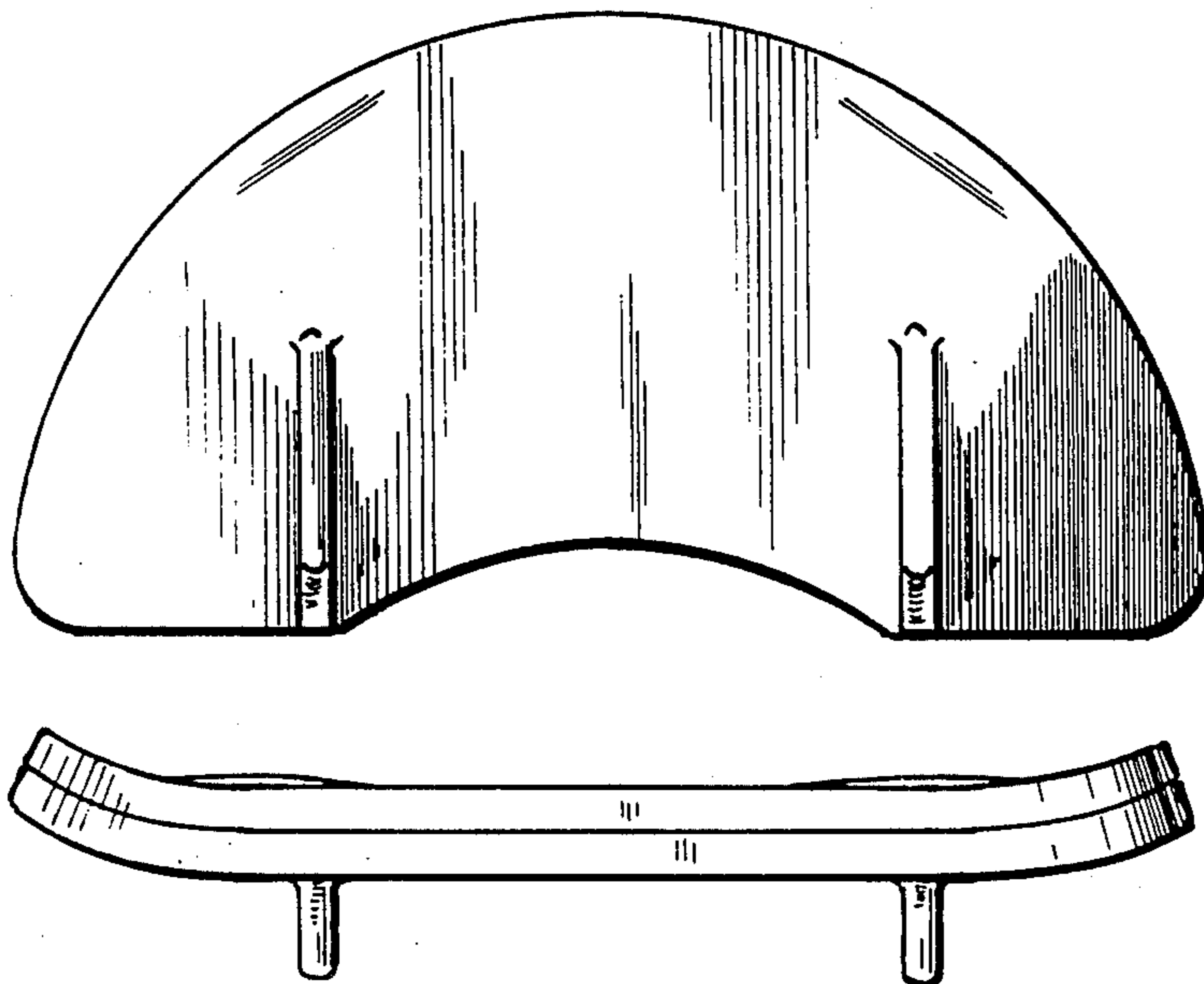

The design for a playing card holder with curvature, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my new design for a playing card holder with curvature;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIGS. 3 and 4 are right and left elevational views thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of an alternate embodiment of my new design for a playing card holder with curvature;
 FIG. 8 is a plan view of the alternate embodiment;
 FIGS. 9 and 10 are right and left elevational views of the alternate embodiment;
 FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the alternate embodiment; and
 FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the alternate embodiment.



