FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and

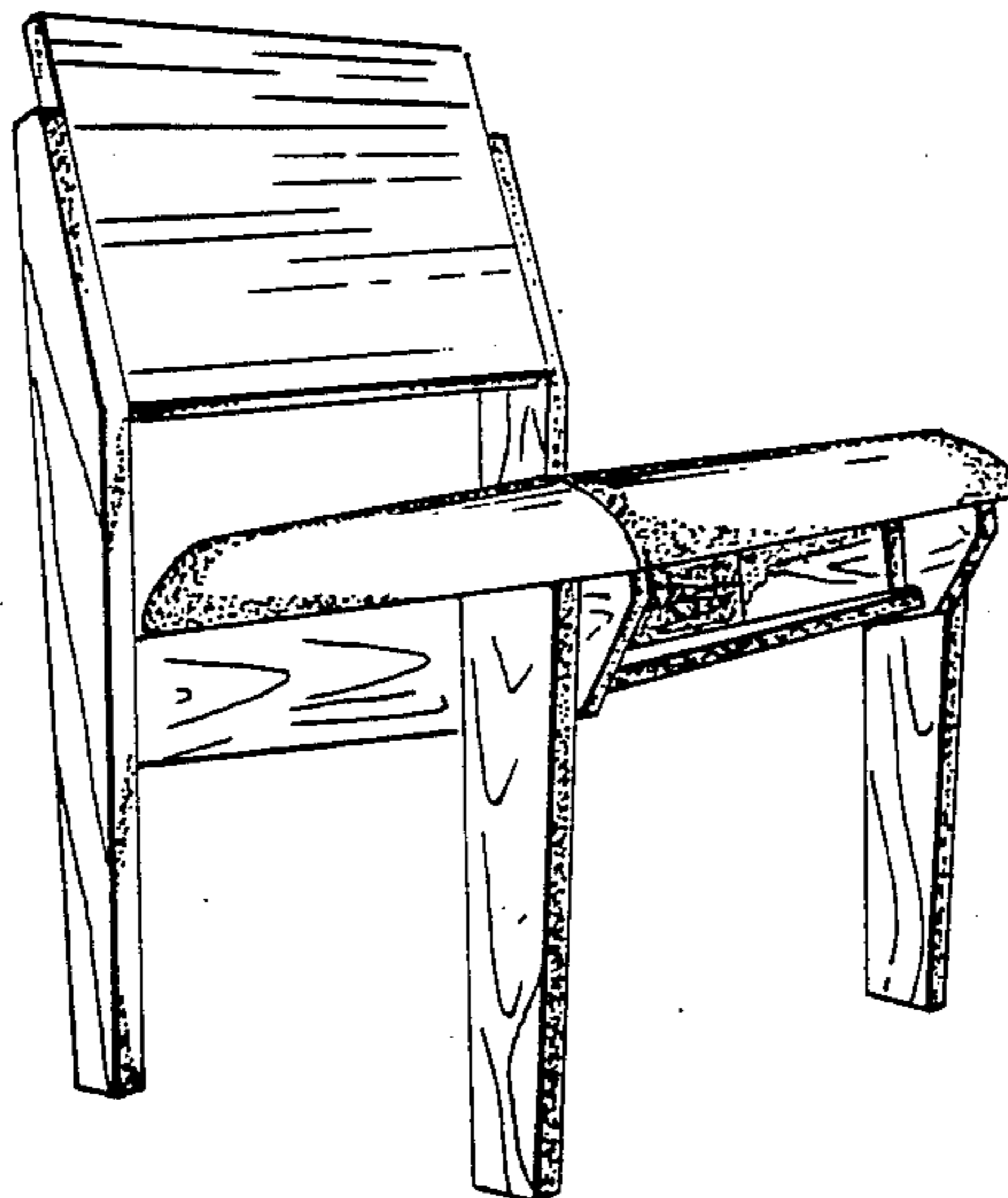
