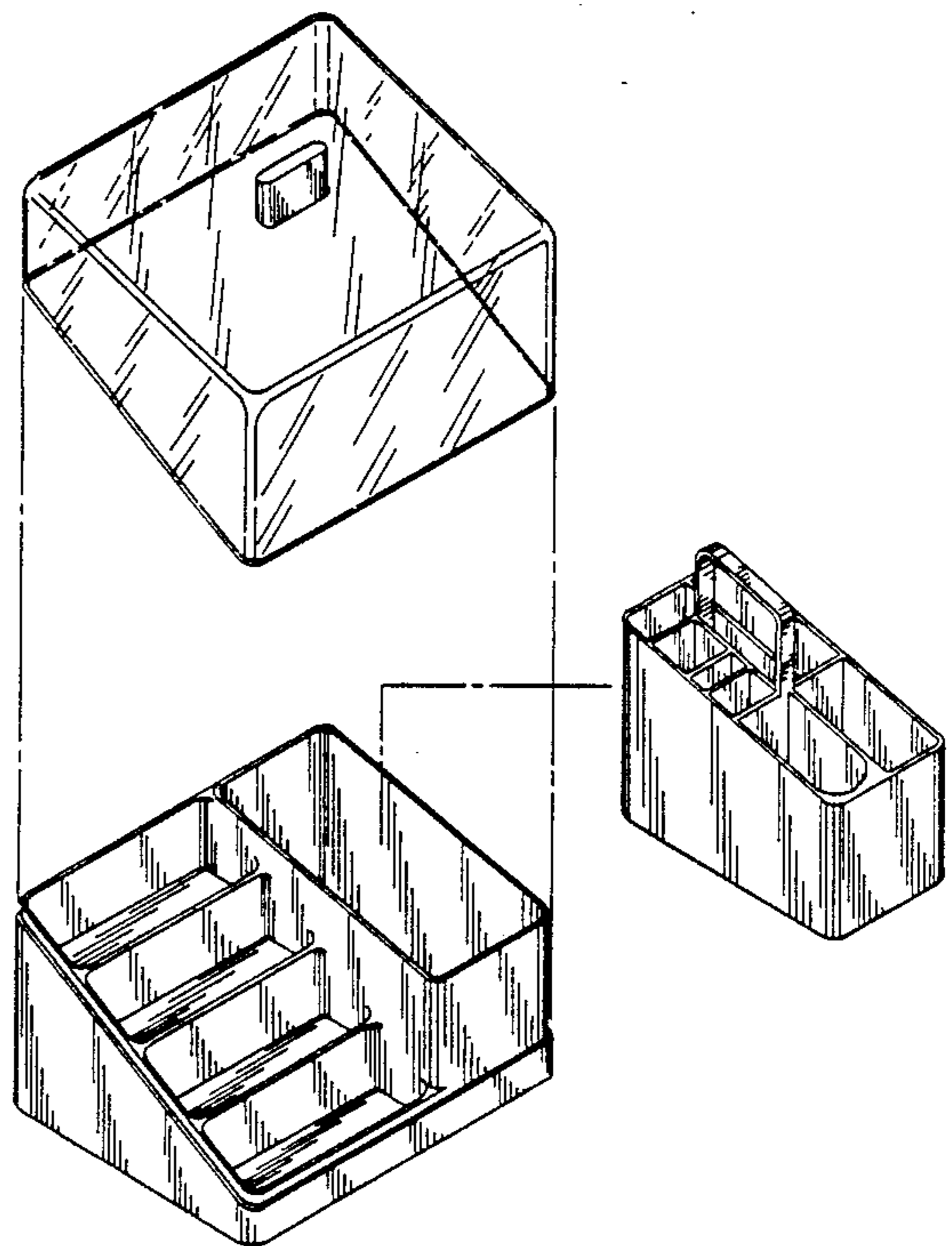
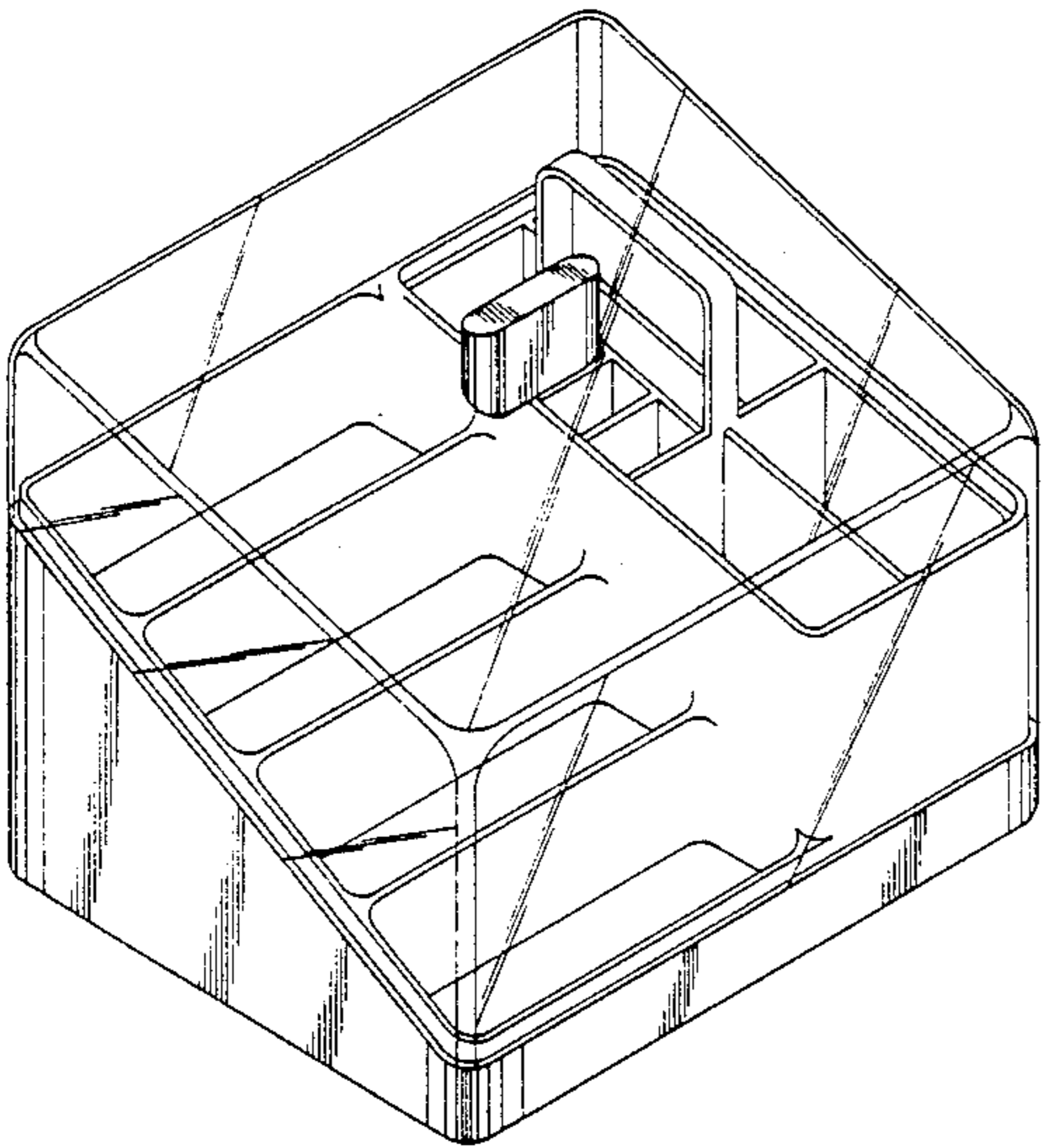

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cosmetic holder having removable cover and accessory tray, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cosmetic holder having a removable cover and accessory tray showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the cosmetic holder with the top and accessory tray removed therefrom;
FIG. 4 is a back elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 8 is an opposite side elevational view;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the accessory tray removed from the cosmetic holder;
FIG. 10 is a back elevational view;
FIG. 11 is a top plan view;
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 13 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 14 is an opposite side elevational view;
FIG. 15 is a front elevational view of the cover removed from the cosmetic holder;
FIG. 16 is a back elevational view;
FIG. 17 is a top plan view;
FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 19 is a side elevational view, this side and the opposite side being of identical design.



