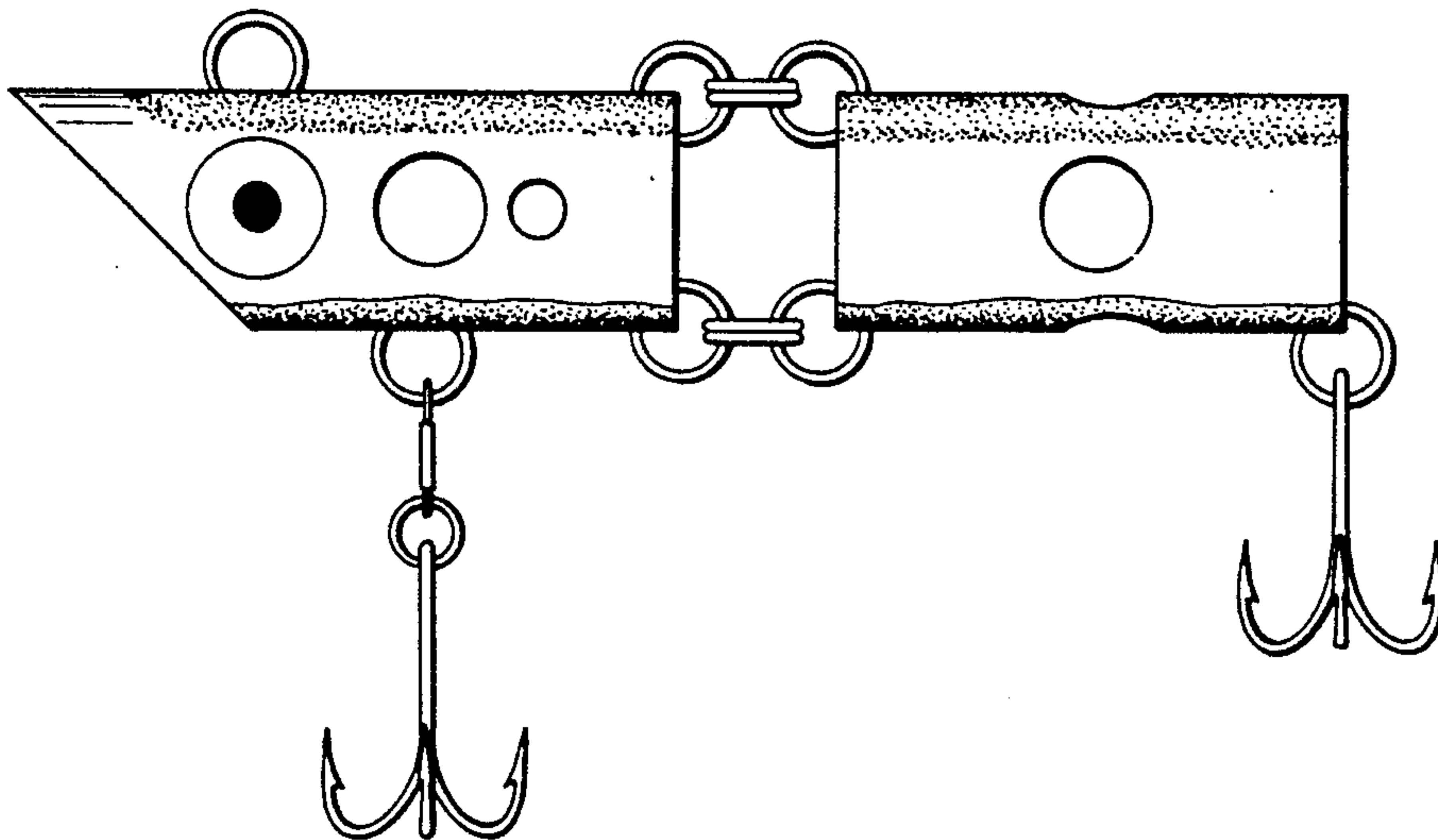

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the fishing lure or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is one side view of a fishing lure or similar article in accordance with my design;
FIG. 2 is a side view of the reverse side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIGS. 1 and 2;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIGS. 1 and 2;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of FIGS. 1 and 2; and
FIG. 6 is a front view of FIGS. 1 and 2.



