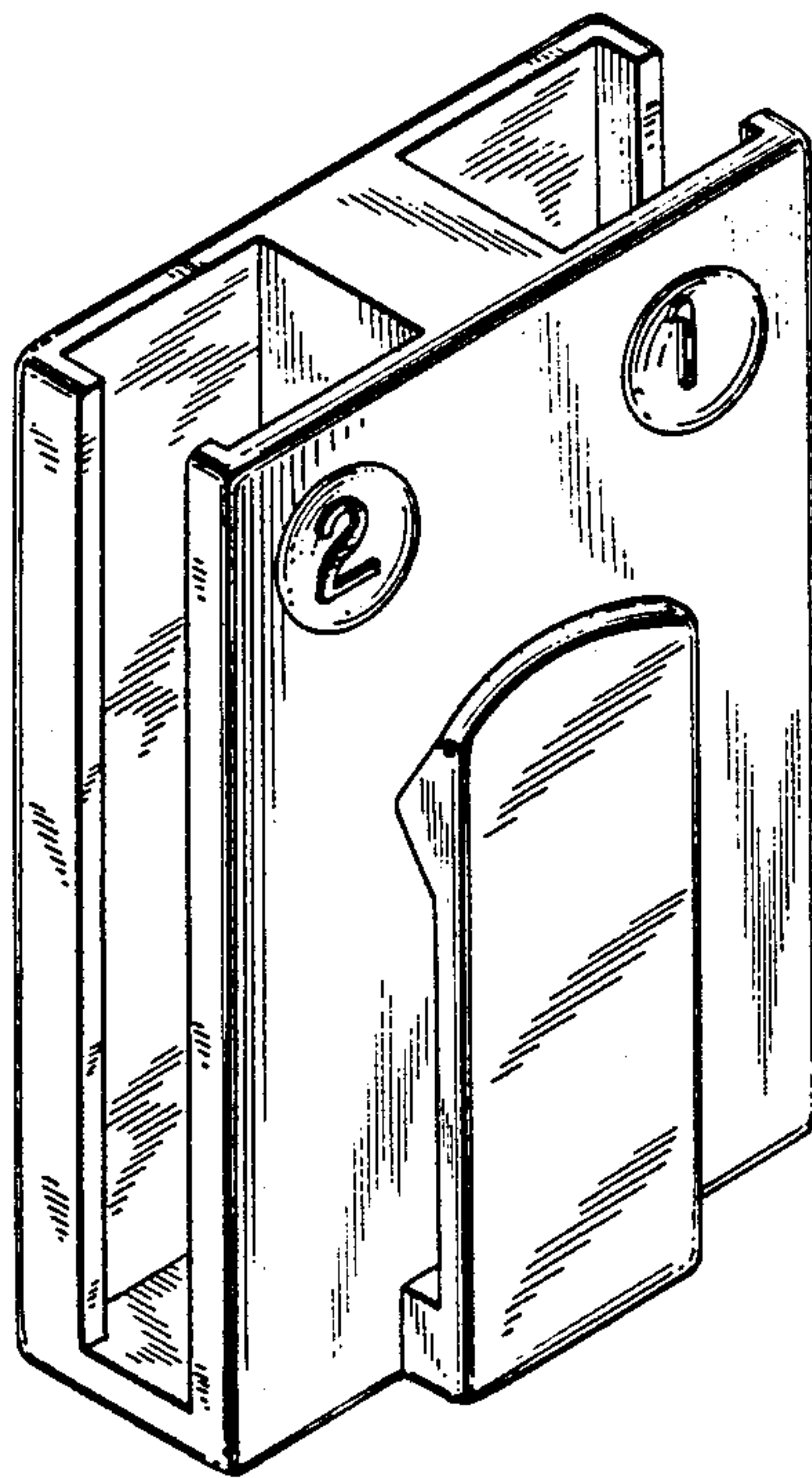

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a