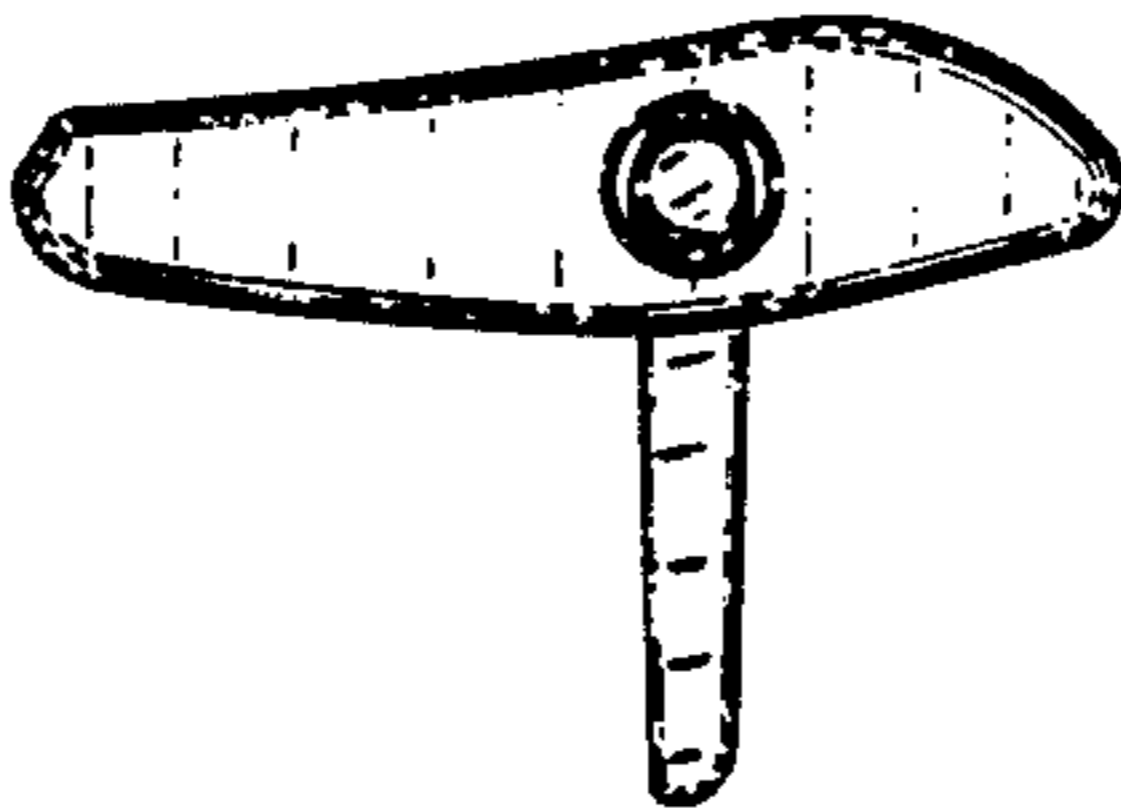
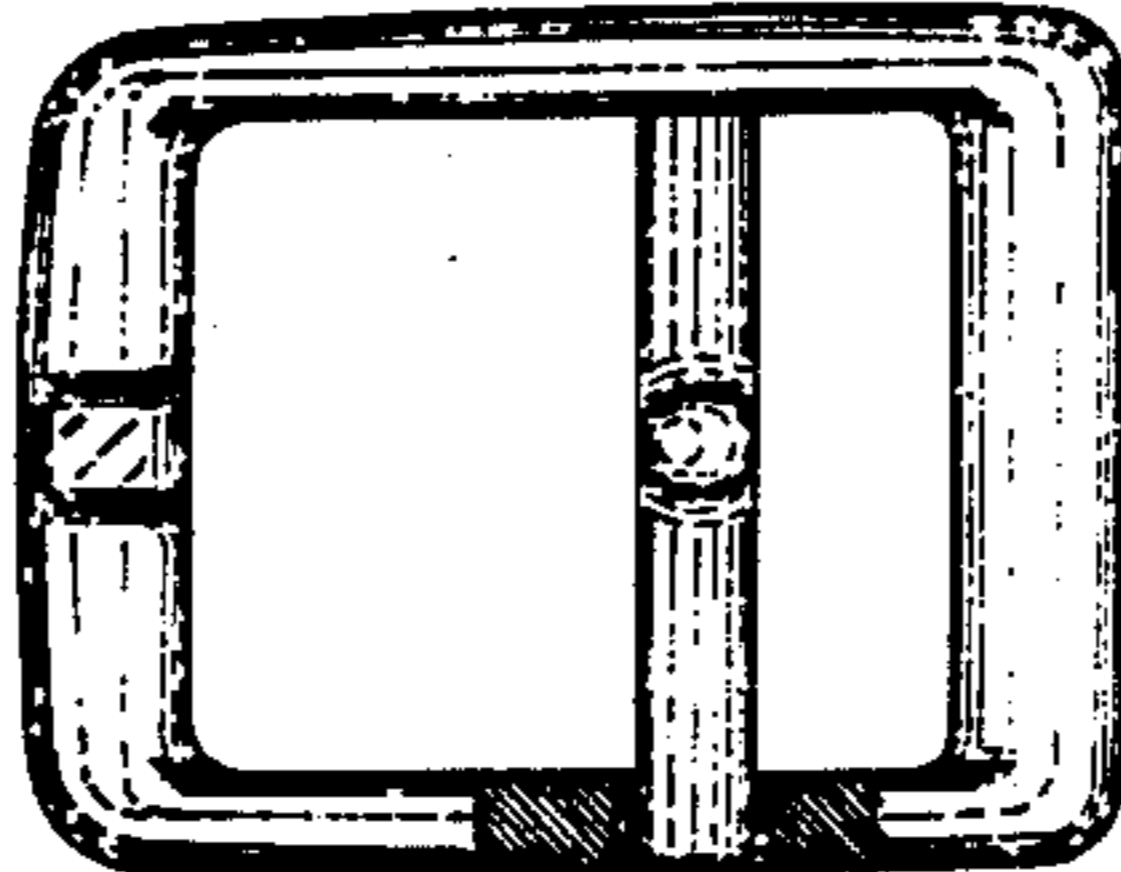

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