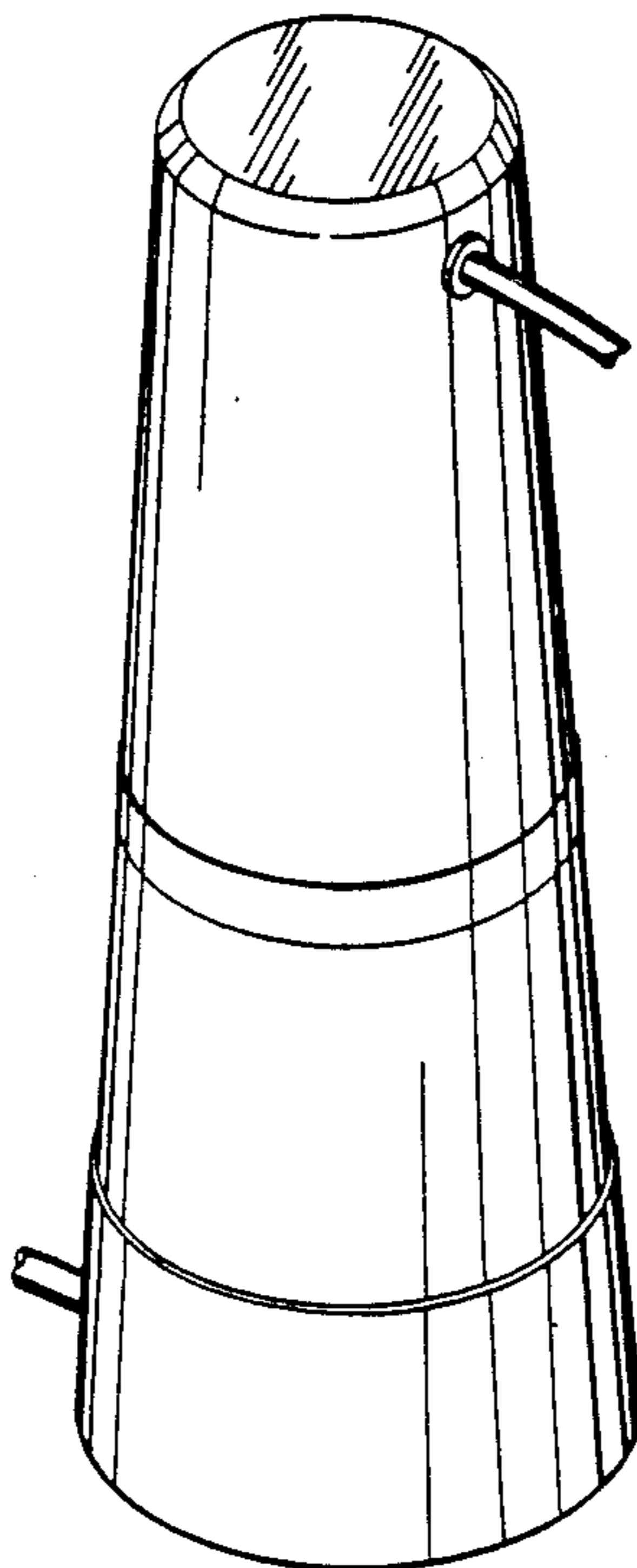

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a water filter or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a water filter or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The tubing elements are shown broken away to indicate indeterminate length.



