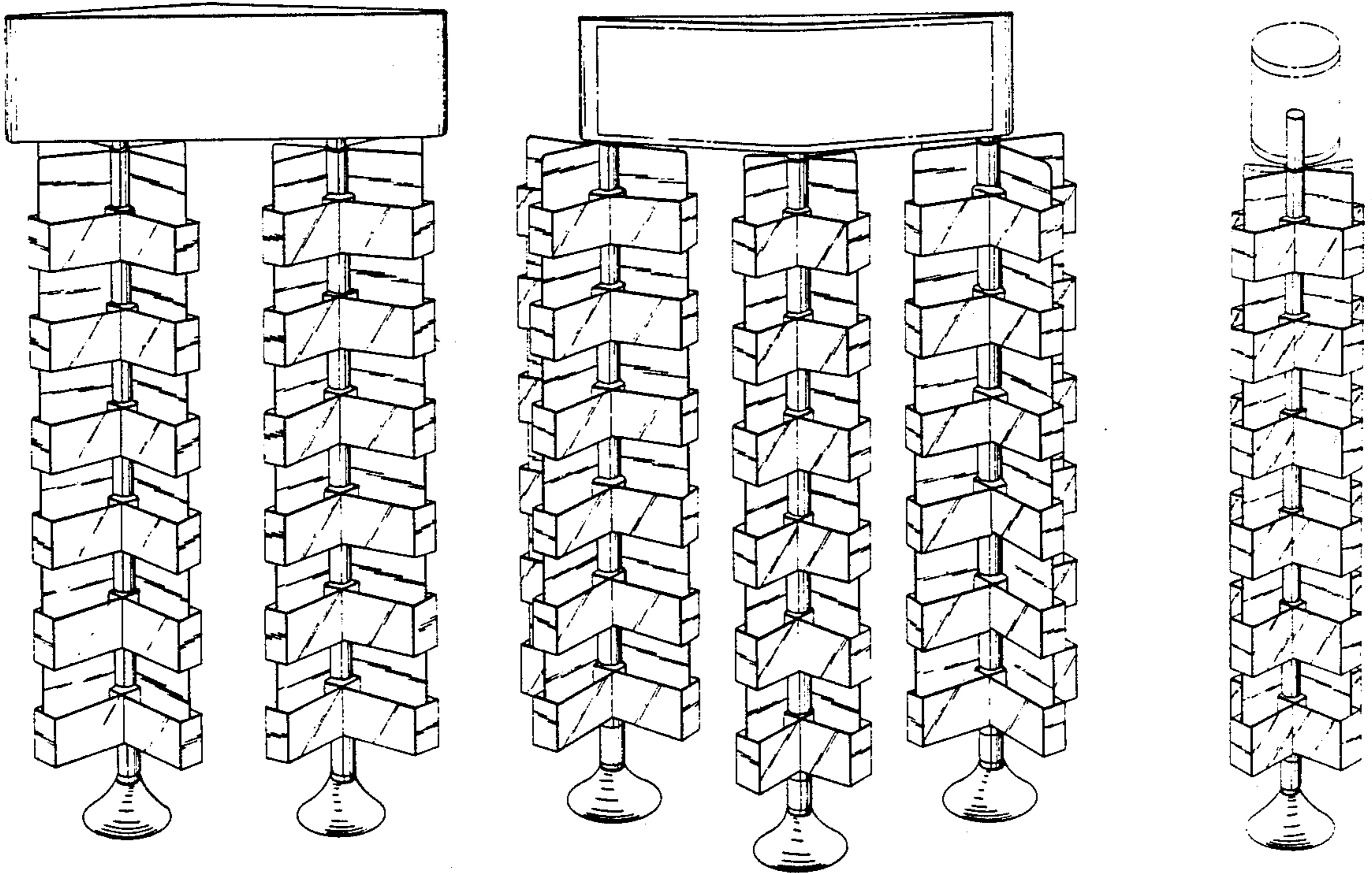

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rotatable merchandising display unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rotatable merchandising display unit showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged perspective view of one of the receptacles shown separately for convenience of illustration;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the rotatable merchandising display unit shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 9 is a third embodiment of the rotatable merchandising display unit shown in FIG. 1.