a low-profile buckle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a low profile buckle showing my new design, with a portion broken away for illustrative purposes;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 3; and,
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view with partial section.



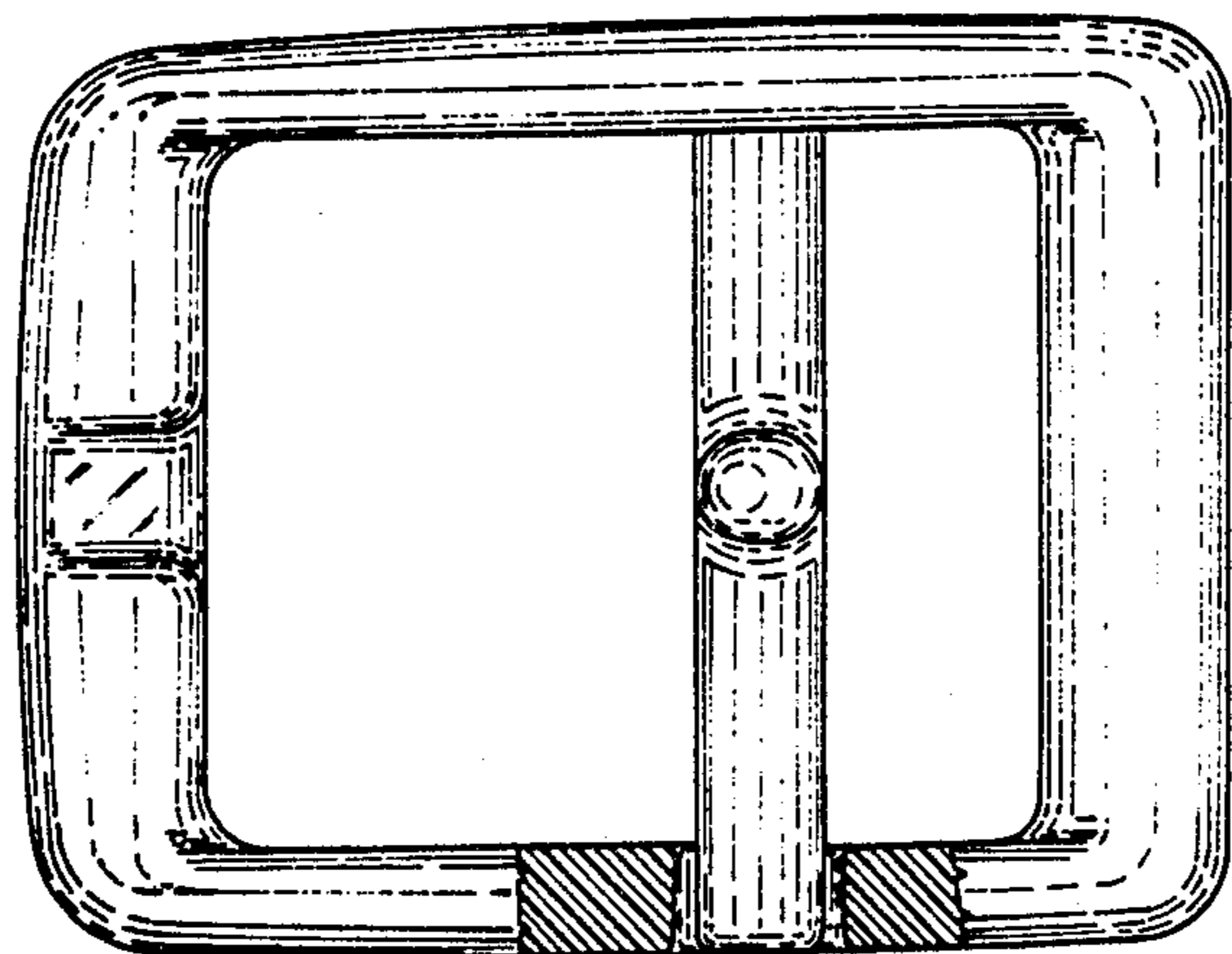

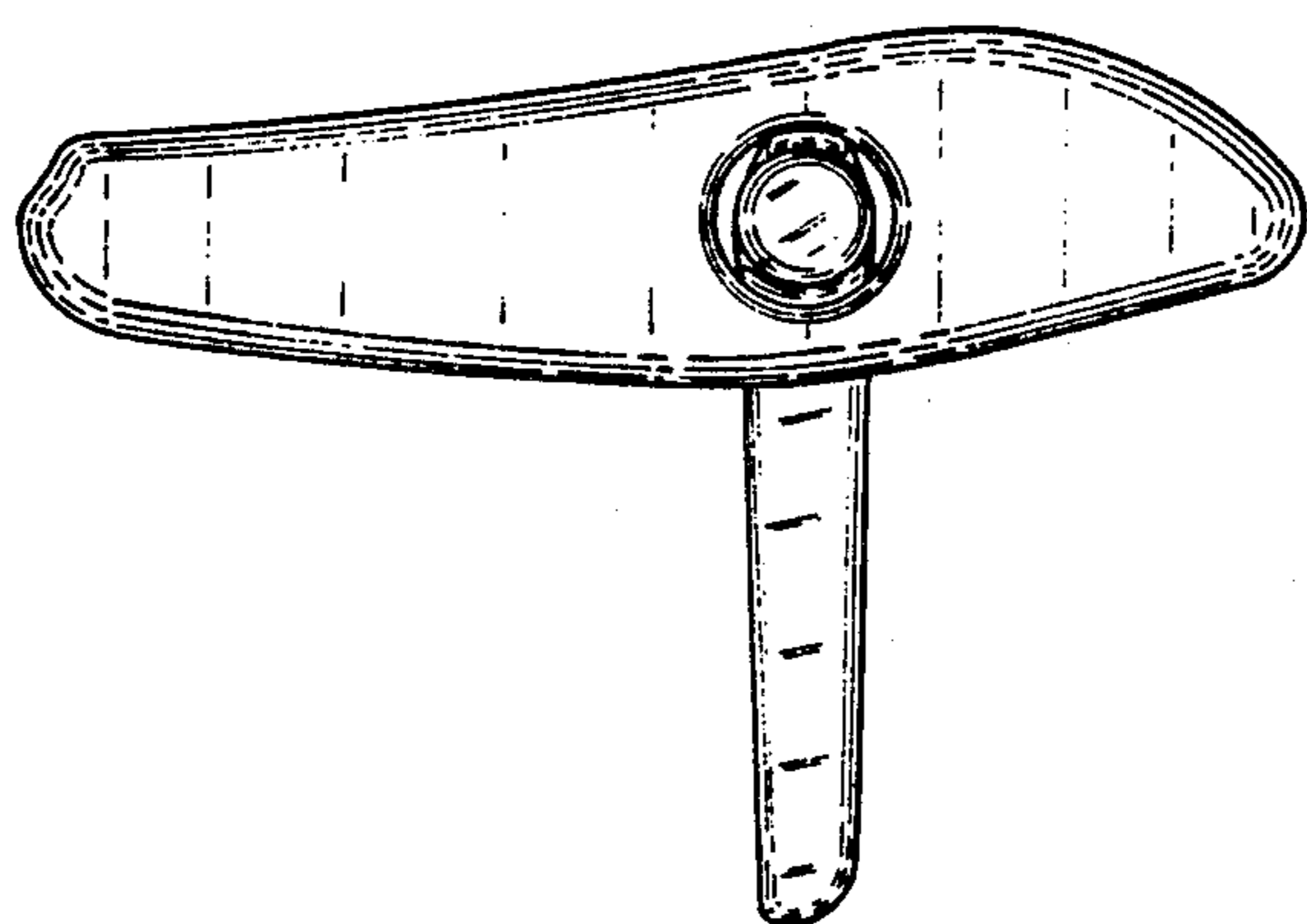

