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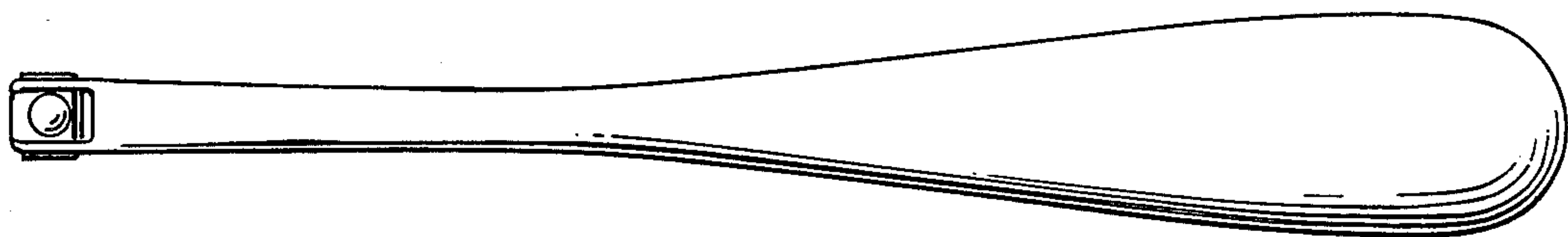

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a planer for planing cartilage showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the planer of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the right side of the planer of FIG. 1, the other side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front view of the planer of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the planer of FIG. 1.



