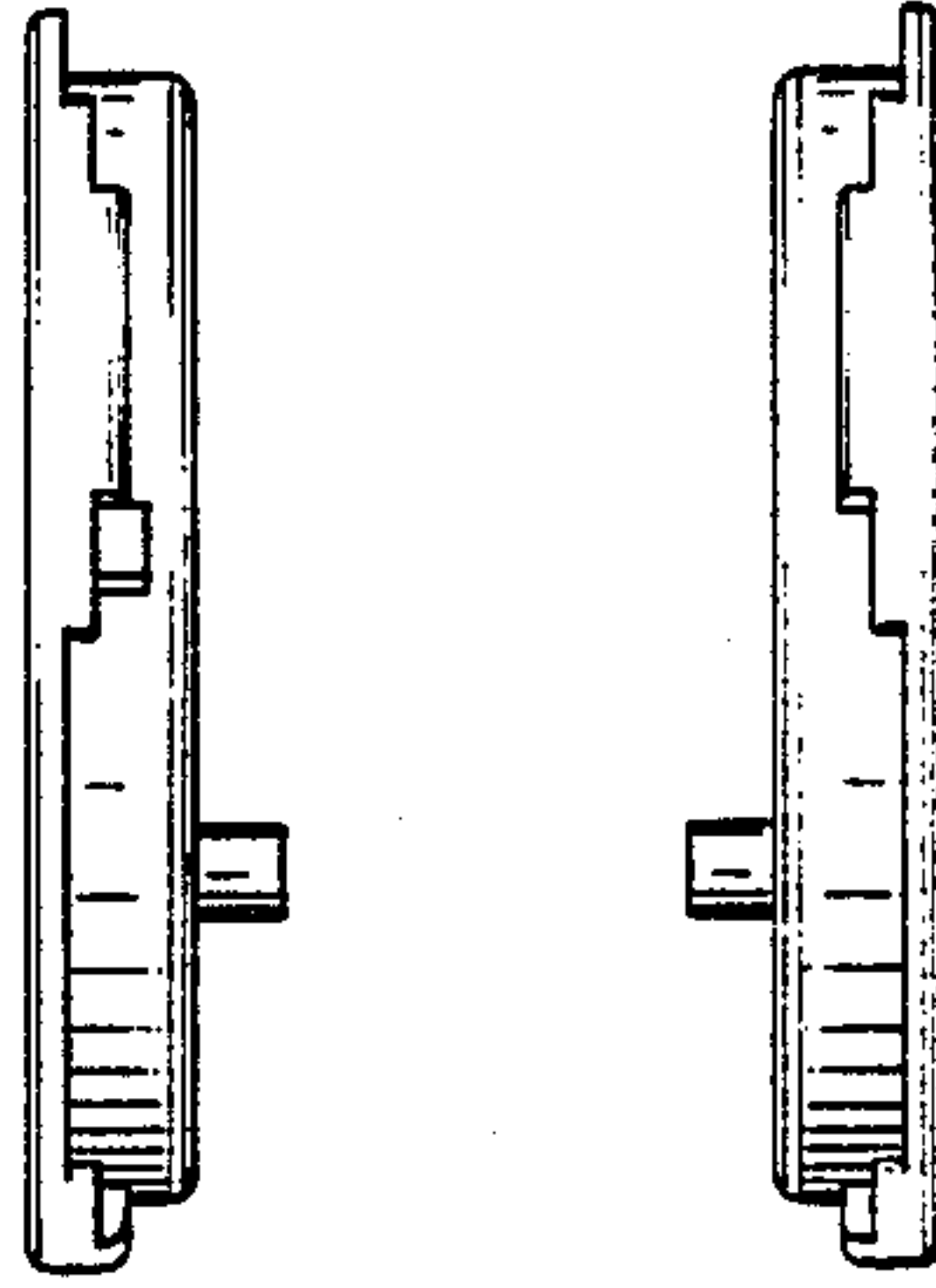

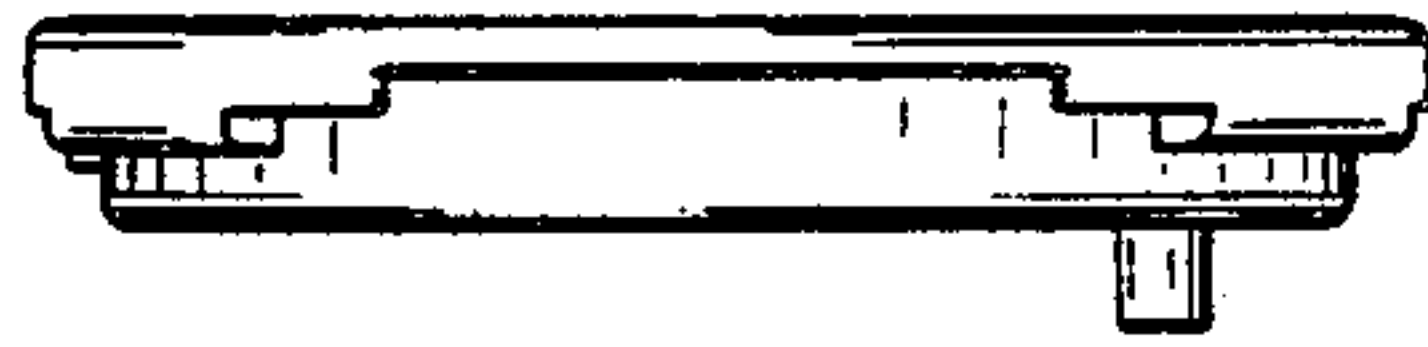

