DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a martial arts shoe show-
ing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

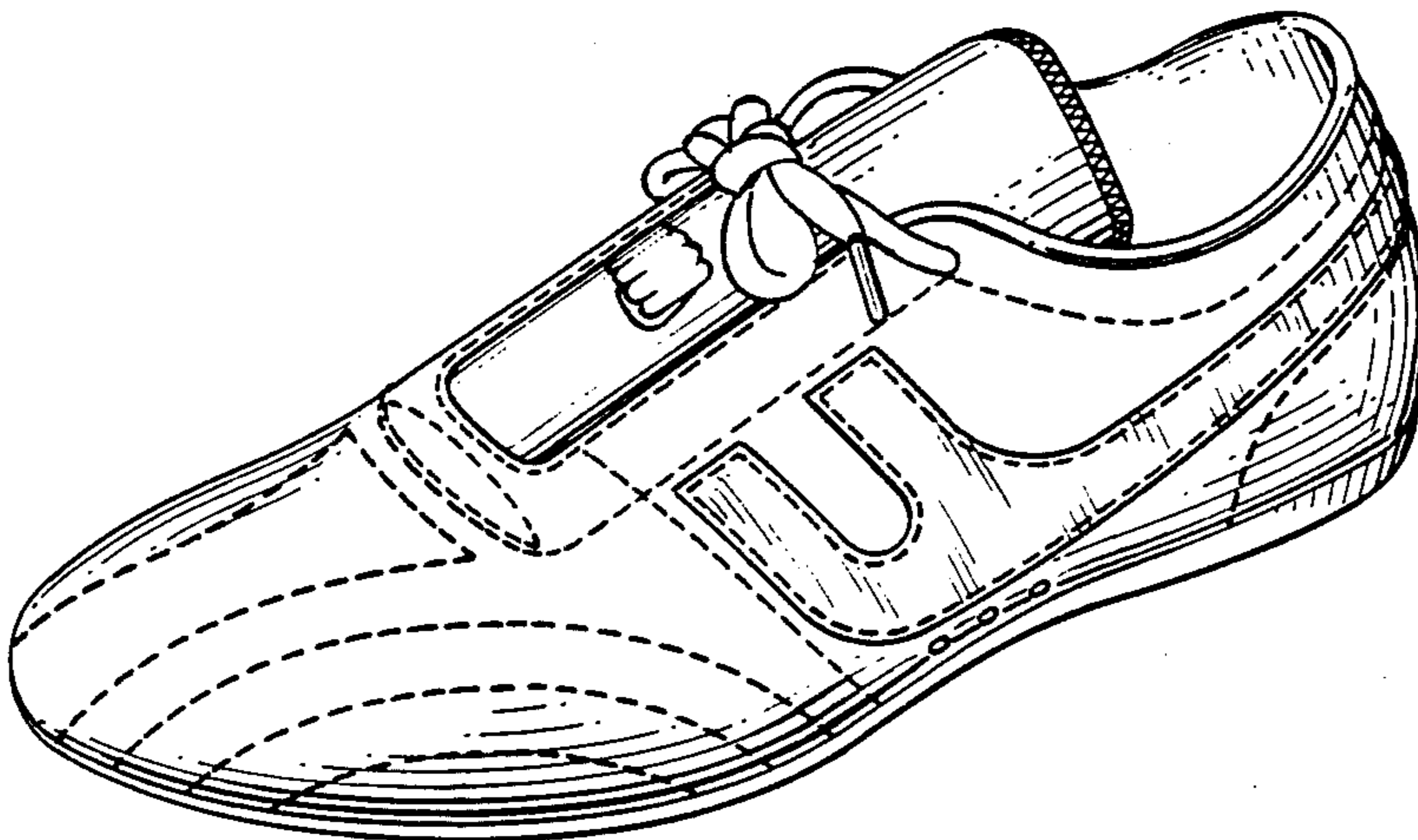

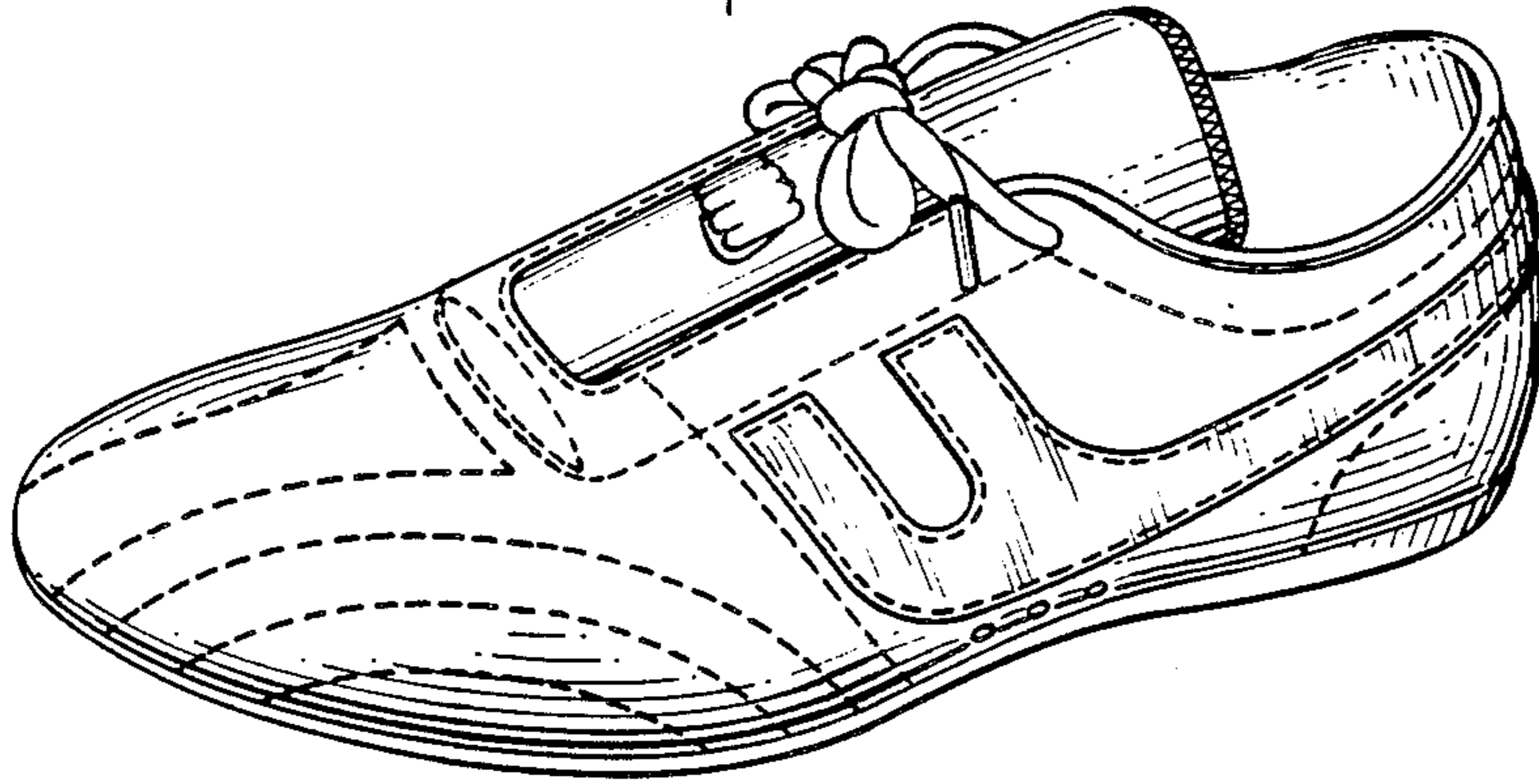

