DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a strobe light showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the left-hand side of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the right-hand side of FIG. 2.

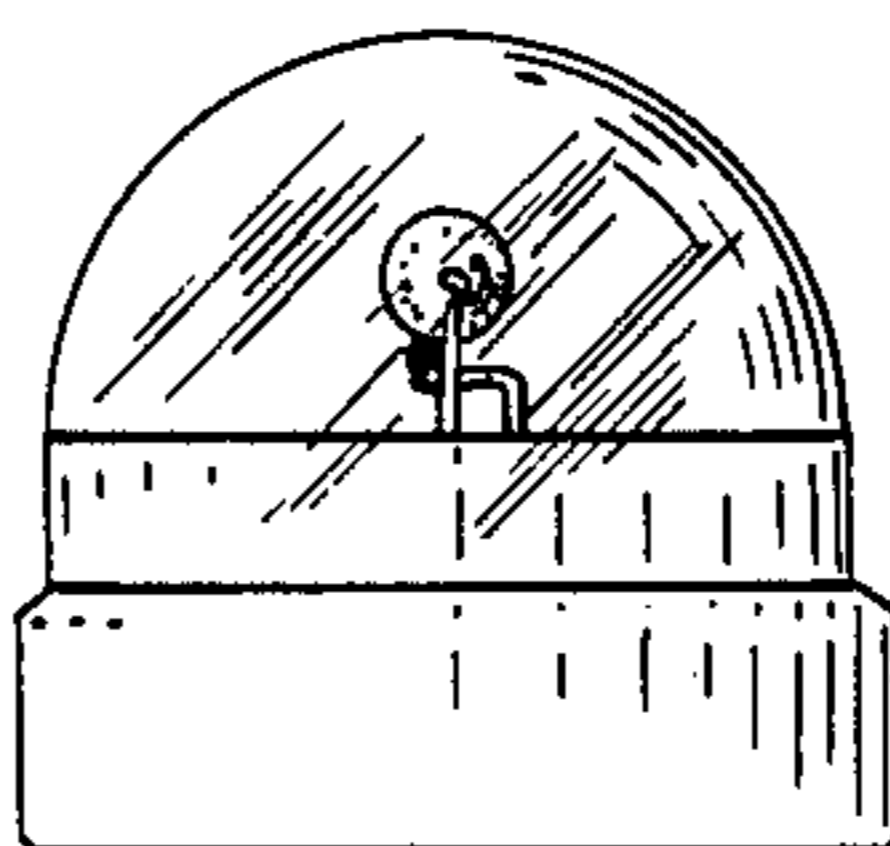
