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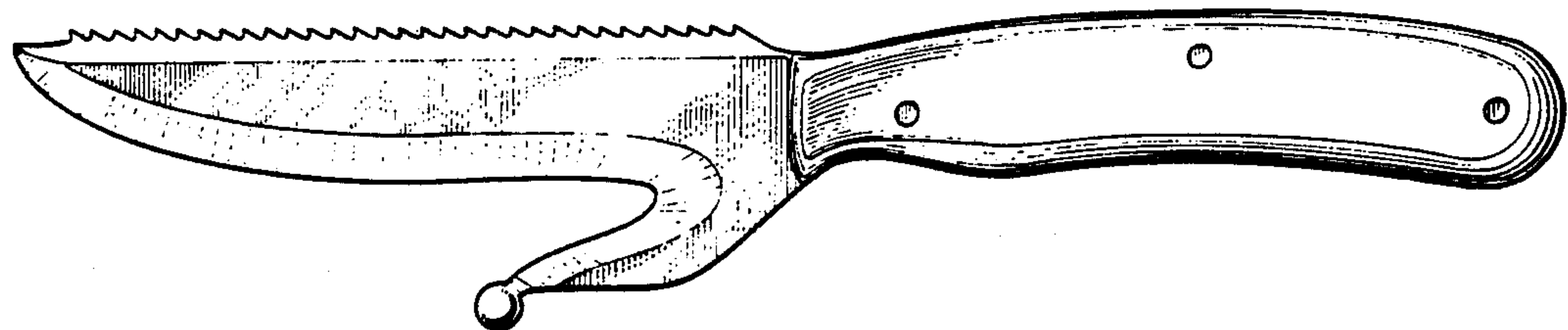

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a knife for animal dressing and preparation showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
FIG. 5 is an end view as seen looking from the handle end of the knife.
FIG. 6 is an end view as seen looking from the blade end of the knife.