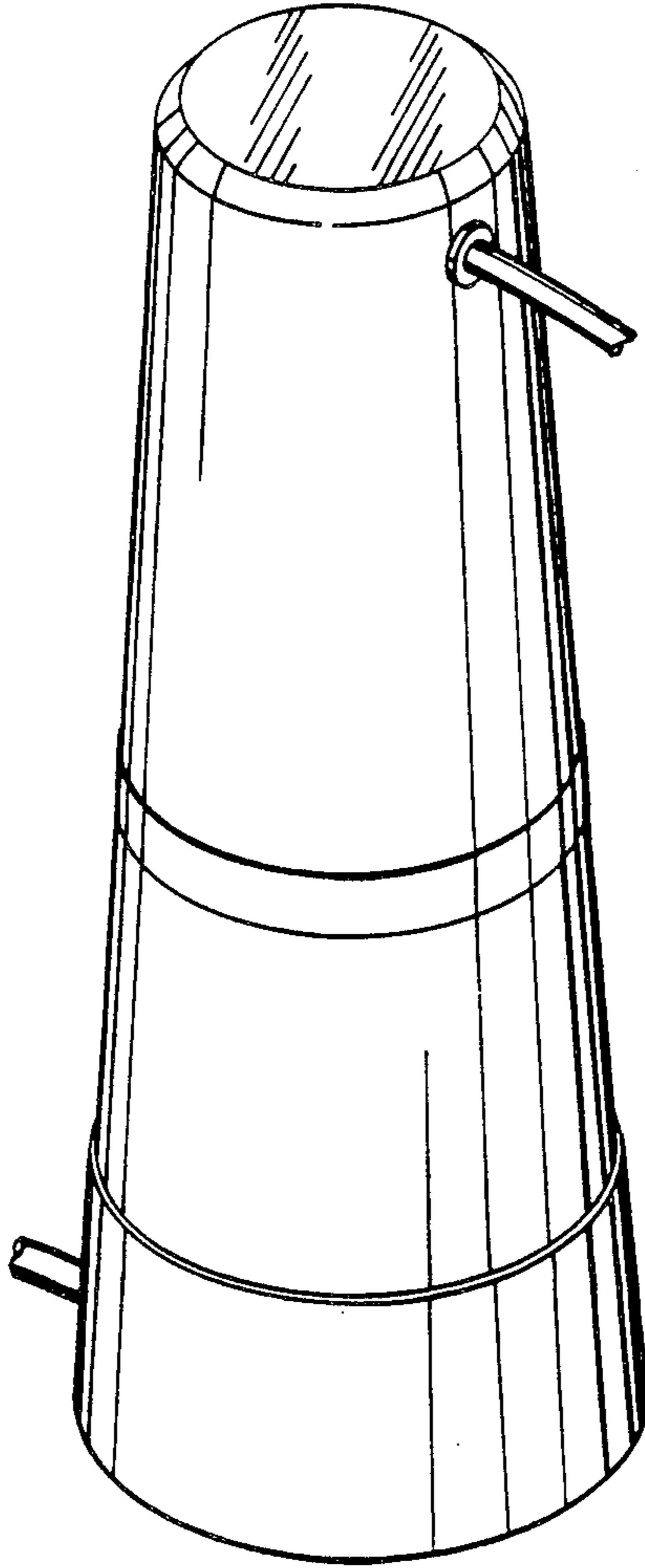