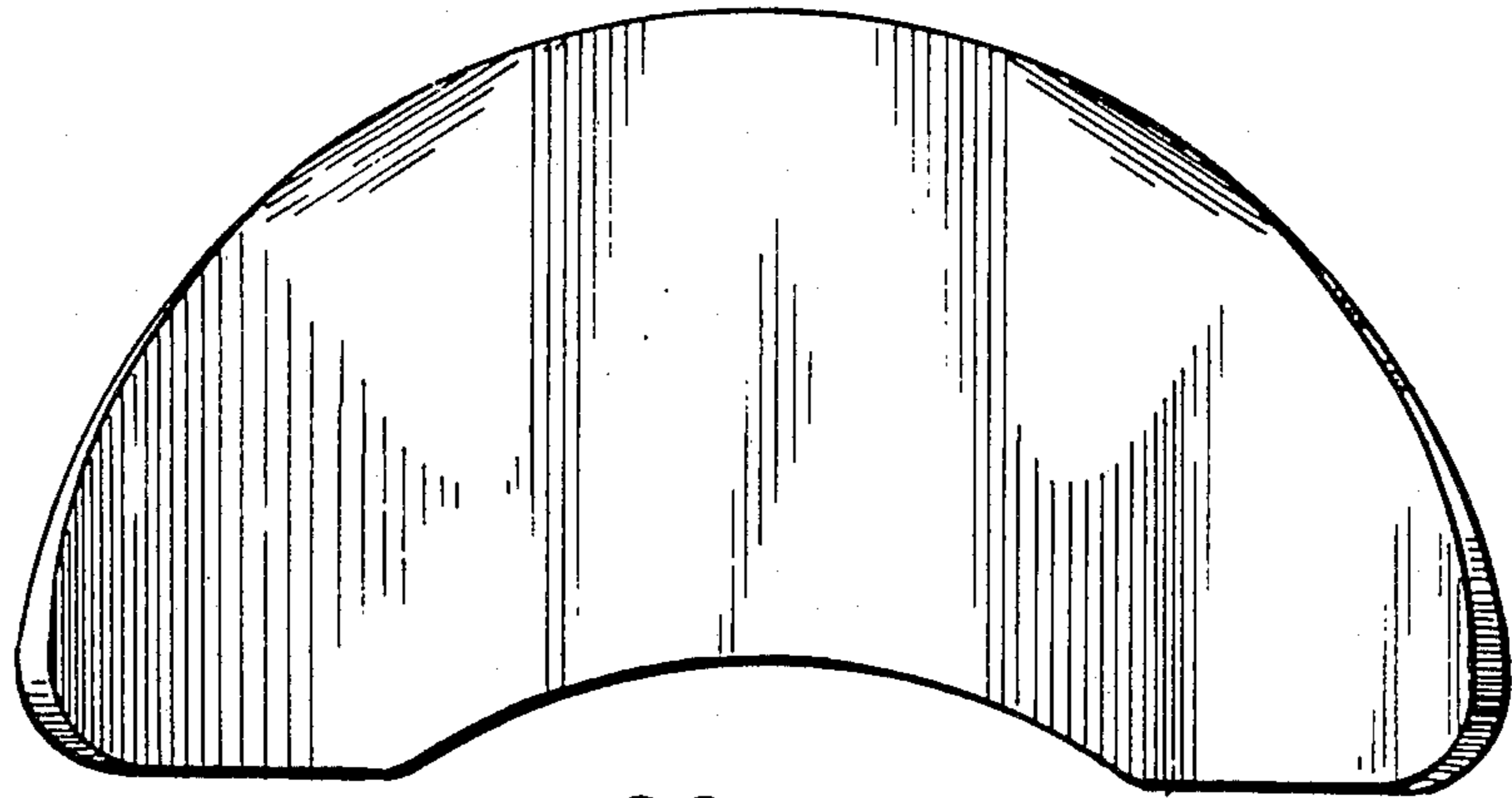

