DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a flashlight showing
my new design;

with the connector prongs extended for recharging.

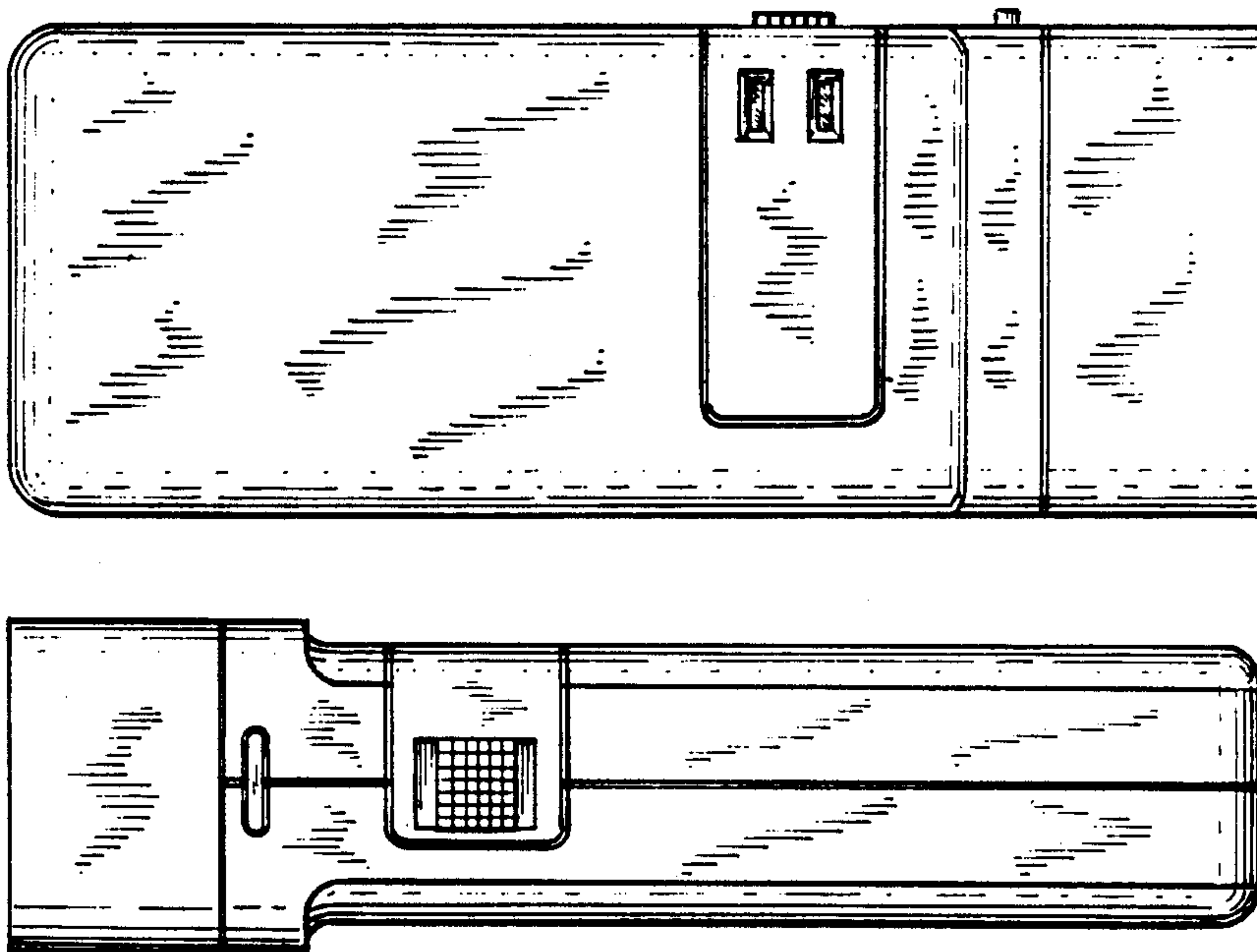

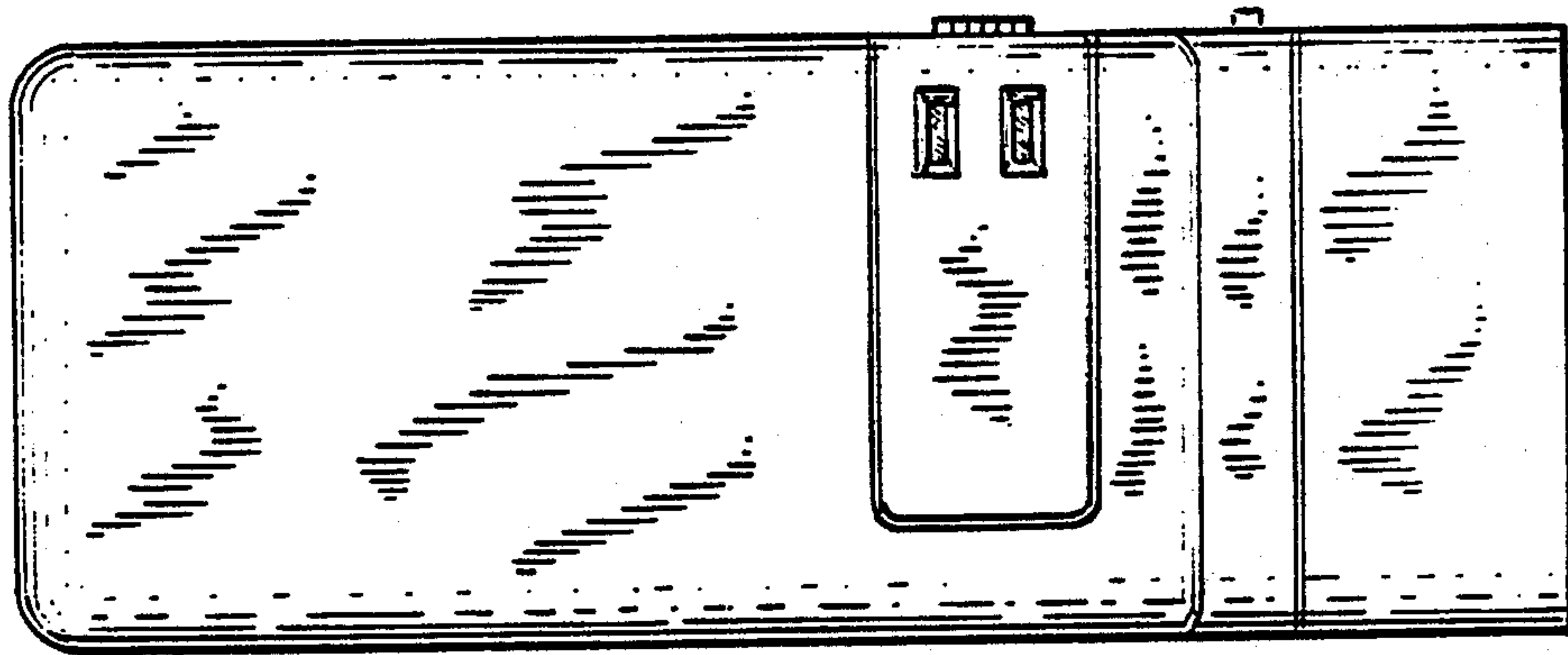

