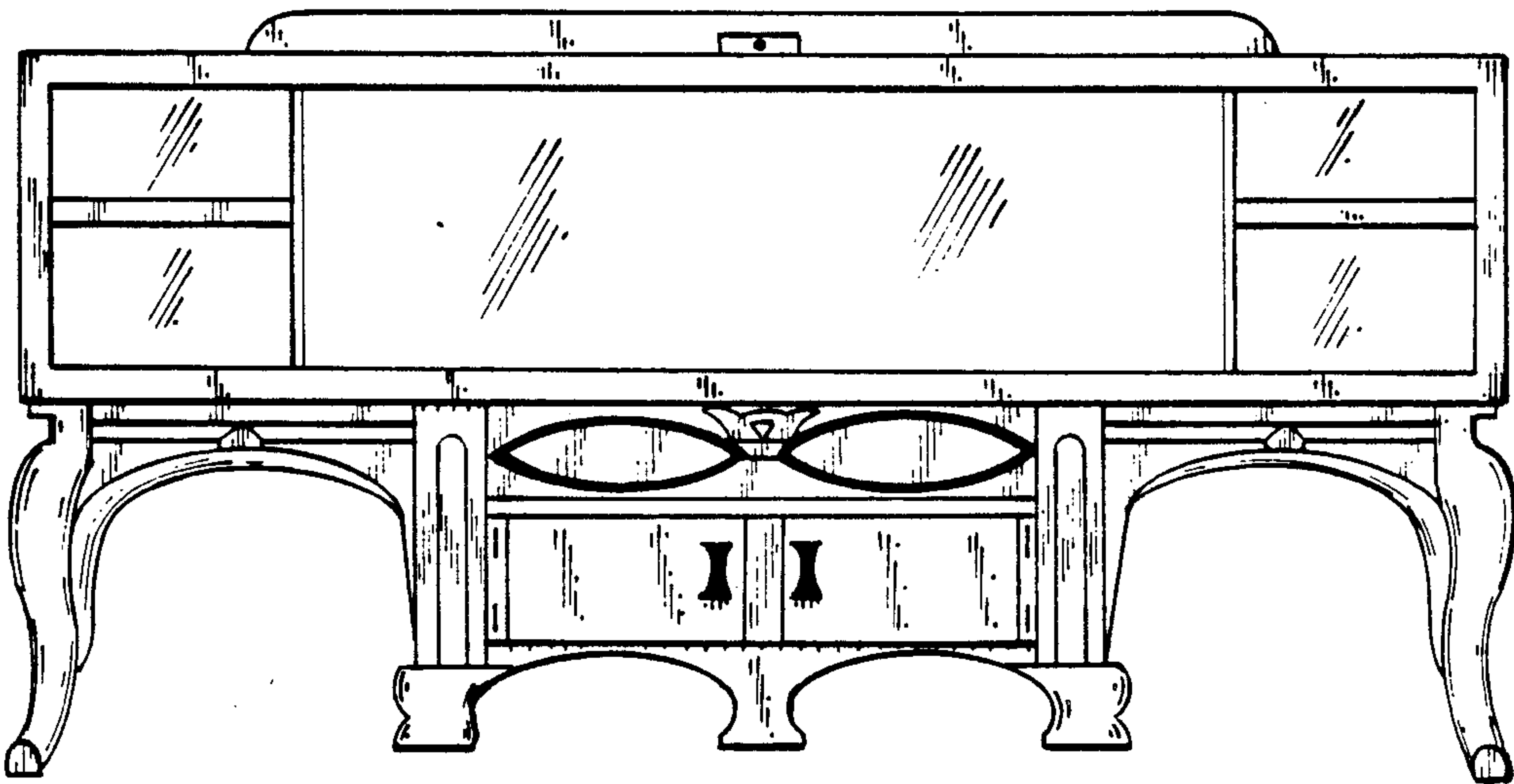
The ornamental design for an aquarium tank, substan-

side being a mirror image of the right side shown.