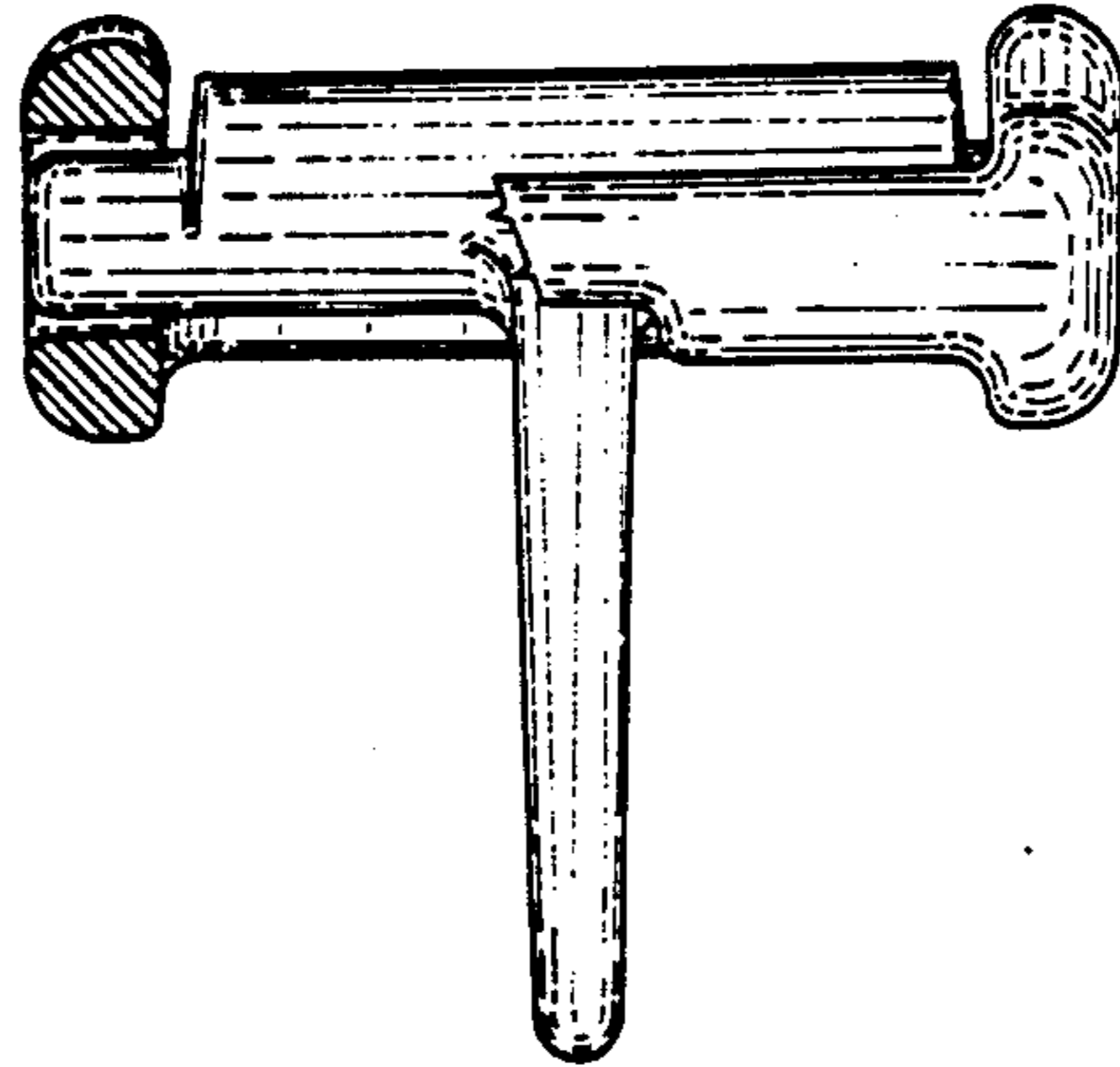

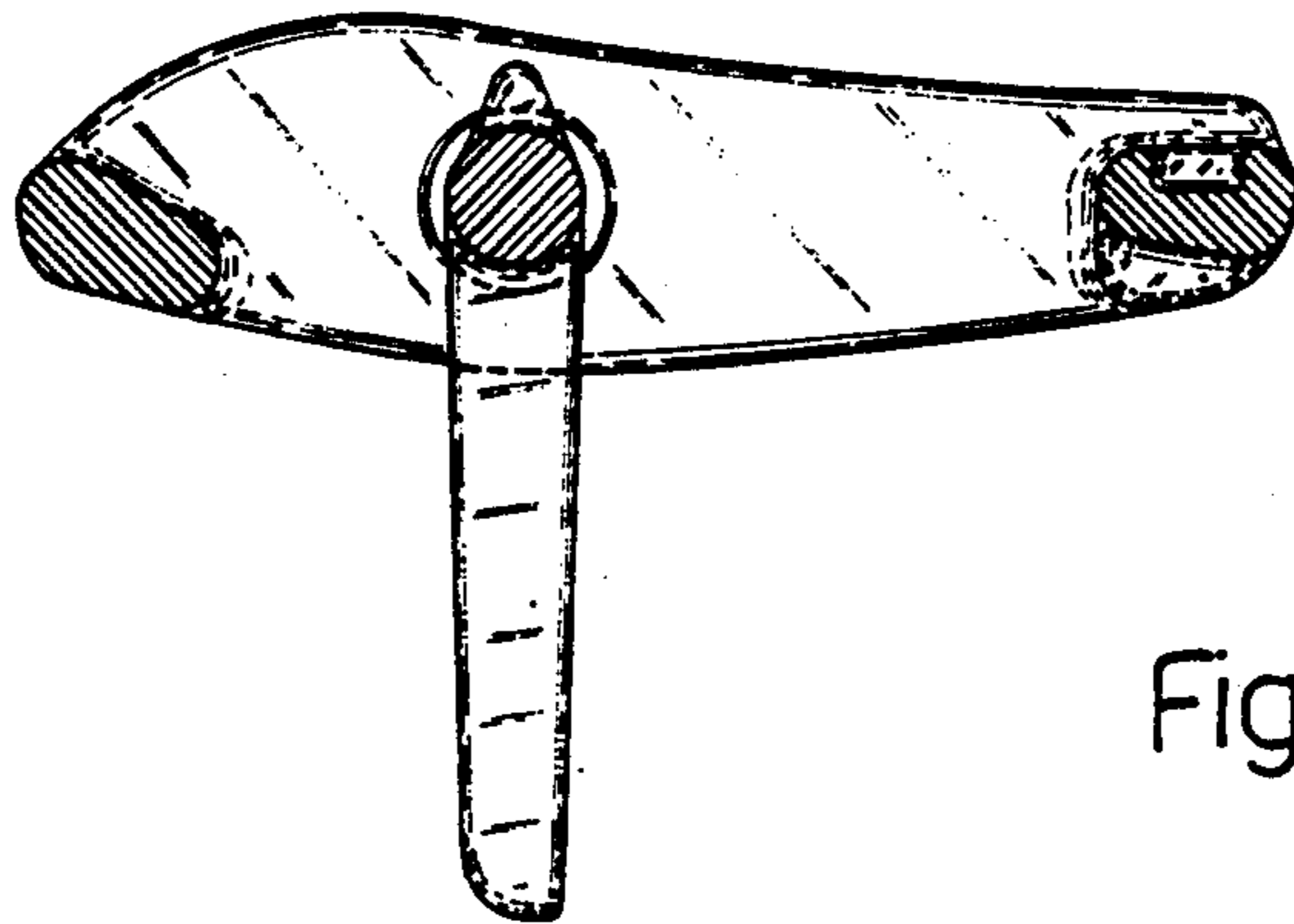

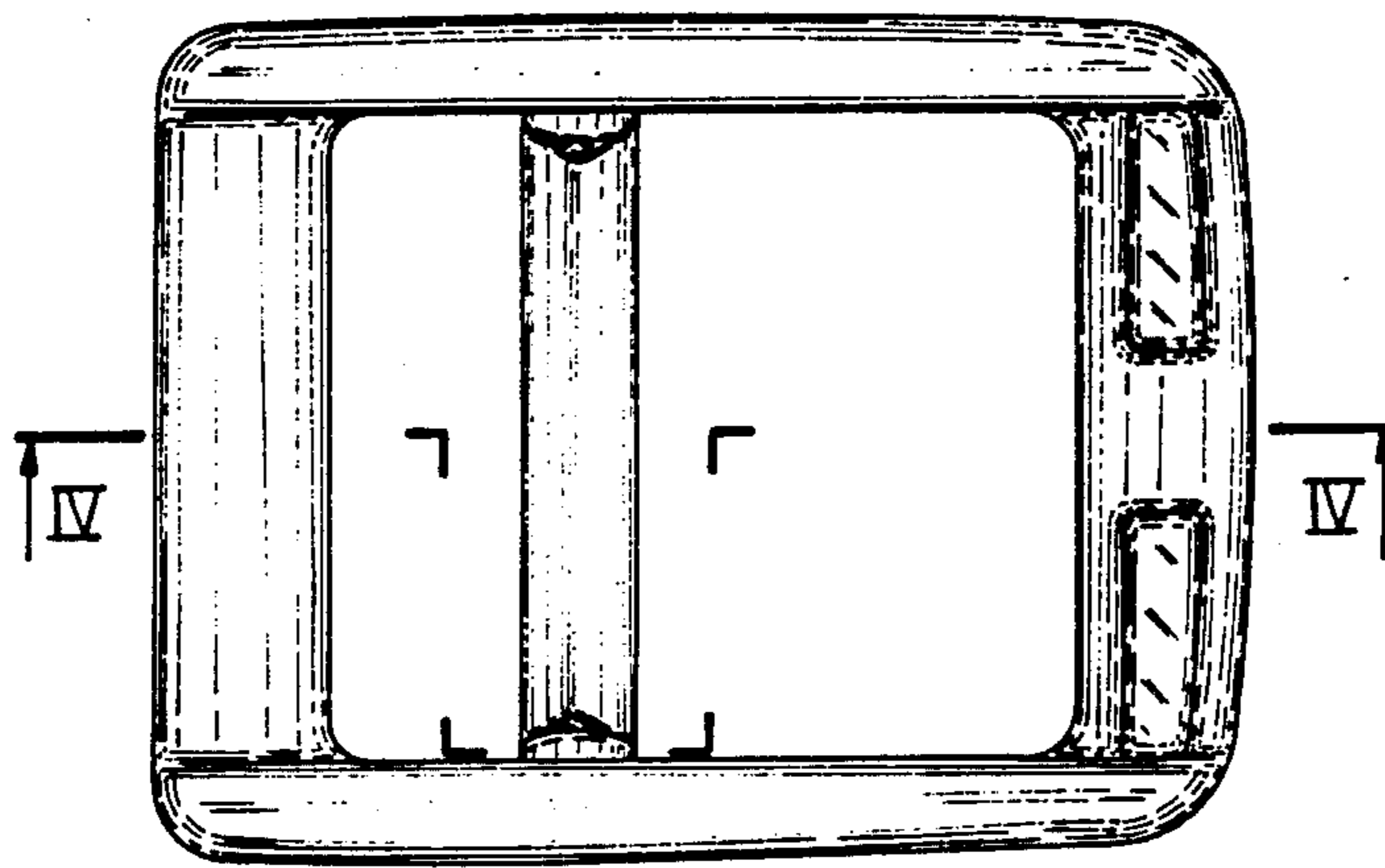