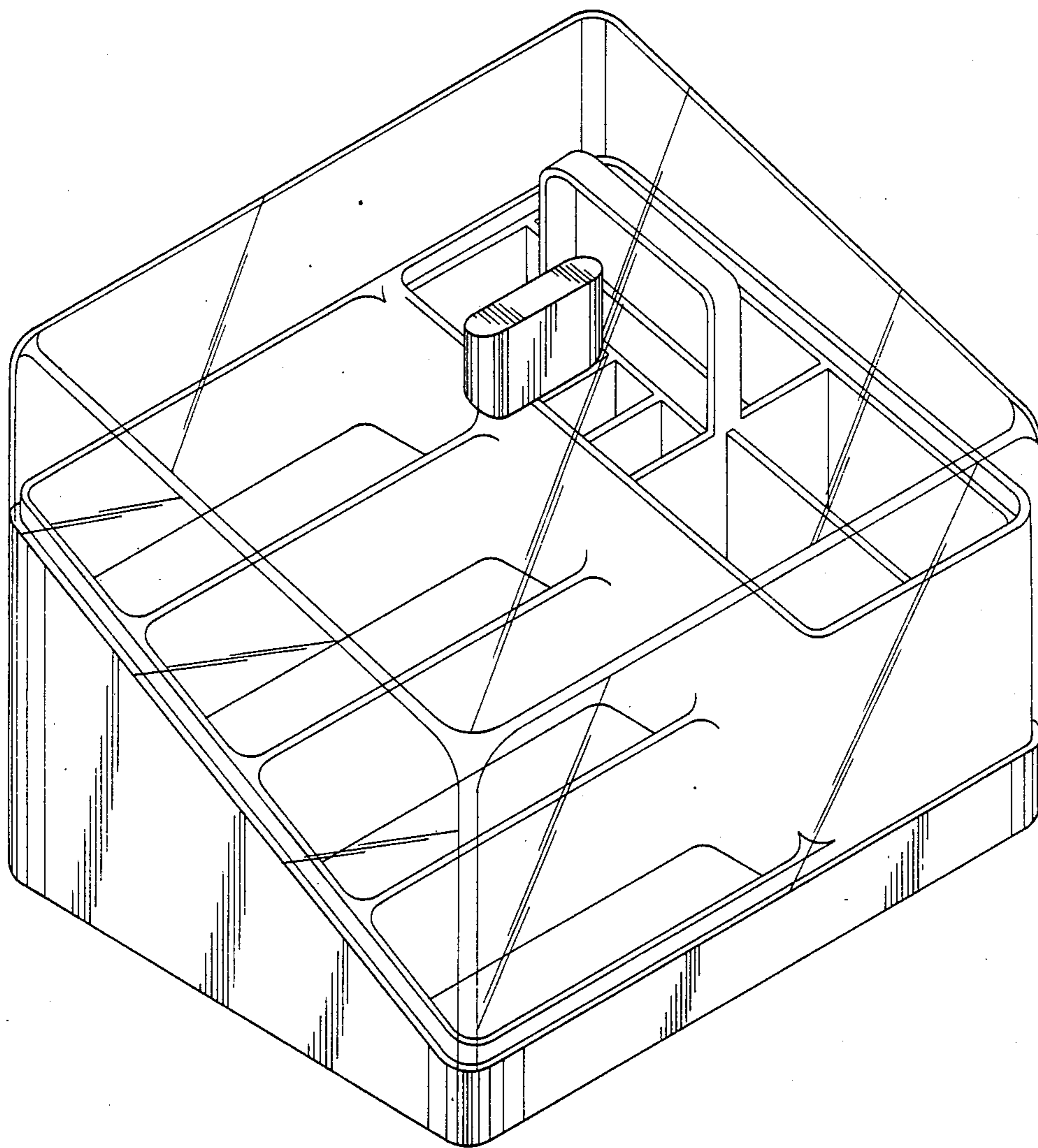

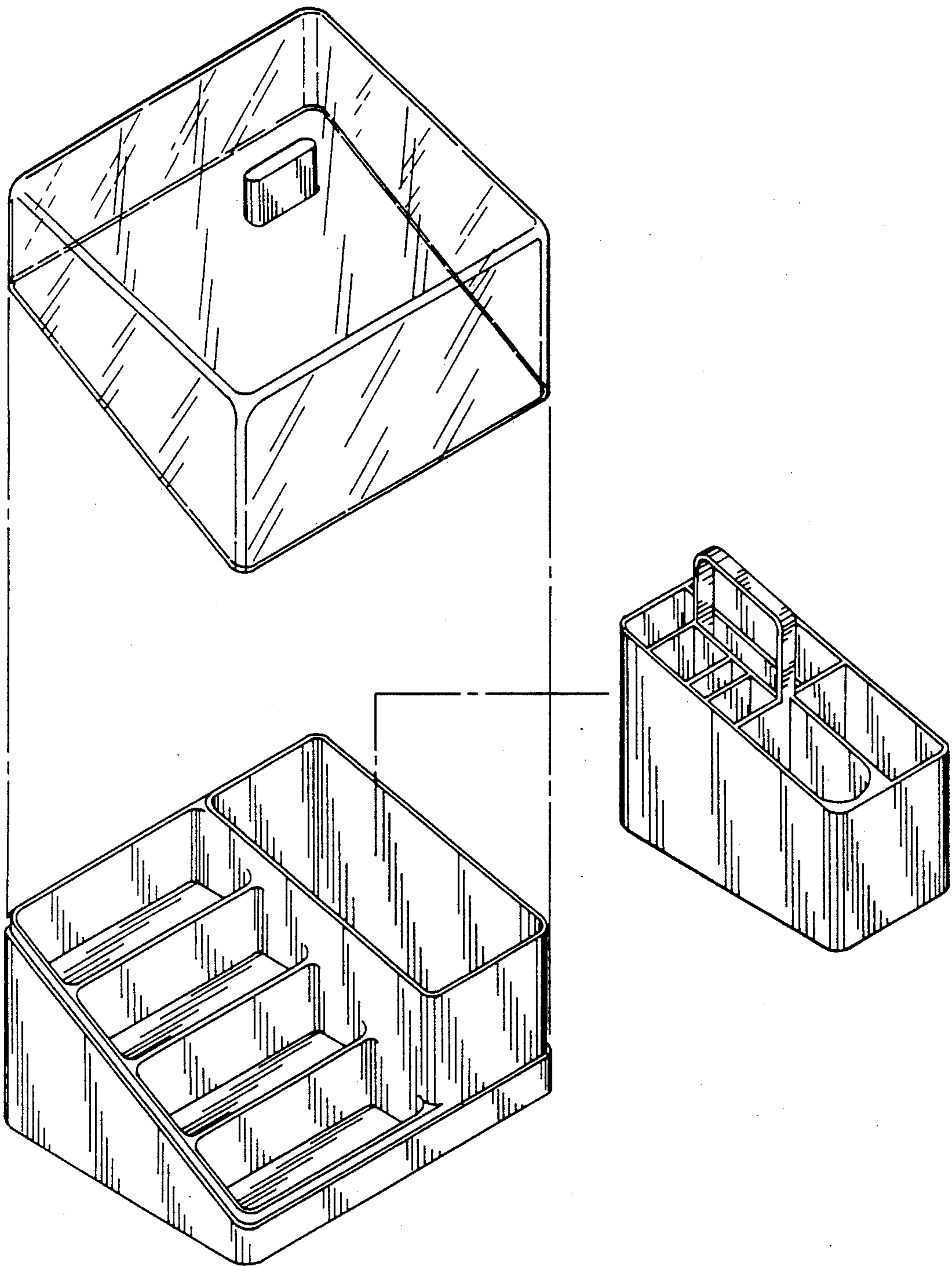

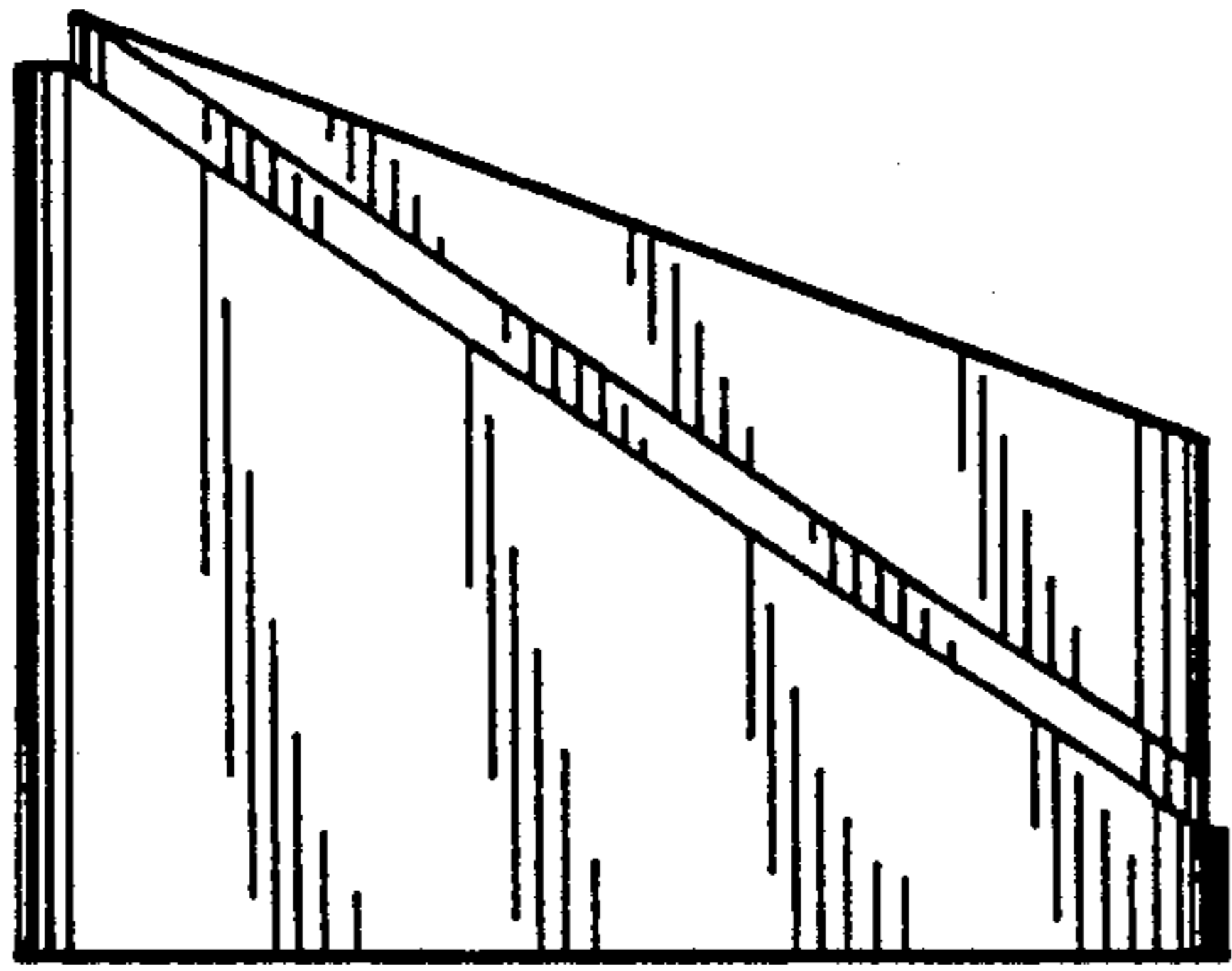

