FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

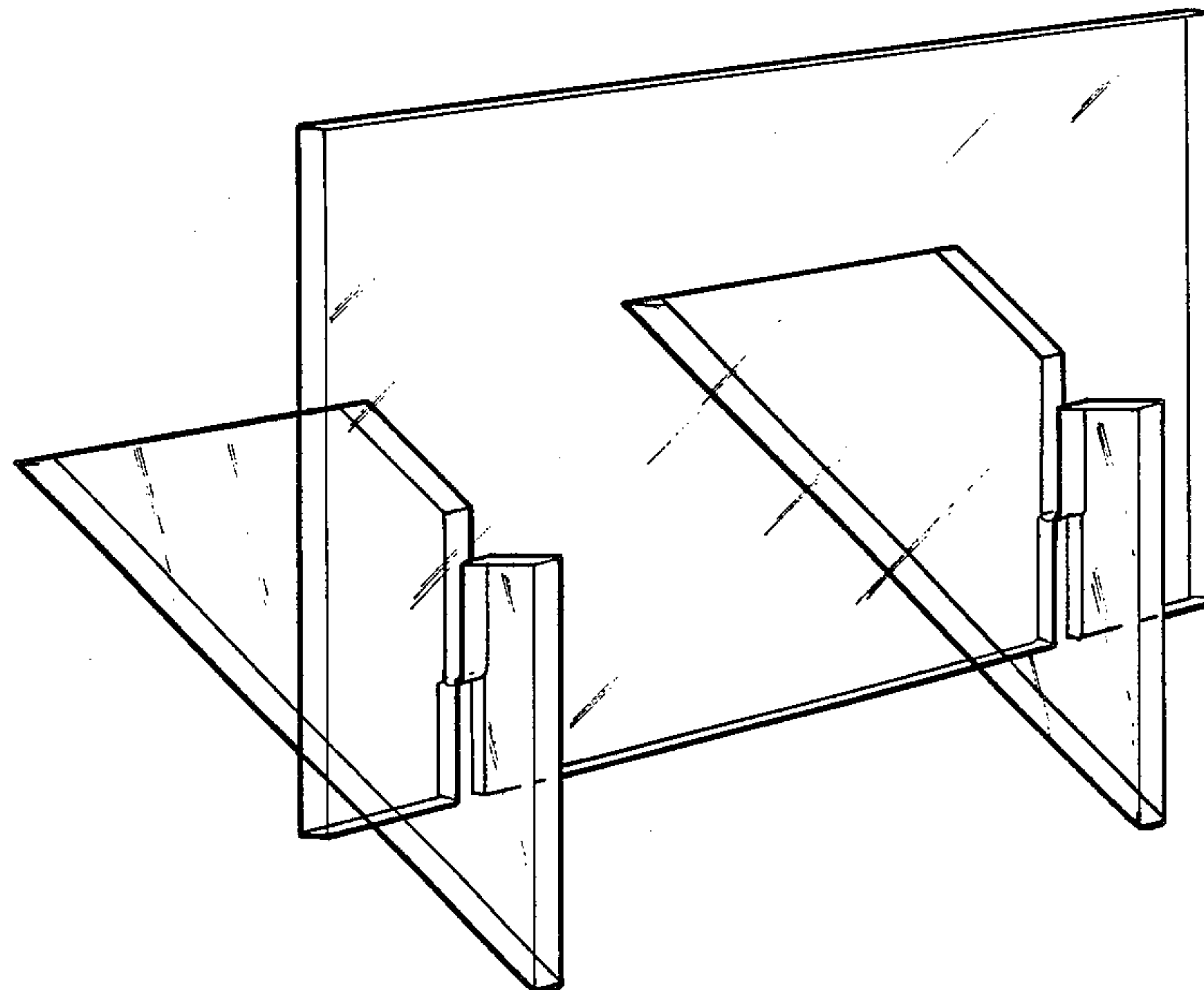
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along 7—7 of FIG. 3.