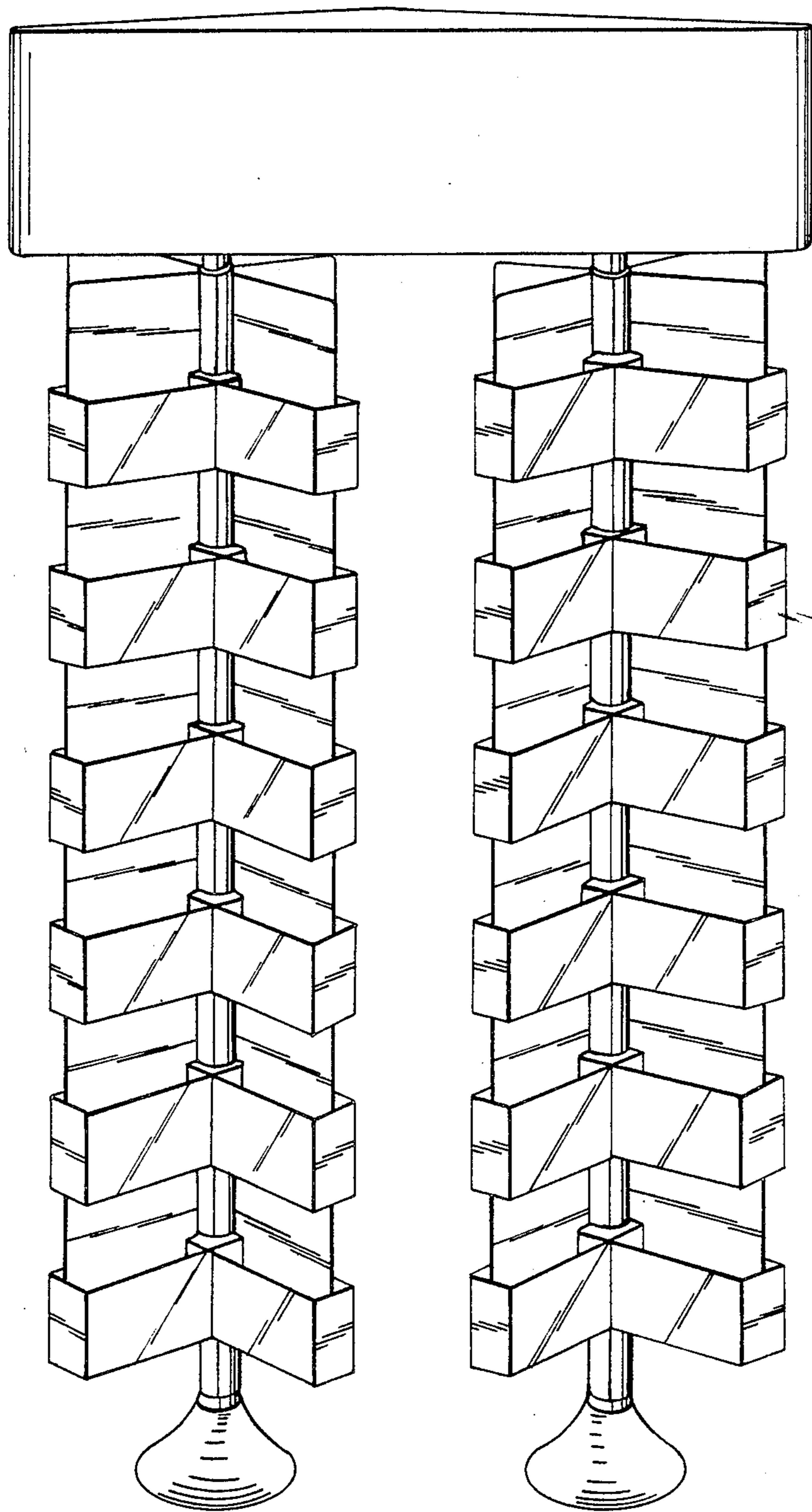

