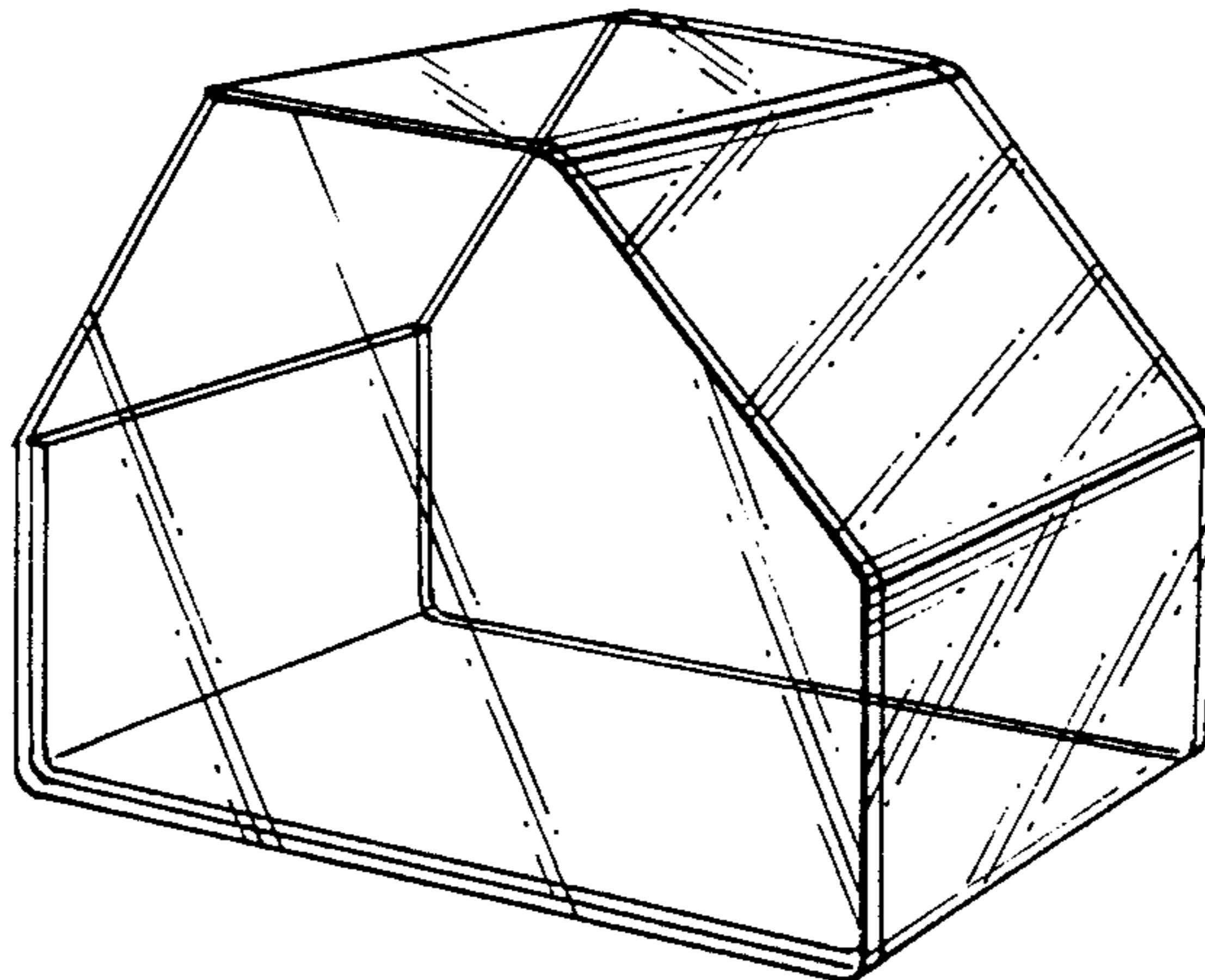

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