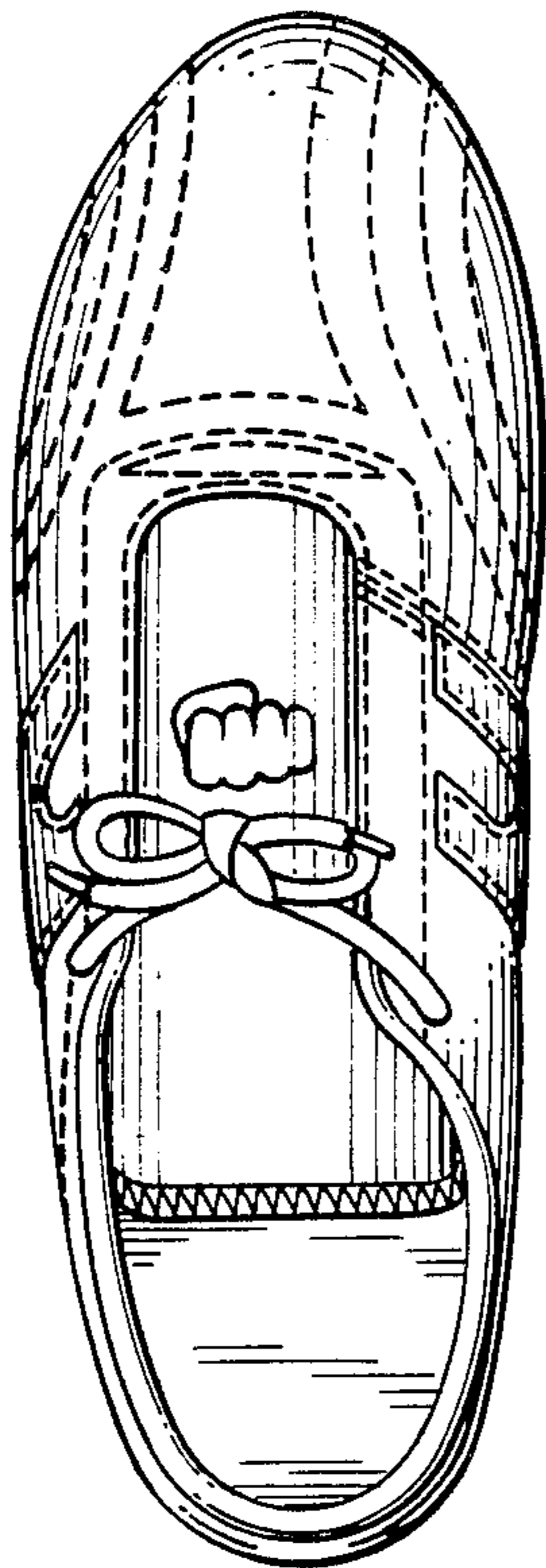

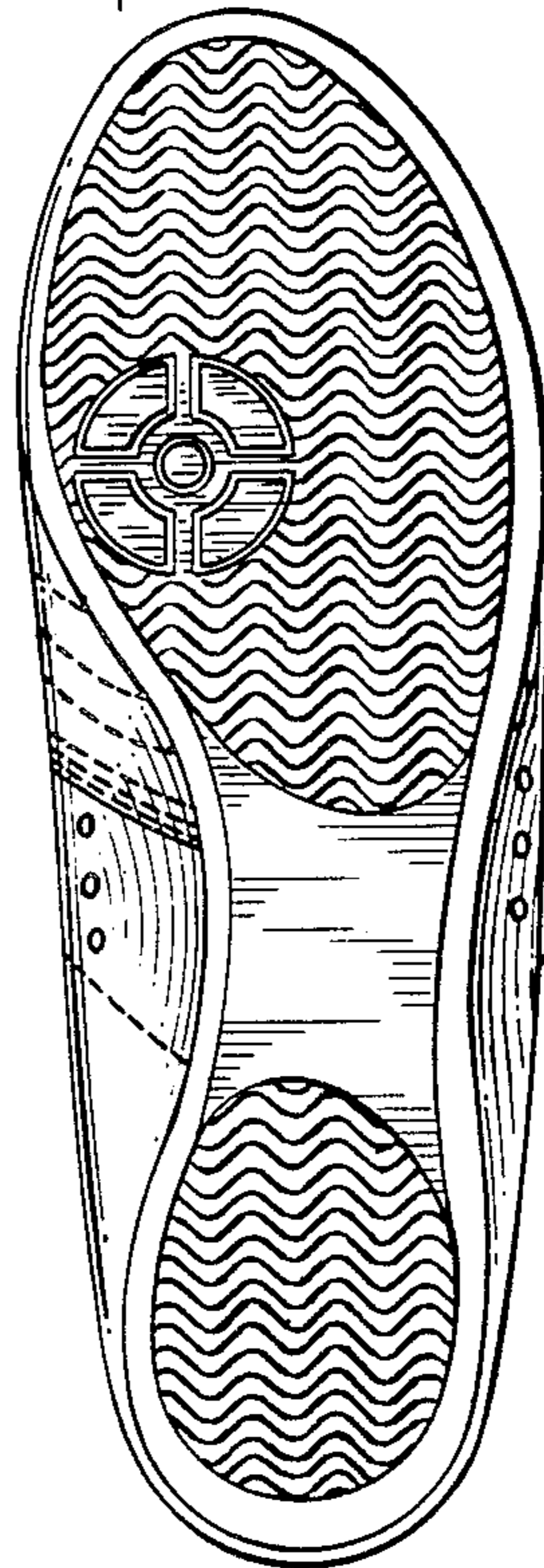