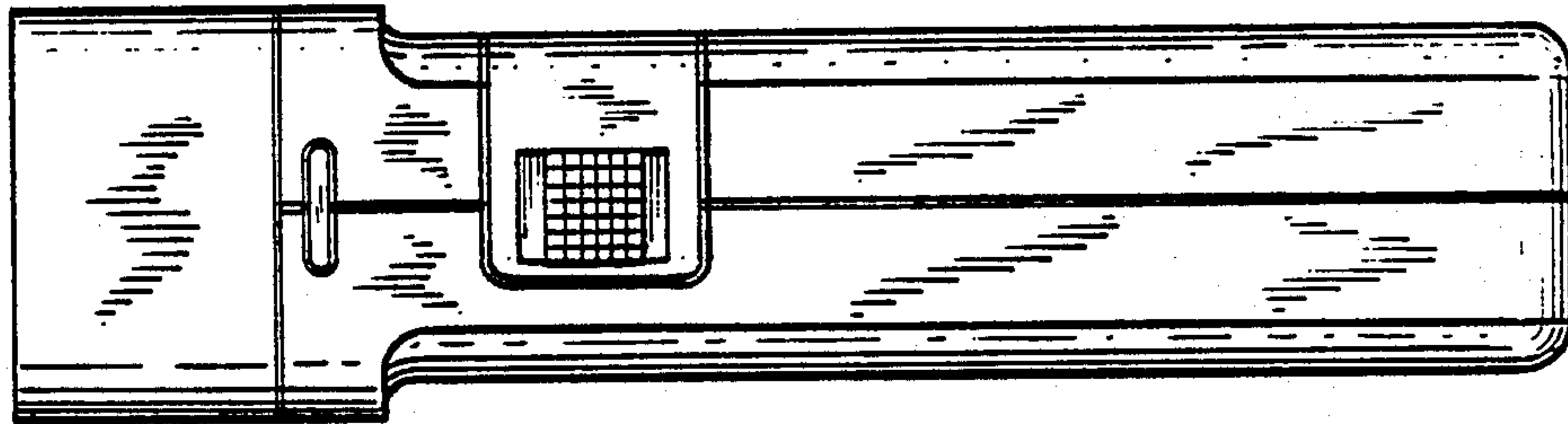

