FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a chair showing my design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

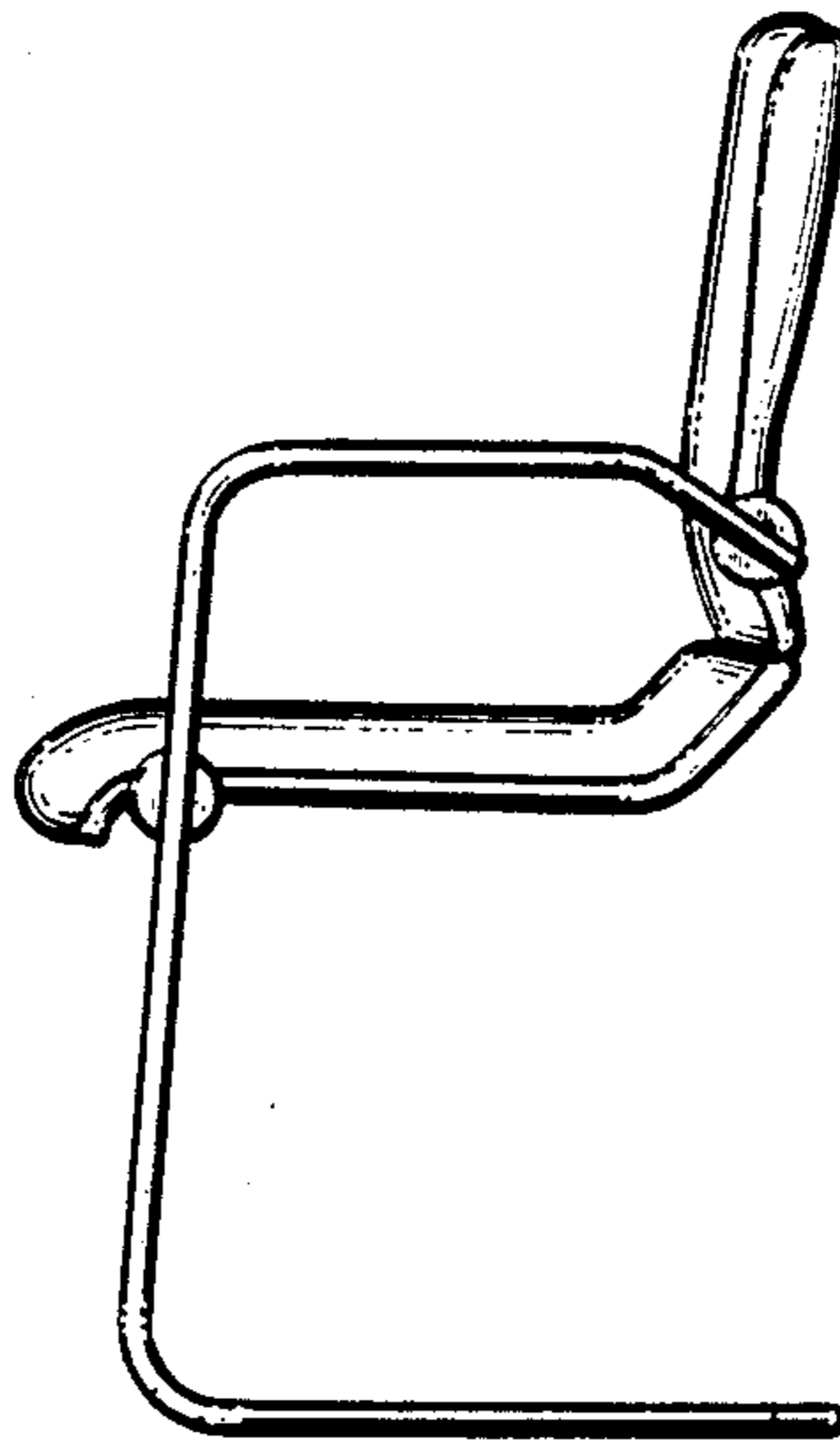

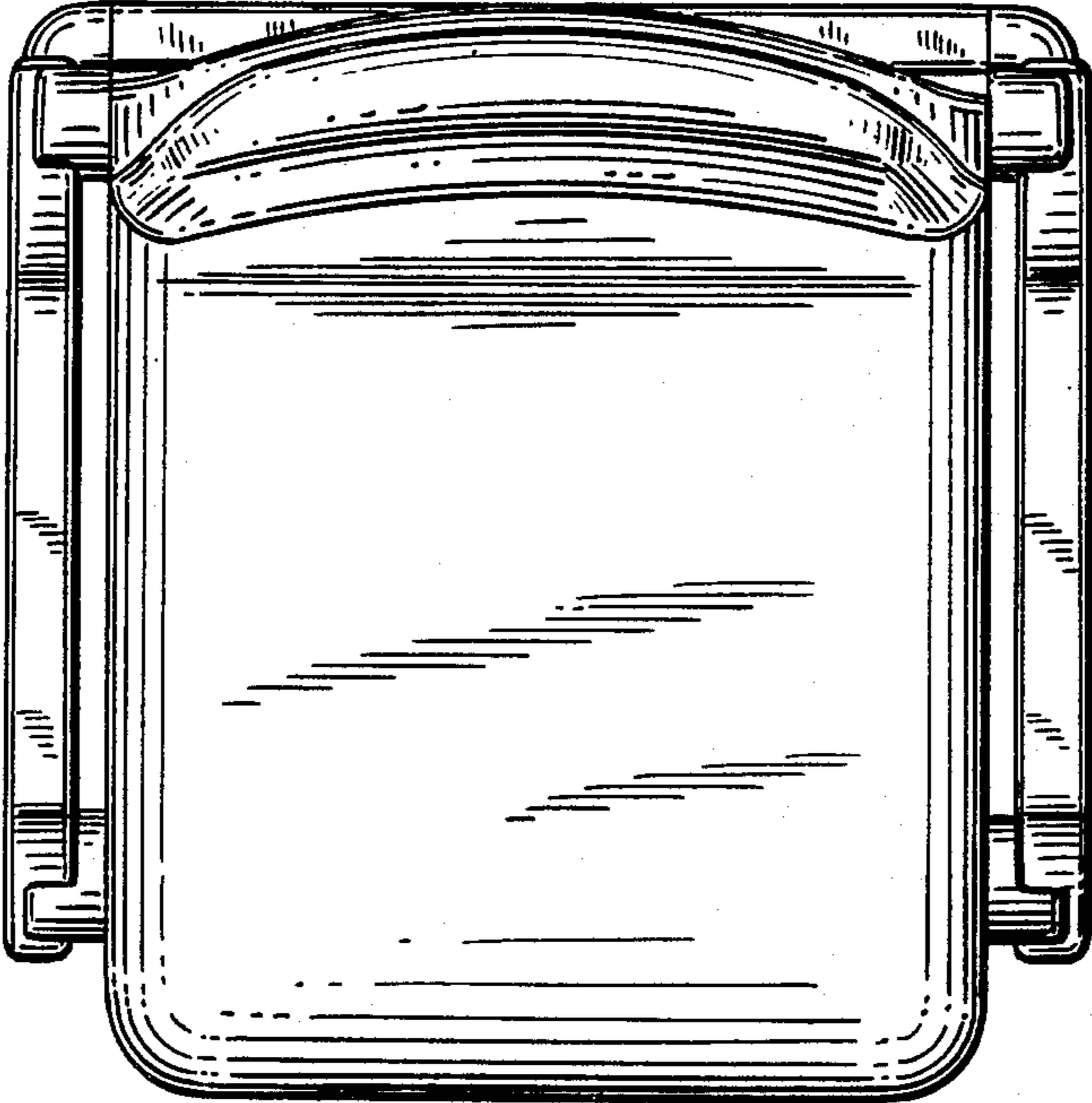