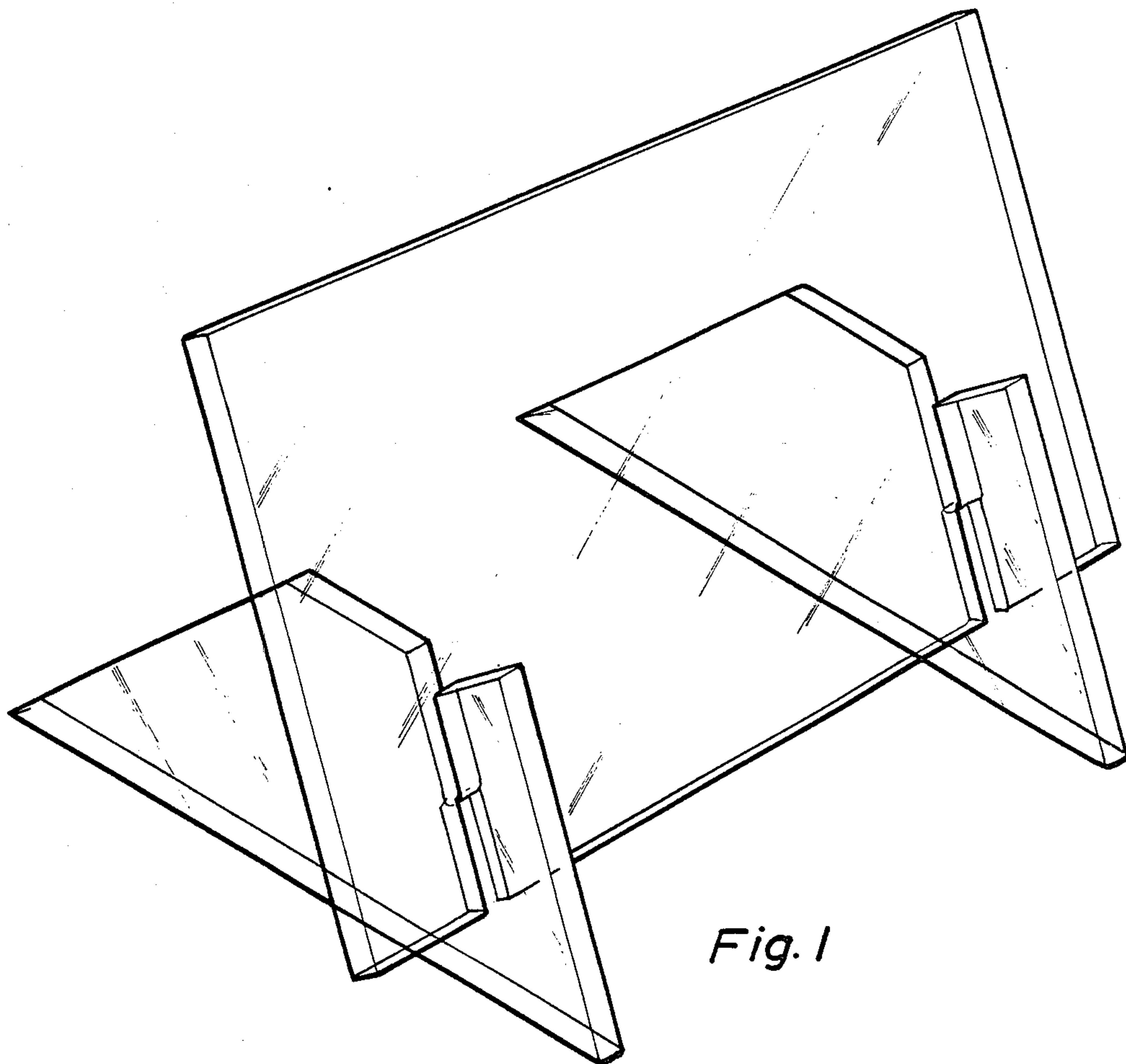