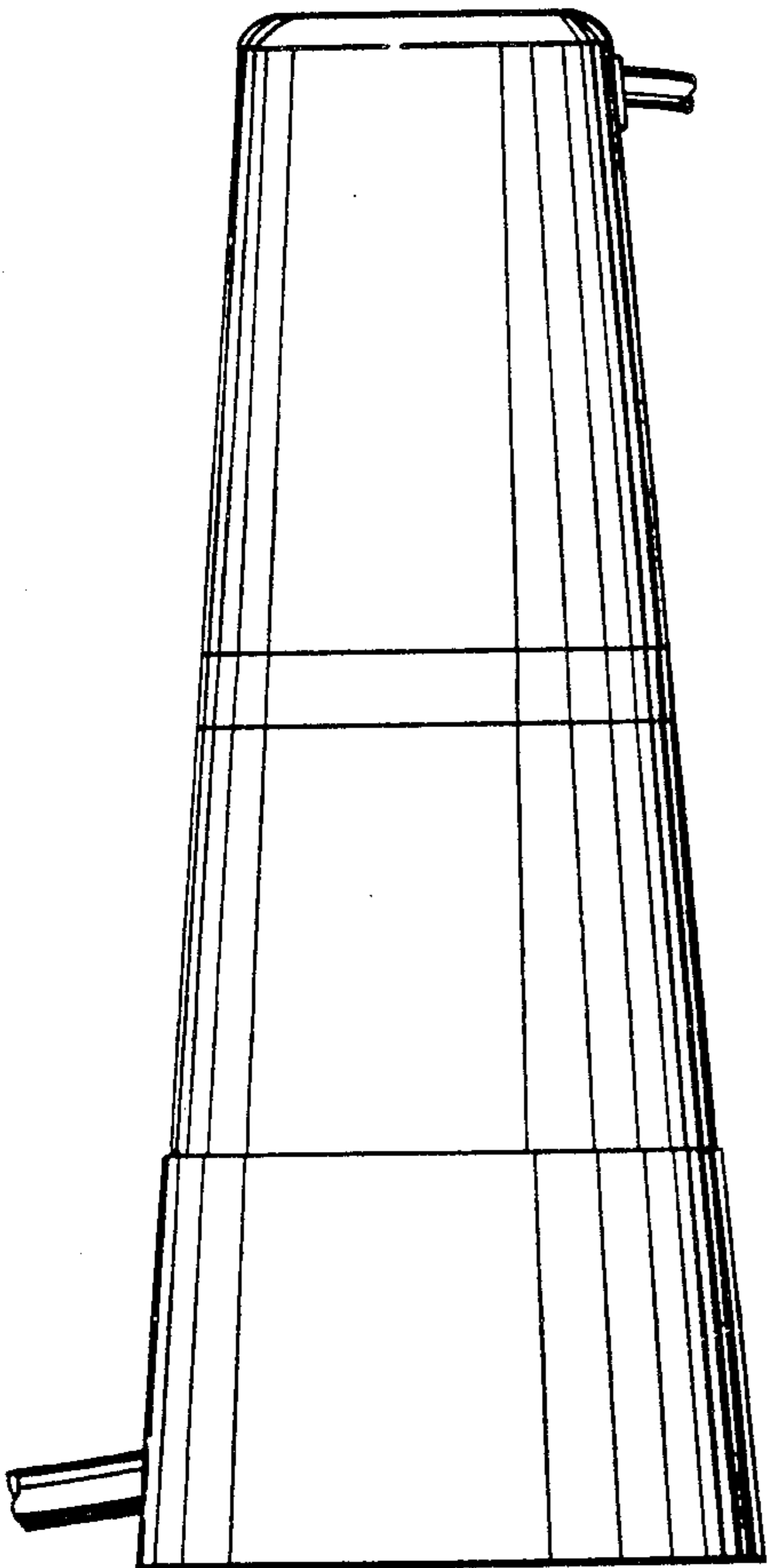