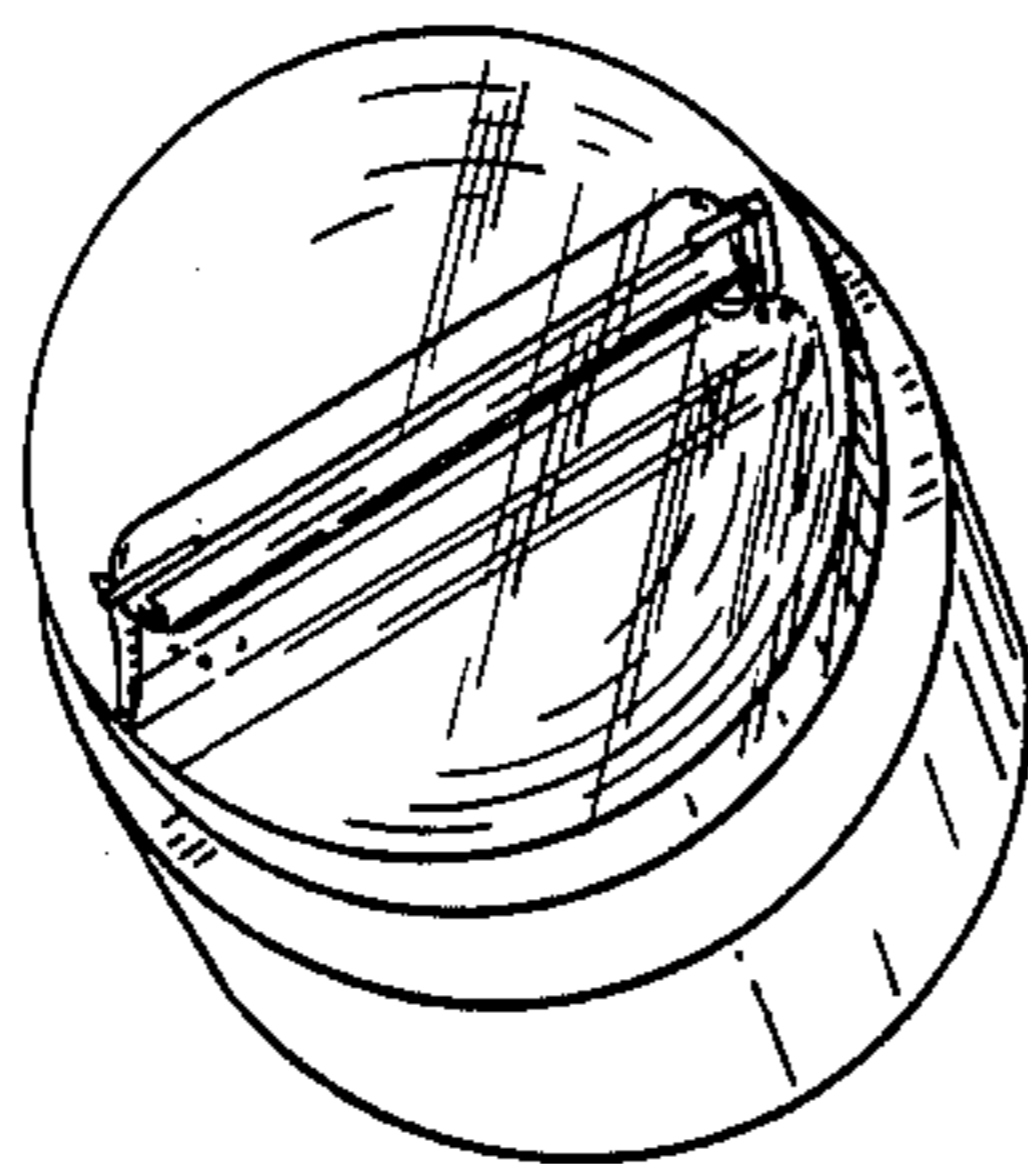

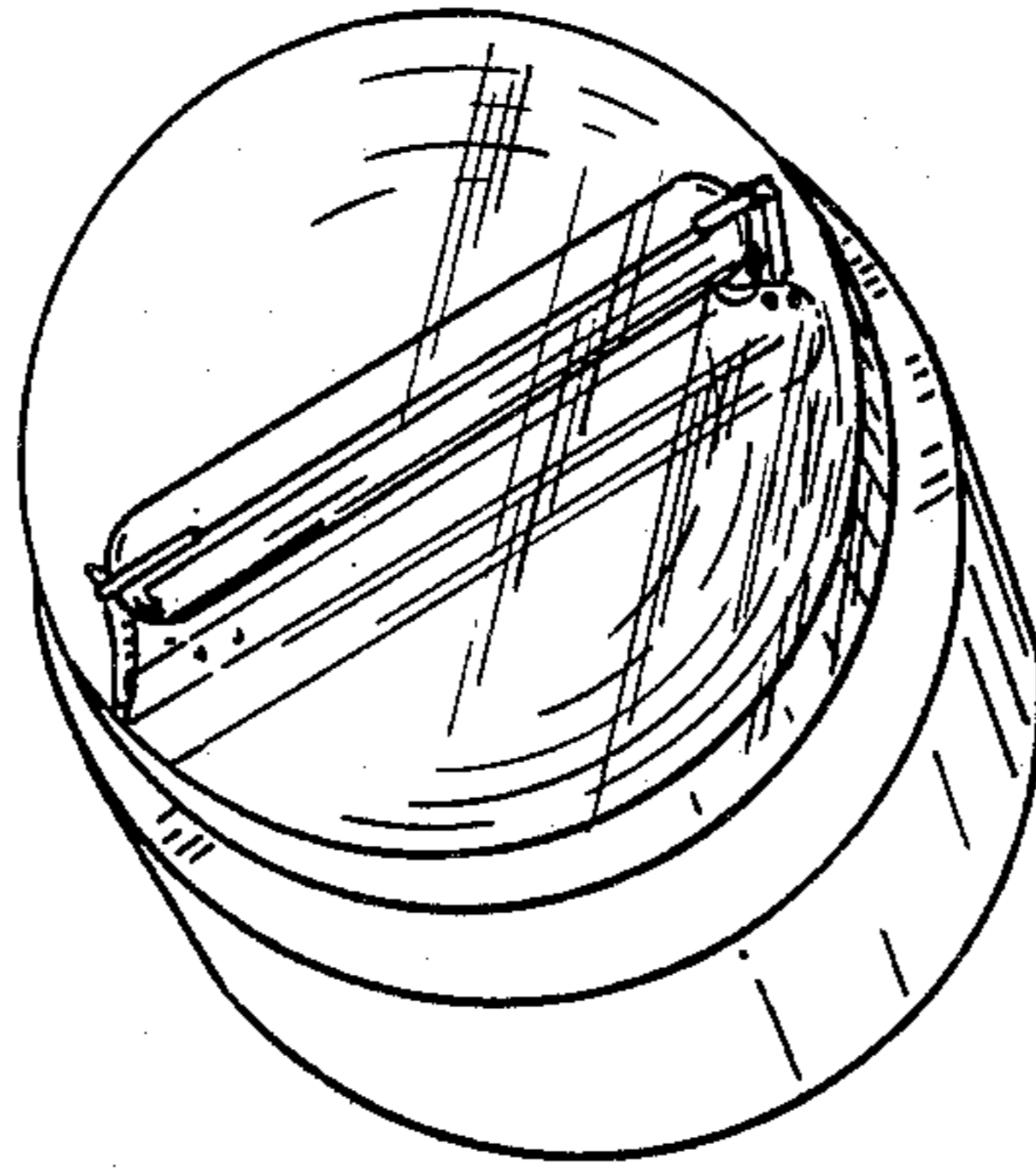

