FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing the front, top and right side thereof.

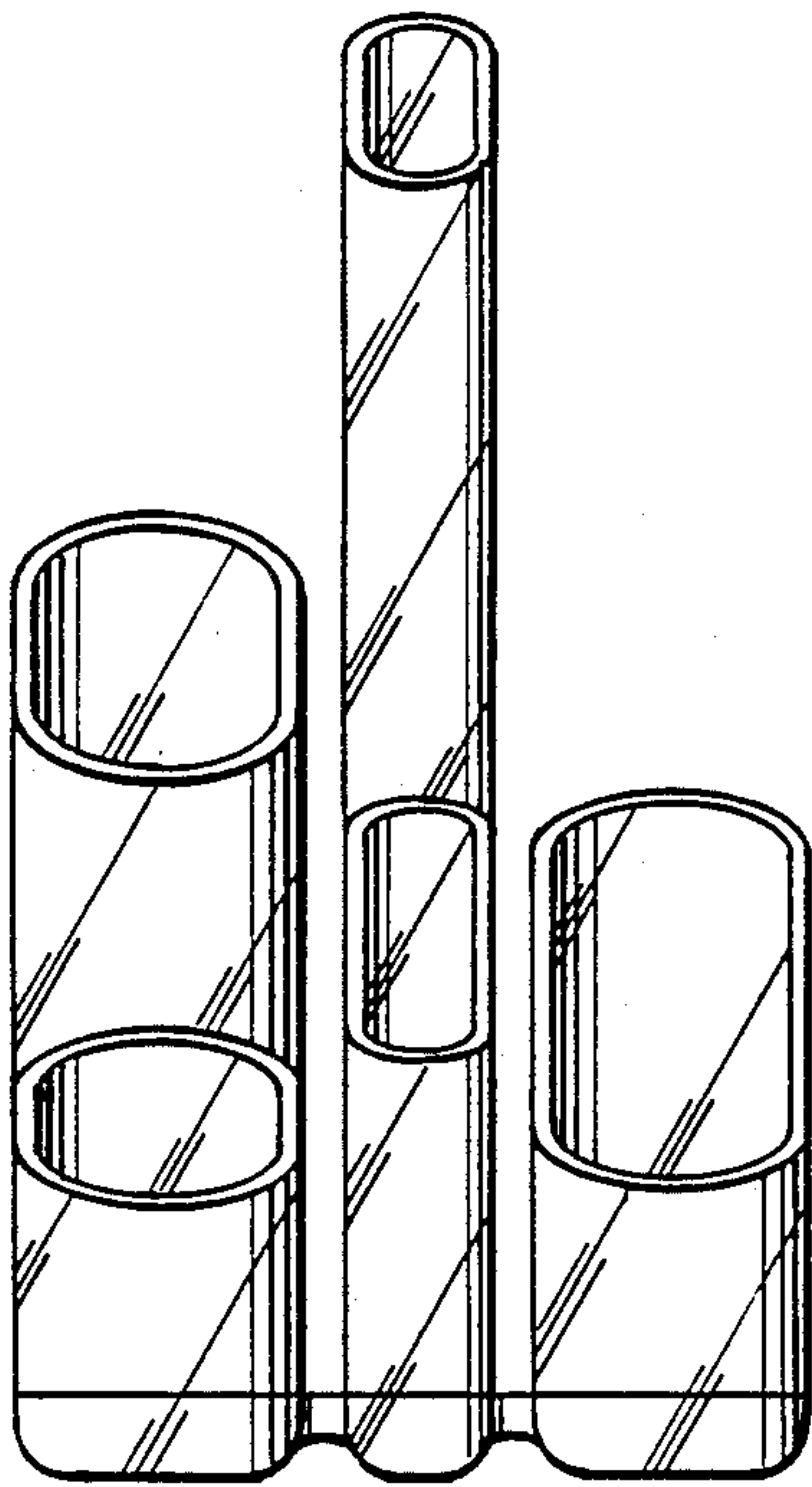

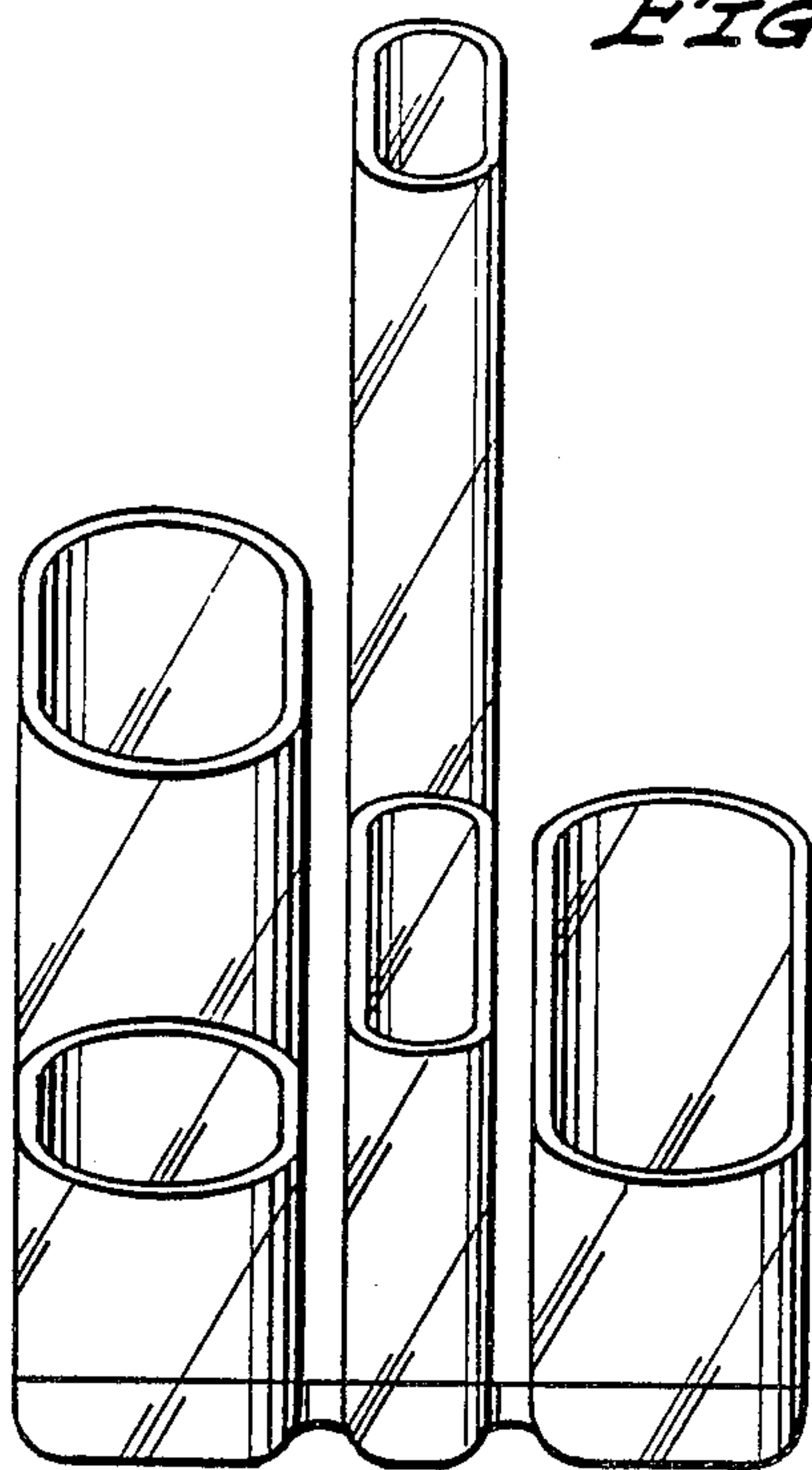

