[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a trash chute, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the upper portion of a trash chute showing my new design, it being understood that the upper portion is shown separately for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view of FIG. 1, with a door/ledge assembly in closed condition;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged sectional view of FIG. 2, taken along the lines 9—9 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the lower portion of a trash chute, shown separately for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged front elevational view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged side elevational view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 13 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 14 is an enlarged bottom plan view of FIG. 10; and

FIG. 15 is a perspective view of the upper and lower portions of the trash chute shown associated with each other as a unit for clarity of illustration.

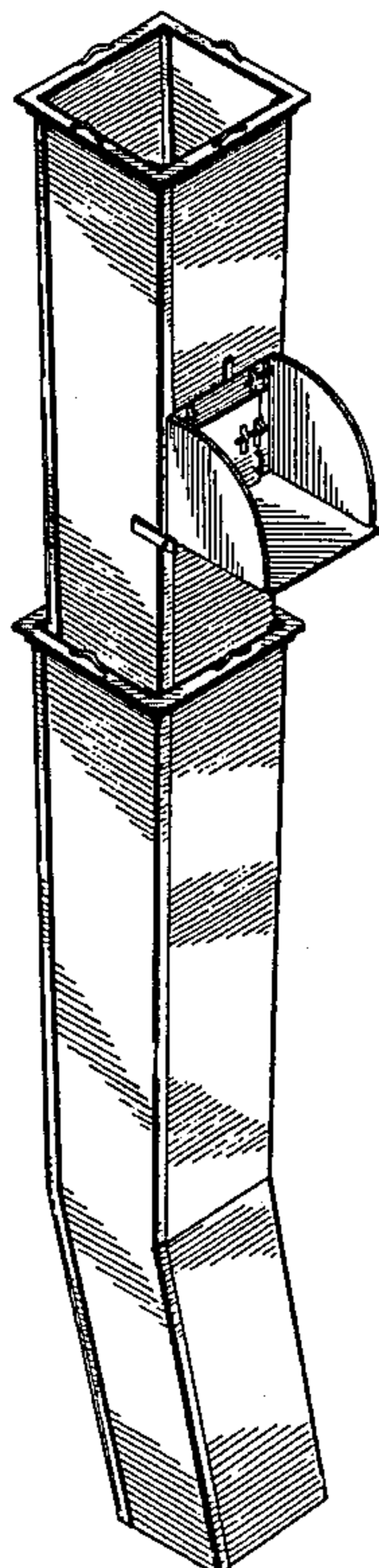
