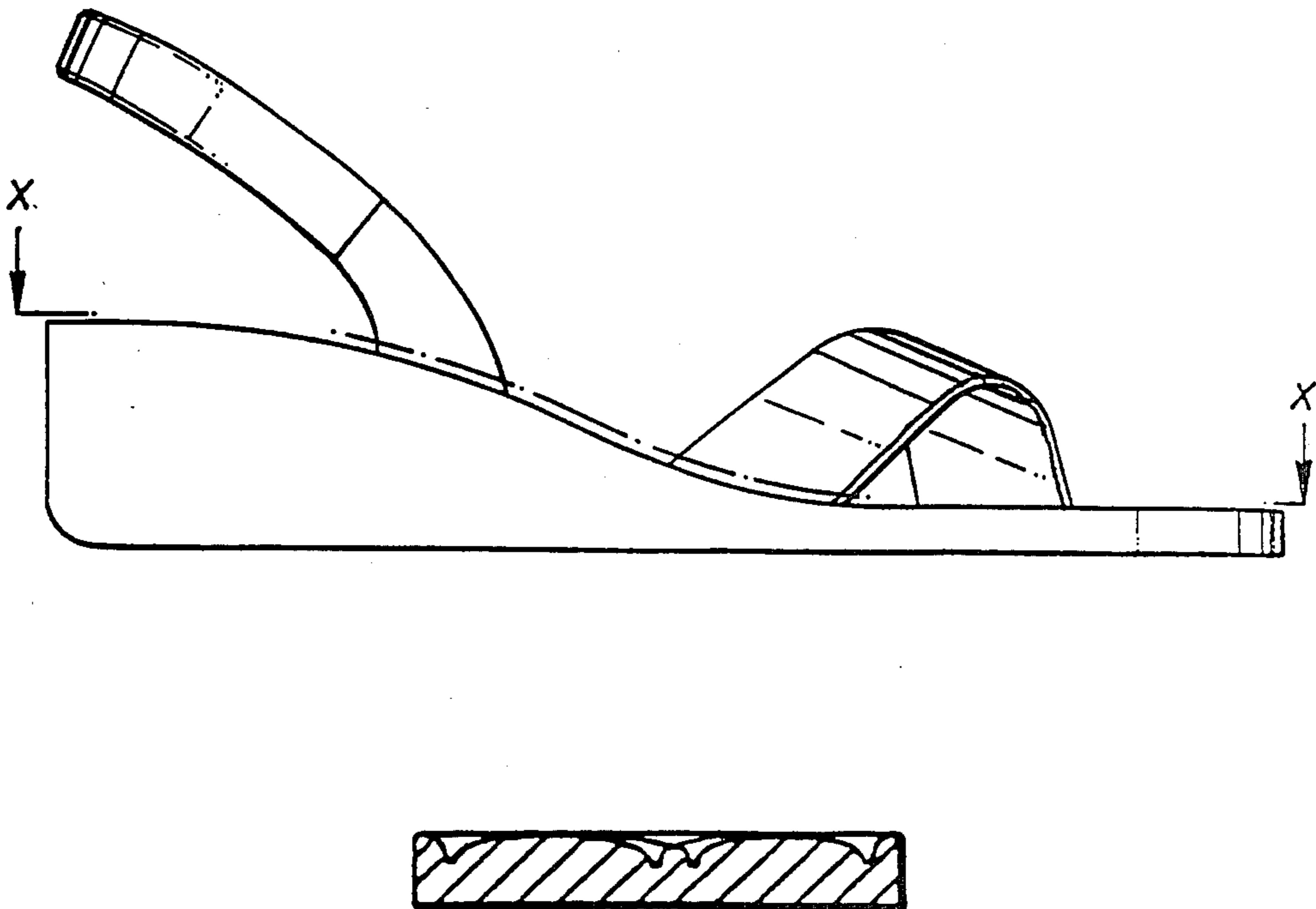

The ornamental design for a sandal, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a sandal