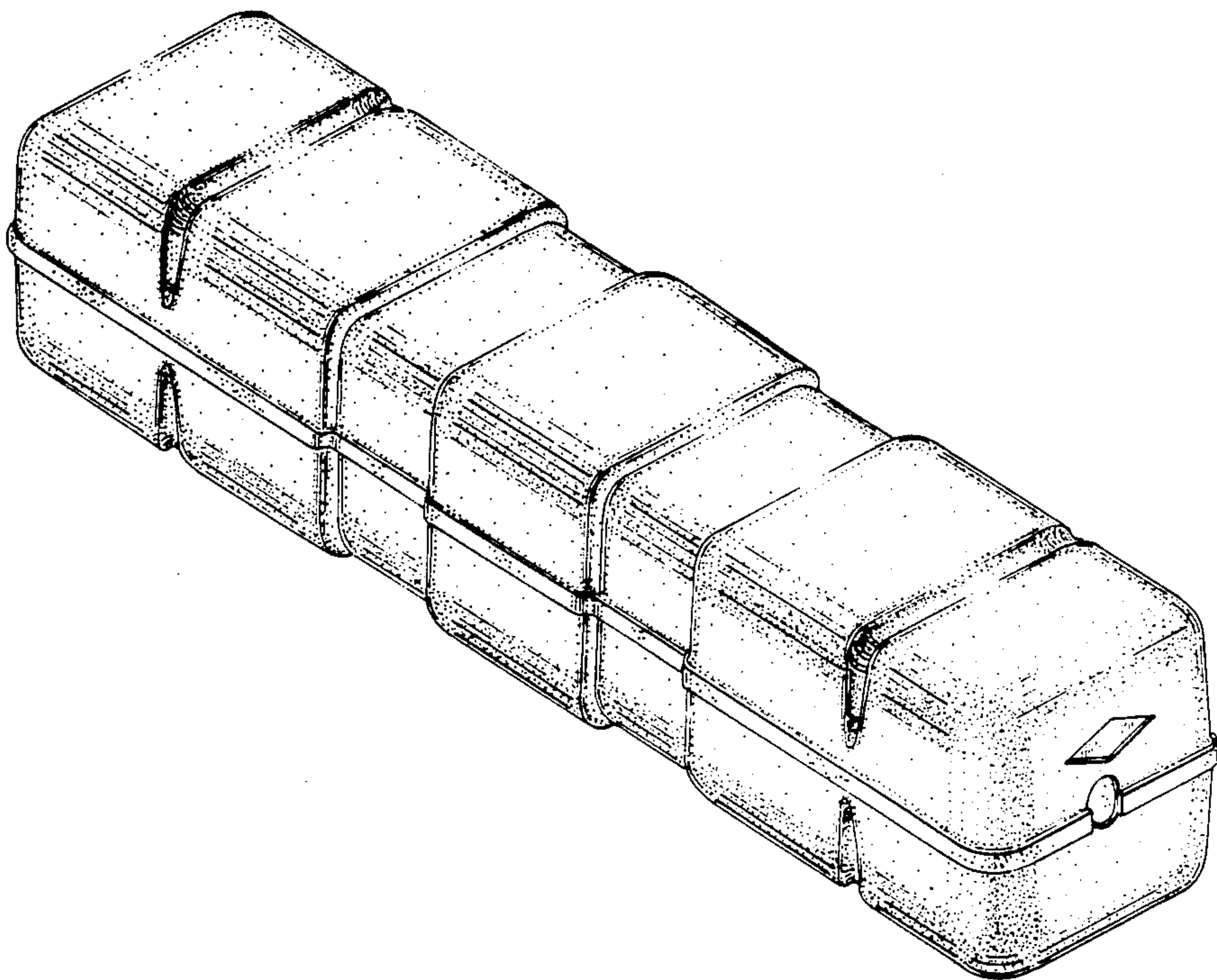

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for