

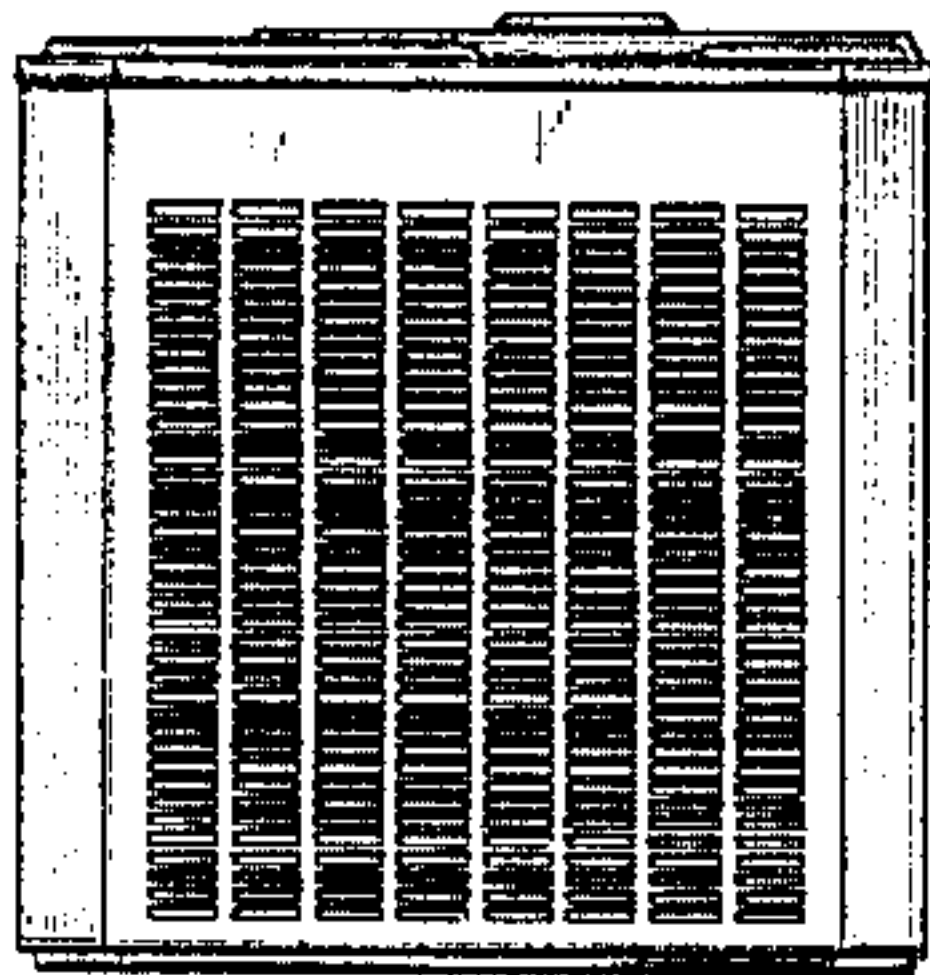
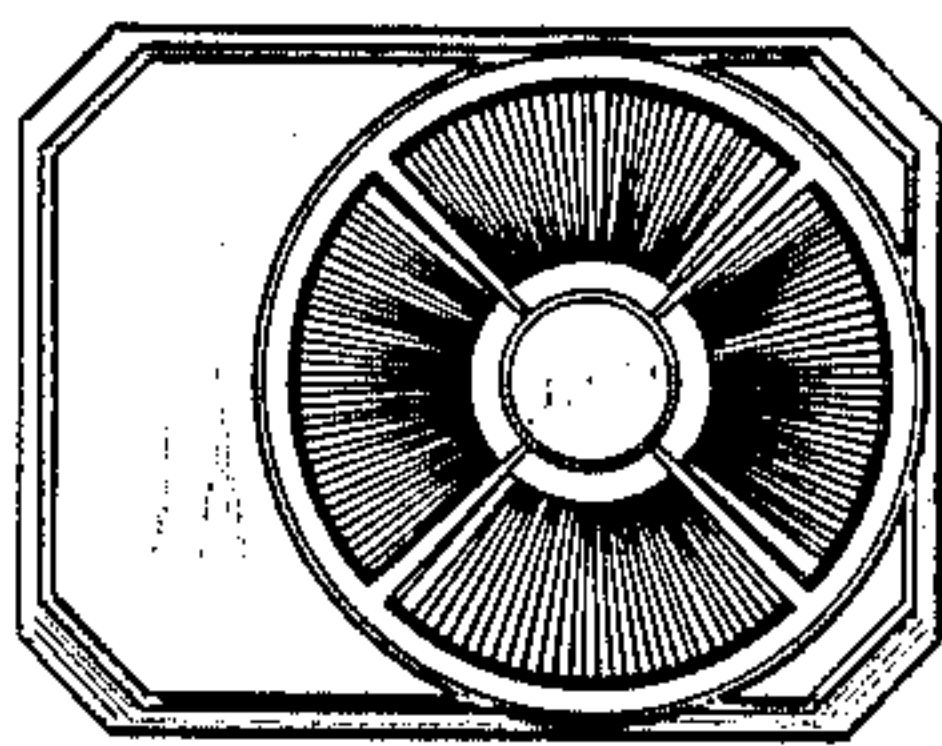

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