showing my new design,
 FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken on line XX of FIG. 1,
 FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line YY of FIG. 2,

 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



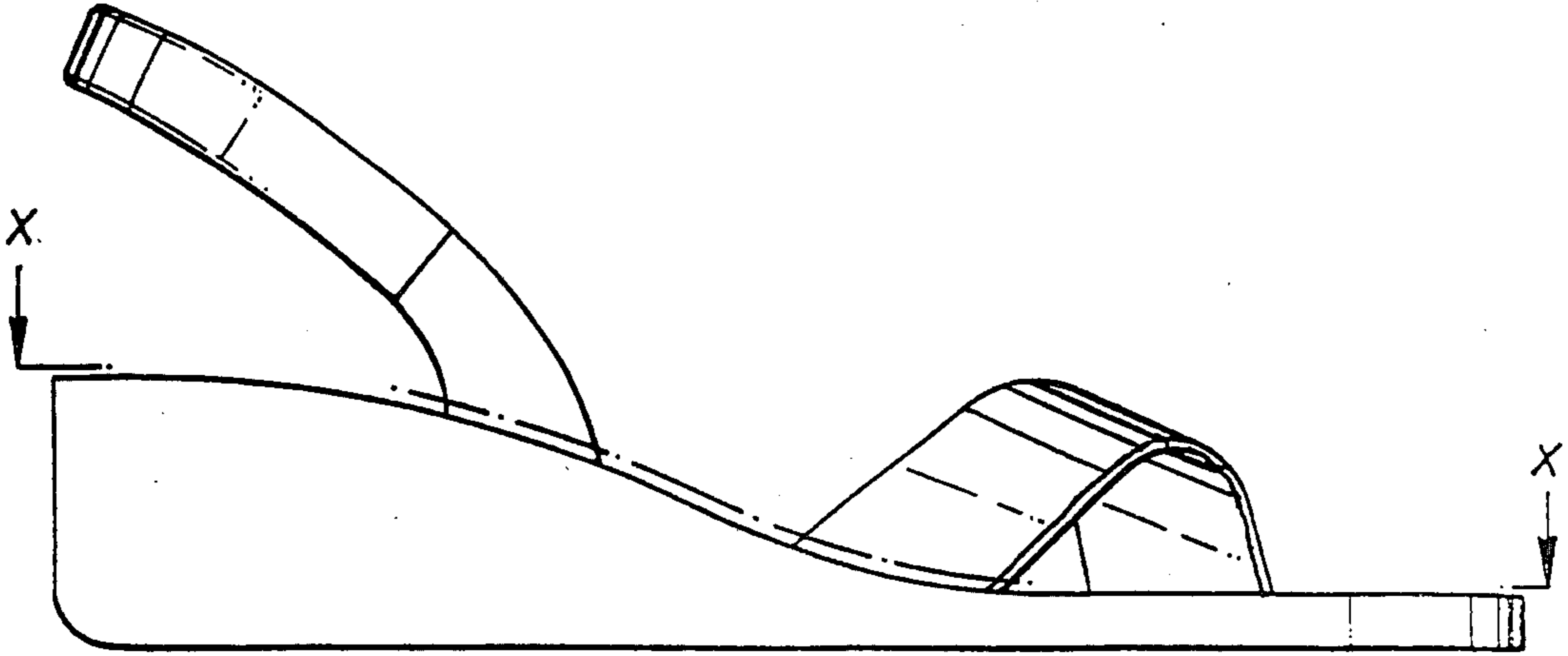

