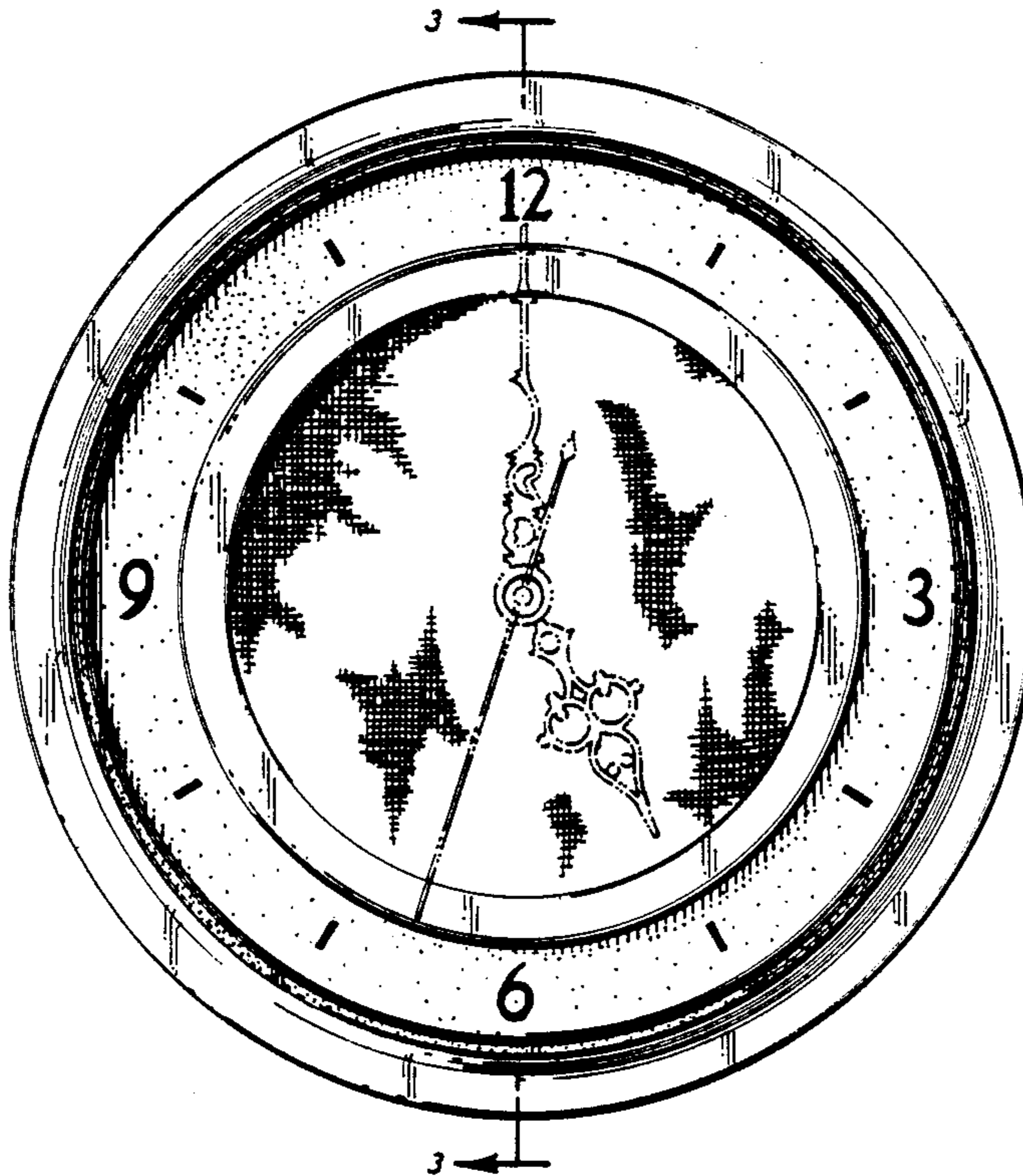

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for wall clock, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wall clock showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a typical side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 3-3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showings of the hands and mechanism are environment only and form no part of the claimed design.



