[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chest protector without epaulette, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chest protector with epaulette showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, the straps broken away for convenience of illustration; and FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof; the straps removed for convenience of illustration.

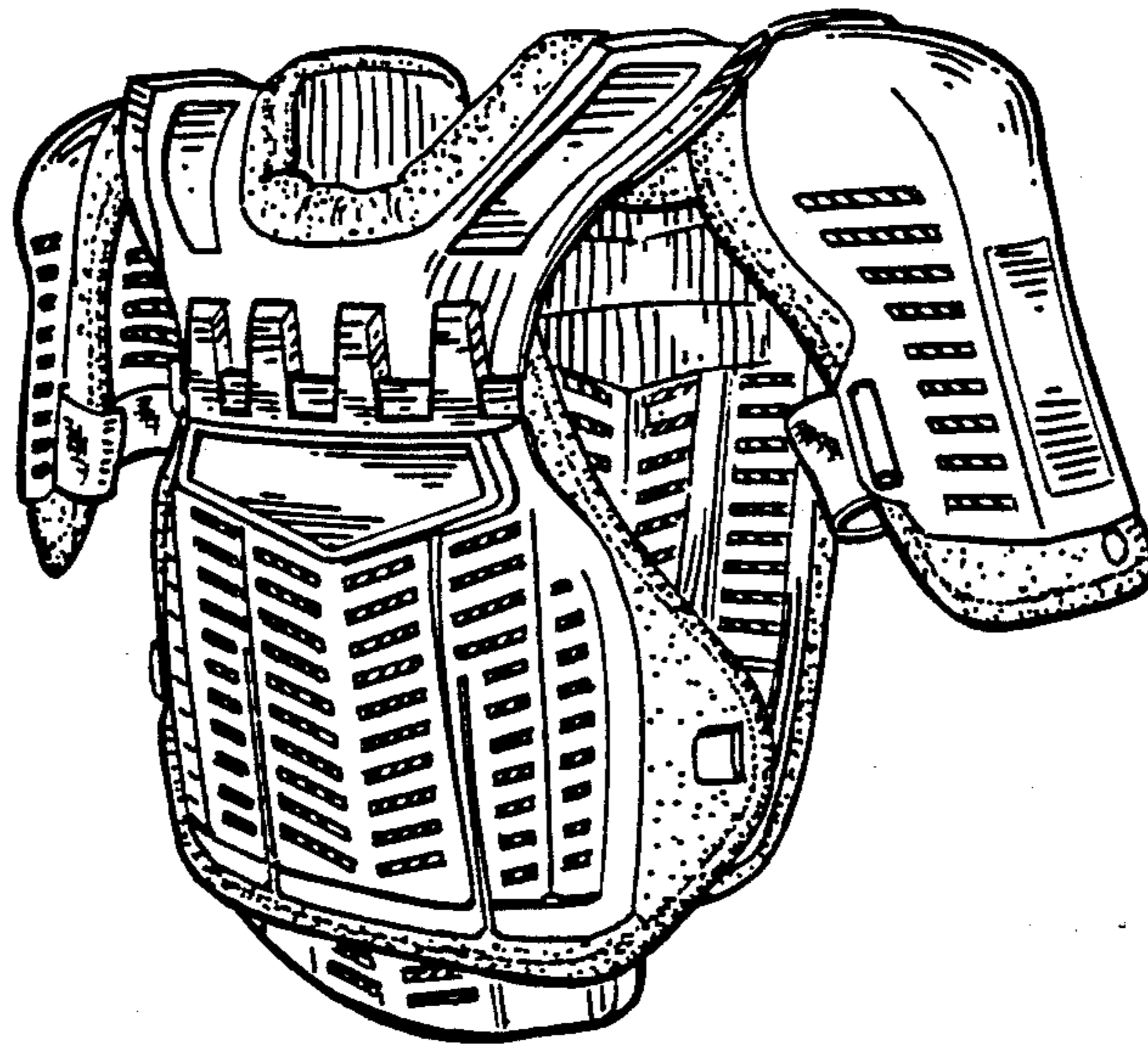

