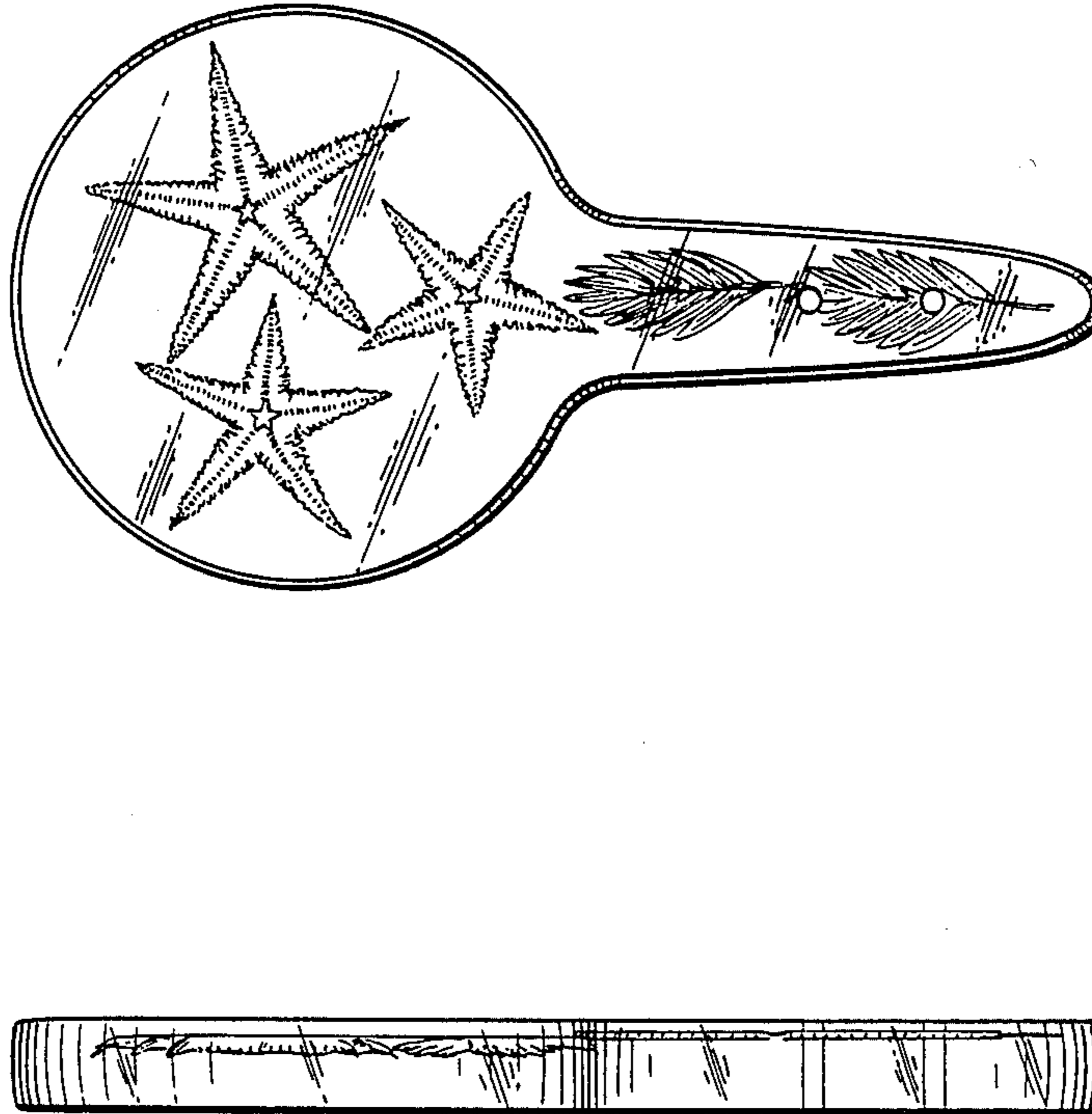

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lifting handle for toilet seats or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lifting handle for toilet seats or the like showing my new design, the bottom being a mirror image of the top shown; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.