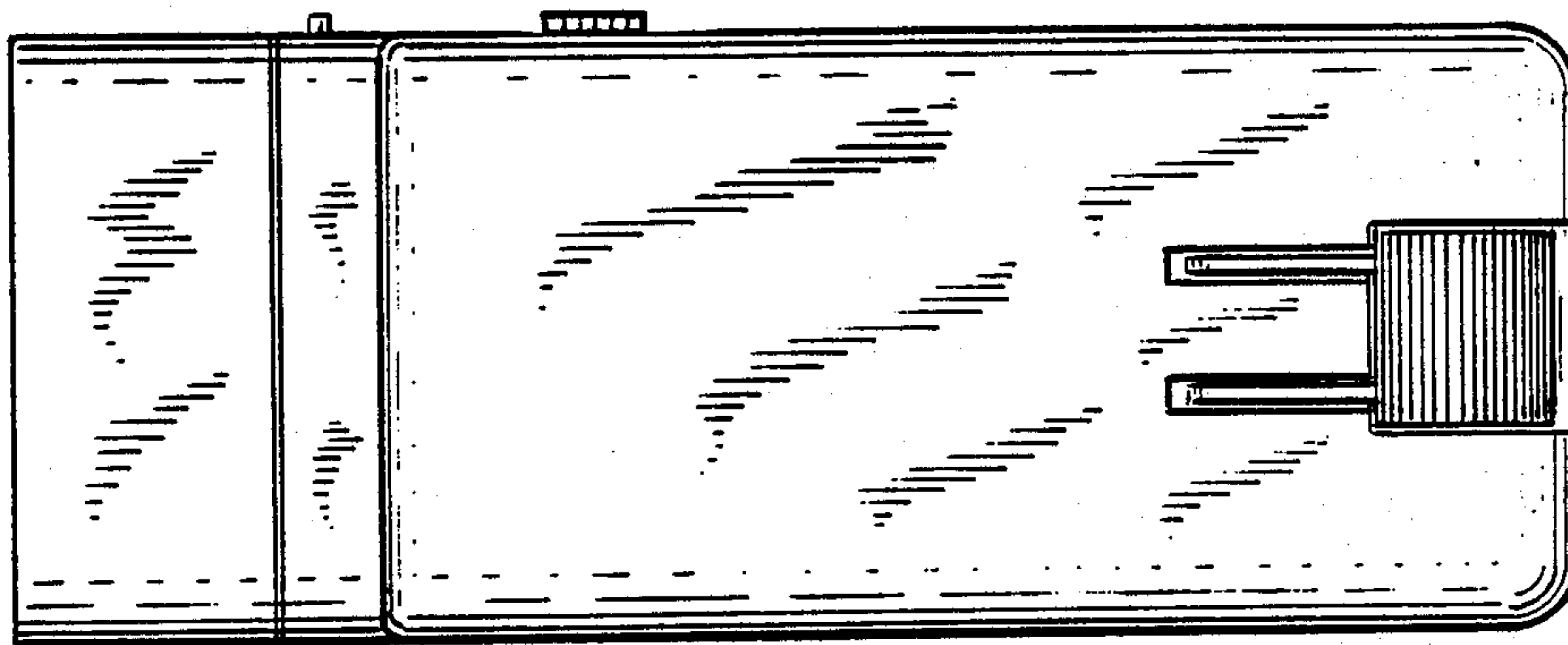

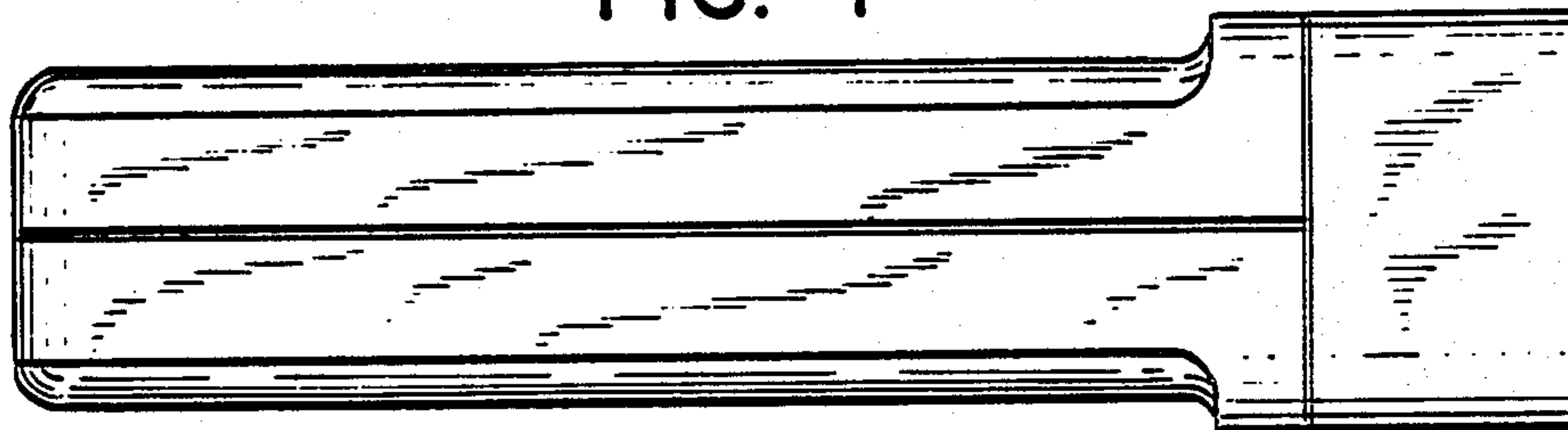