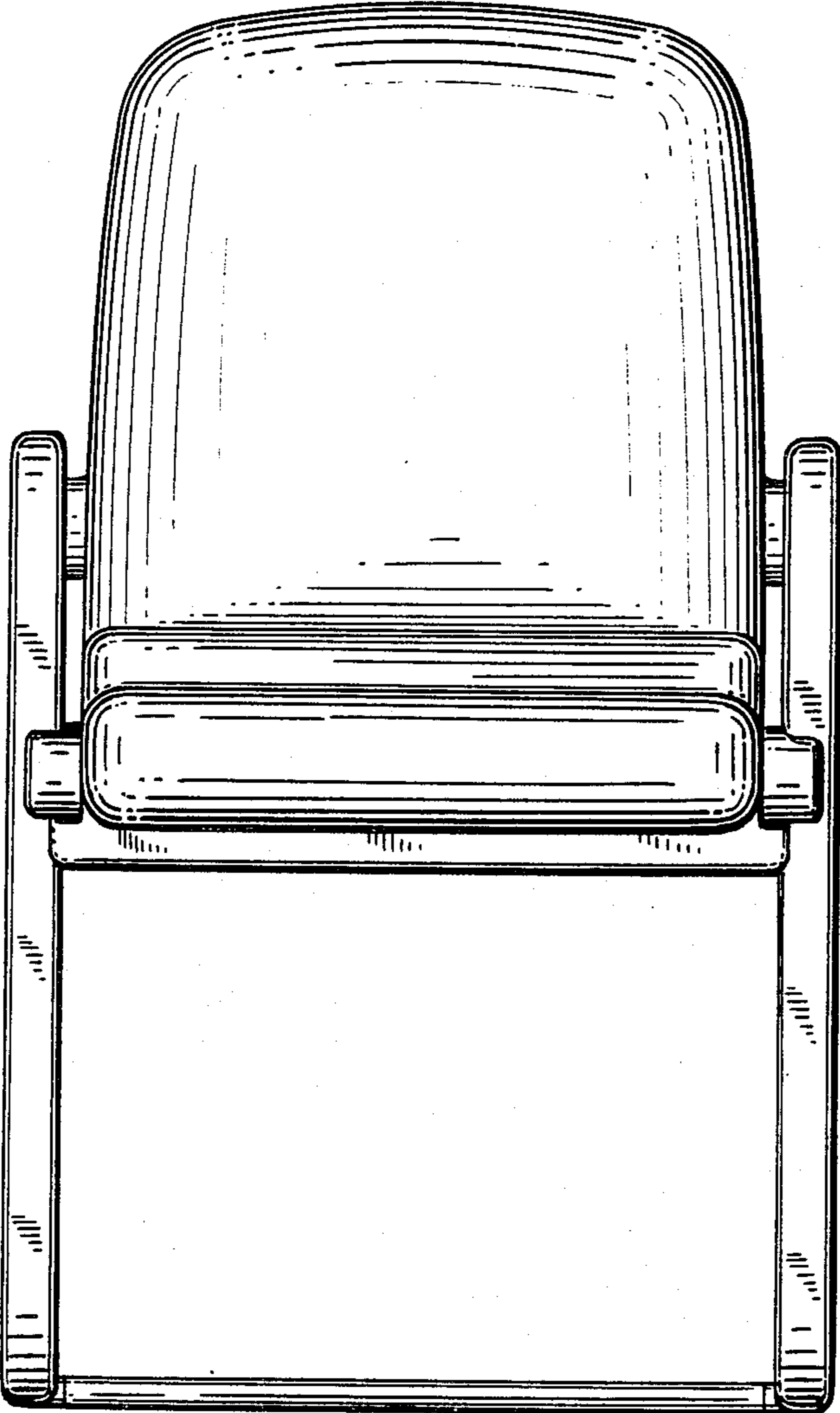