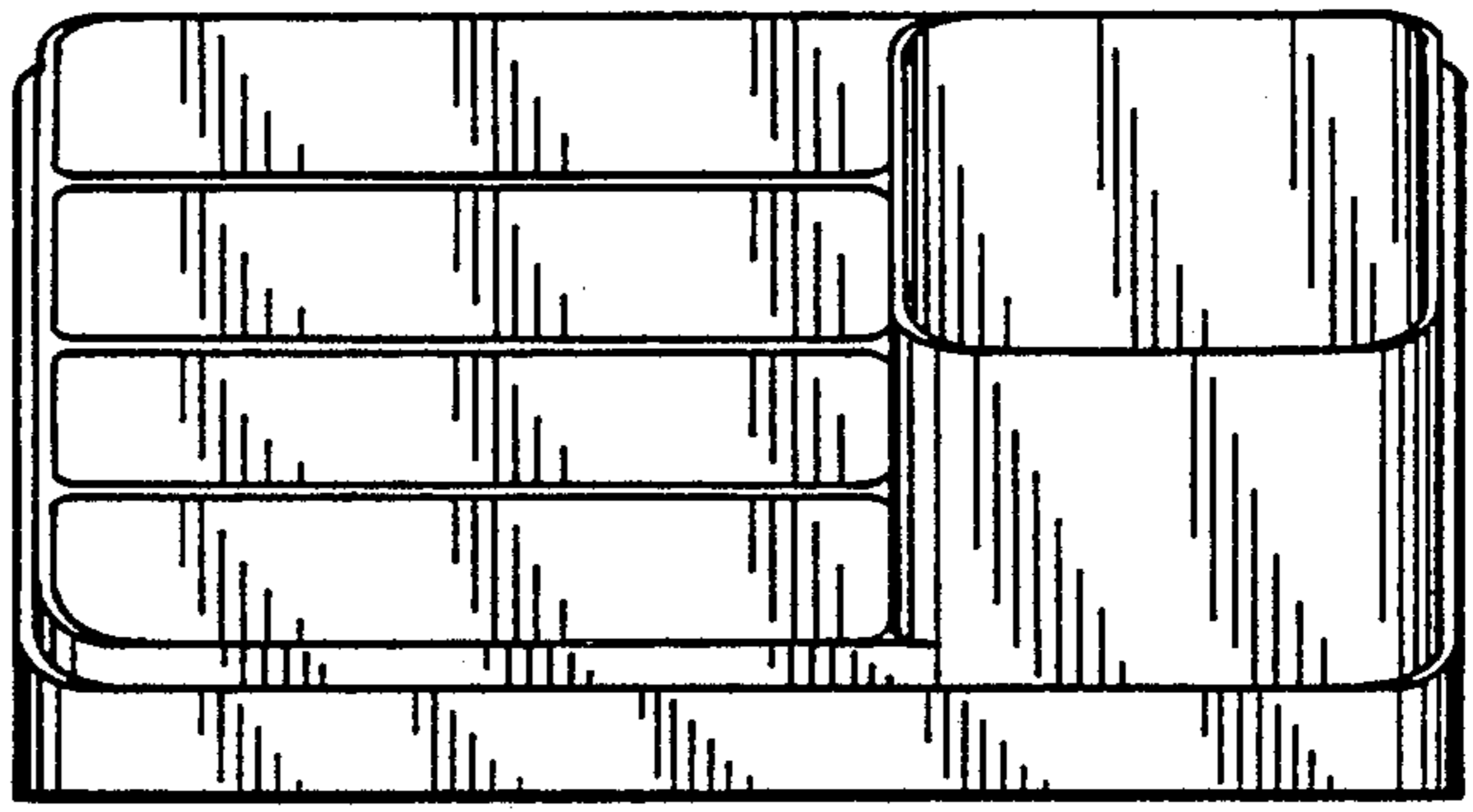

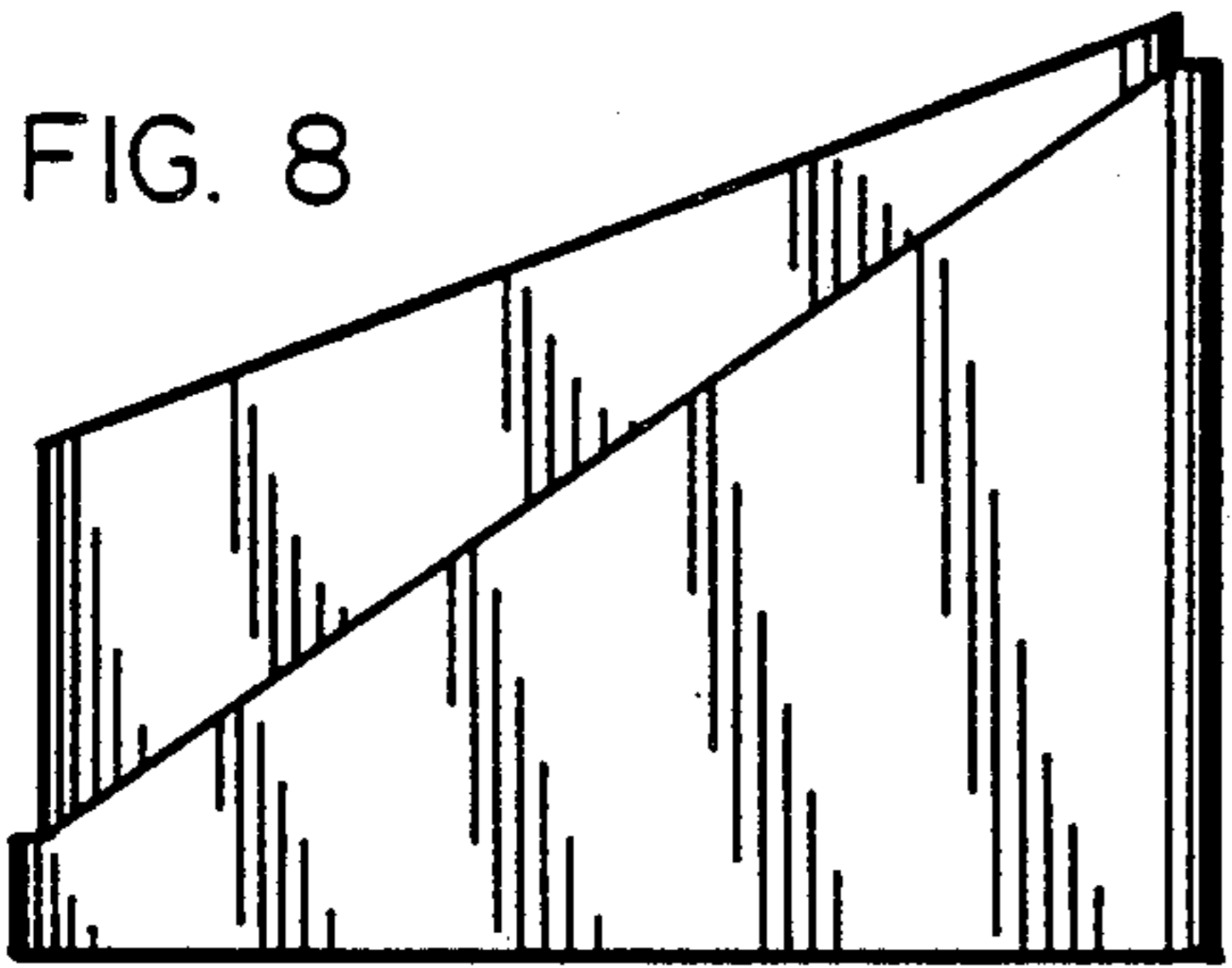