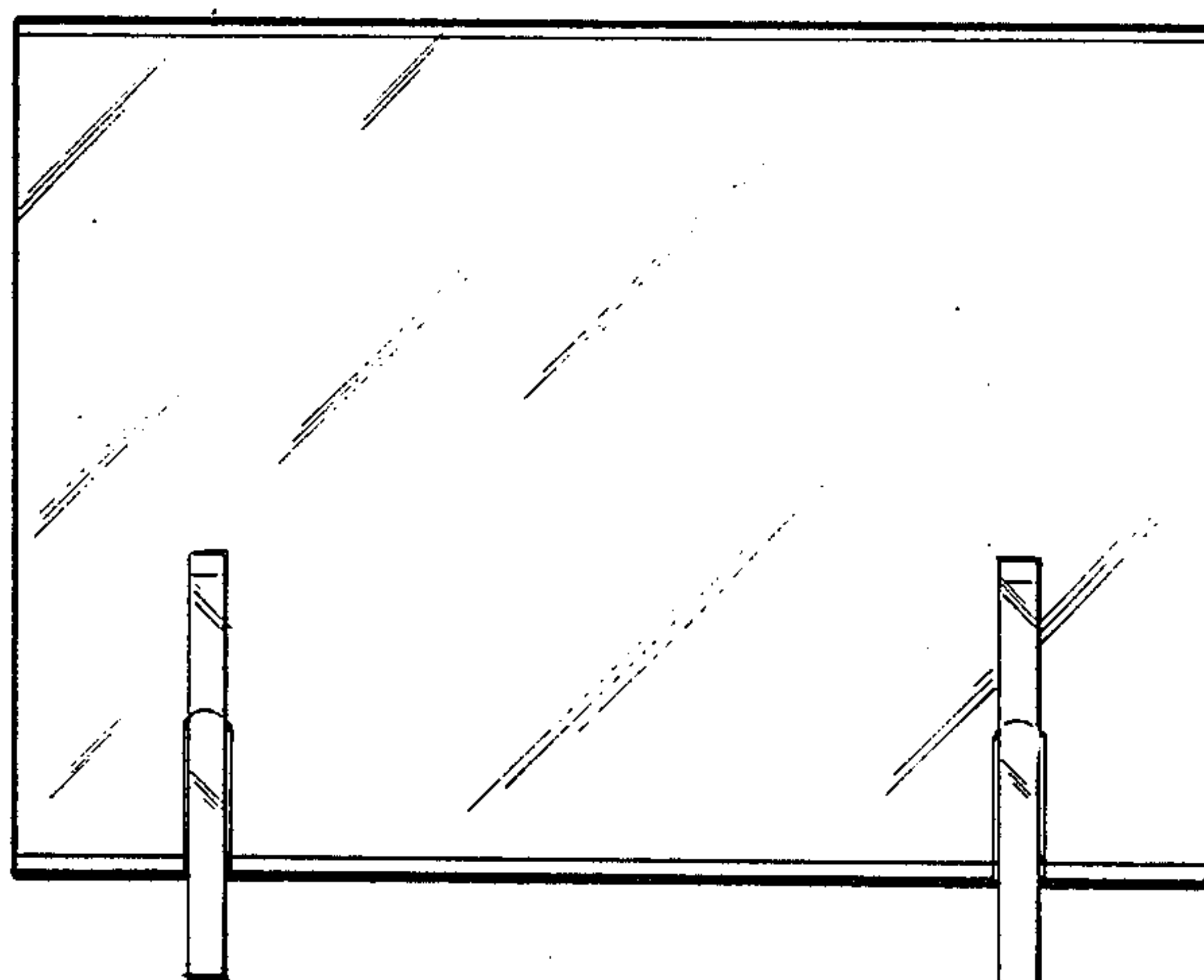

