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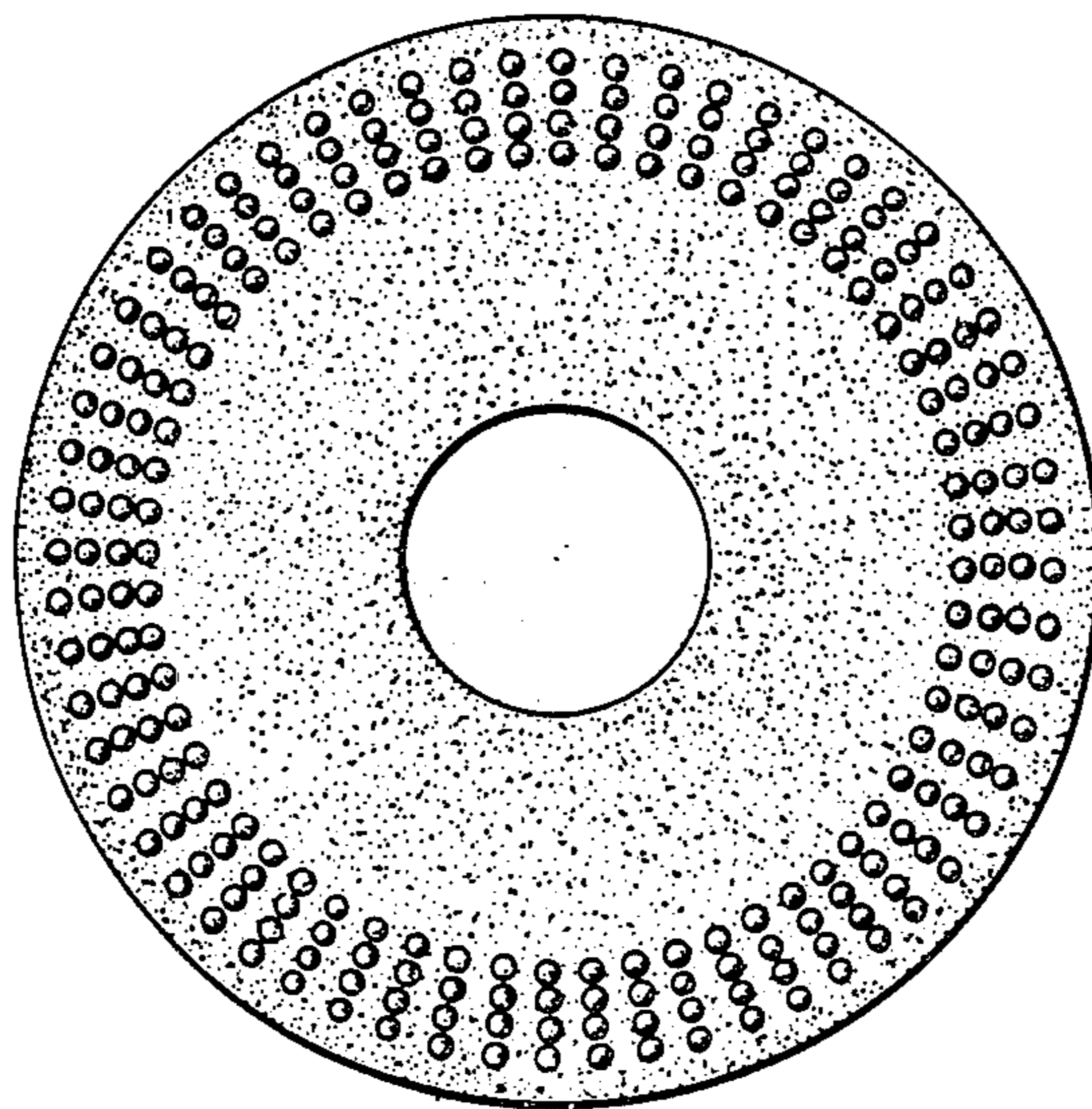
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