belt mounted holder for cassettes, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of the belt mounted holder for cassettes showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



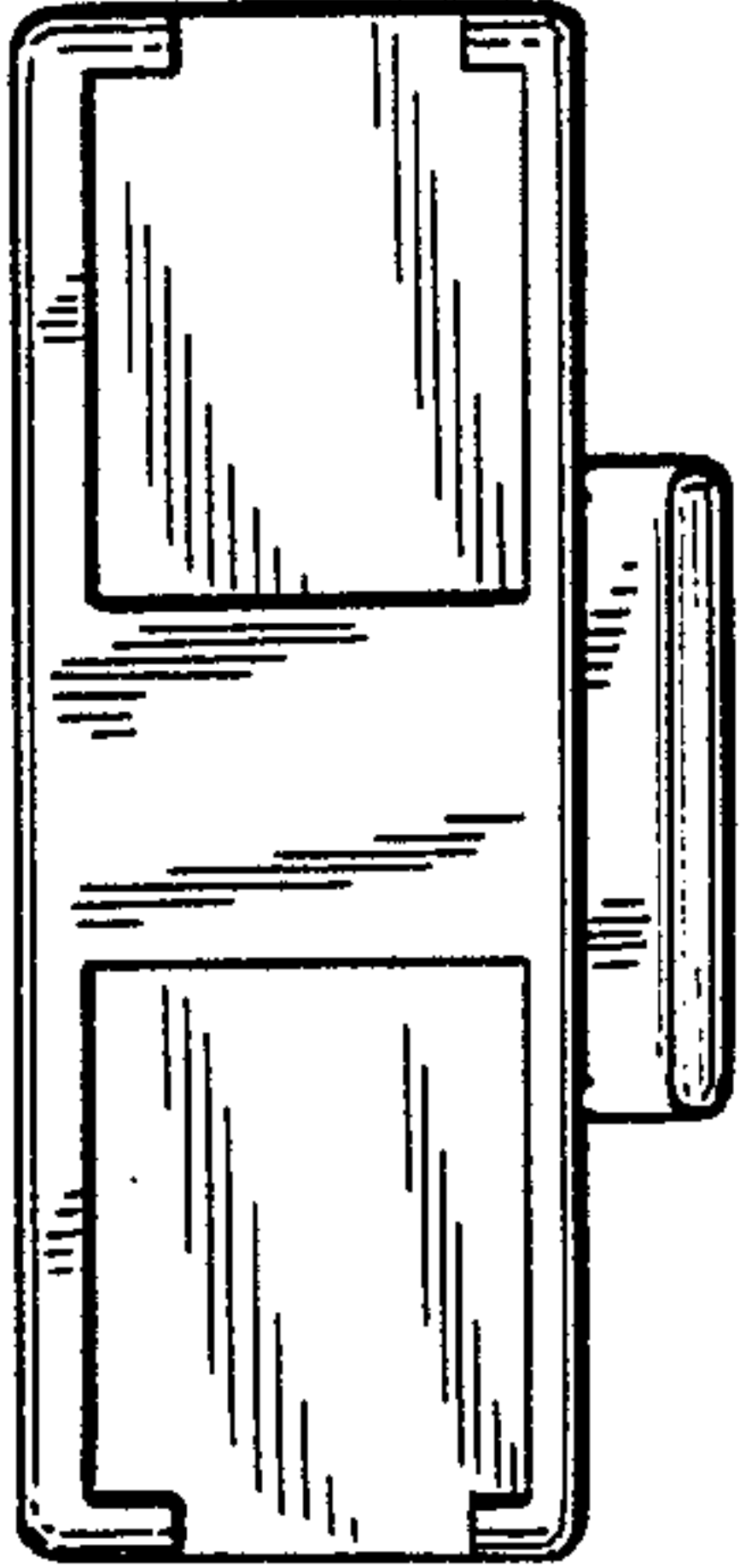

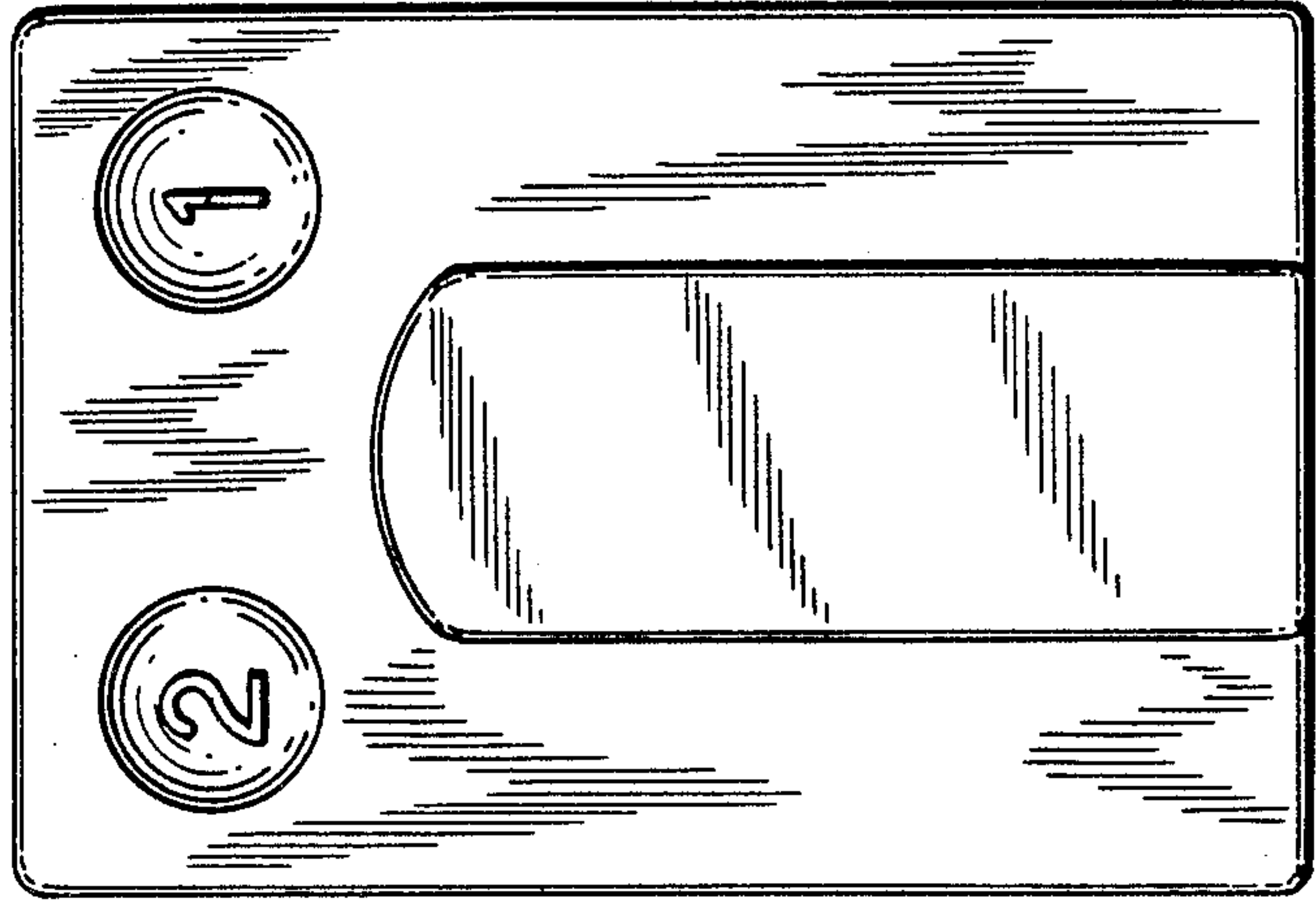

