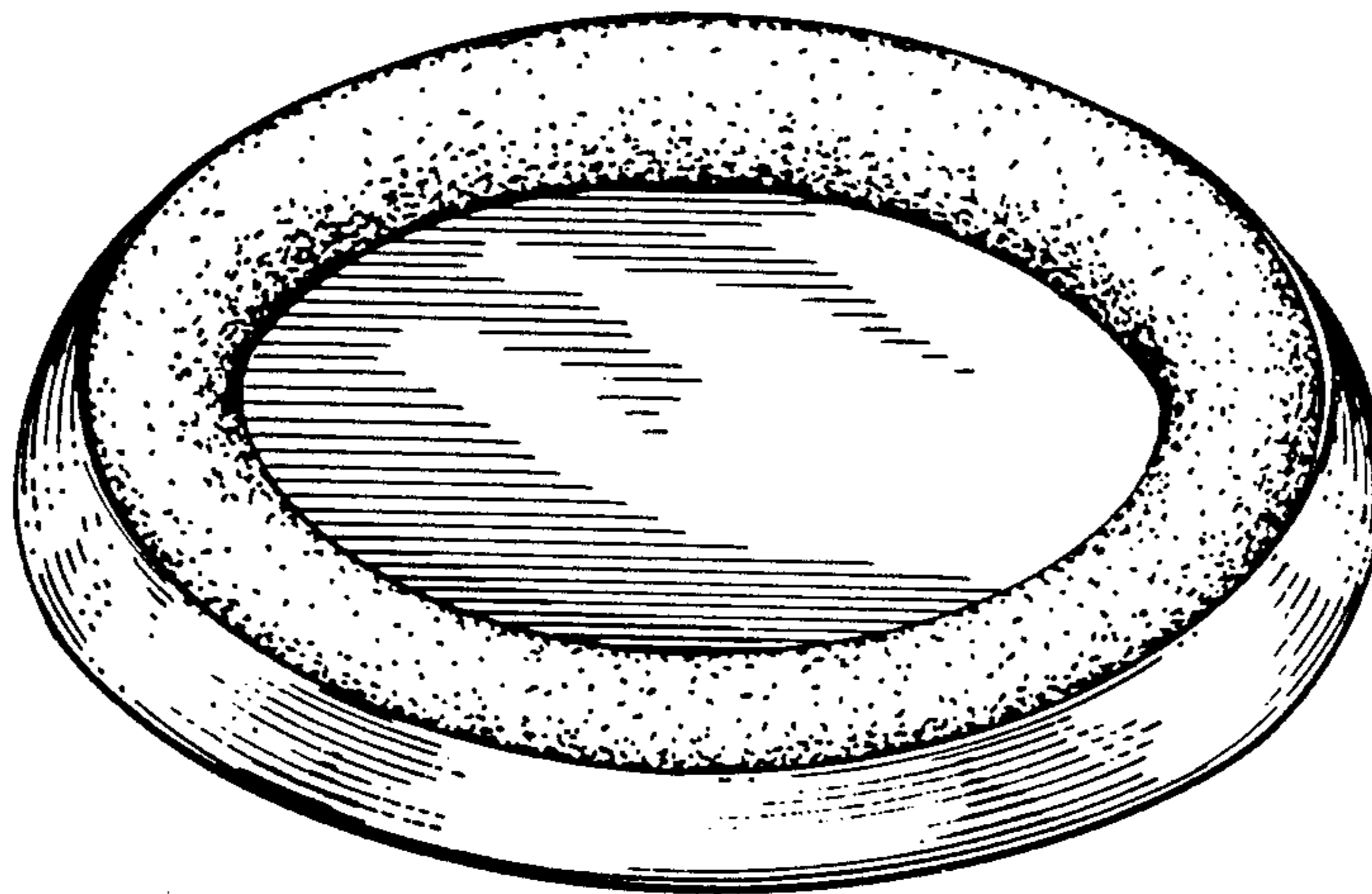

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a laboratory flask support, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a laboratory support, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof. The bottom of the laboratory flask support is substantially plain and unornamented.