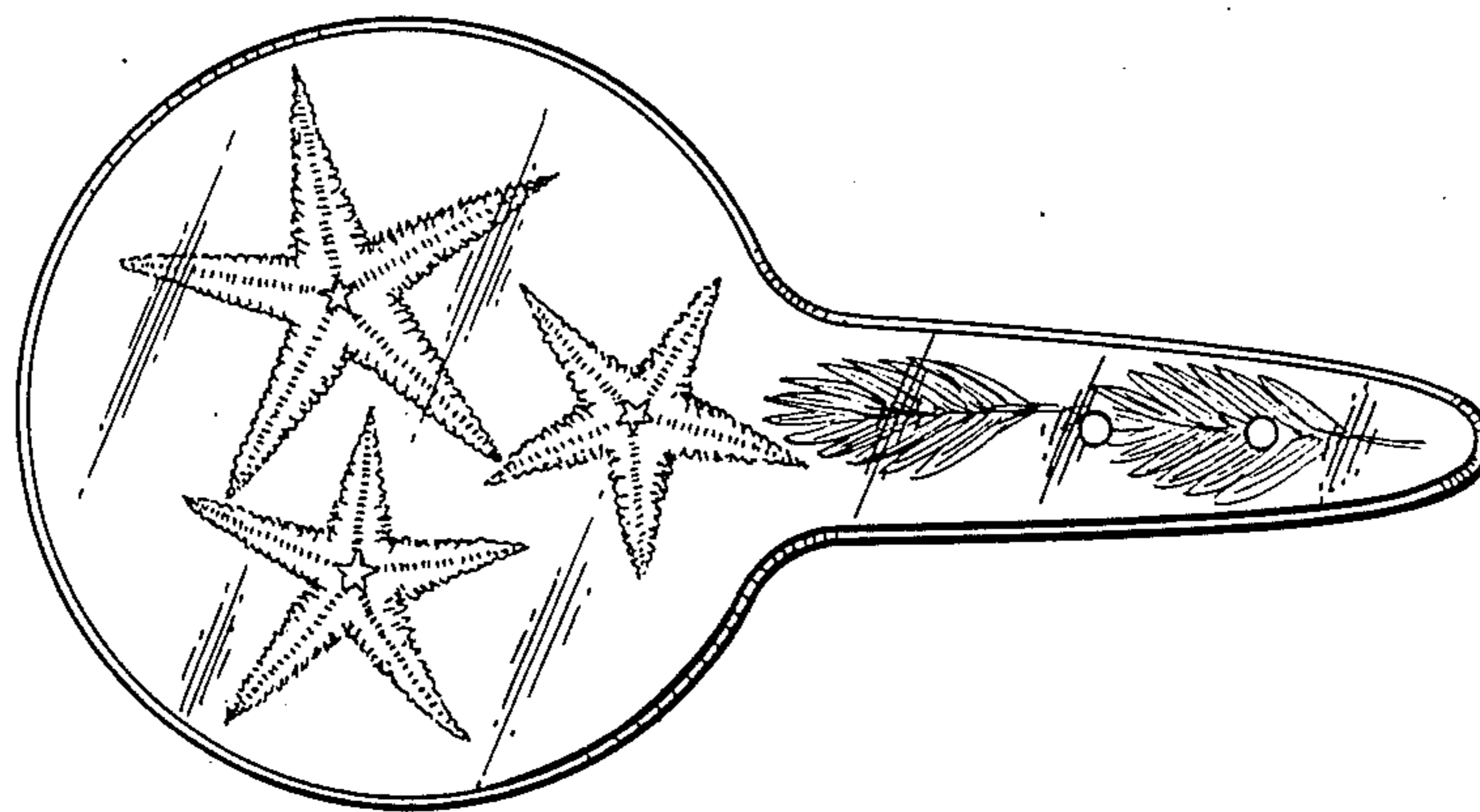
