FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof.

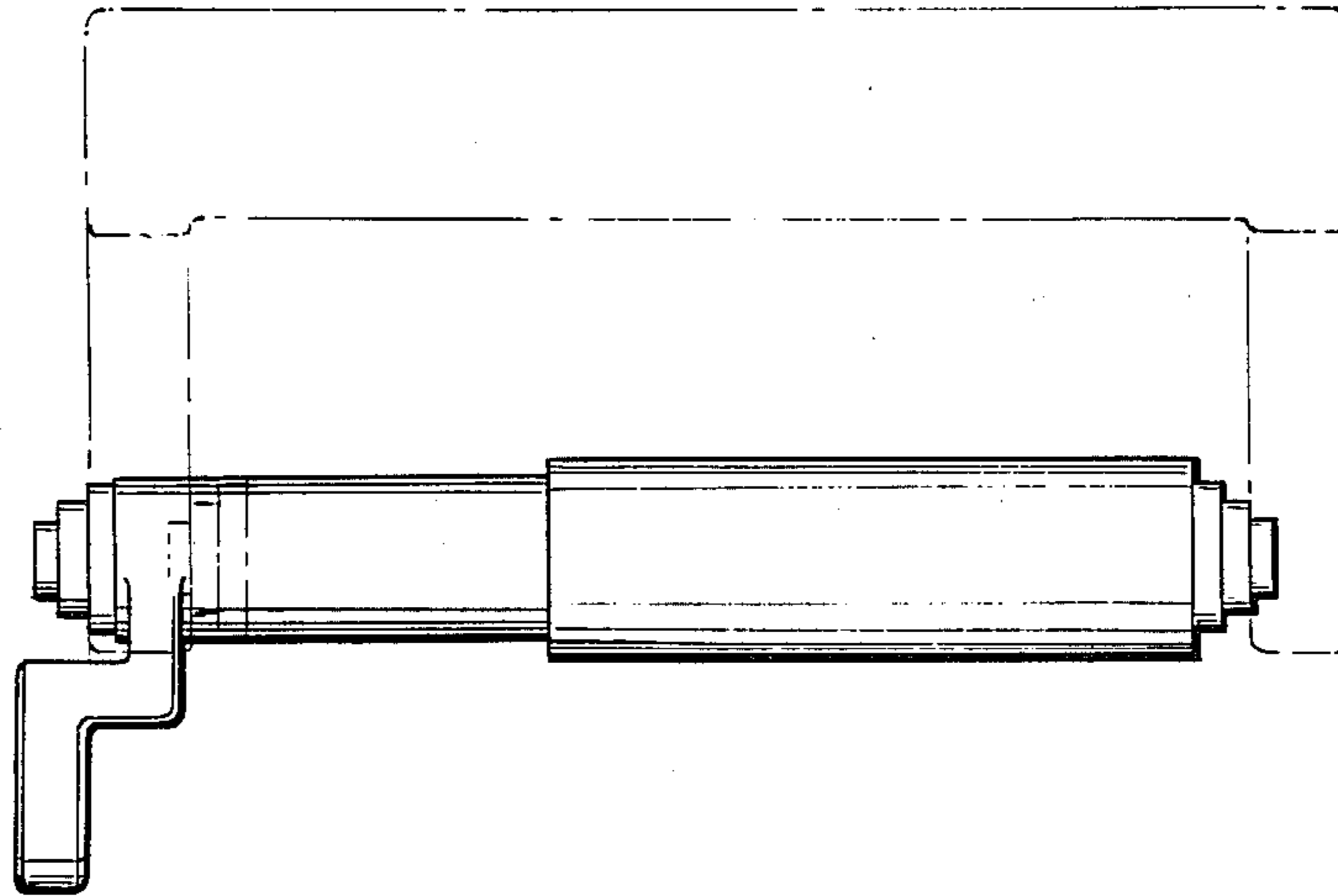