a food bin showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image;

 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



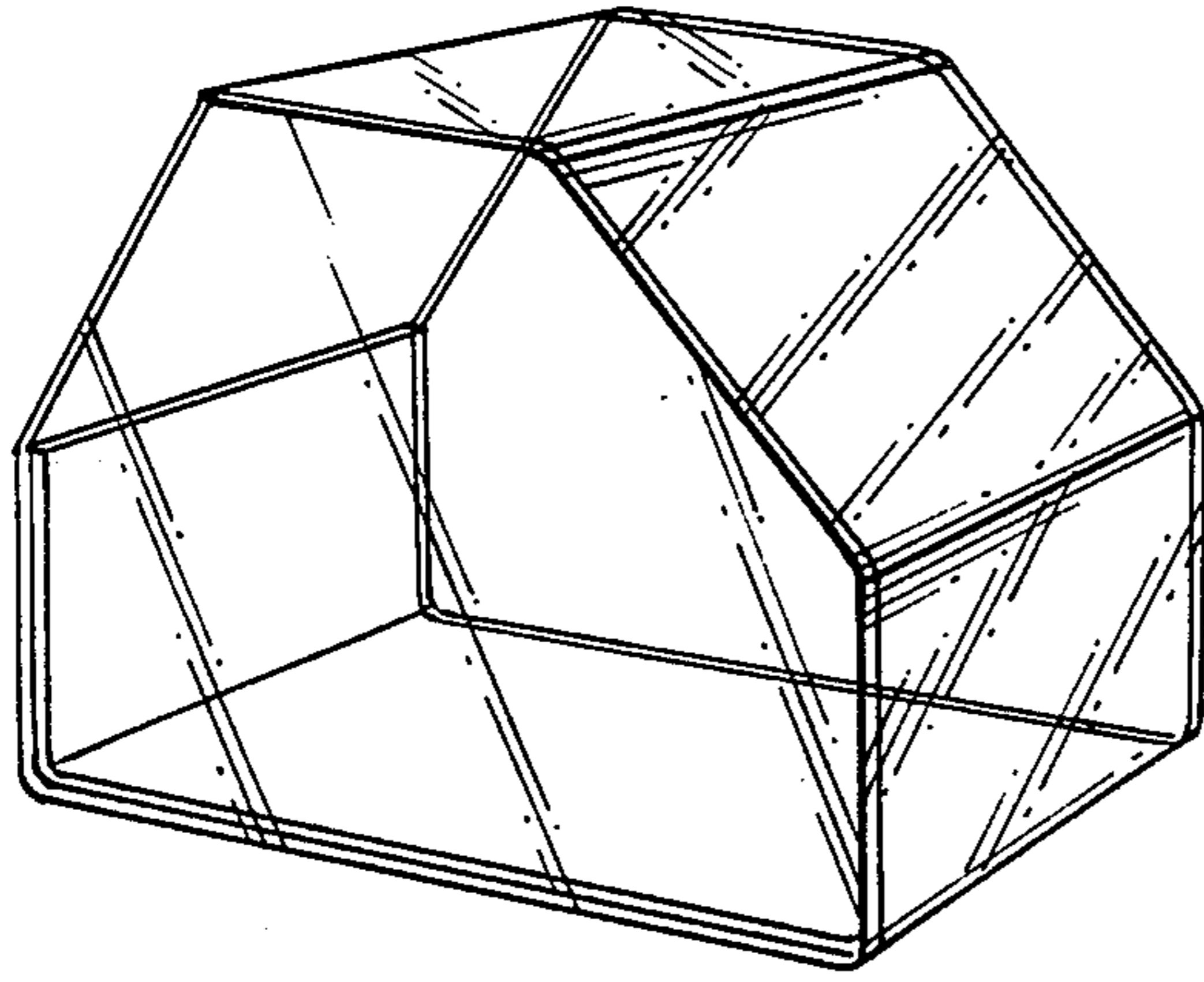