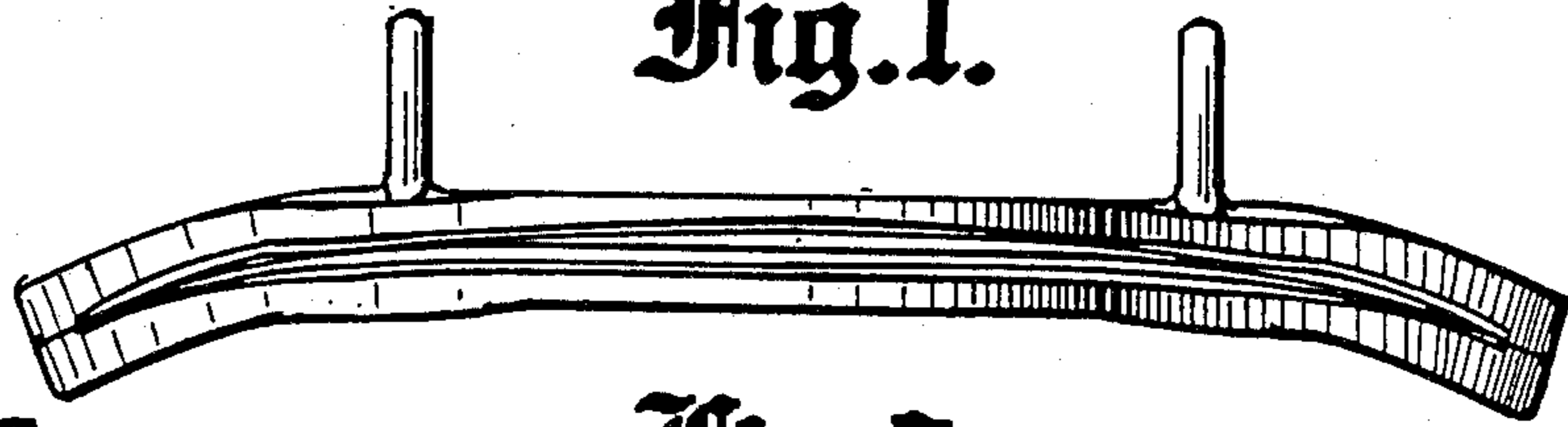

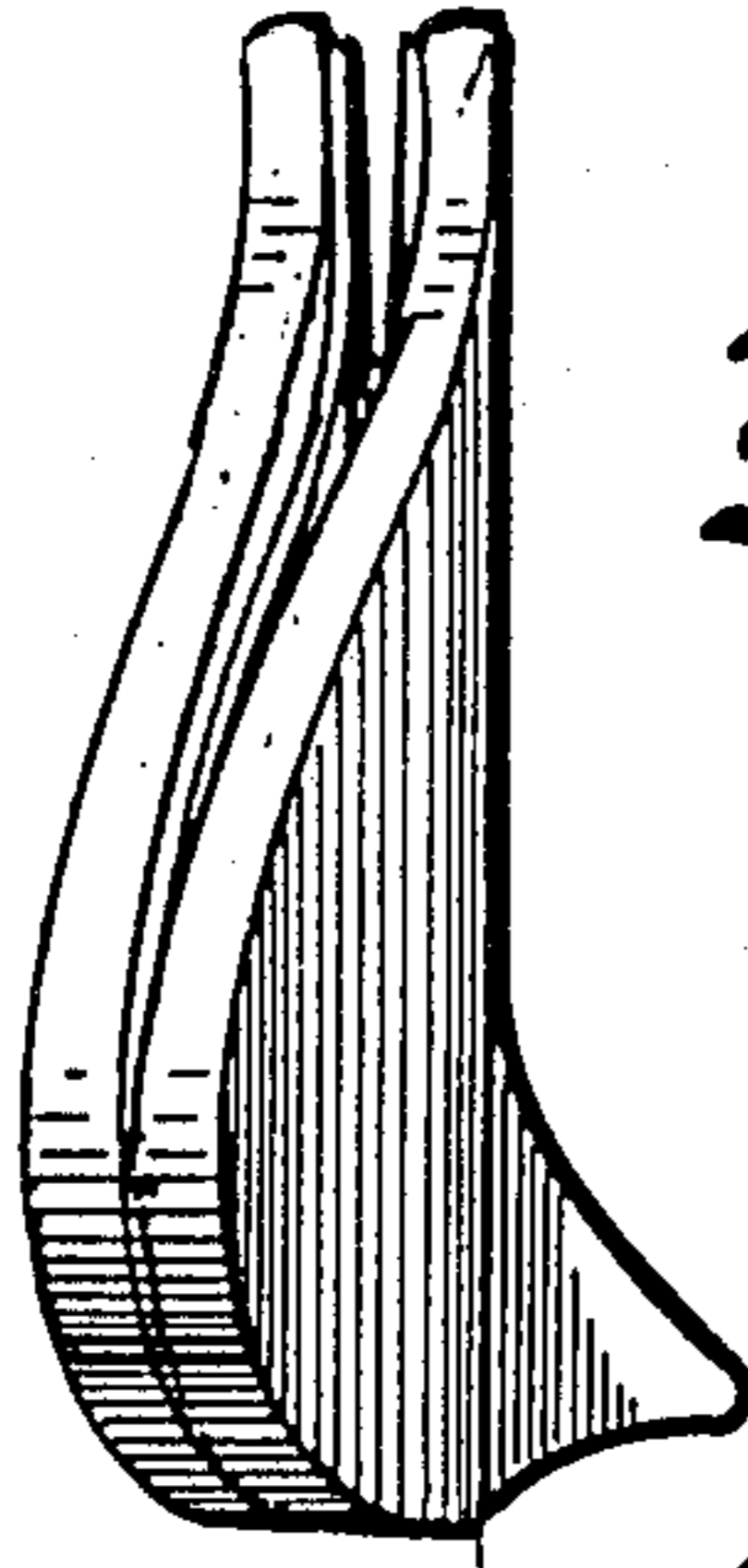