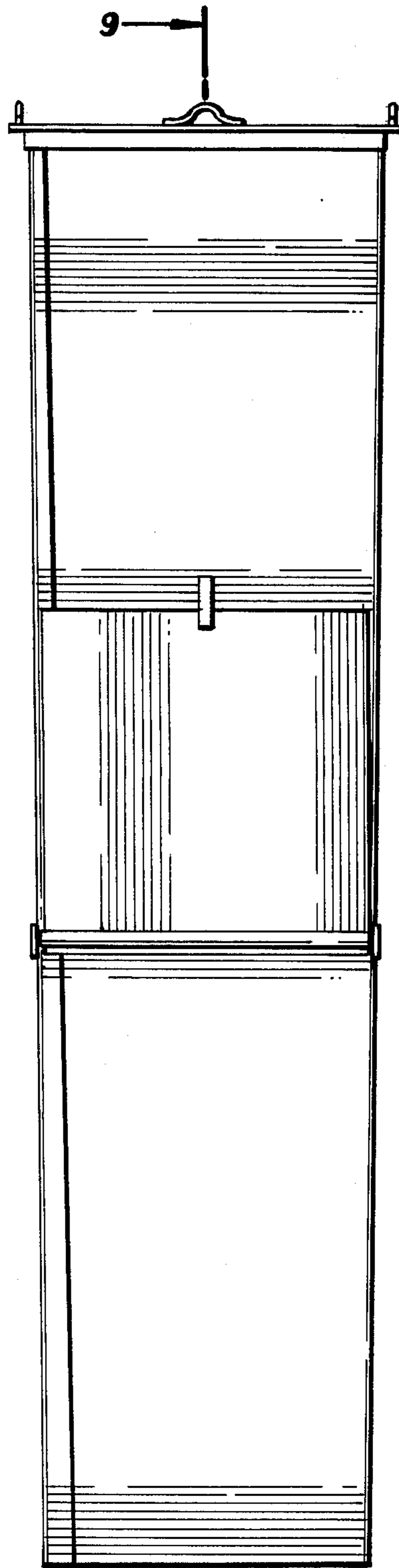
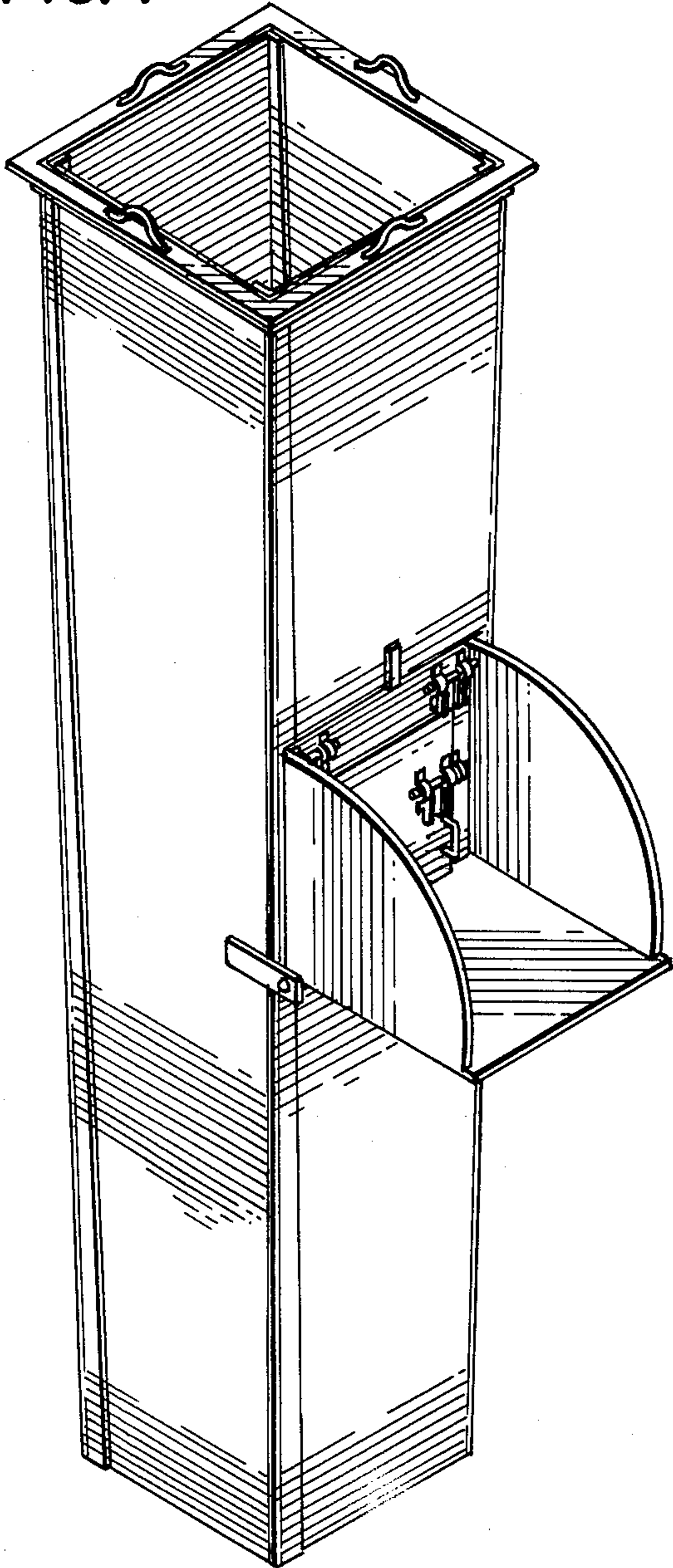

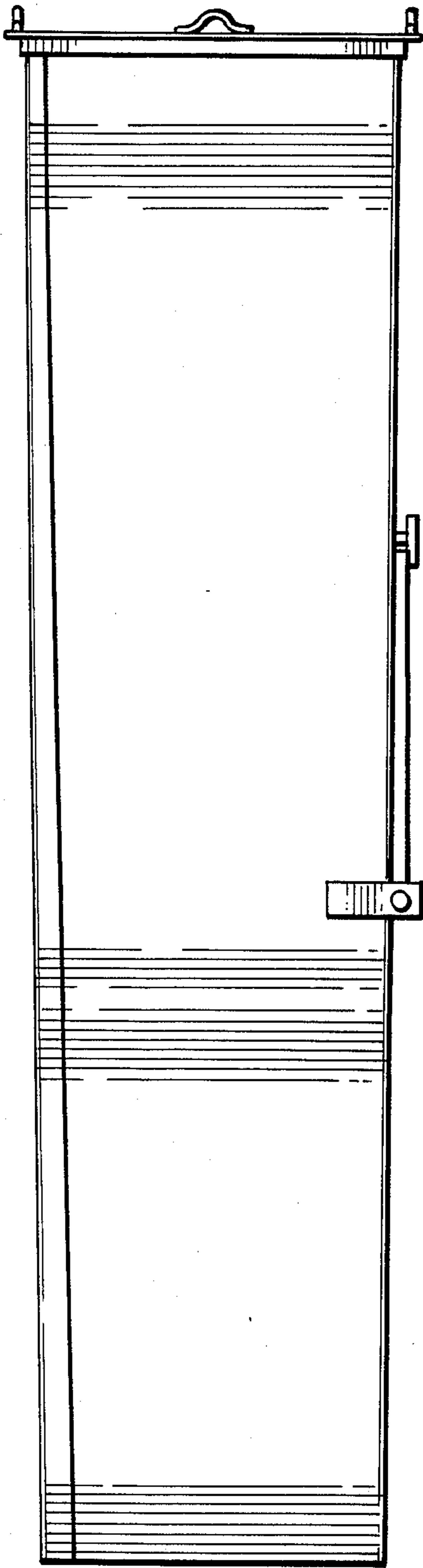

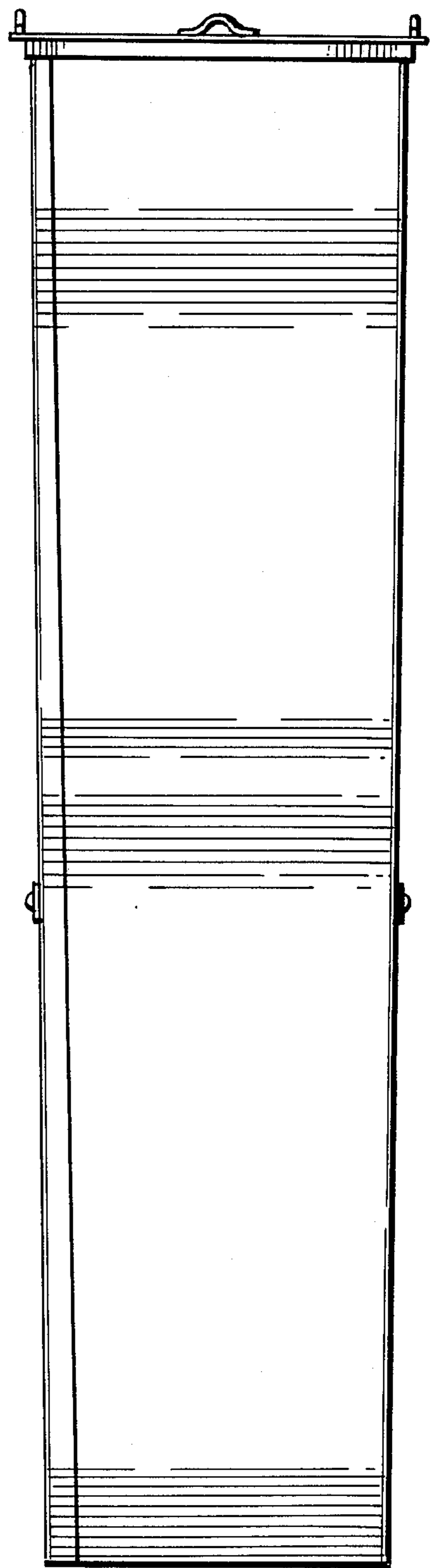

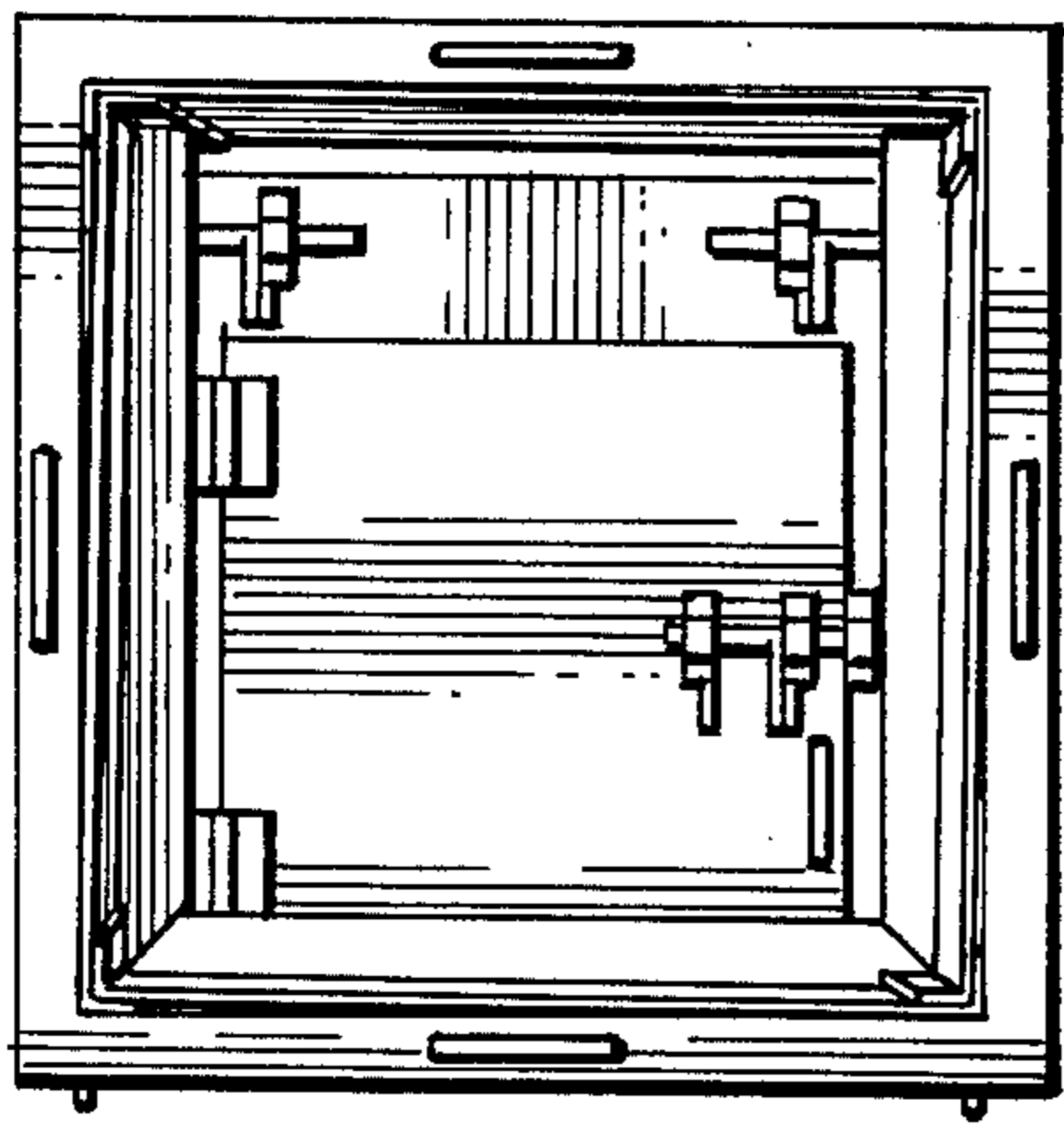