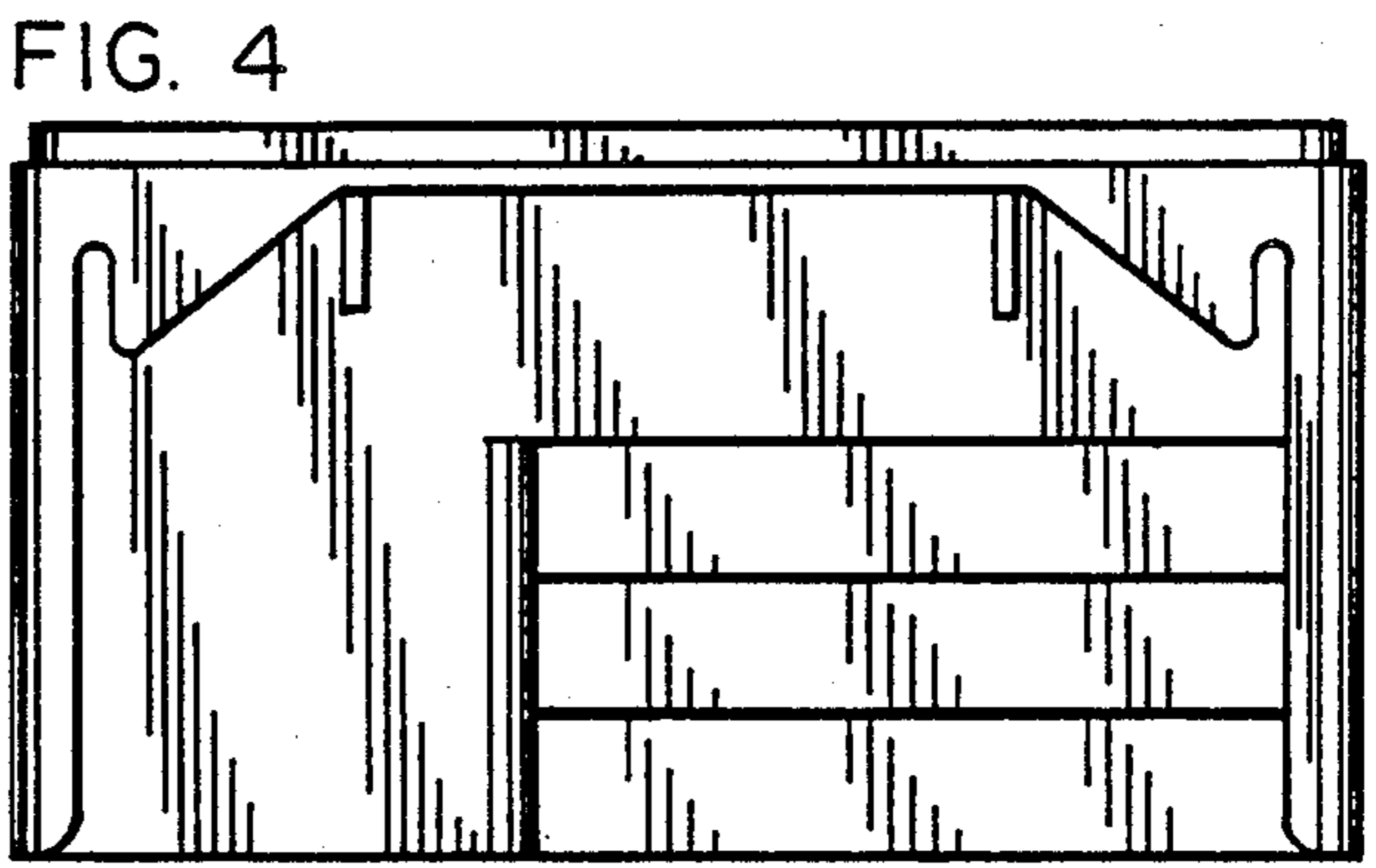

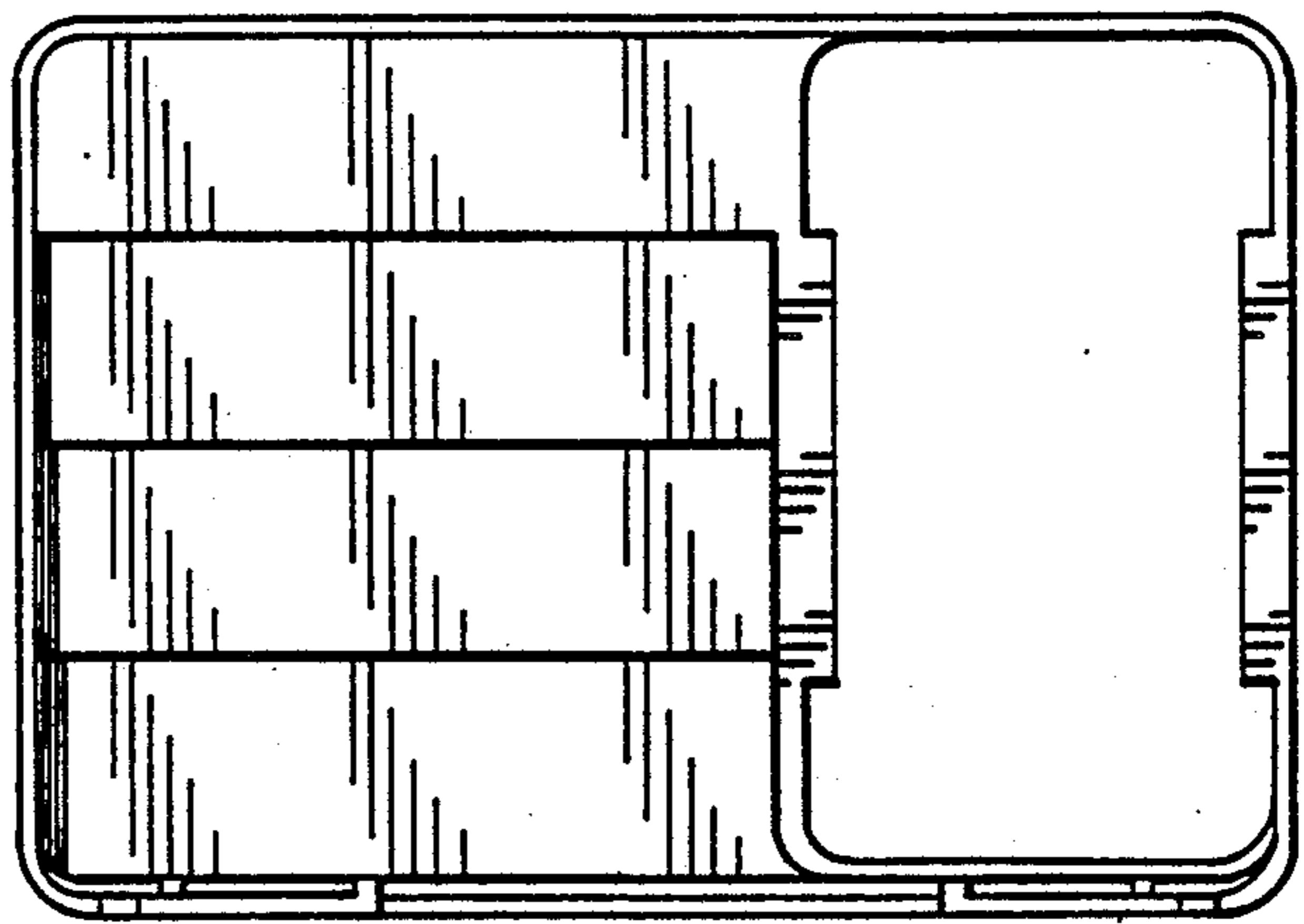

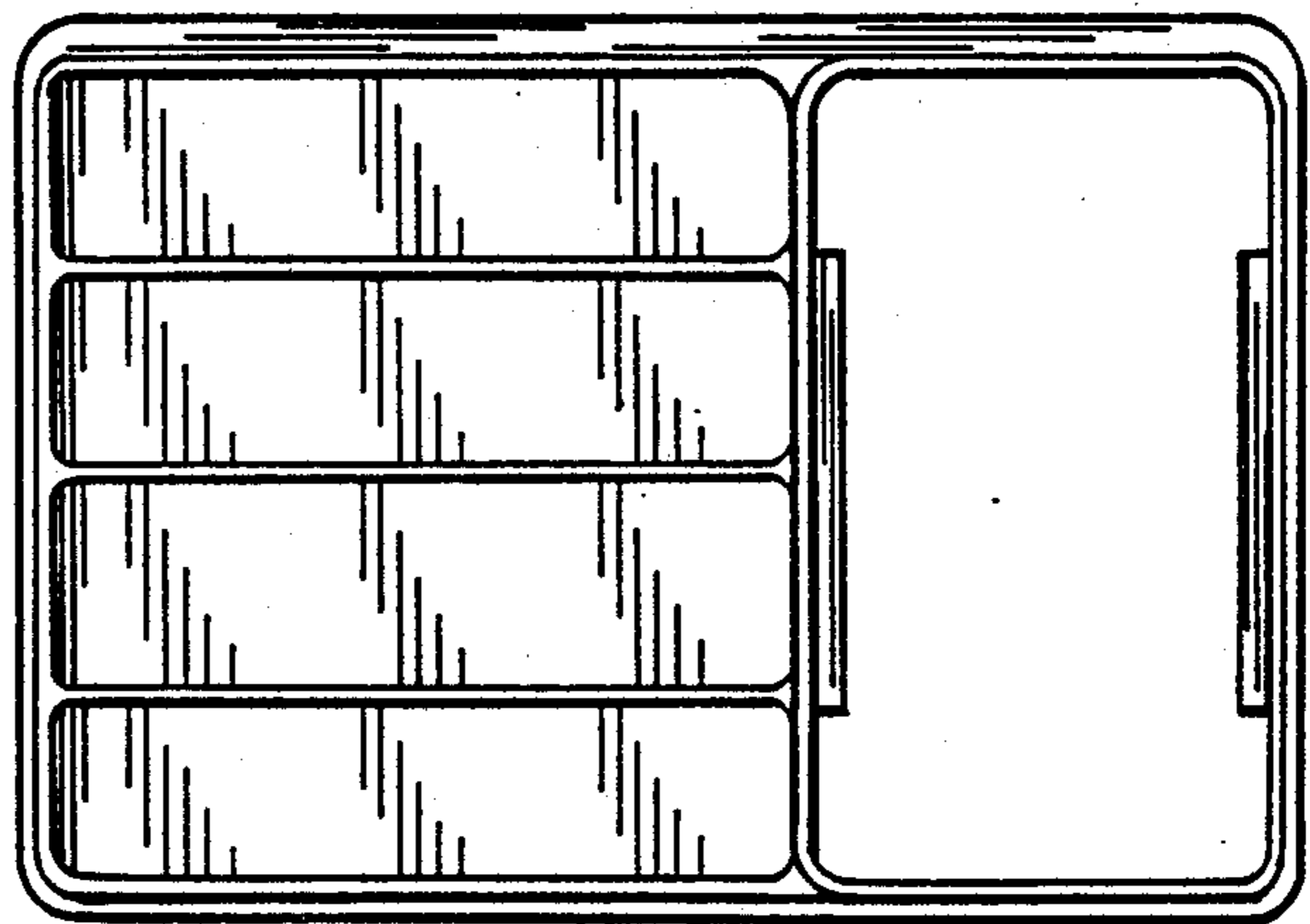