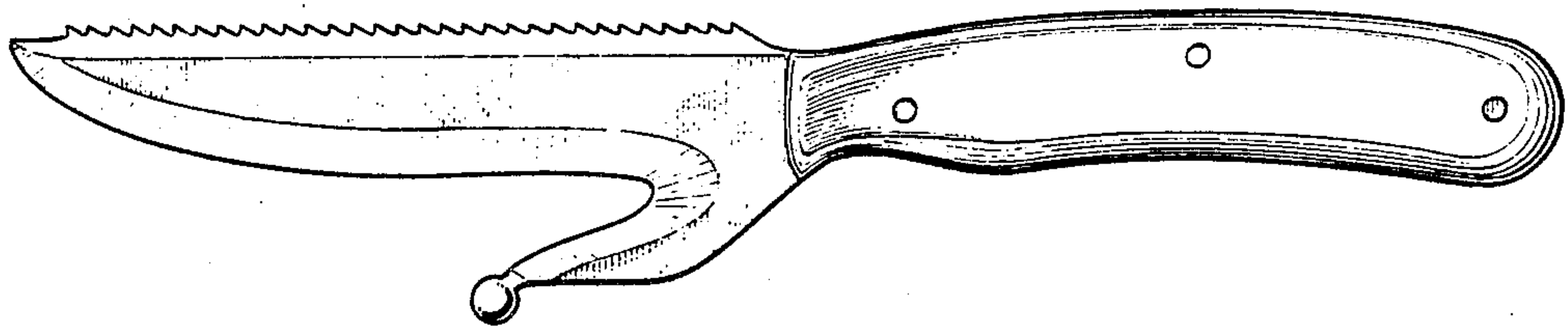

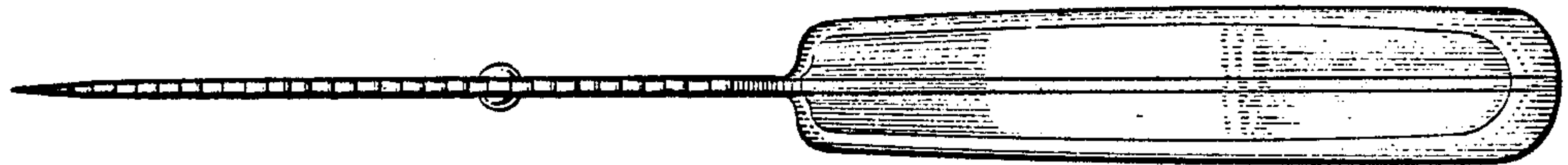

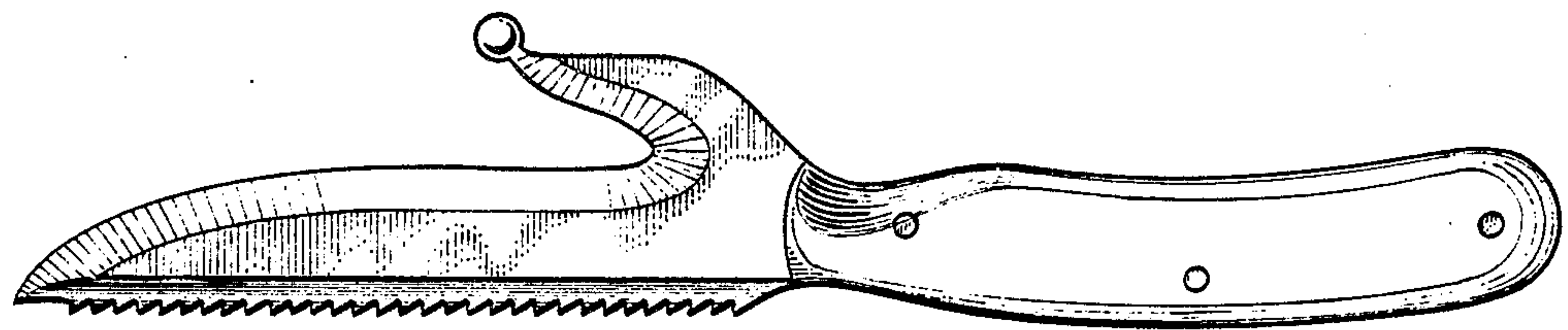

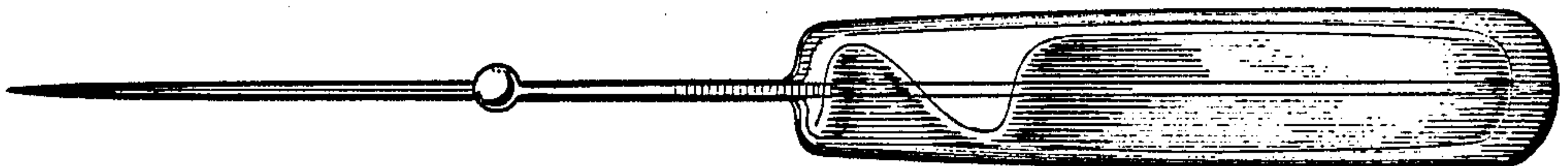

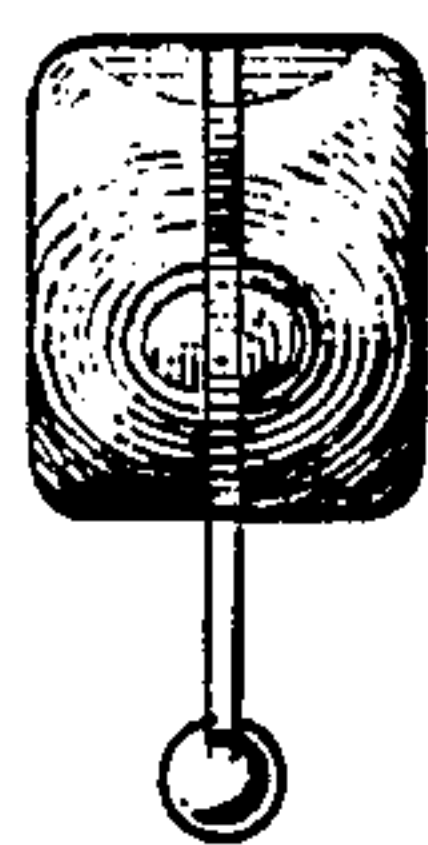