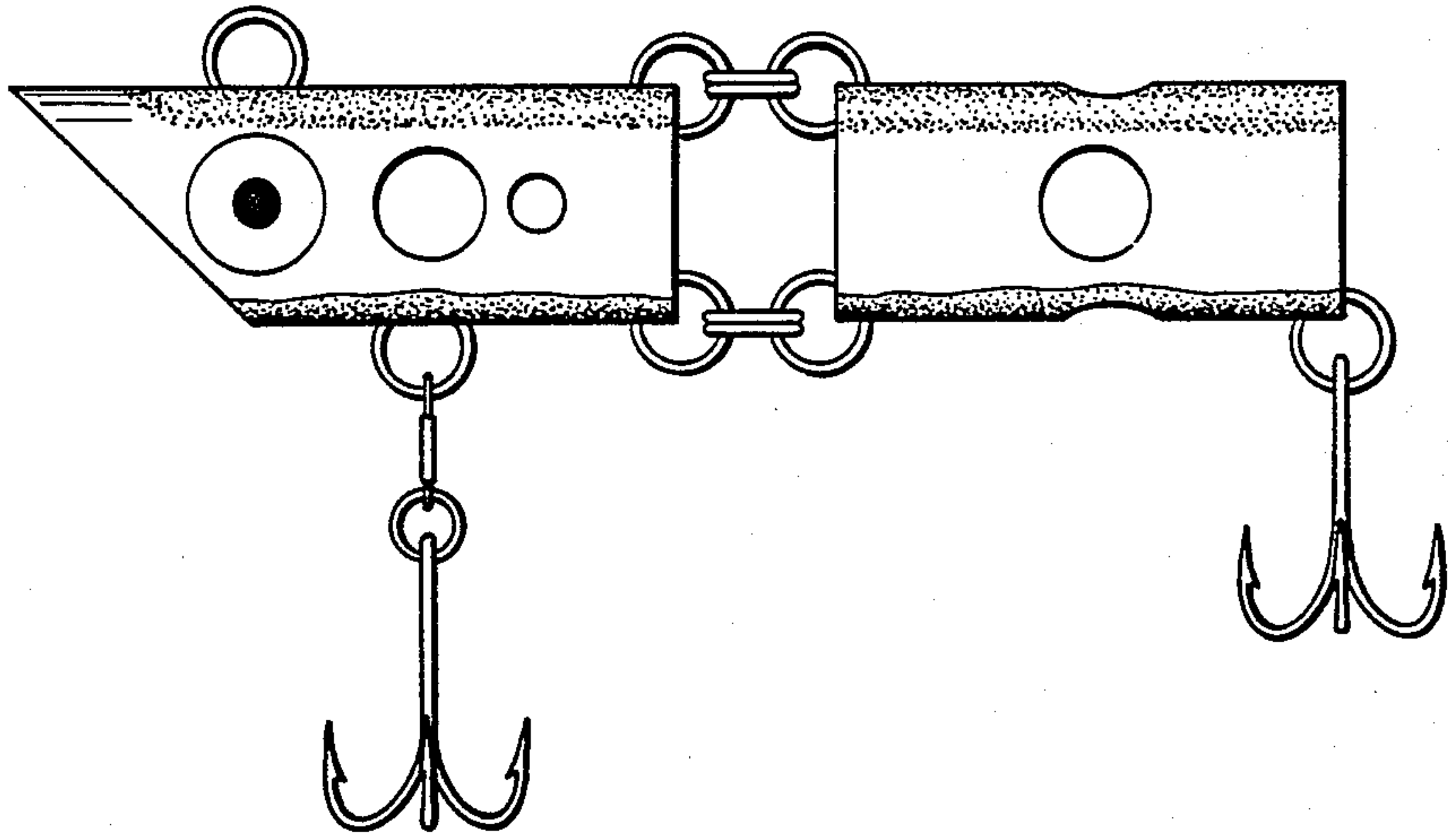