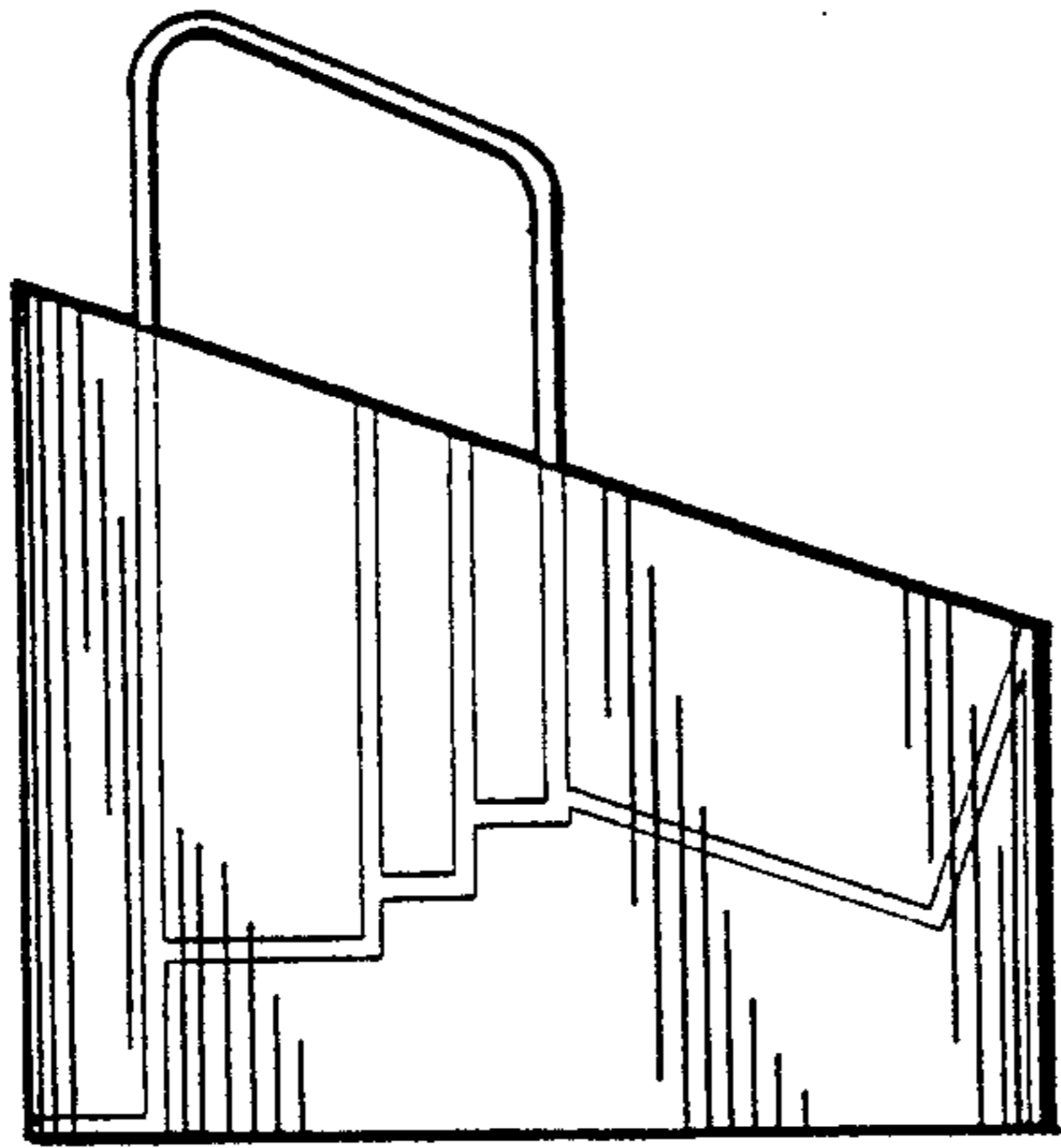

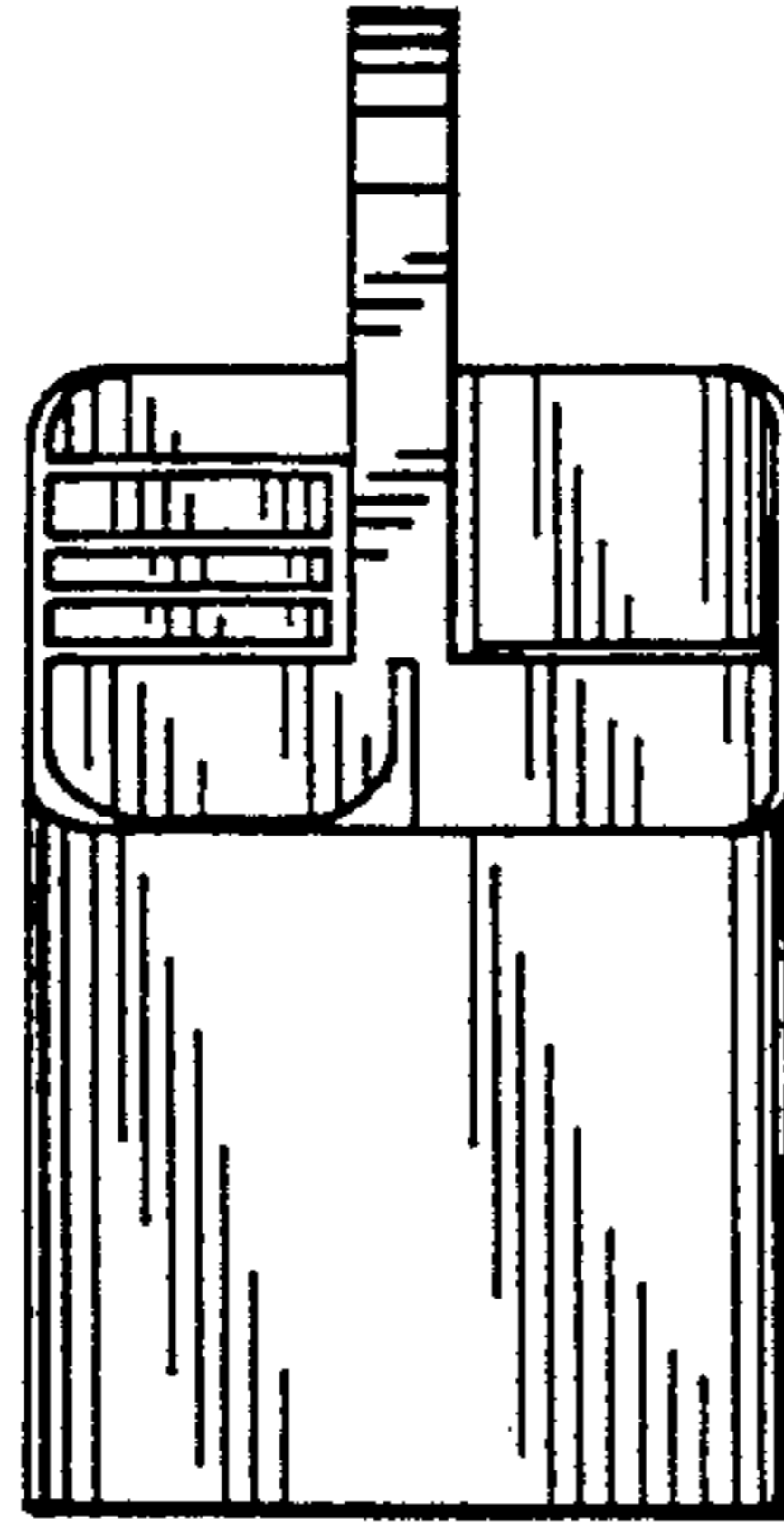

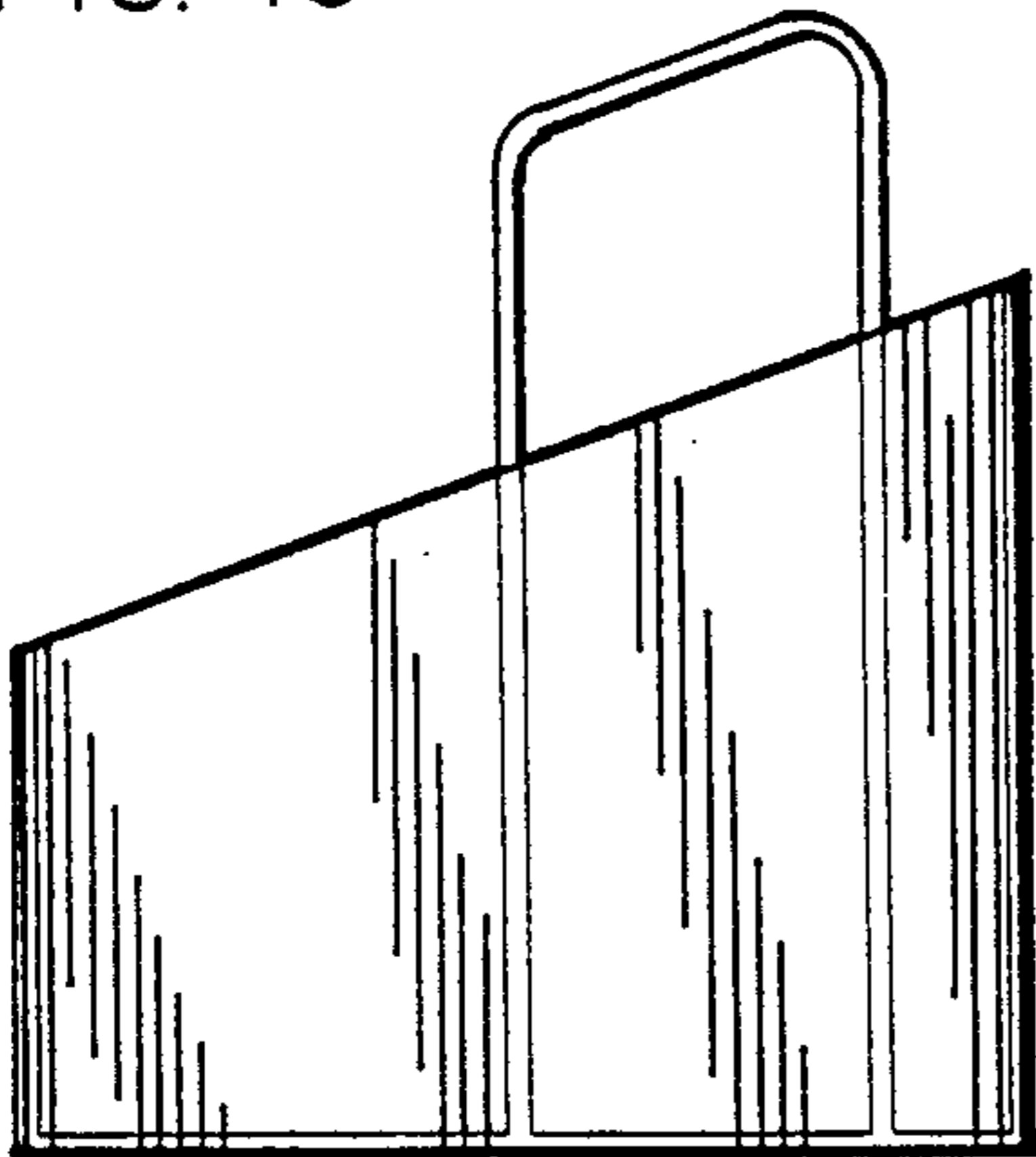