[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for an outdoor condenser cabinet for an air conditioning unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an outdoor condenser cabinet for an air conditioning unit showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment thereof, the rear being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the second embodiment thereof, the left side being a mirror image.



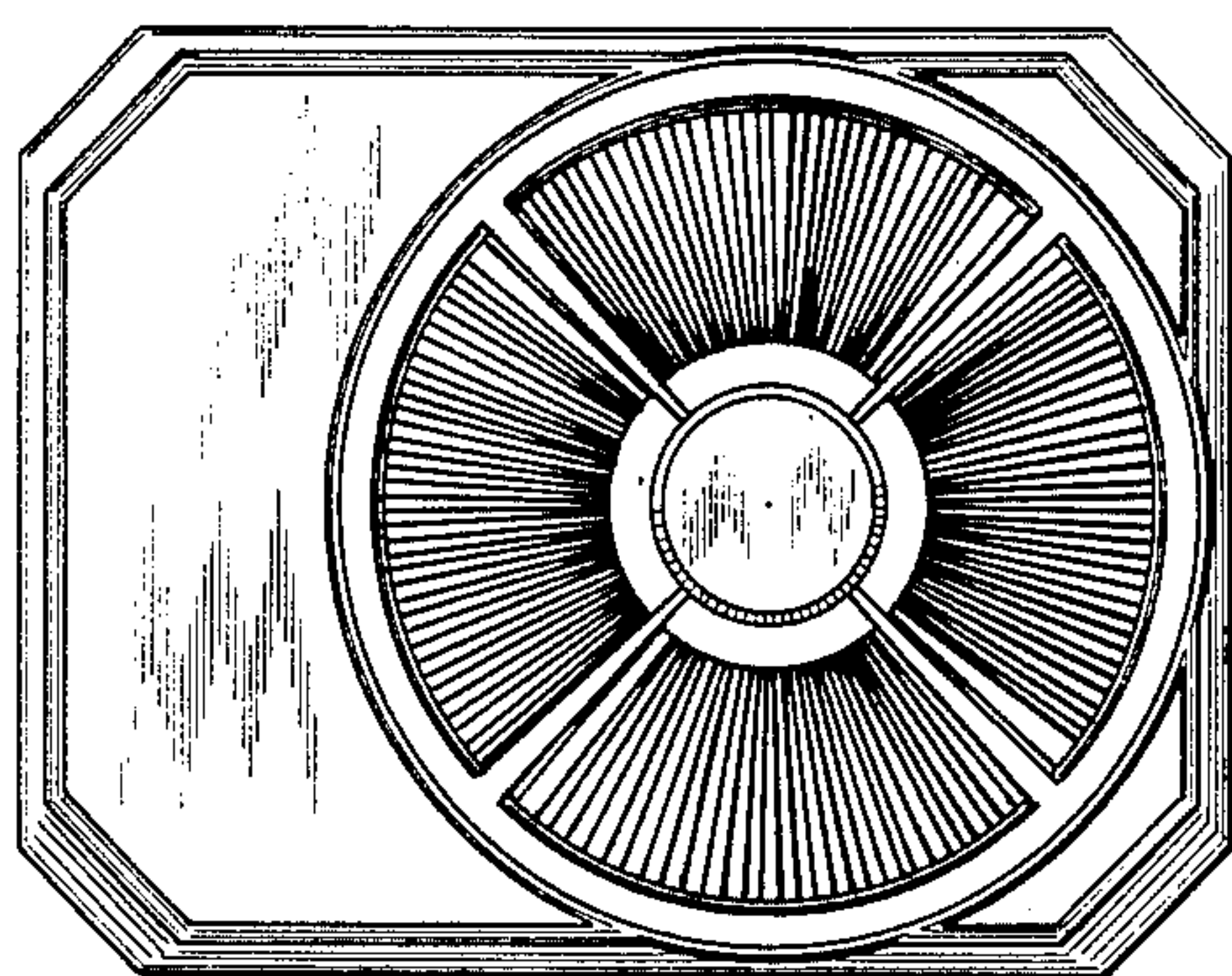

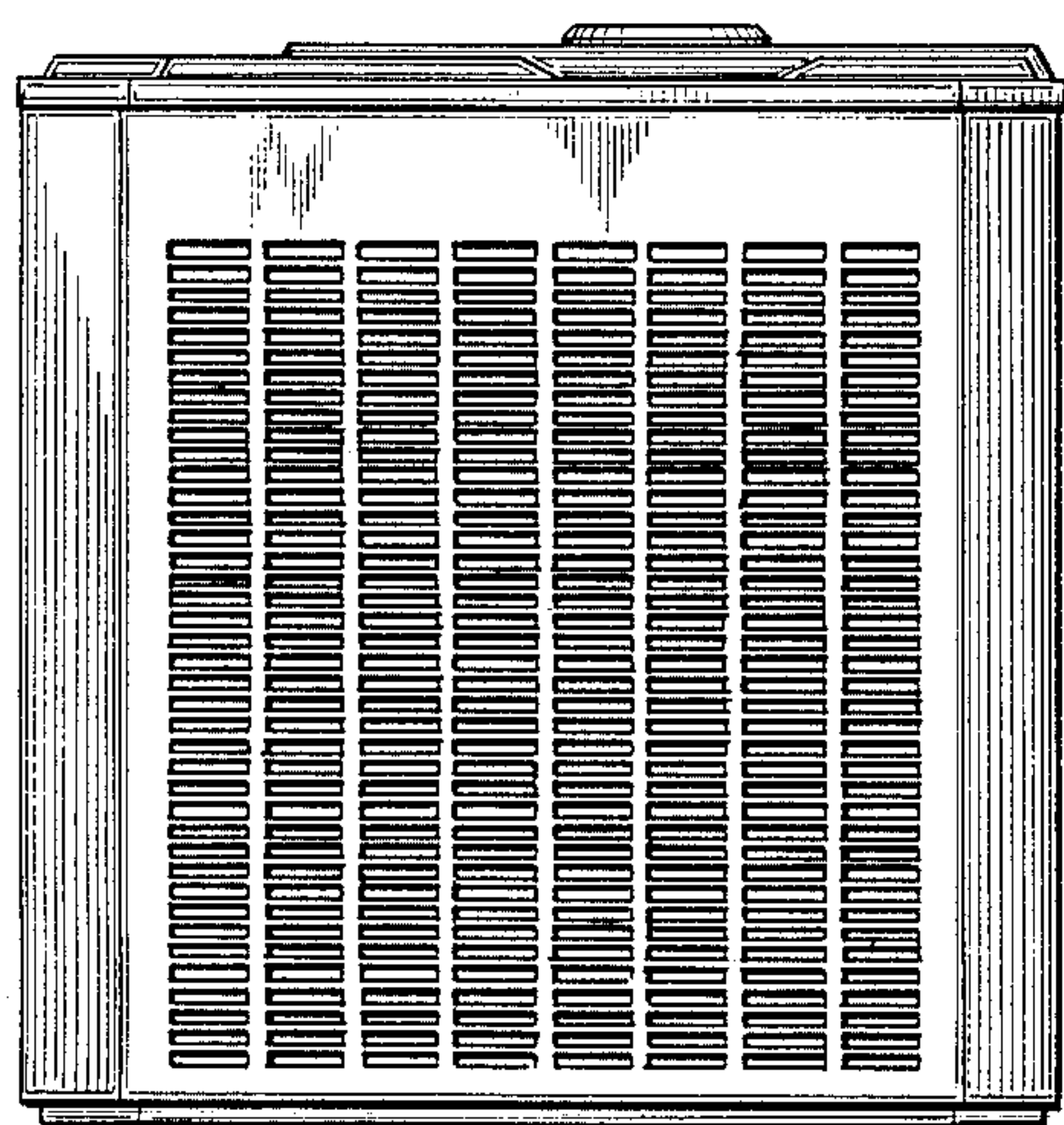

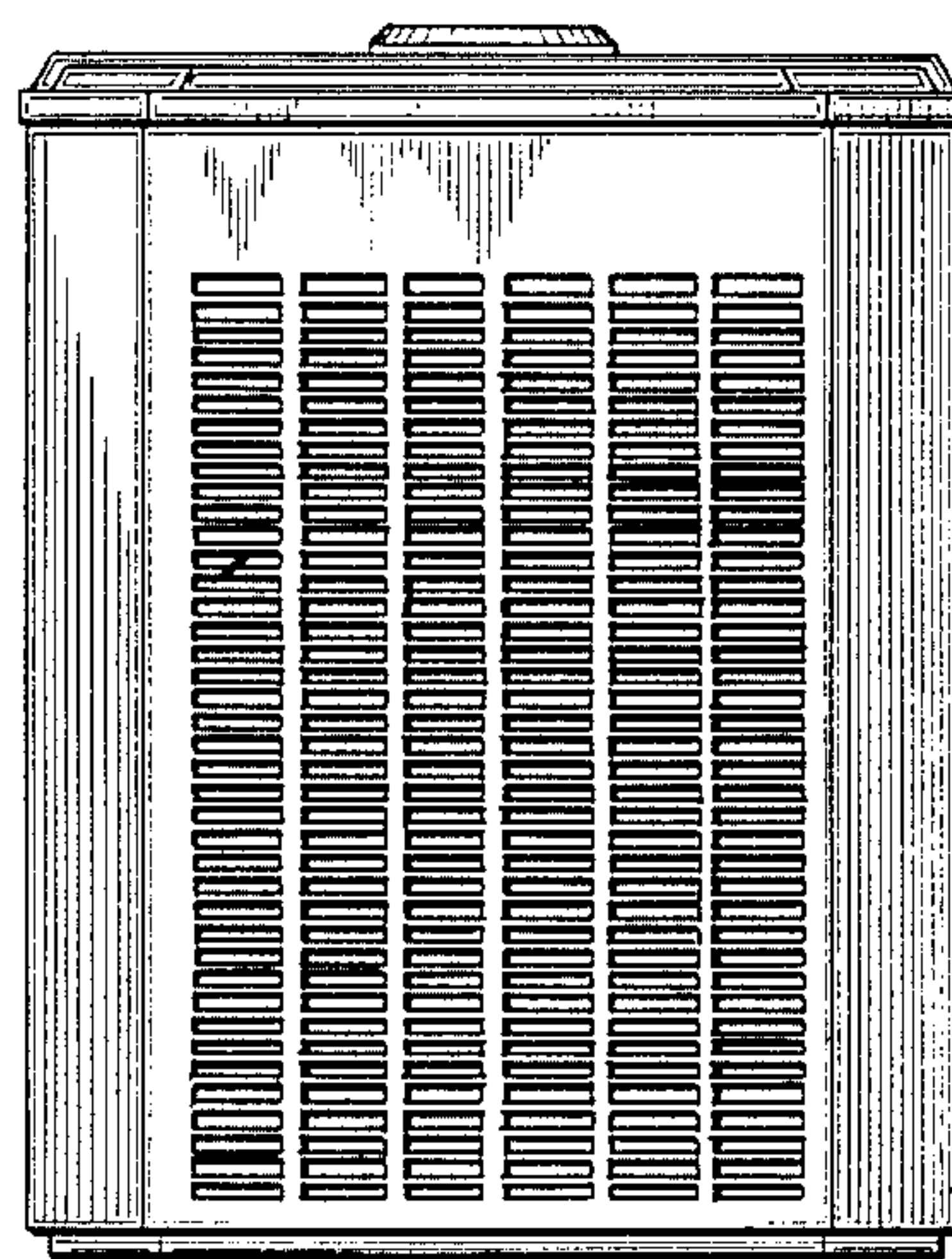