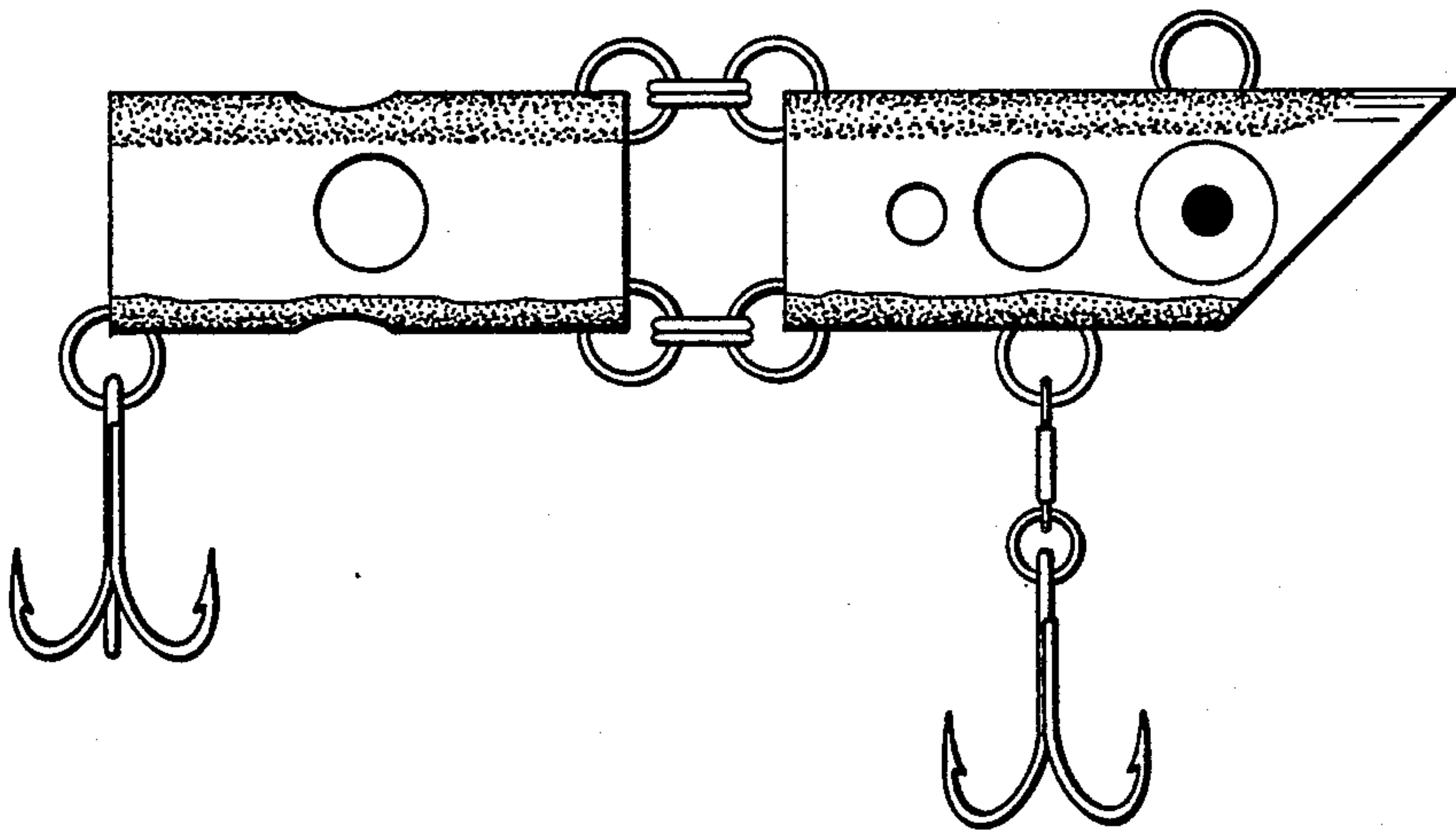

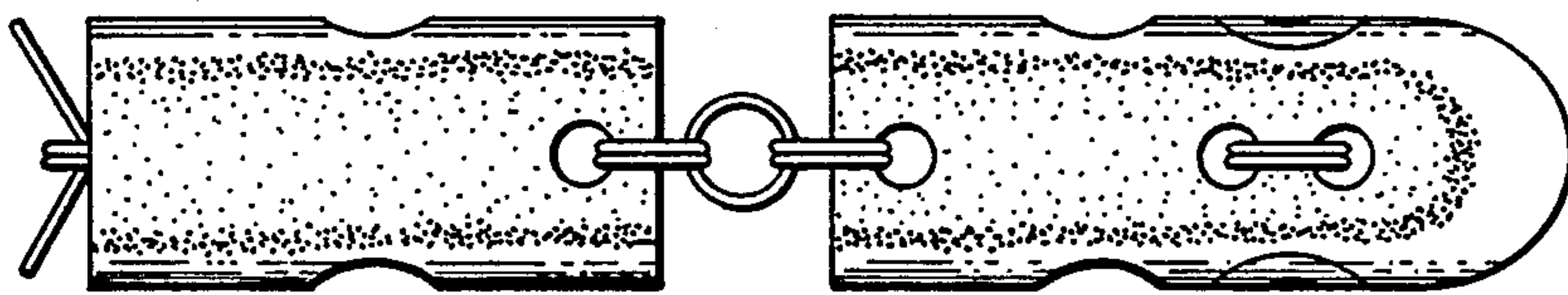

