The ornamental design for a clock, substantially as shown and described.

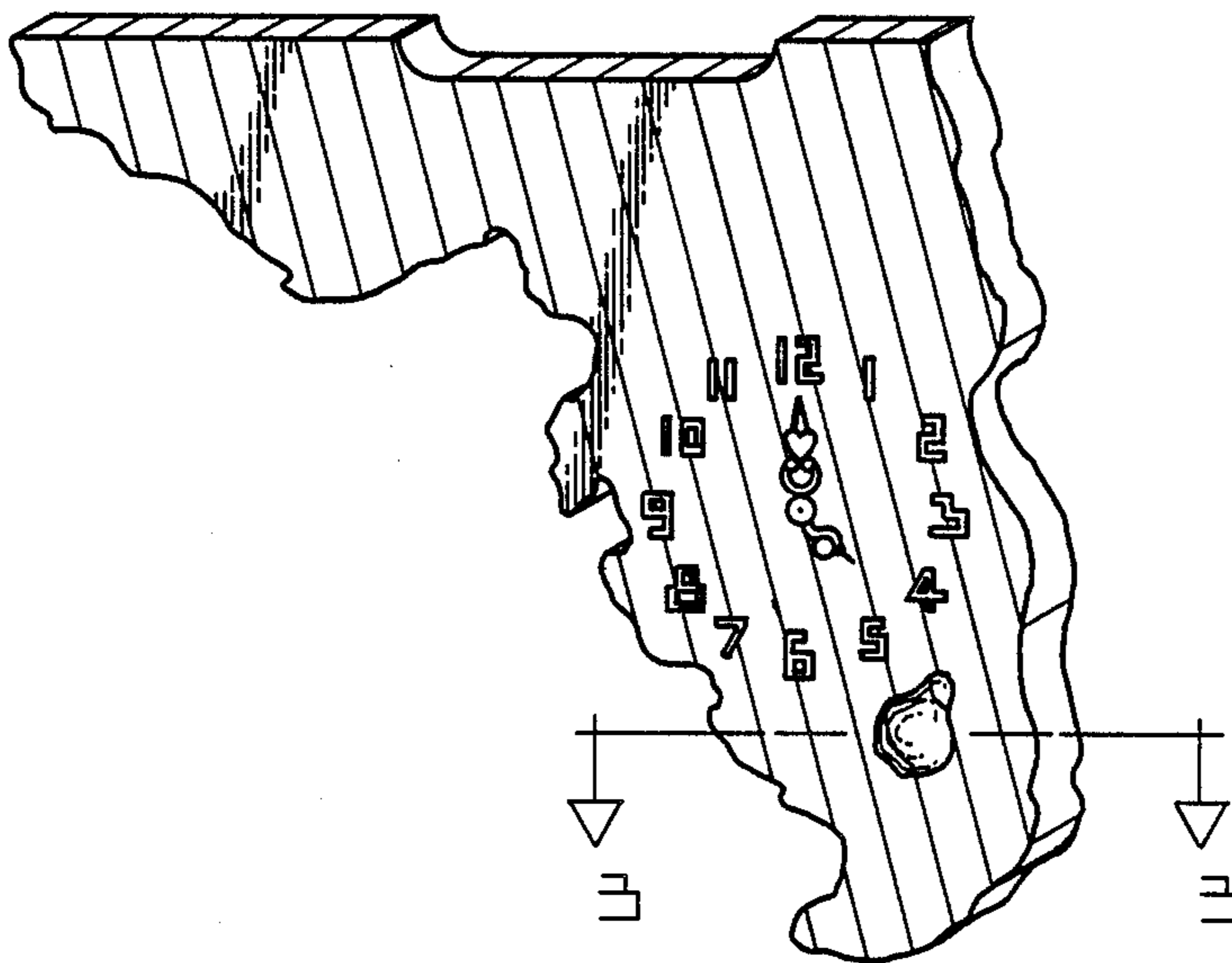
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a clock showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right elevational view thereof on a reduced scale.



