The ornamental design for a stackable end display stand for a merchandising unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stackable end display stand for a merchandising unit showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view, the broken lines indicate environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design;

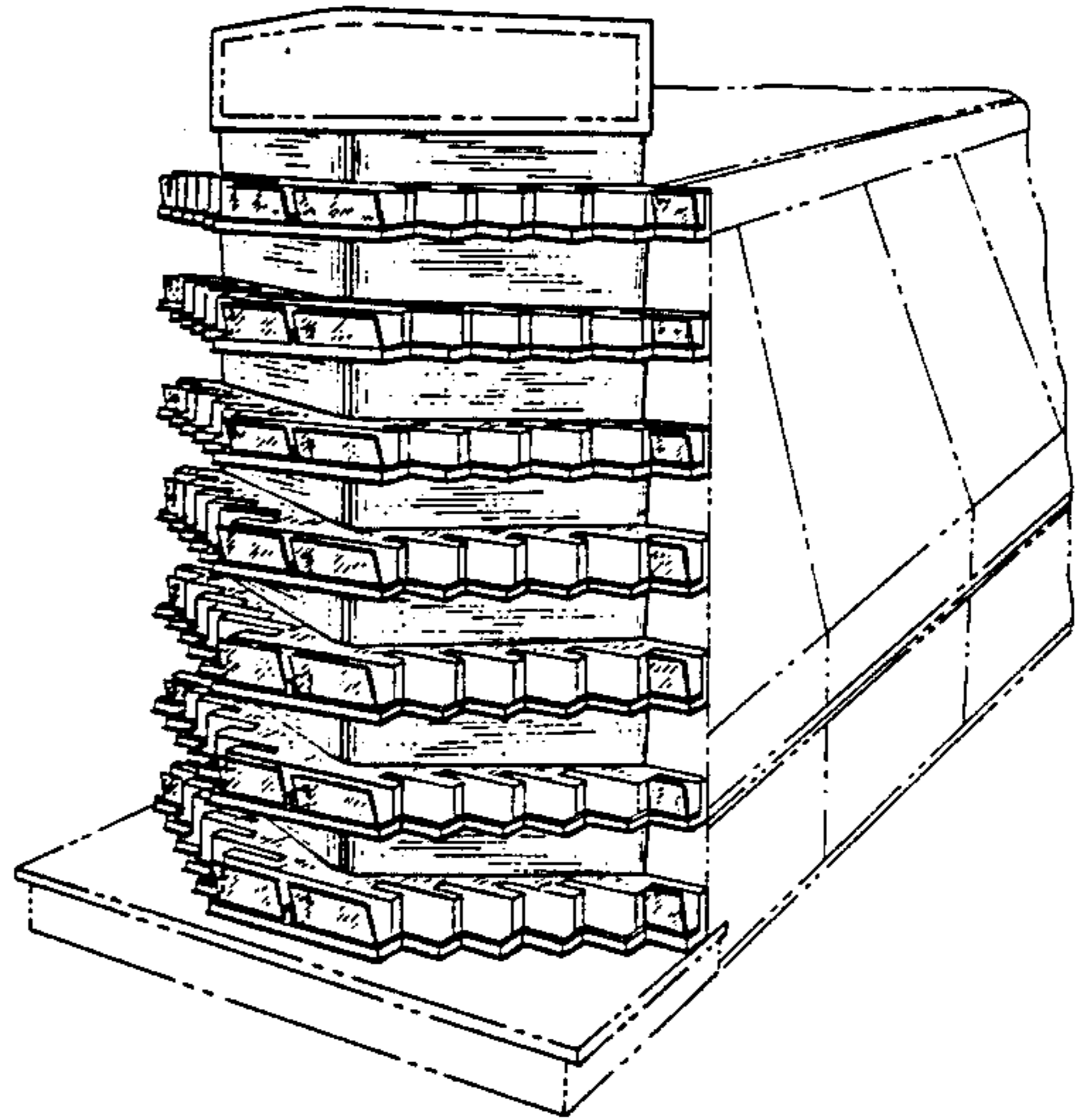