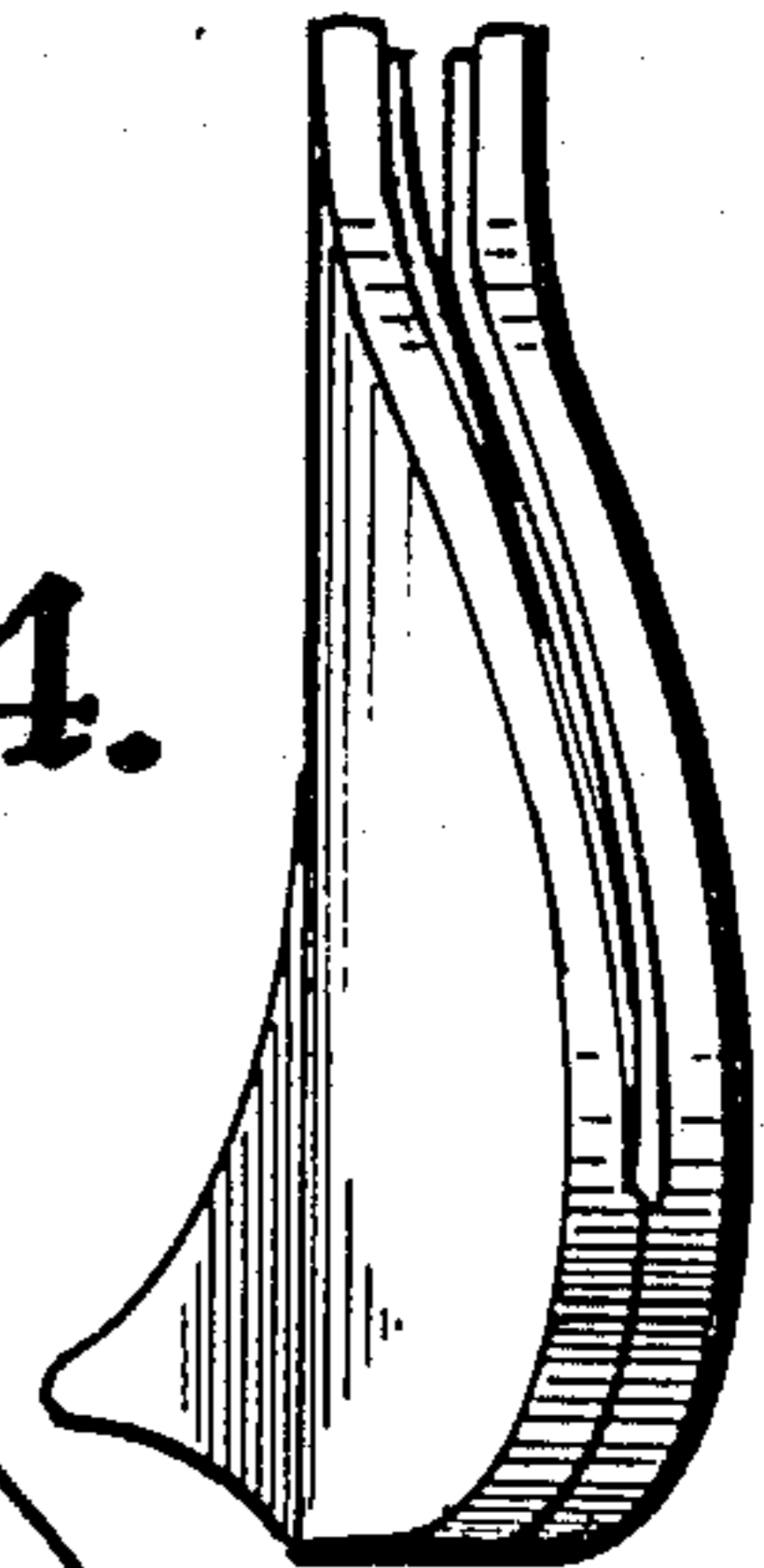