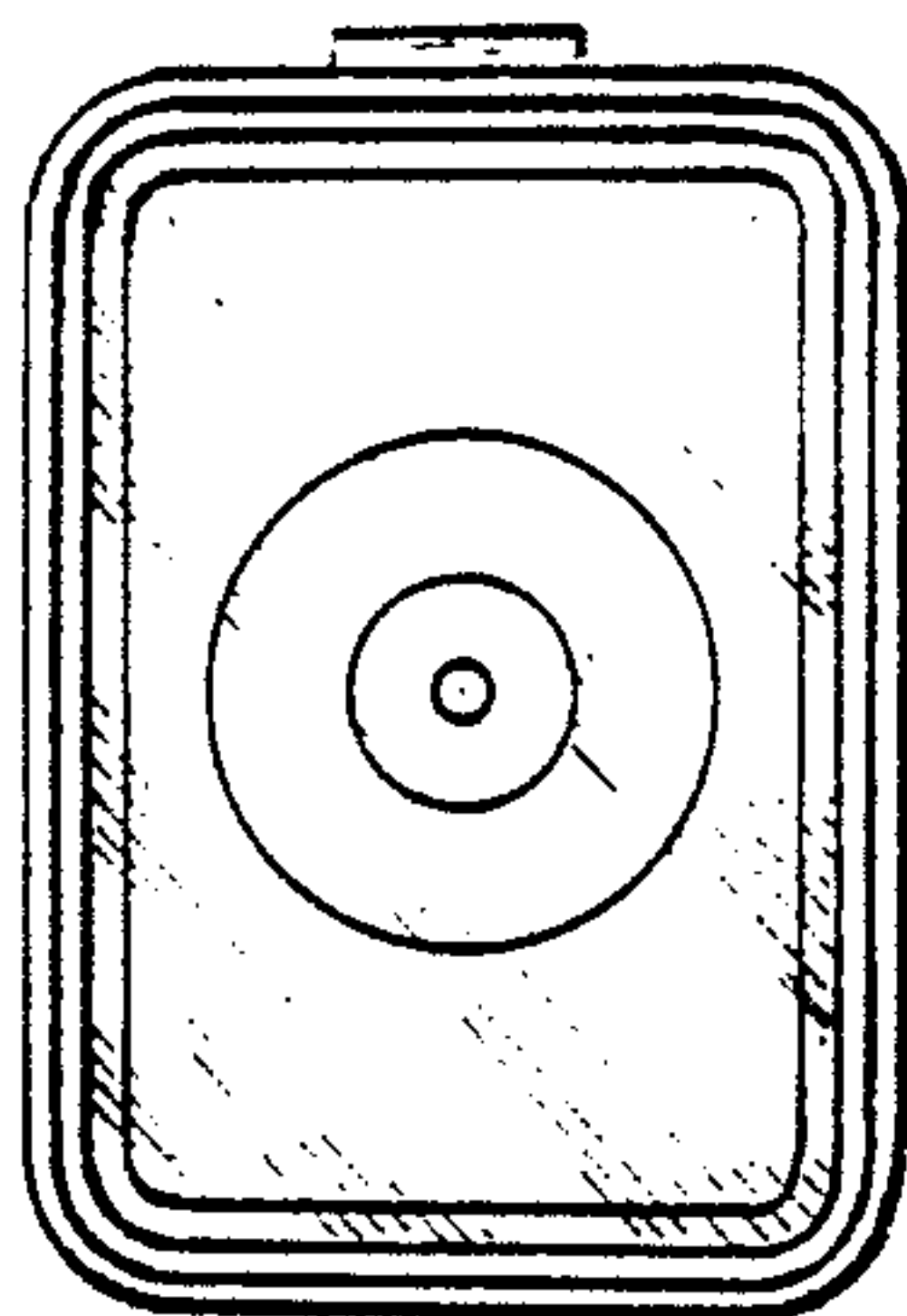

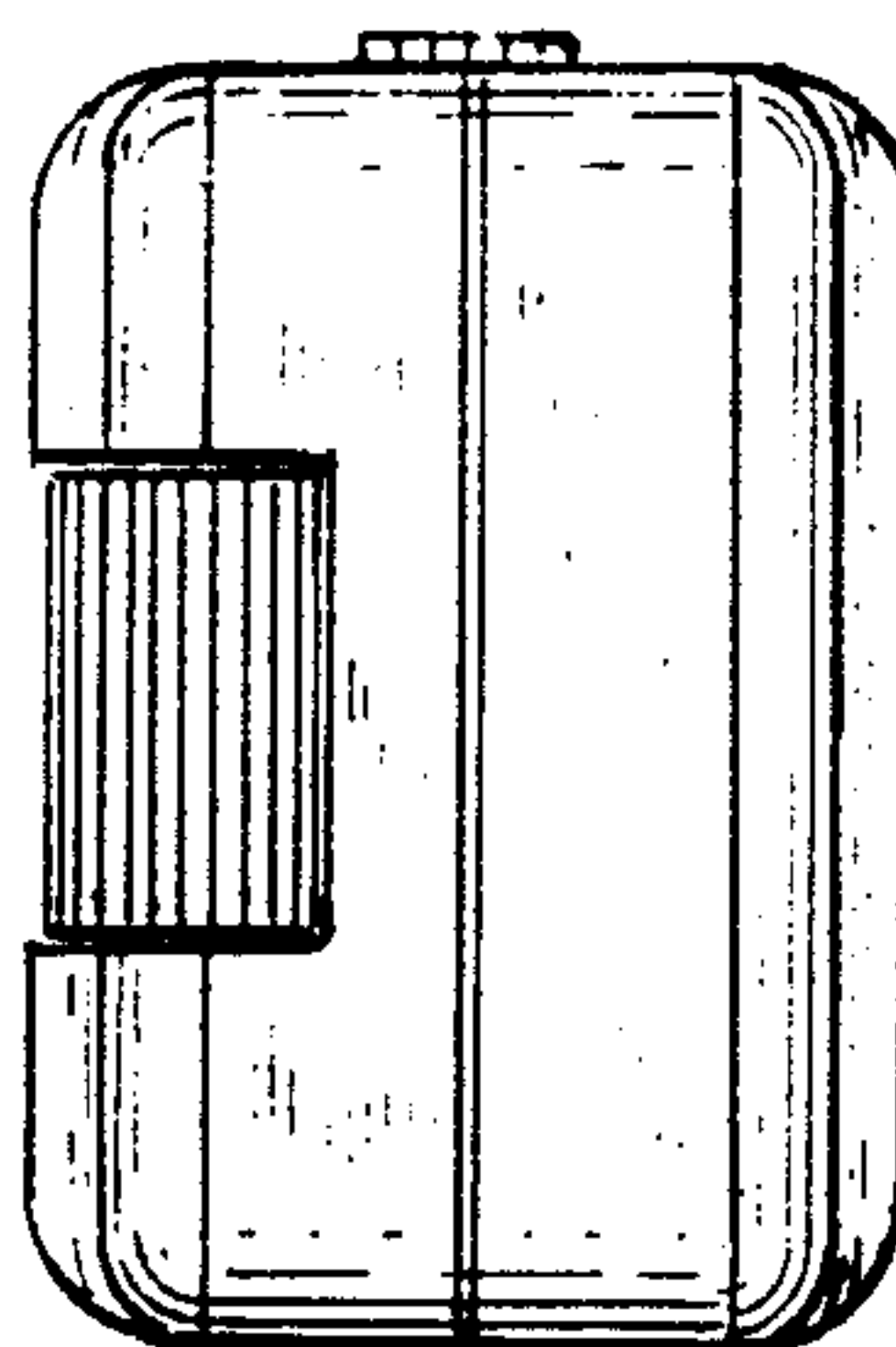