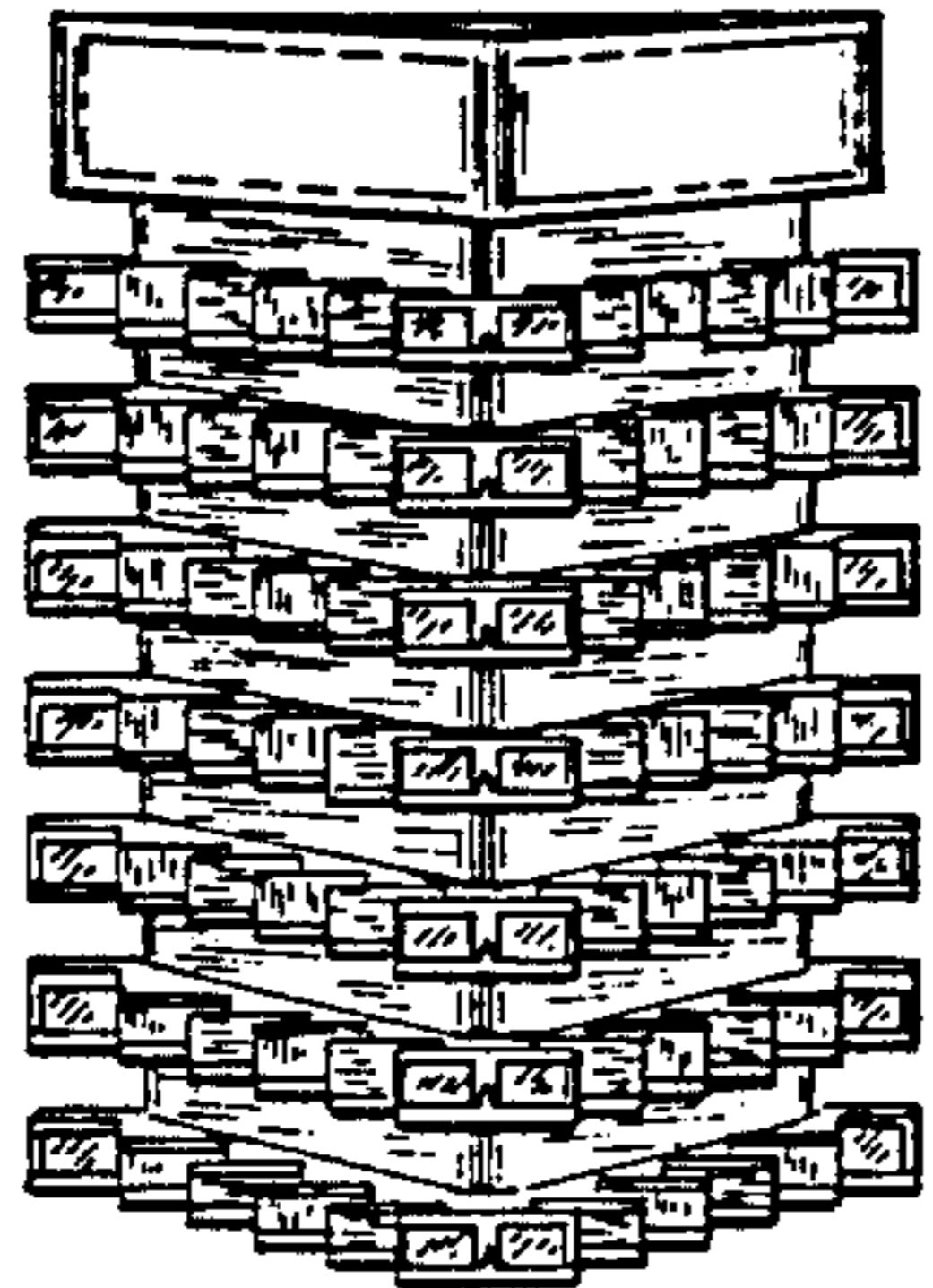
FIG. 8 is an enlarged top plan view of one of the stackable units shown separately for convenience of illustration;