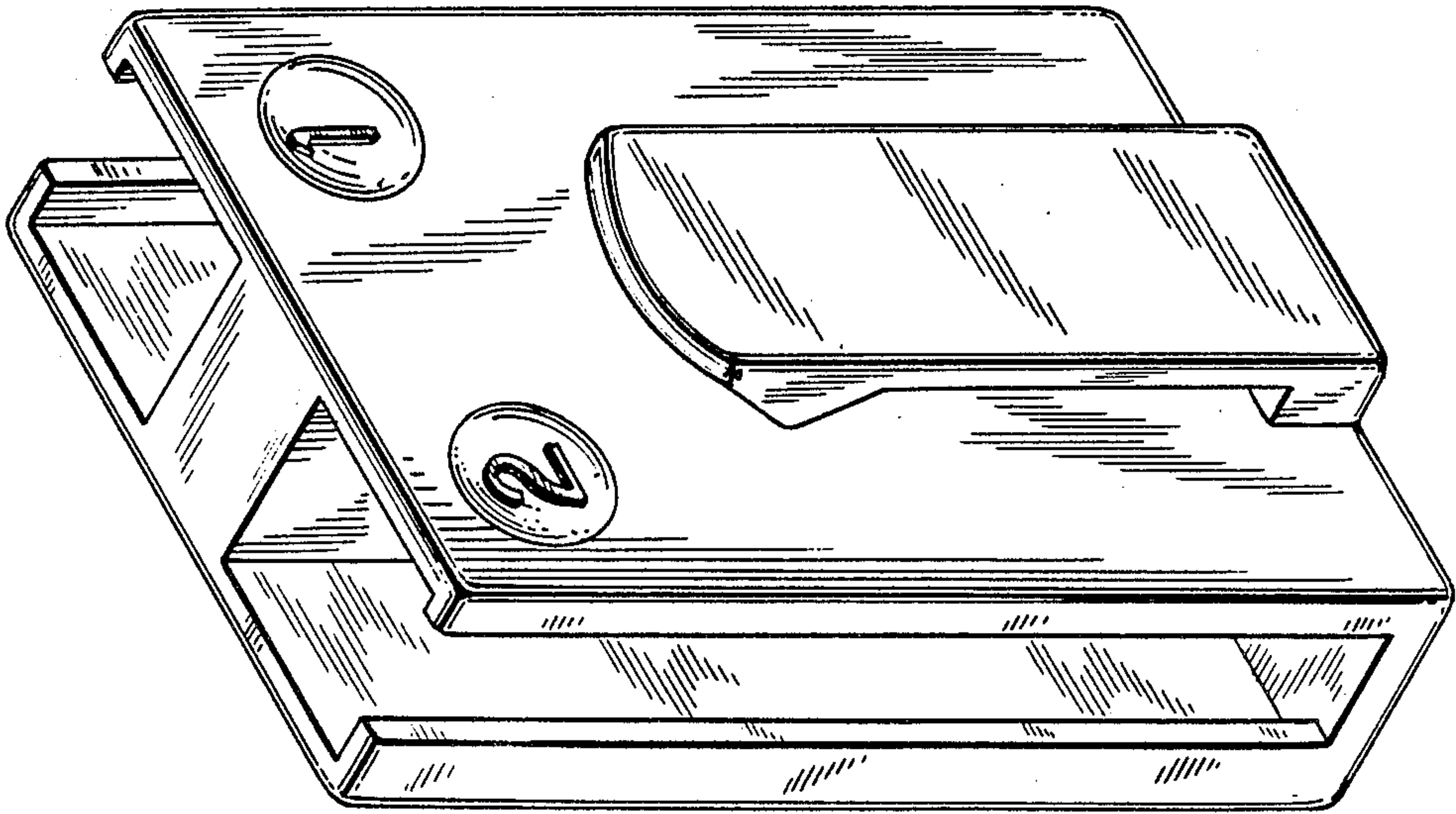

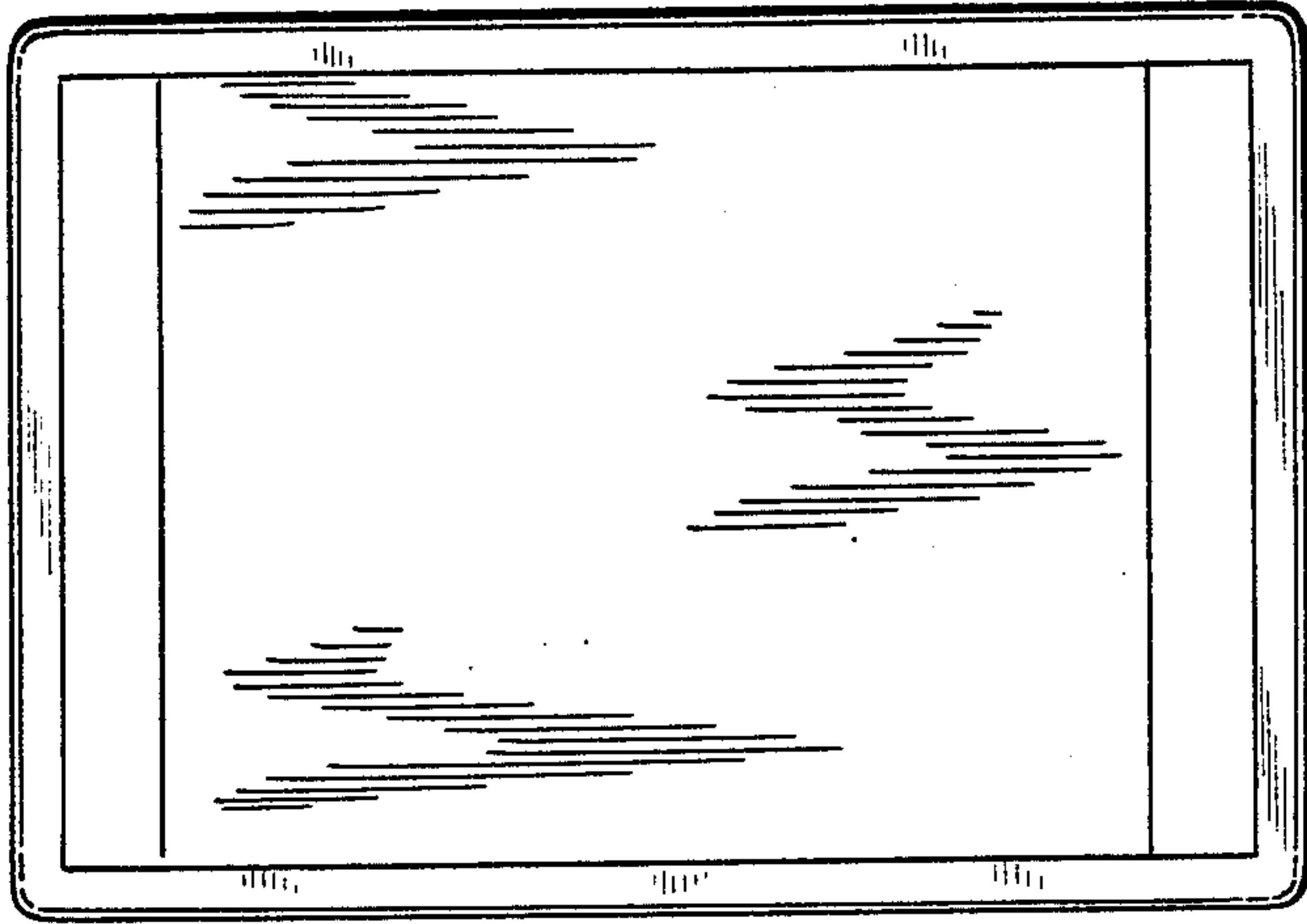