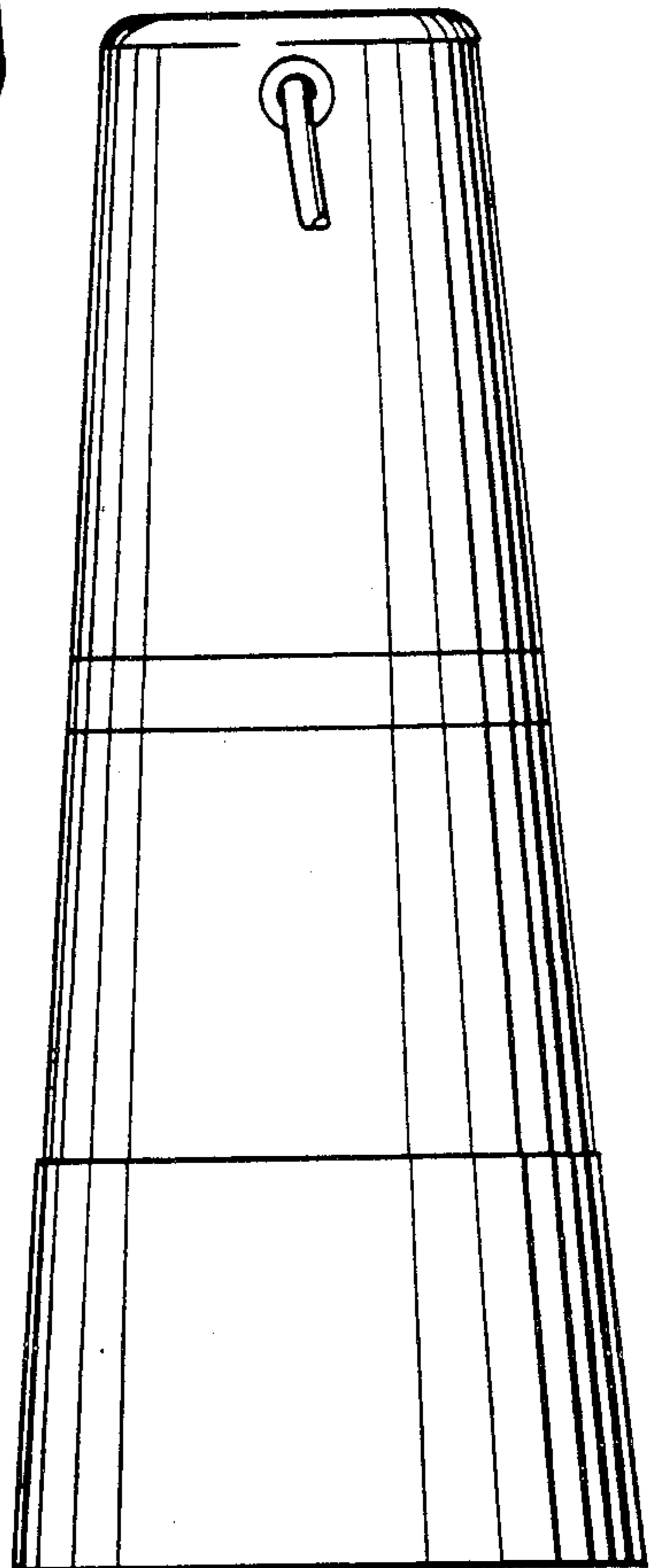

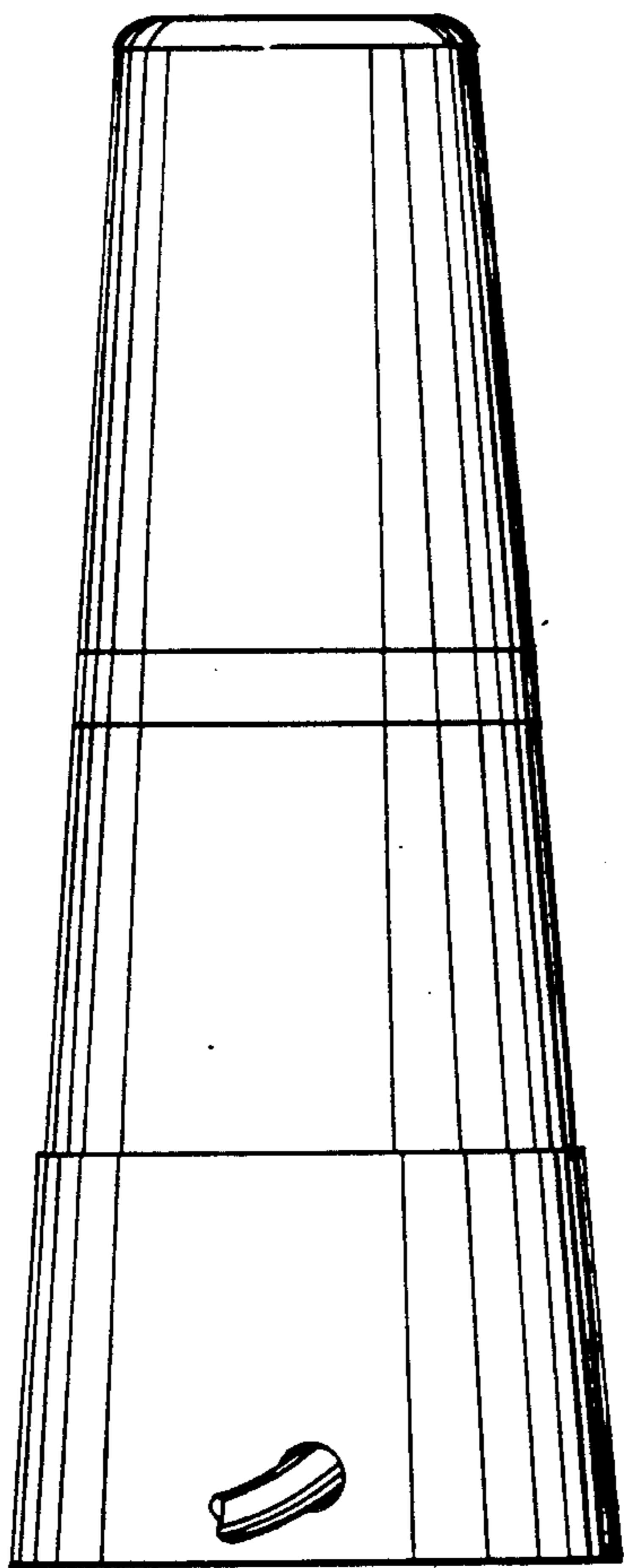

