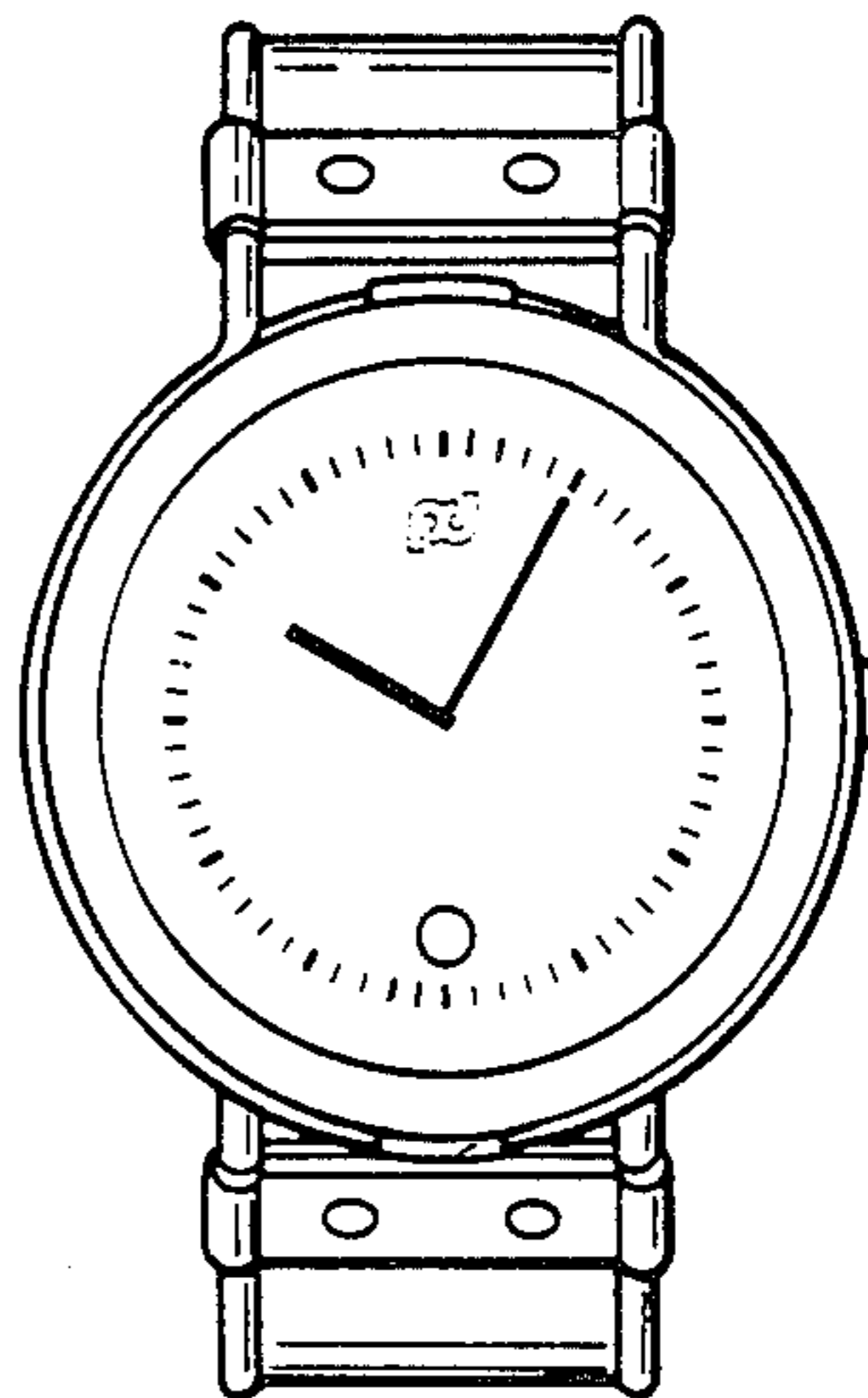
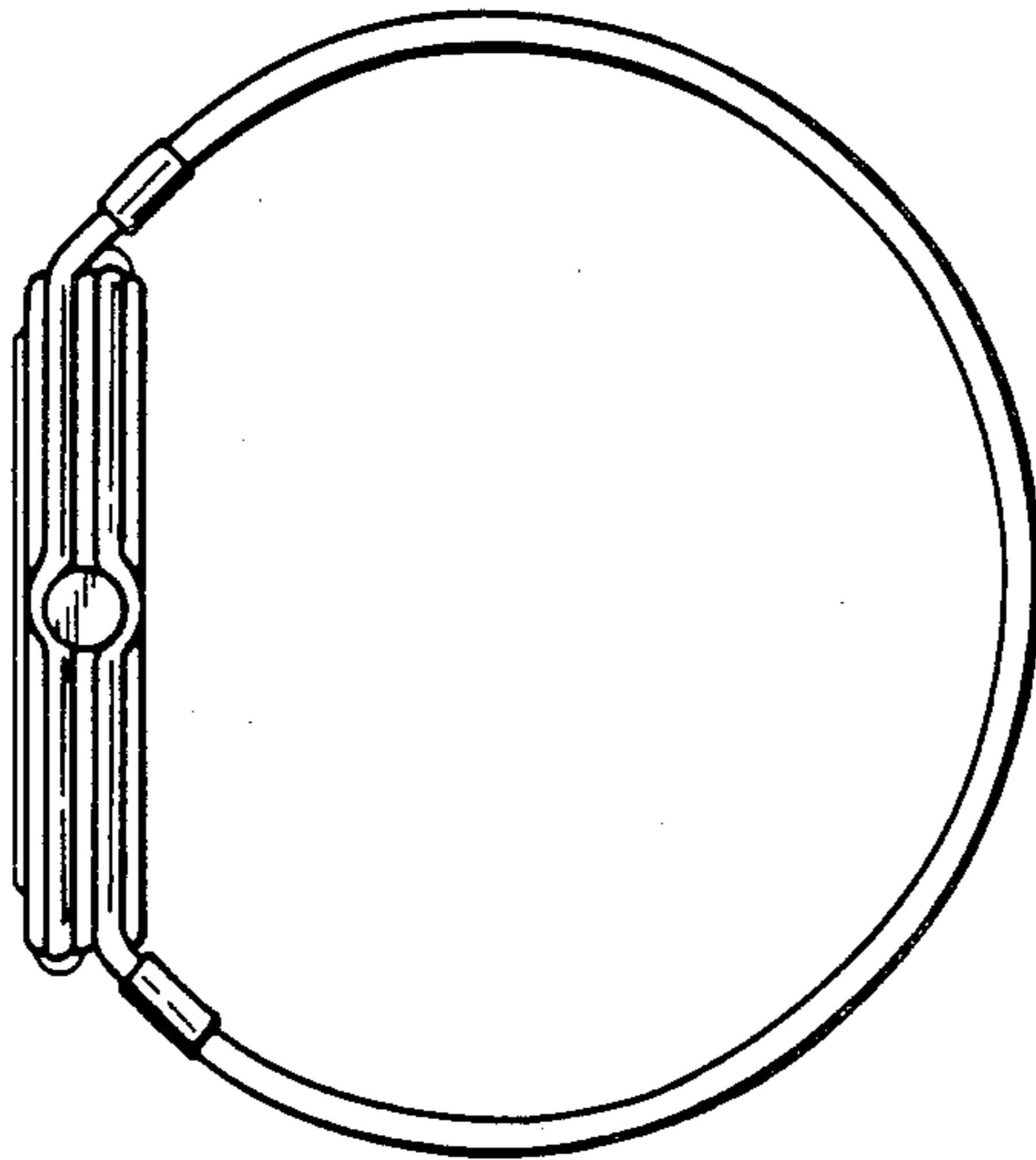

The ornamental design for a sport