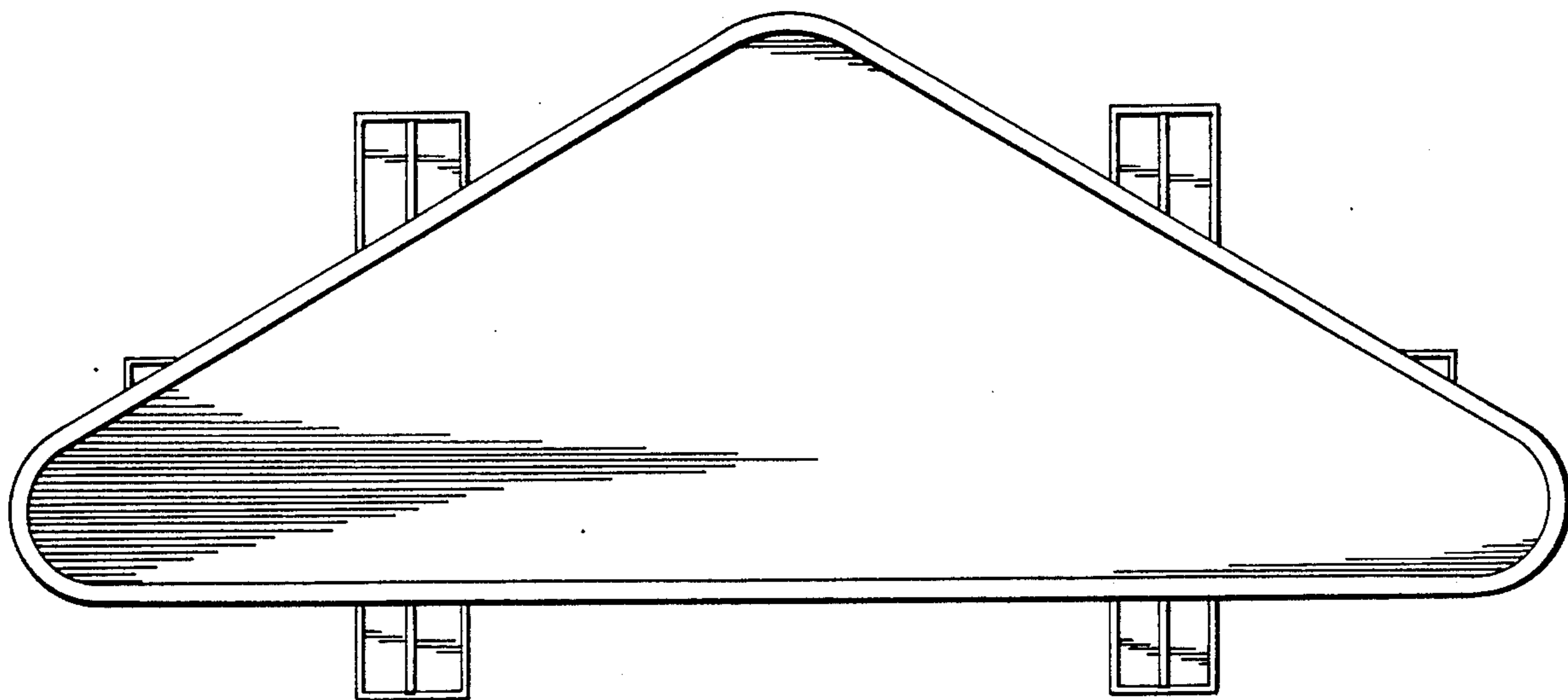

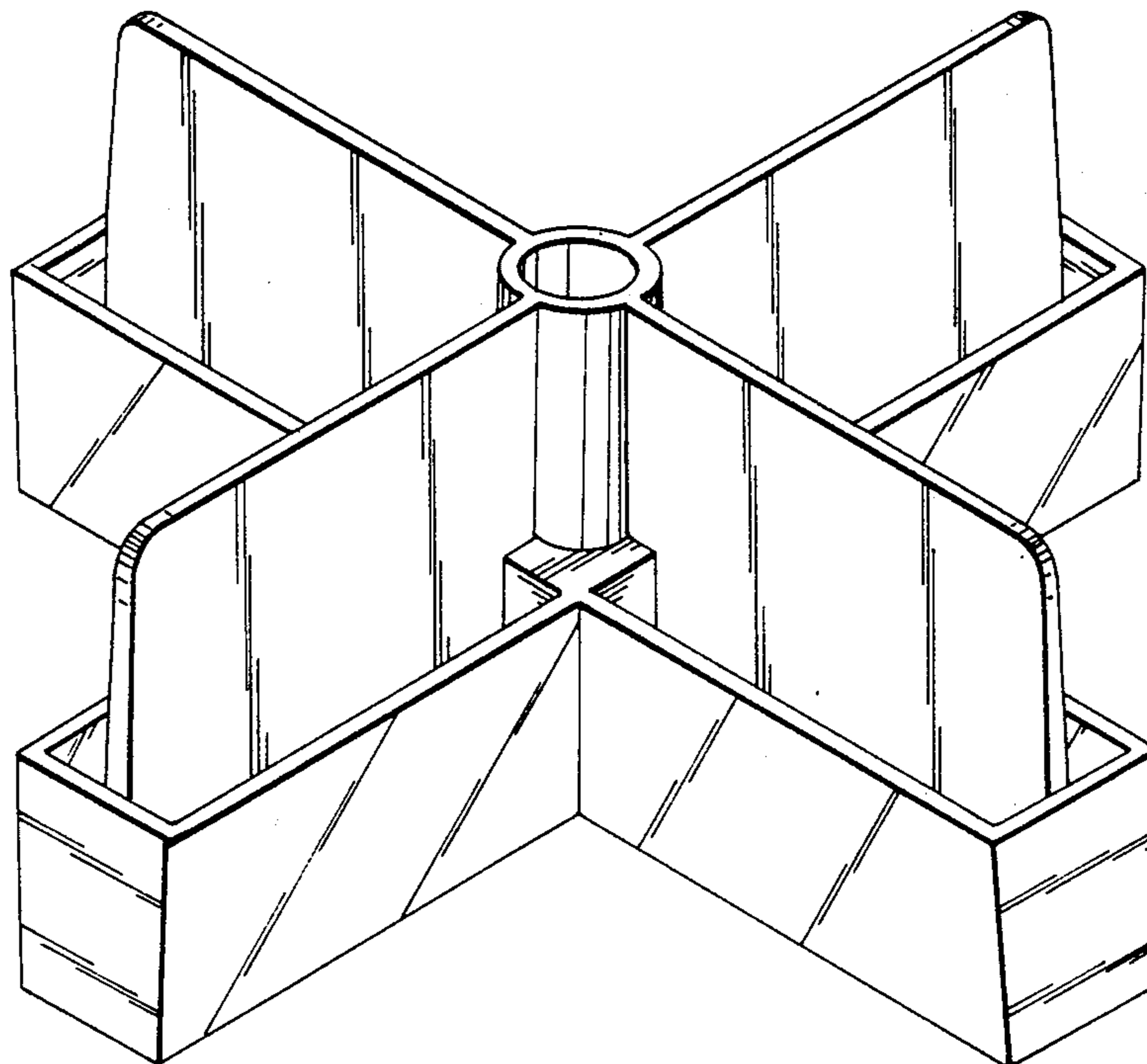