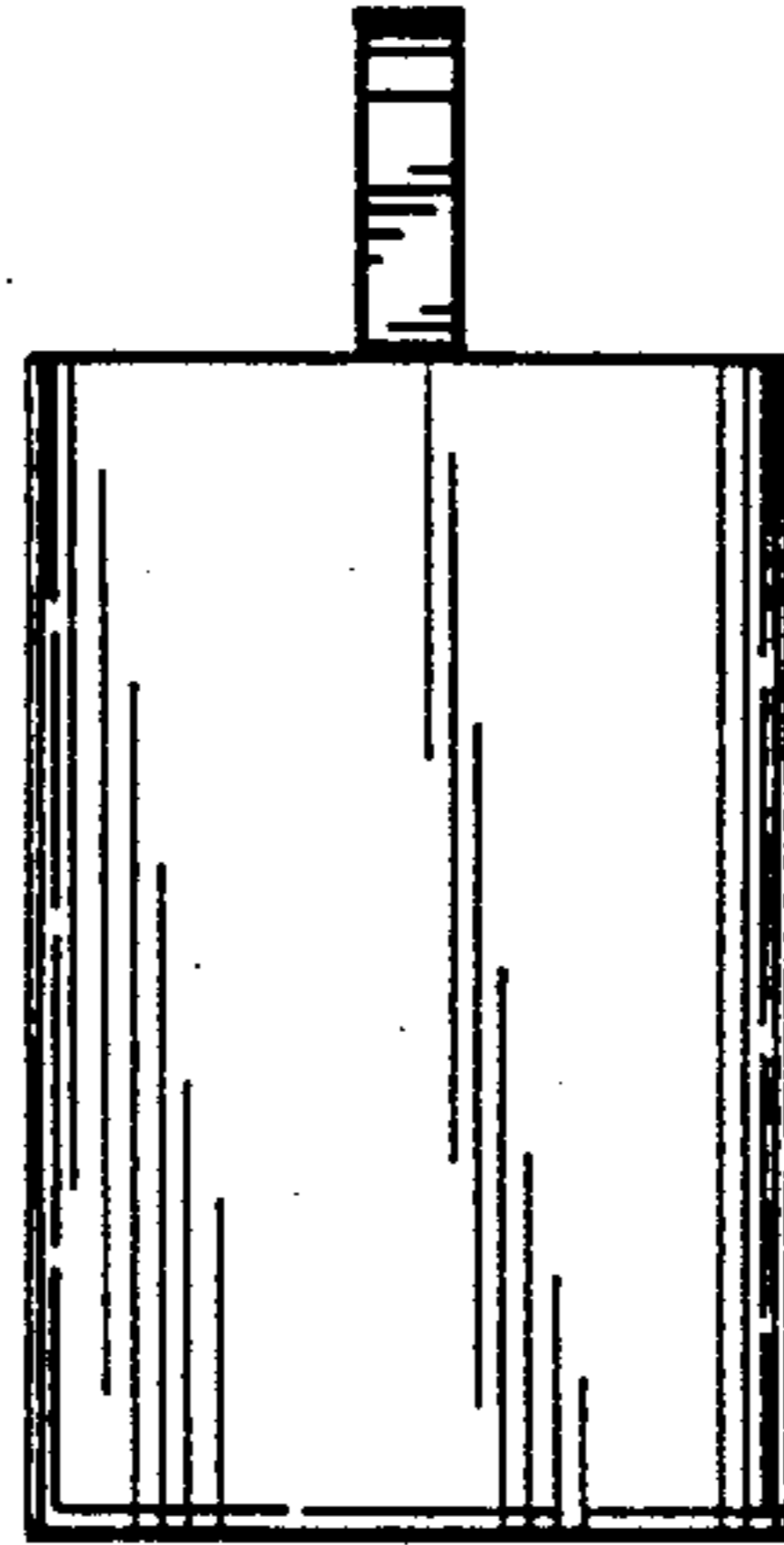

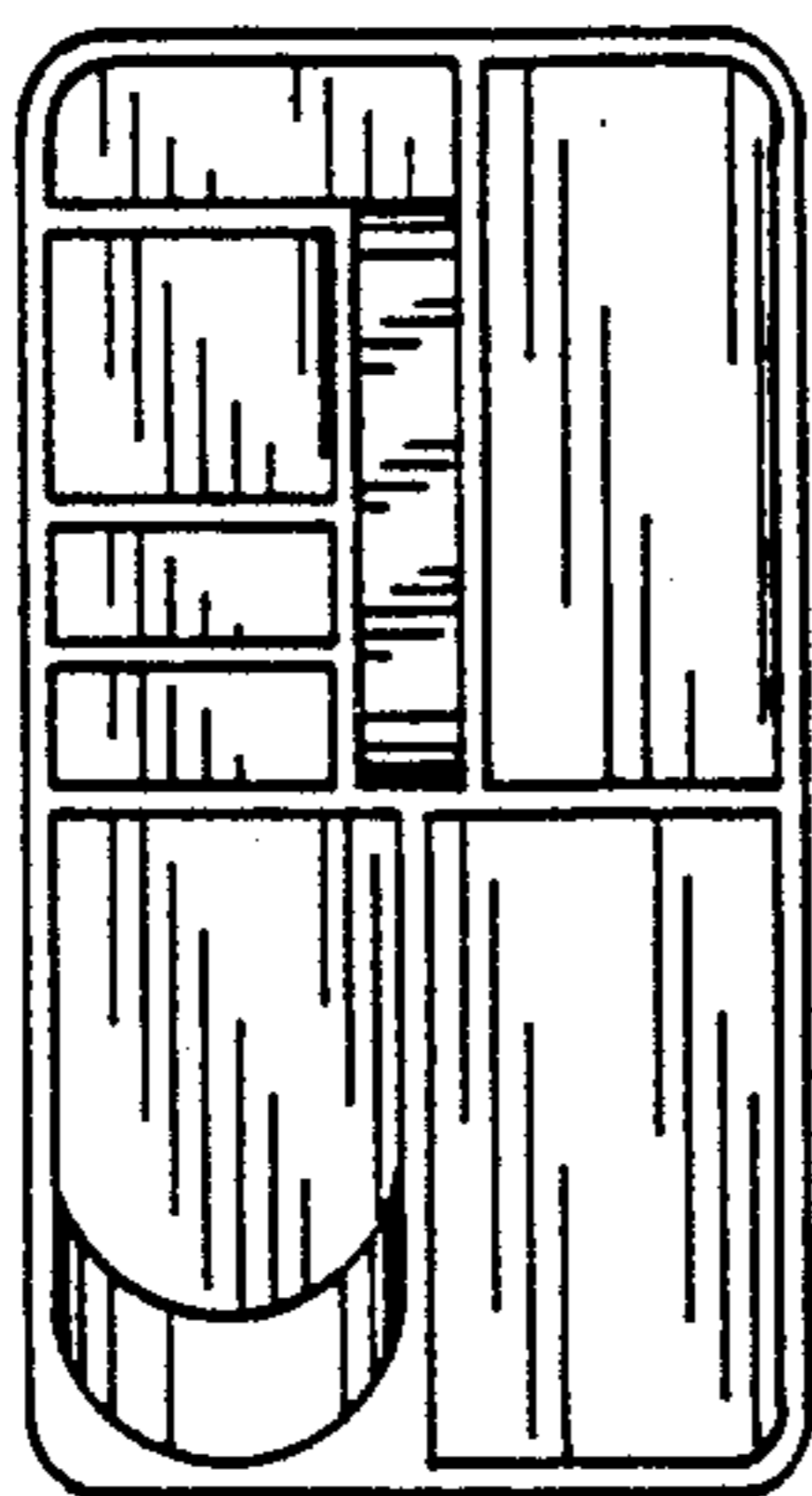

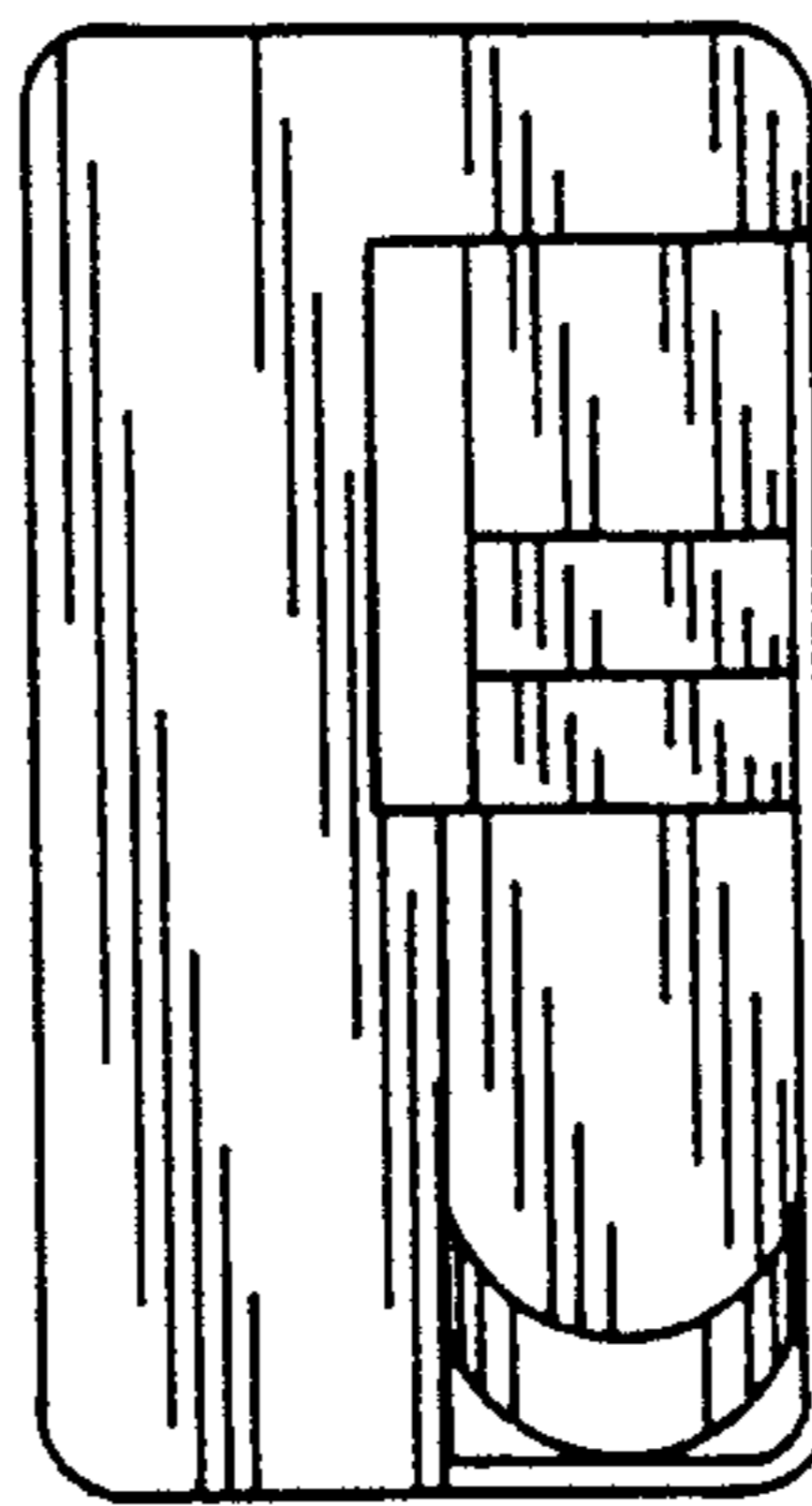