watch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sport watch showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1-6;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1-6;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1-6;
FIG. 10 is top plan view of a fifth embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1-6.
All other views of the 2nd through 5th embodiments are identical to FIGS. 1-2 and 4-6.



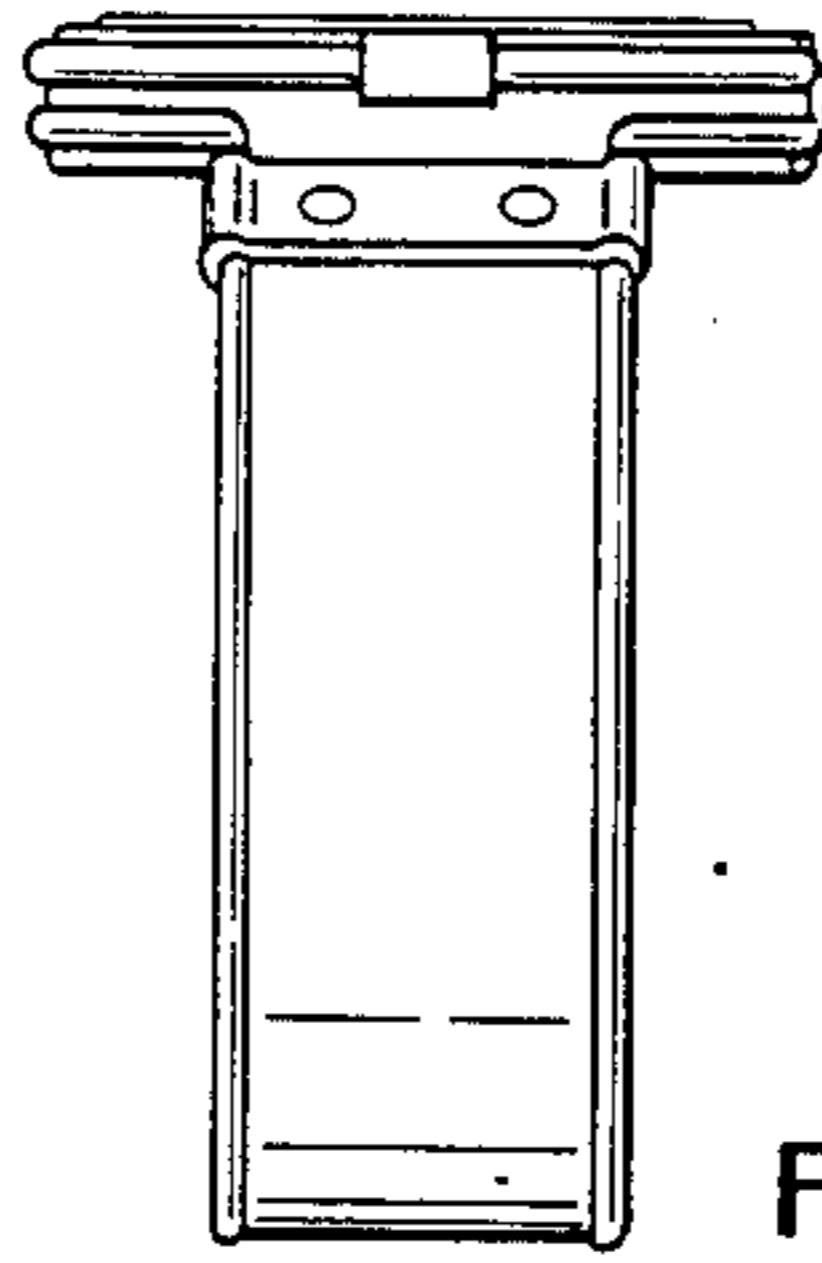