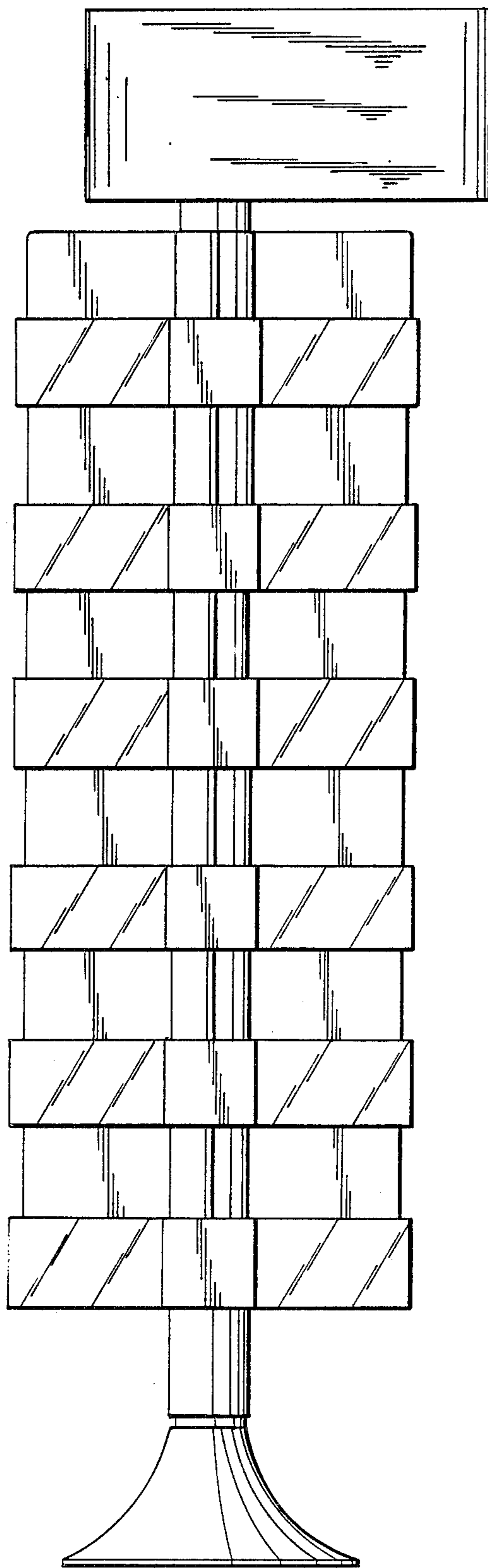