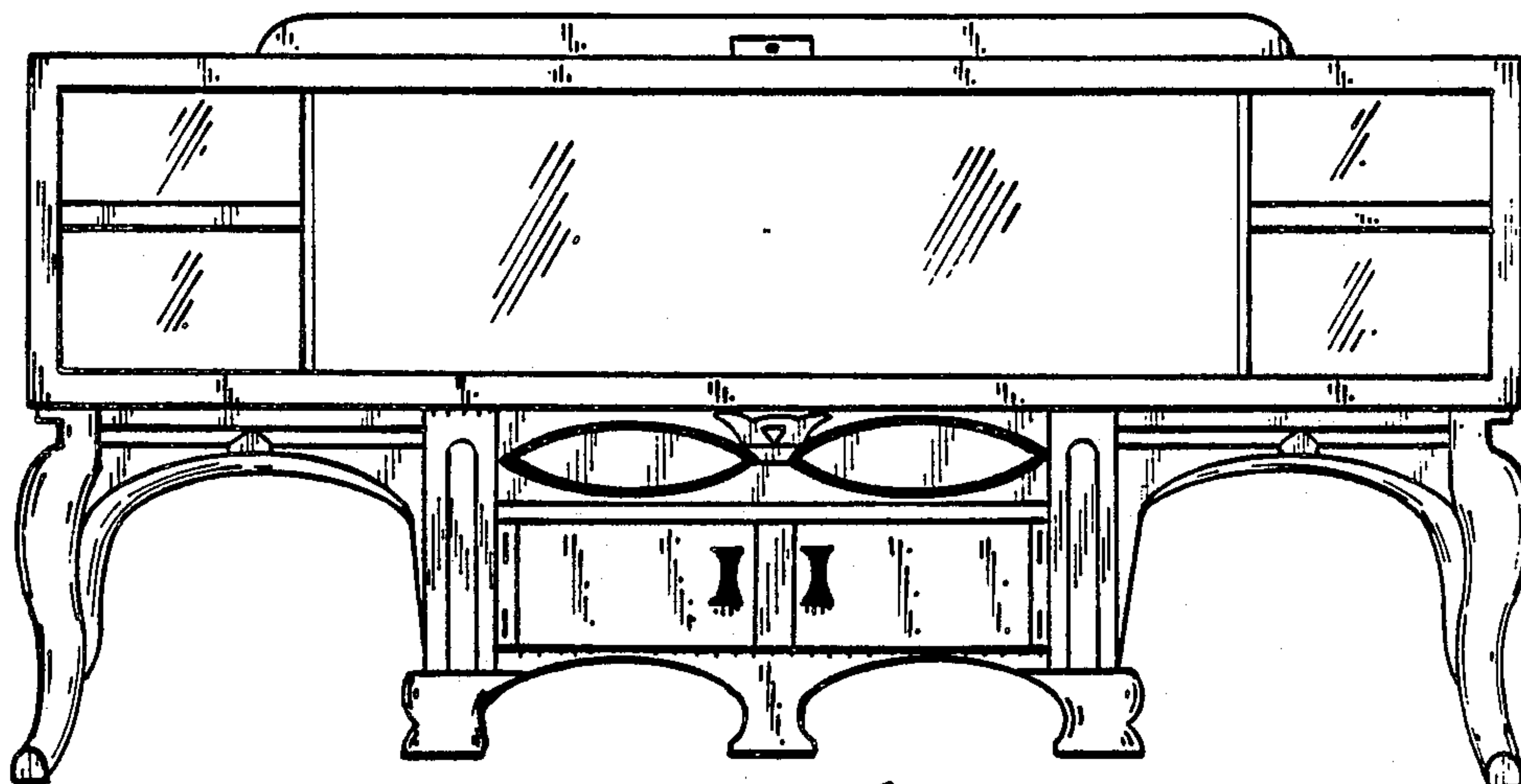