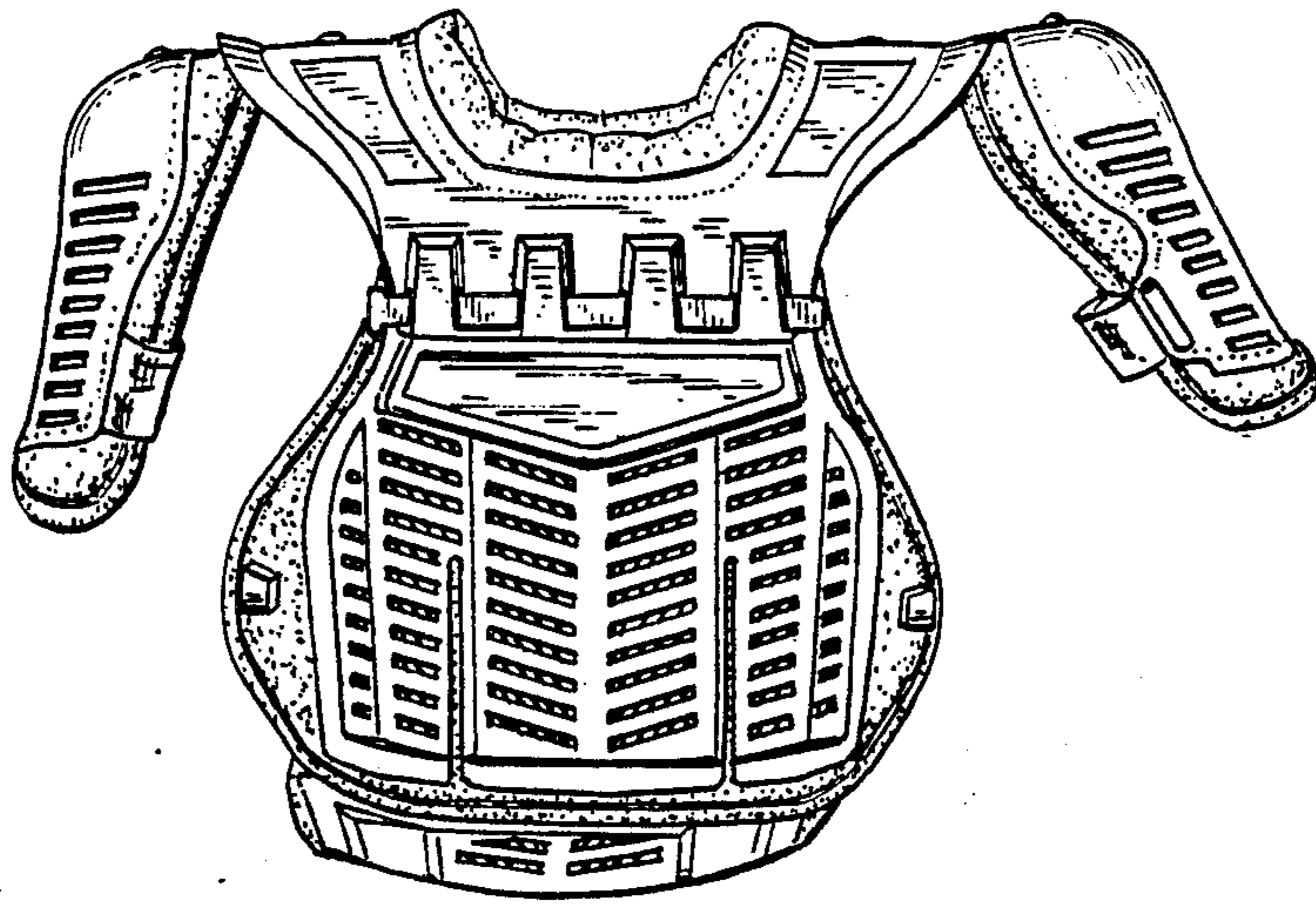
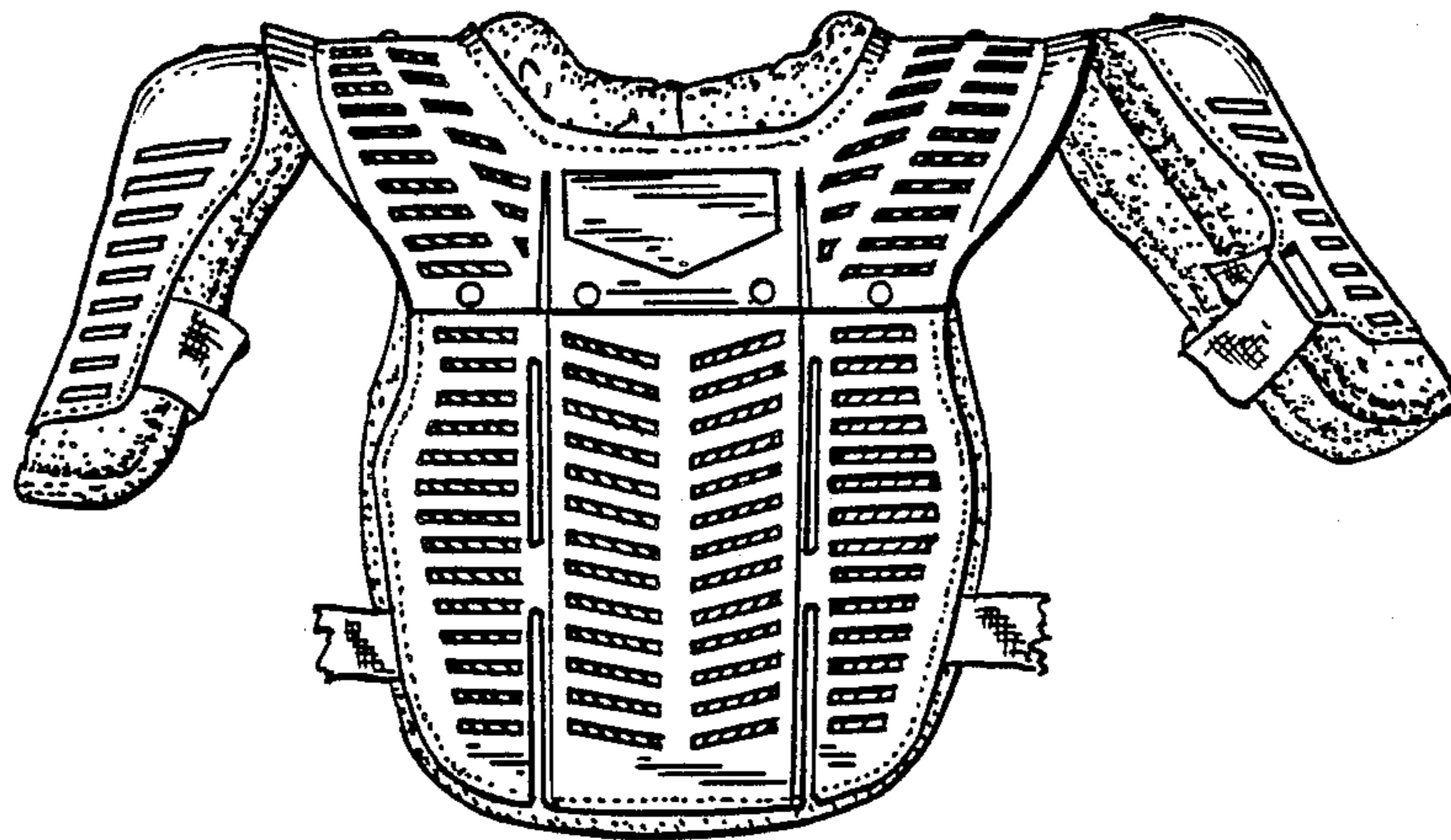

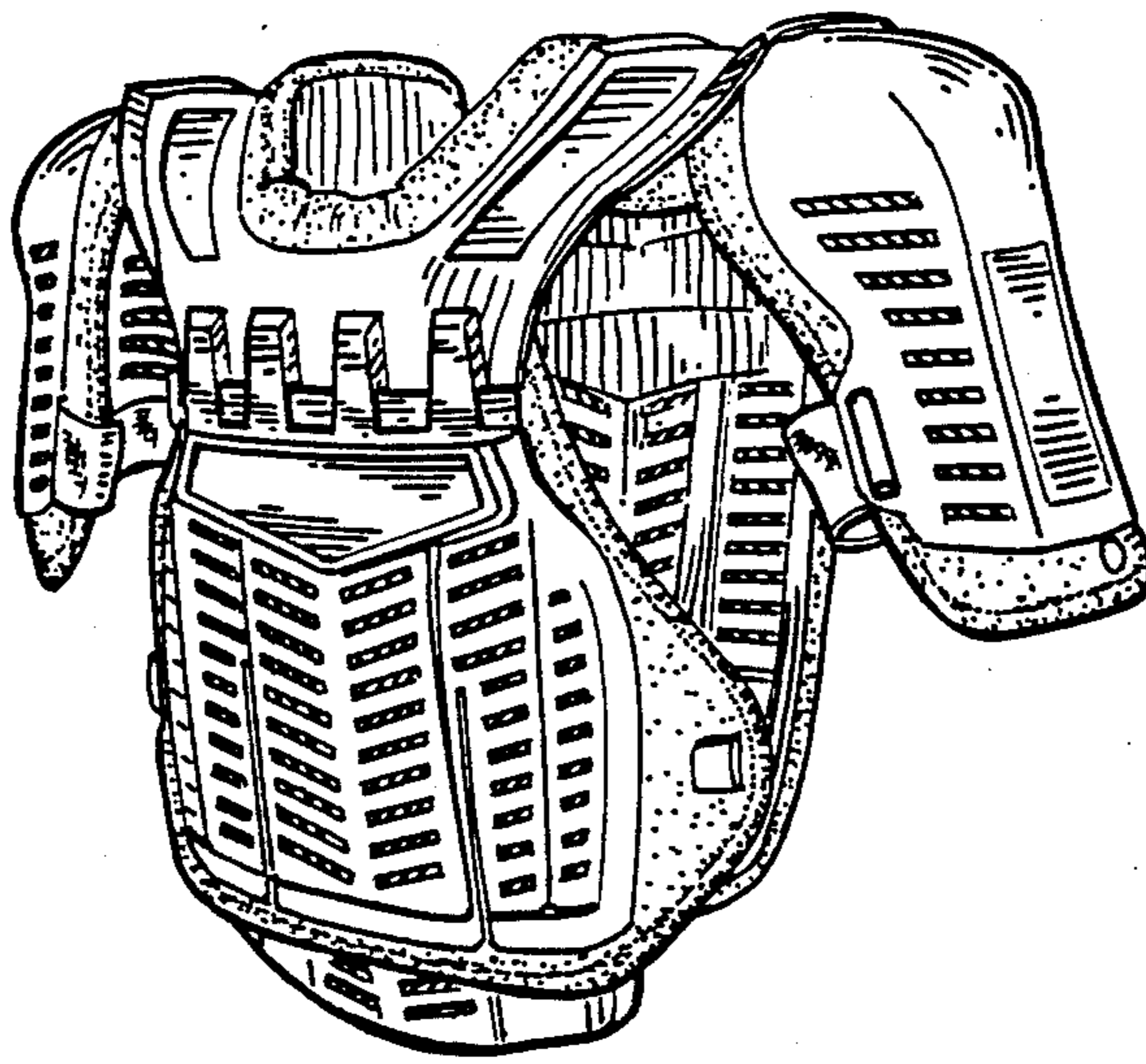