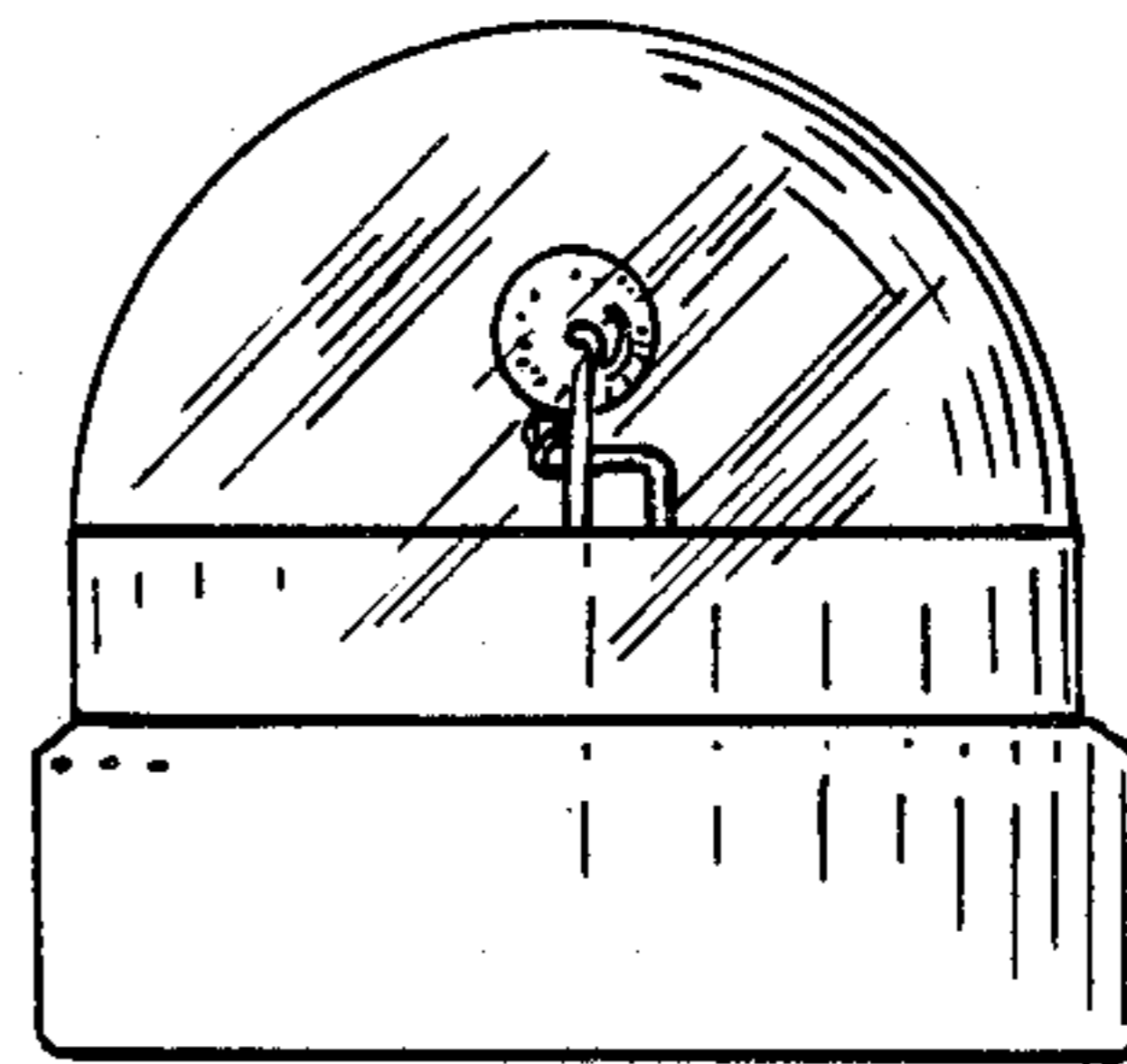
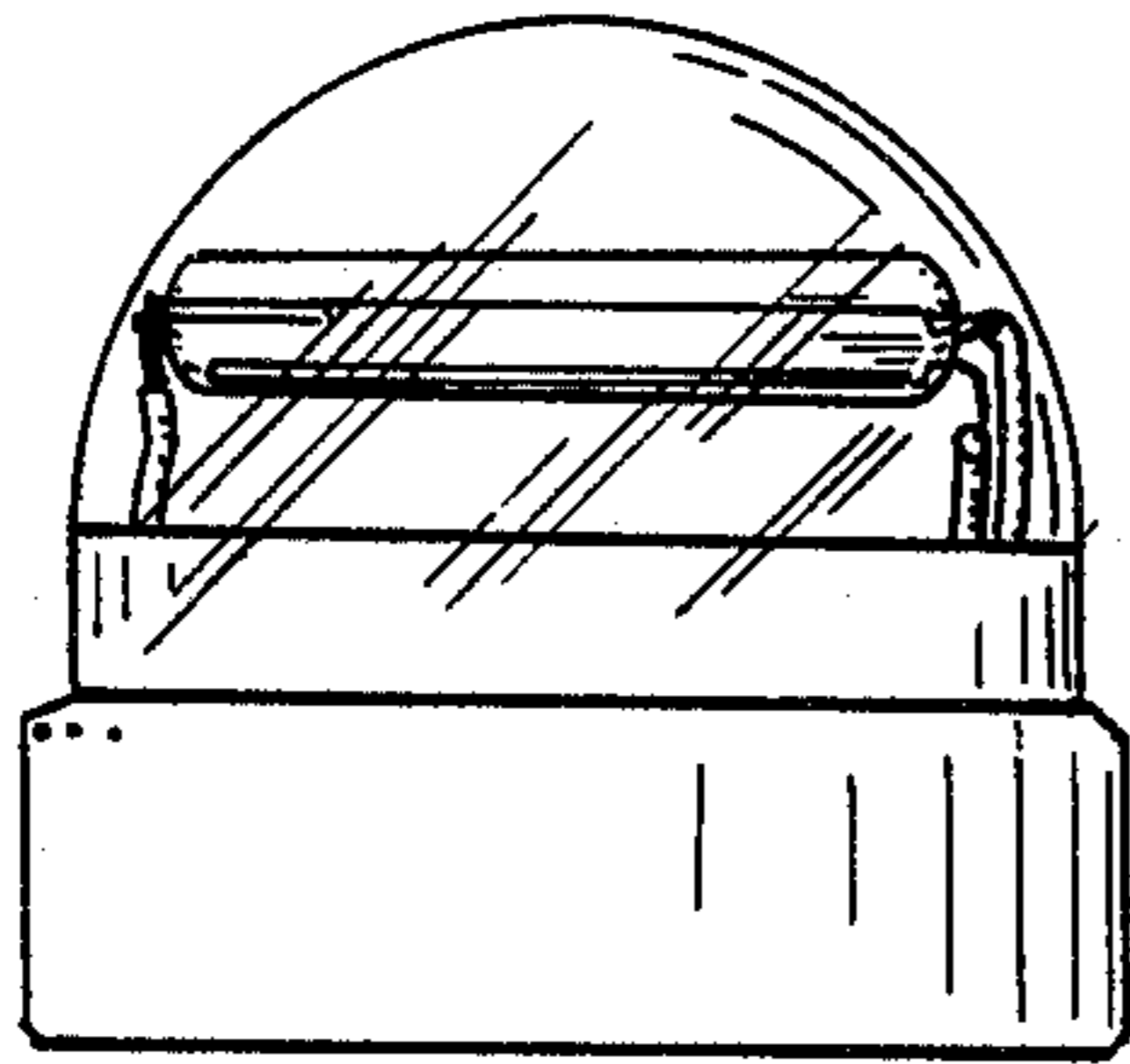