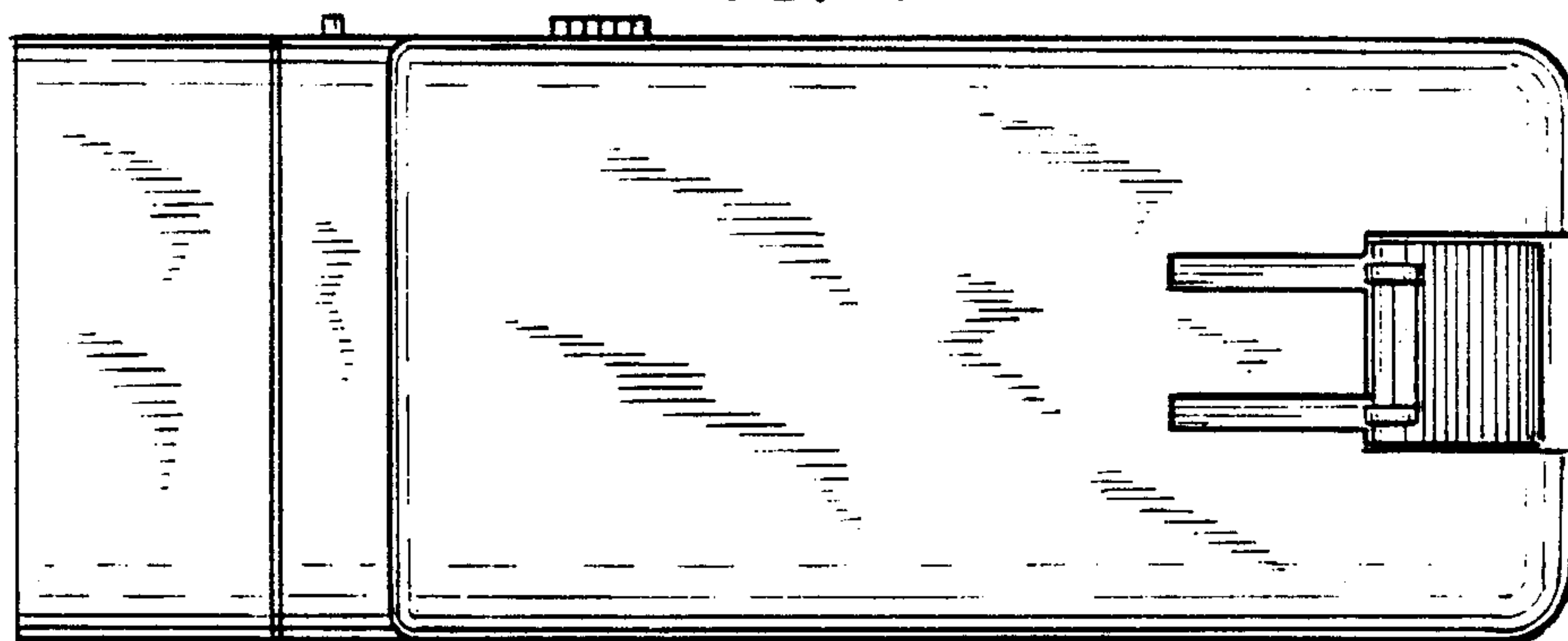