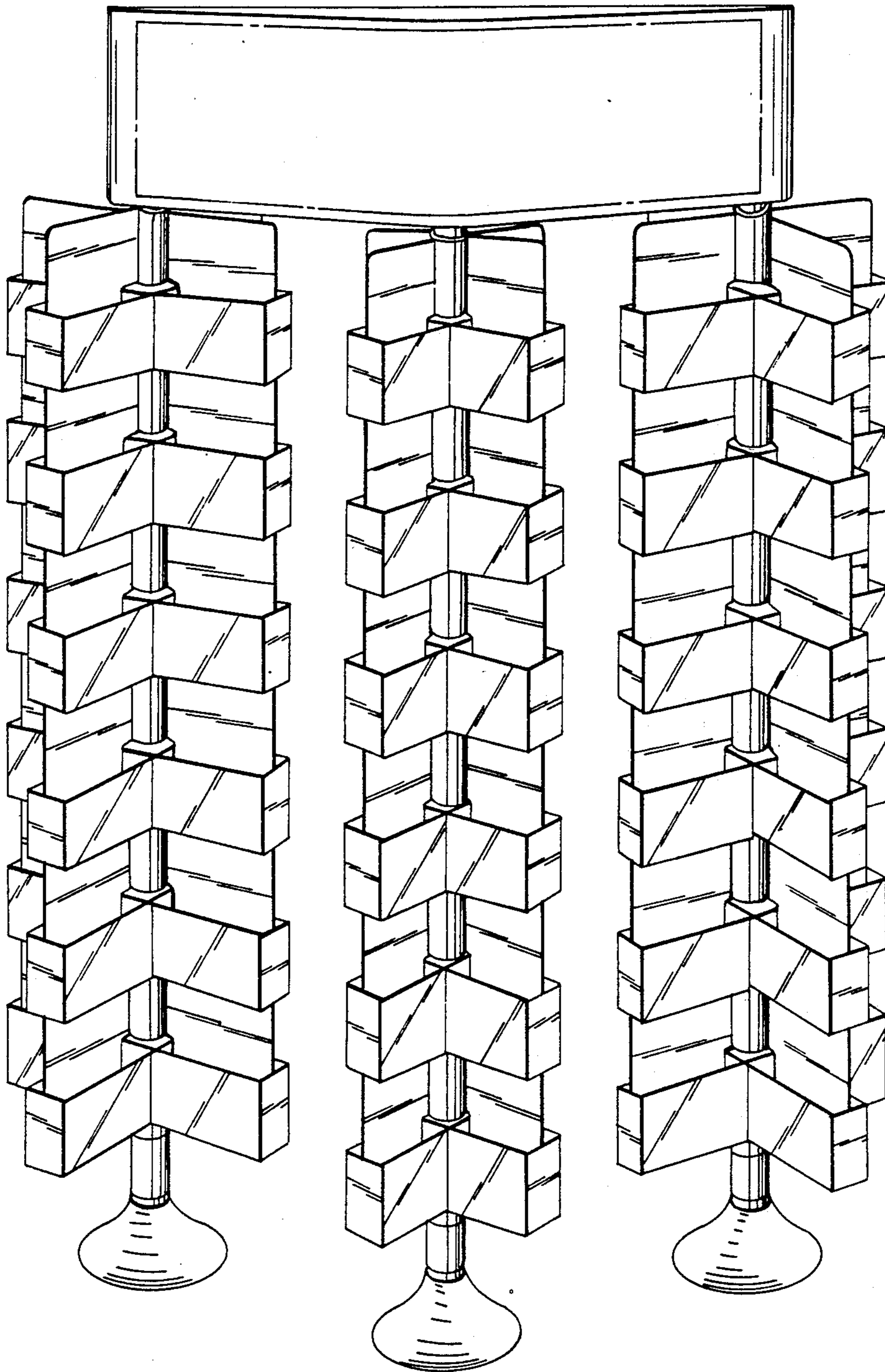