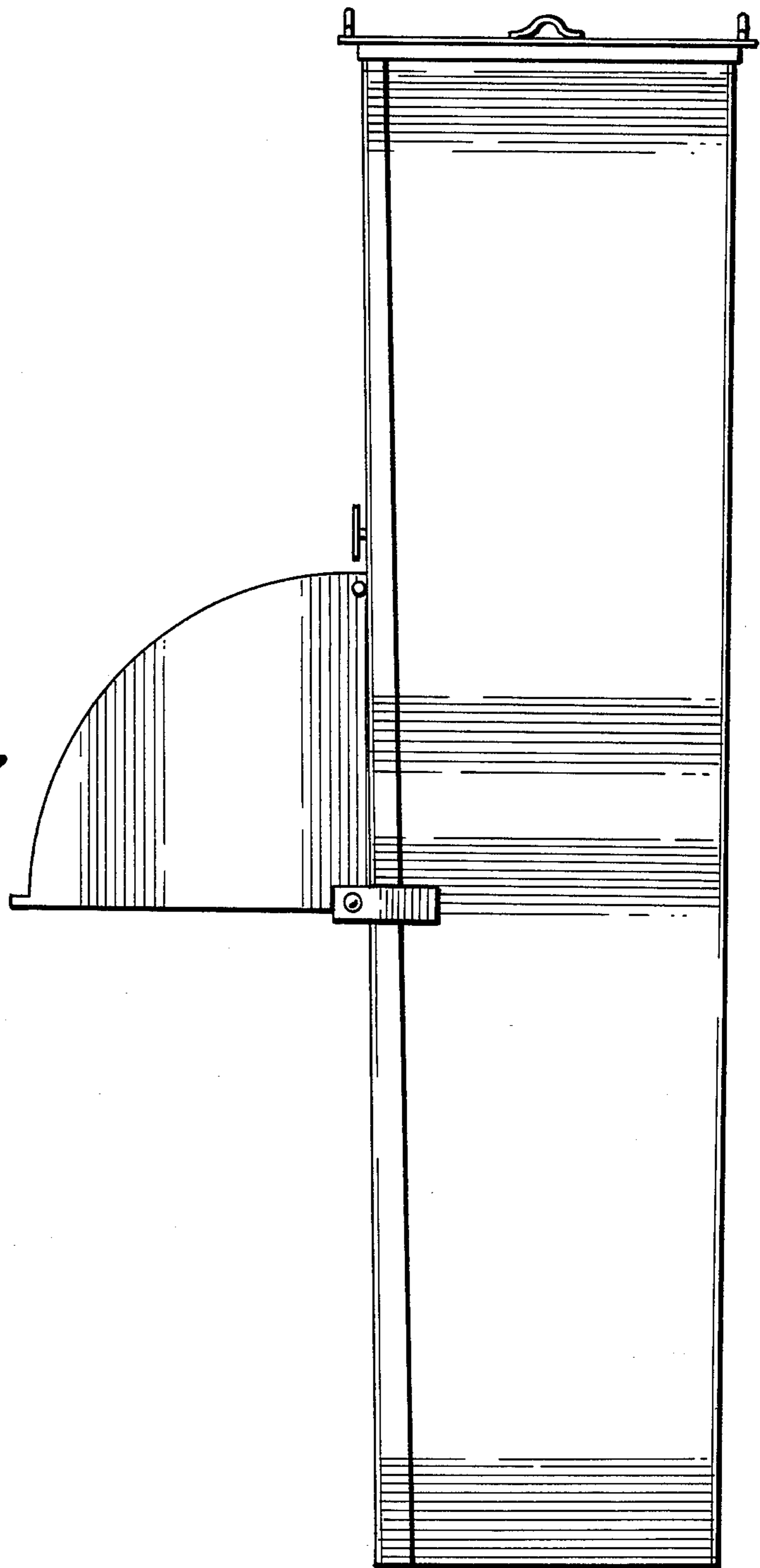
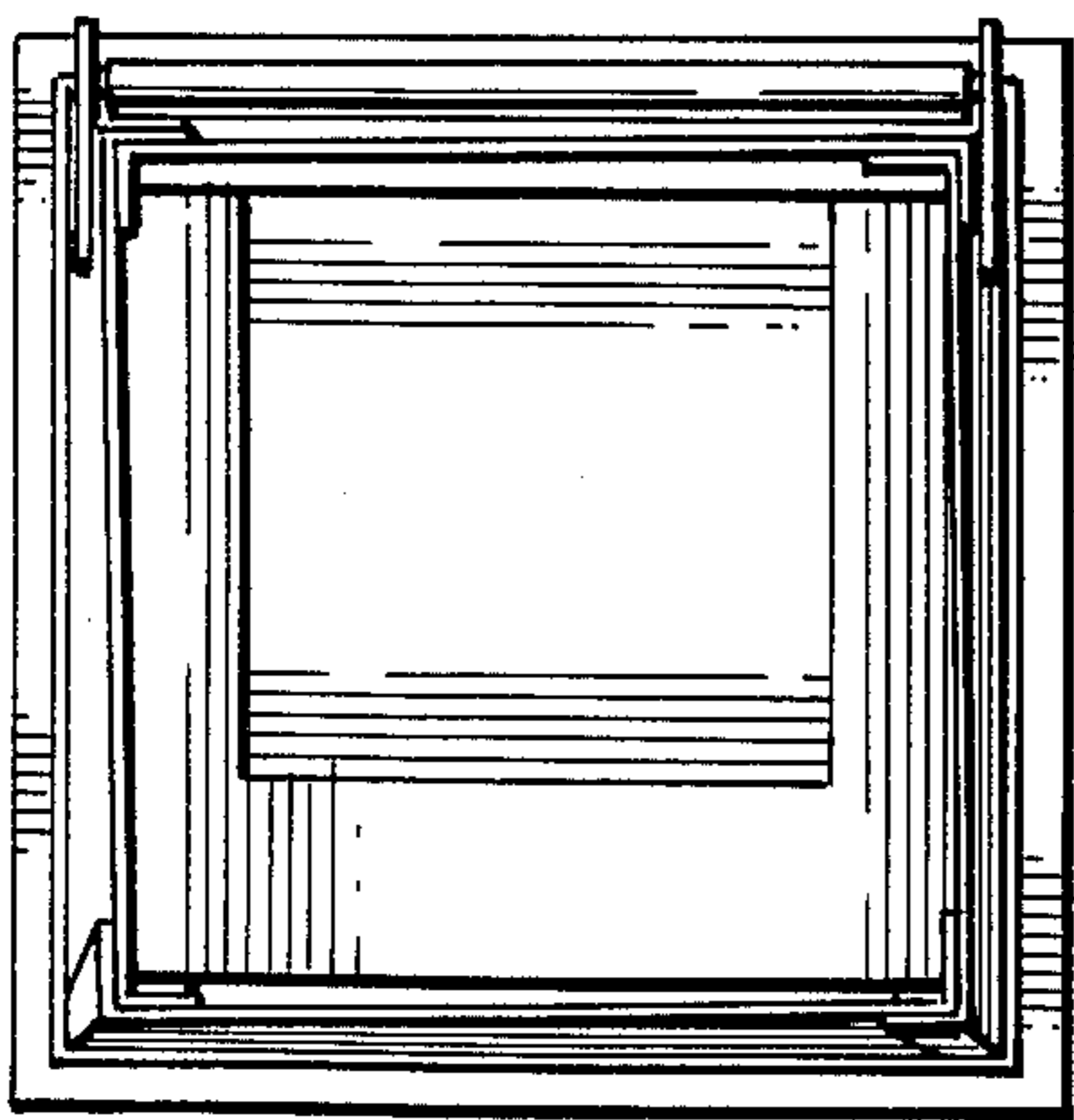

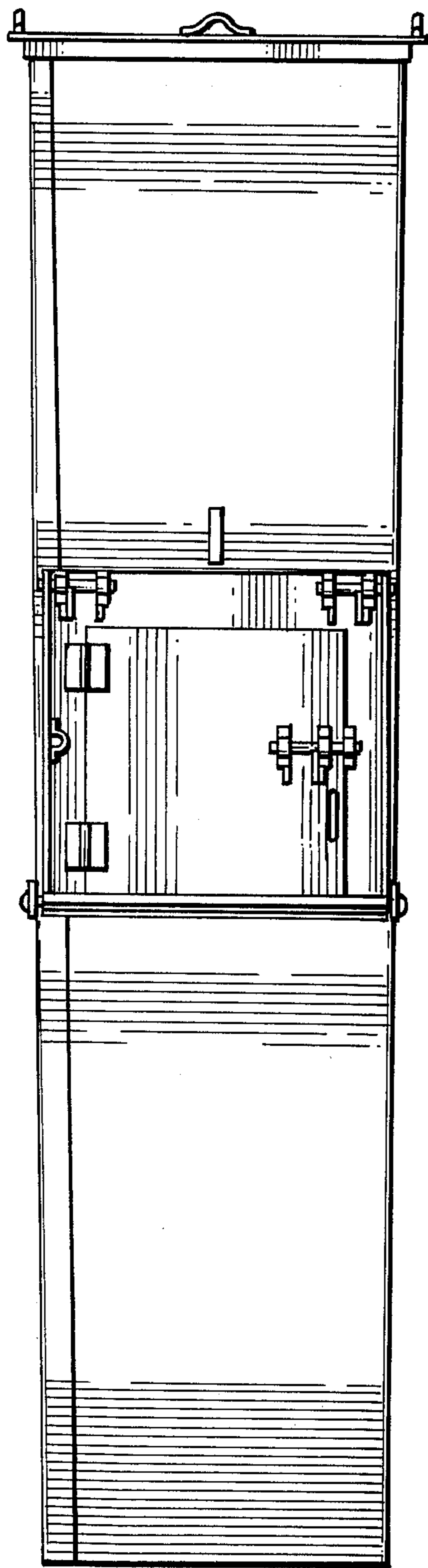

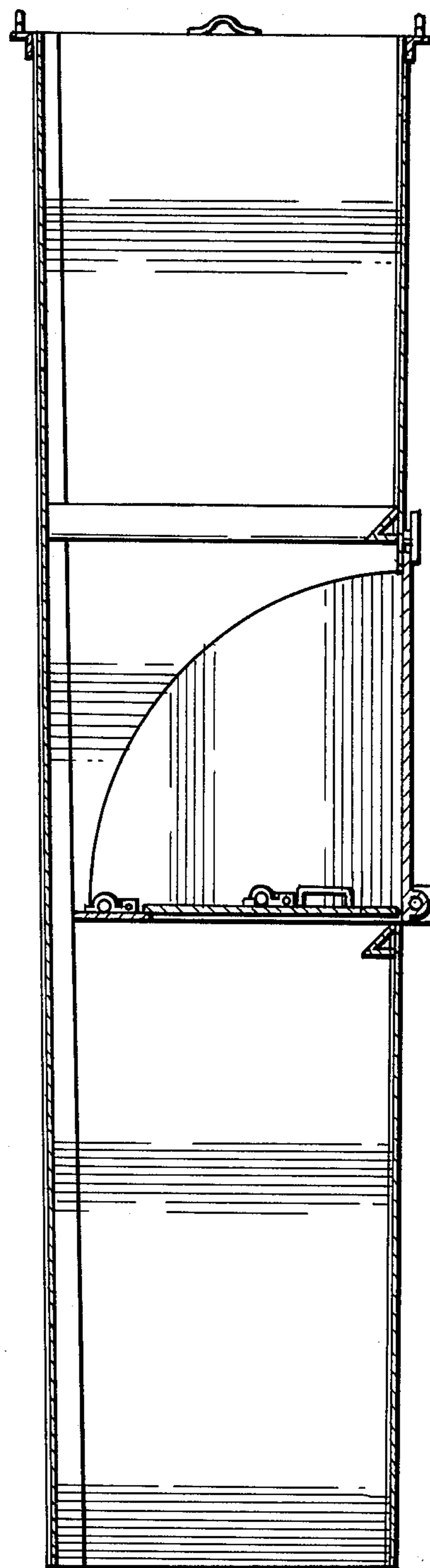
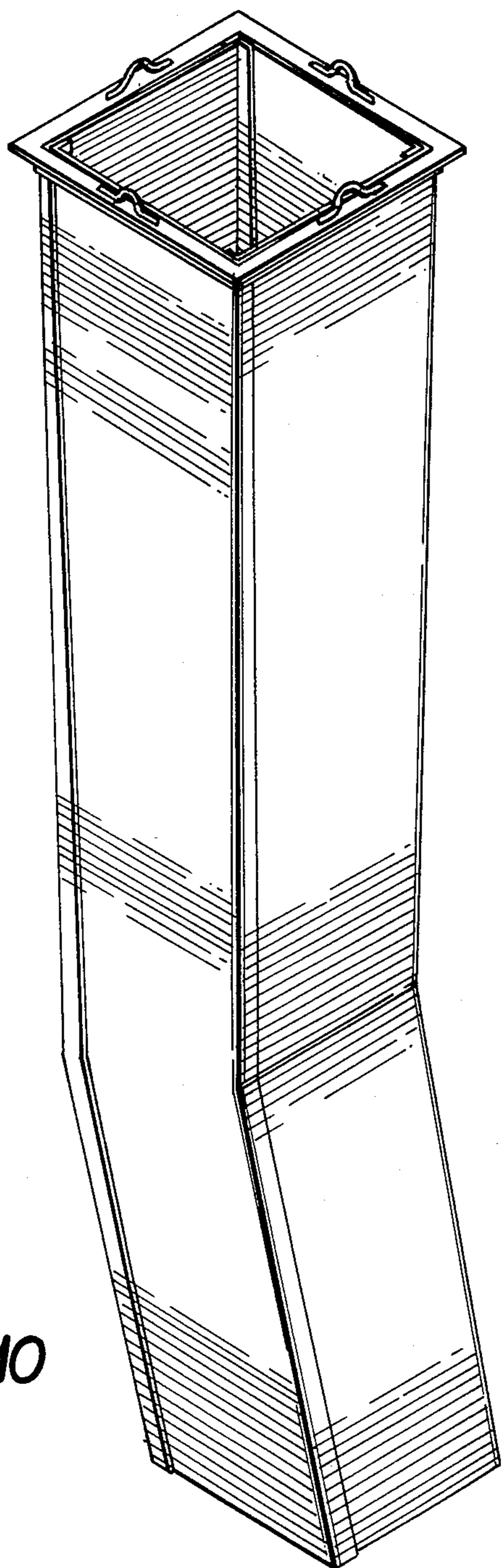