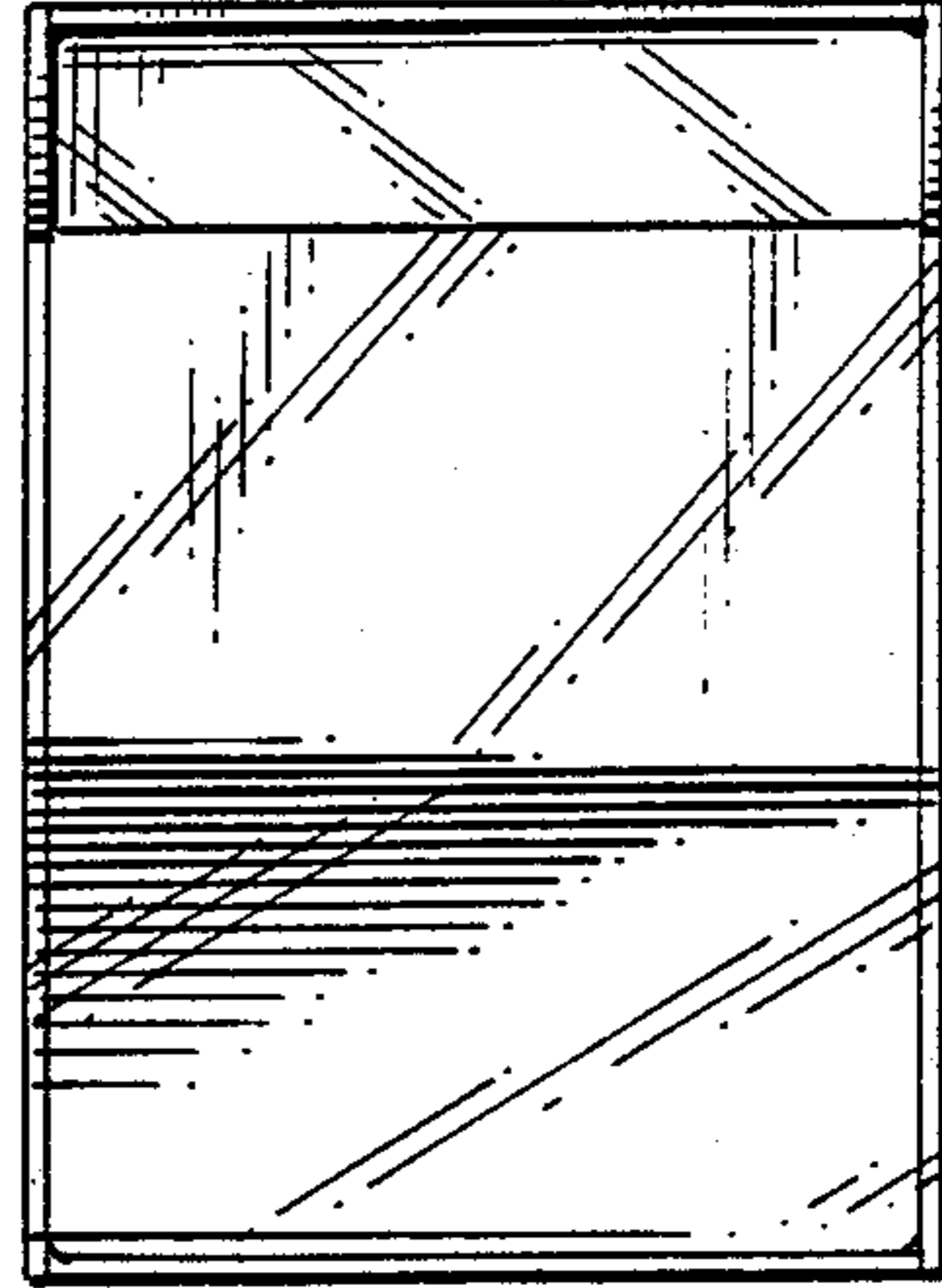

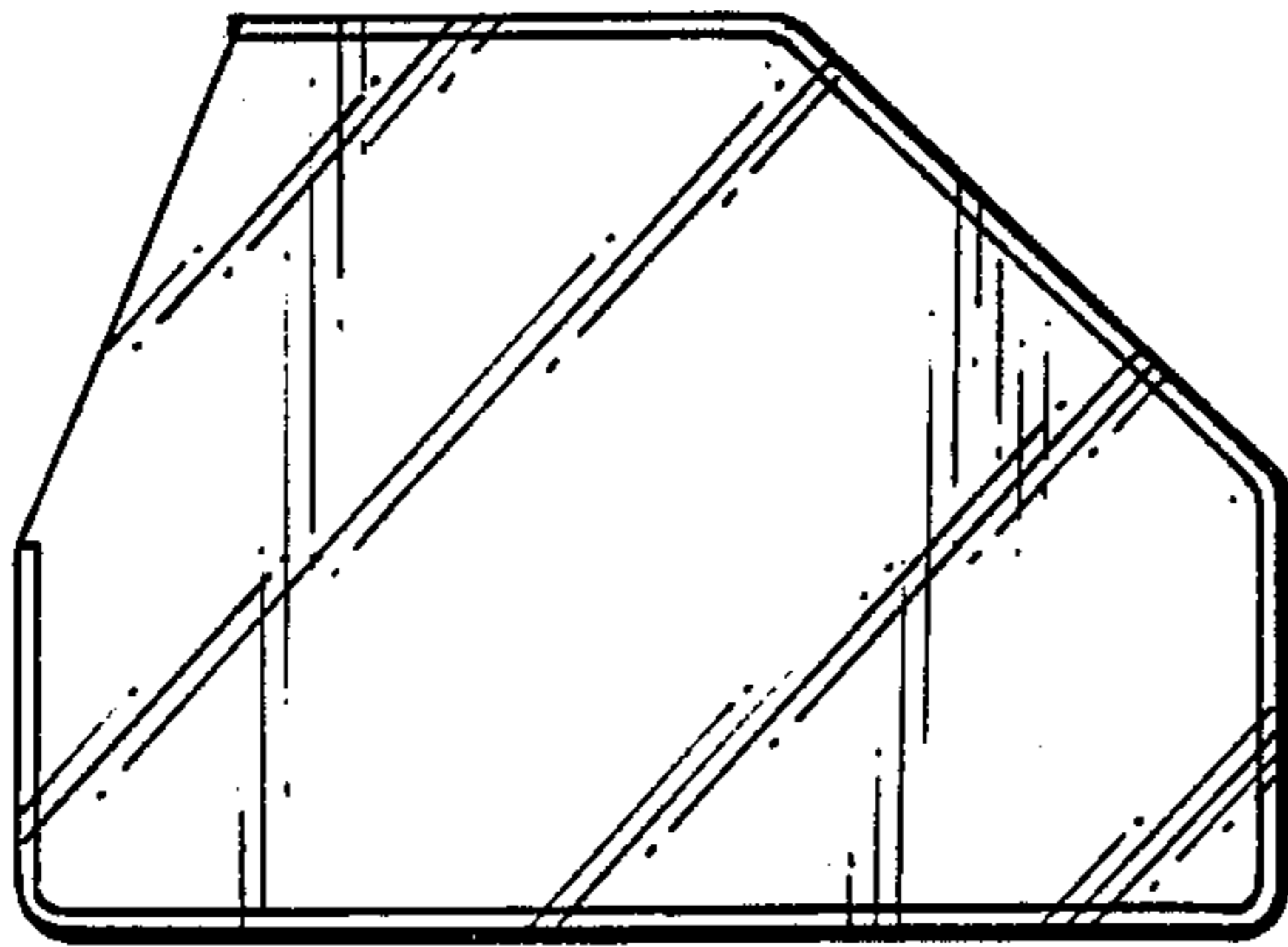