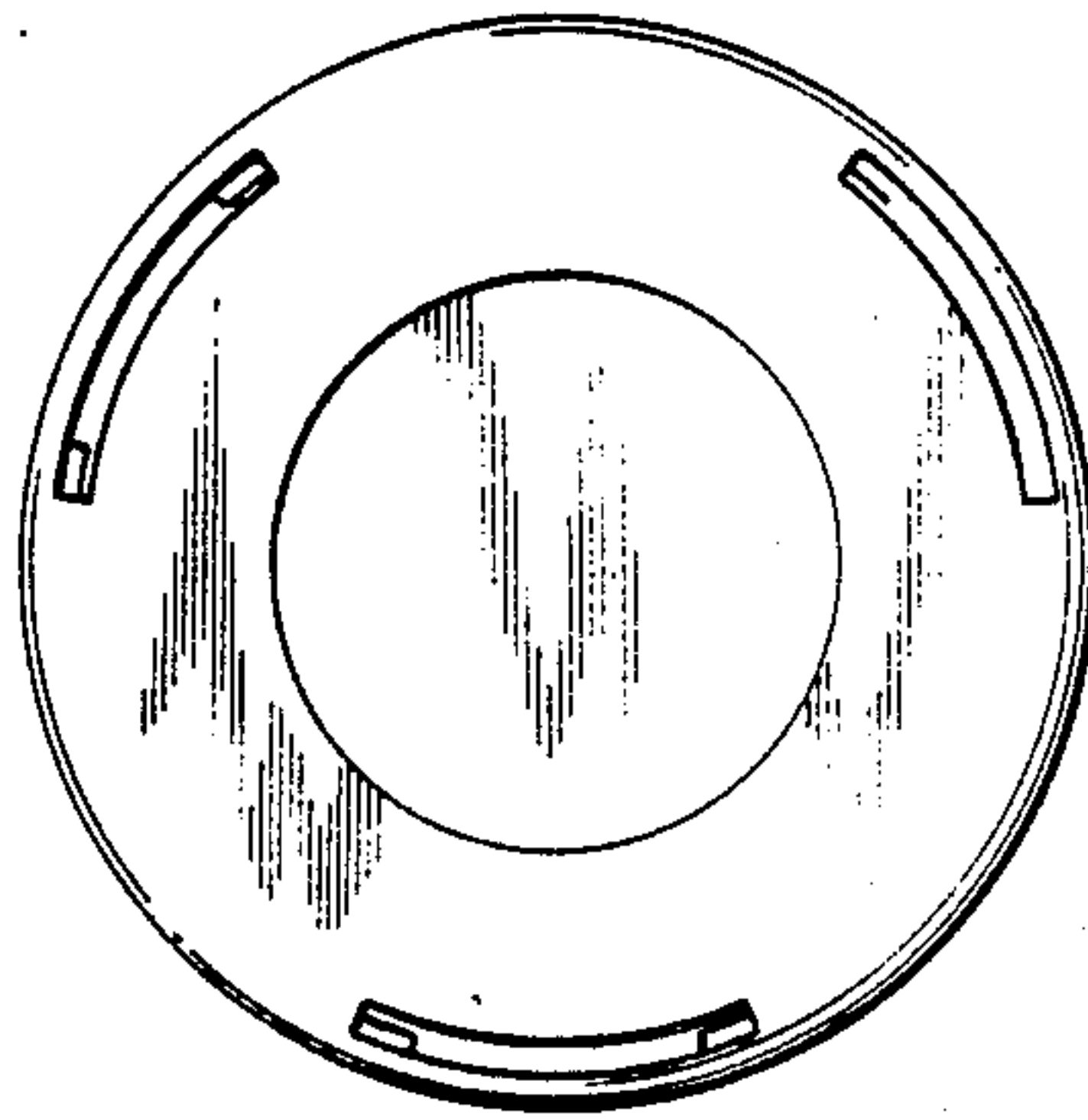

