DESCRIPTION

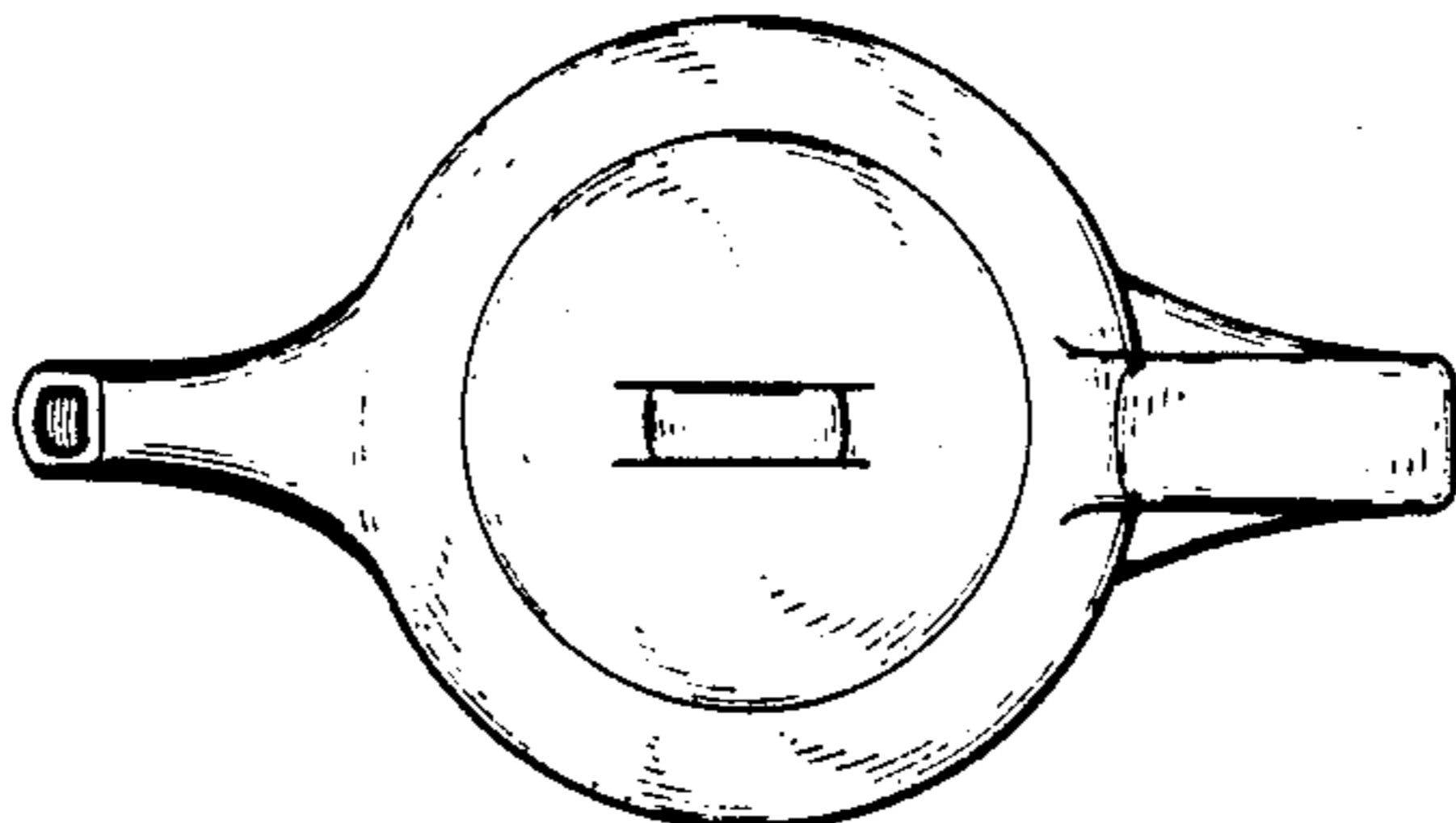
FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a coffee pot showing my new design, the left side elevational view is a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



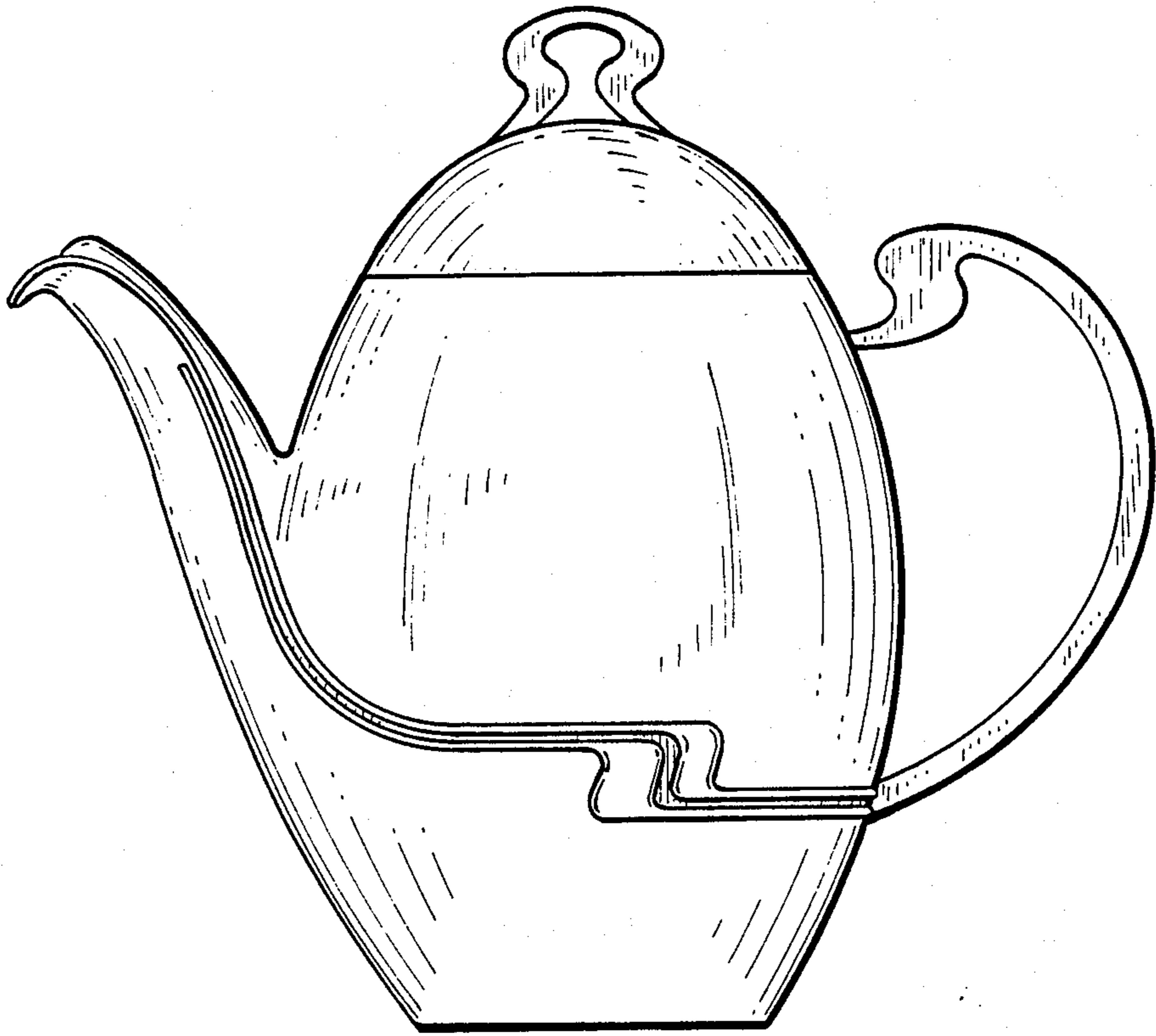

