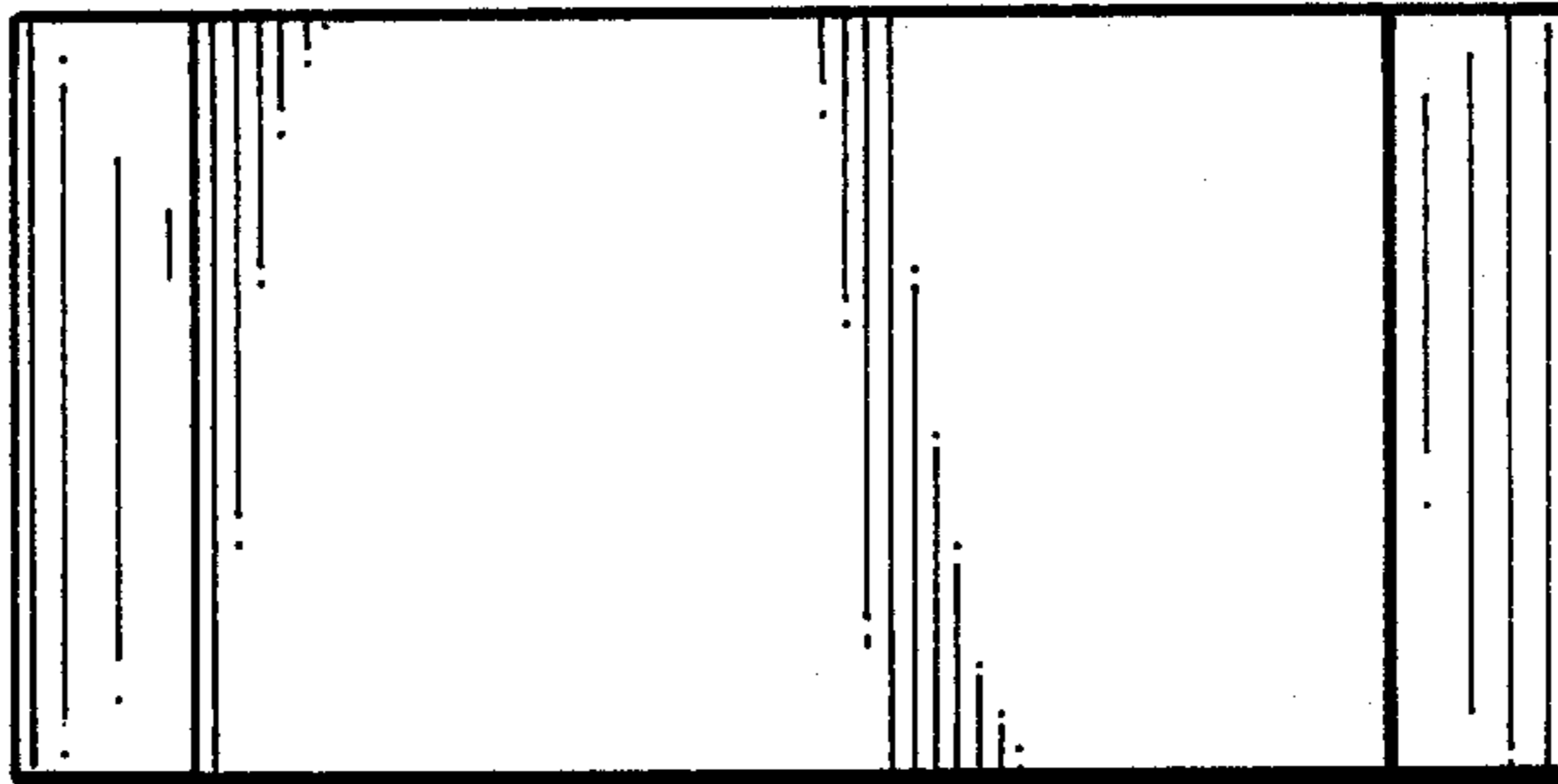

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cap for a