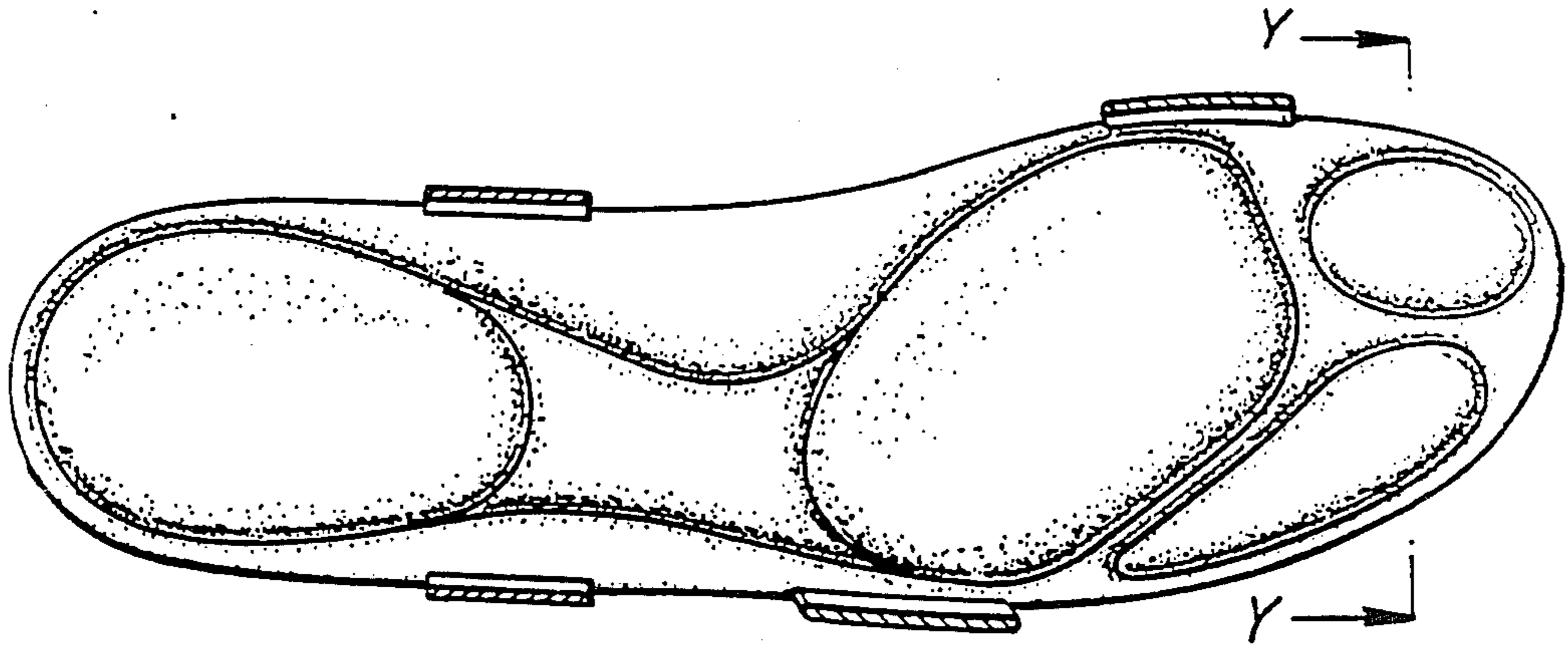

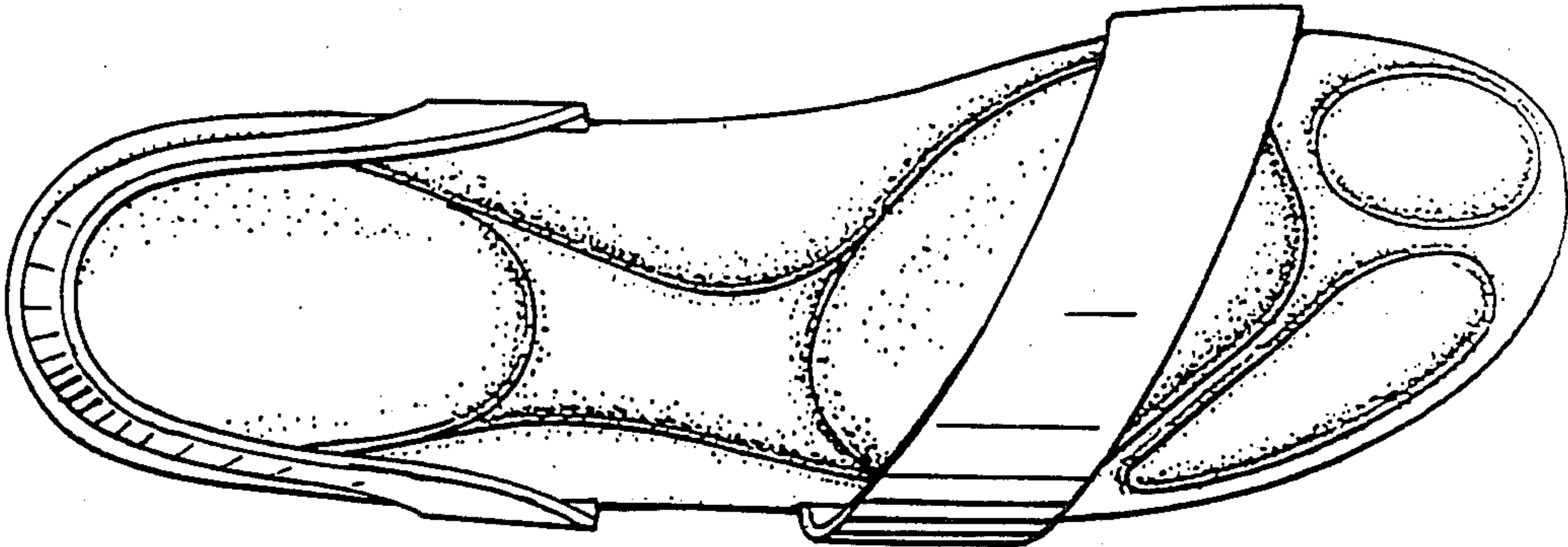

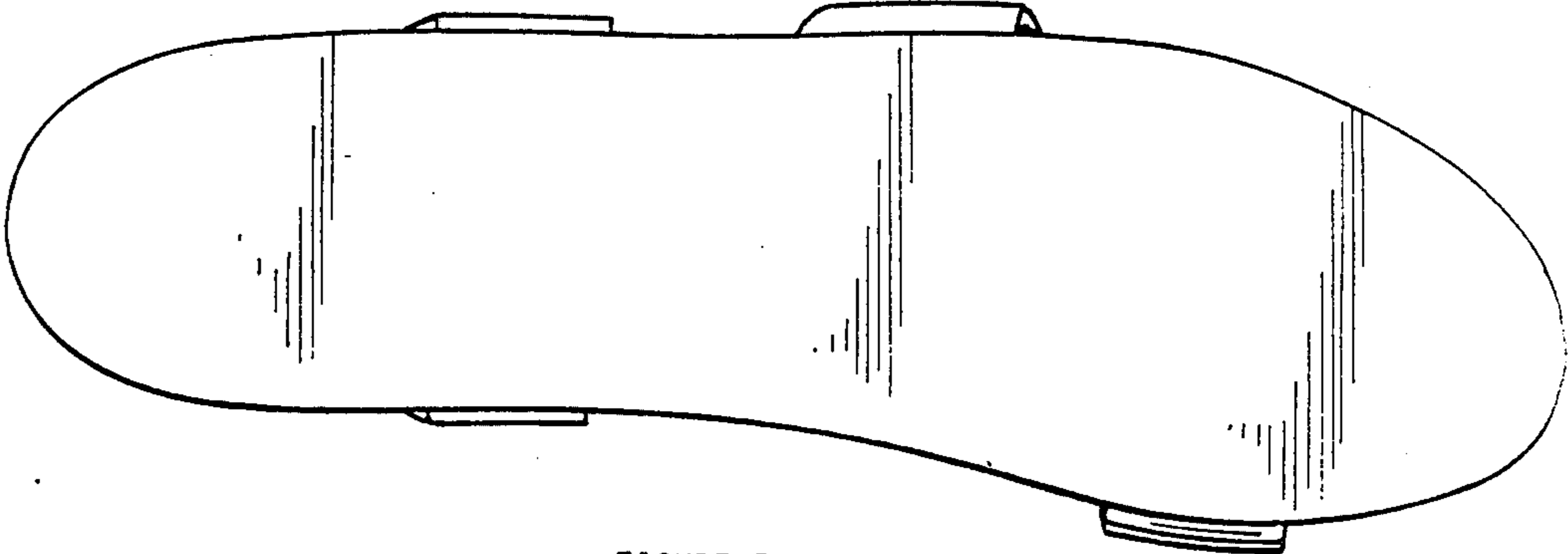