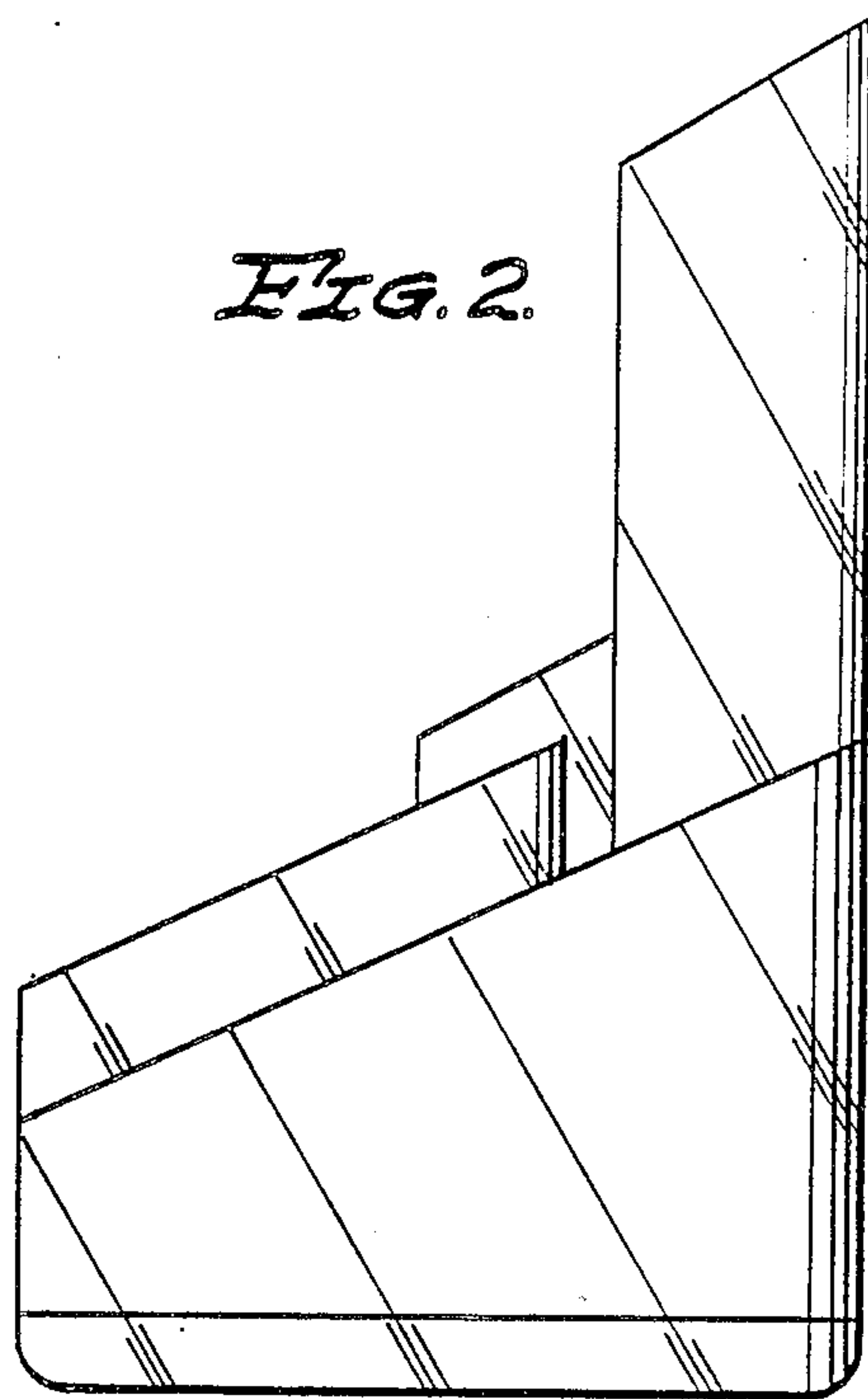