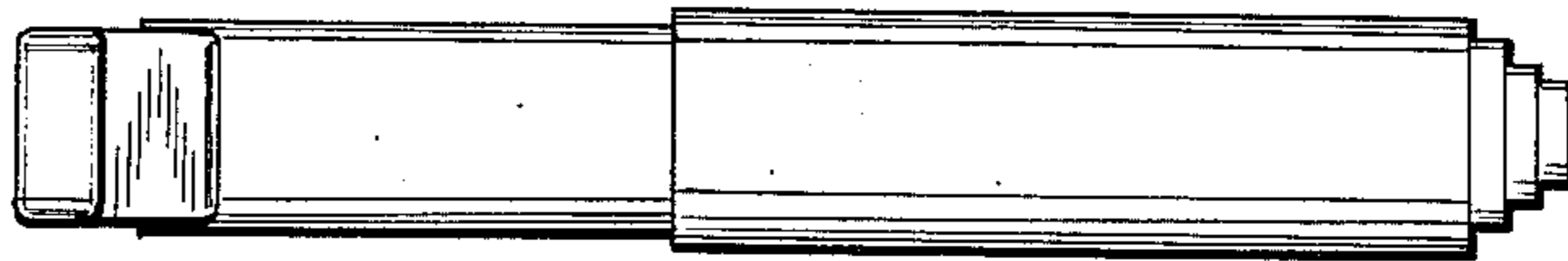

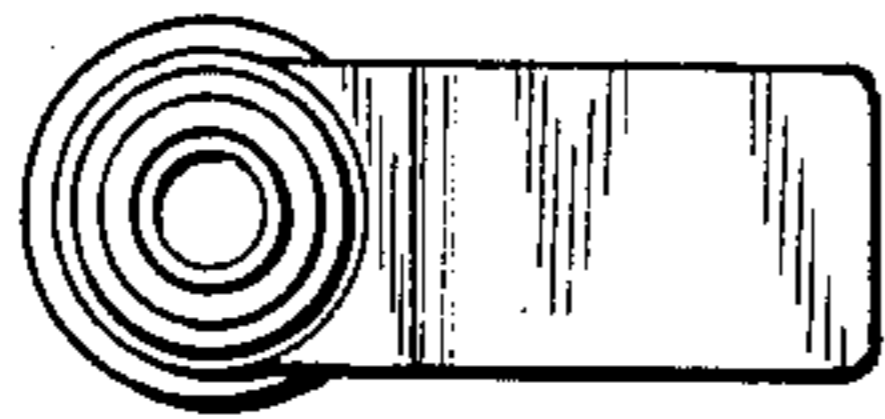
