

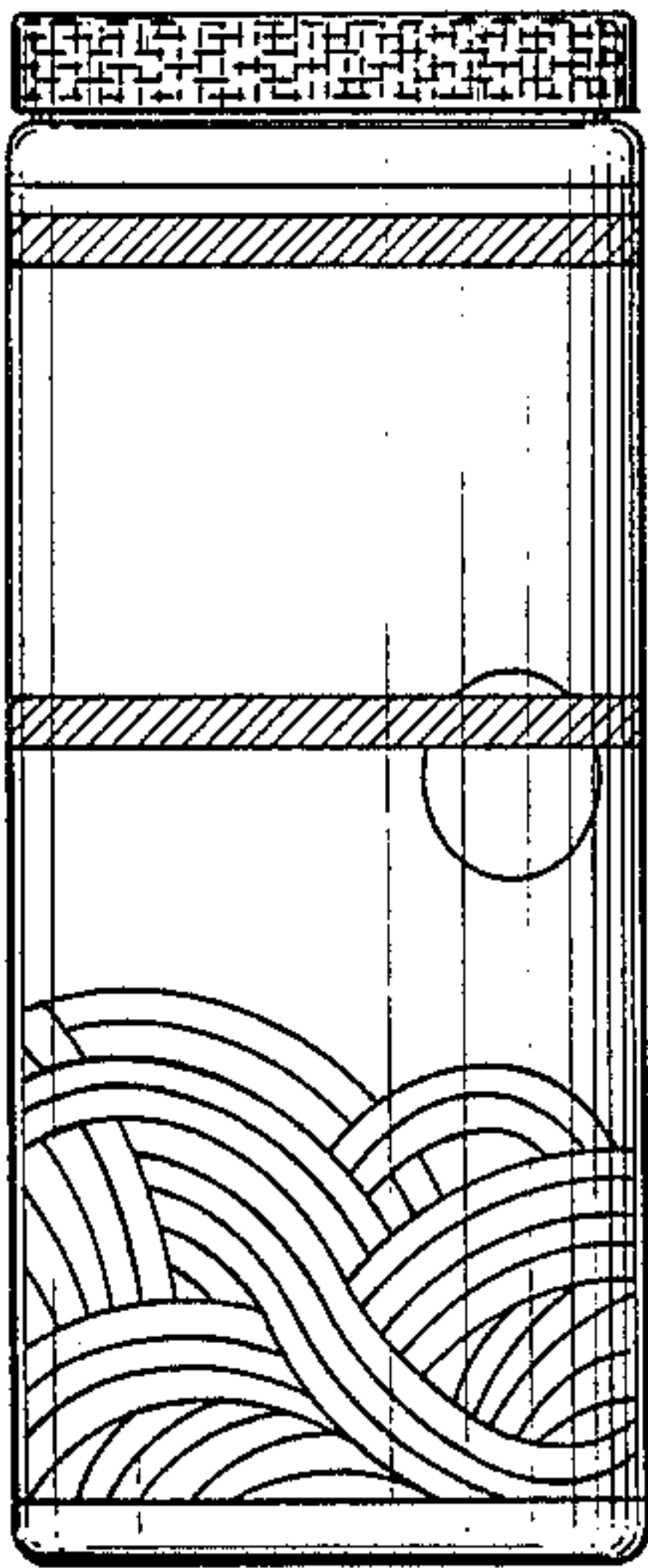

The ornamental design for a jar, substantially as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jar showing our
new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.
The drawing is shaded to show contrasting color.
The characteristic features of our design reside in the
configuration and the appearance of the ornamentation
as seen in FIG. 1 and the two contrasting circular bands
seen in FIGS. 1 and 2 on a jar as shown.