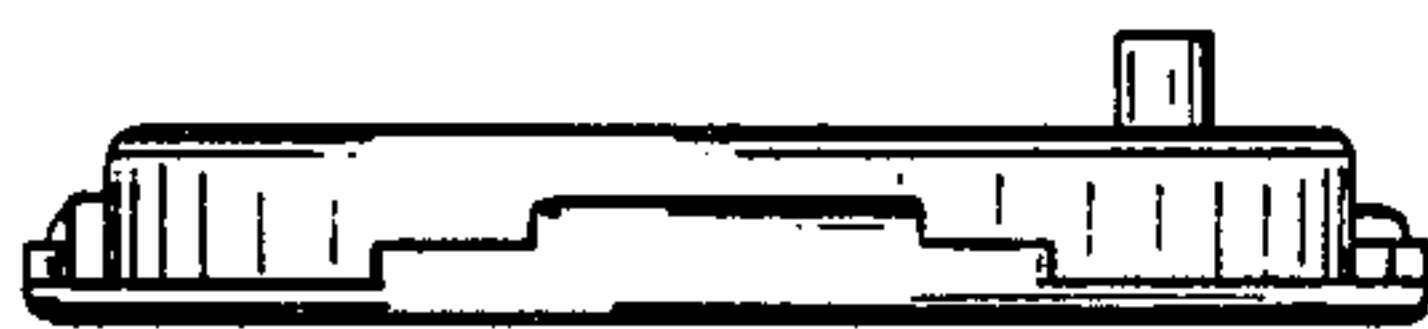