a reverse
osmosis water purification unit showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



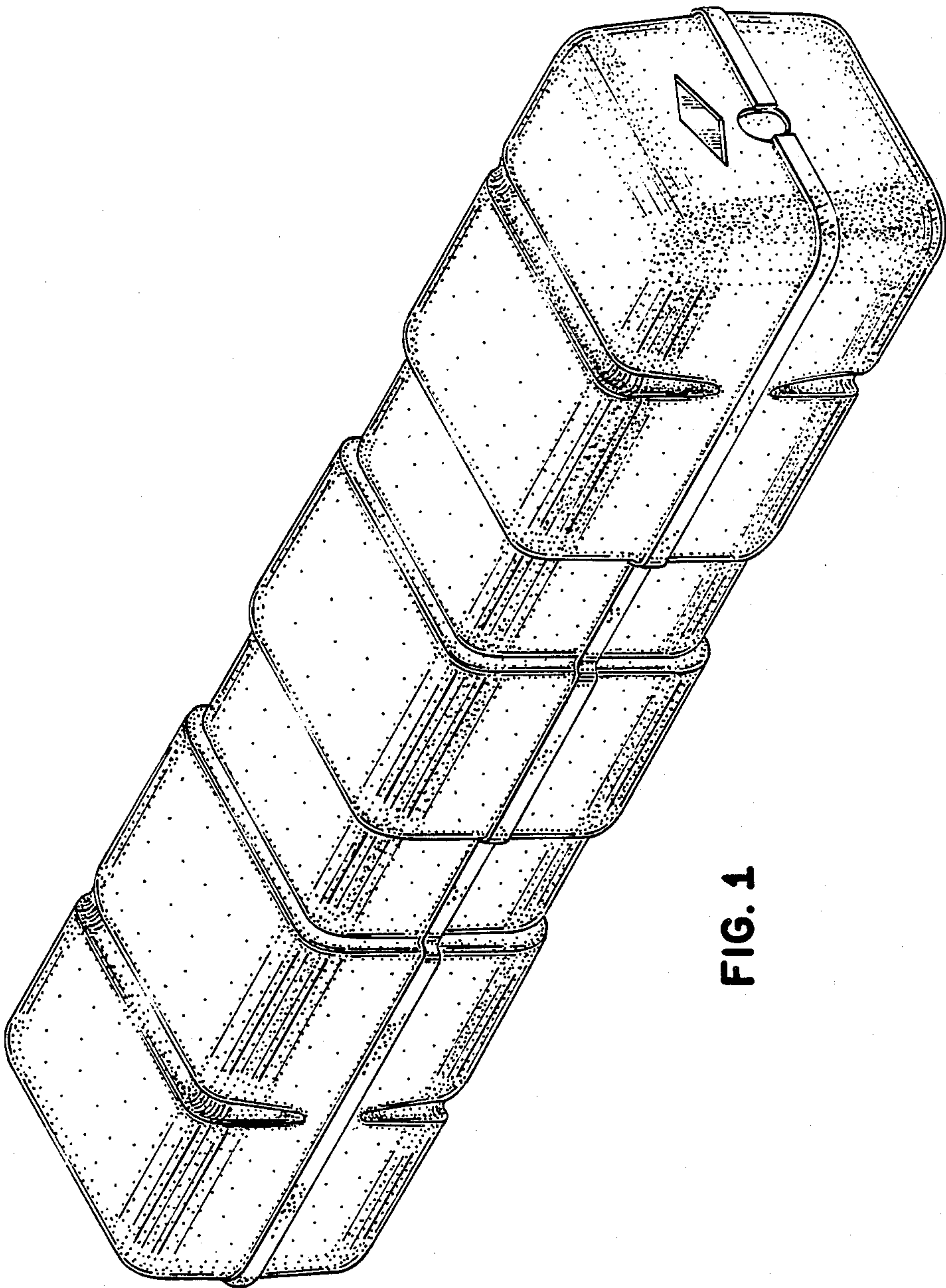

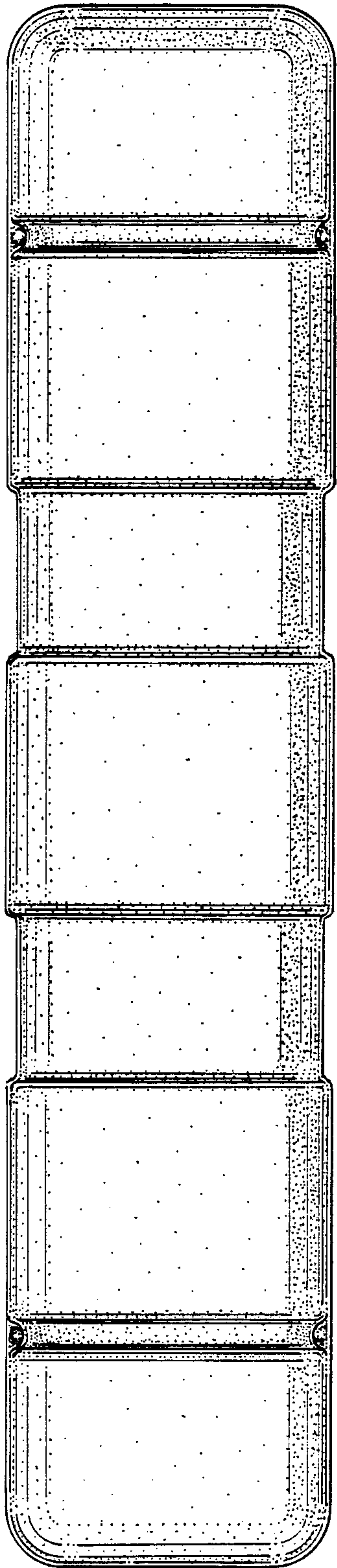