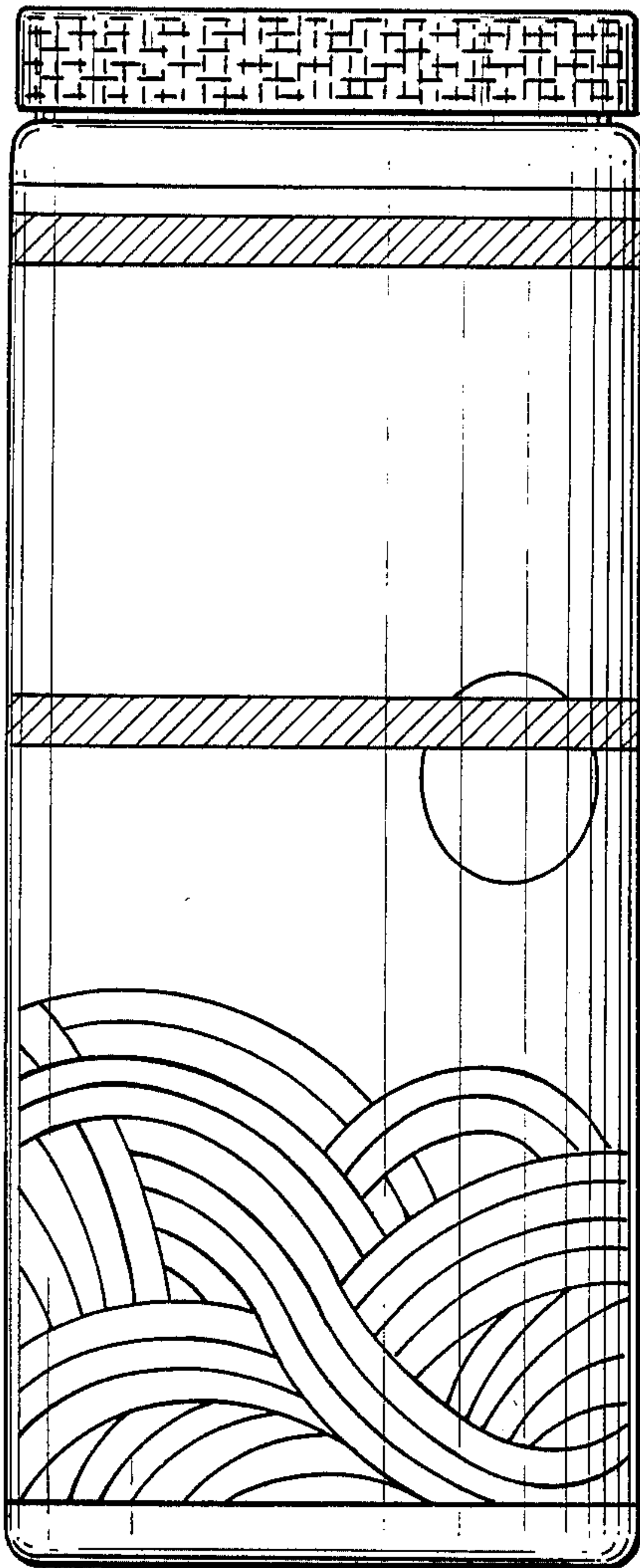