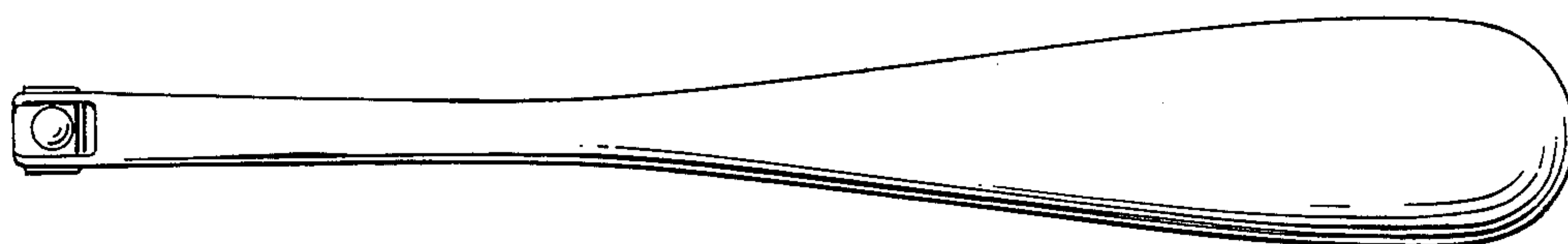

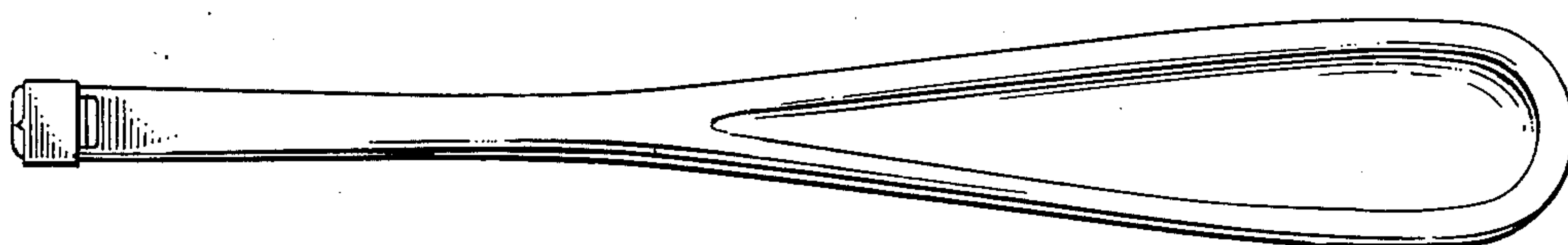

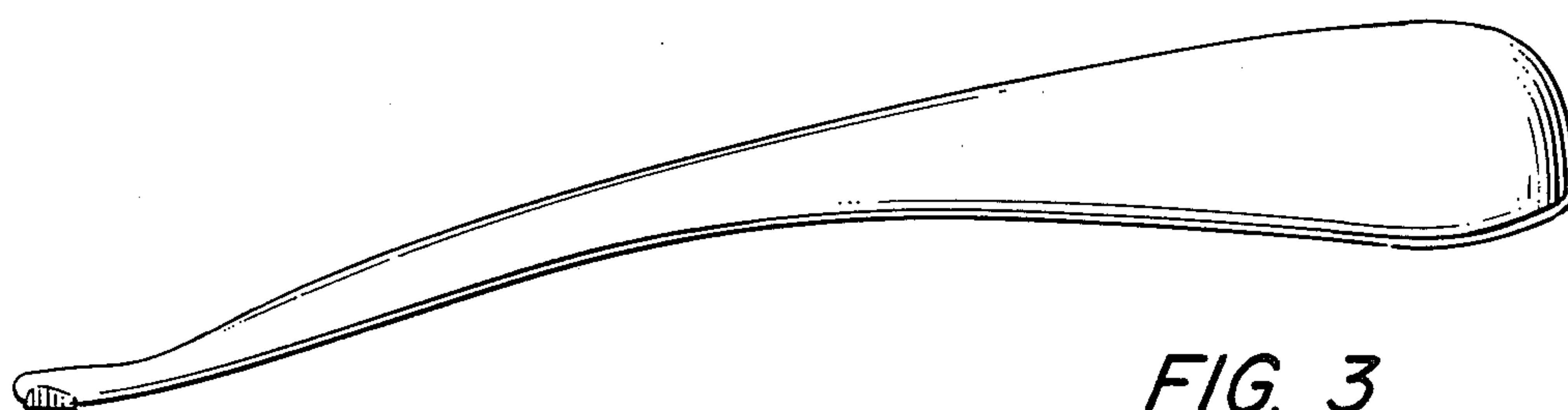

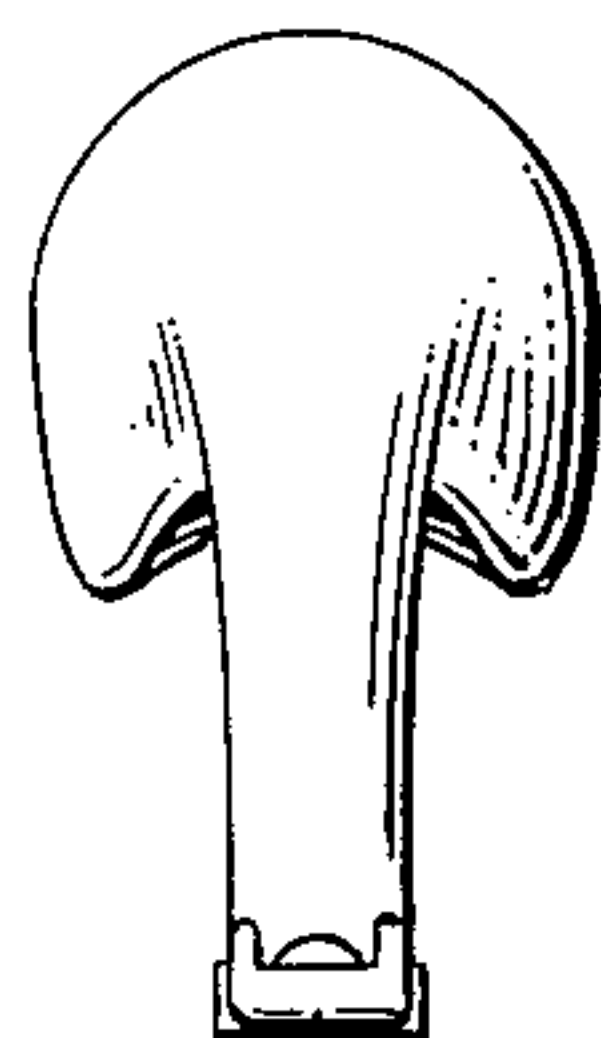

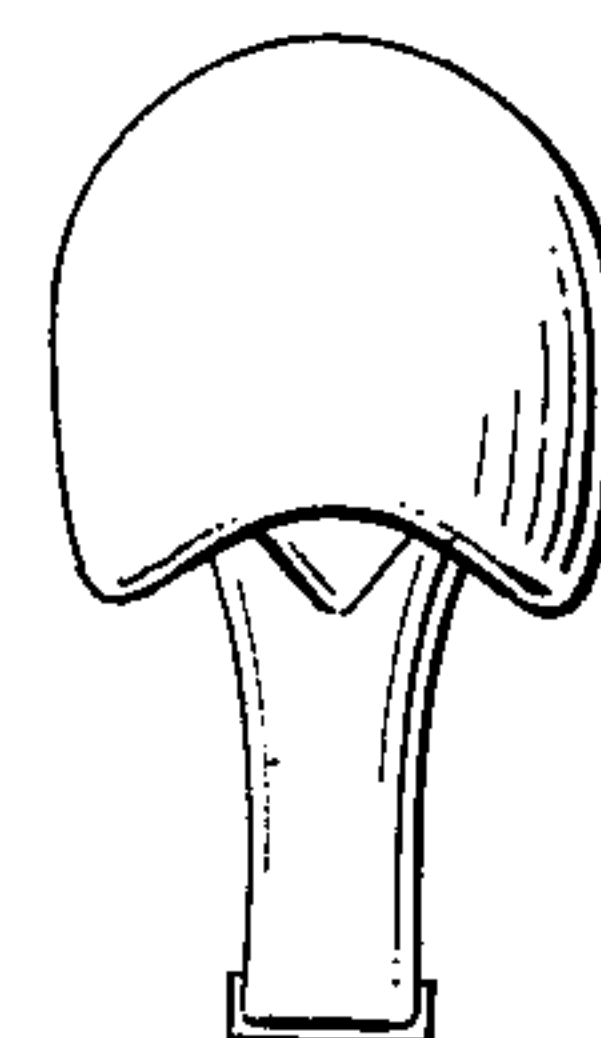