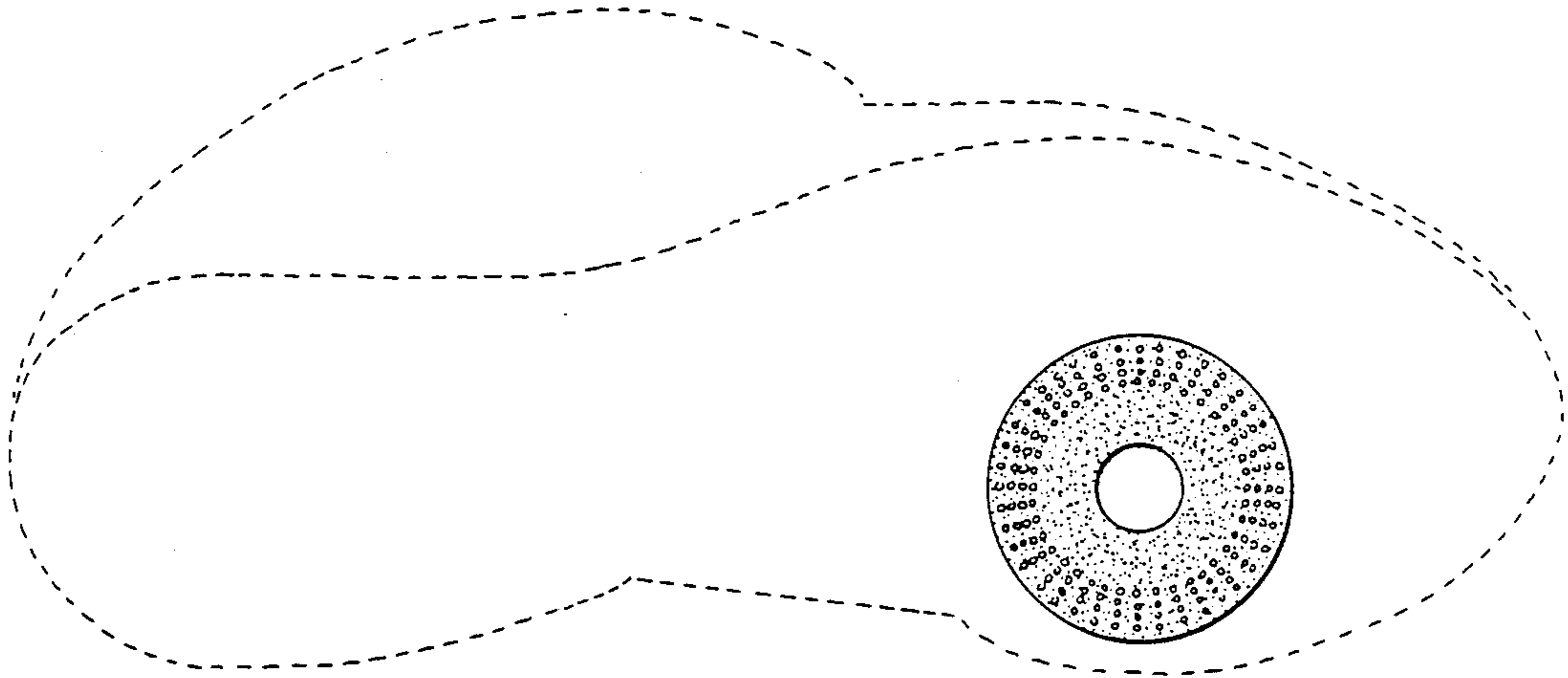

 The ornamental design for an element of a shoe sole, as shown and described.

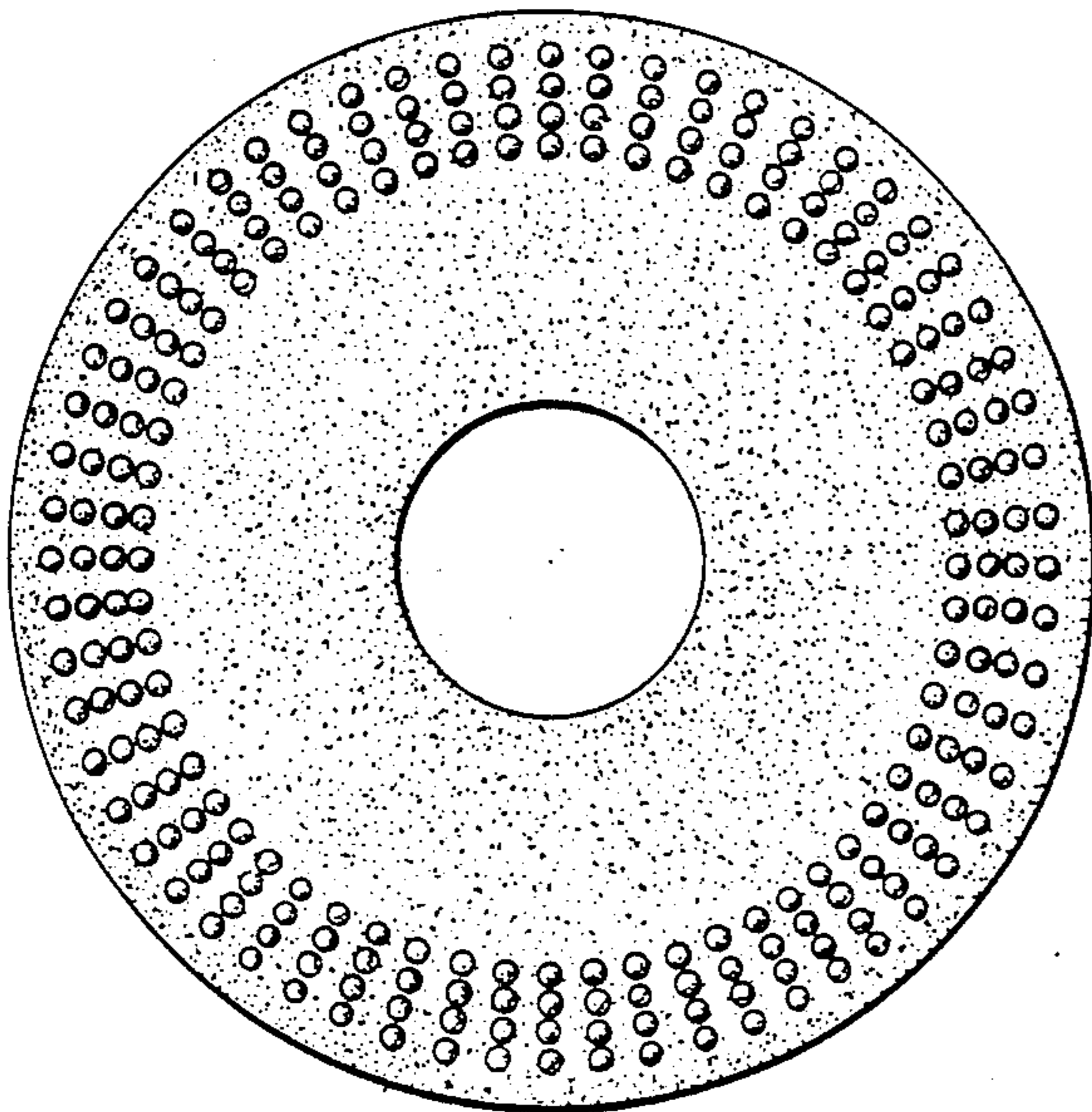
DESCRIPTION