container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a cap for a container showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



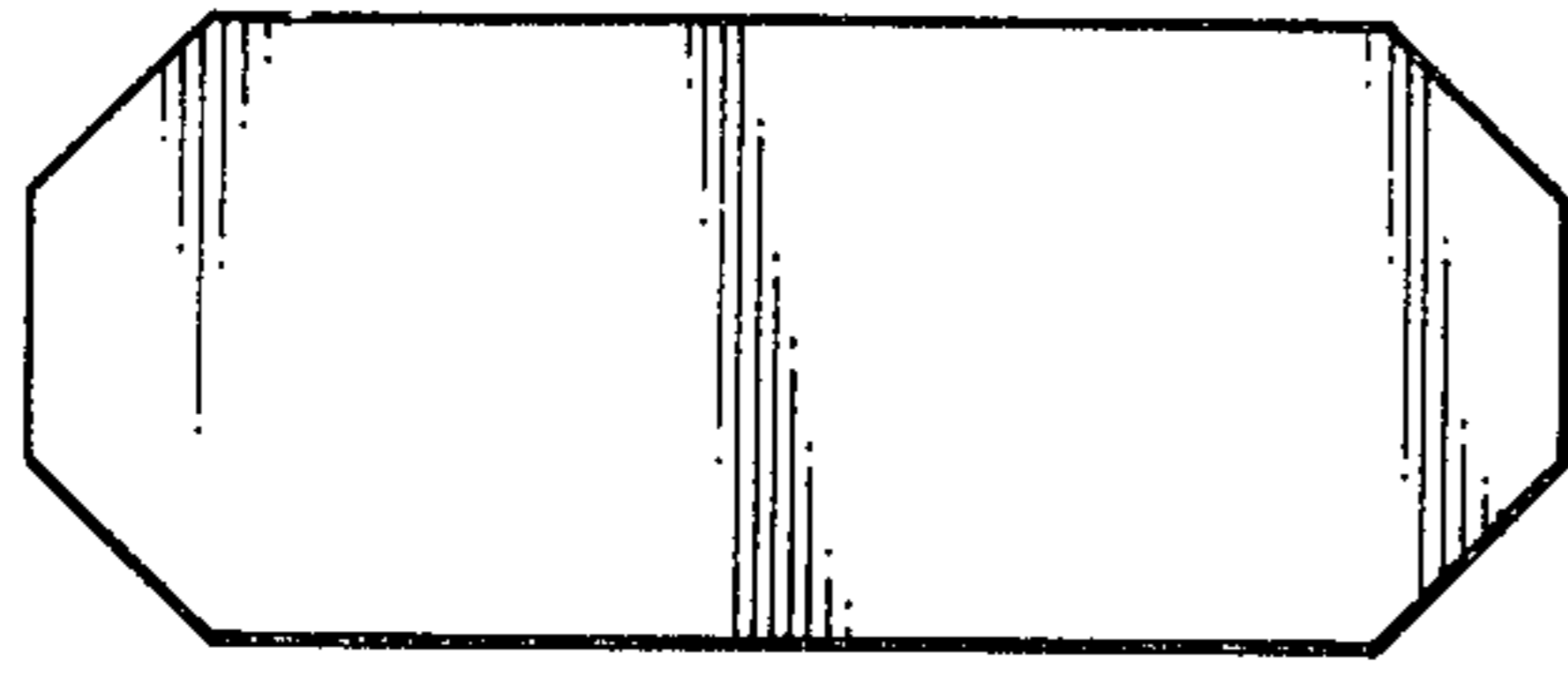

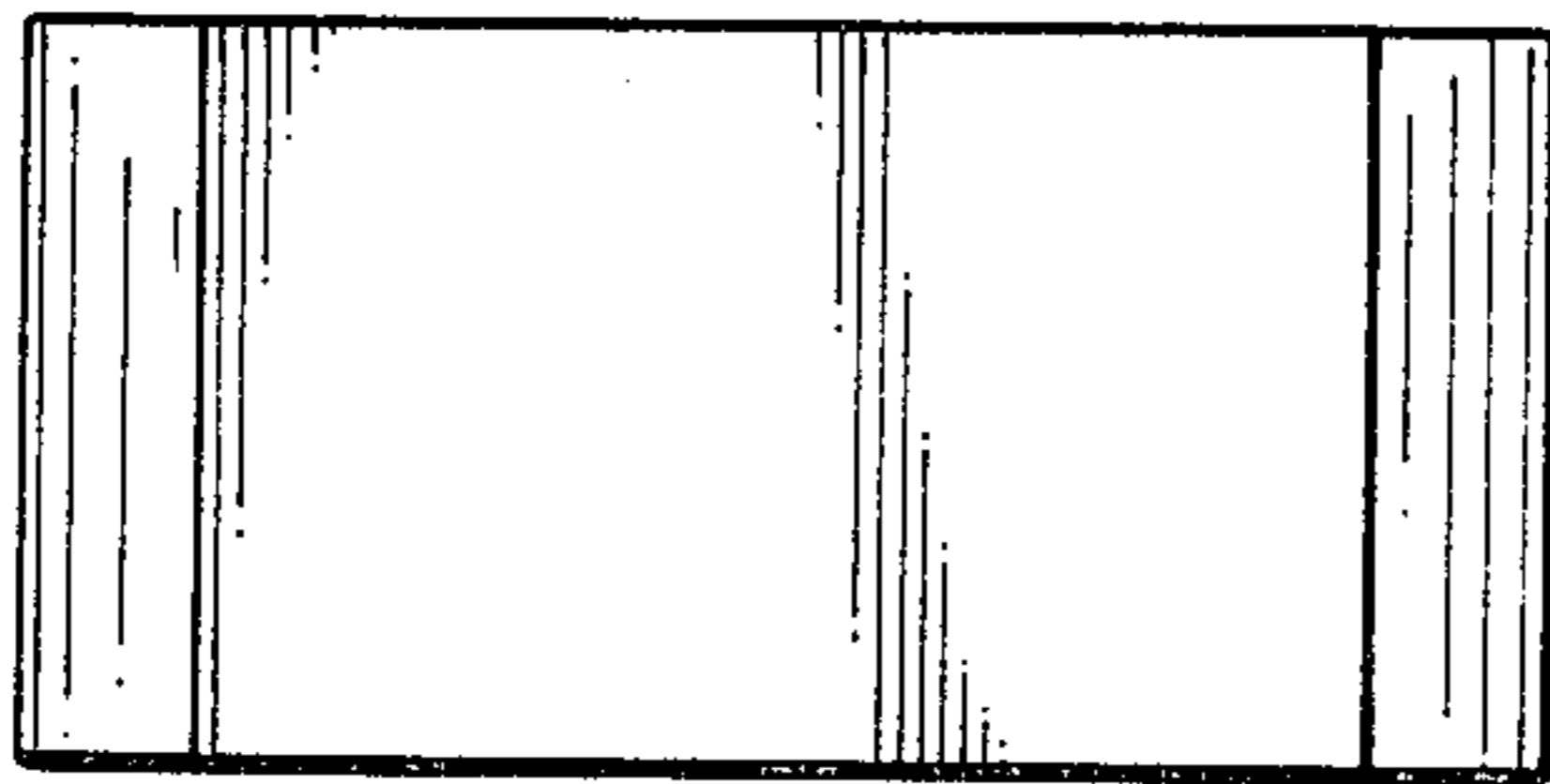