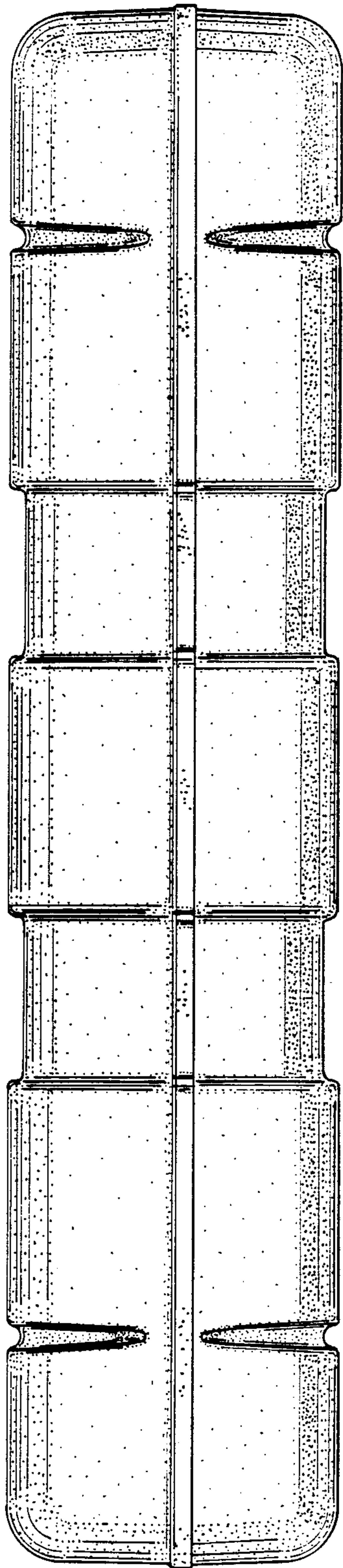

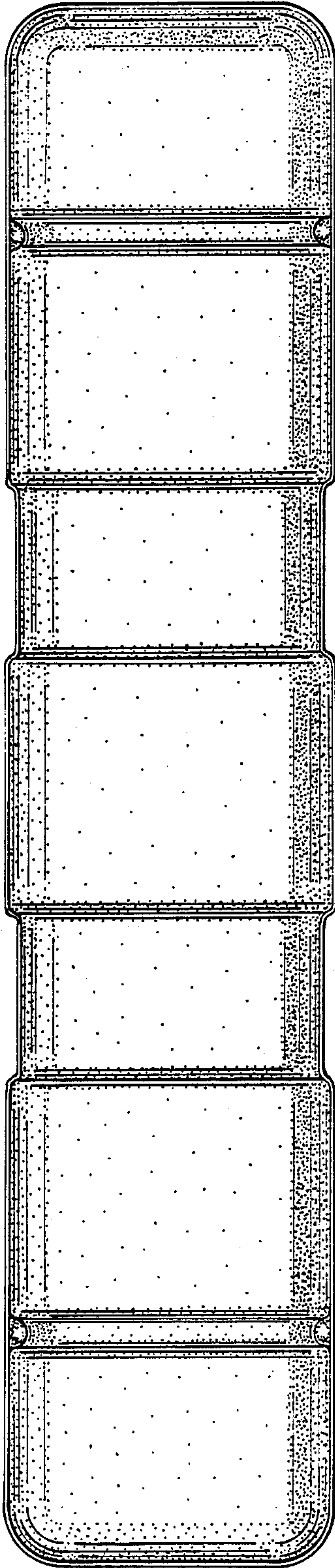

