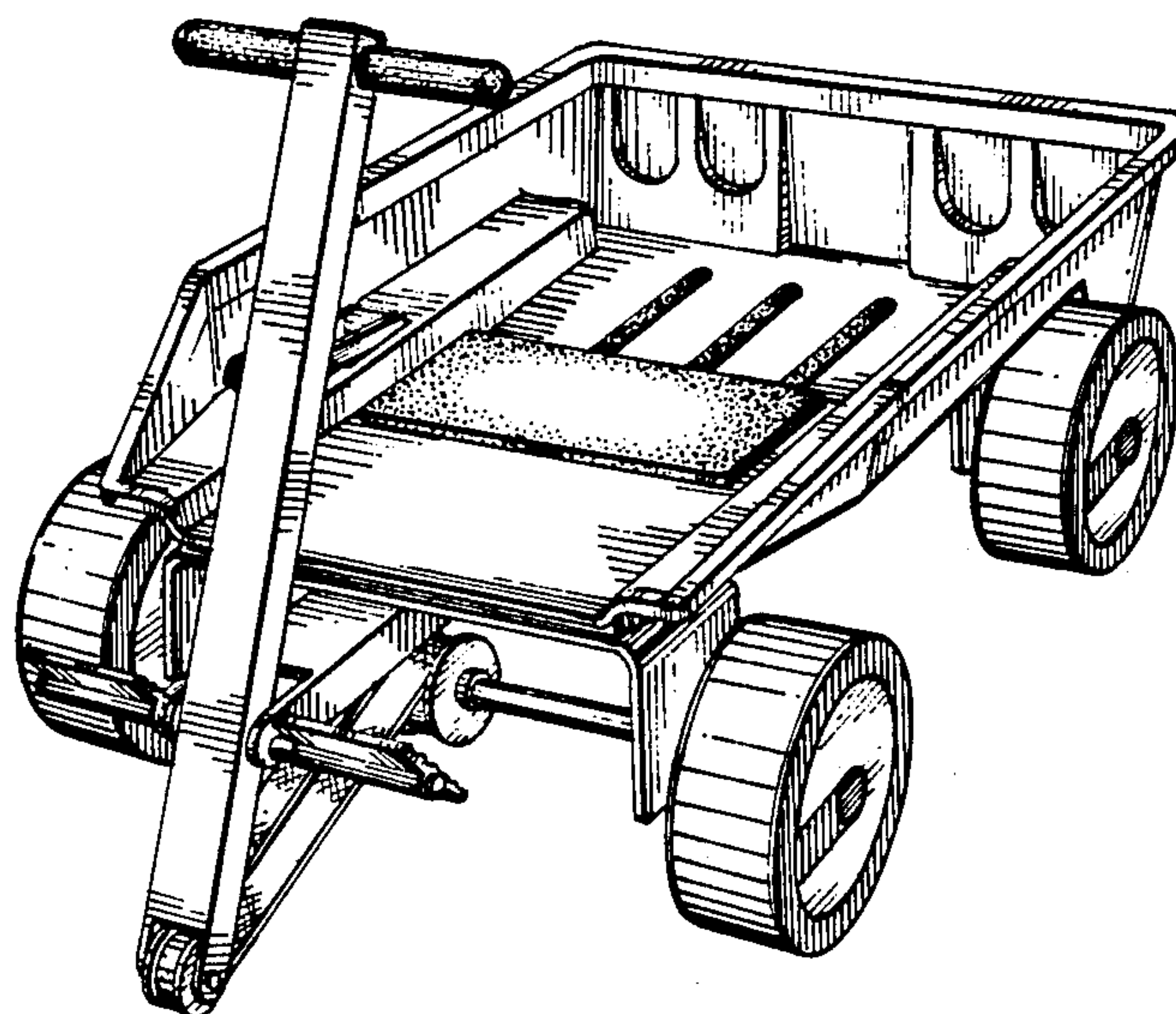

The ornamental design for an exerciser