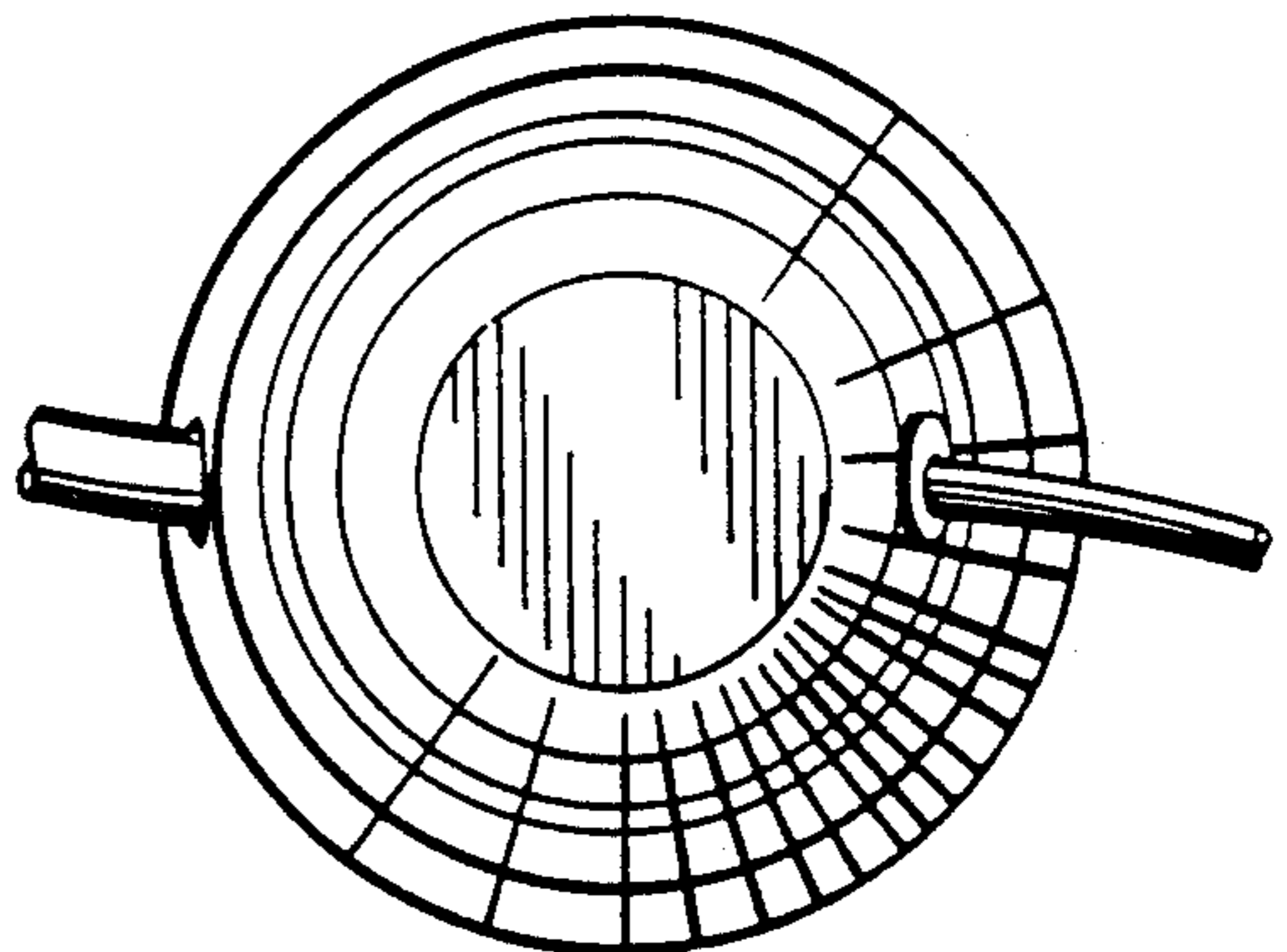