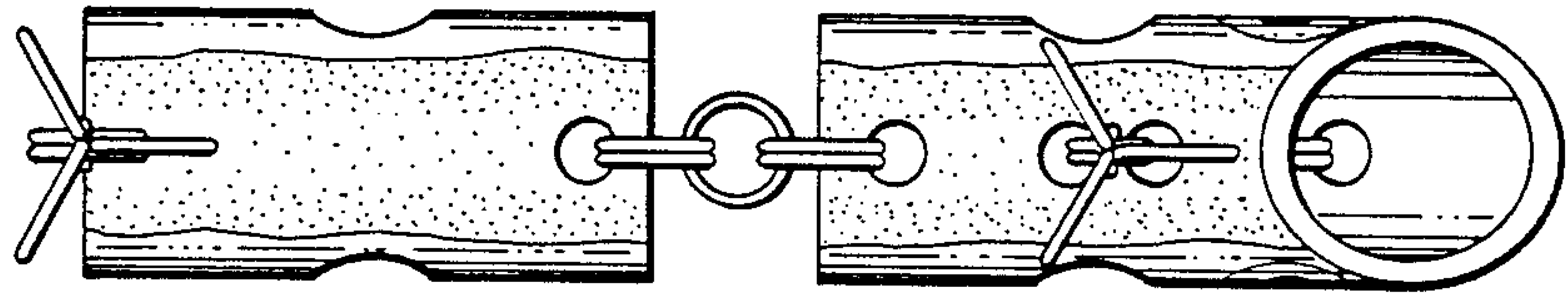