wagon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an exercise wagon or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



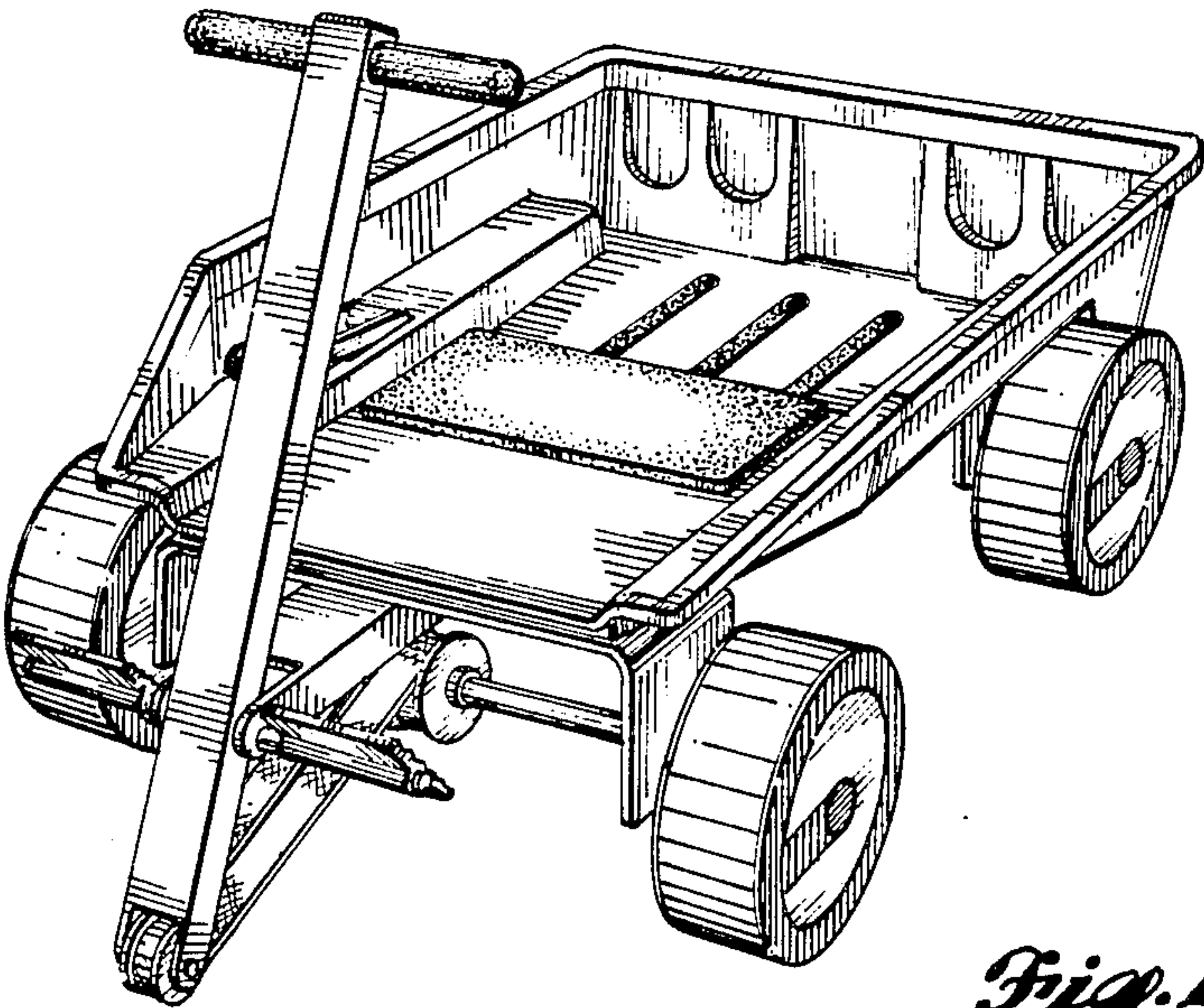

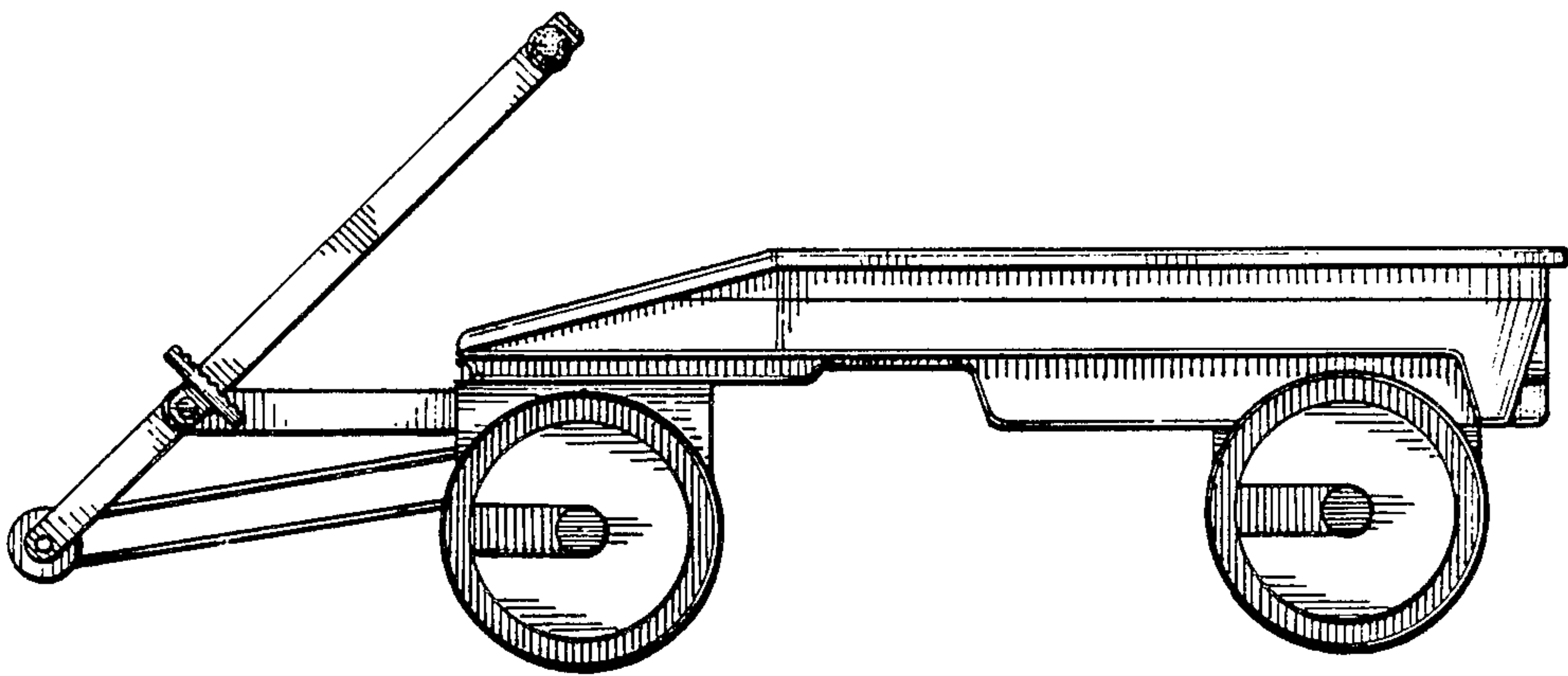