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

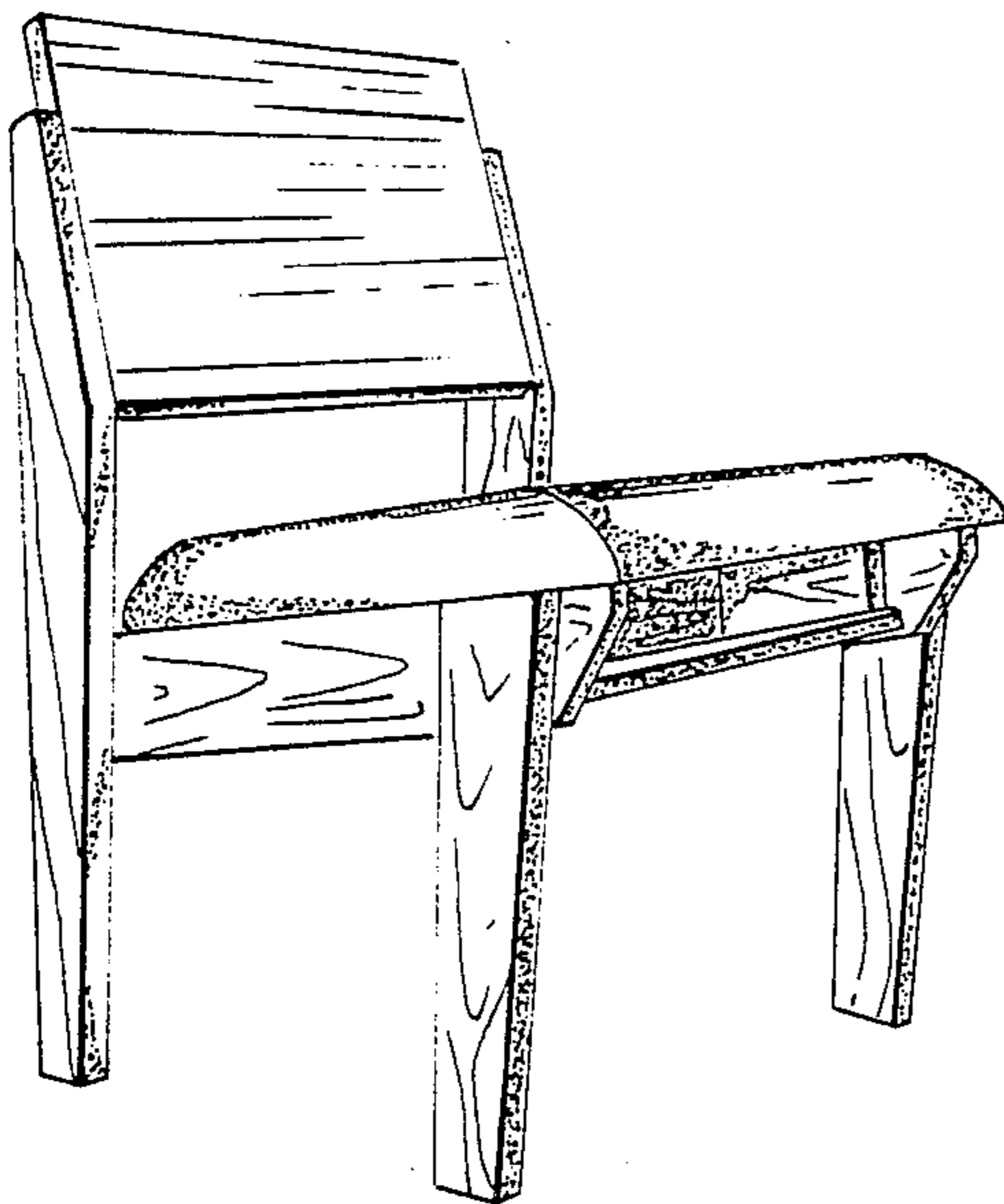

