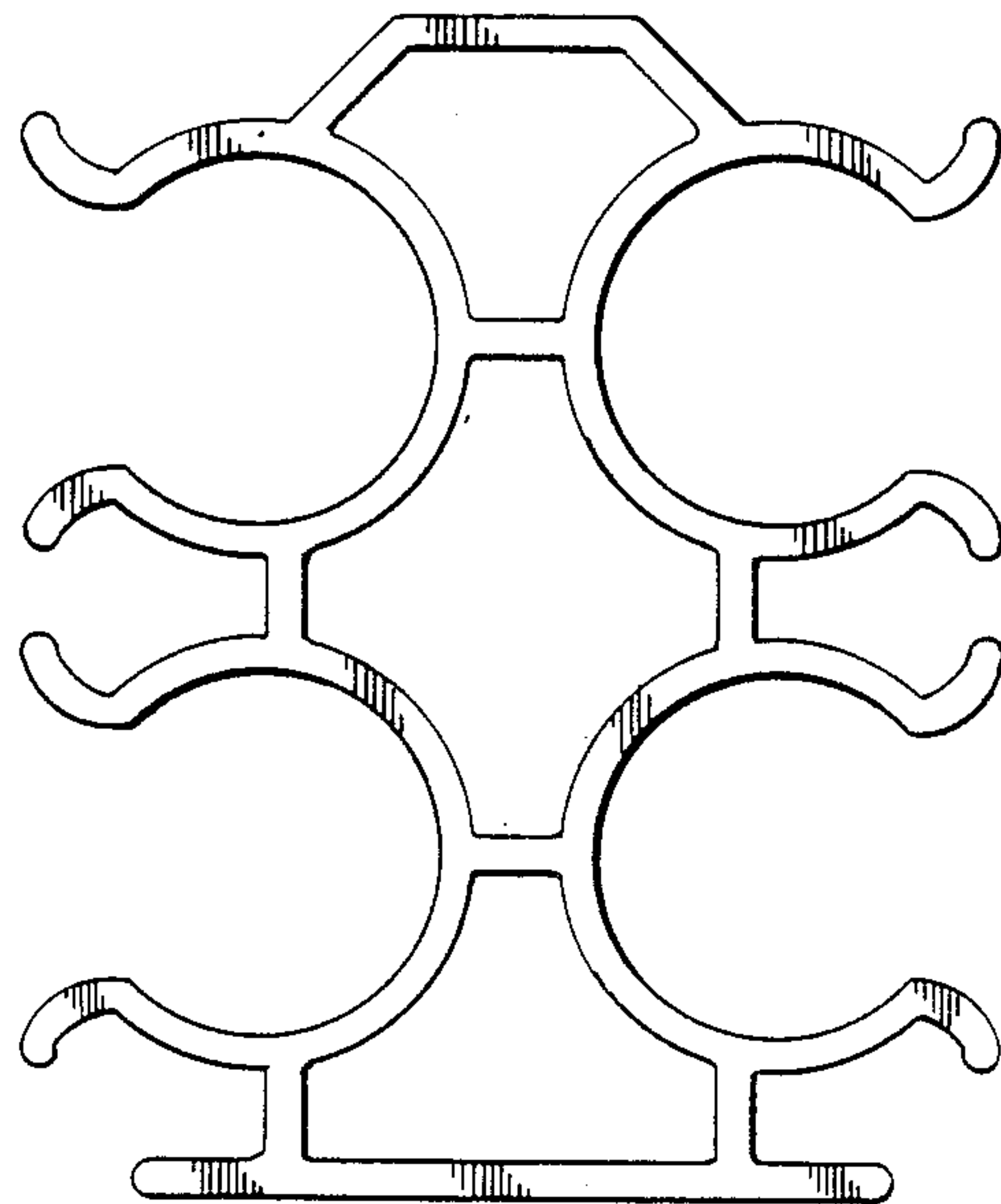

FIGS. 3 and 4 are respectively top and bottom plan views thereof.