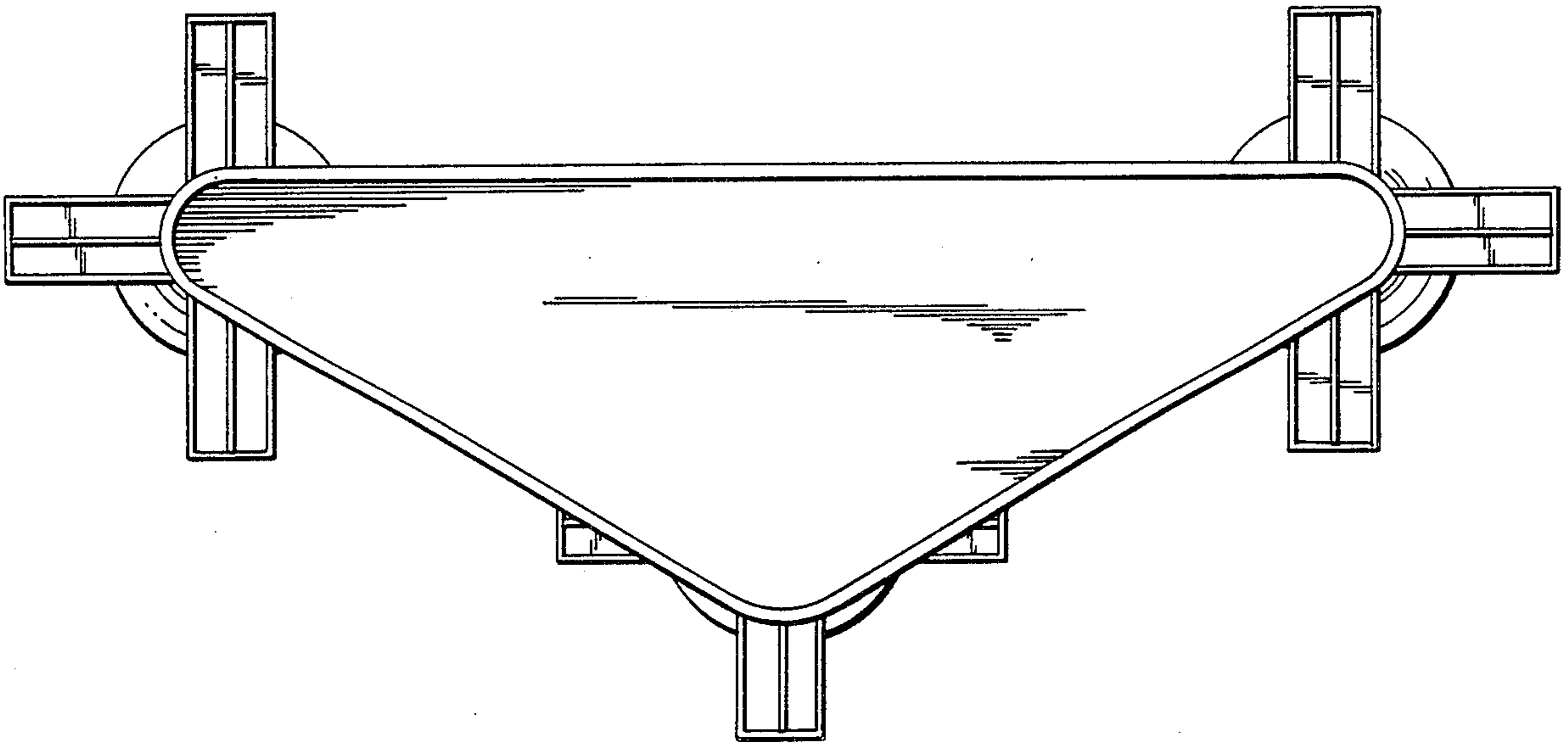