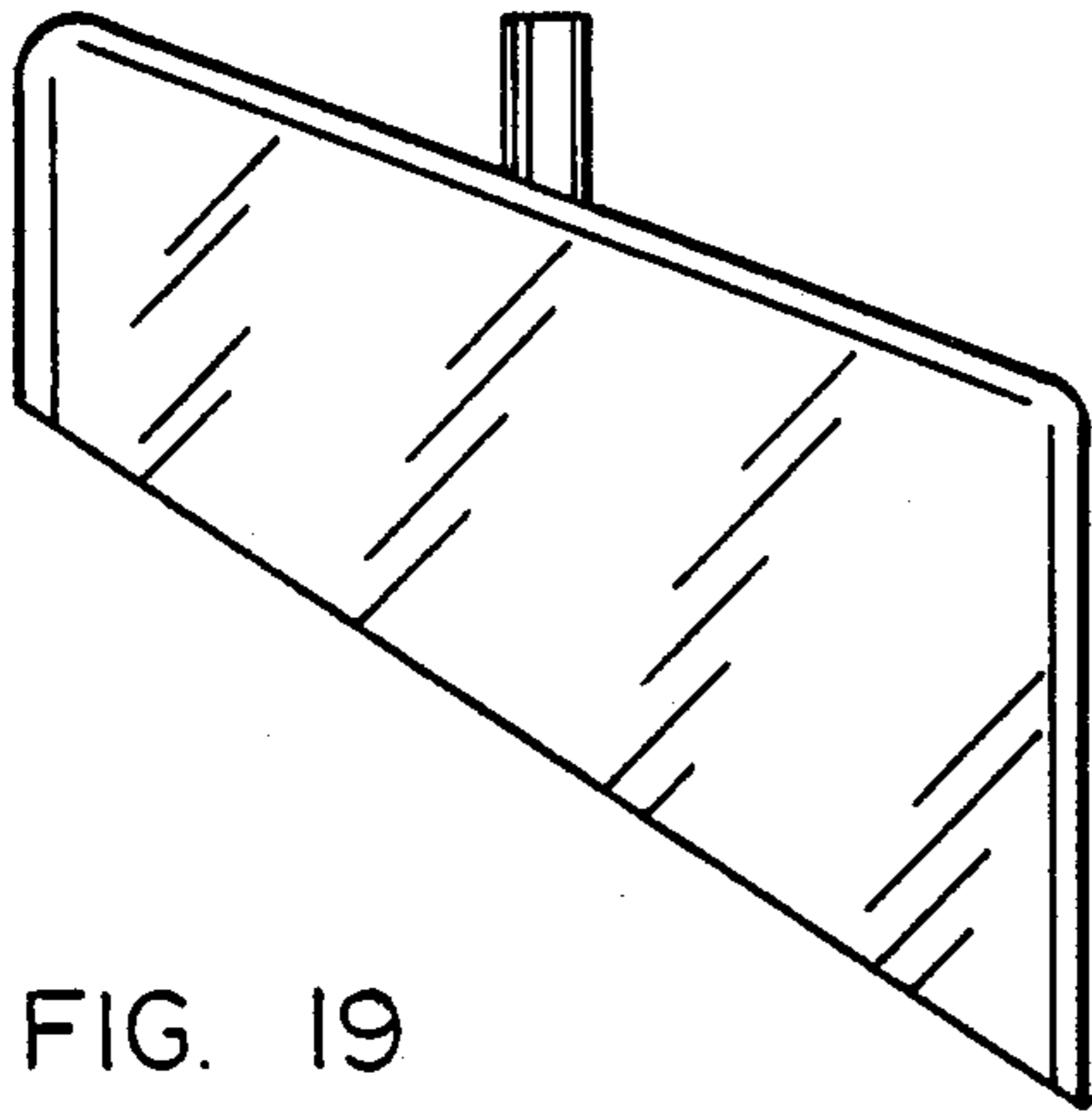

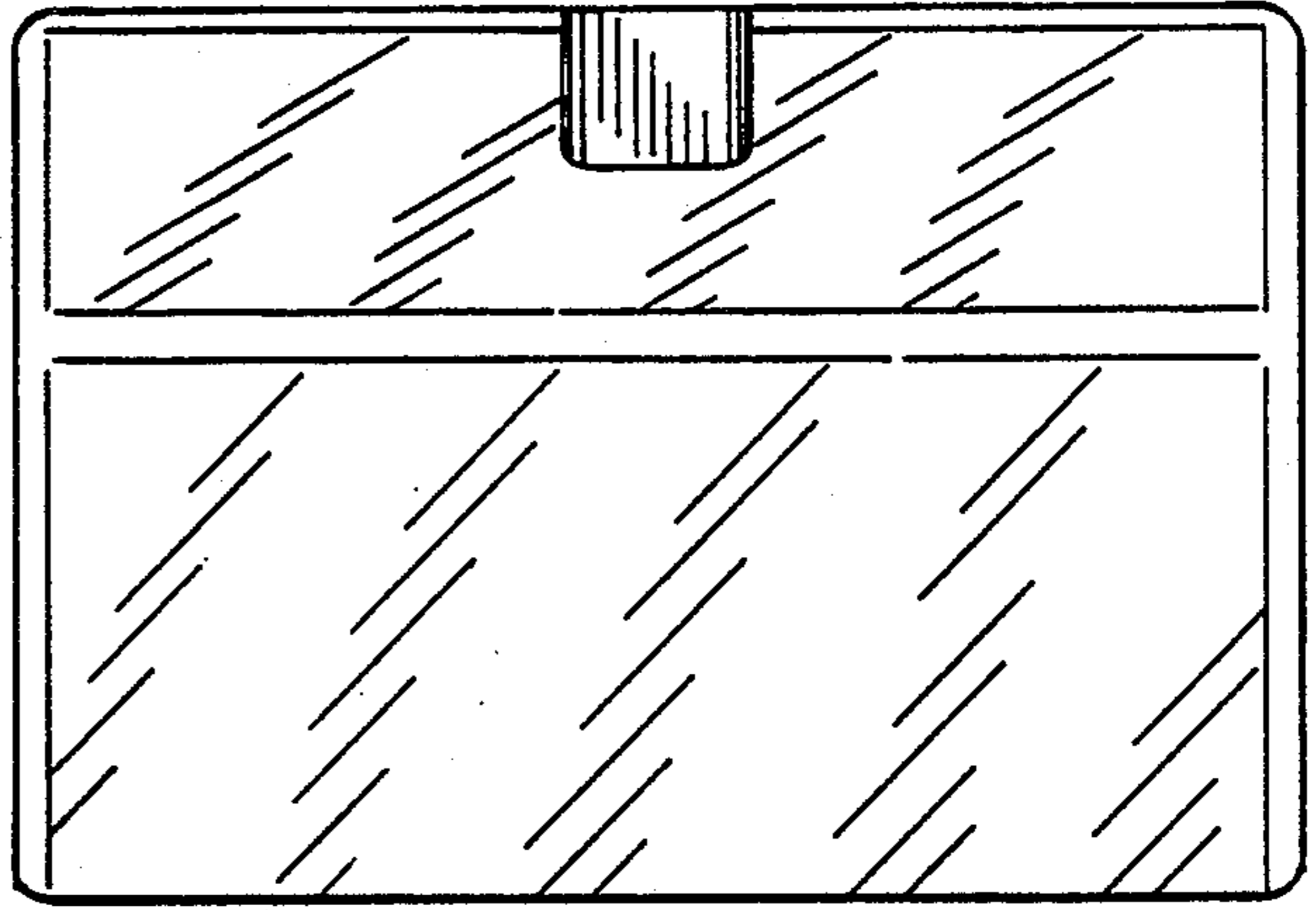