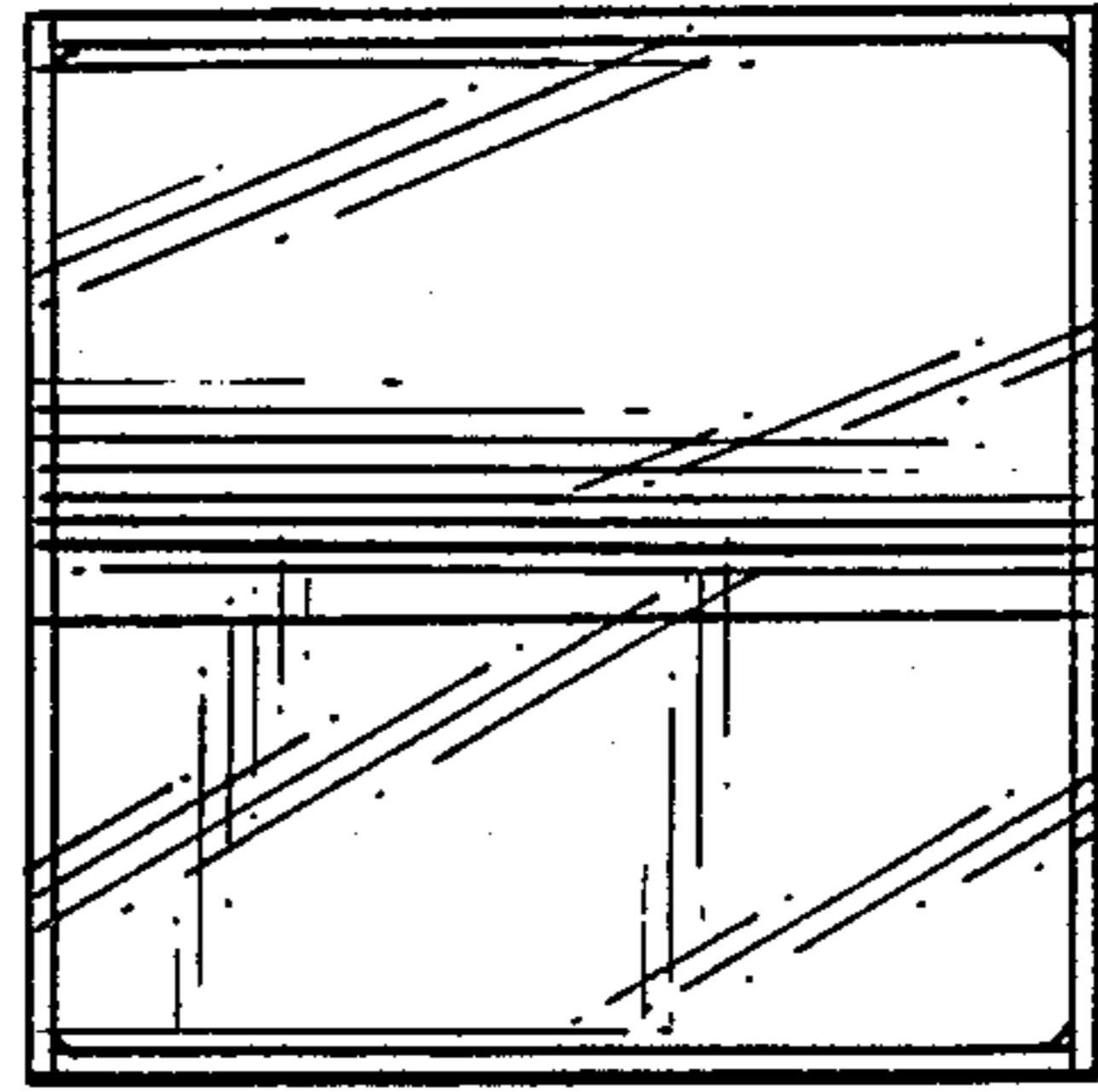