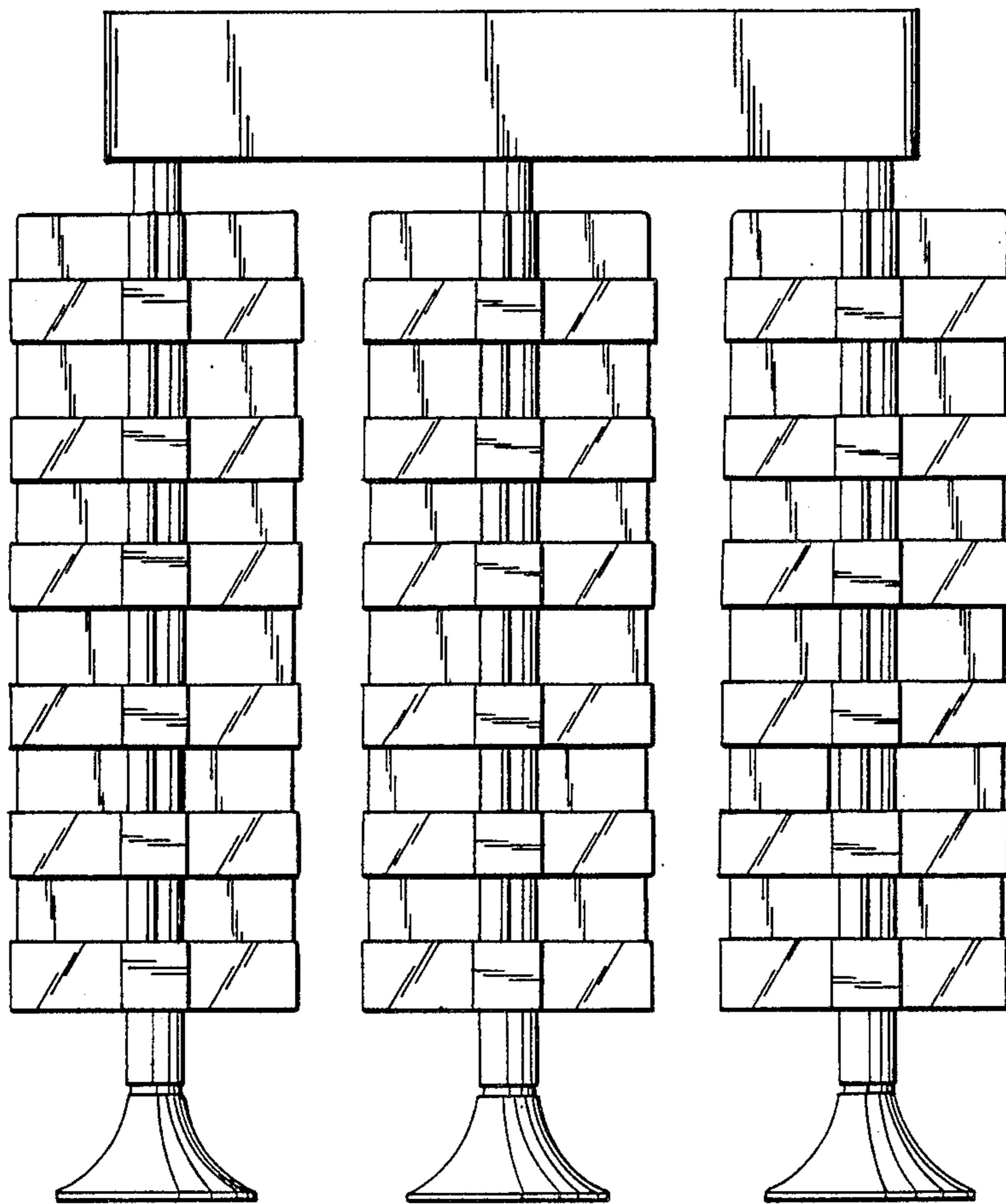

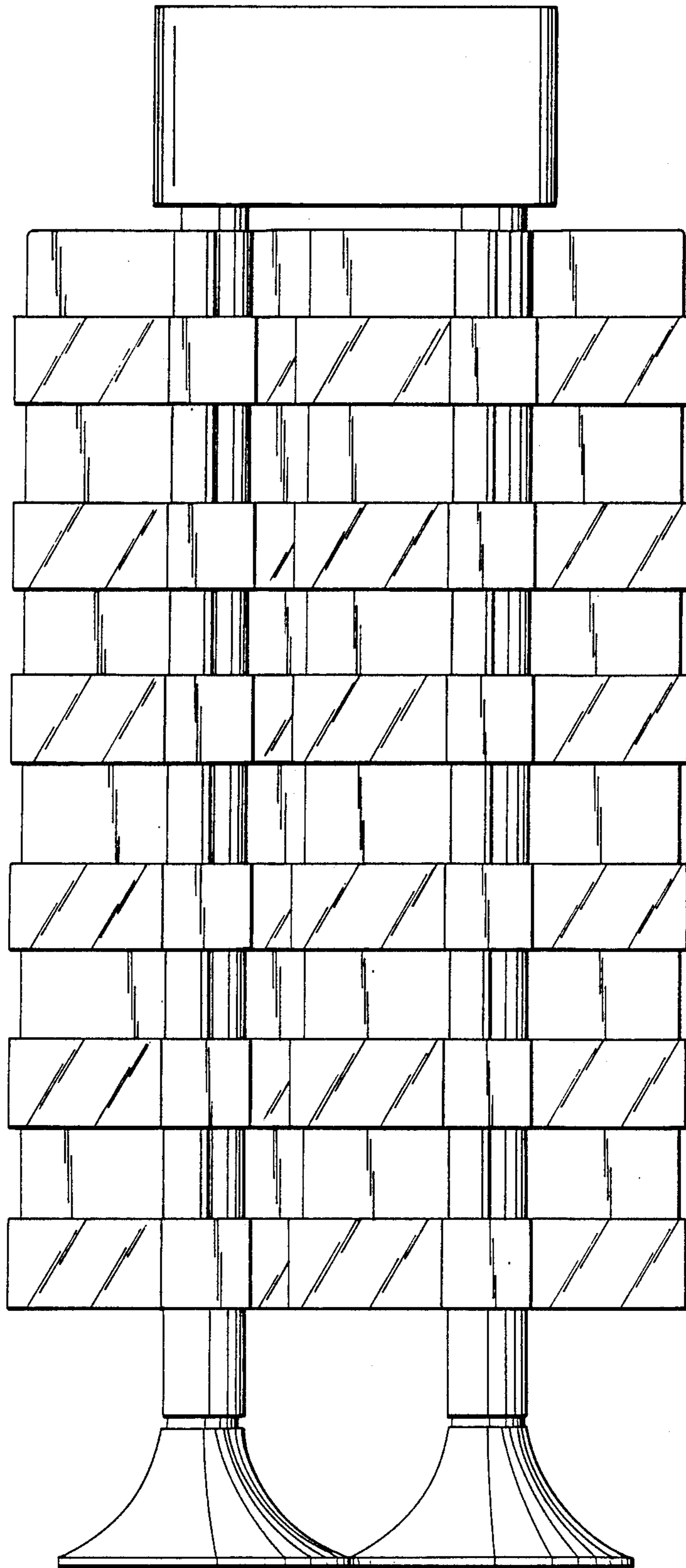