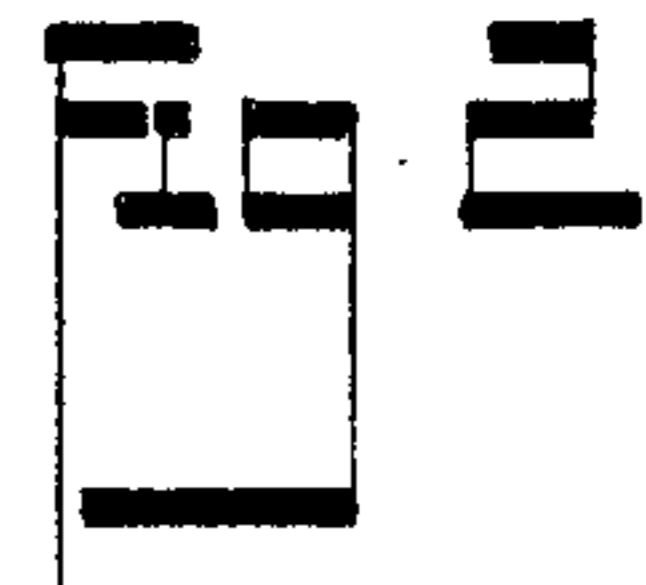
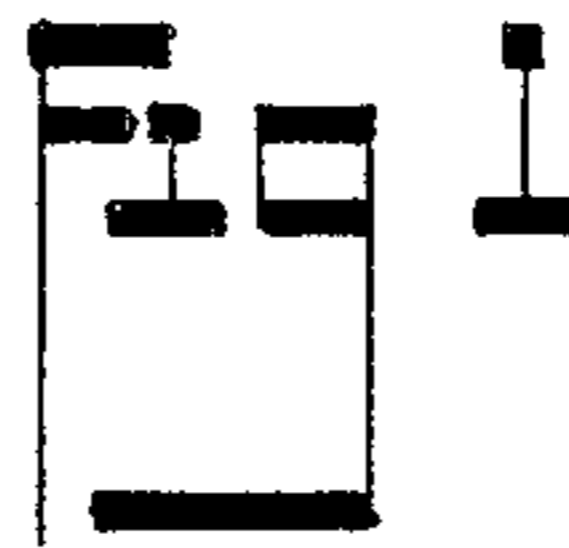
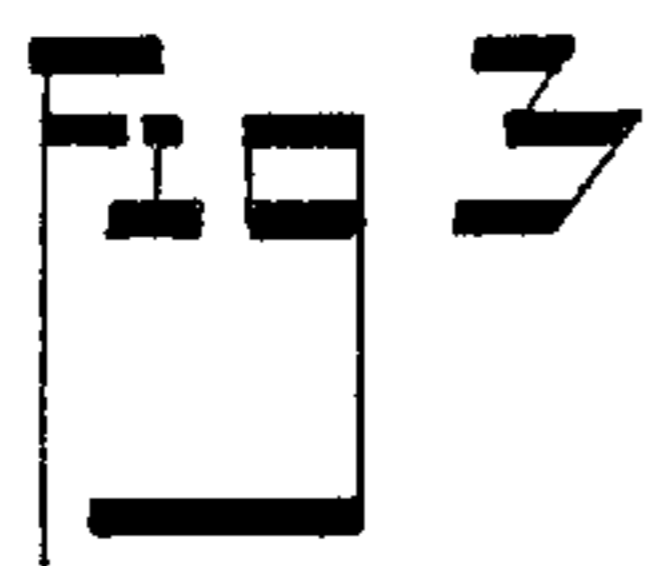