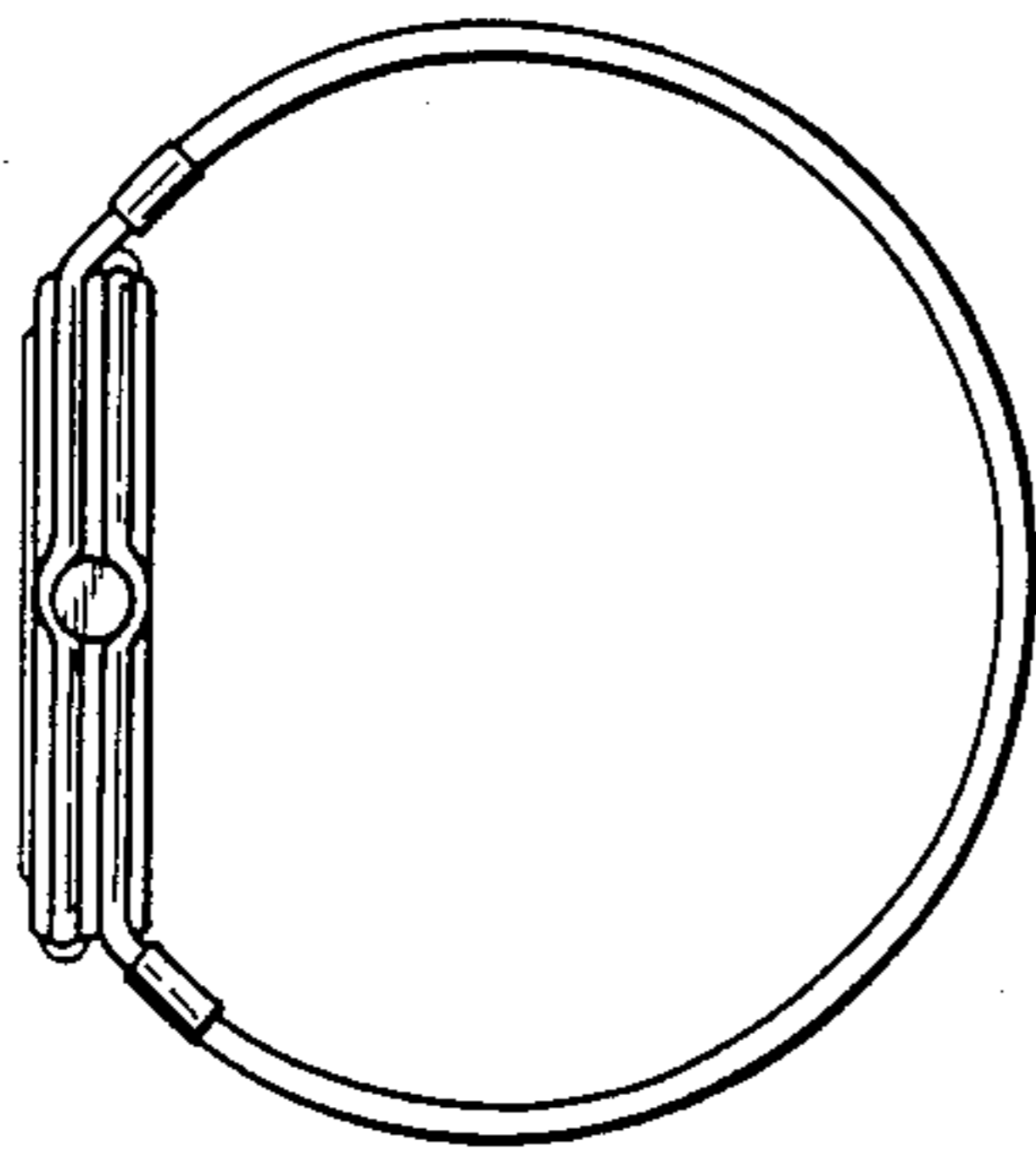

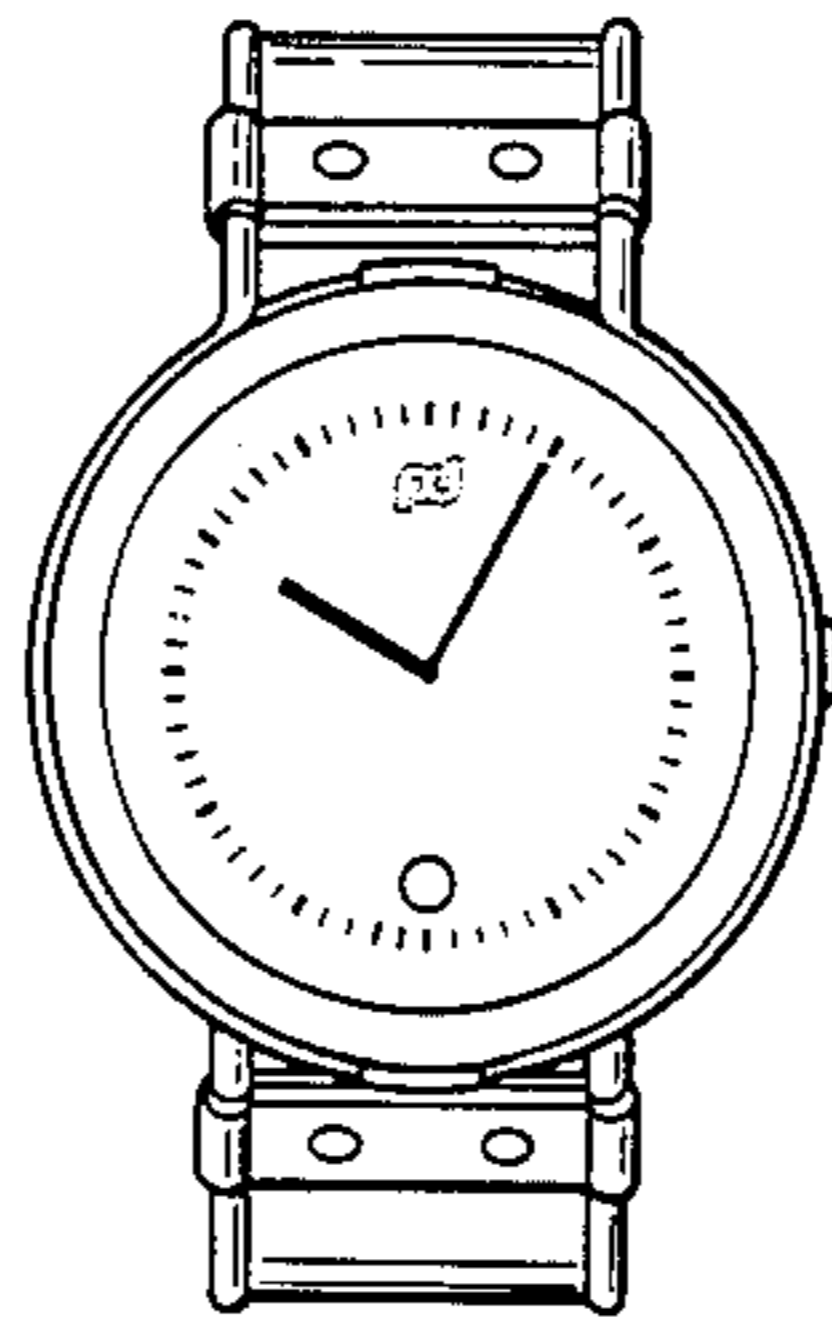

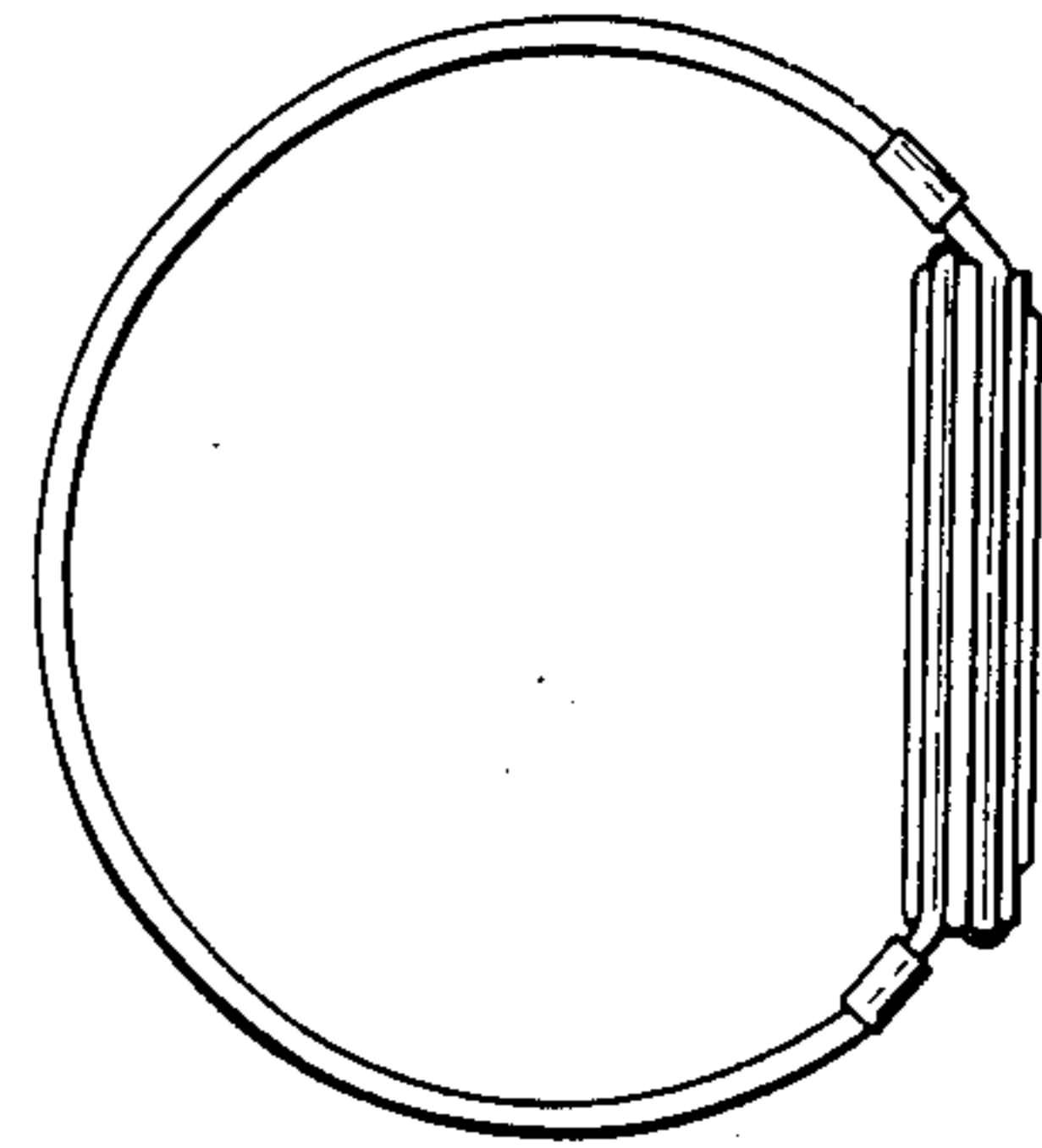