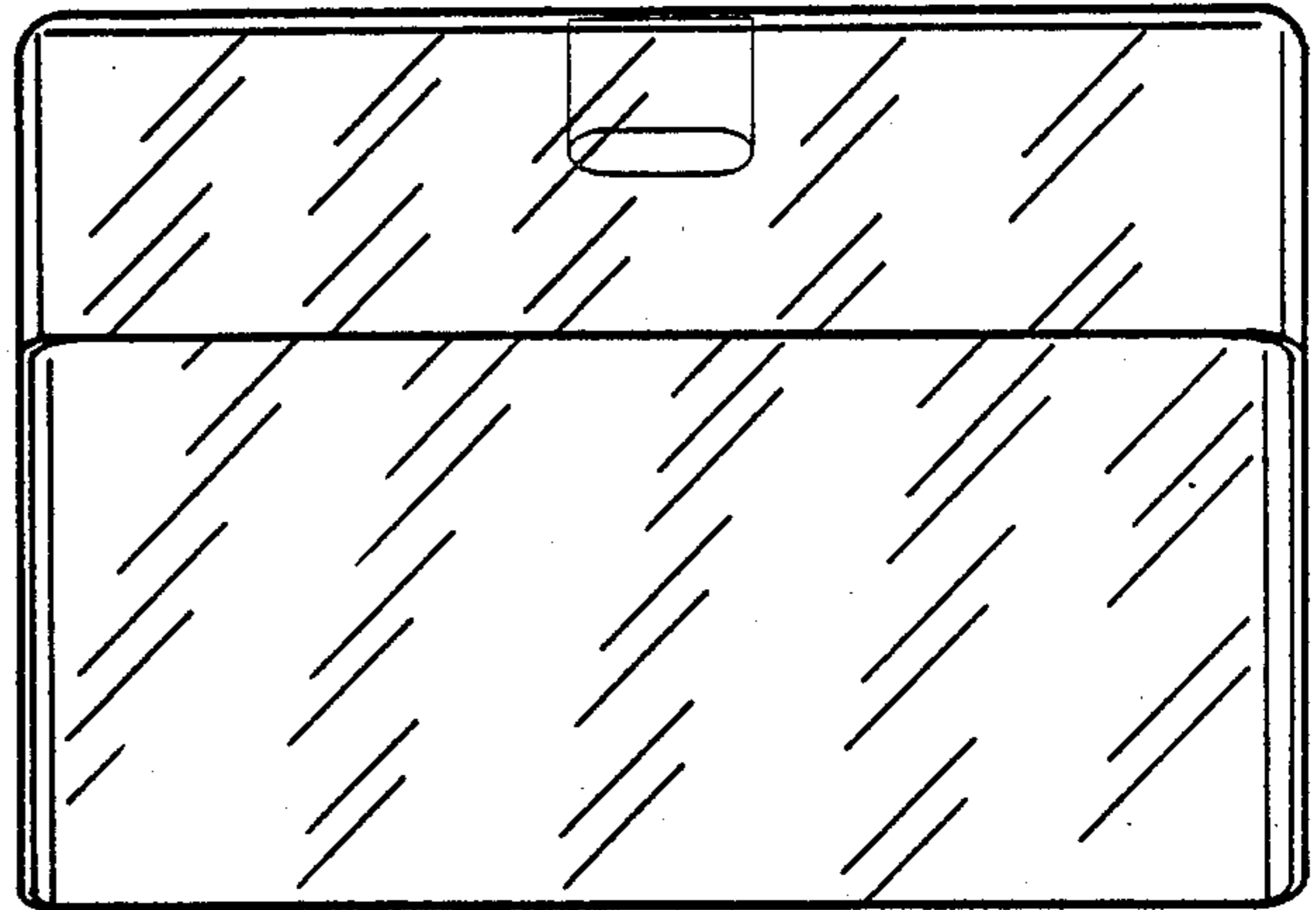

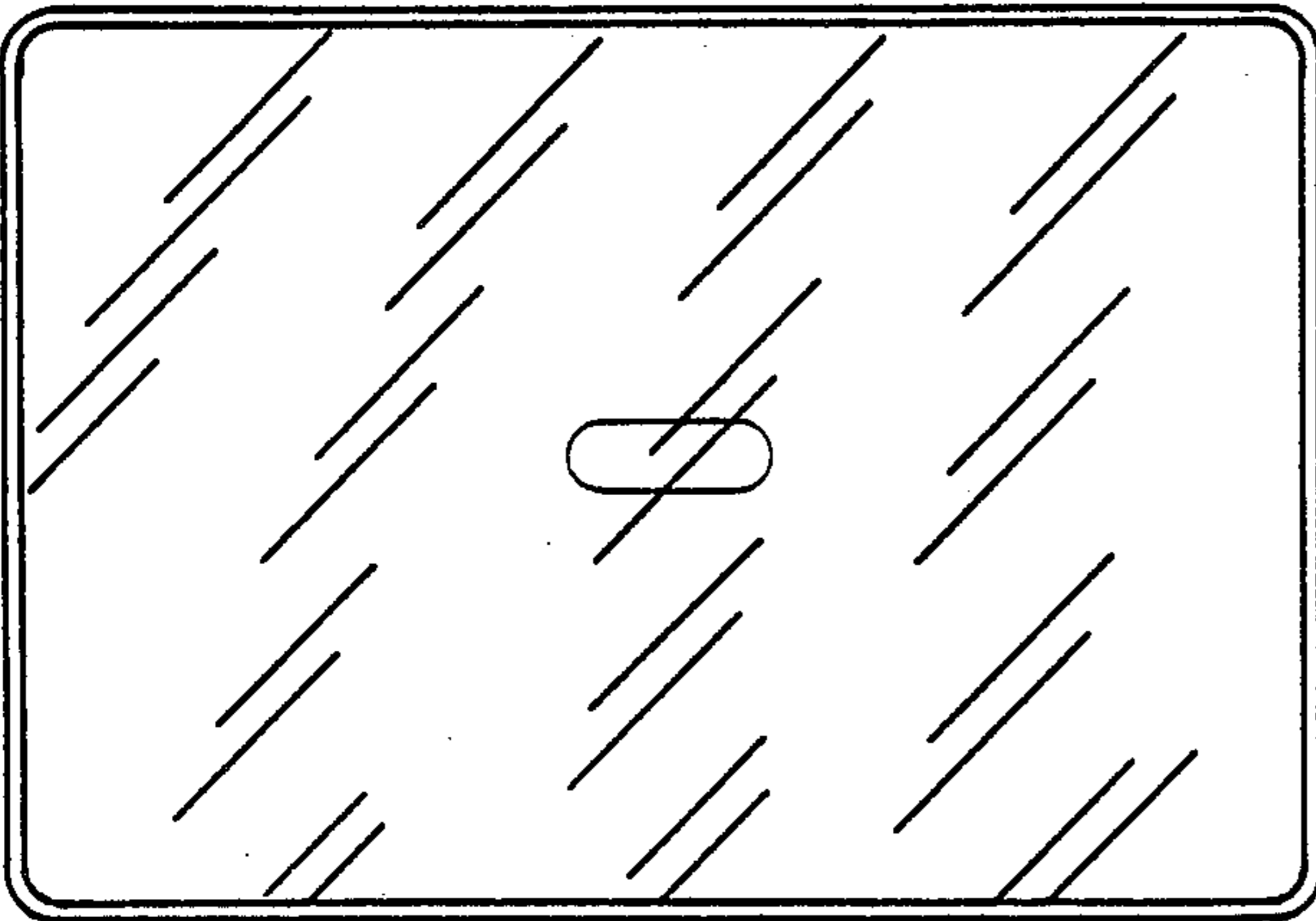

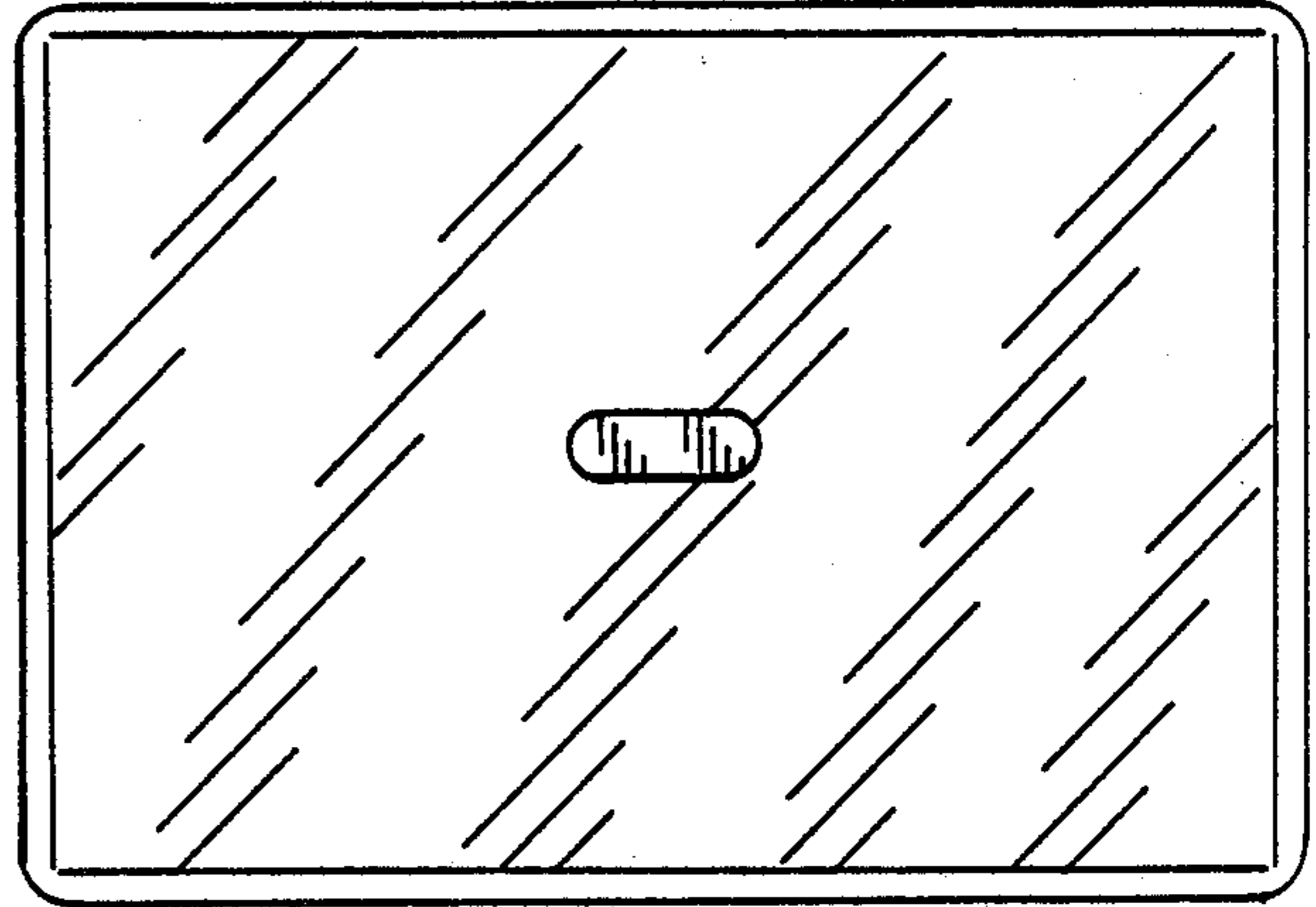