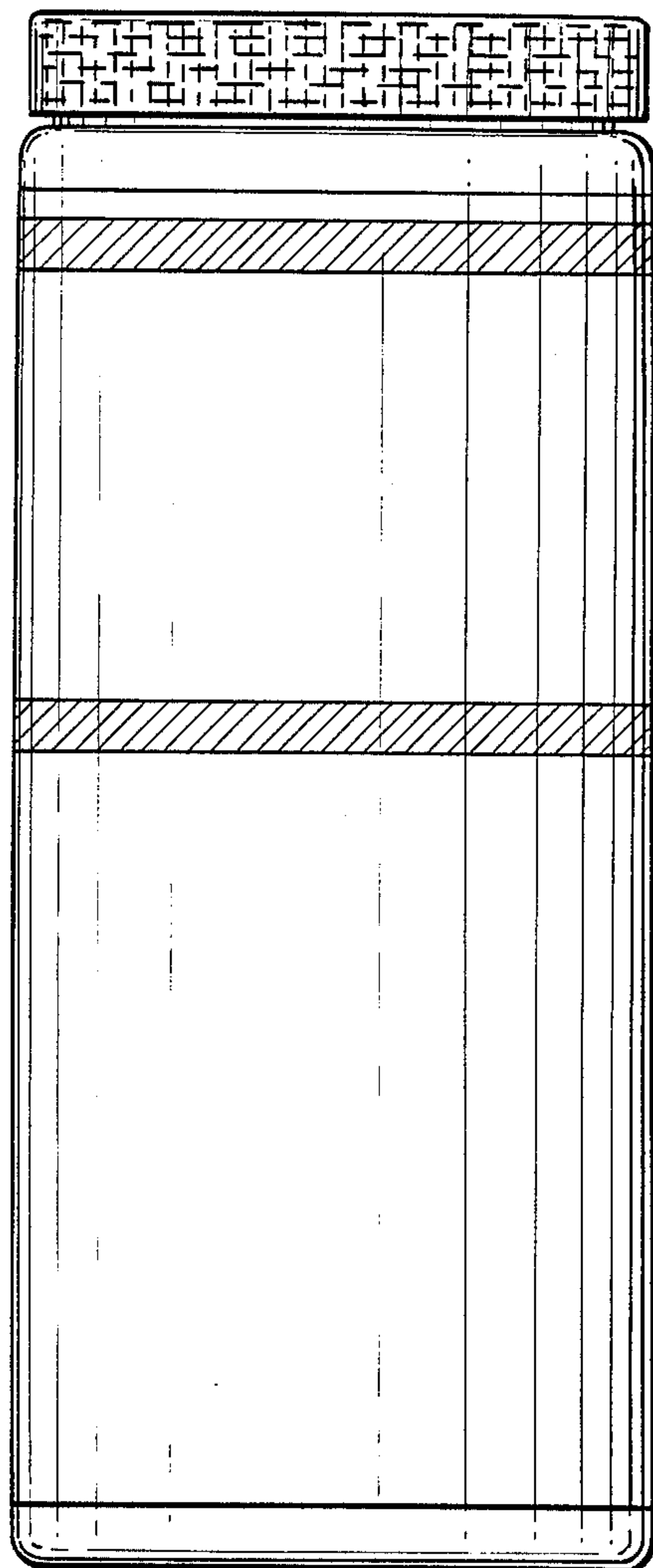

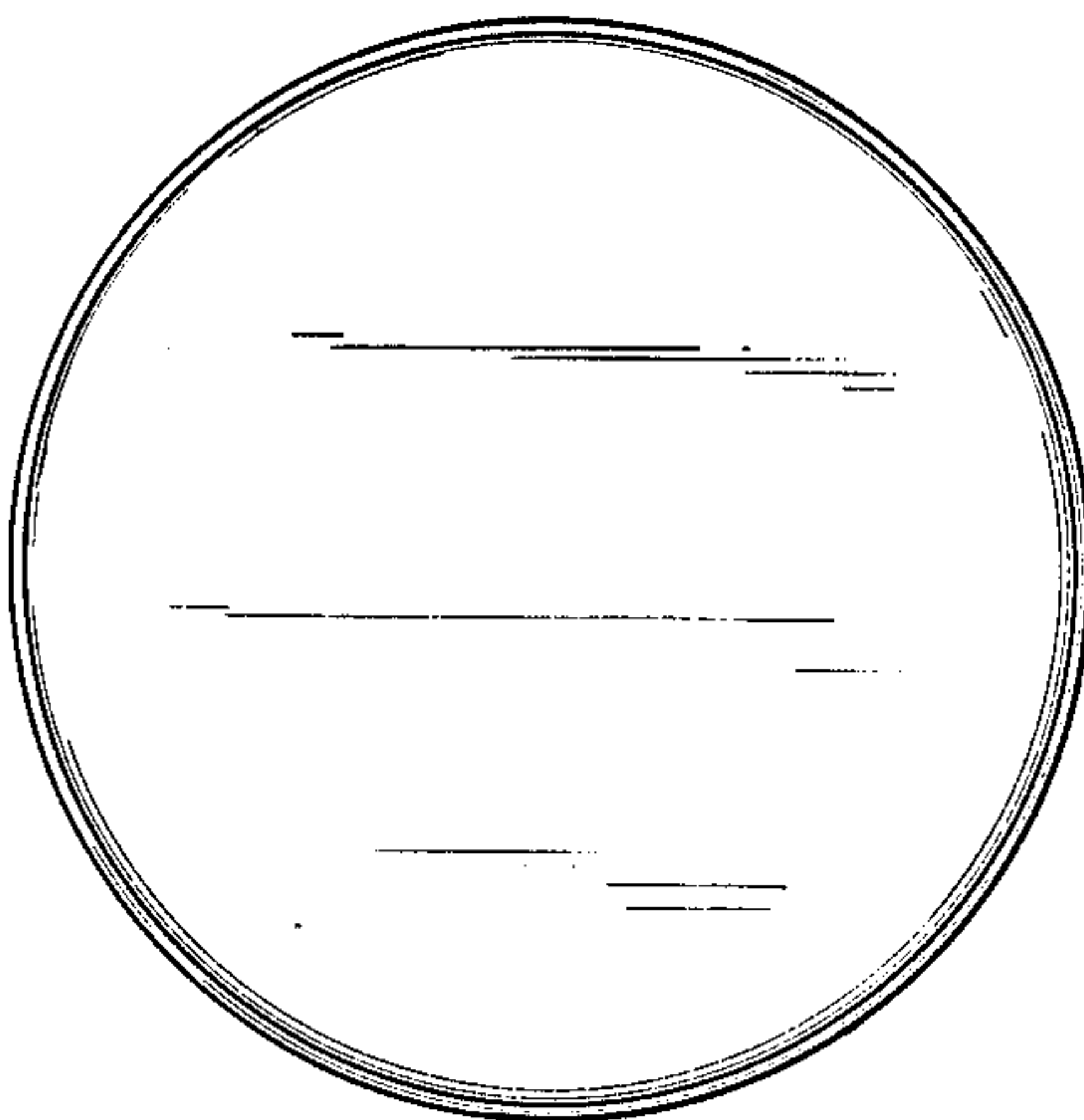