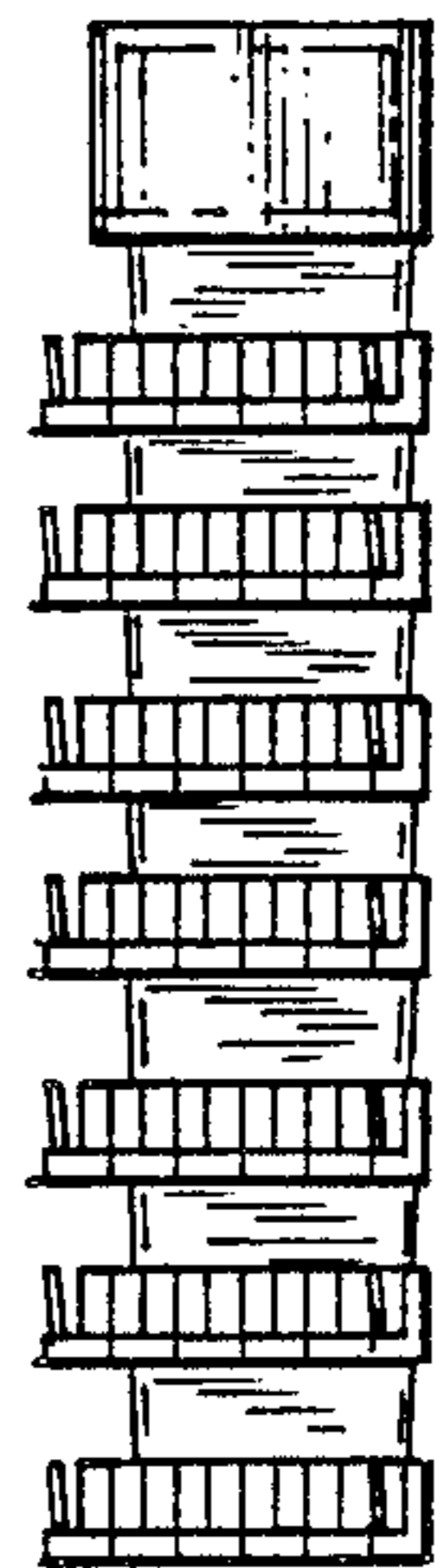
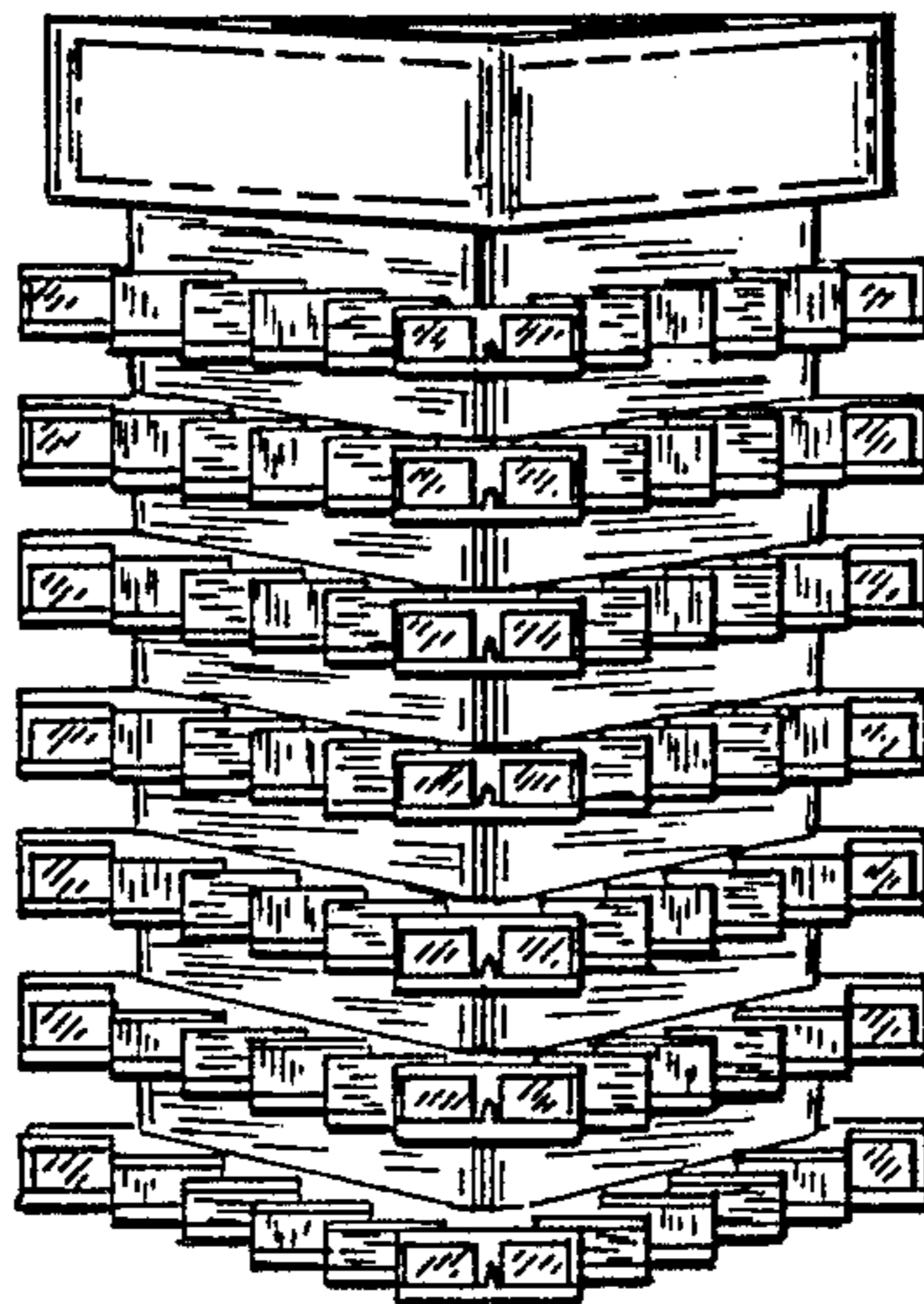
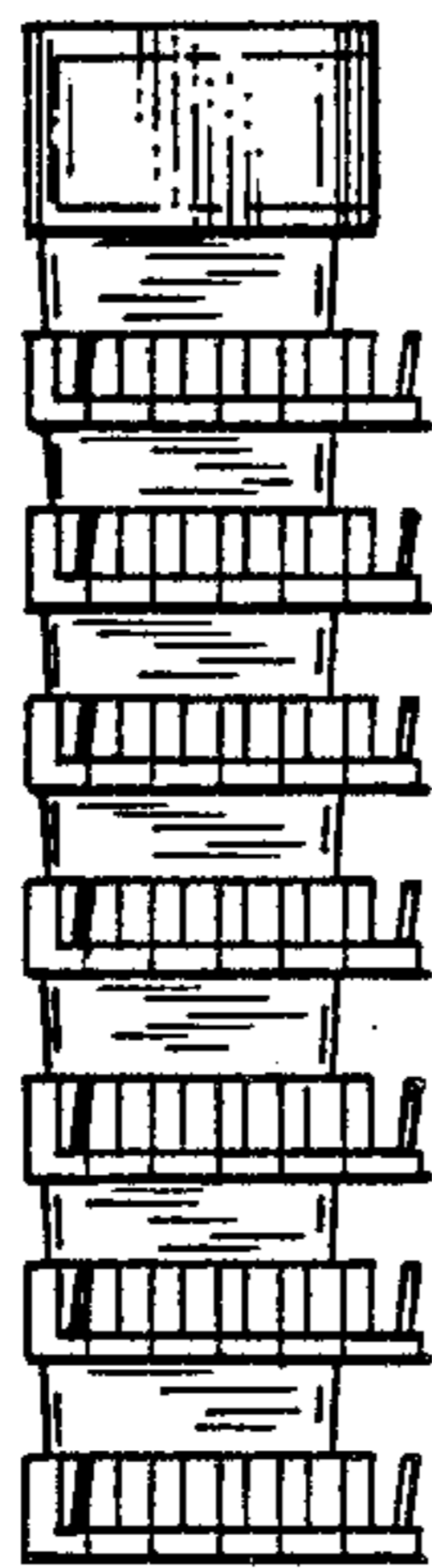
