[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dinner plate or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a dinner plate showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof partly in section, with the surface decoration being omitted therefrom for convenience of illustration; and
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.





