FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the flashlight with the connector prongs extended for recharging;


FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the flashlight with the

FIG. 10 is a left-side elevational view of the flashlight with the connector prongs extended for recharging.