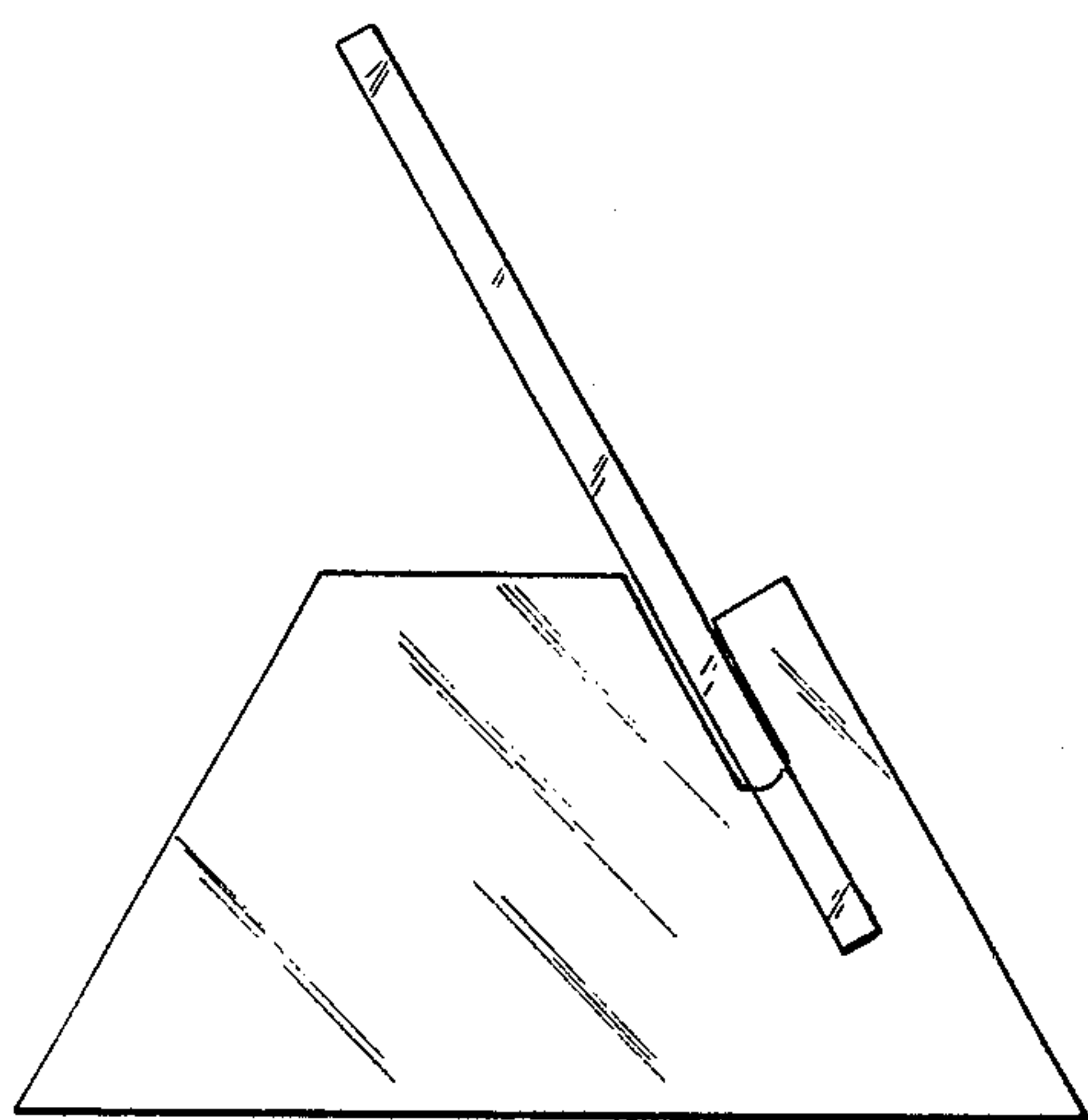