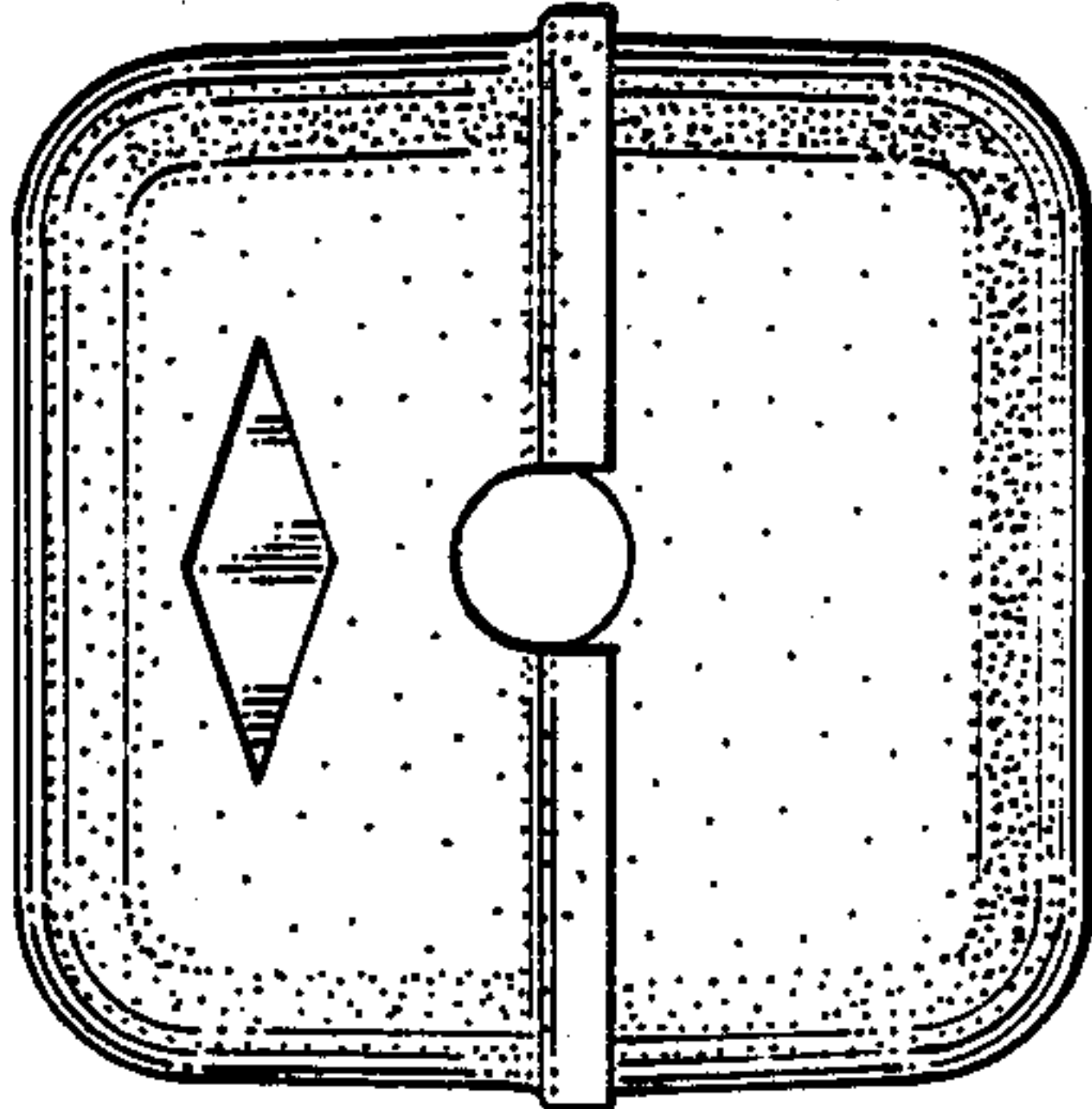

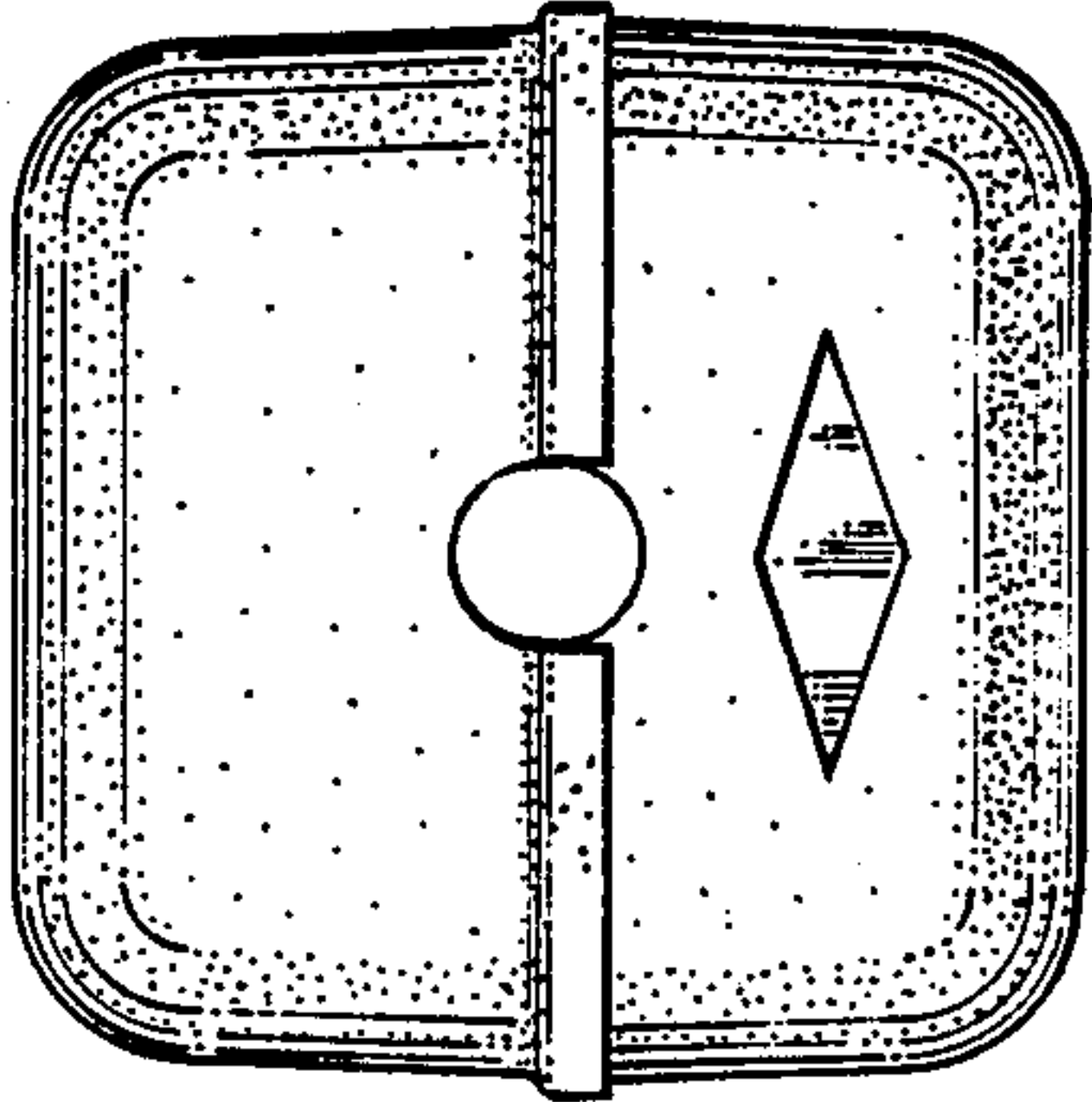