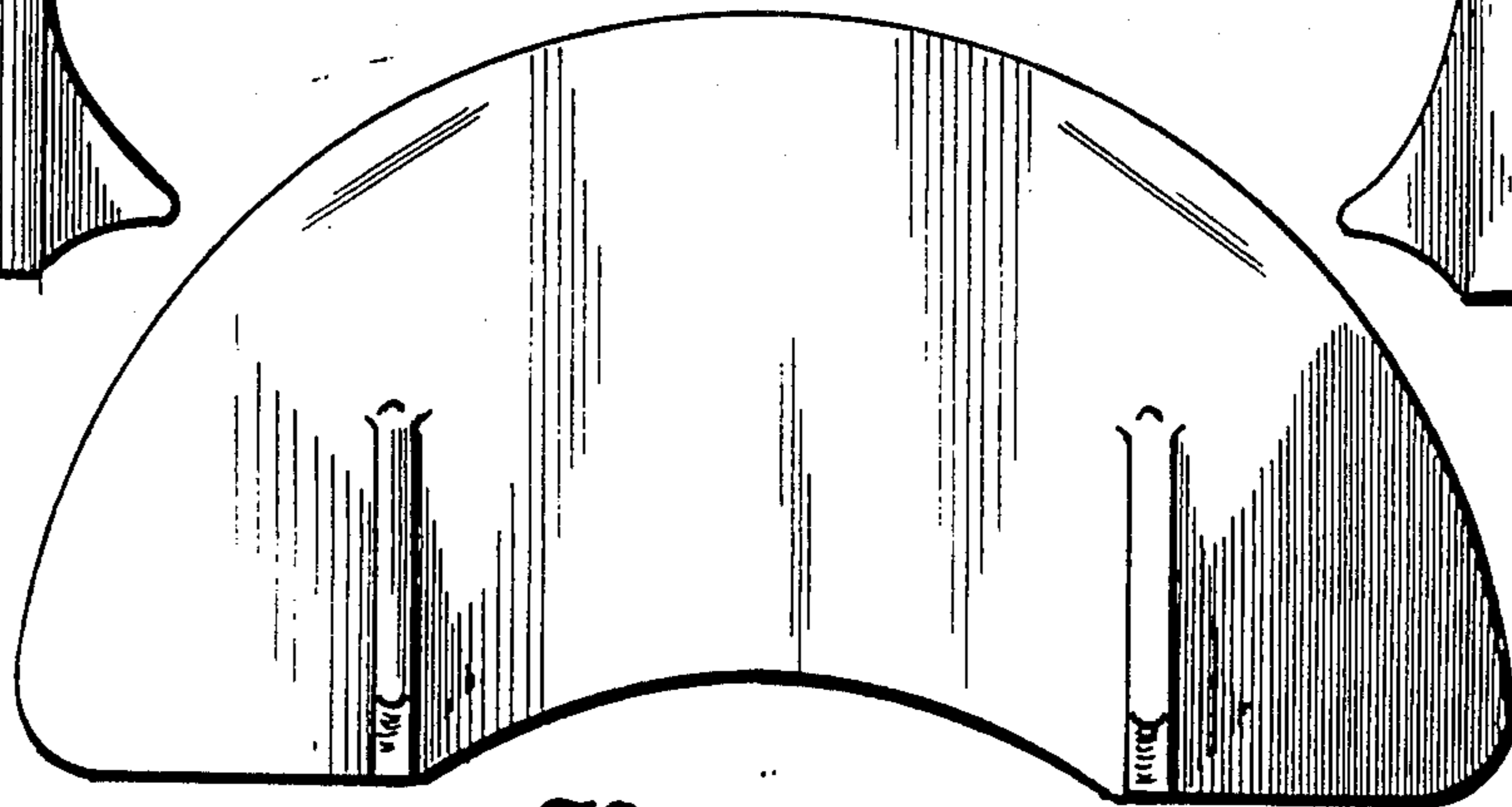

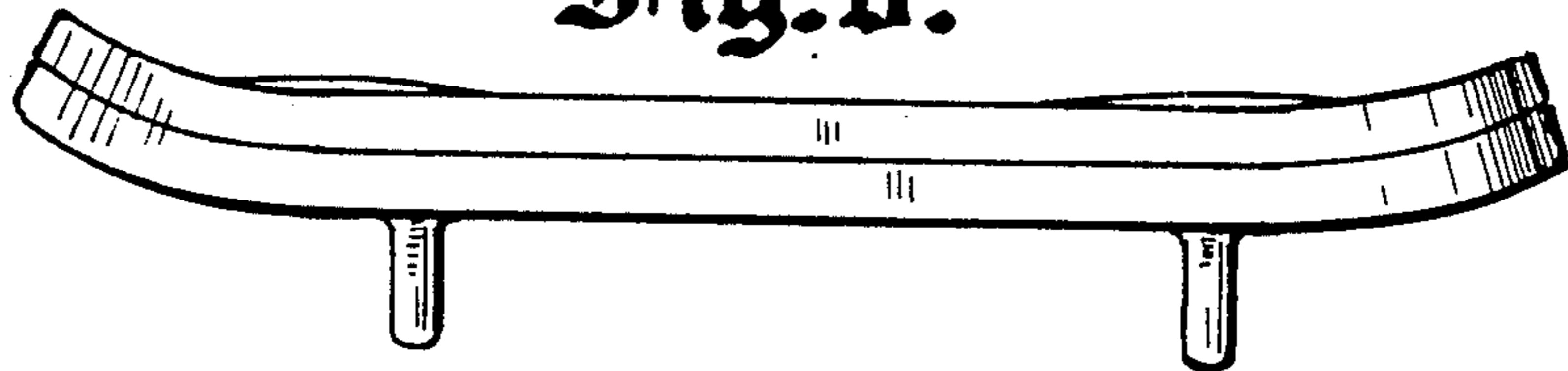