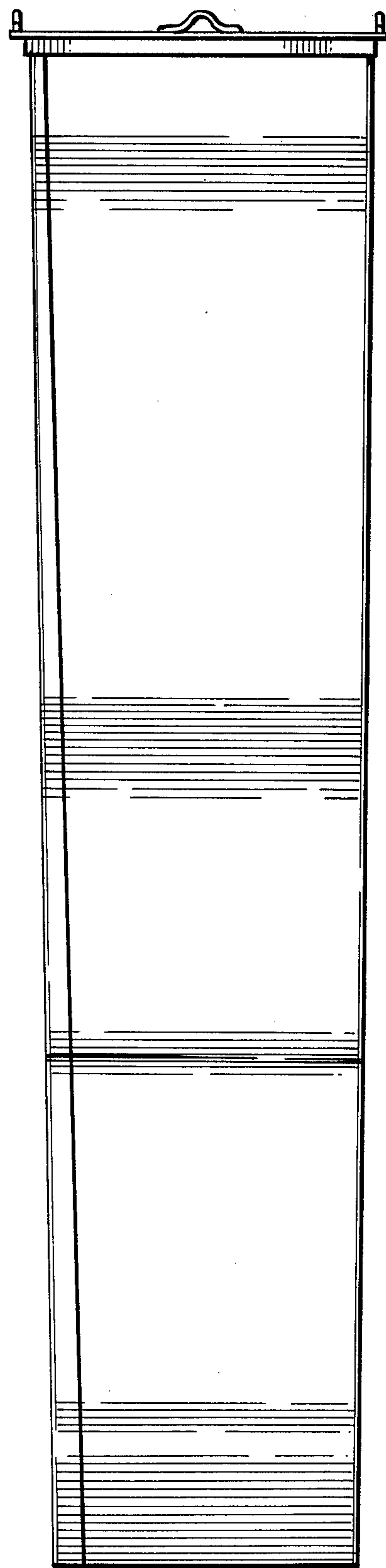

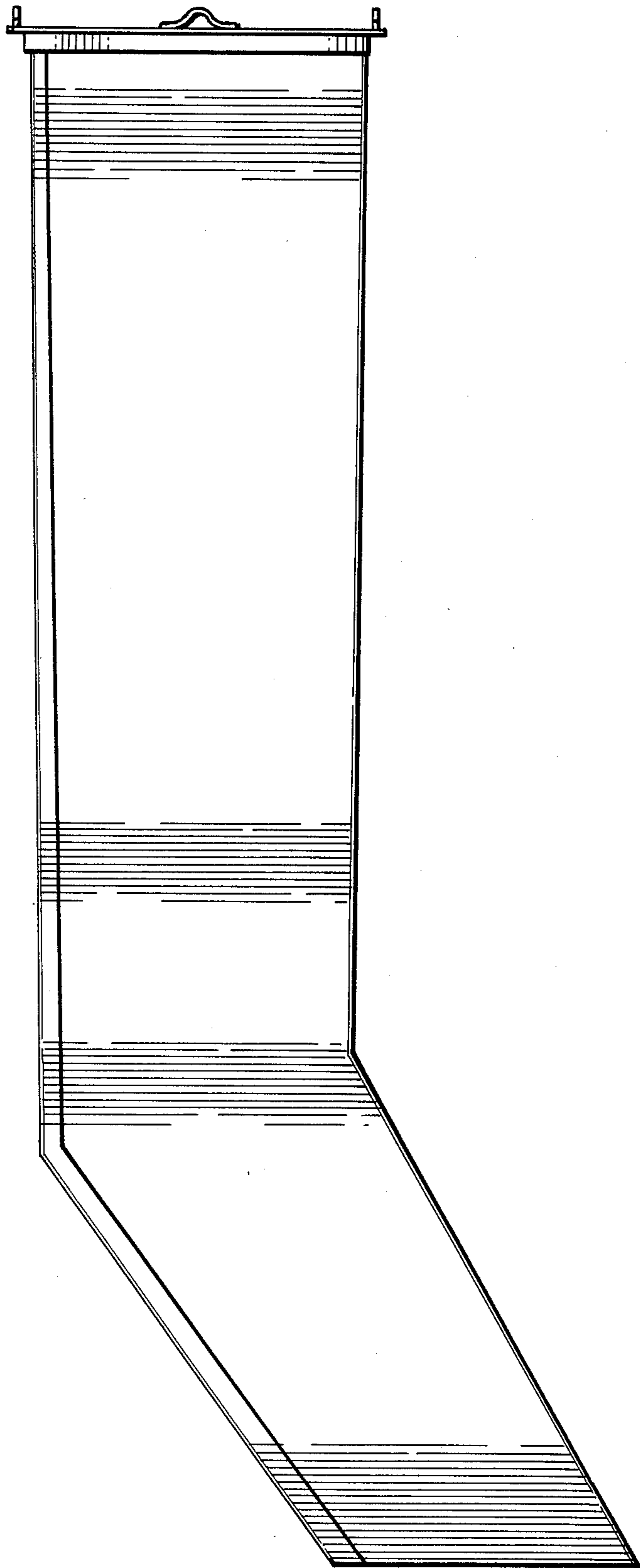

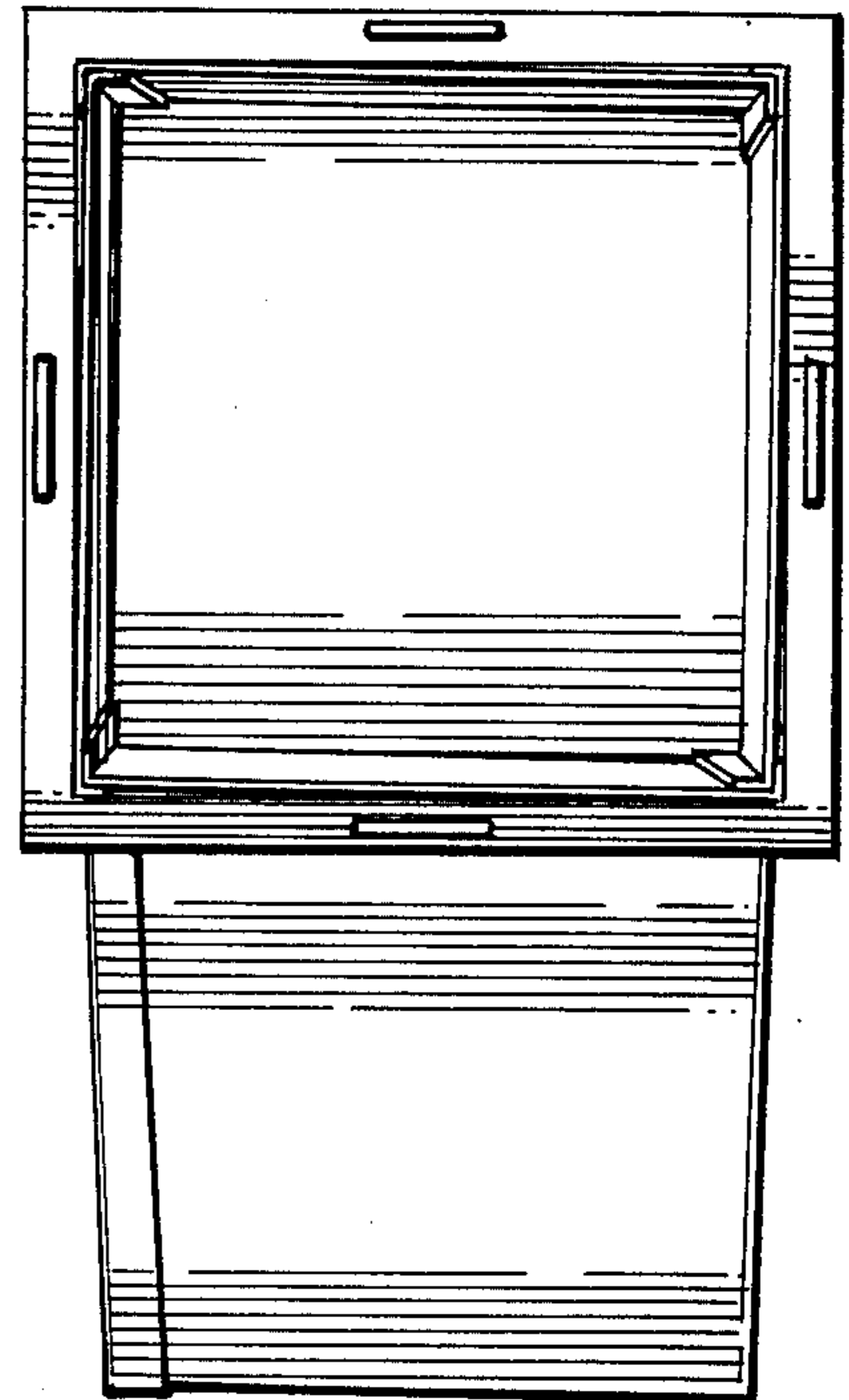

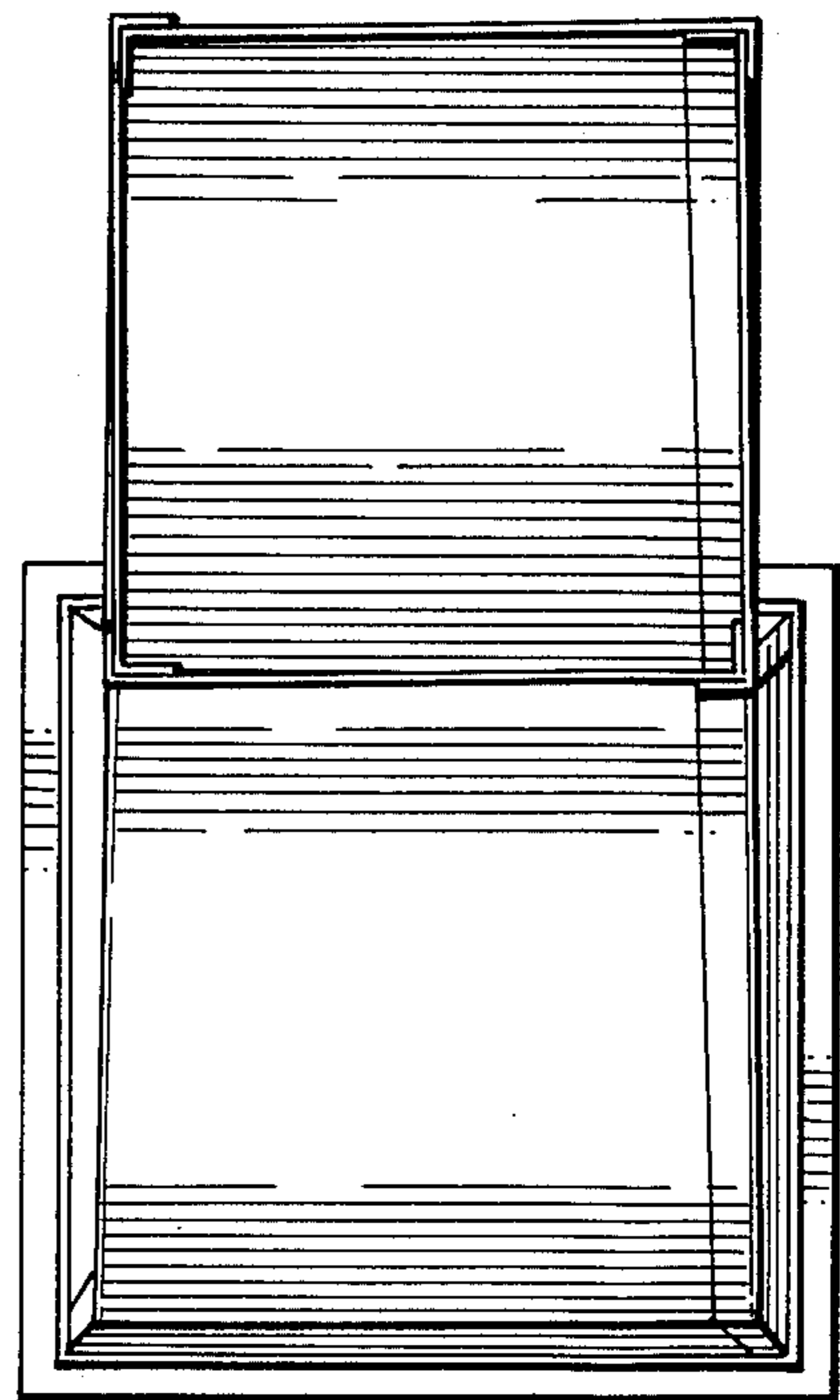

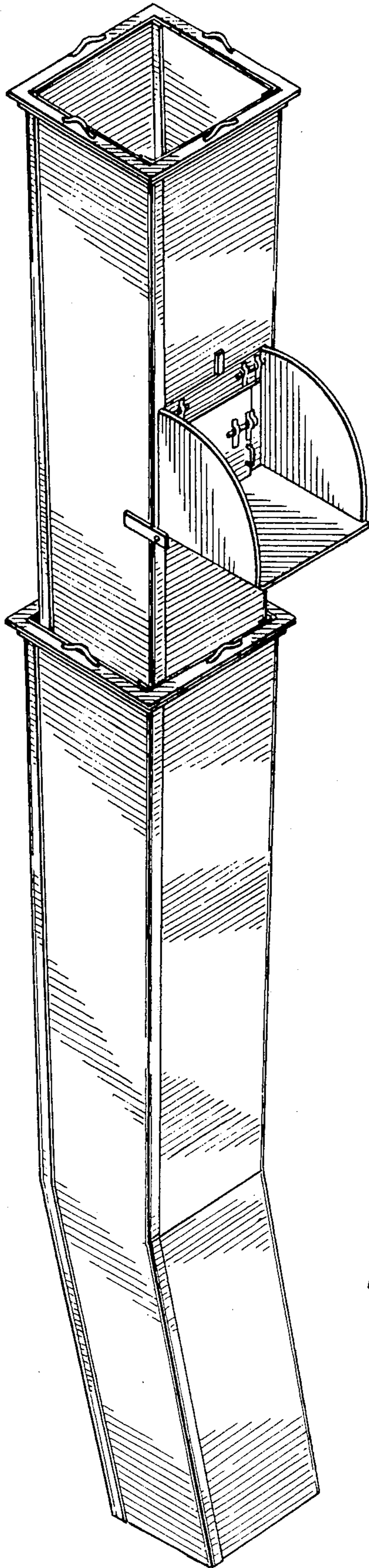