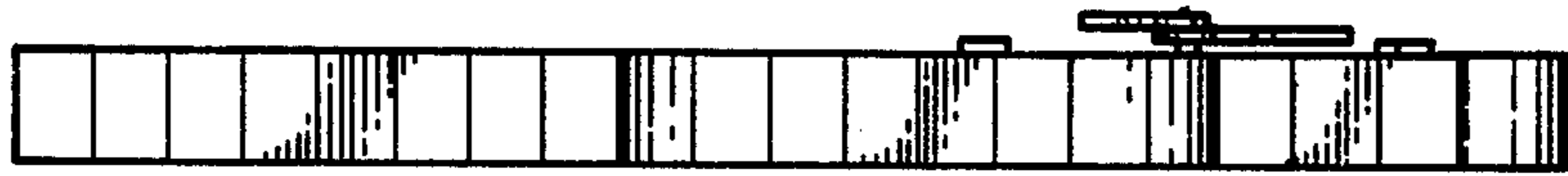
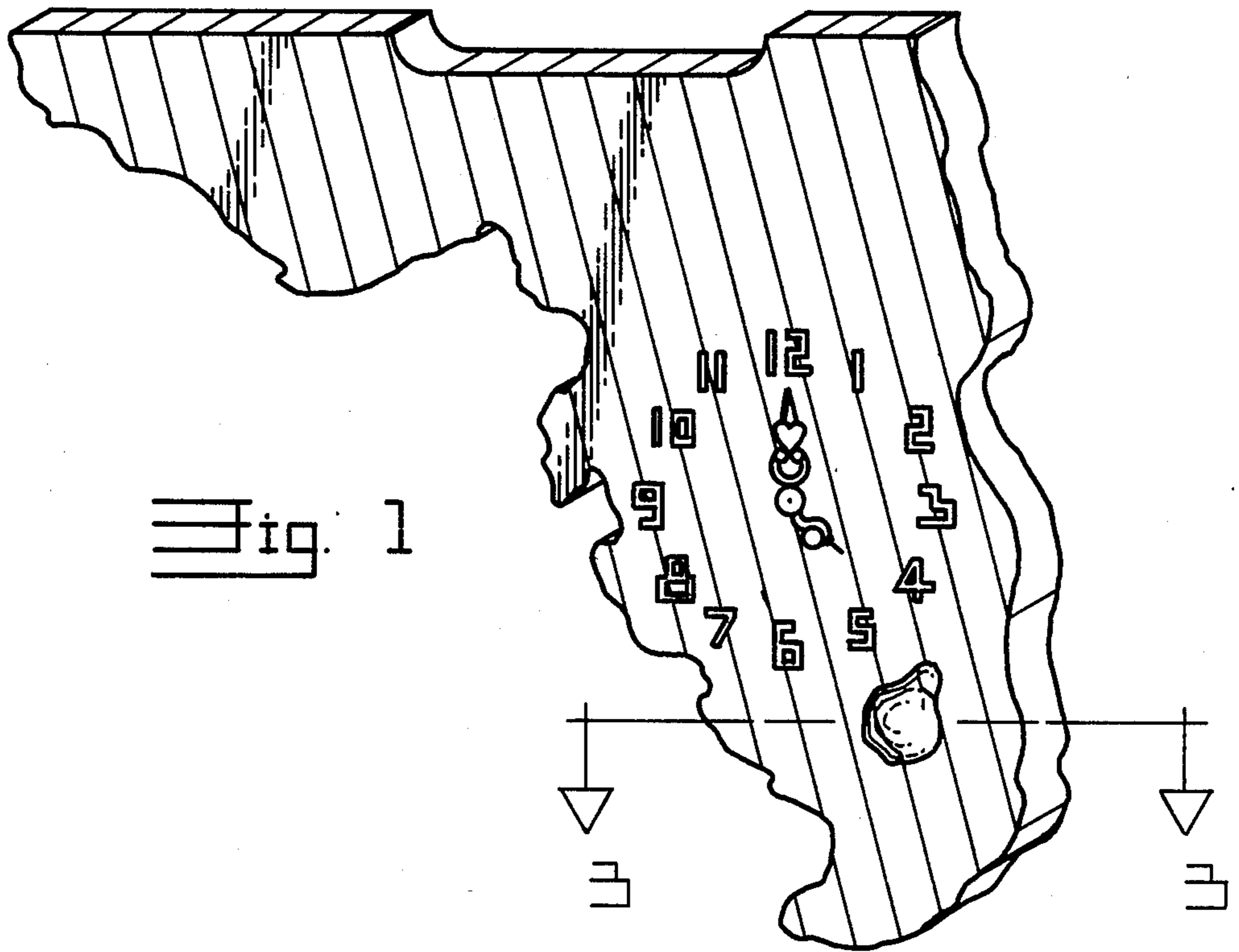

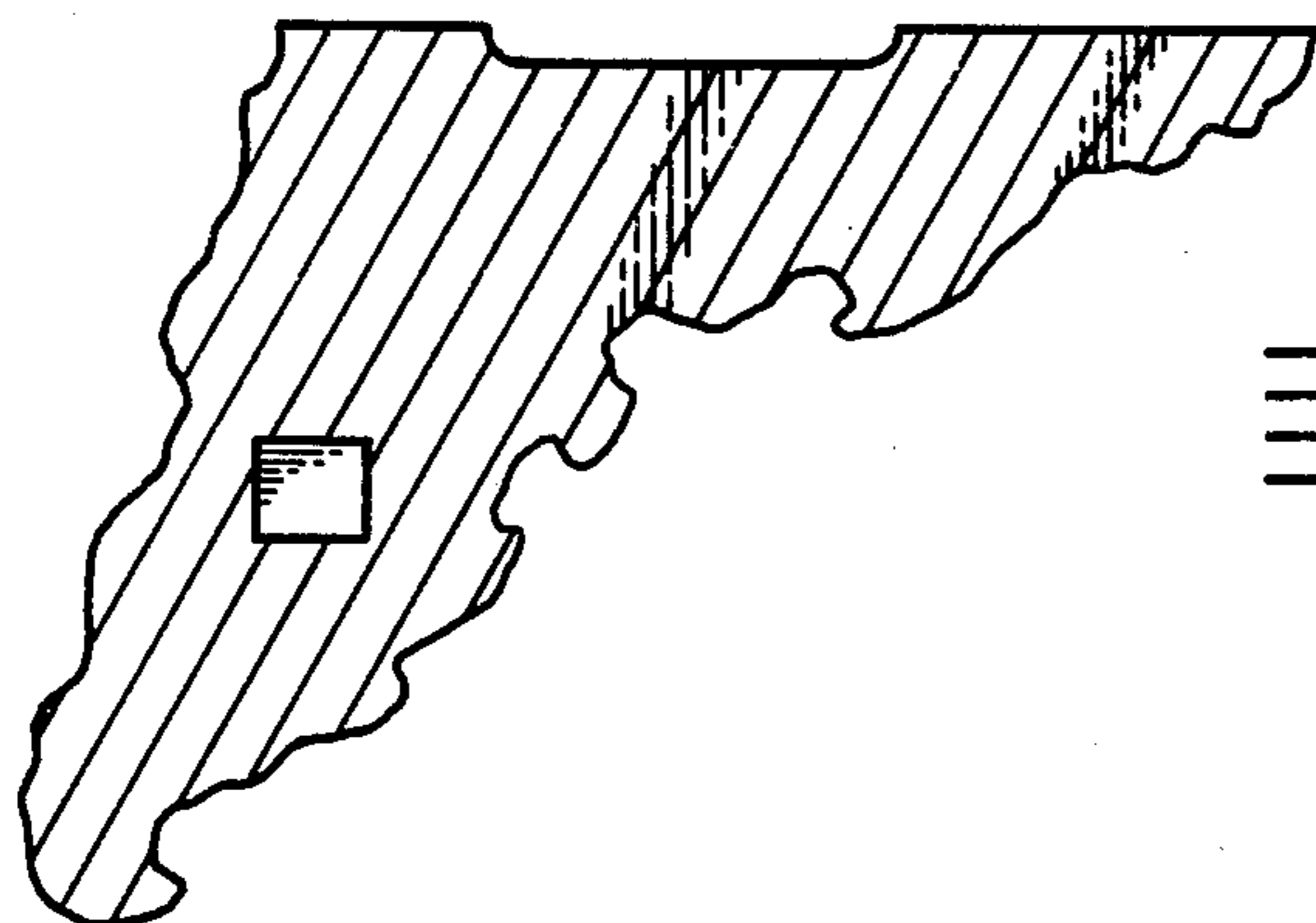