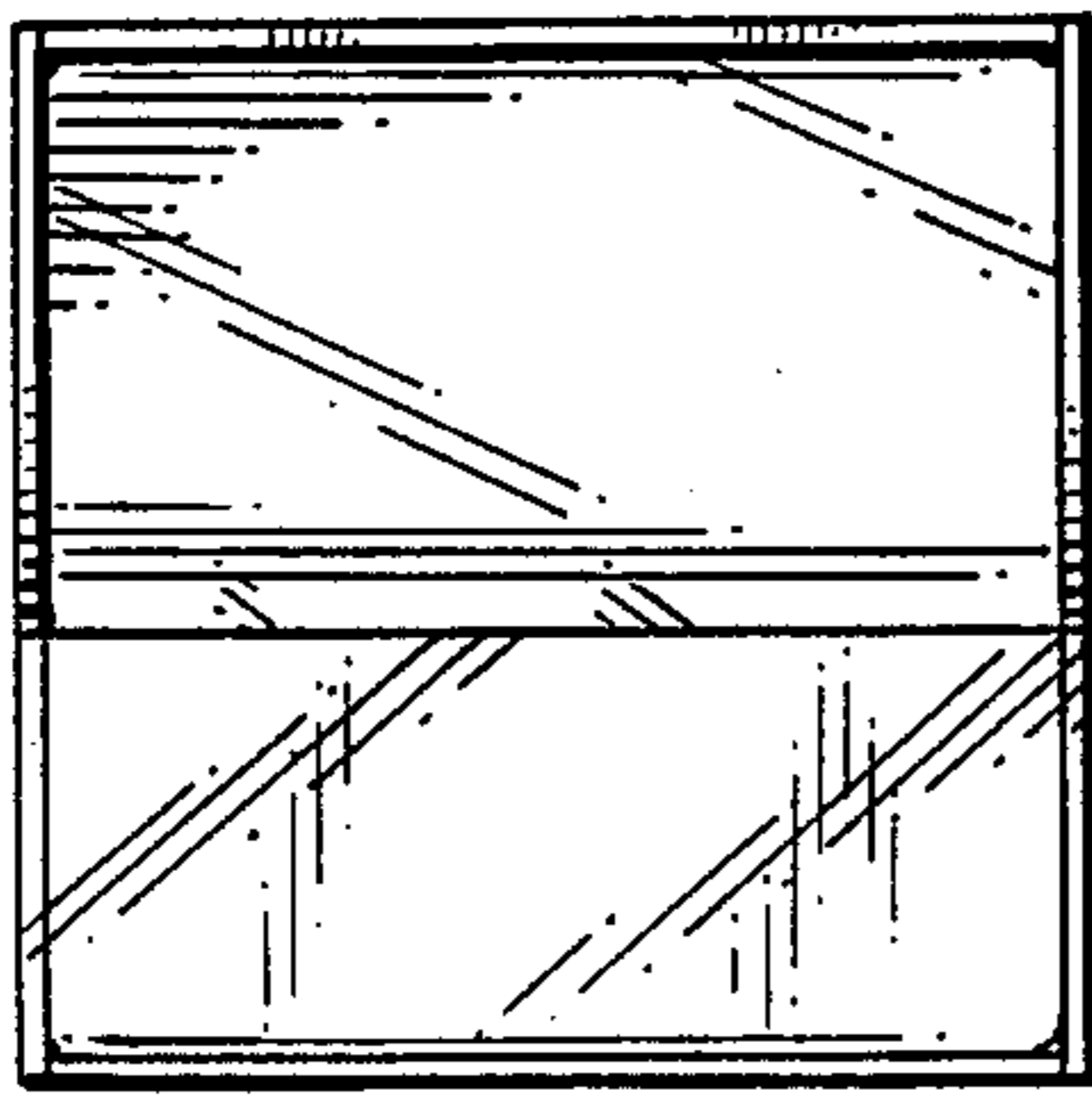

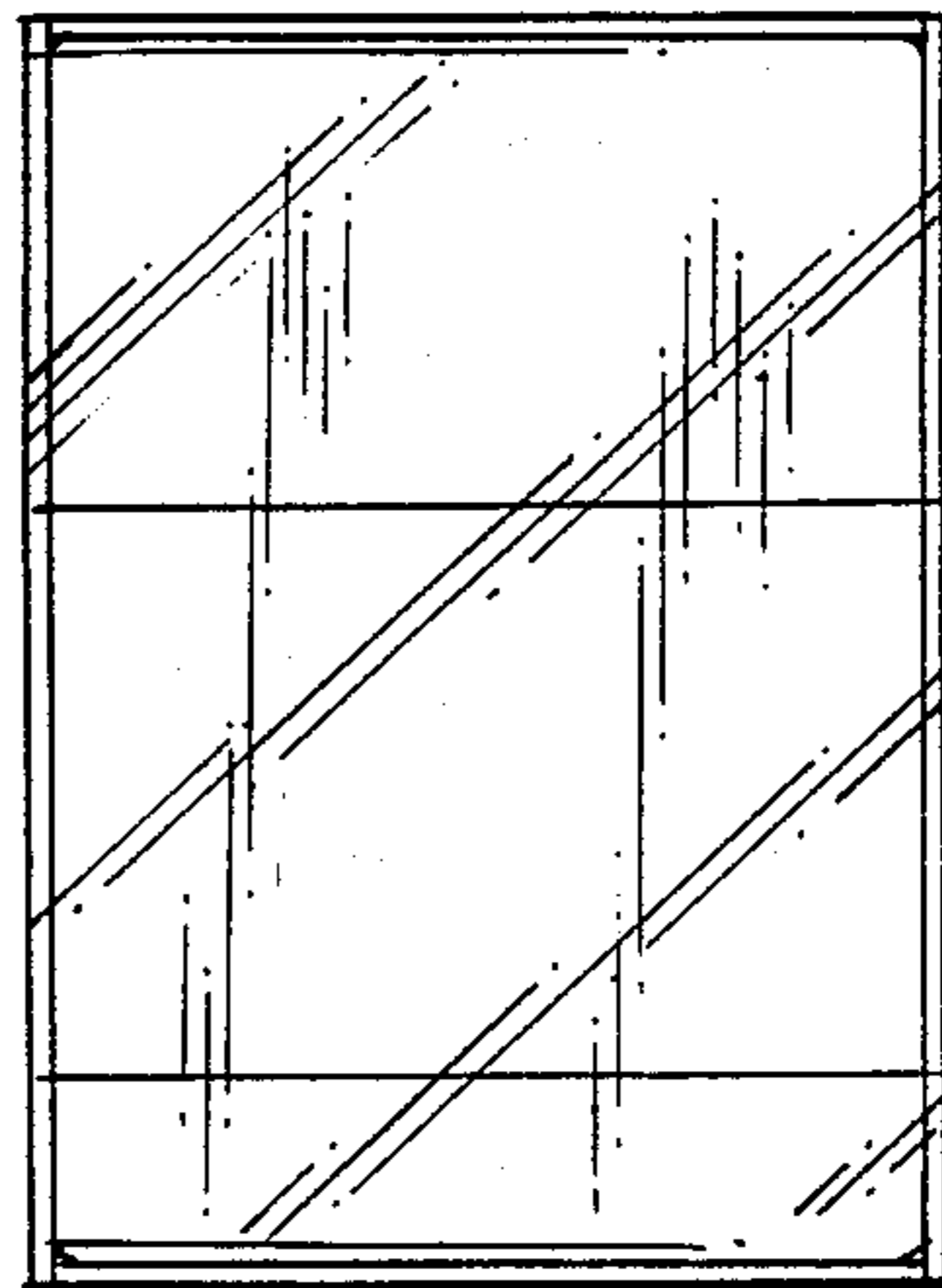
