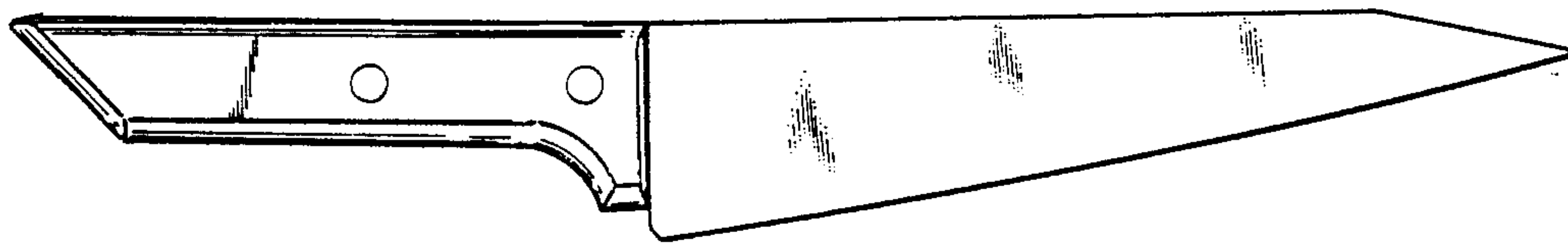

The ornamental design for a carving knife, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a carving knife showing our new design, the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1 being the mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a bottom edge view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a top edge view thereof.



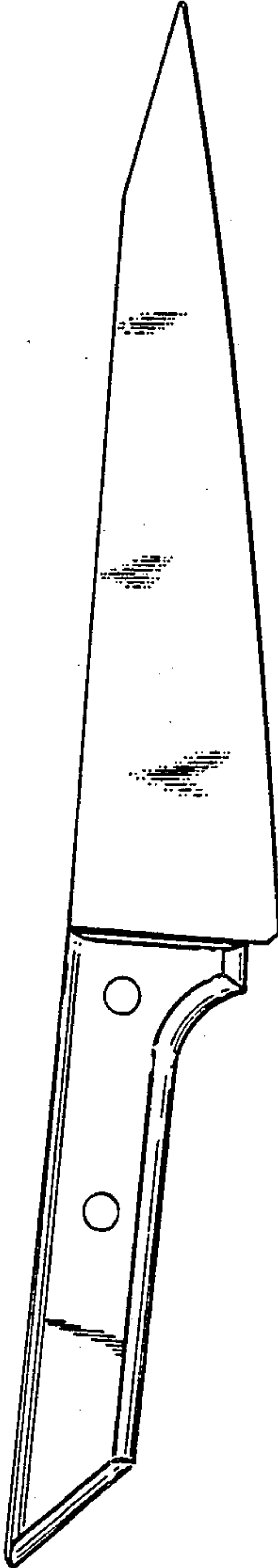

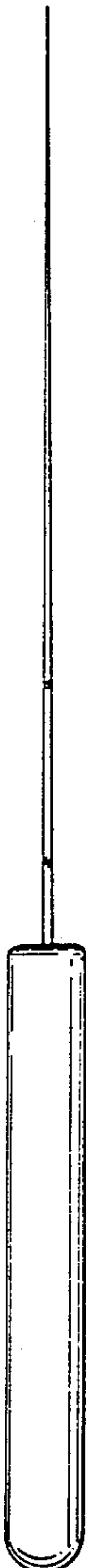