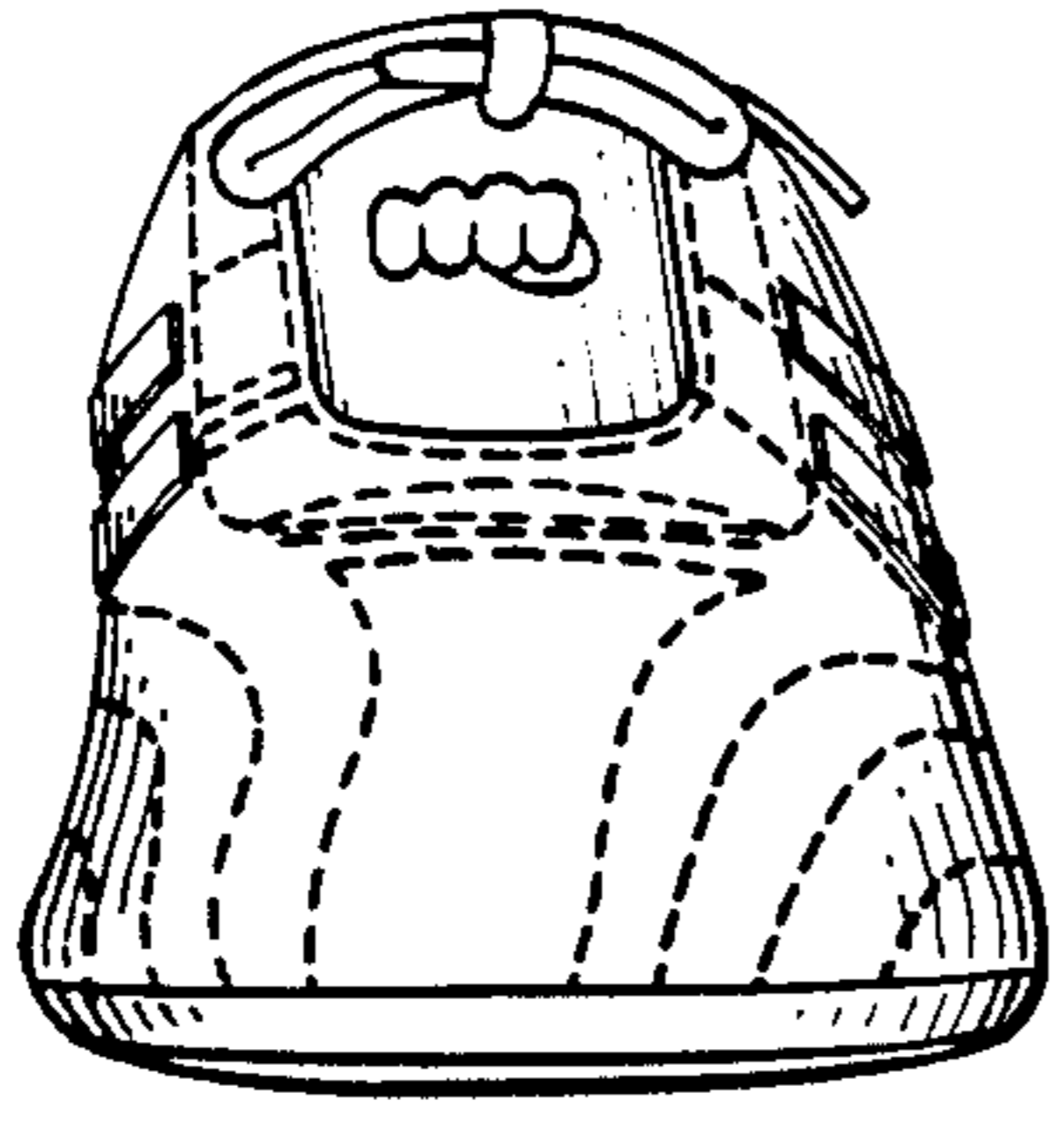