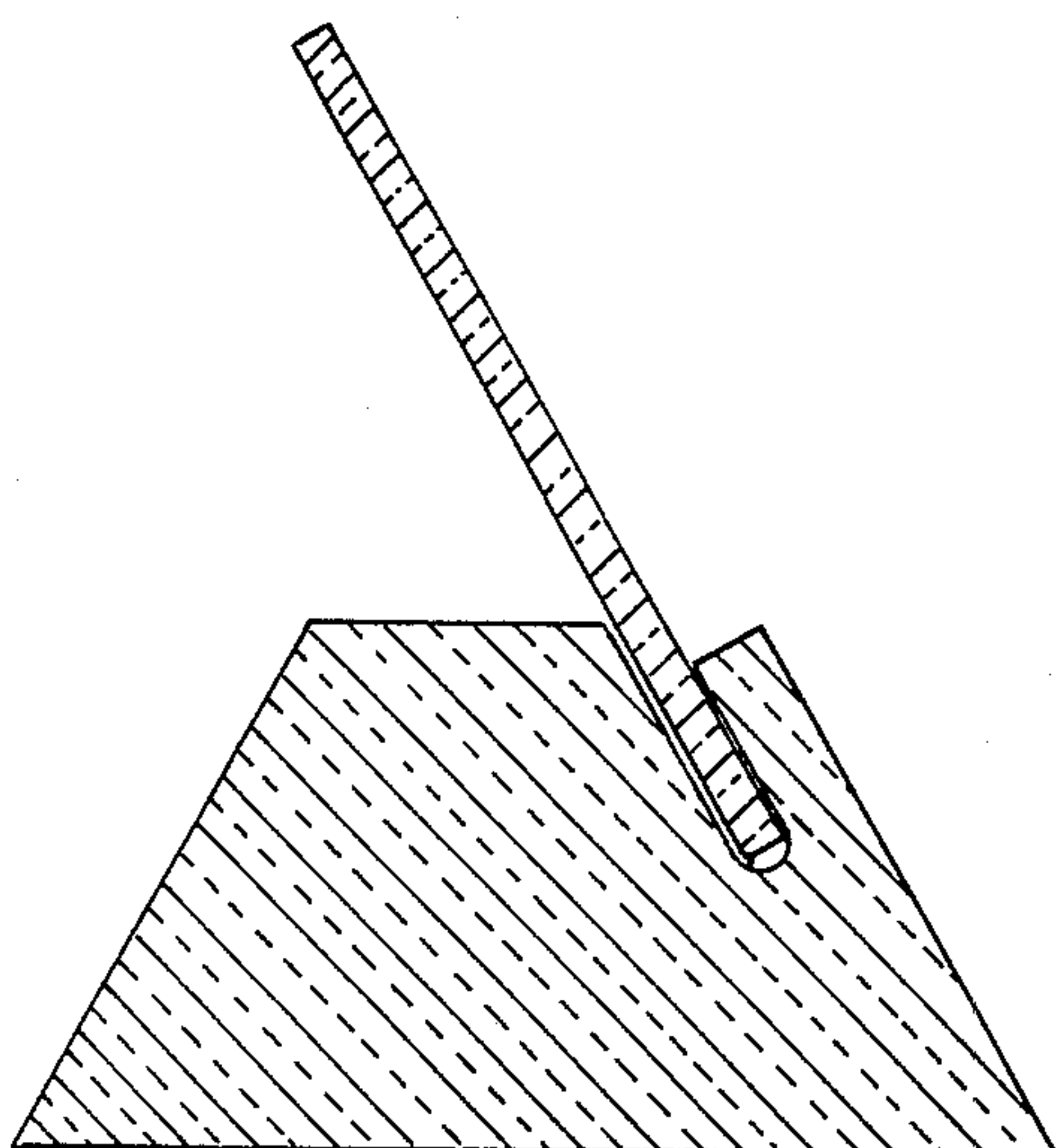