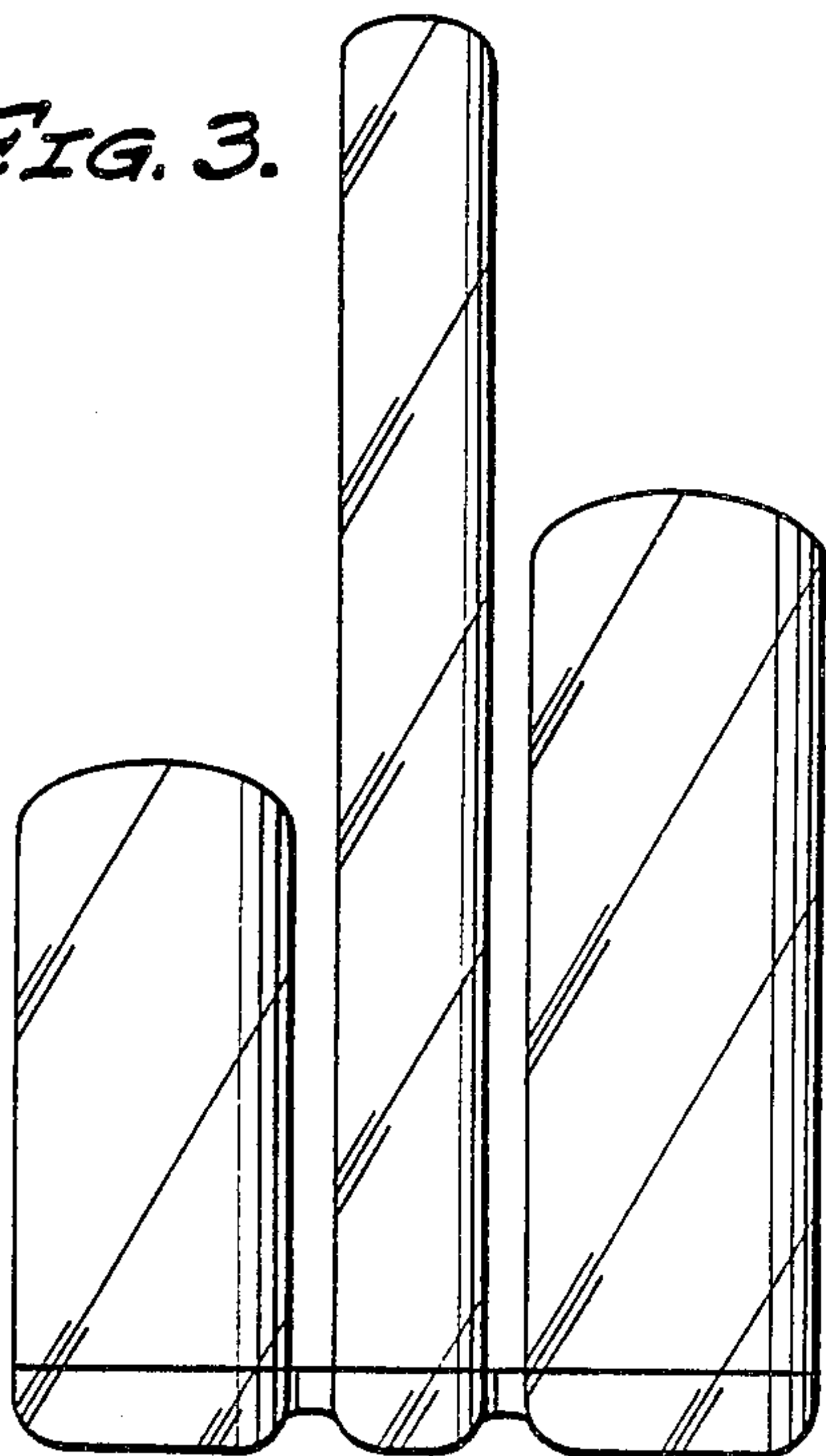