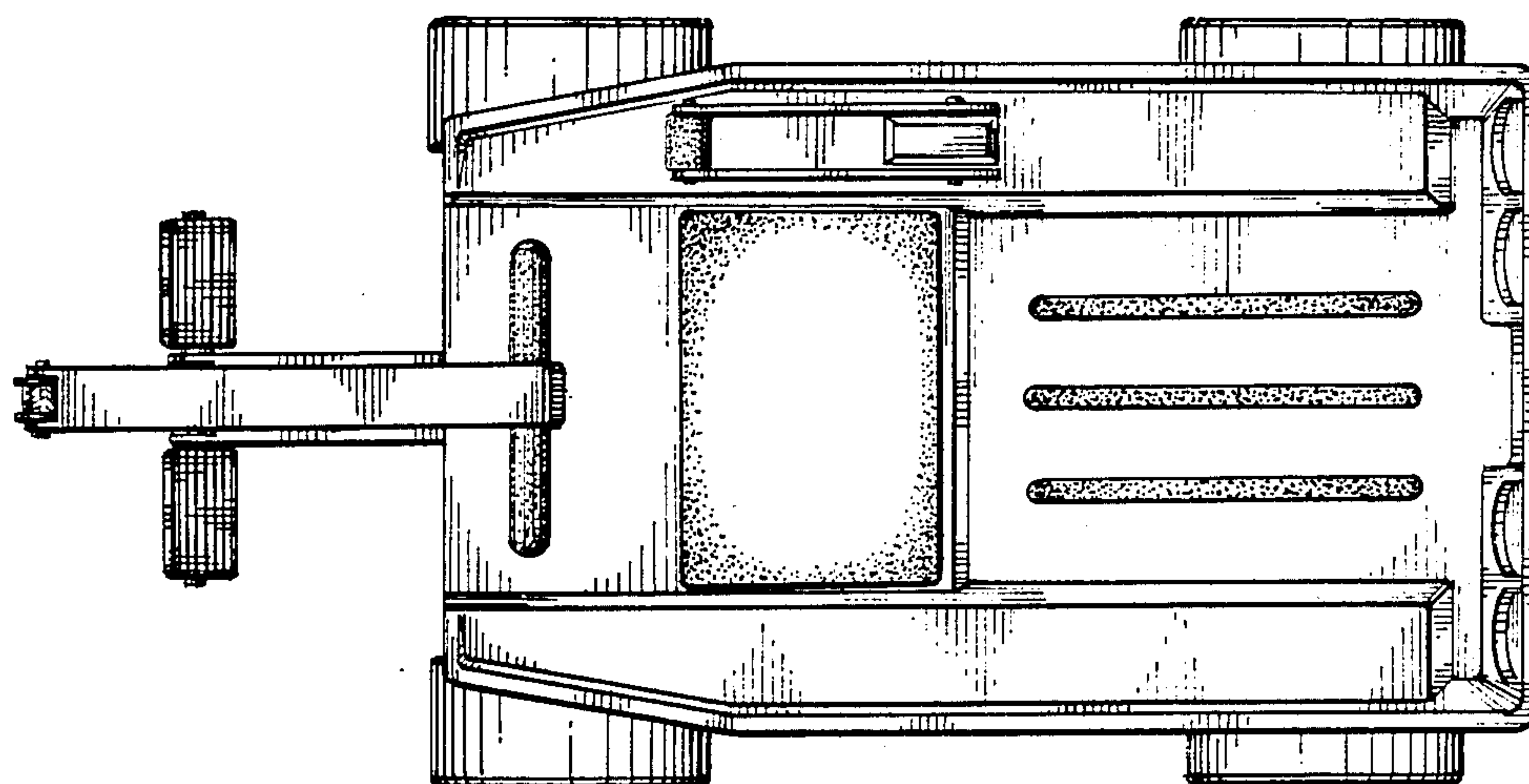

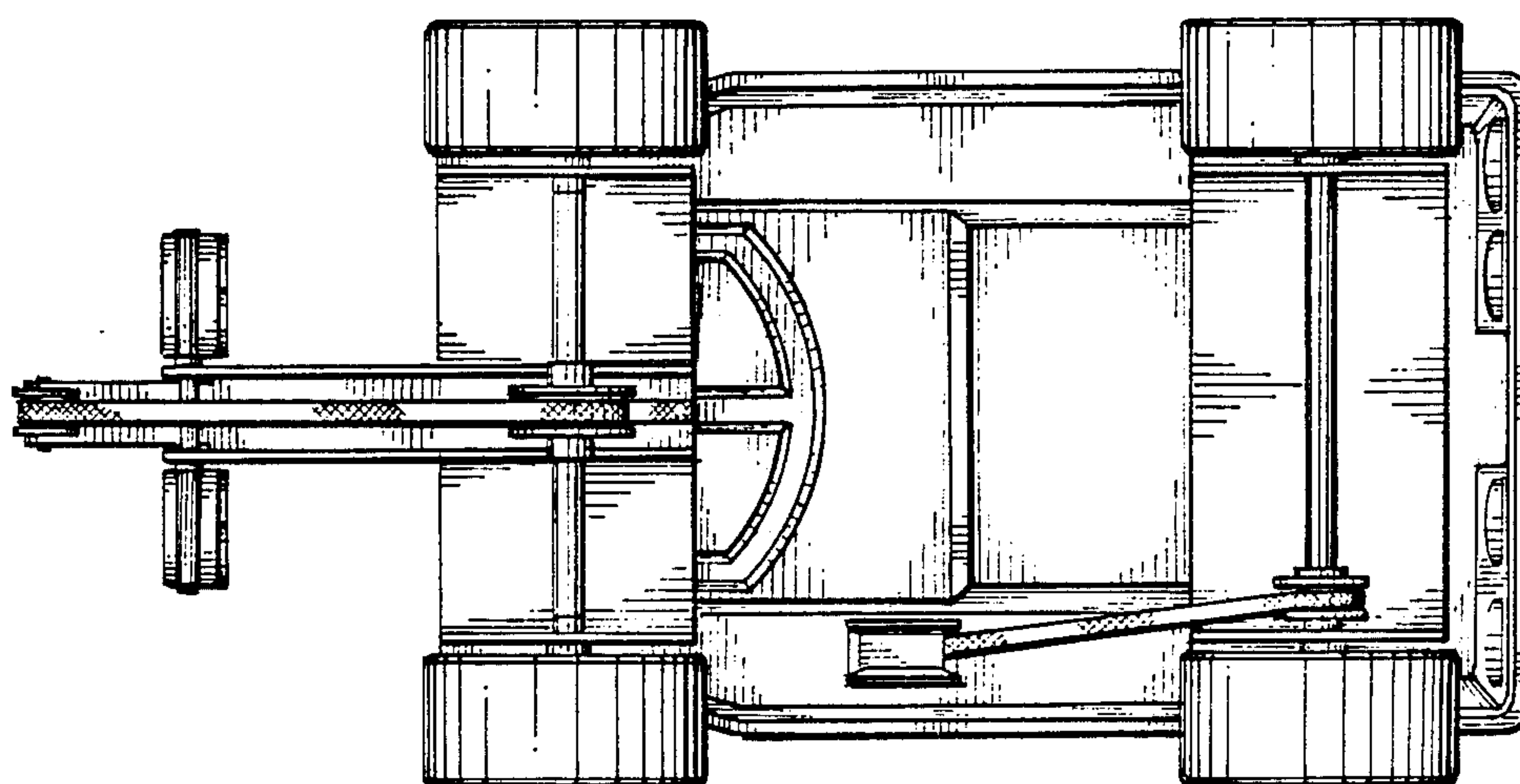

