[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a note pad holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a note pad holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof shown on a slightly enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 6;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 11;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image; and

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.