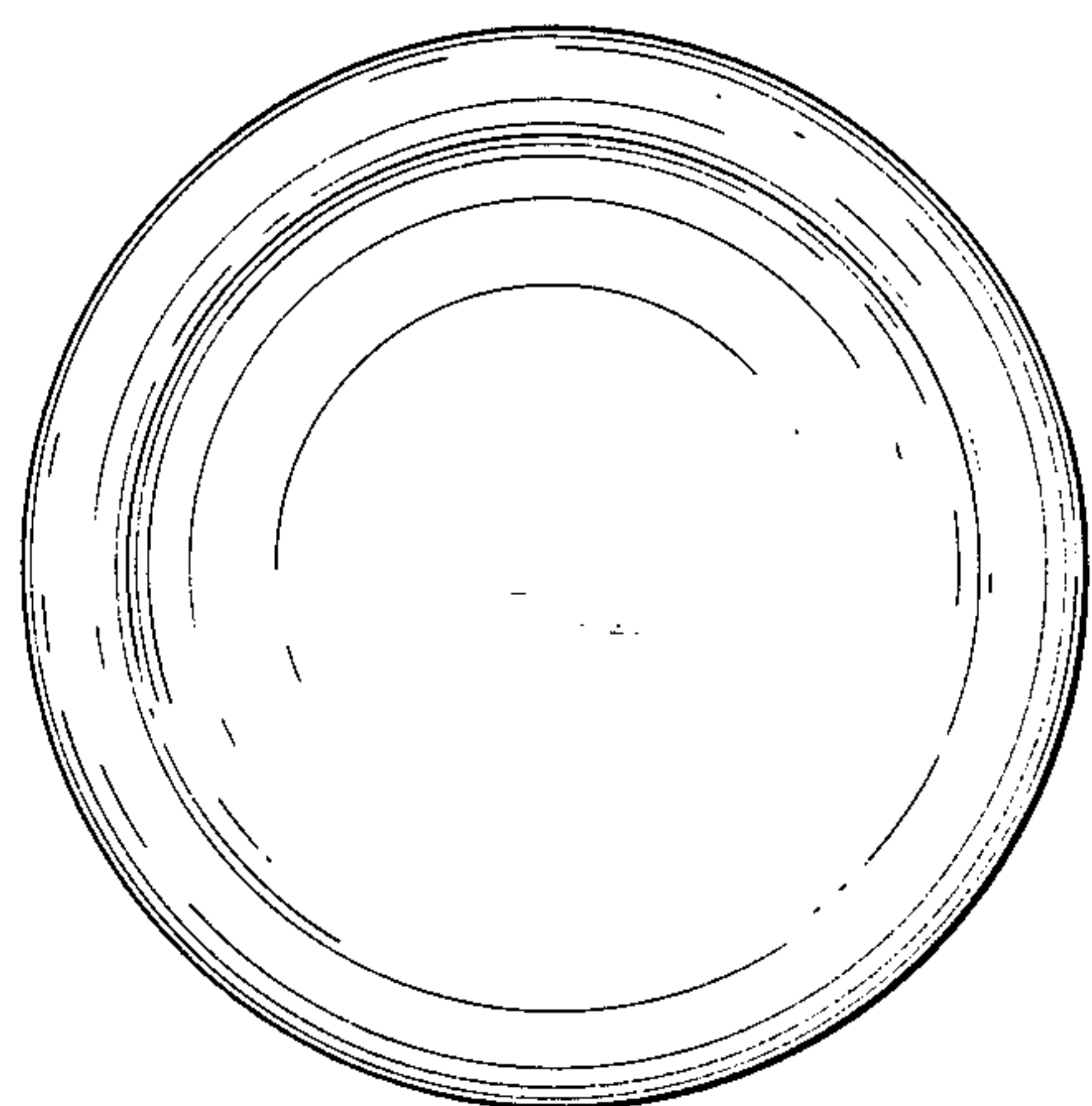