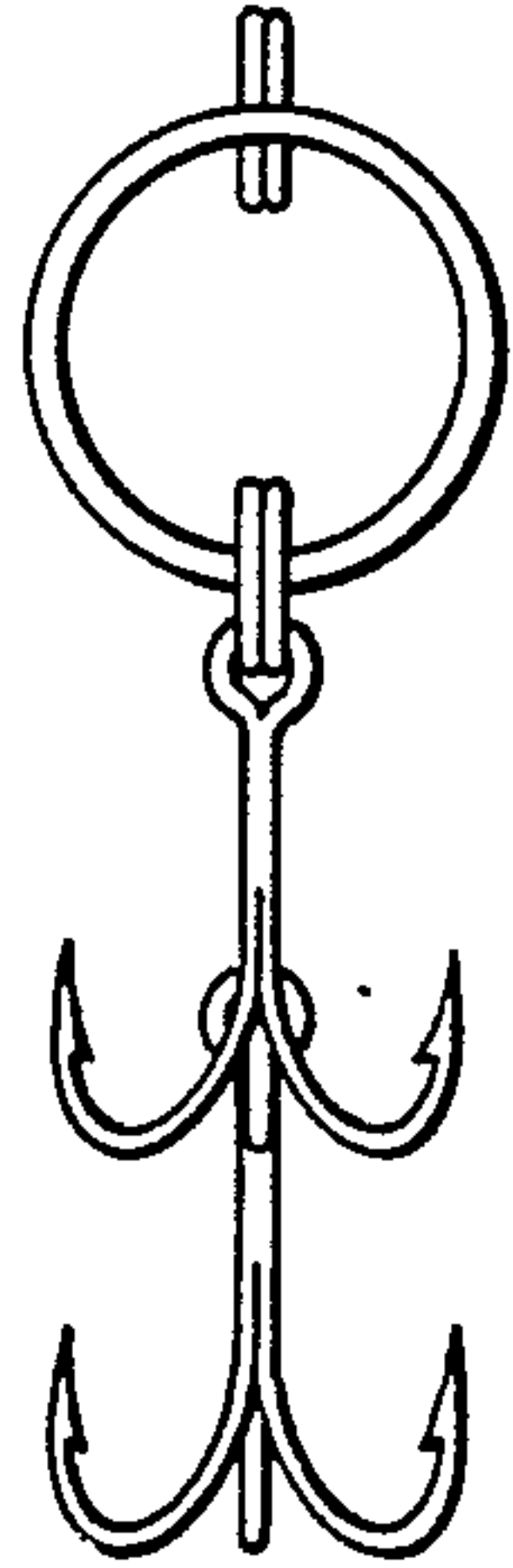

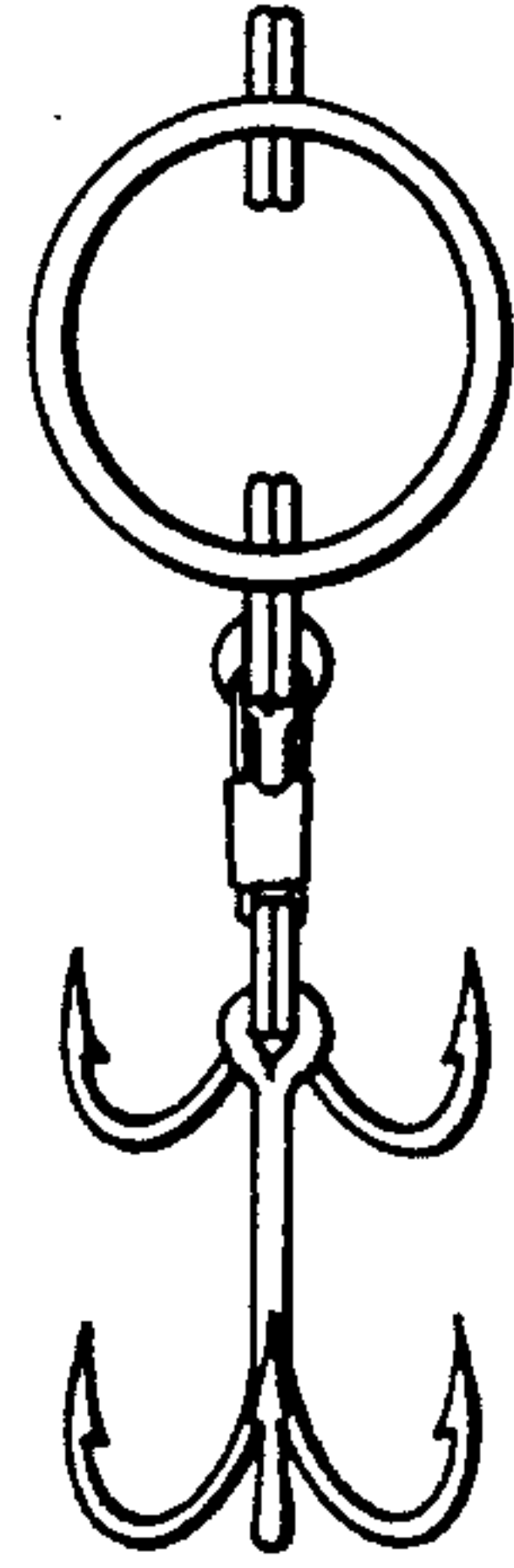