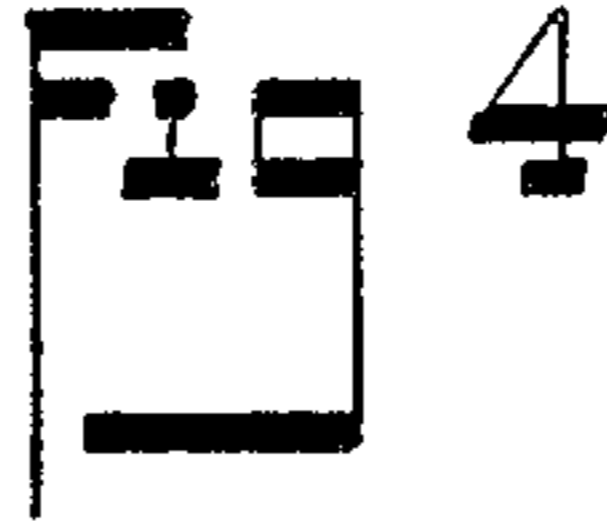
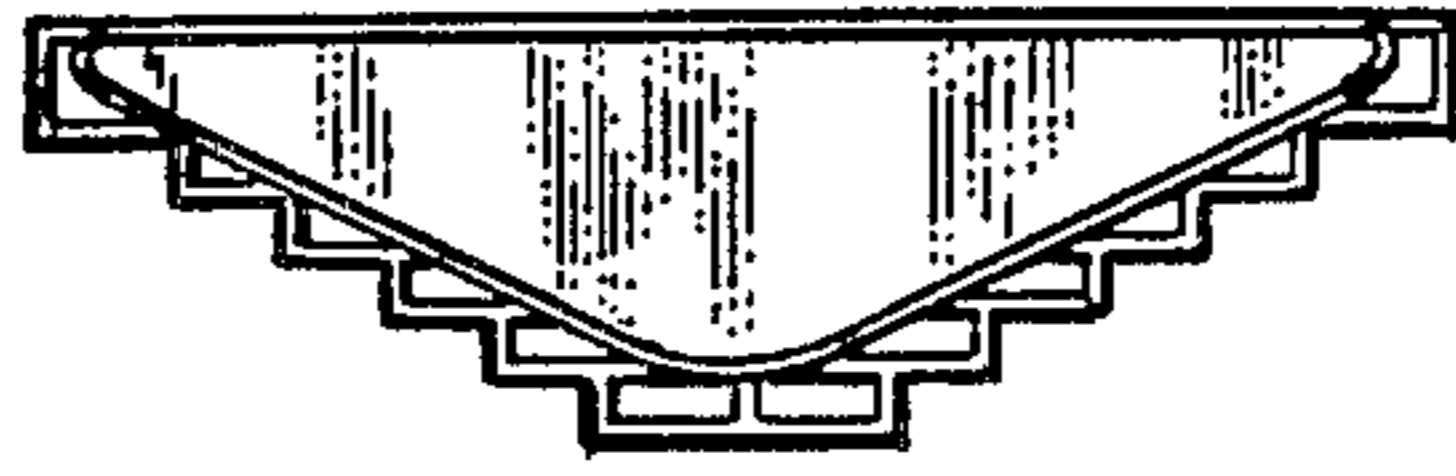
FIG. 9 is front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof.