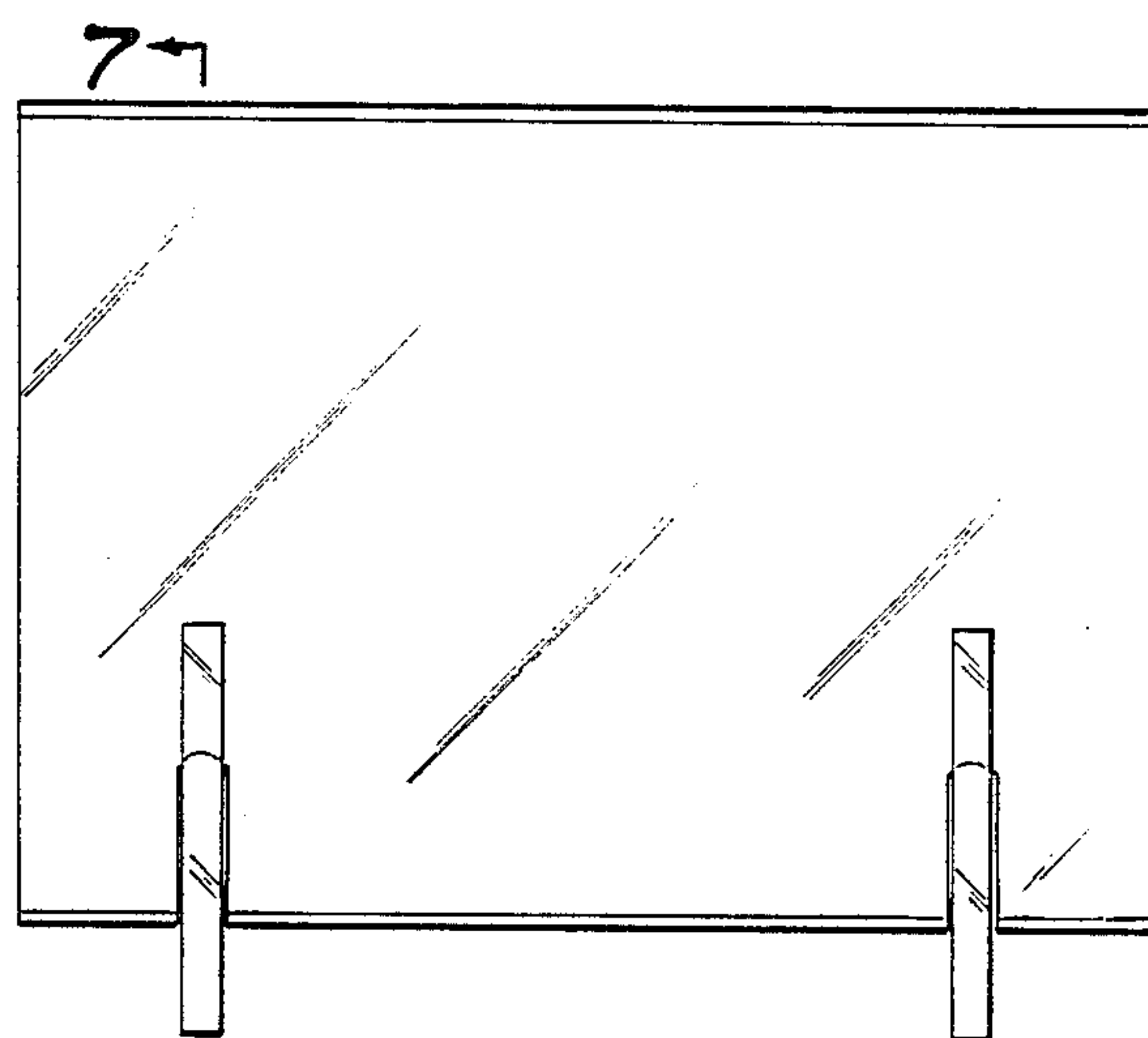