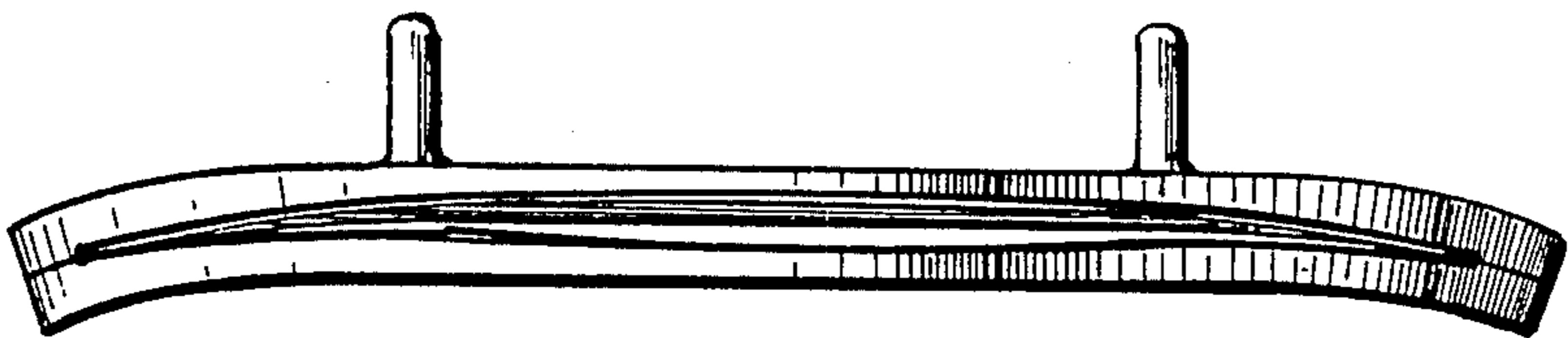