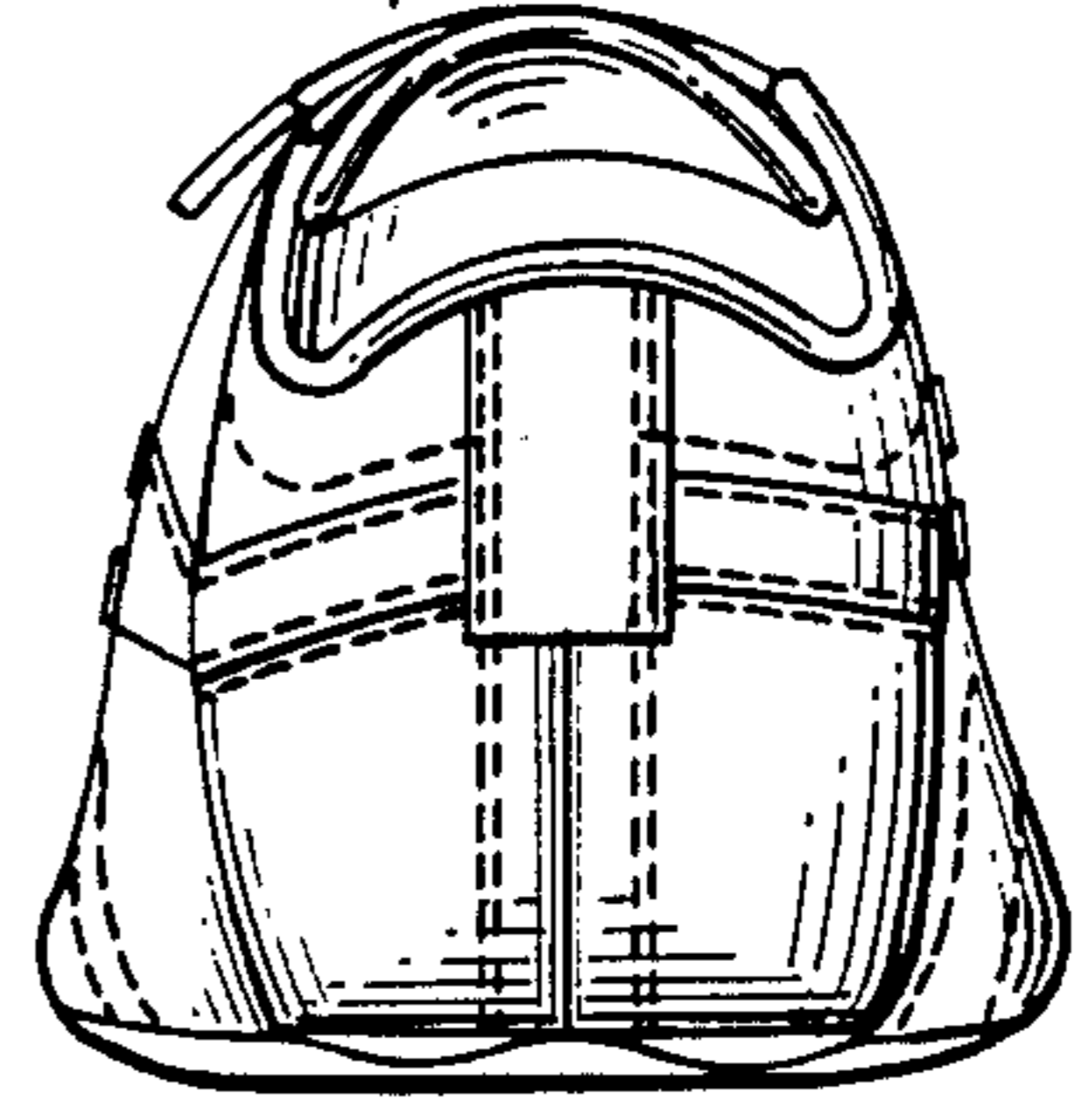

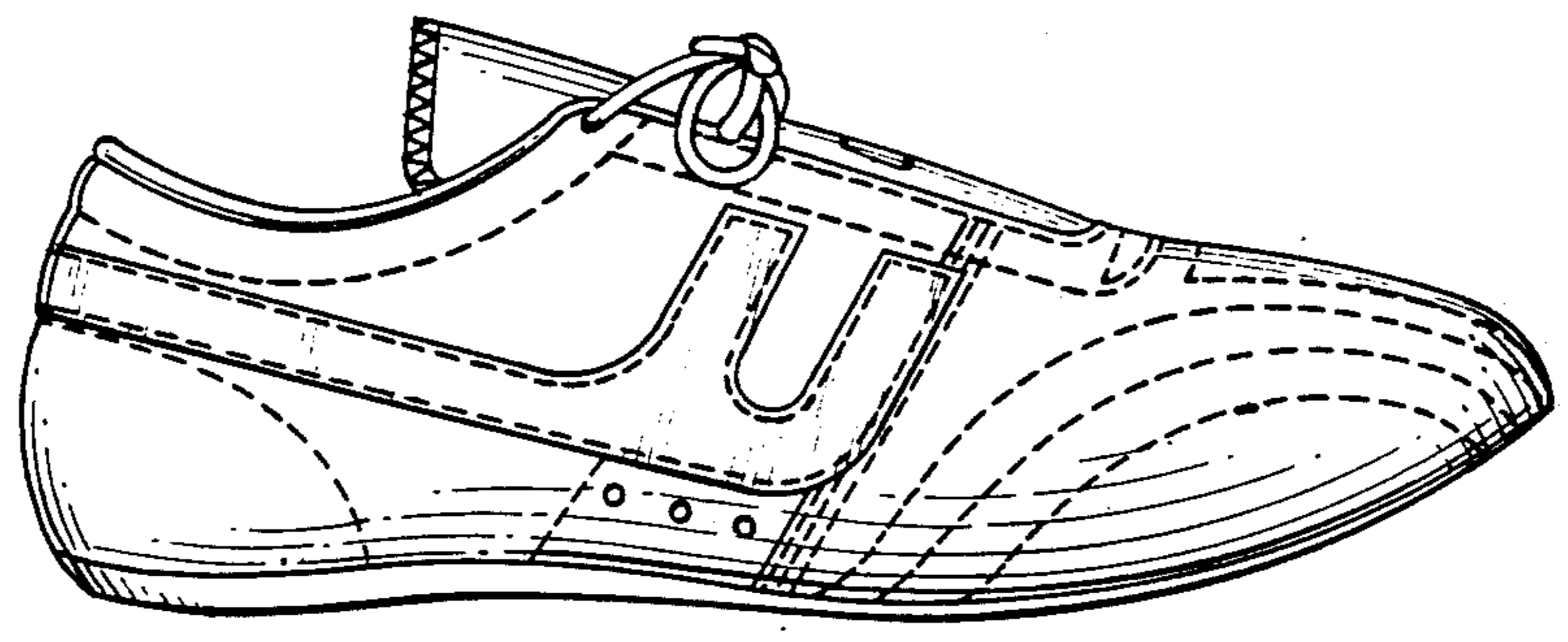