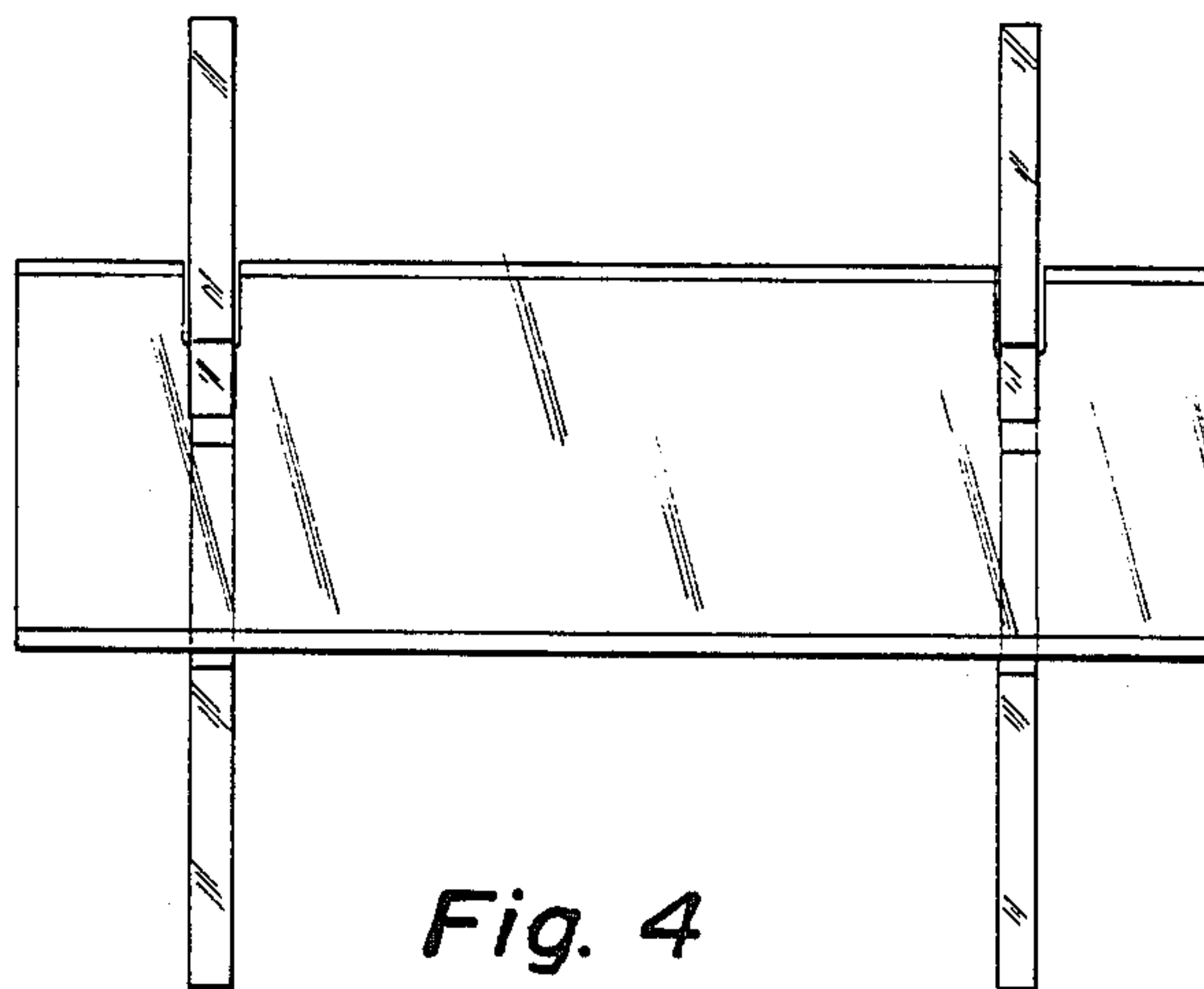