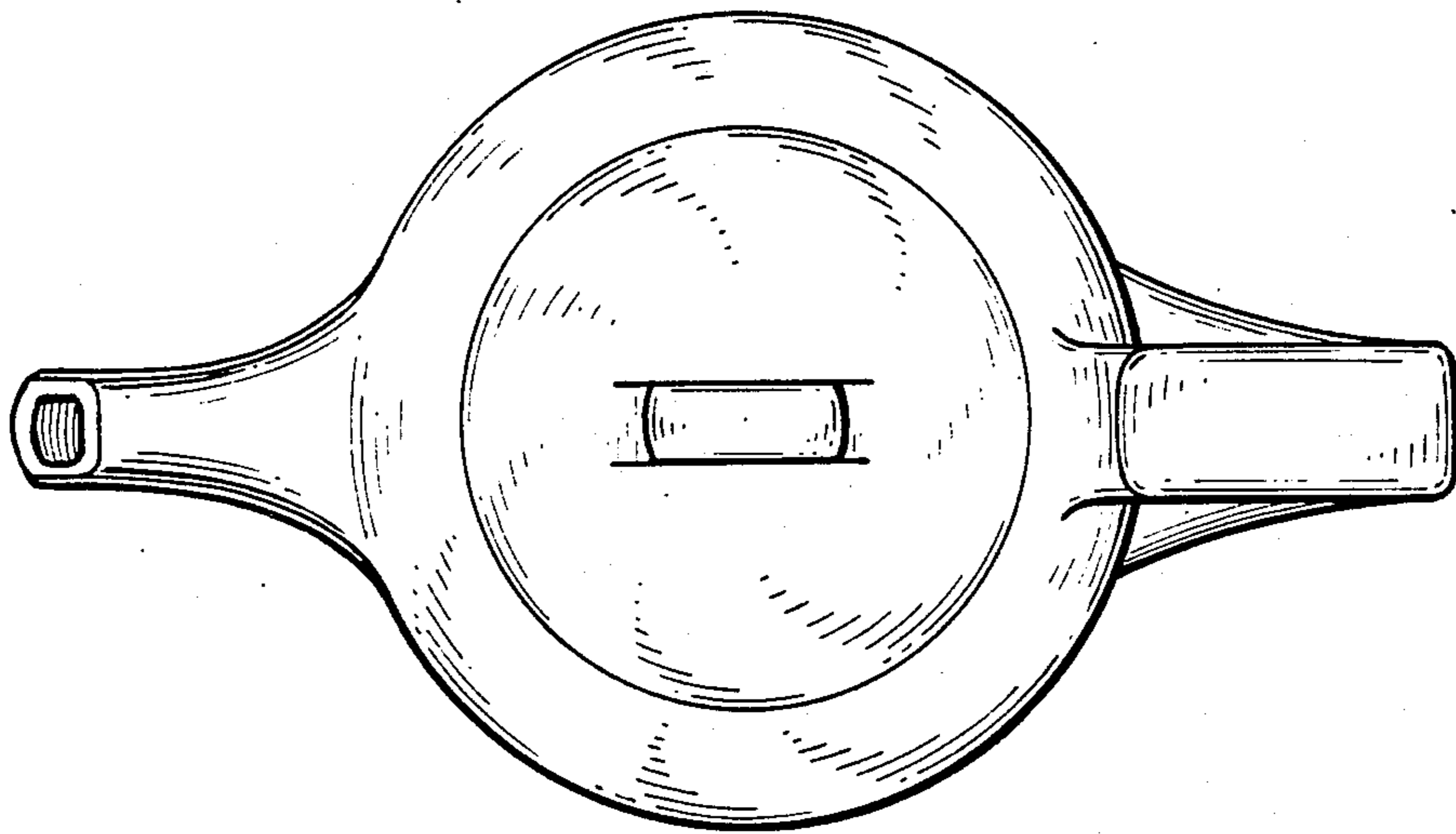

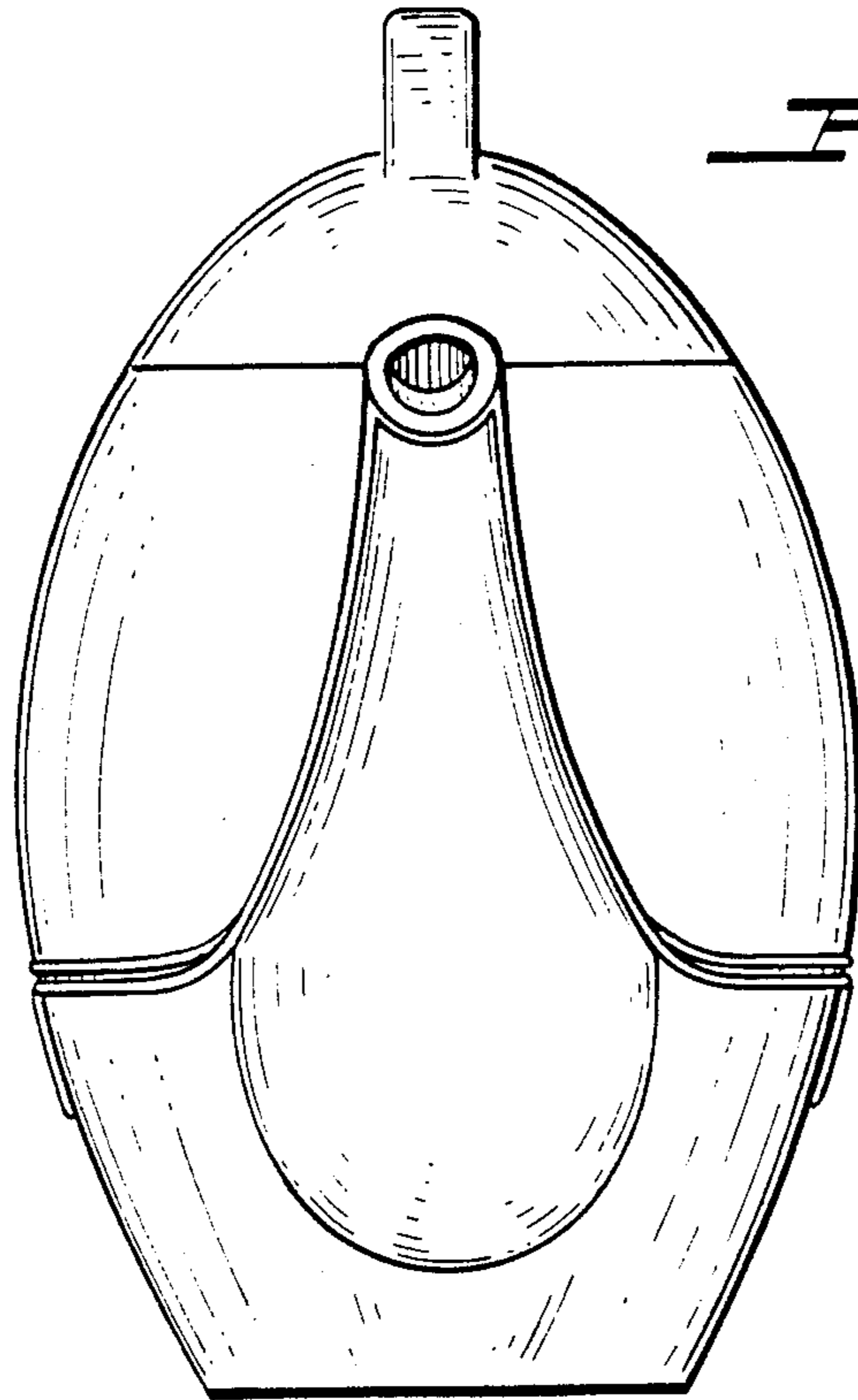

