The cushion members indicated by means of dotted lines in FIGS. 1 and 2 have been shown for illustrative purposes only.

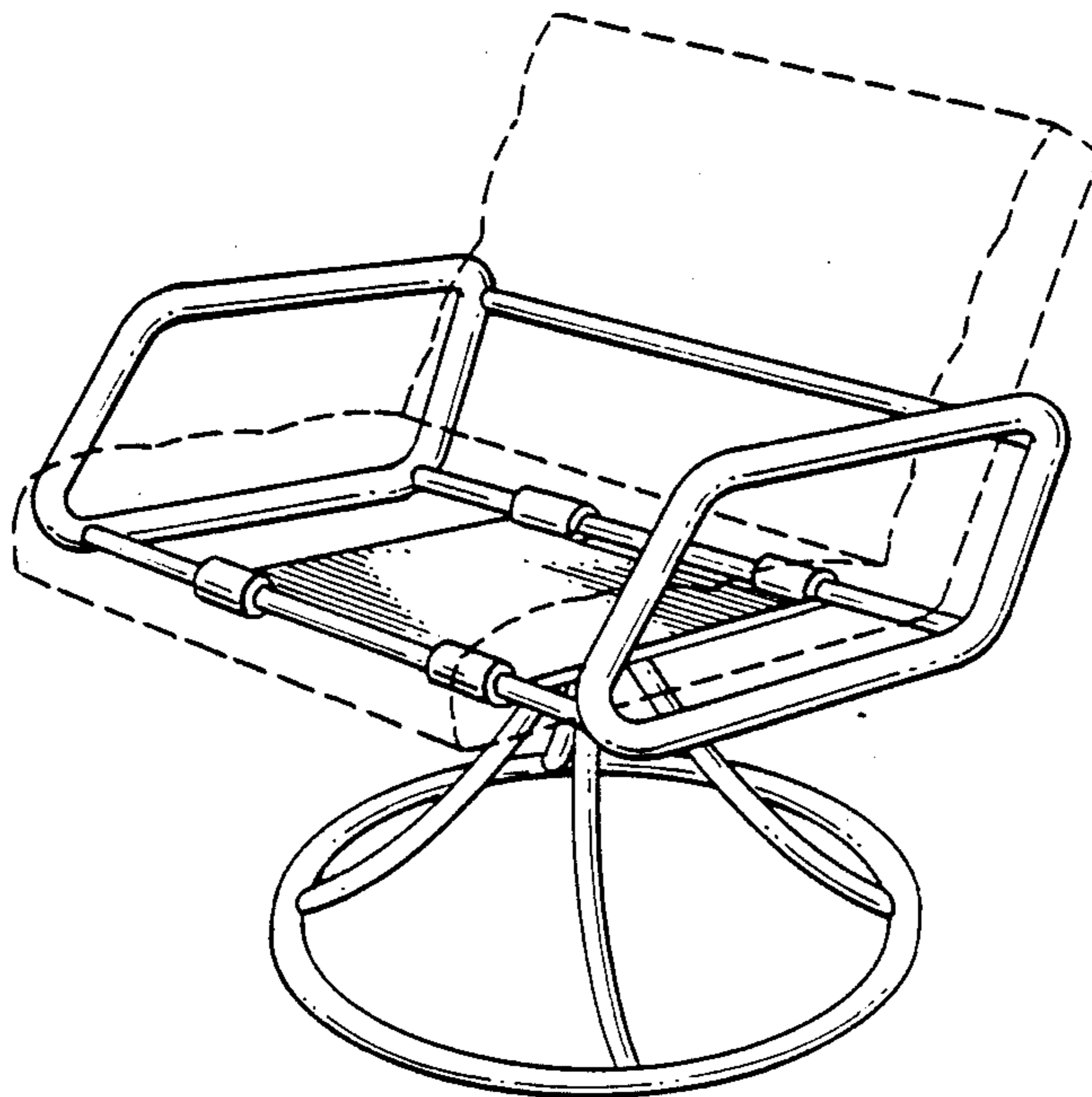

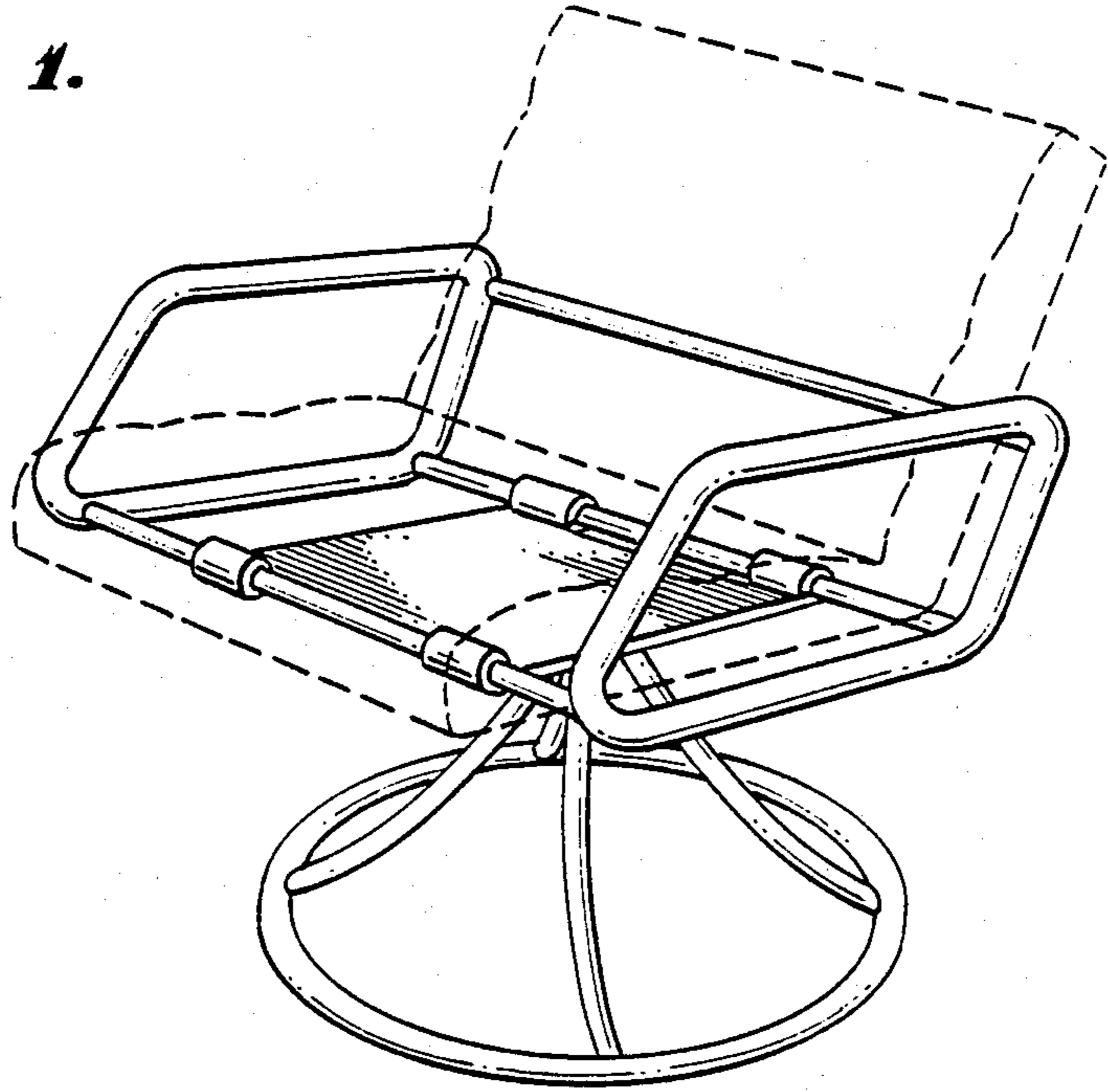