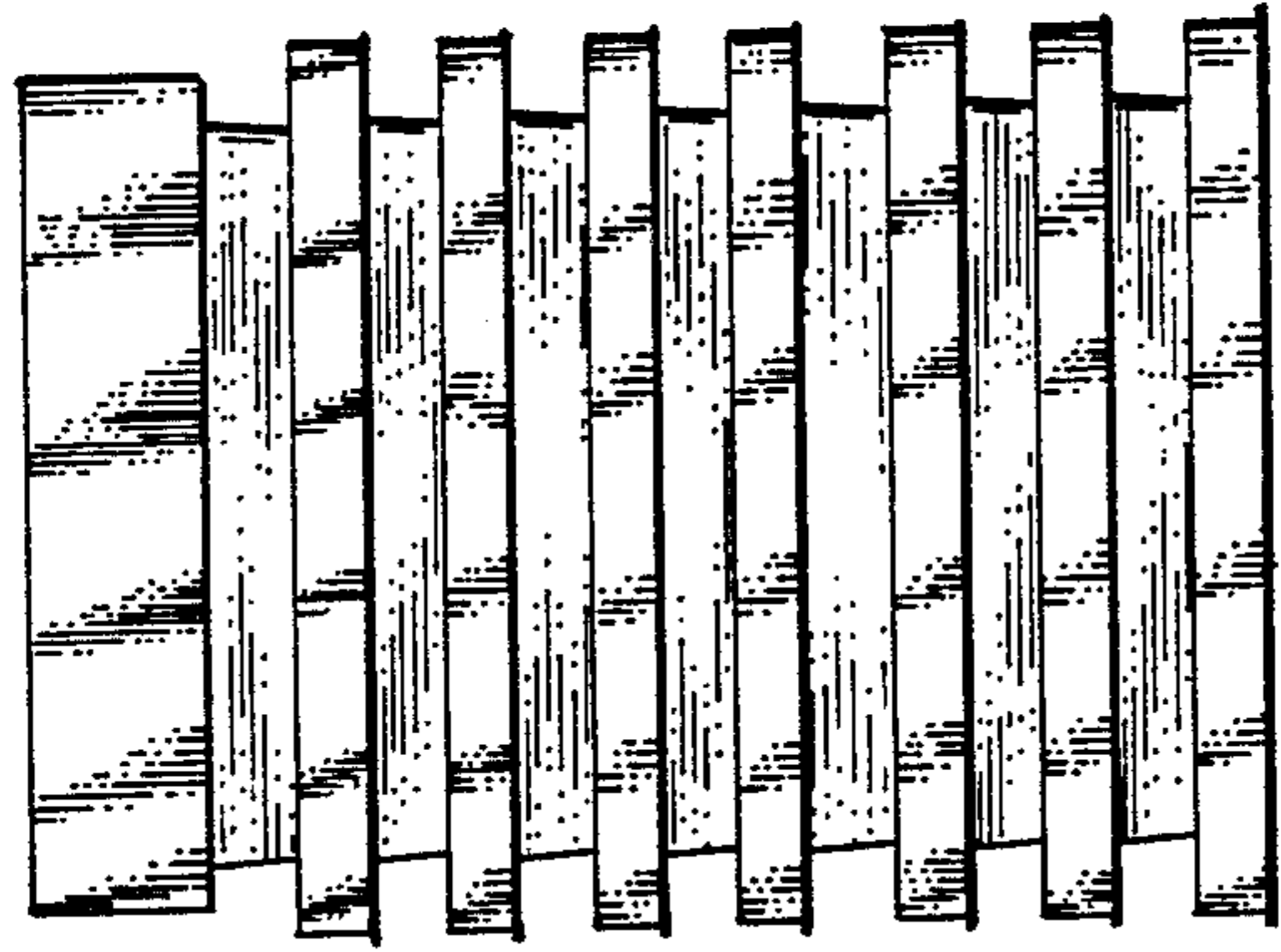

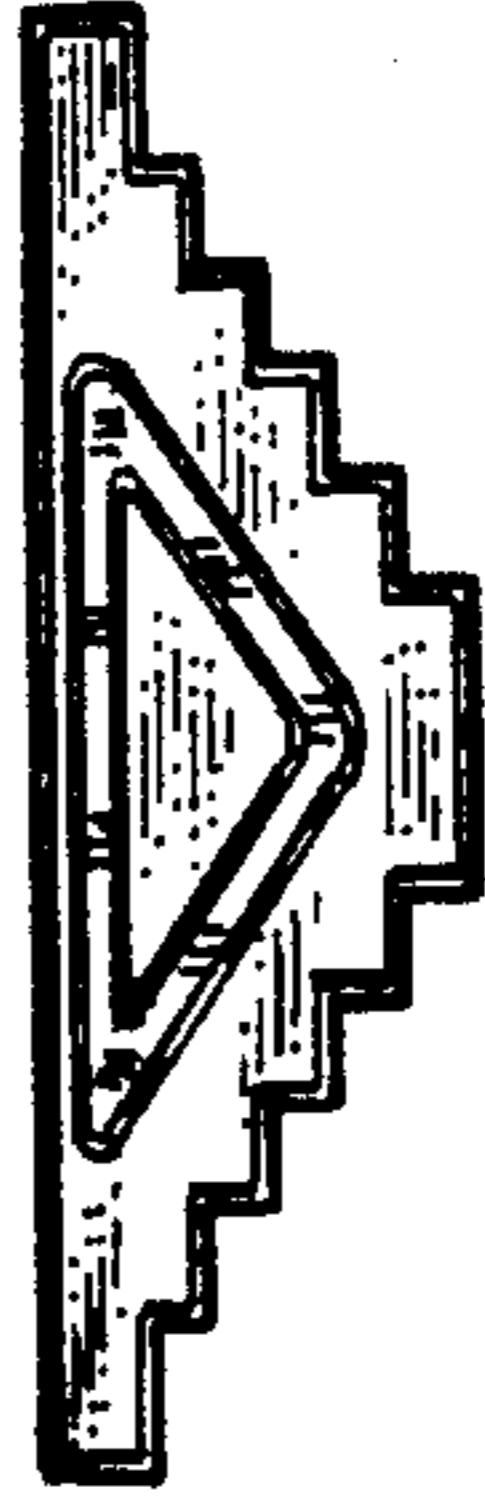

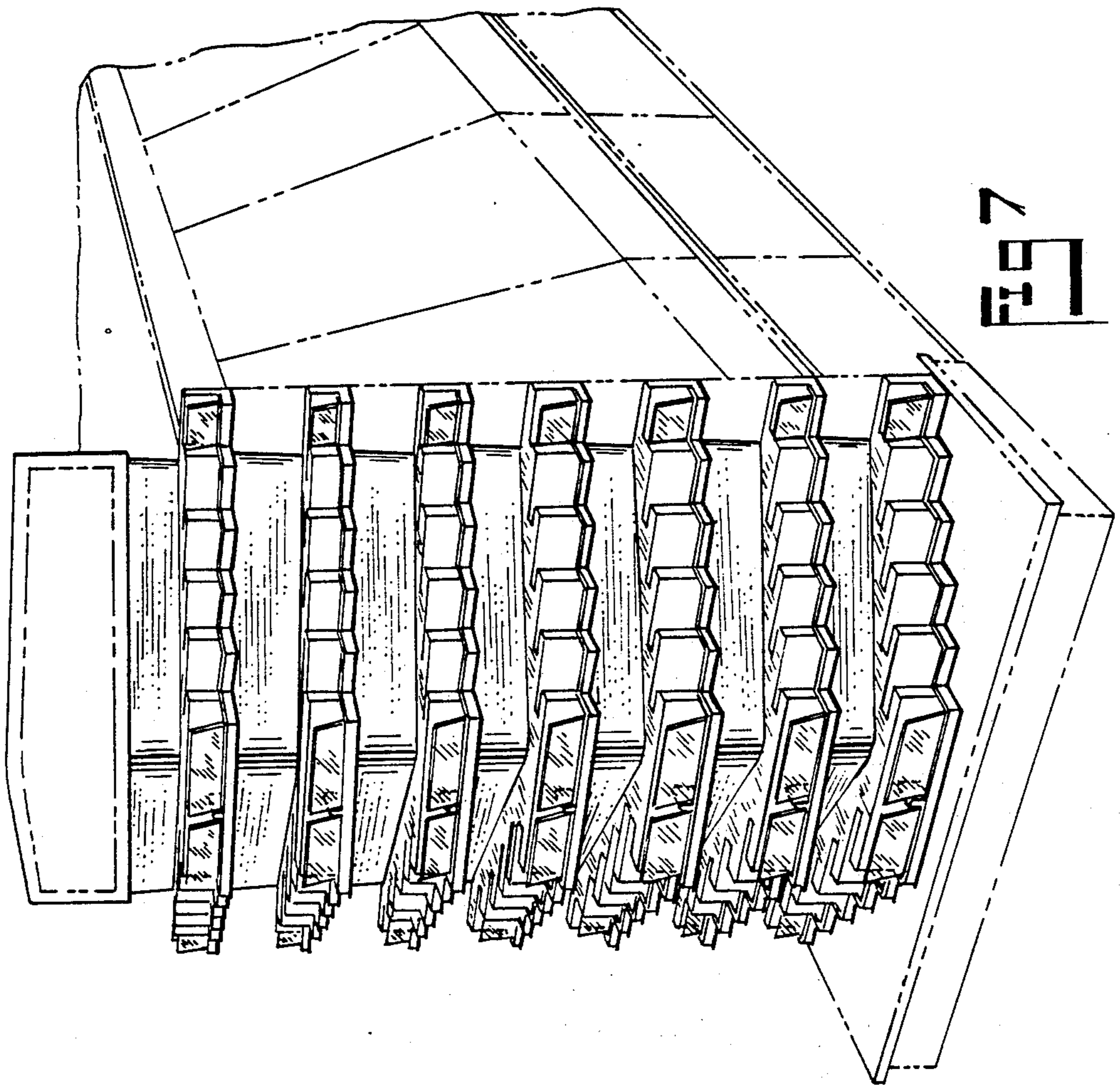