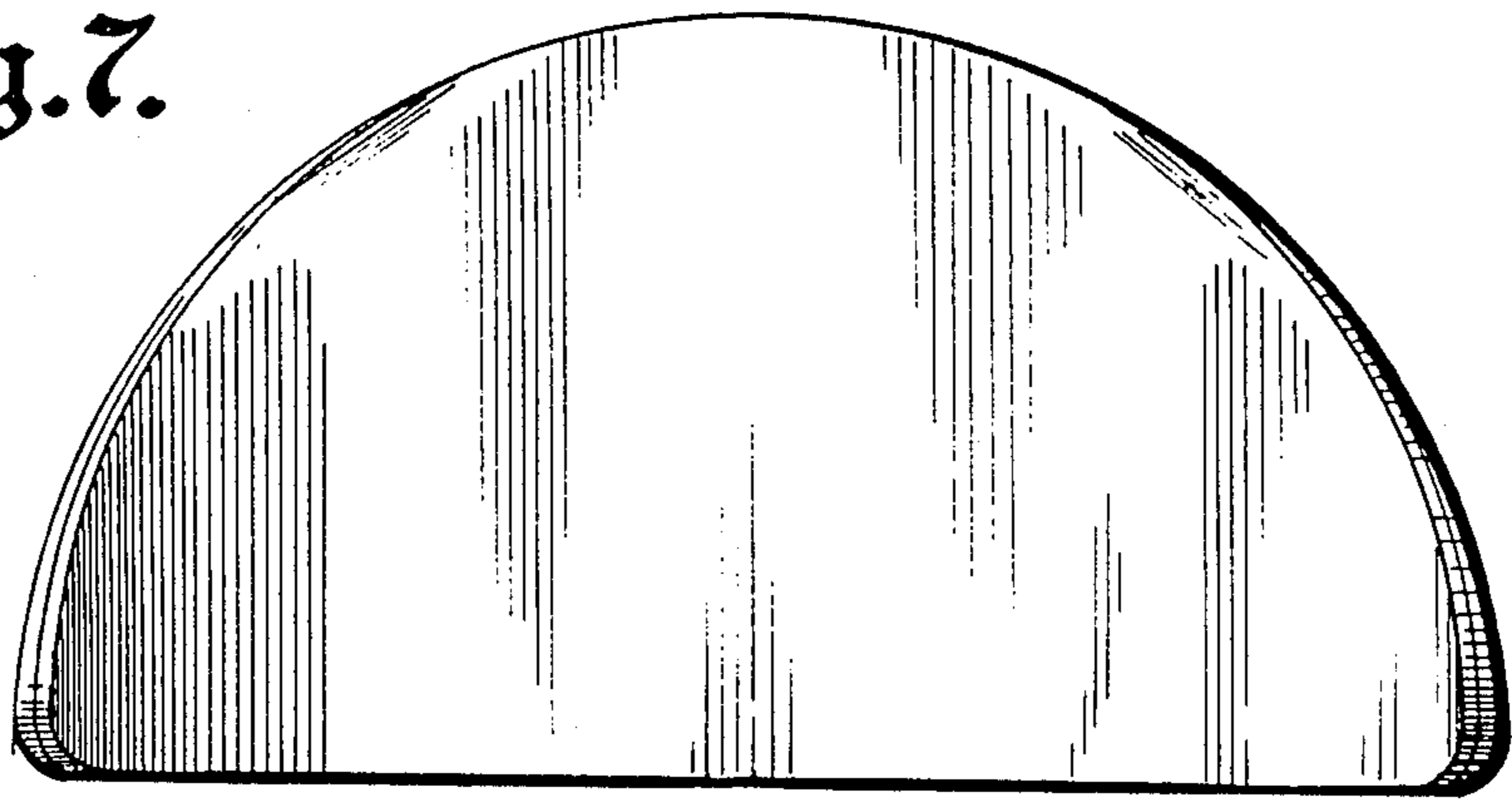

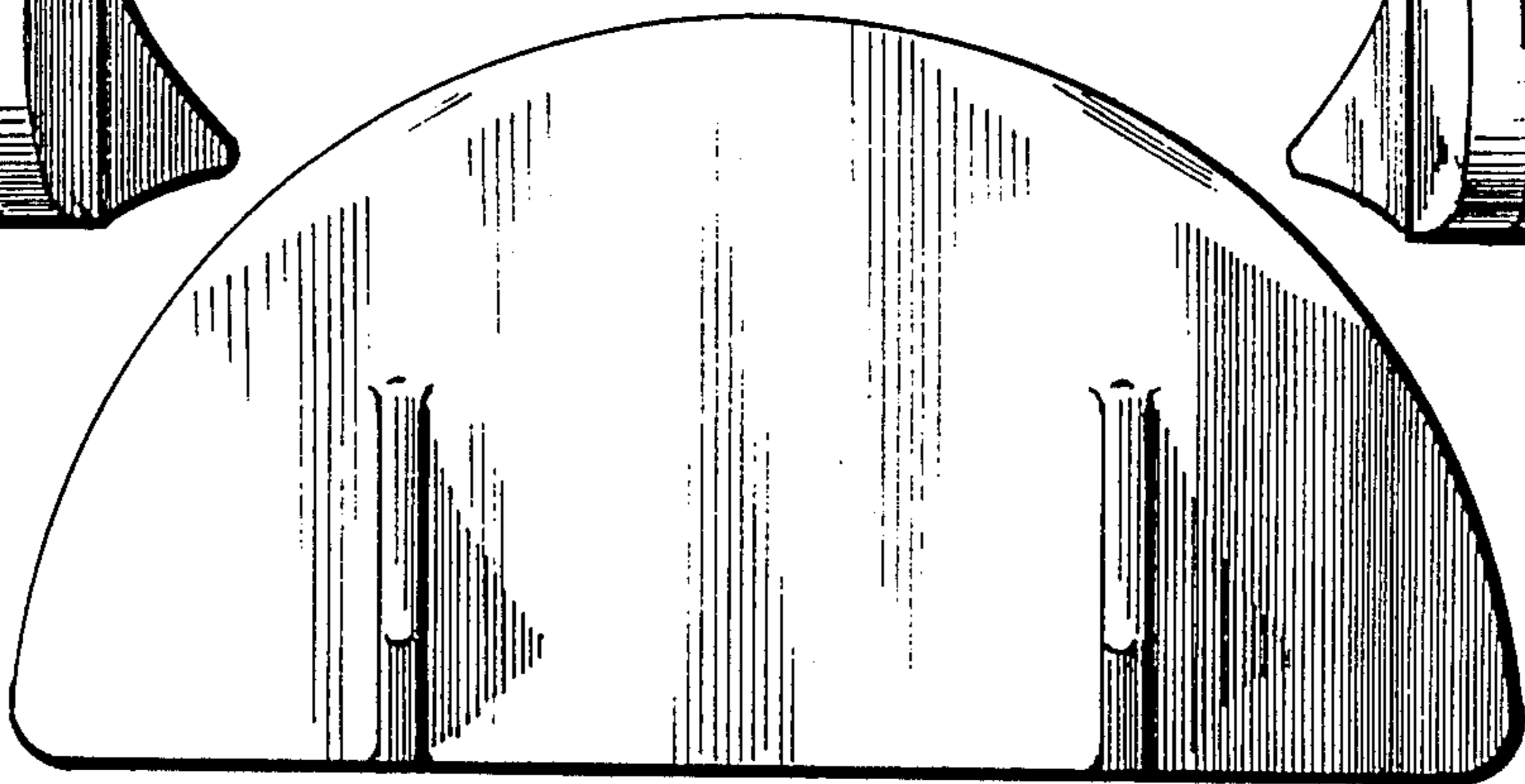