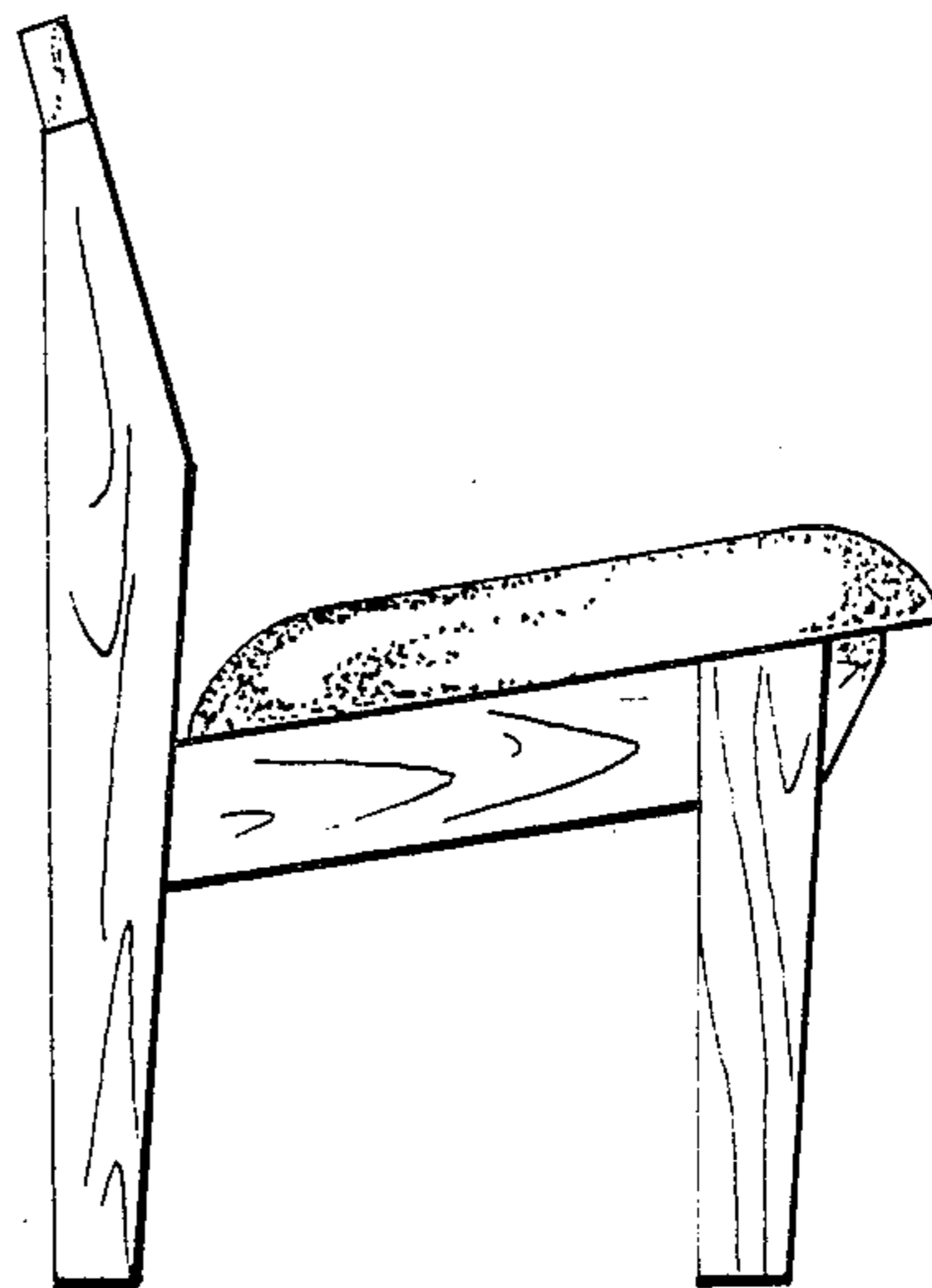