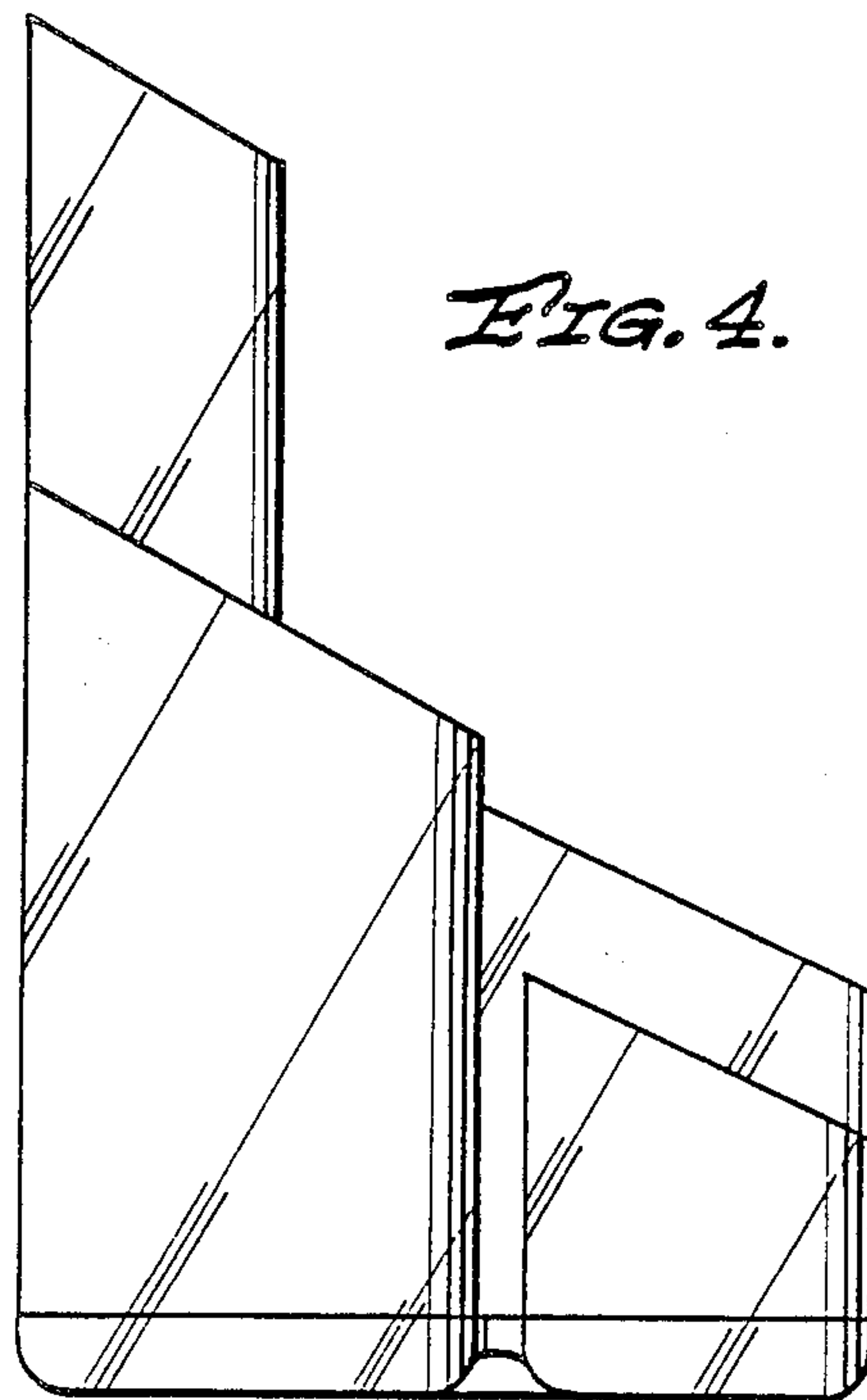

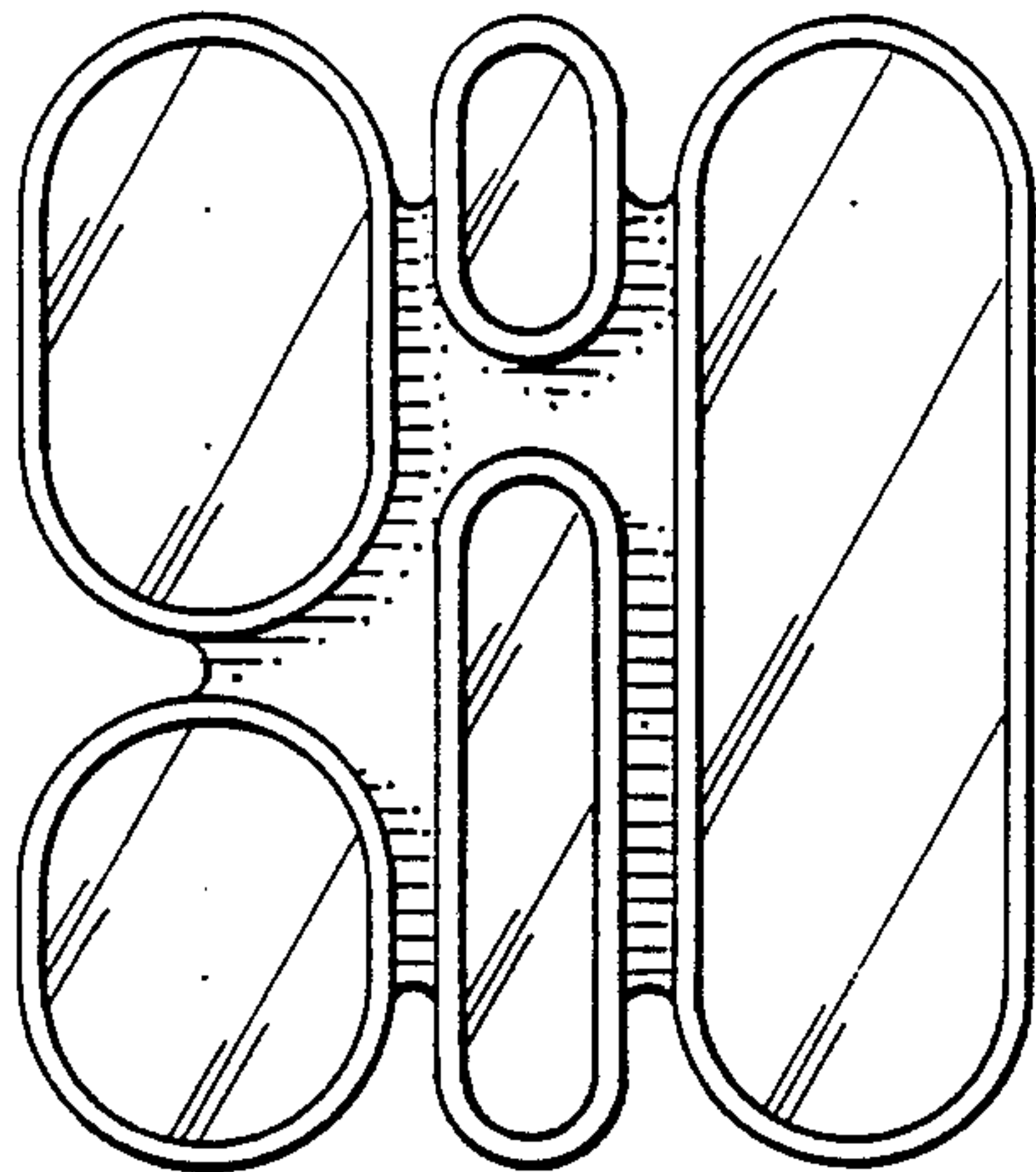