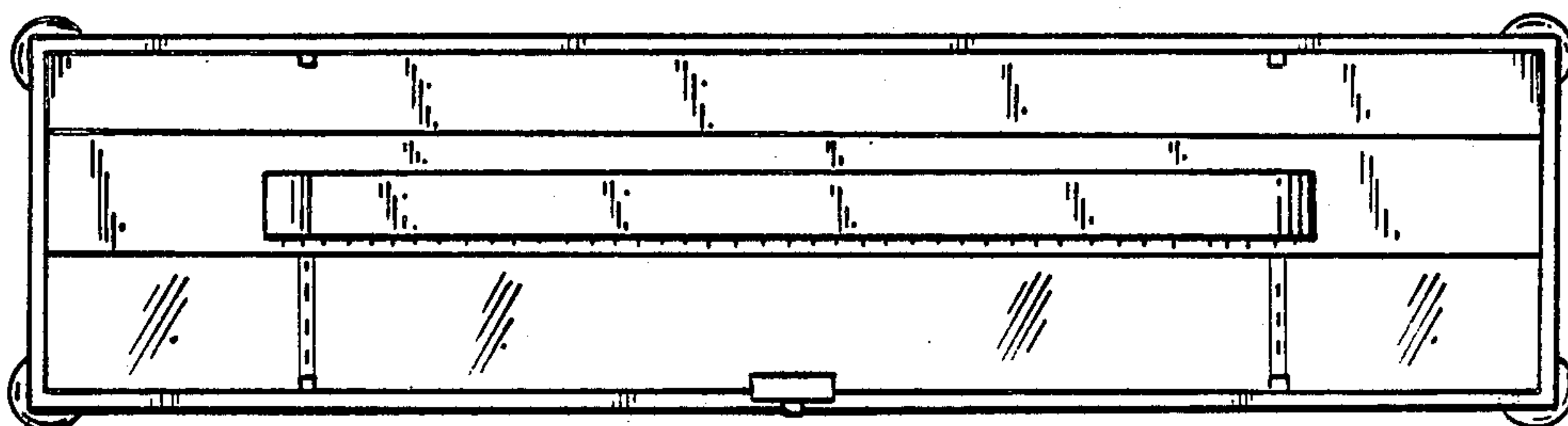

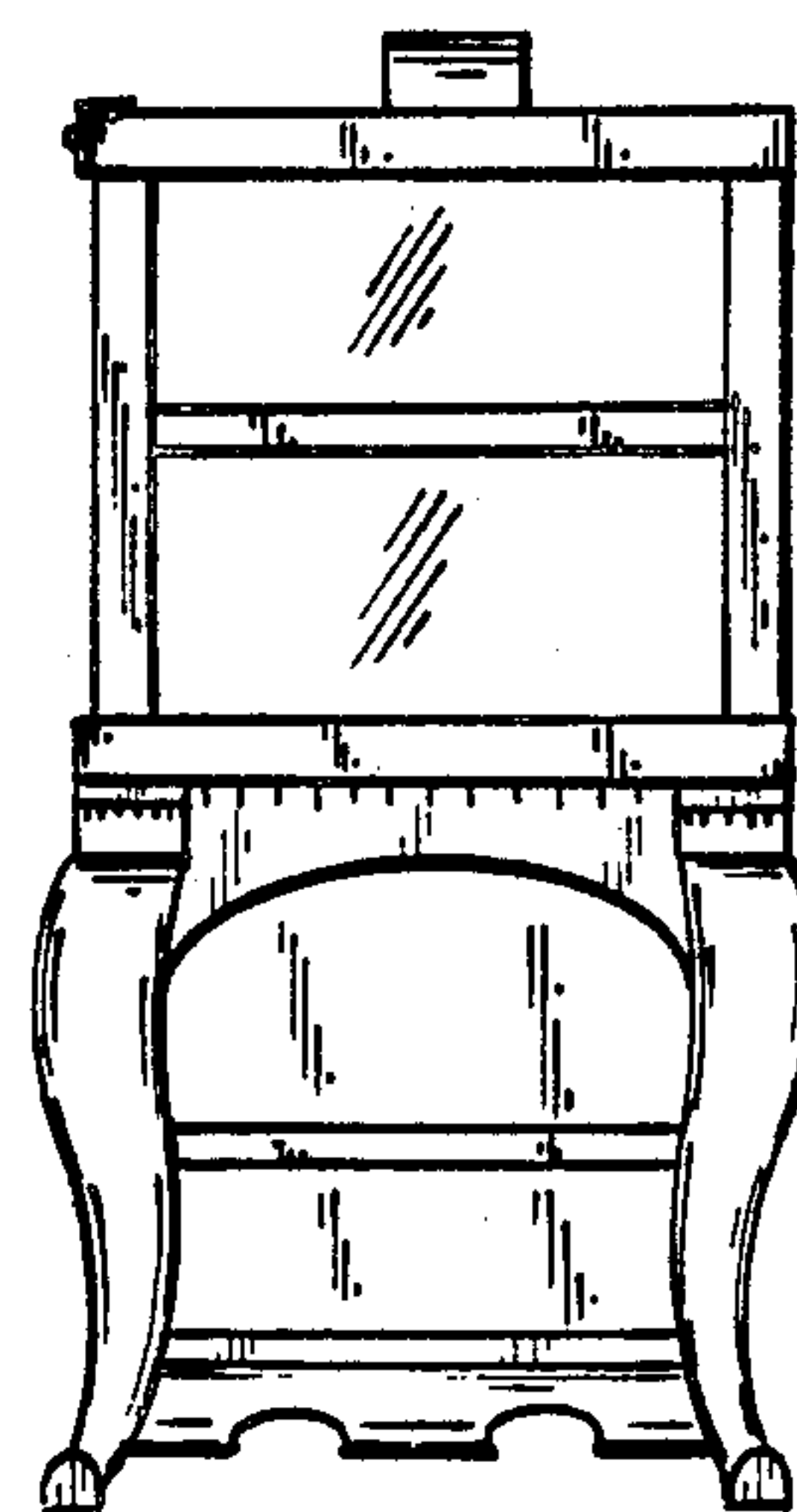