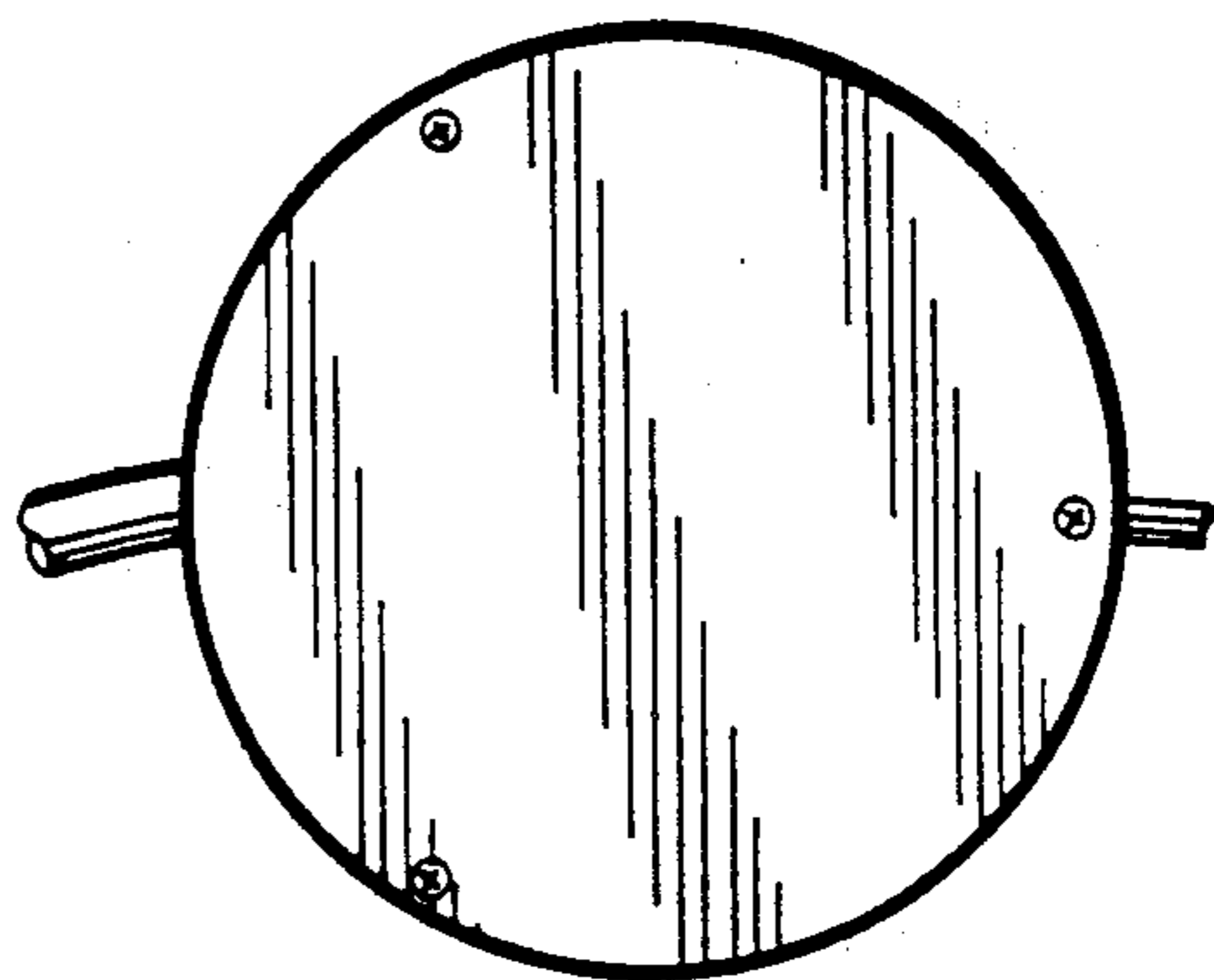