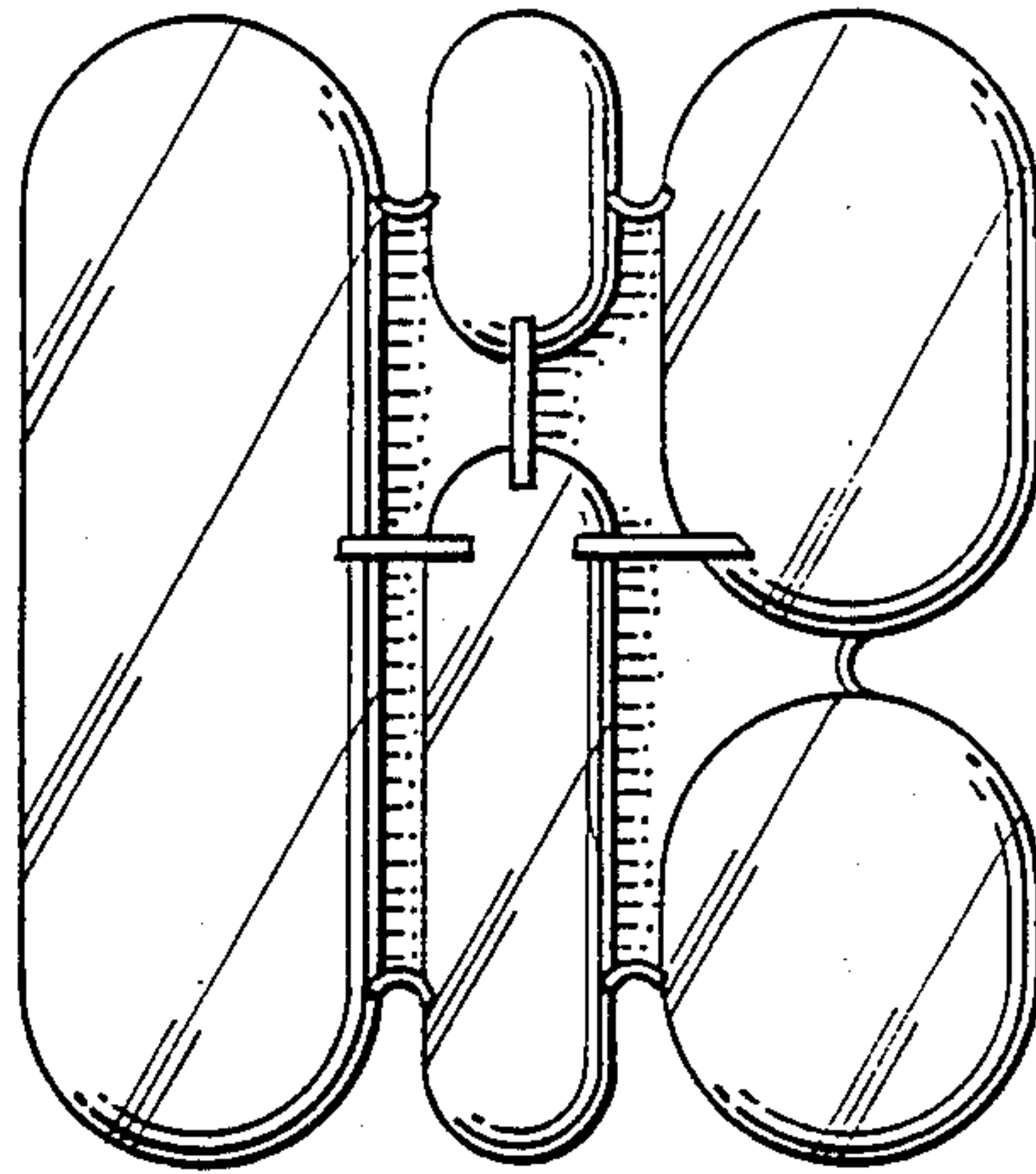