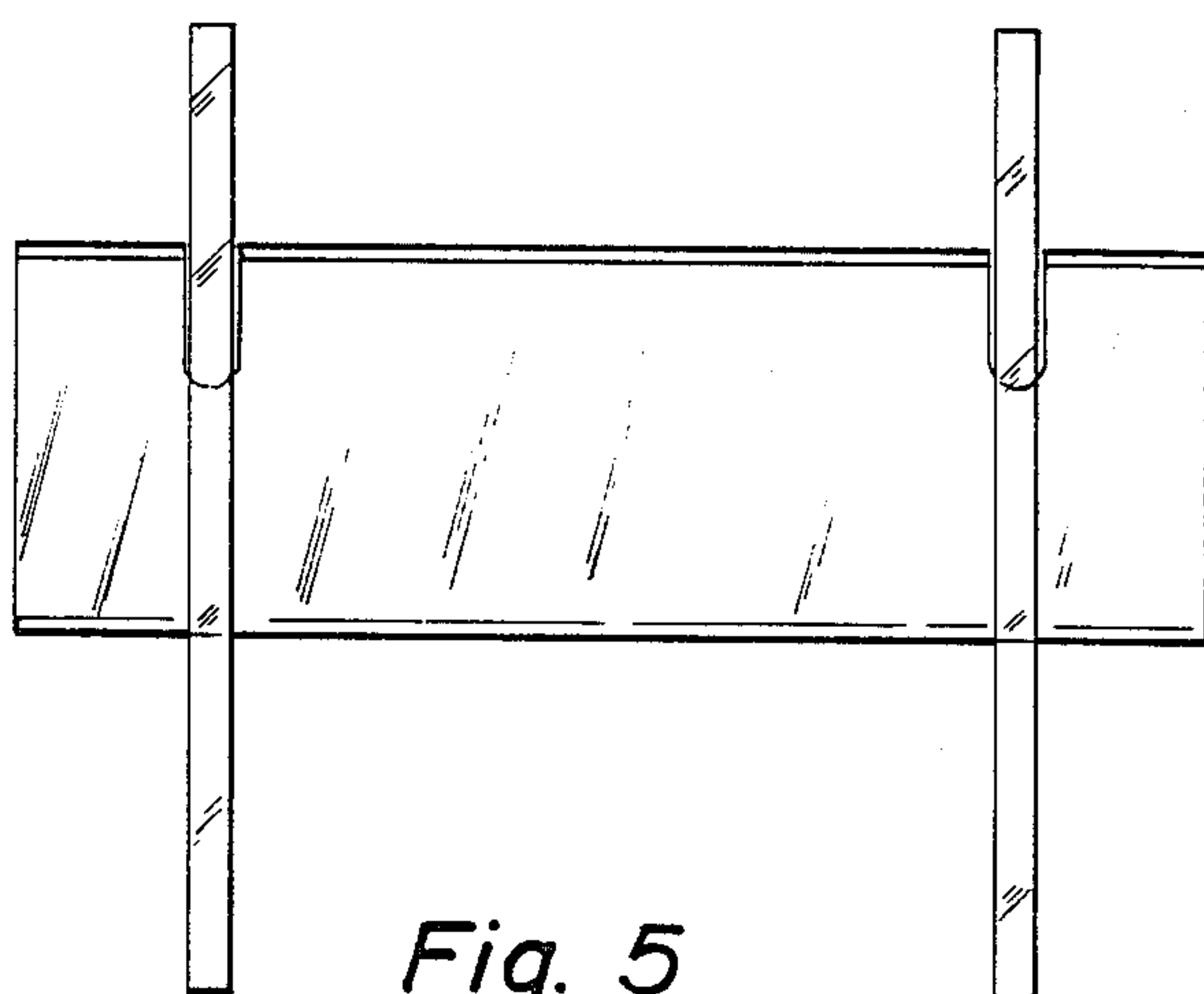