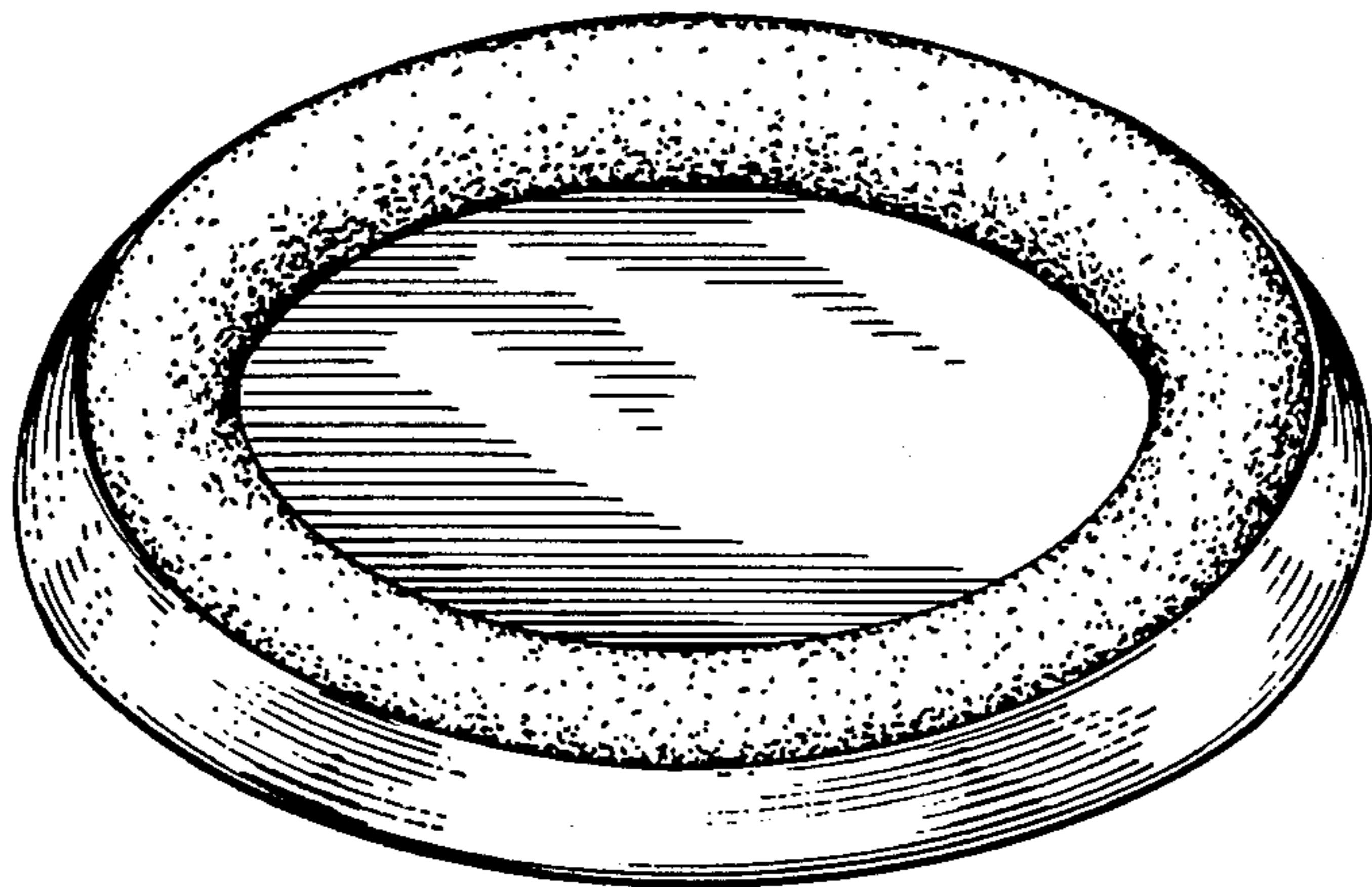