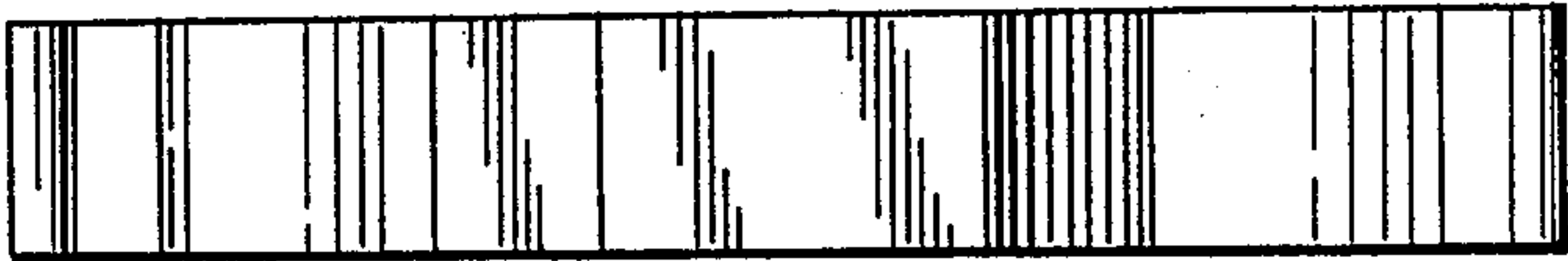

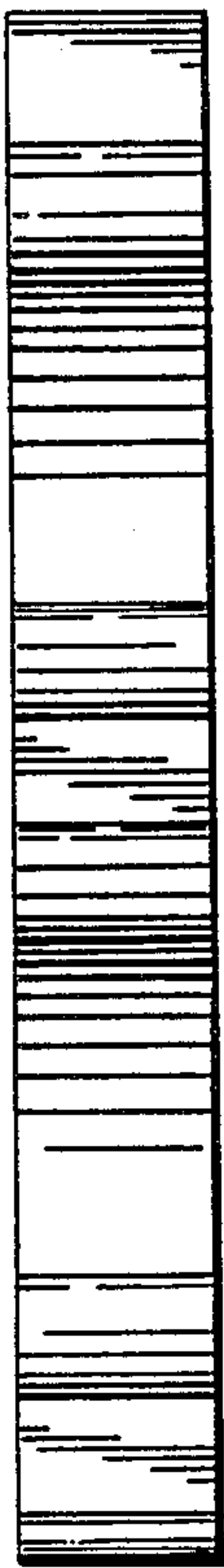

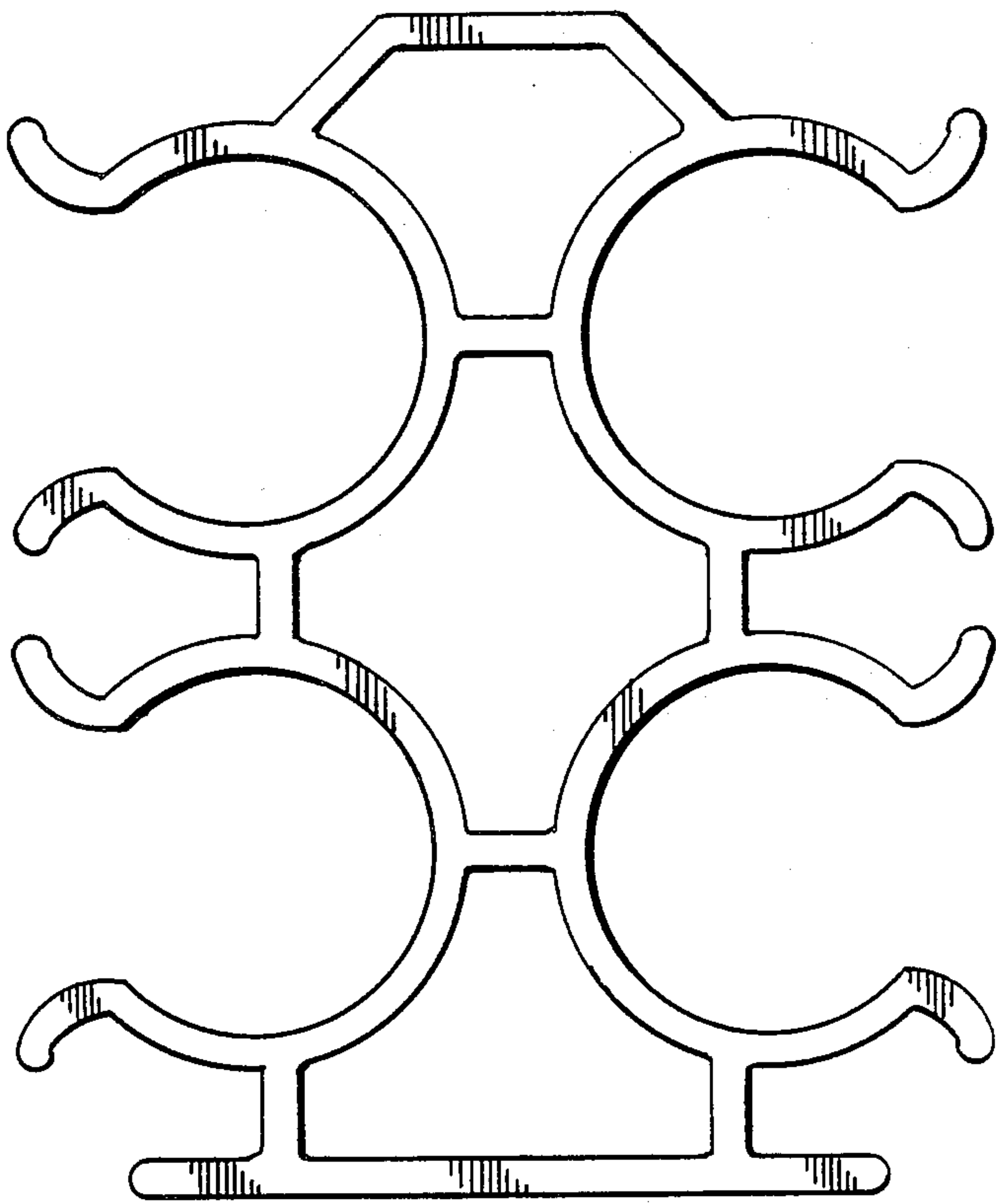