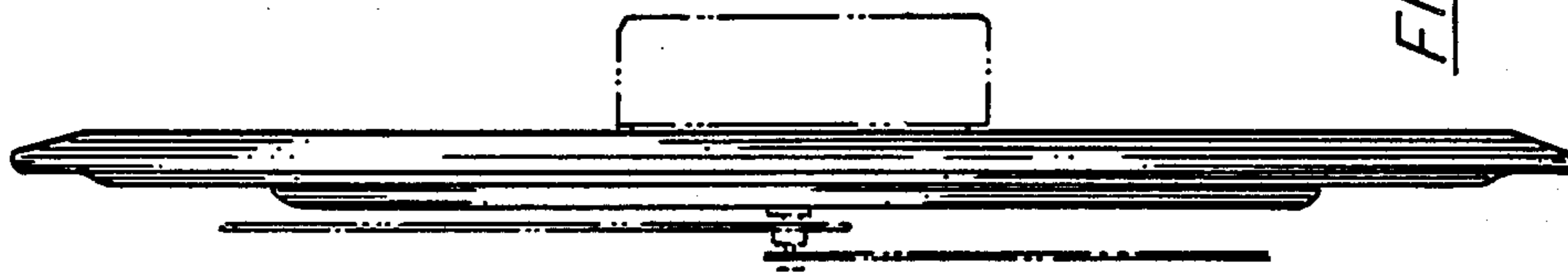

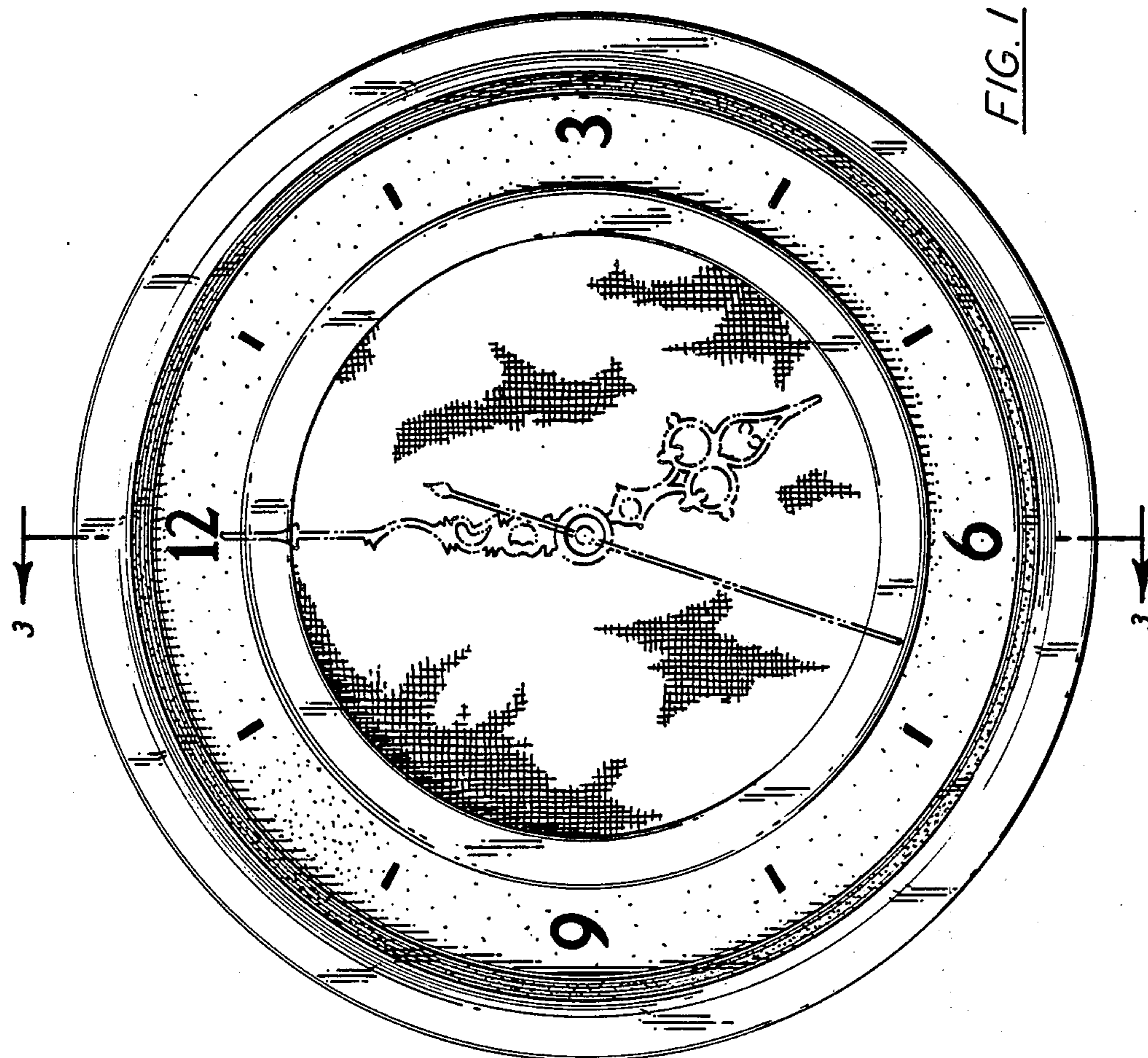