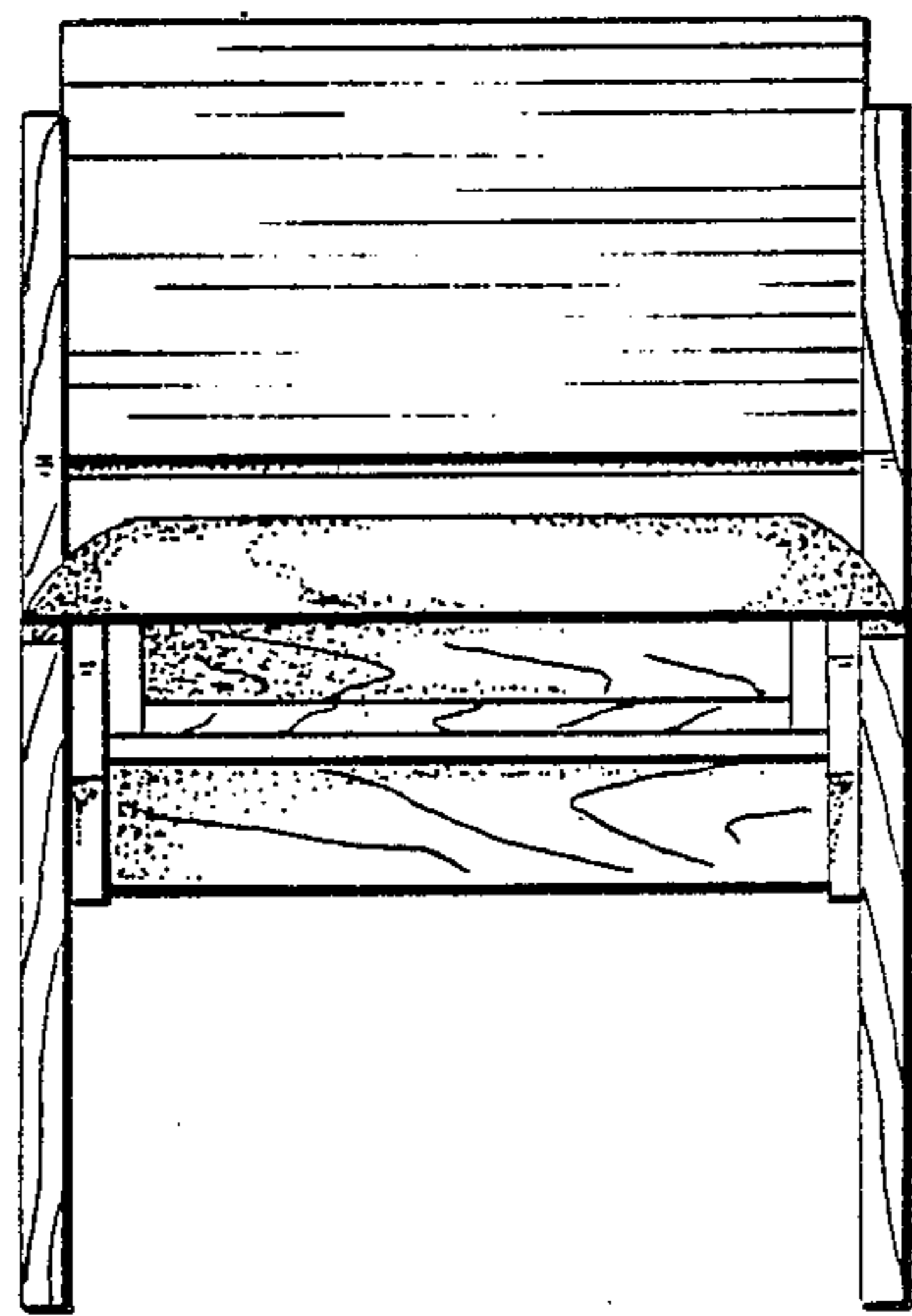

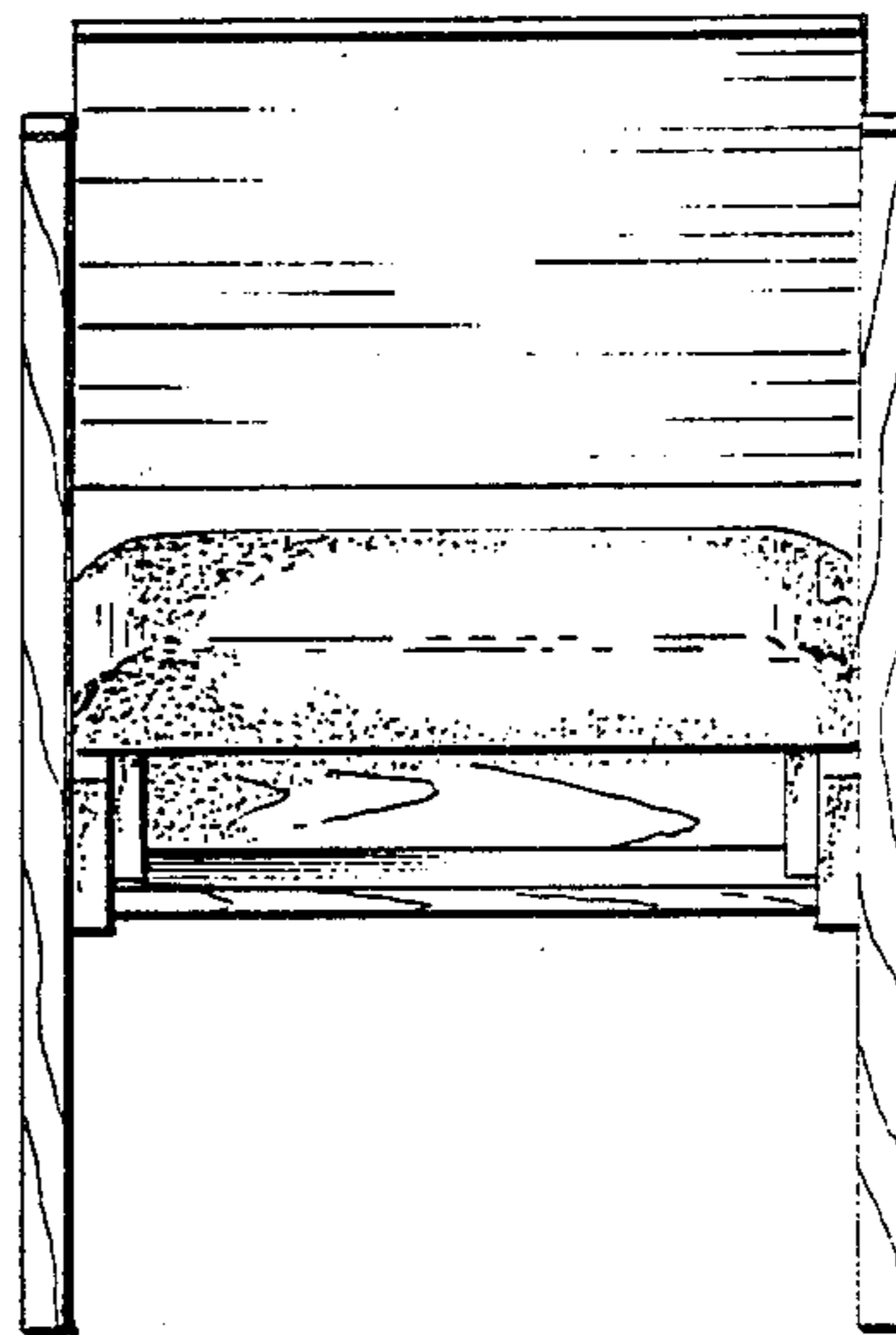