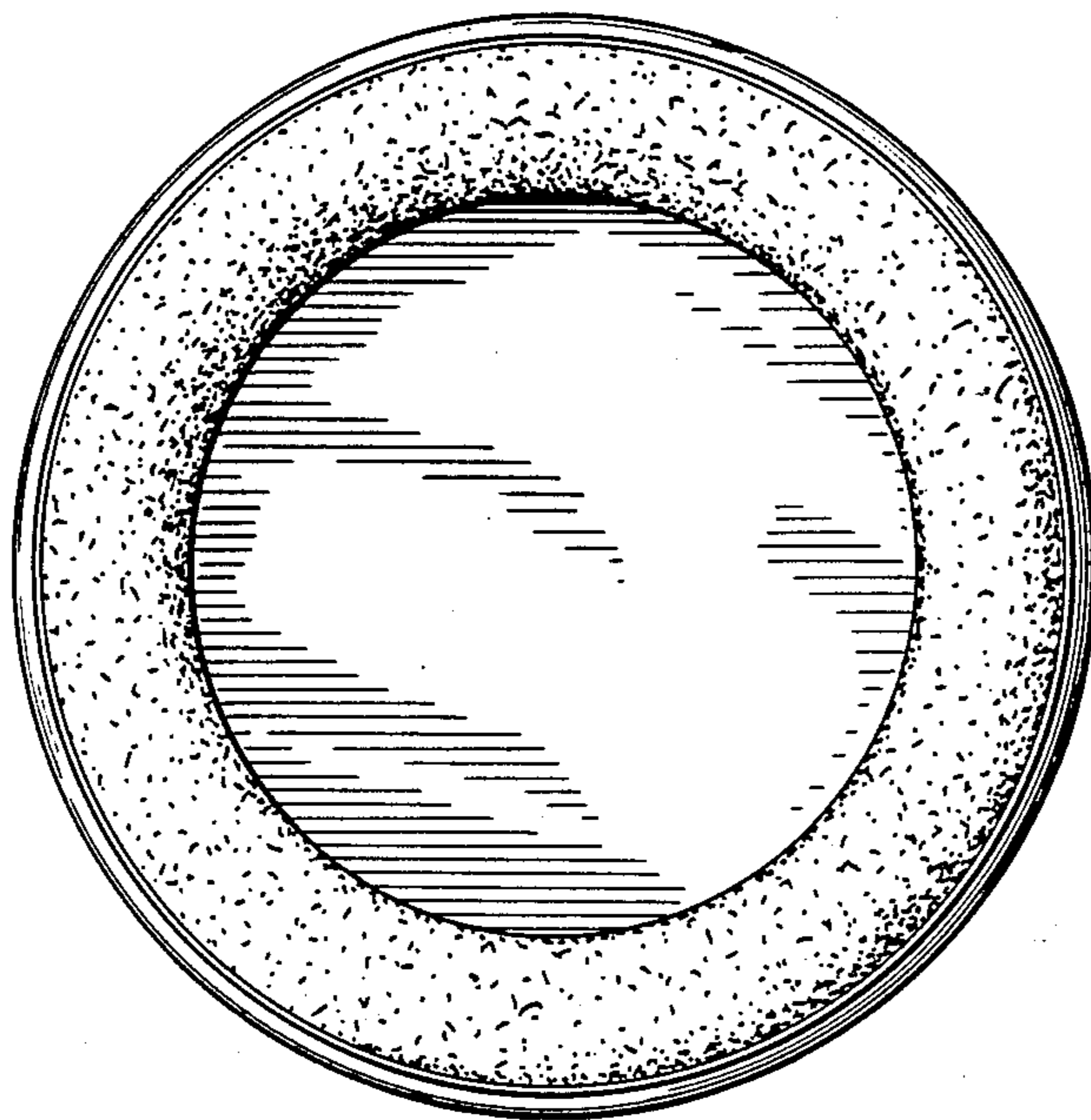

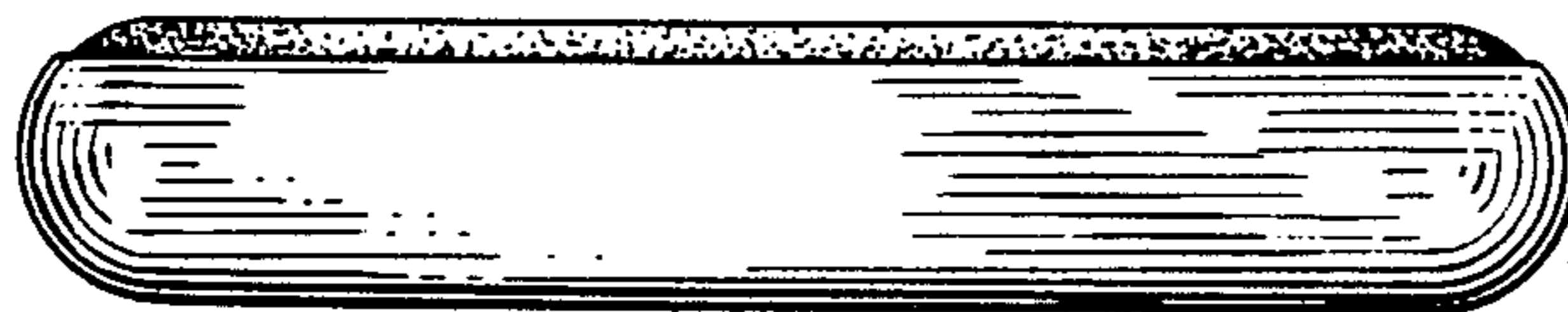