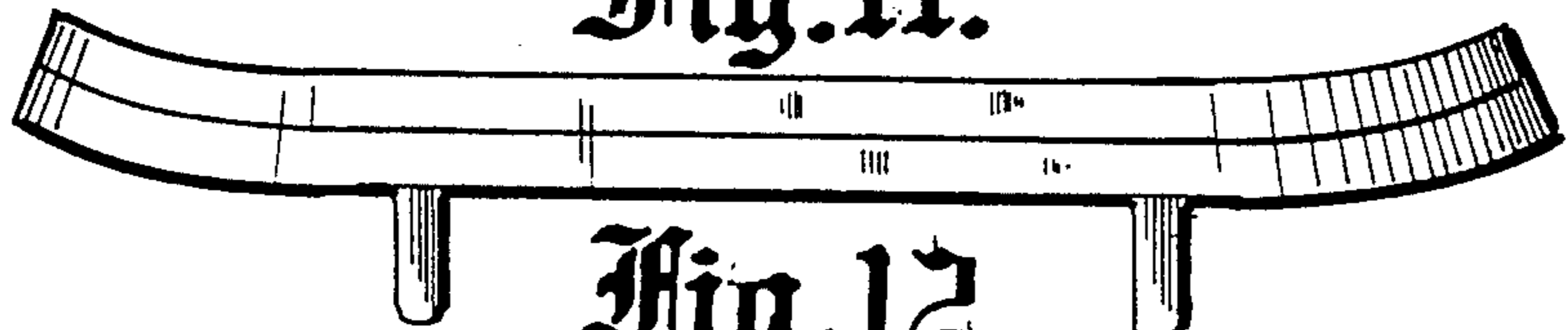