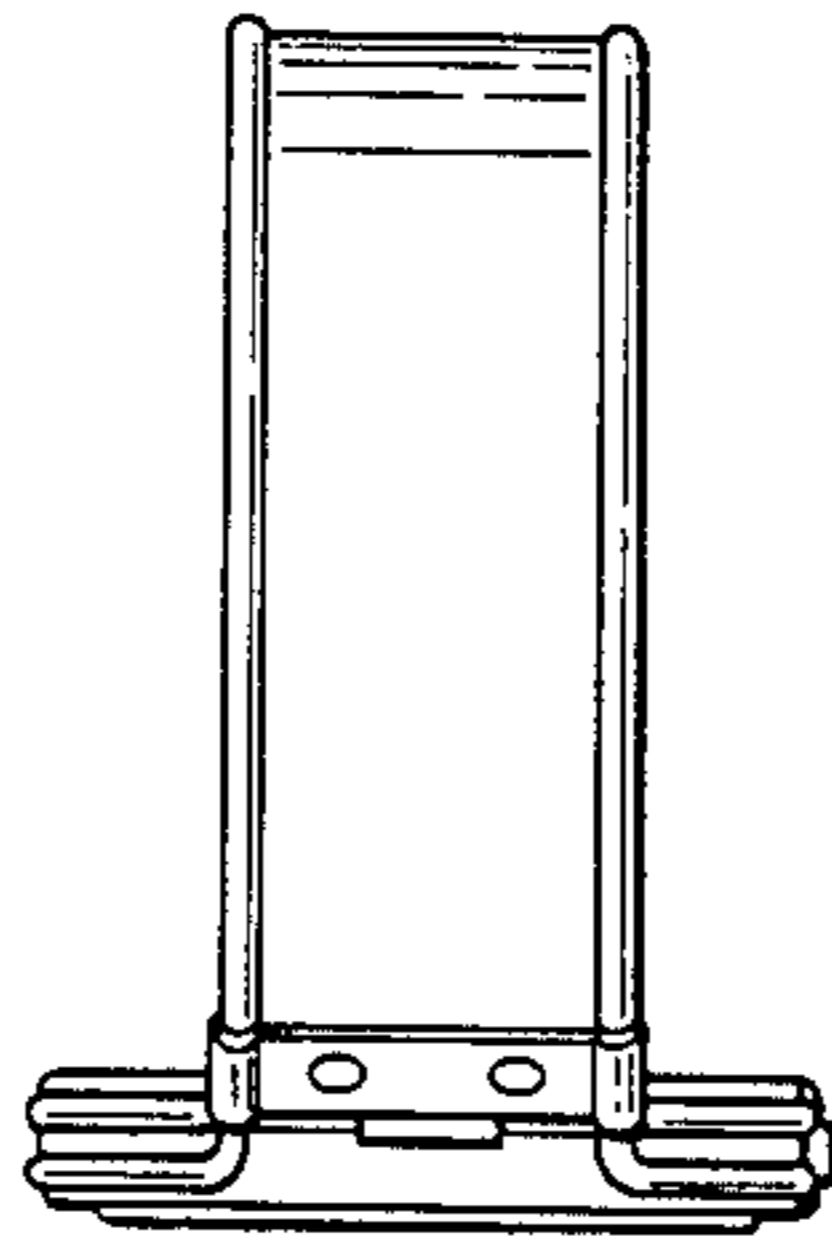

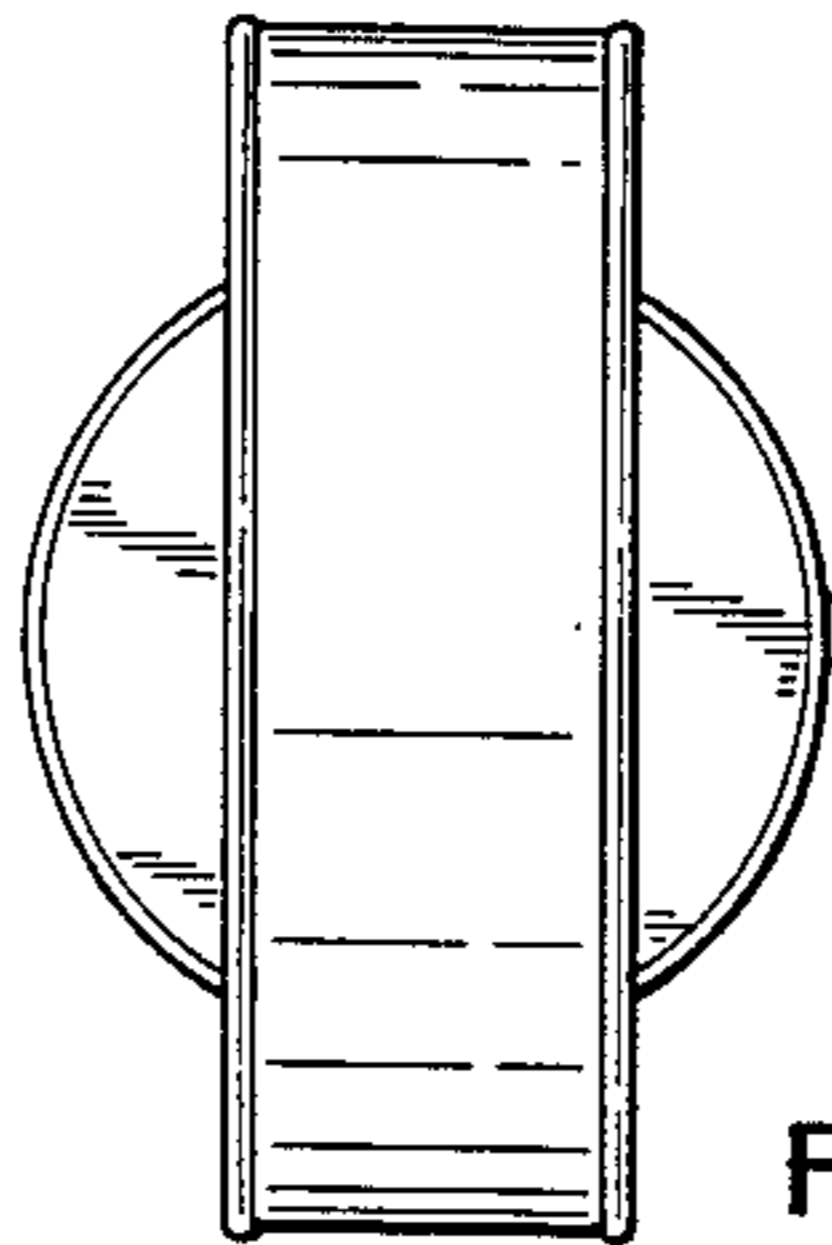

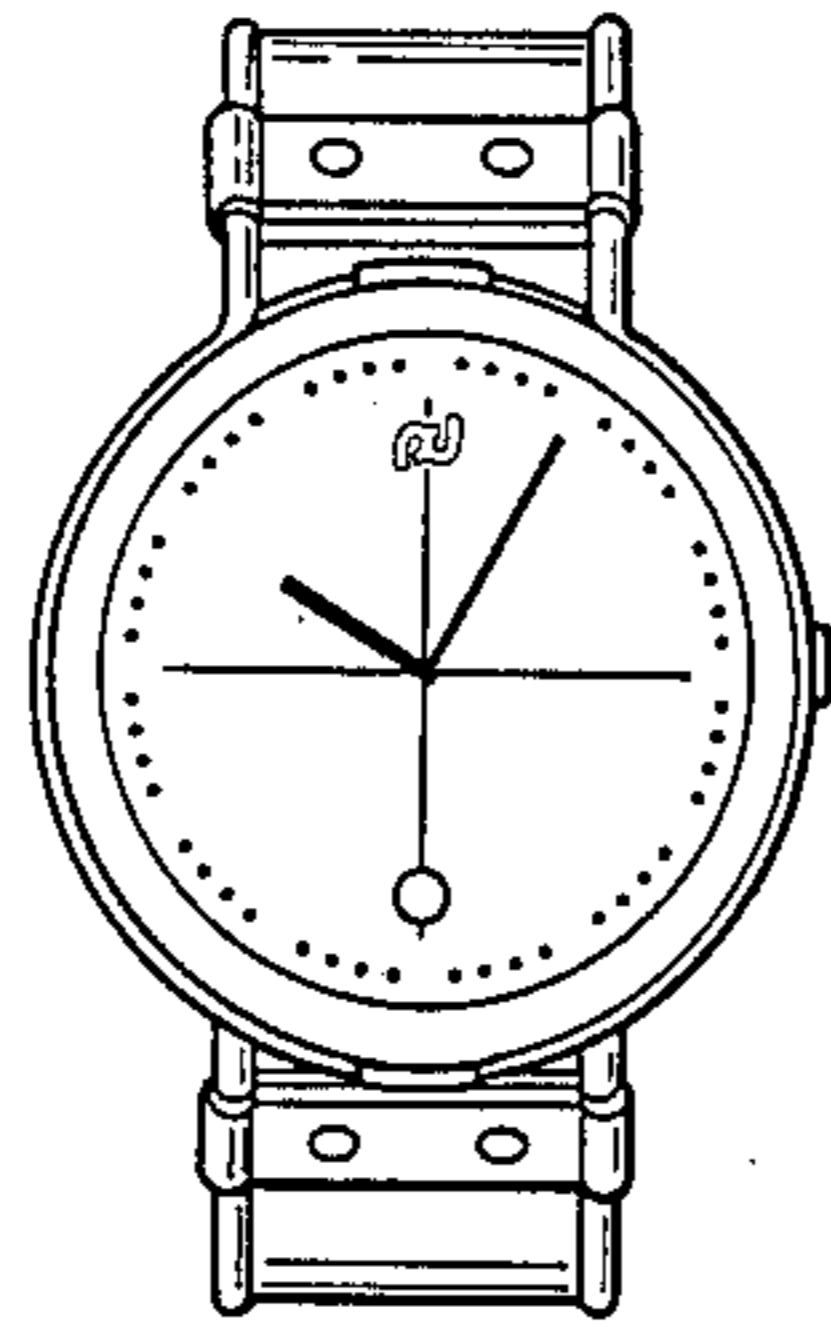