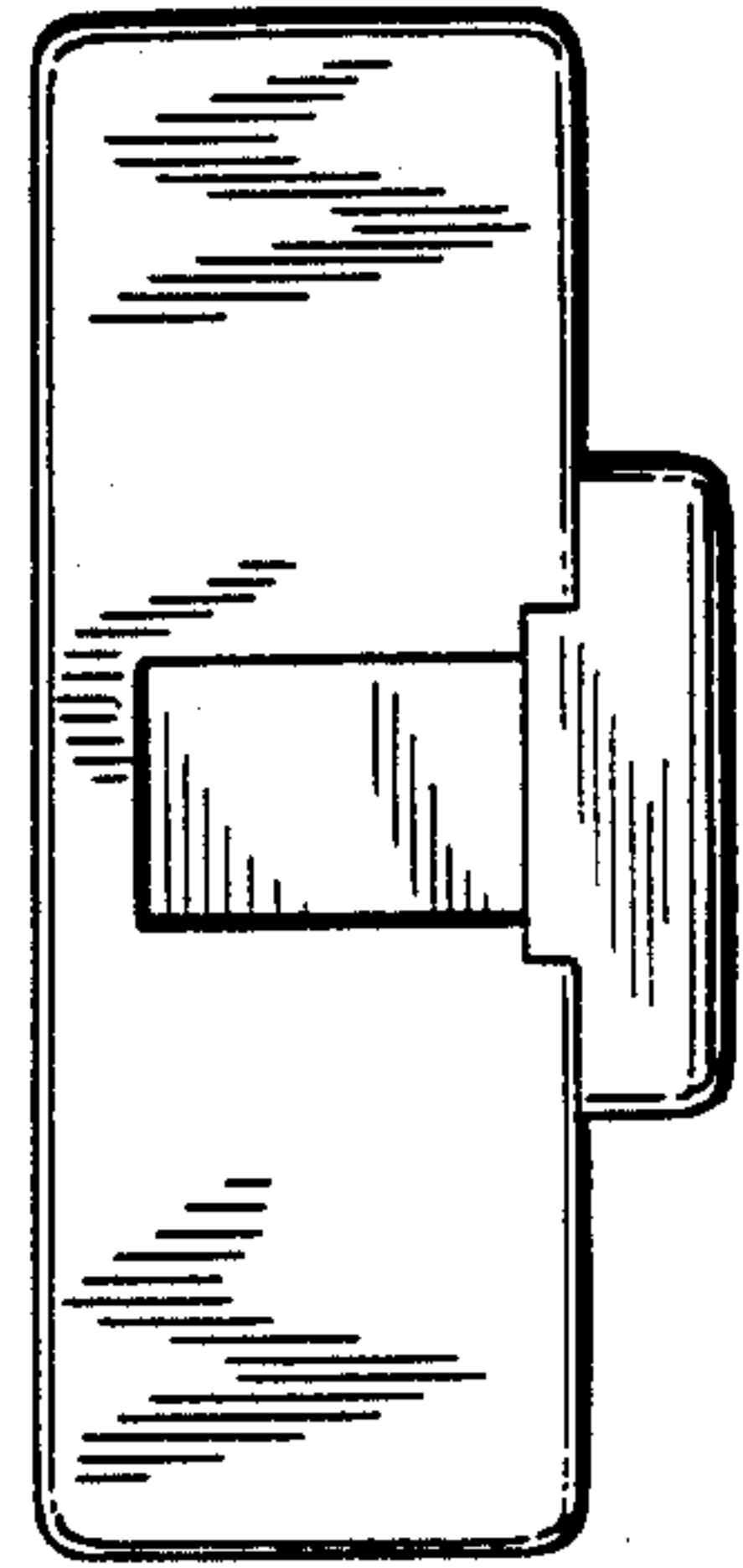

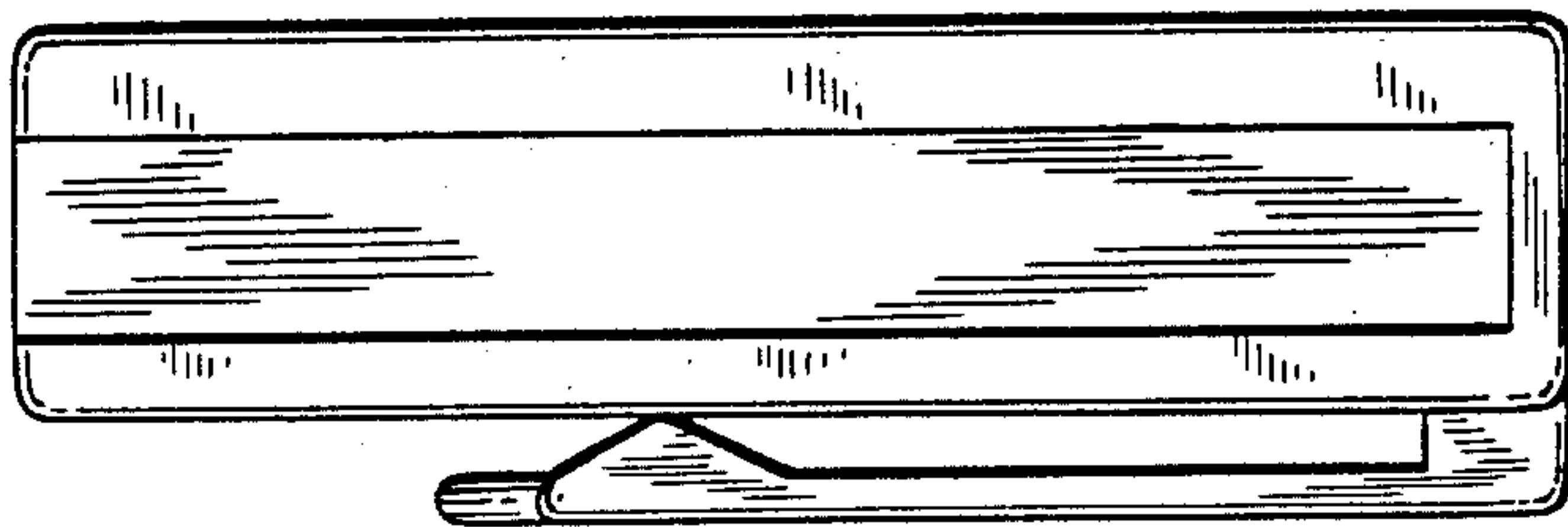