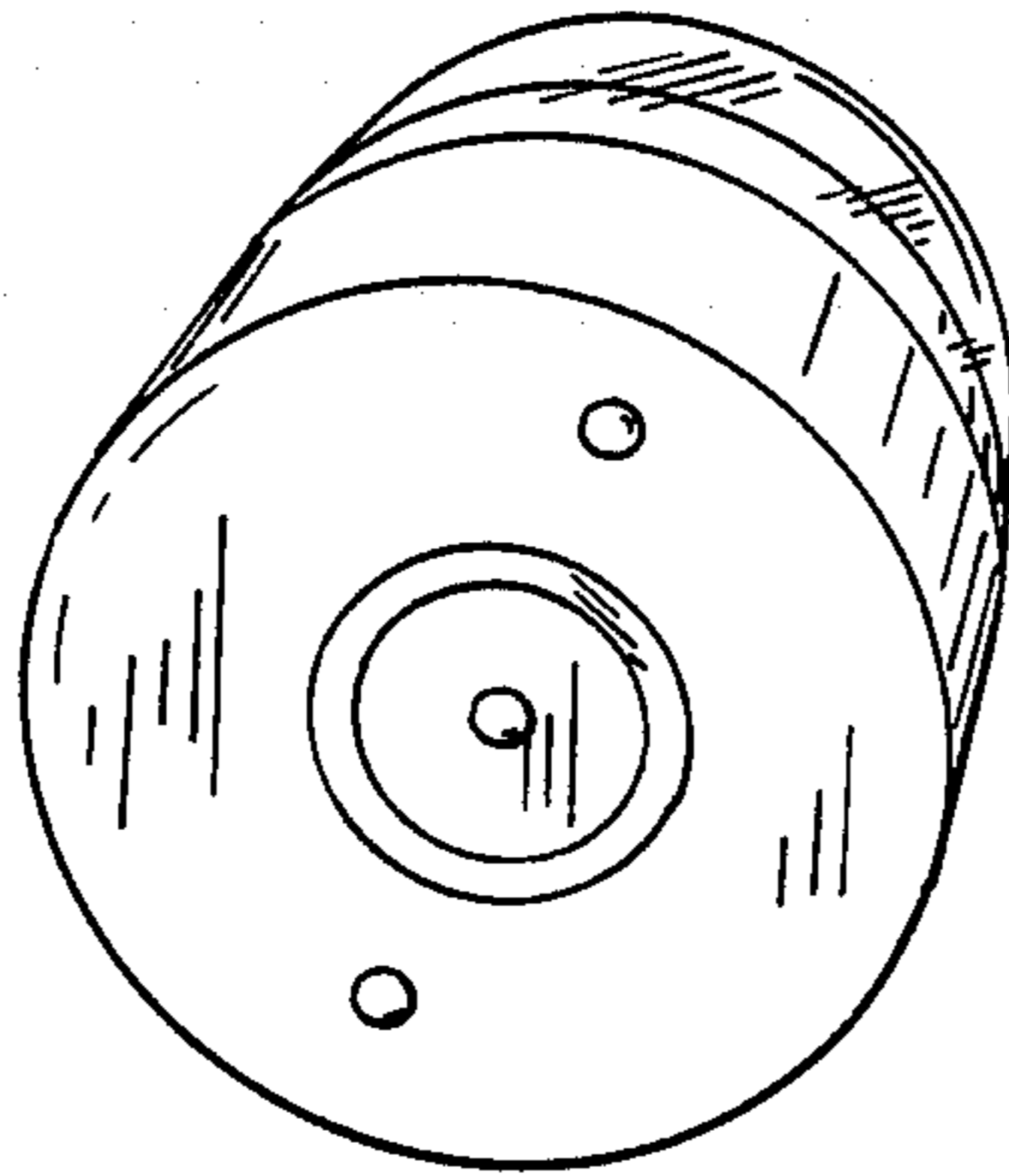

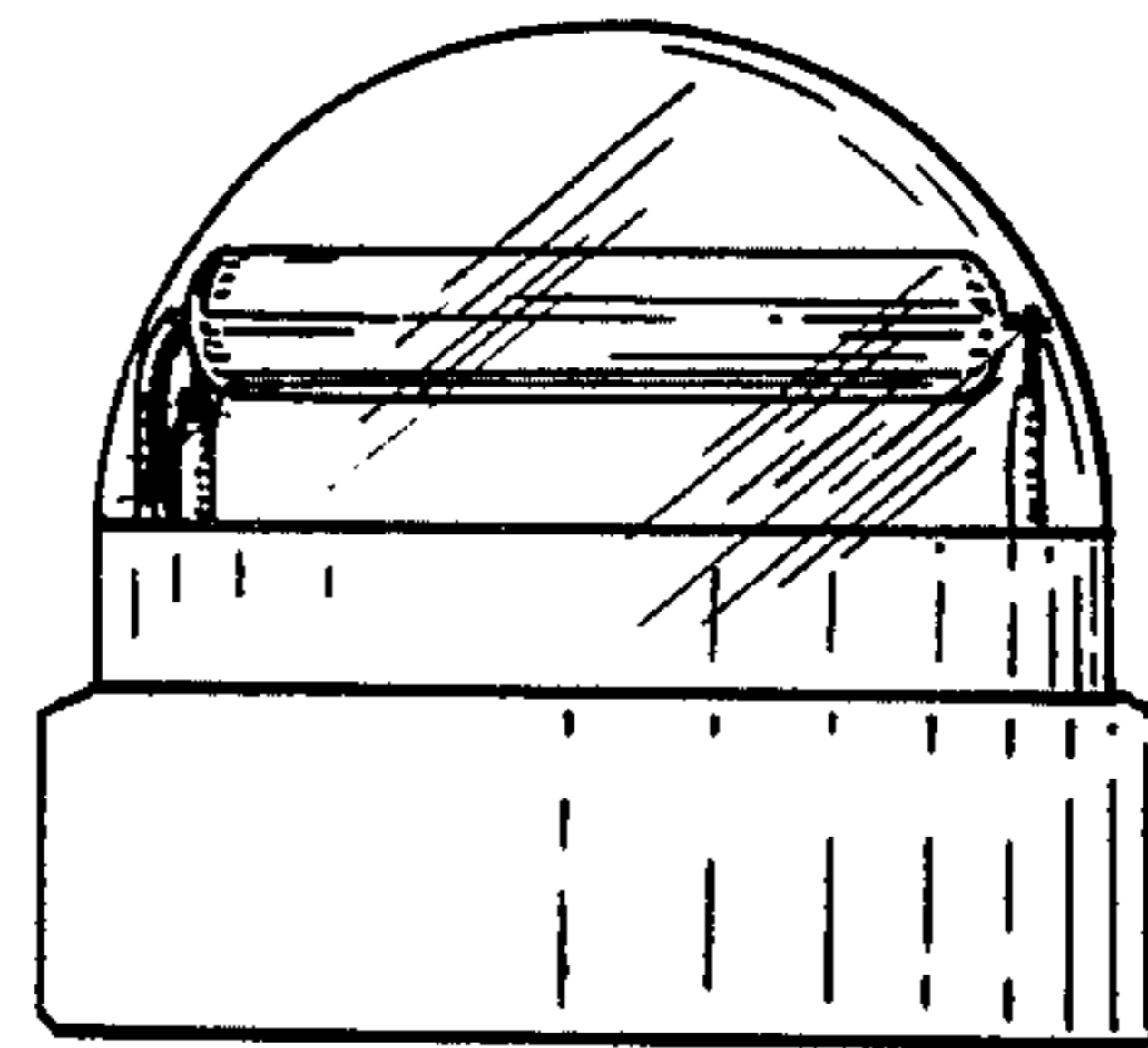