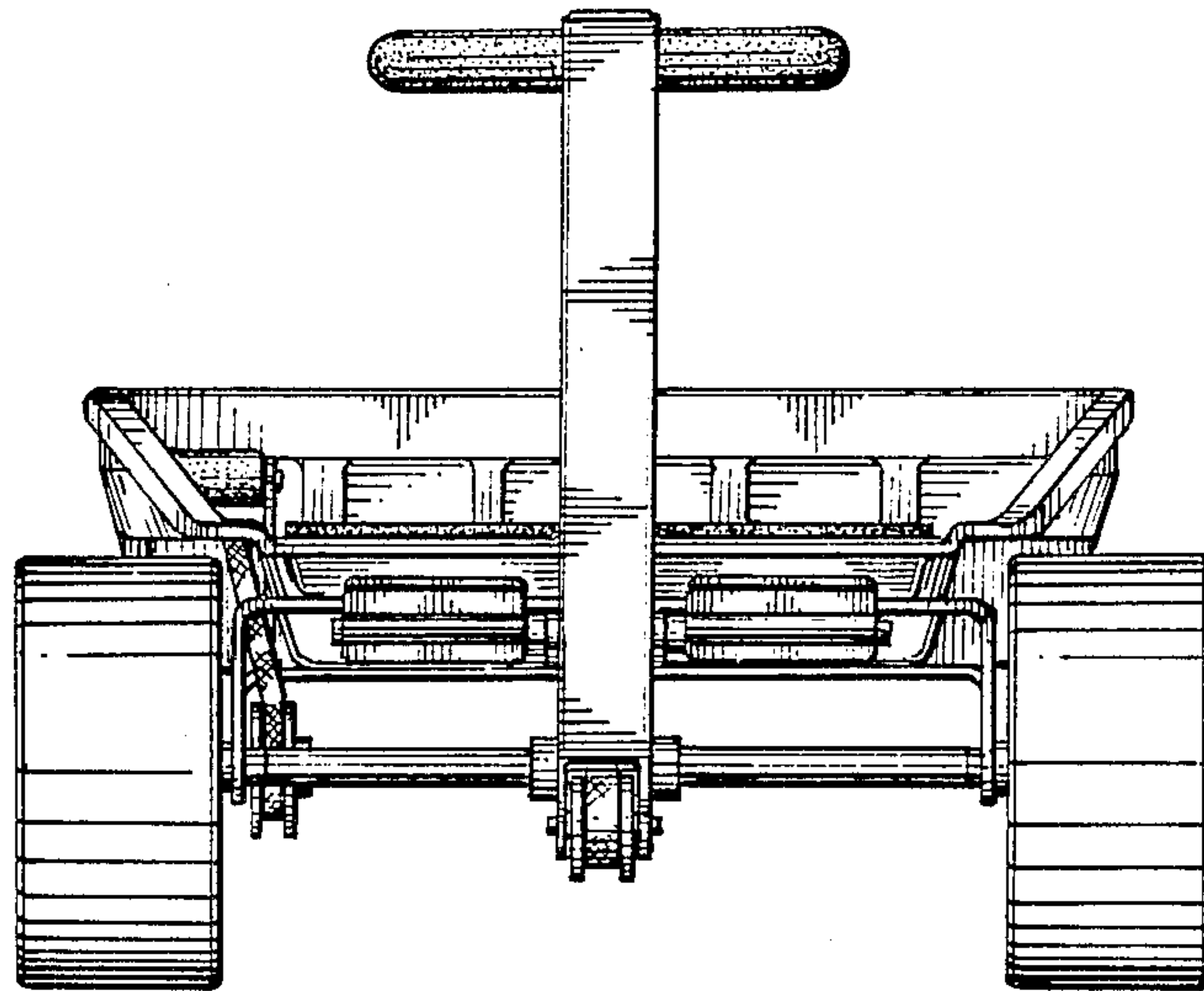

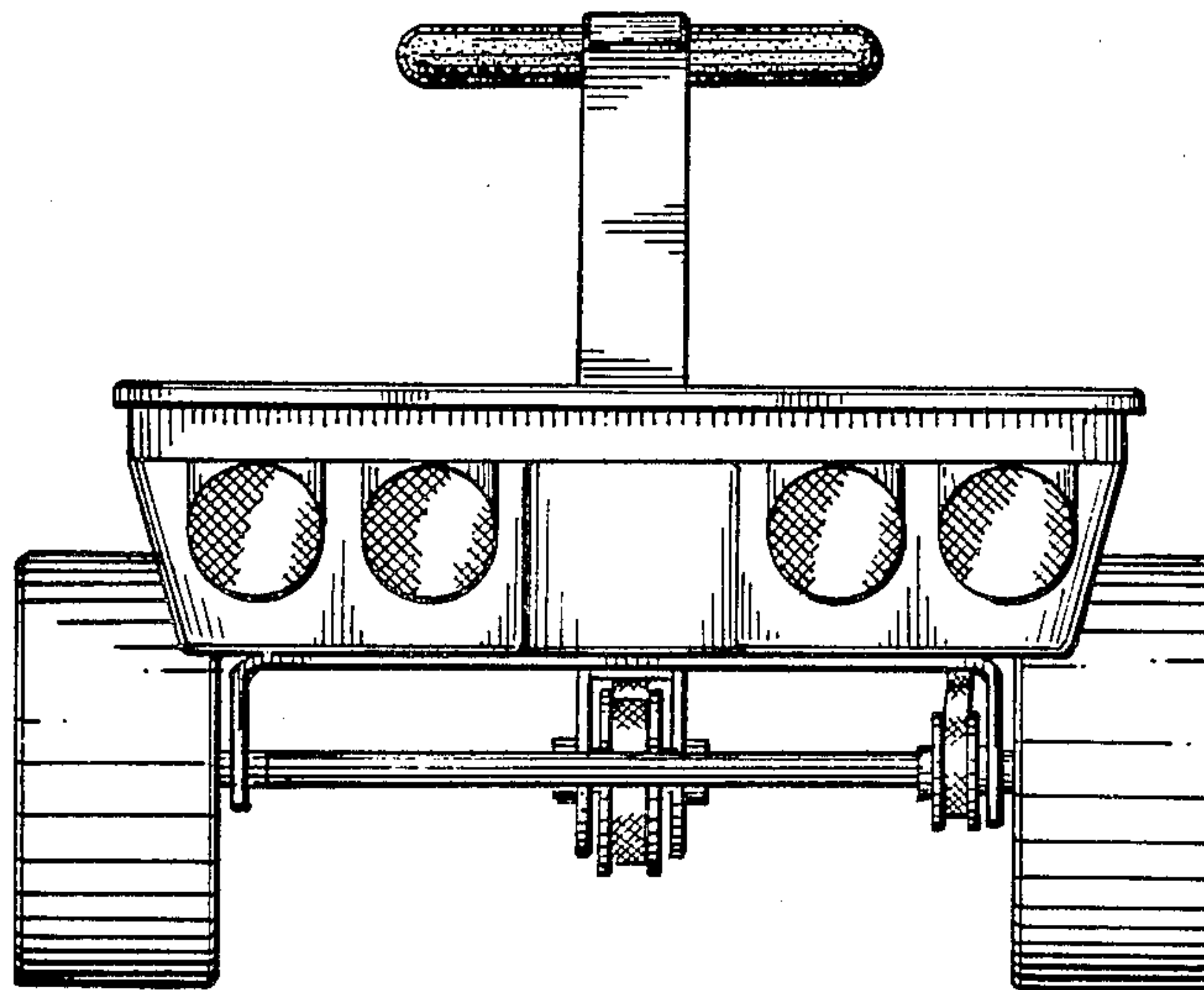