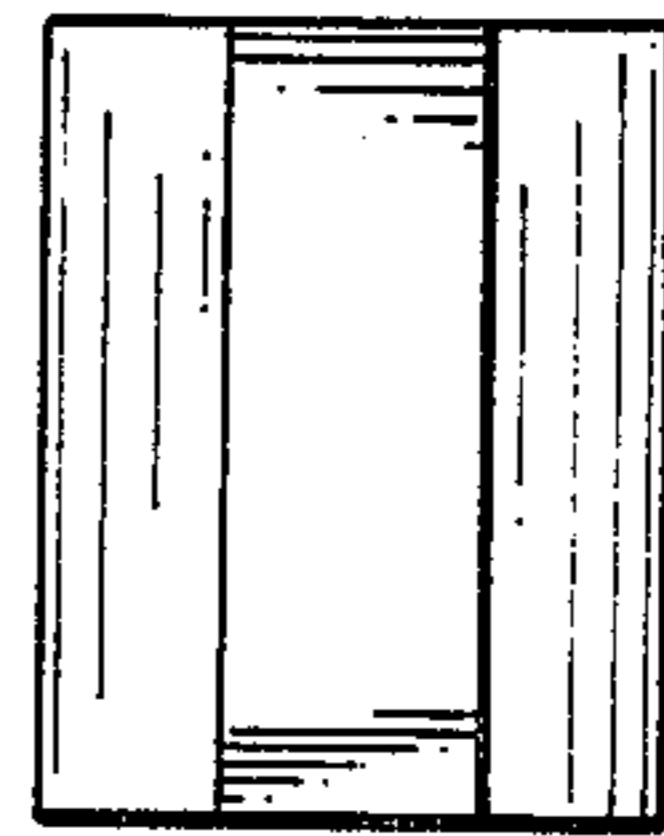

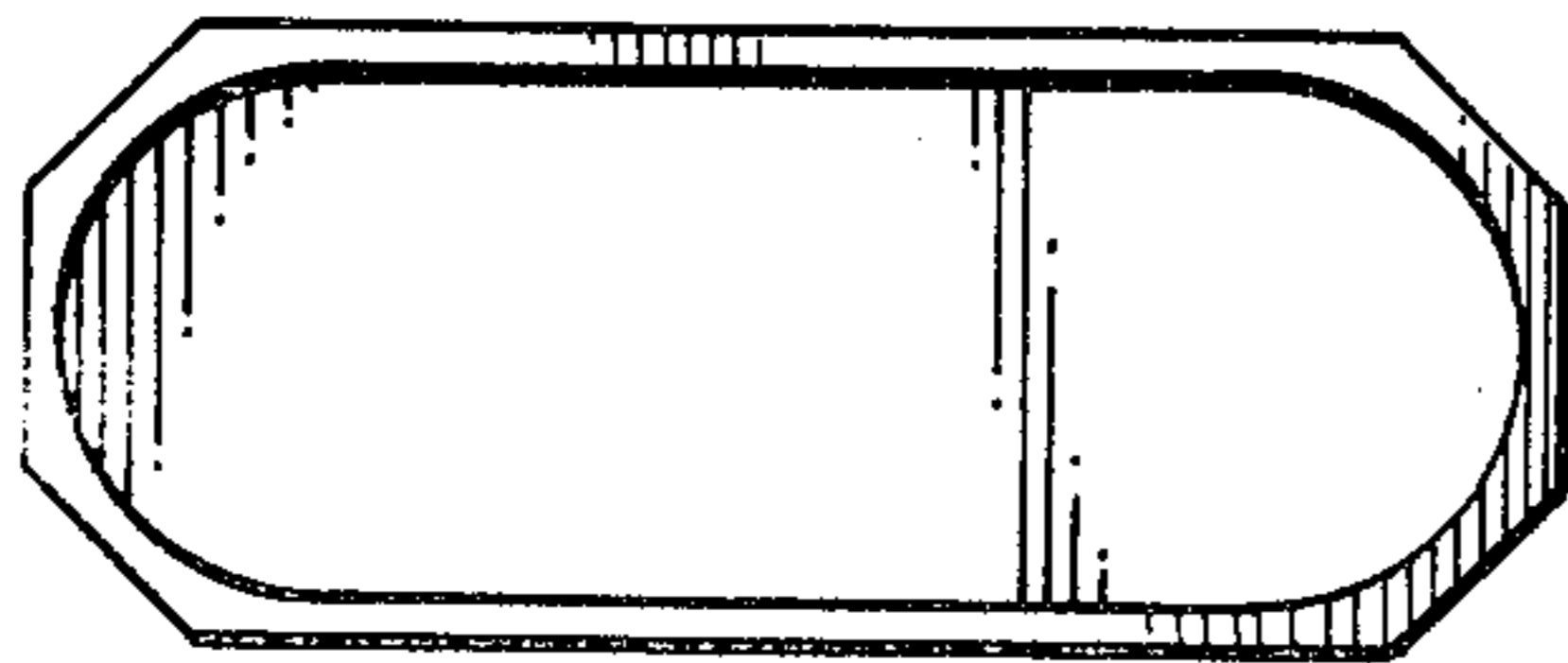
