[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a disposable holder for surgical knife blade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a disposable holder for surgical knife blade showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a right end elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view thereof on line 8—8 of FIG. 3; and FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view thereof on line 9—9 of FIG. 3.

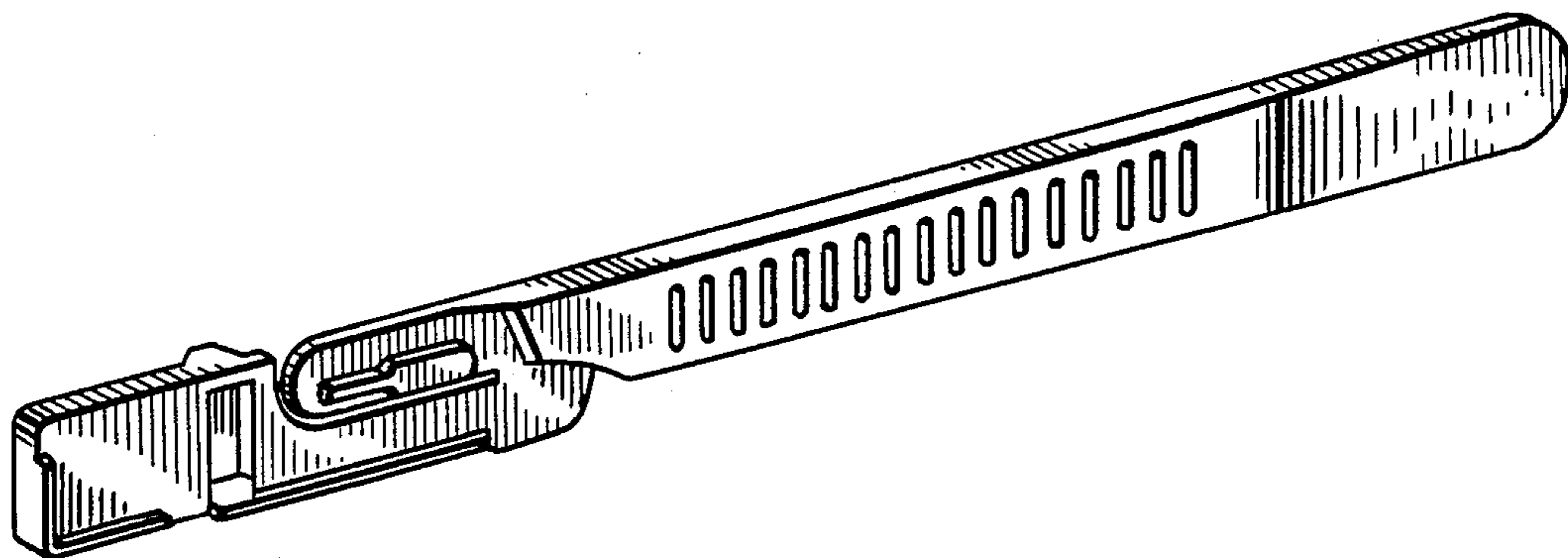

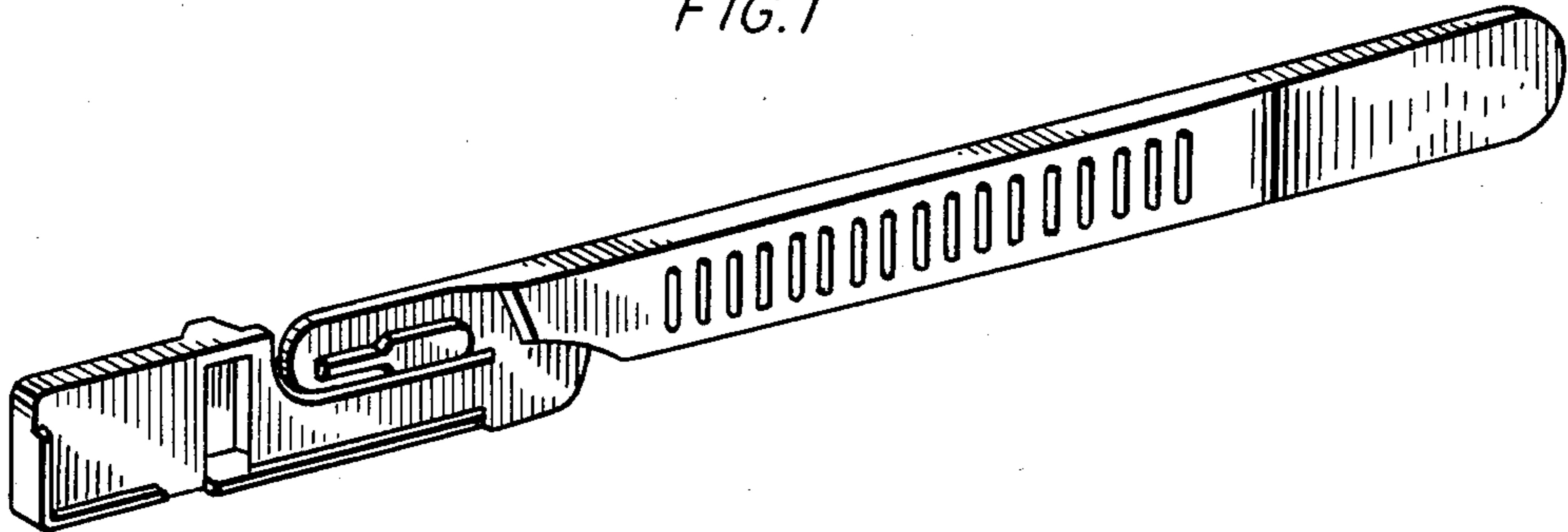

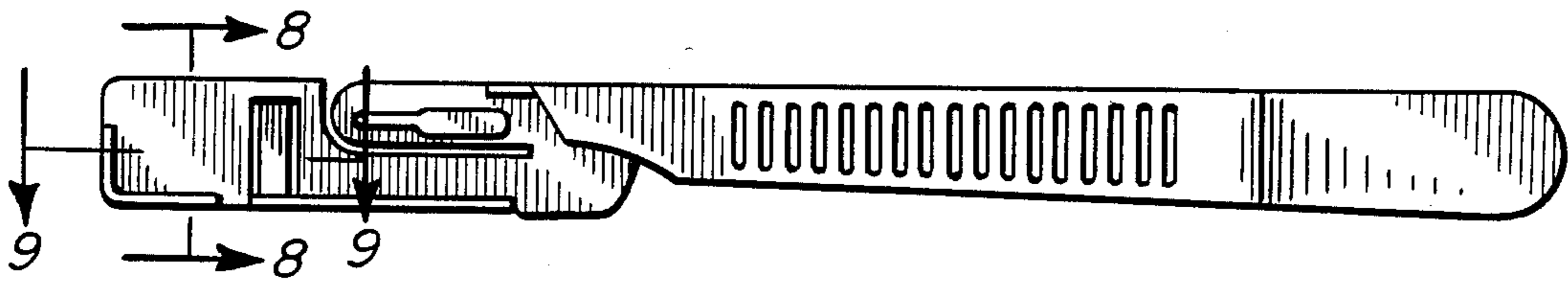

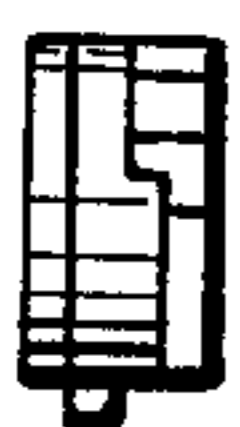