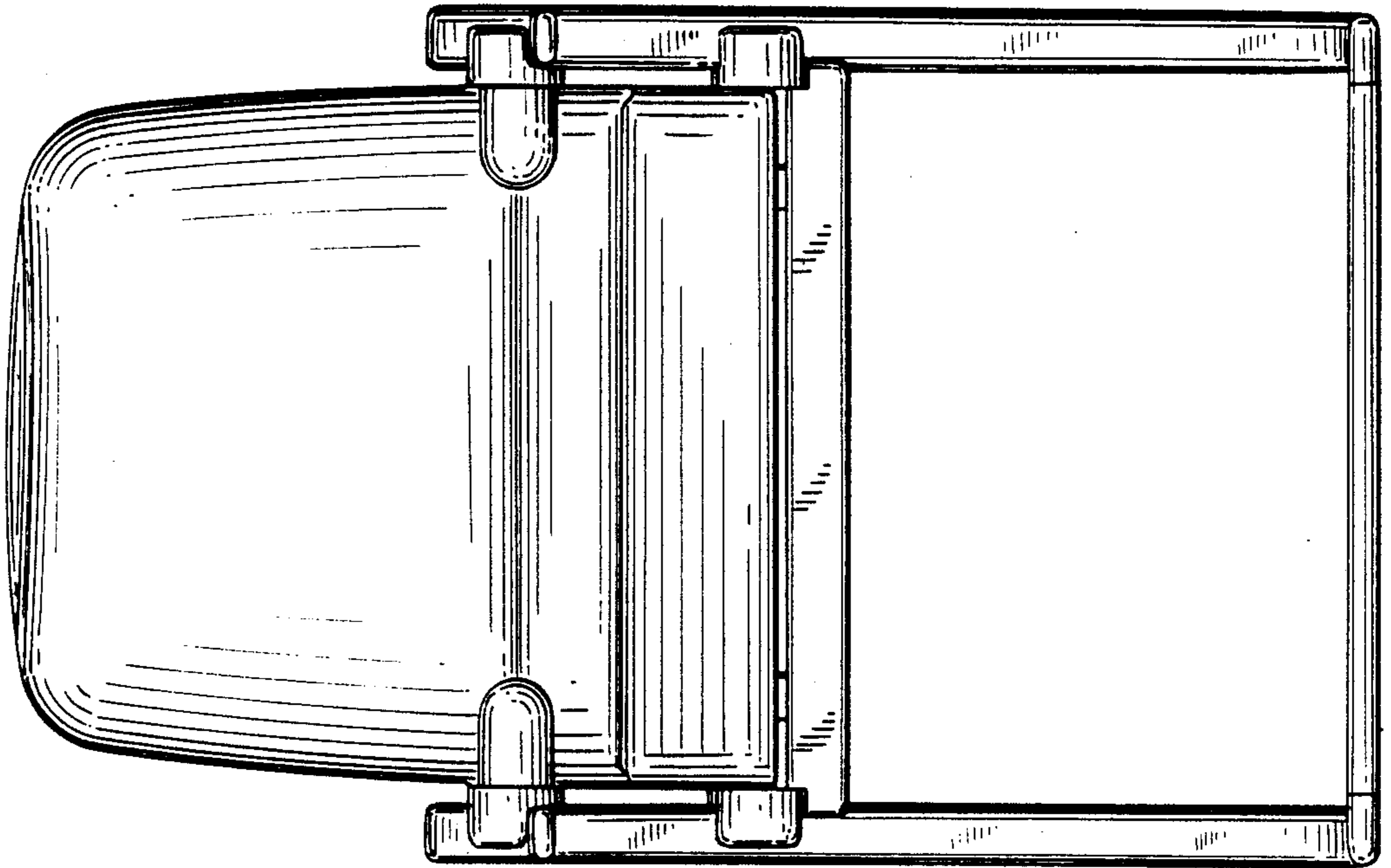

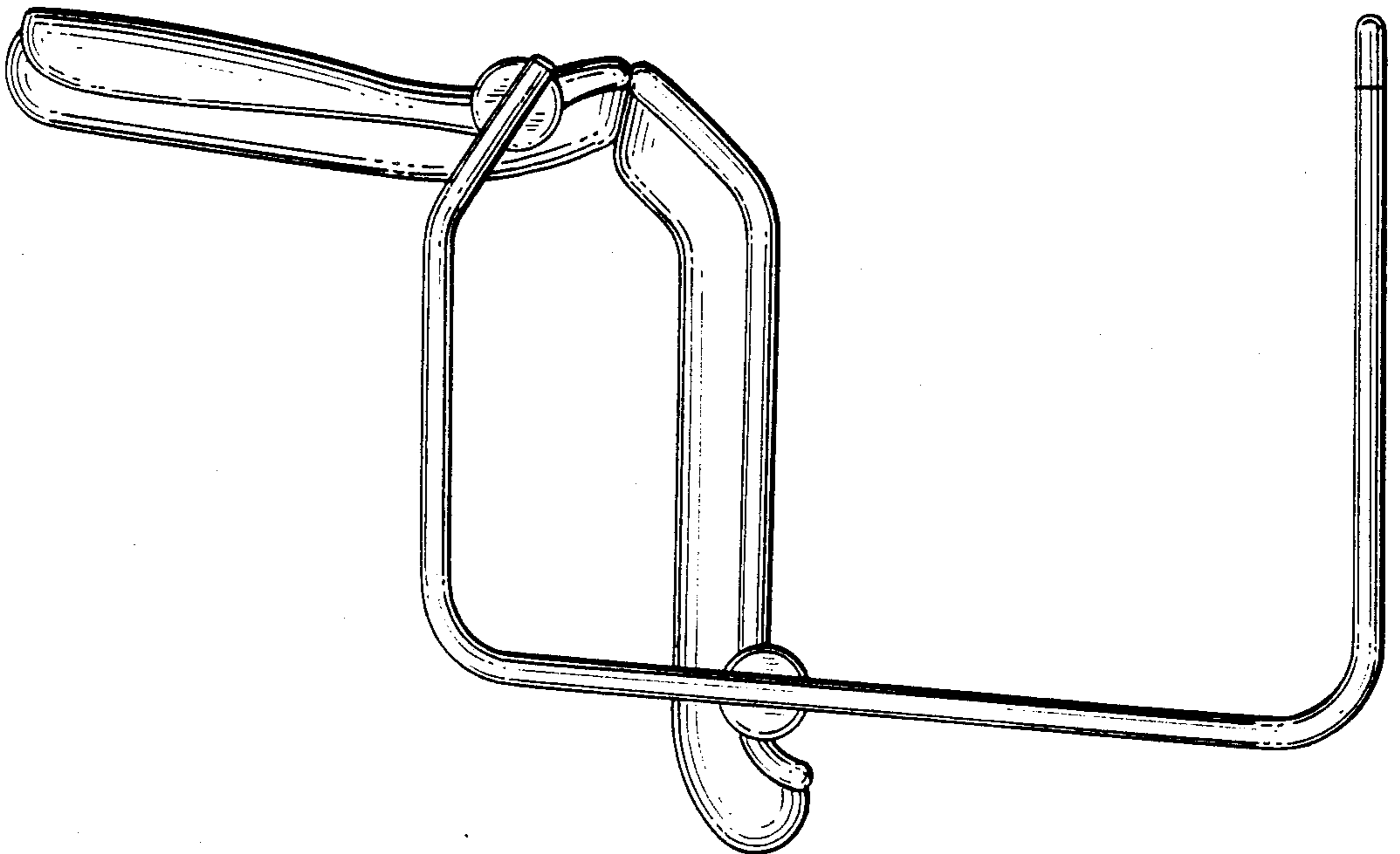