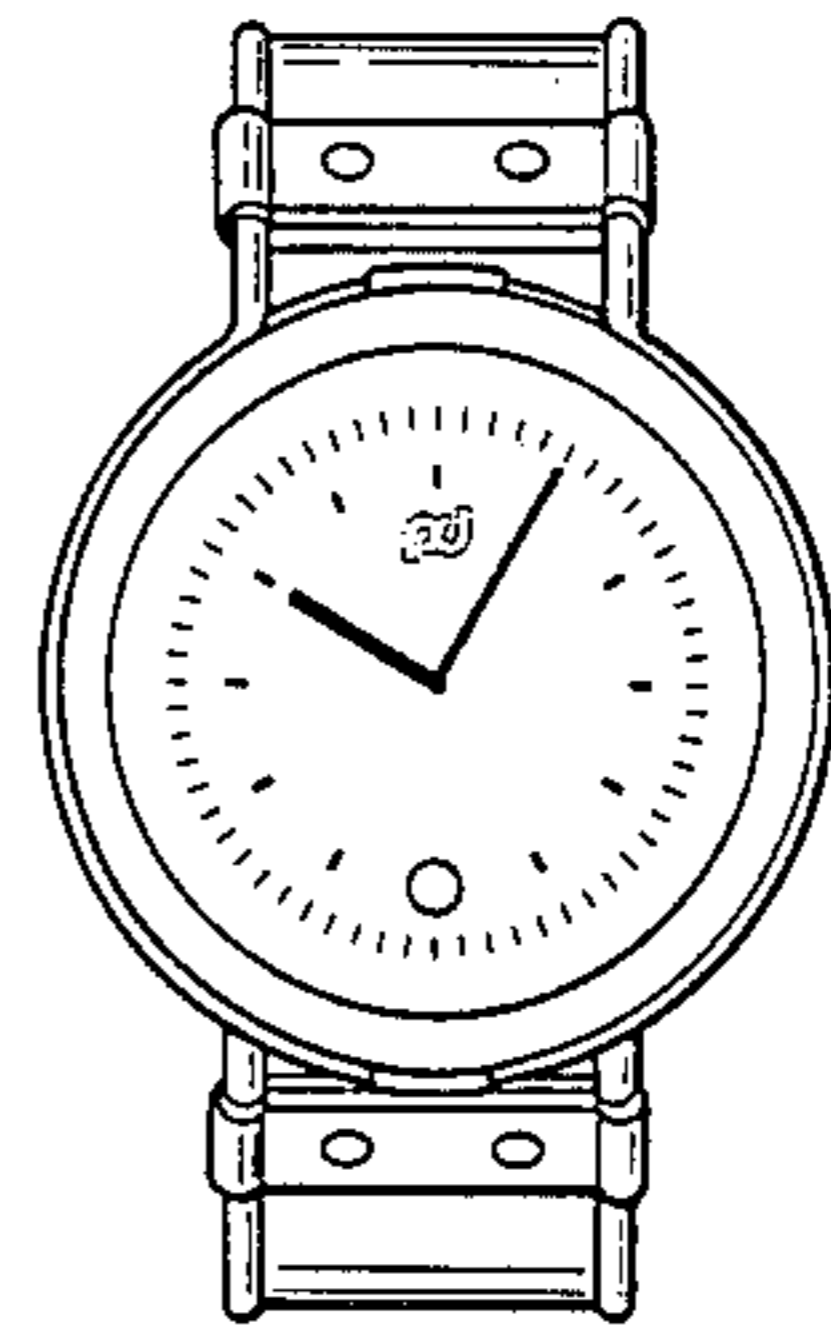

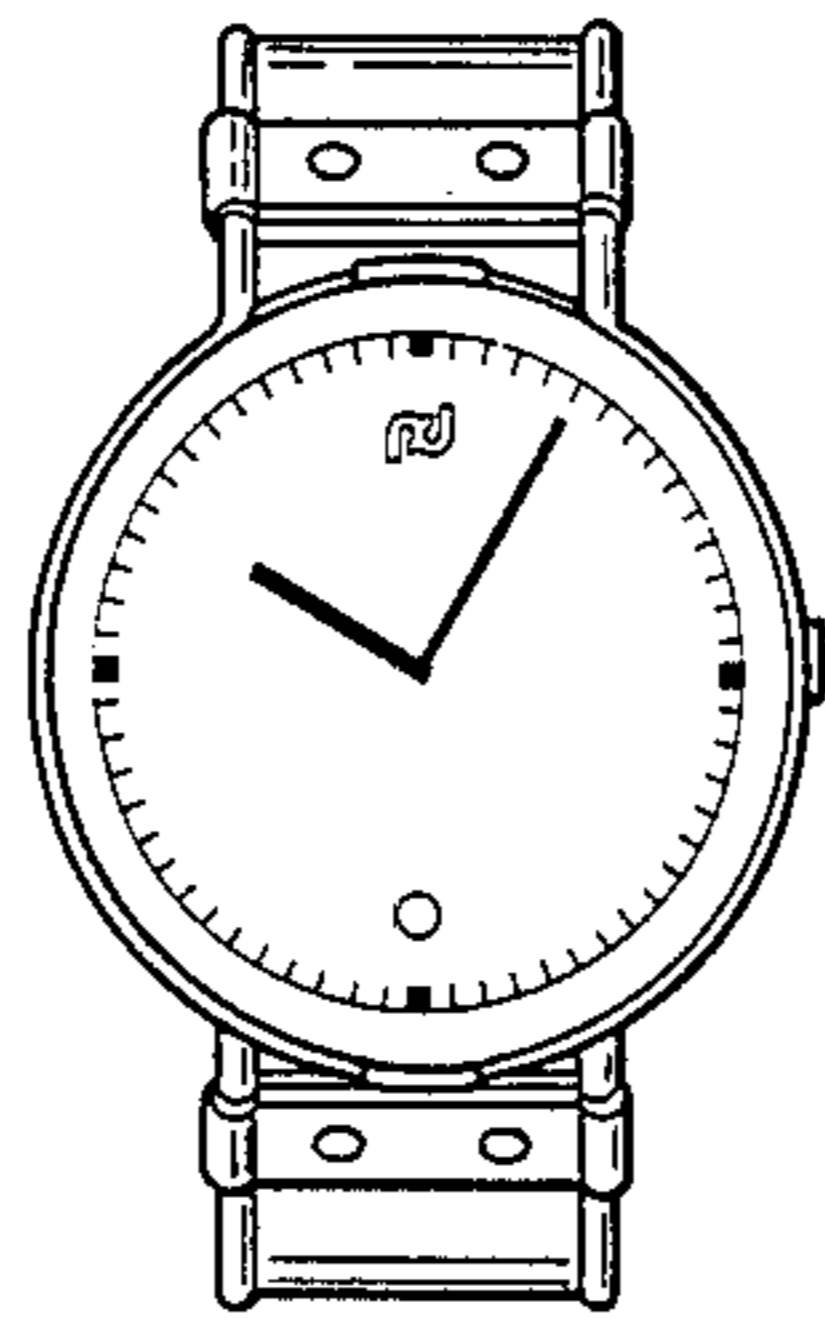

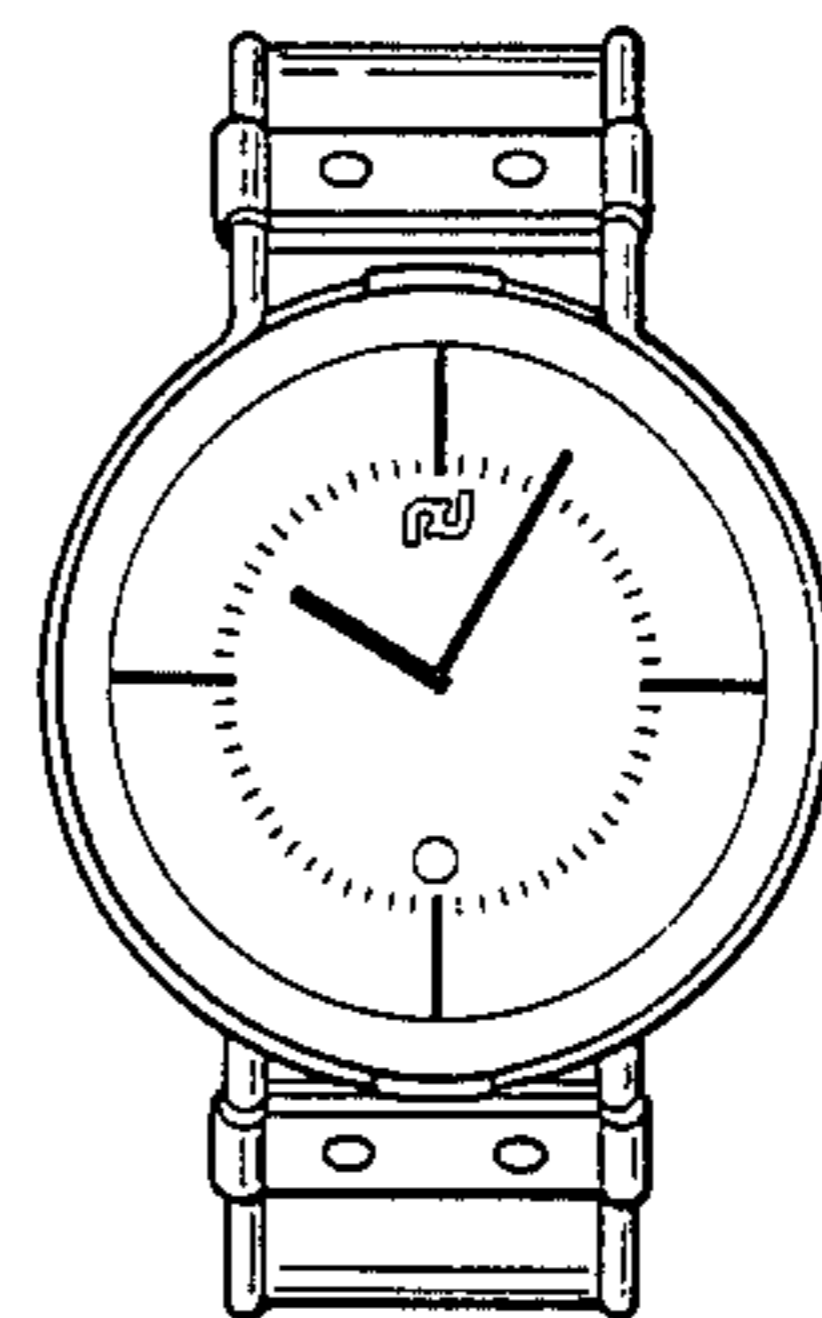