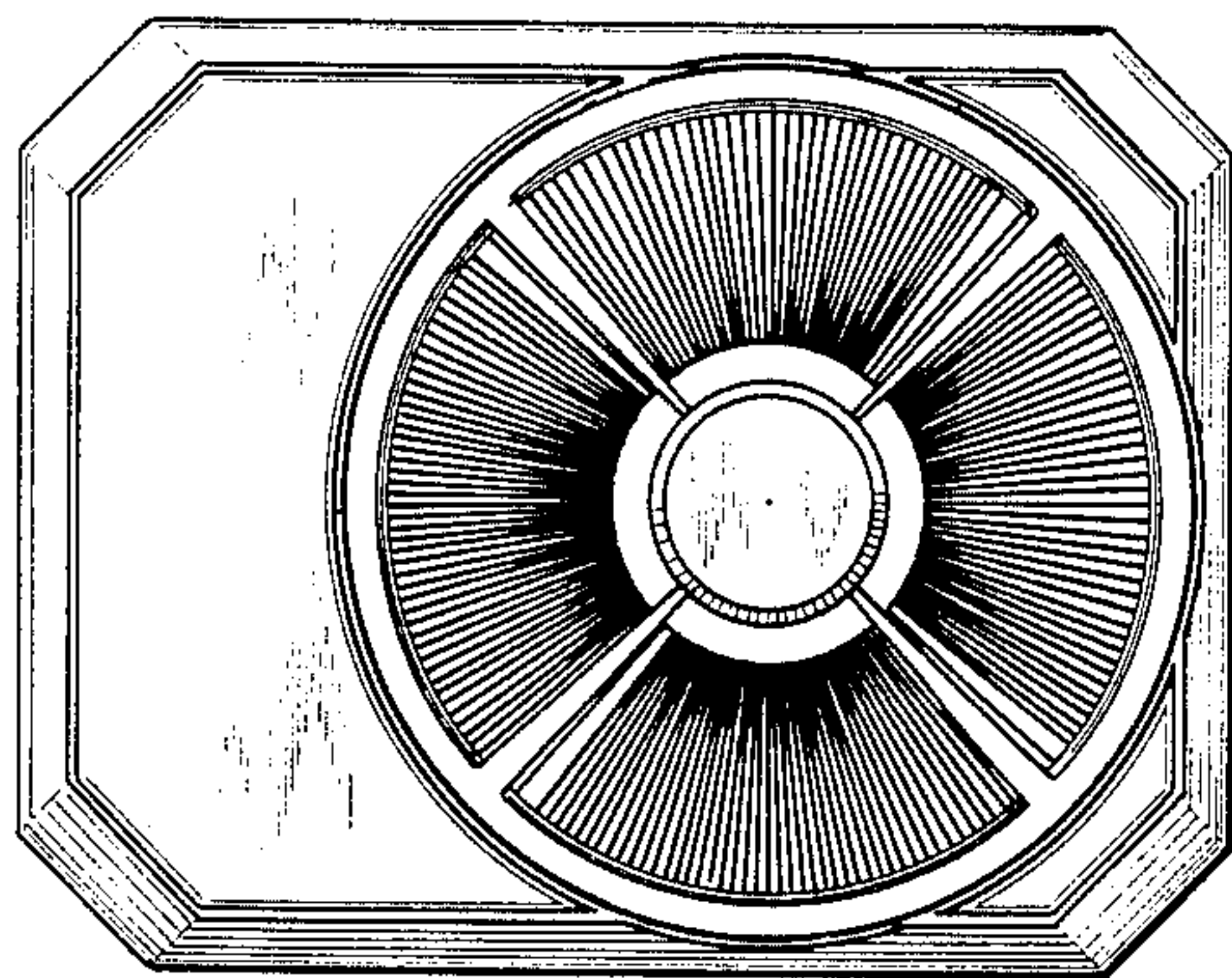

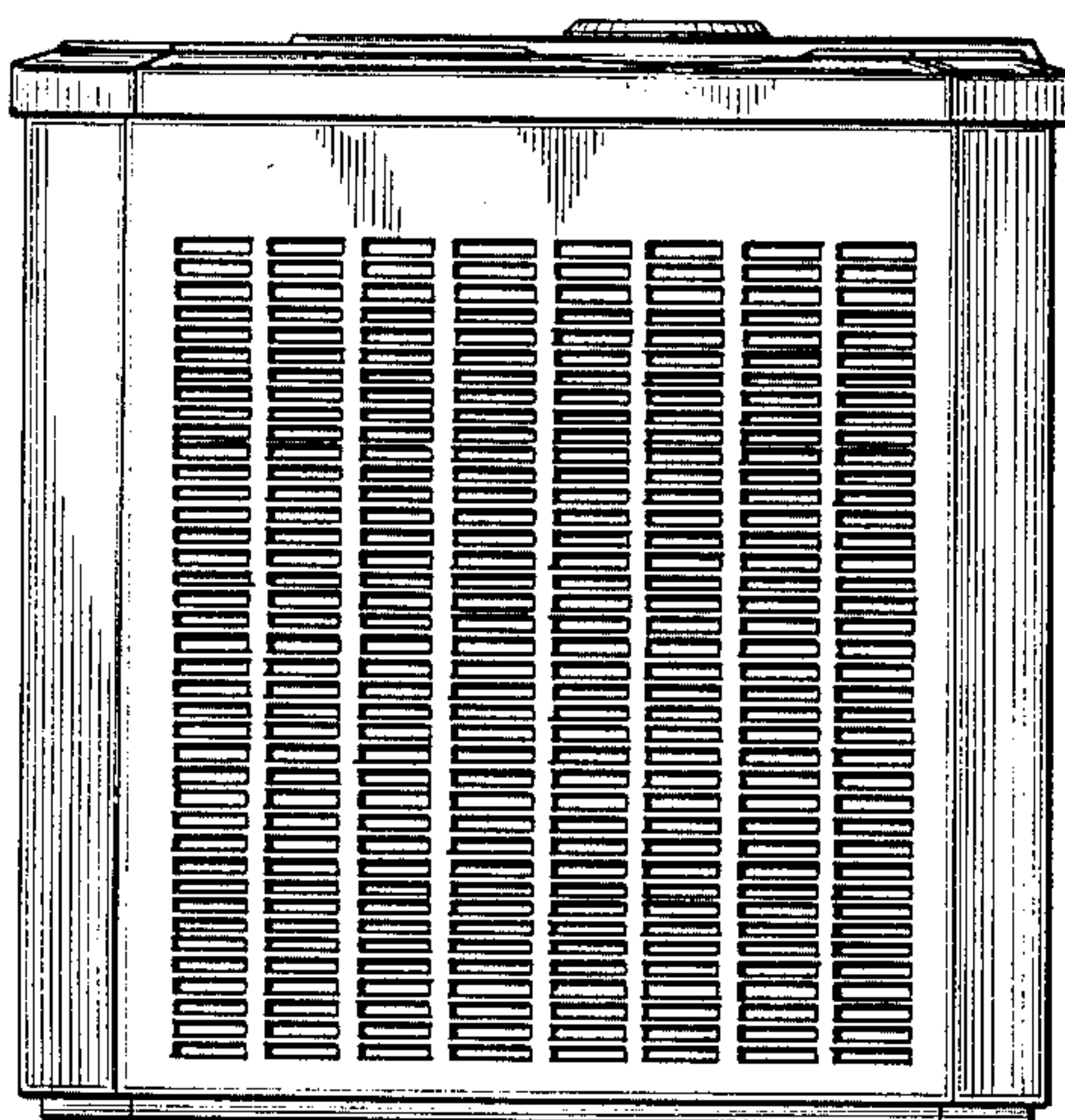

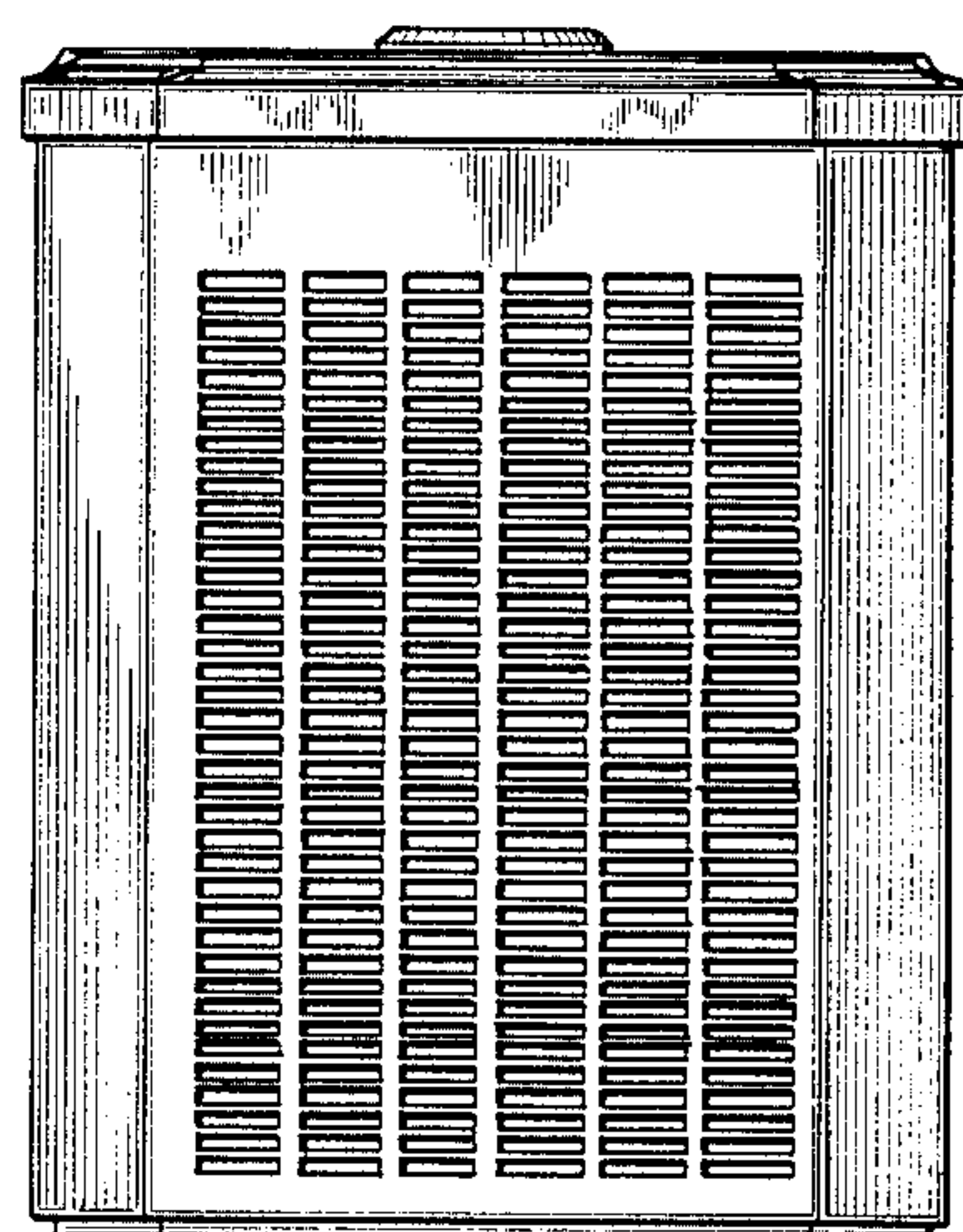