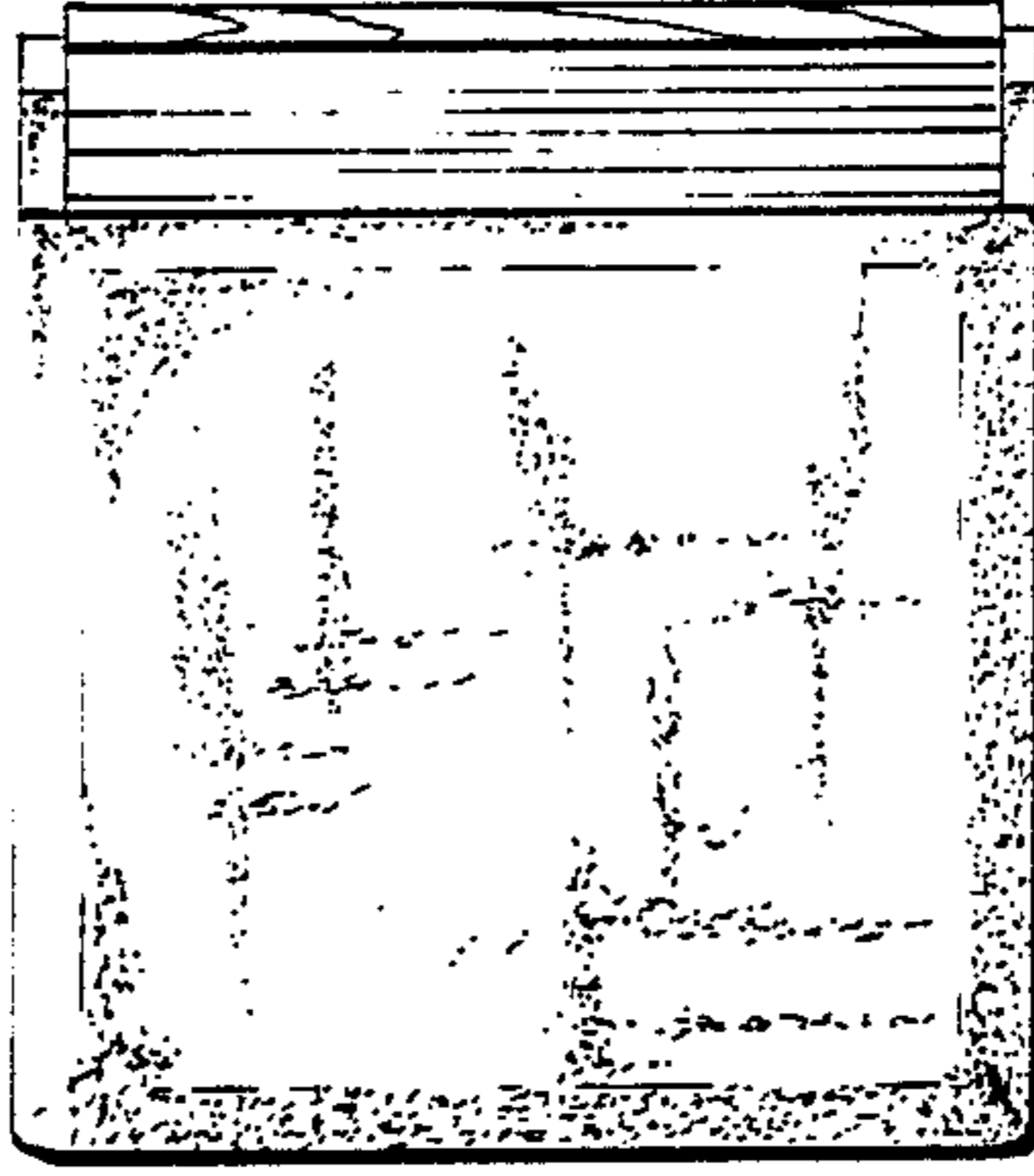