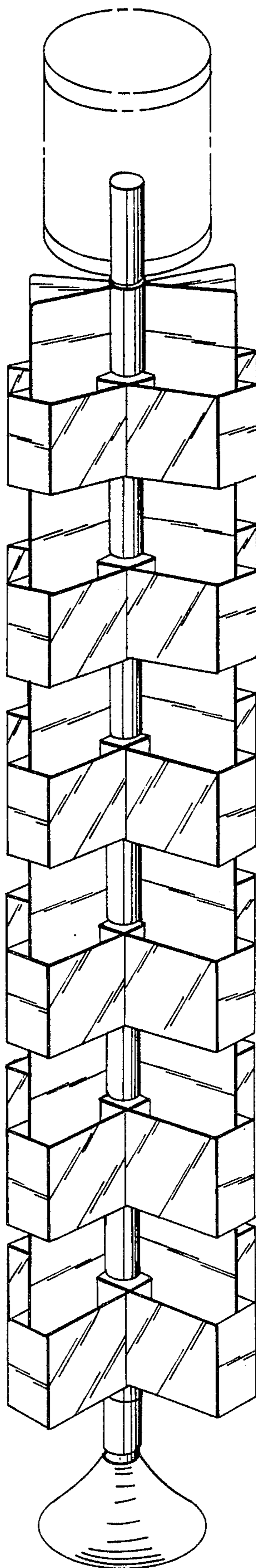