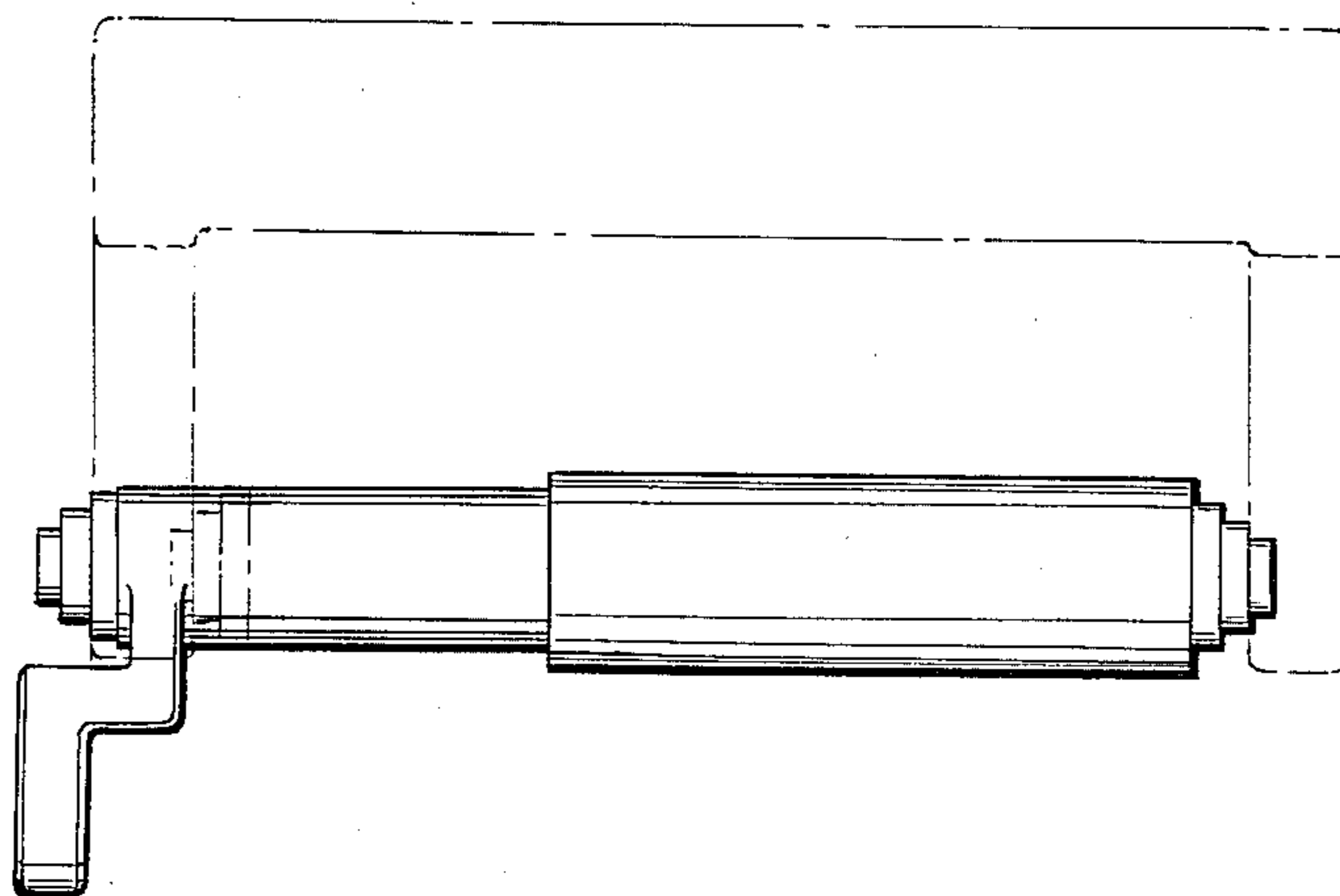

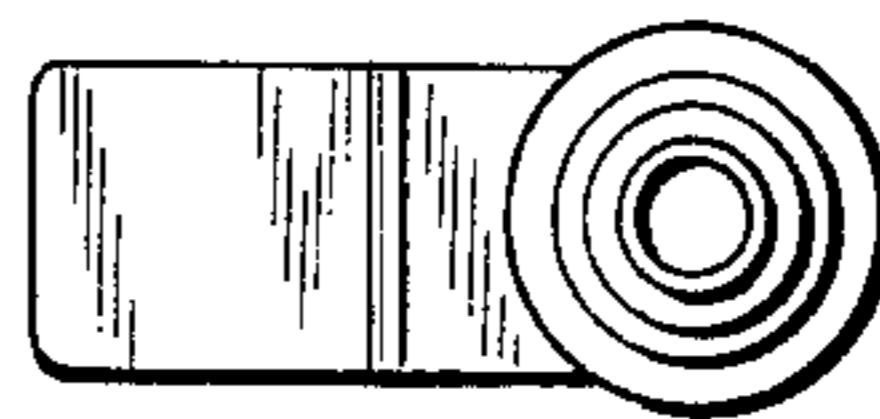