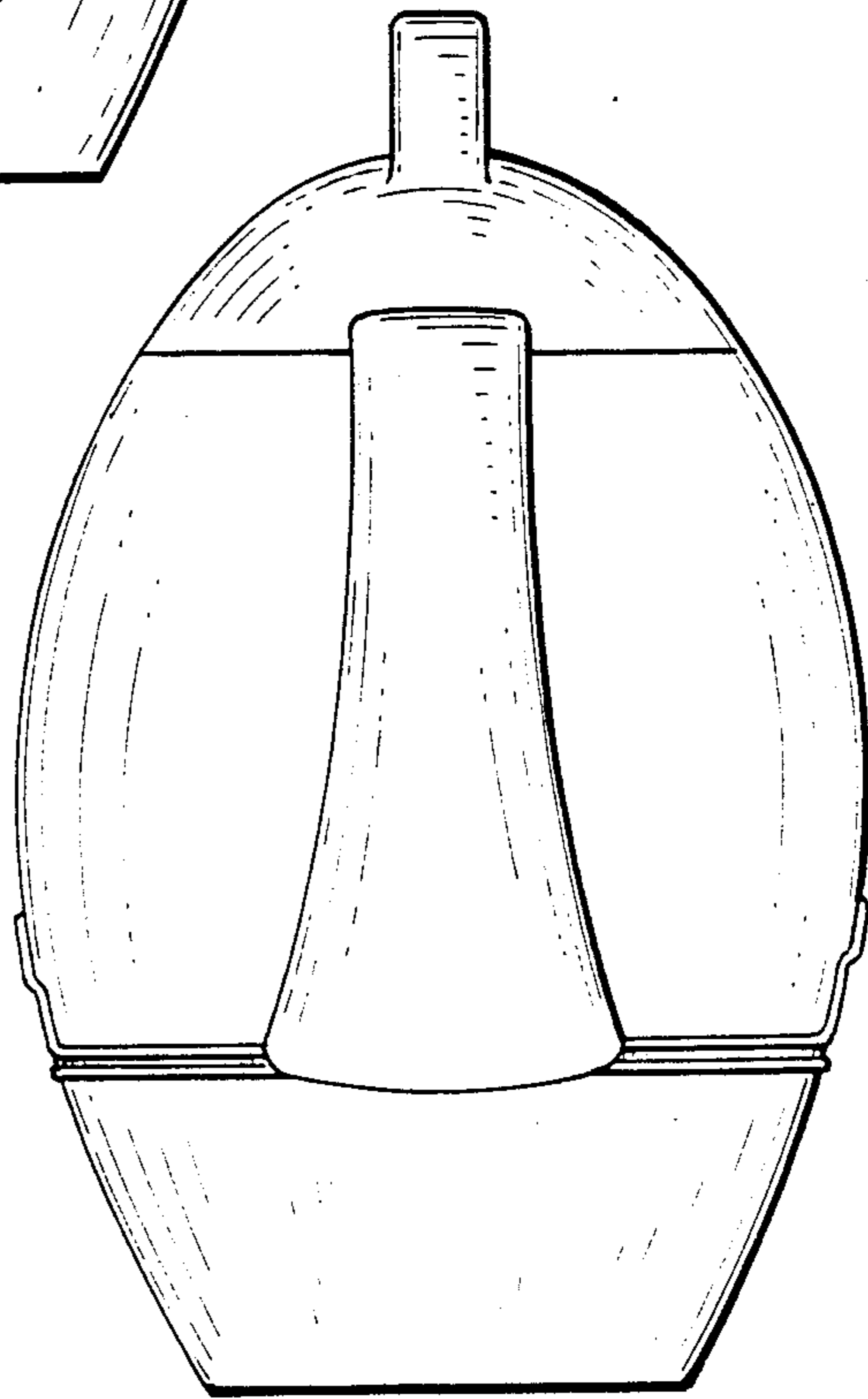
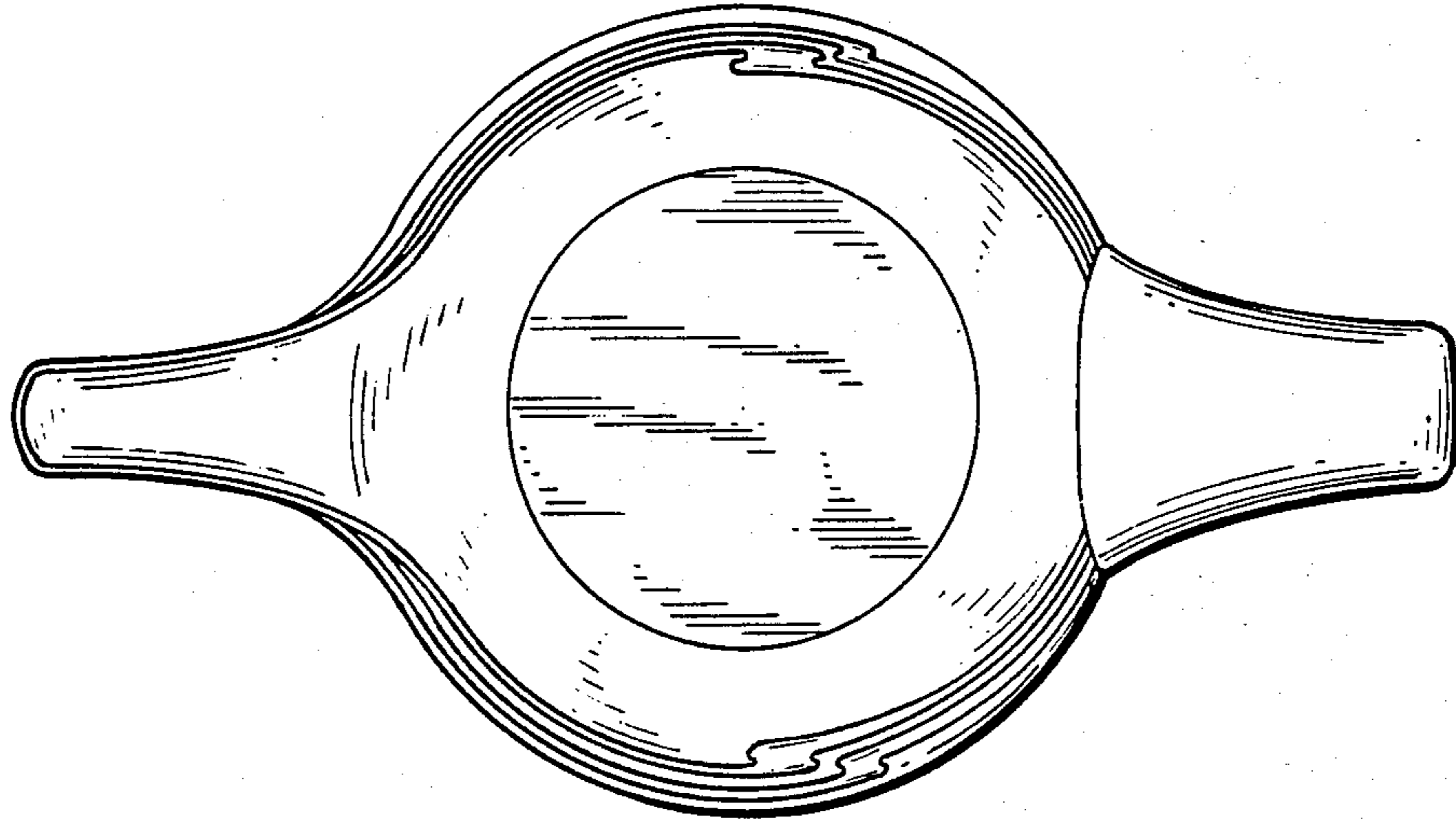