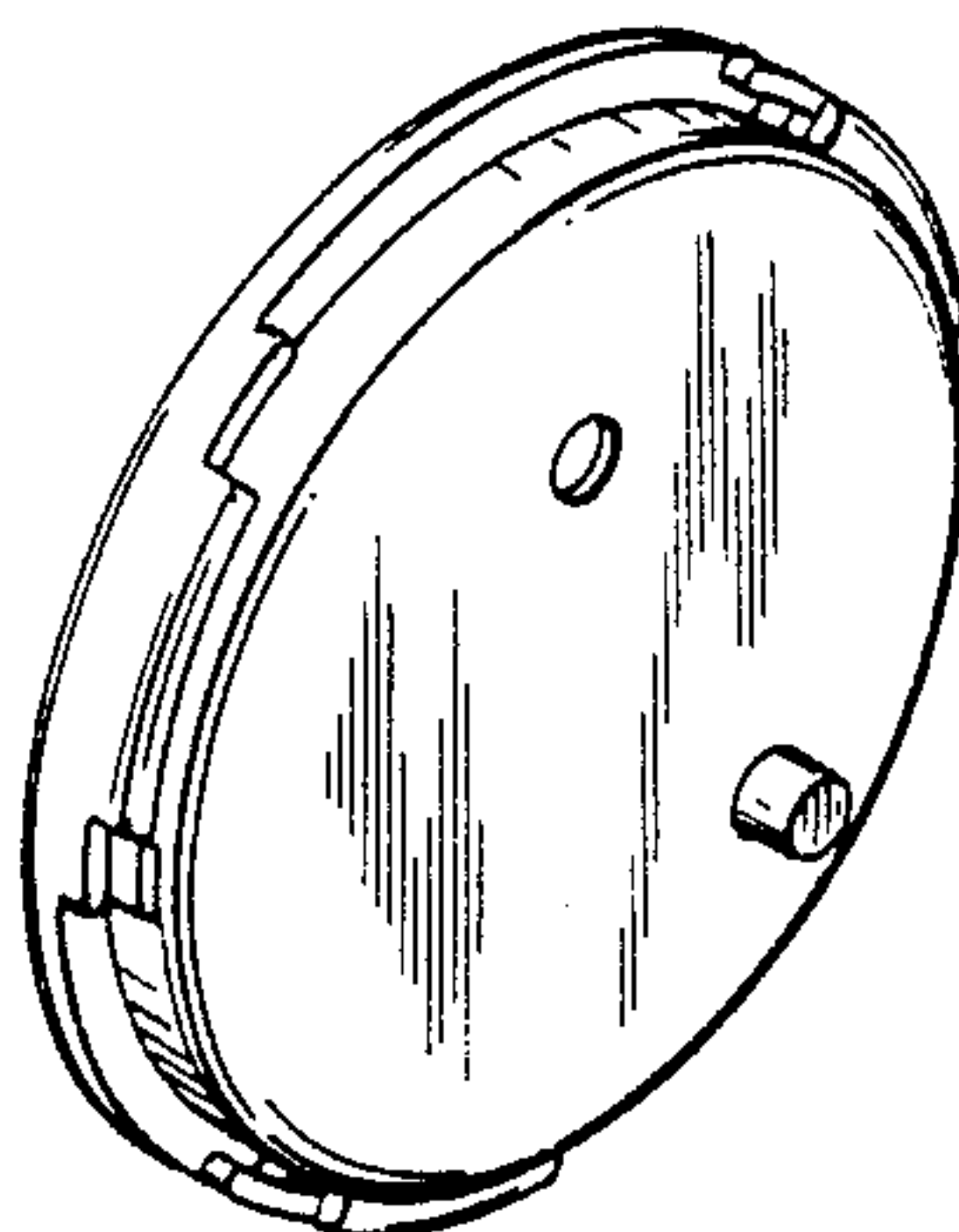

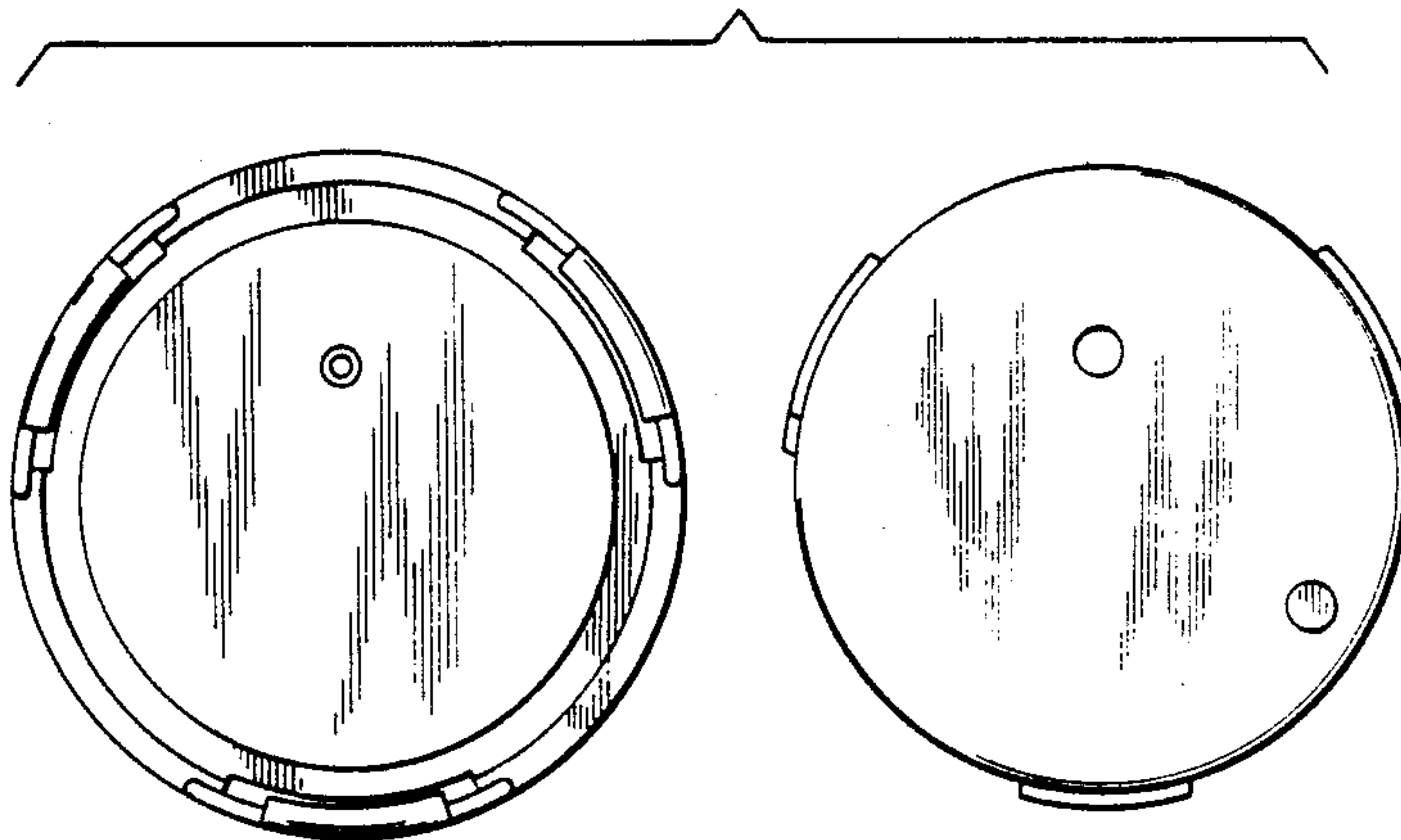