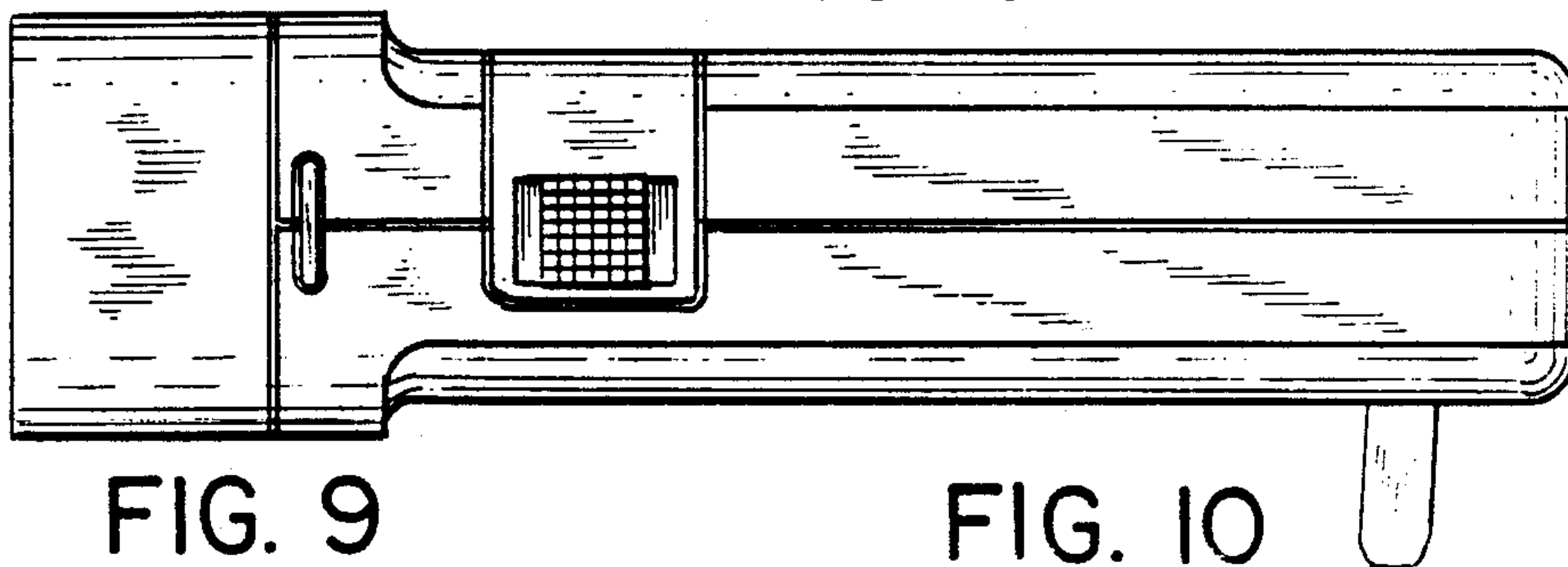

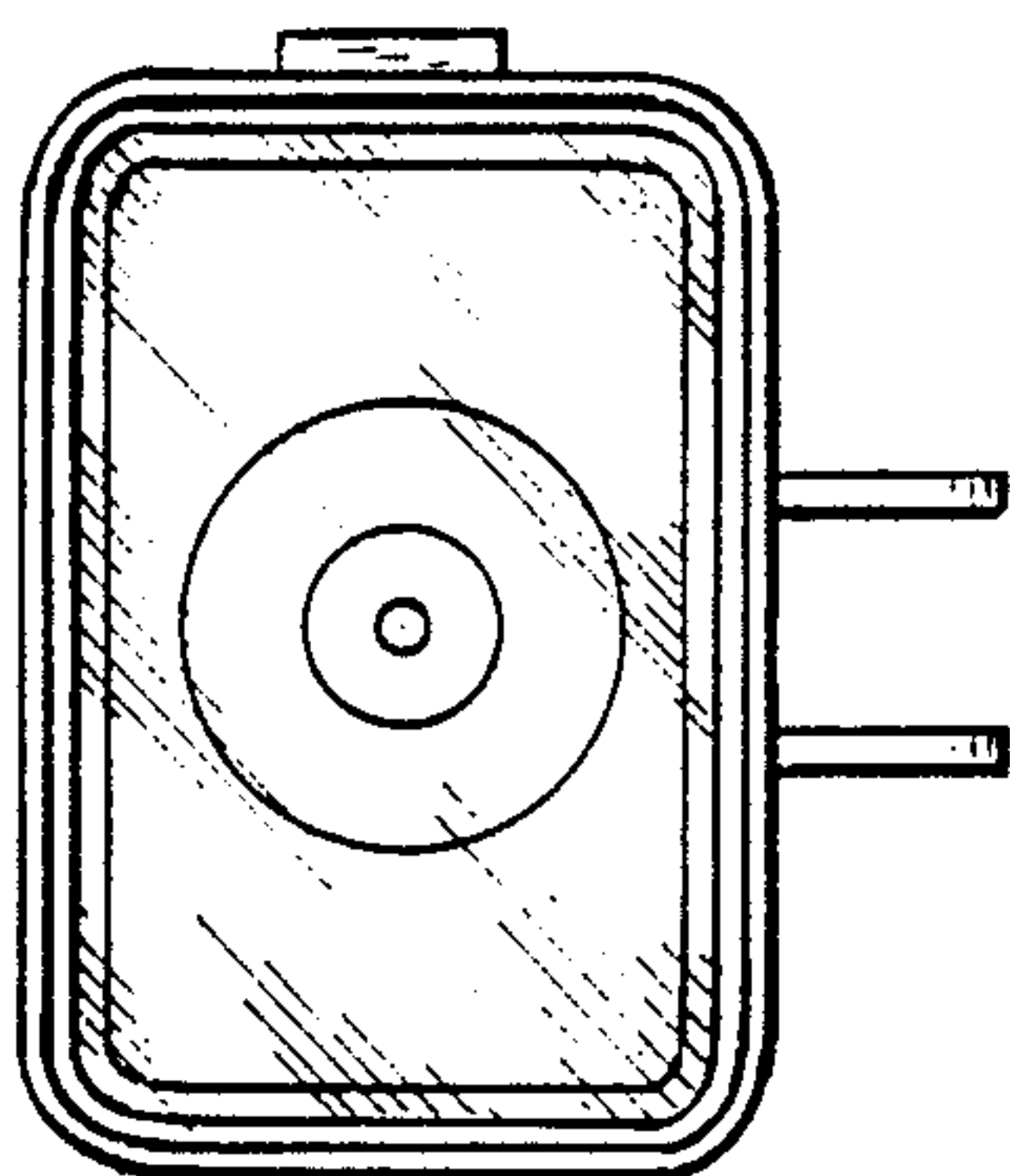
